Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Week

Andy Shadid, Sr., OF, Bradley

Shadid led the Braves to a 3-1 week by batting .438 with four doubles, two home runs and 11 RBI. Shadid had a .474 on-base percentage and 1.063 slugging percentage in the four games, giving him a 1.537 OPS this past week. Shadid did most of his damage late, going 5-for-8 with three doubles, two home runs, a sacrifice fly and nine RBI from the seventh inning on in the four games. In Tuesday's 4-2

loss to Illinois in 10 innings, Shadid hit a game-tying (1-1) home run in the seventh inning and a game-tying (2-2) sacrifice fly in the ninth inning. In Friday's 10-9 win against Missouri State, Shadid hit a RBI double in the ninth inning and came around to score the tying run. In Saturday's 16-9 win at Missouri State, Shadid hit a go-ahead (6-5), three-run double in the seventh inning, added a second double in the eighth inning and then capped Bradley's late-game outburst with a three-run home run in the ninth inning. Shadid then opened Sunday's scoring with a 2-run double in the second inning, sparking Bradley's 6-5 win to complete the sweep against the Bears.

Collin Liberatore, Jr., RHP, Indiana State

Indiana State junior Collin Liberatore set a new career high with 10 strikeouts as he helped clinch the series with a 7-2 victory over Southern Illinois Saturday. Liberatore held the Salukis to just two hits over eight innings on the mound. The right-hander retired seven-straight batters to close out his day while retiring the Salukis in order in four different innings. Liberatore issued just one free pass in the win of the 27 hitters he faced as he improved to 8-0 on the year.

NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and newcomer of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

Bryce Ball (DBU) – Junior Bryce Ball went 9-for-19 with two home runs, two doubles, and seven RBIs this week as DBU went 3-1 against TCU and MVC-leading Illinois State. Ball's second home run of the week sparked a four-run rally Sunday as the Patriots erased an early deficit to win the series.

Nate Reeder (UE) – Senior Designated Hitter Nate Reeder was a key contributor in the Aces' series win at Valparaiso this past weekend. At the plate, Reeder posted an eye-popping .545 batting average (6-for-11), a .636 slugging percentage, a .643 on-base percentage, while knocking in 4 RBI. Reeder remains the team leader in nearly all offensive categories, including a .354 batting average and 33 RBI.

Jordan Libman (ILS) – Jordan Libman was great for the Redbirds this week slashing .438/.500/.688, as he went 7-for-16 at the plate with a double, home run, three RBI, and two runs. Libman went 1-for-3 with a walk versus Northern Illinois on Tuesday, and in the series opener at DBU helping the Redbirds claim victory in both games. On Sunday, Libman homered to put the 'Birds up 2-0 in the first inning. Libman finished the day going 4-for-5 with a double as well. He also scored twice in the game.

Jarrod Watkins (INS) – Second baseman Jarrod Watkins hit for a team-best .626 batting average over the weekend against Southern Illinois in three starts. The senior scored five runs, drove in six and picked up one walk for a .615 on-base percentage. He recorded five extra-base hits over the weekend with four doubles and a home run for a 1.273 slugging percentage. A Washington, Illinois native, Watkins went 4-for-4 with three doubles in the series opener against SIU while hitting a two-run home run in the bottom of the first to put the Sycamores in front in the finale. He was also perfect fielding his position in 13 chances.

Dakota Kotowski (MSU) – Dakota Kotowski powered the Missouri State offense with a pair of home runs and a .429 batting mark in four games for the Bears last week. The freshman outfielder homered twice and recorded seven of his eight RBIs on the week in MSU's MVC series with Bradley over the weekend, going 5-for-10 overall against the Braves. In Friday's series opener, the Channahon, Ill., product hit a game-tying two-run blast, then drove in a career-best three runs with the first of back-to-back 2-for-4 performances in game two. In the finale on Sunday, Kotowski drove in two more runs and went deep for the ninth time in 2019, moving him into a tied for third place on the Bears' freshman home run list.

Will LaRue (SIU) – Will LaRue went 5-for-12 with a double, two runs scored, an RBI and four stolen bases for Southern Illinois at Indiana State. LaRue, who is playing through a broken wrist, had a four-hit game against the Sycamores on Sunday, matching the high hit total for any Saluki this season.

Jeremy Drudge (VALPO) – Drudge batted .400 (6-for-15) over Valpo's four games this week and .455 (5-for-11) in a three-game conference series. He collected three of Valpo's four hits in Friday's series opener against Evansville, accounting for his first career multi-hit game. The Valpo freshman followed that with his second multi-hit game in Sunday's series finale. He had six hits in four games this week after totaling six hits in his first 20 games.

Sam Lund (BRAD) – In a series that saw Missouri State score 23 runs on 23 hits in the 22 innings he did not pitch, Lund blanked the Bears on two hits in his 5.0 IP ... Lund allowed just two singles and one walk, while striking out two in his 5.0 innings of work to even his record at 3-3.

MD Johnson (DBU) – DBU senior righty MD Johnson was key in the Patriots' series-tying win over Illinois State on Saturday. Johnson threw 6.0 innings and allowed just three runs on seven hits with two walks and nine strikeouts. The start was his third of the season with nine or more strikeouts.

Michael Parks (UE) – Freshman RHP Michael Parks continues to be the most reliable arm out the University of Evansville bullpen. Last week, Parks made a trio of appearances, picking up a win and a save against Valparaiso, striking out six, walking none, while scattering four hits. Opponents posted just a paltry .190 batting average against the newcomer.

Brent Headrick (ILS) – Brent Headrick was outstanding in the series opener at DBU on Friday night. The left-handed pitcher hurled six complete innings allowing three hits, three runs, one earned run, walking two batters, and punching out 11. Headrick finished the game with a 1.50 ERA with batters hitting just .130 on the afternoon. The win moves him to 5-3 on the year with a 4.28 ERA.

Matt DeSomer (SIU) – Matt DeSomer pitched 3.2 scoreless innings at Indiana State, allowing just one hit and one walk. He limited the Sycamores to an .083 average and extended his streak of consecutive appearances without allowing an earned run to eight.

Zach Fricke (VALPO) – Fricke picked up his first career win, helping Valpo knock off Evansville 6-2 in the middle game of a three-game series this weekend. The Valpo right-hander pitched into the seventh inning for the first time in his young career, going 6 2/3 frames while yielding two runs on four hits. He walked five and struck out three. All four hits he permitted were singles. Fricke retired the side in order in three of the game's first six innings.

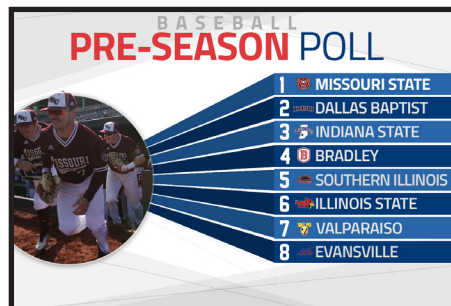

Valley RPI Ranks No. 6

According to the latest RPI update from WarrenNolan.com (April 29), the Missouri Valley Conference ranks No. 6 amongst 31 leagues. Four of the Power-Five conferences (SEC, Big 12, ACC, Pac-12) hold four of the top five positions, while the American sits fifth just ahead of The Valley.

The last time the MVC finished a season rated 6th in conference RPI was in 2015 when the league sent Bradley, DBU and Missouri State to the NCAA Tournament.

Five in RPI's Top-75

Five league teams continue to rank in the top-75 of the RPI, led by Illinois State (No. 29), DBU (No. 31), Indiana State (No. 348), Evansville (No. 49) and Bradley (No. 73).

Elite Company

The Valley has four teams ranking in the Top 50 of the RPI, joining four other leagues in the club. The SEC leads the nation with 12 teams in the RPI top 50, while the ACC (8), Big 12 (6), Pac-12 (7) and MVC (4) round out the elite club.

Wins Over Power Five

Entering this week's action, the MVC has earned 26 wins over members of Power Five conferences (26-39 record). The Valley sits 1-0 vs. the Pac-12, 2-1 vs. the ACC, 16-19 vs. the Big Ten, 5-9 vs. the Big 12 and 2-10 vs. the SEC.

Six of the eight MVC teams have earned wins against the Power Five. Indiana State leads the league with eight Power Five wins, including an 8-4 mark vs. the Big Ten. DBU has seven Power Five wins, while Evansville has four. Illinois State has three, while Missouri State and Bradley each have a pair.

This week's schedule features three games against Power Five teams. Southern Illinois will host Illinois on Tuesday, while Indiana State will travel to face the Illini on Wednesday. Illinois State will face Northwestern in Evanston on Tuesday.

Top 25 Wins

The Valley has earned five Top 25 wins this season. Indiana State has a pair of Top 25 wins on the season. The Sycamores beat #25 Michigan on April 9 and #25 Illinois on March 26. DBU also has a pair, beating #19 TCU on April 9 and #20 Texas A&M on March 12. Illinois State has the league's fifth Top 25 win, beating #1 Vanderbilt on March 10.

Top 50 RPI Wins

Five league teams have won three or more games against teams currently ranked in the Top 50 of the RPI. DBU sits 7-9 against the Top 50, while Evansville (6-11) has six wins. Indiana State (3-3), Illinois State (3-10) and Missouri State (3-16) each have three wins.

Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 13 leagues in non-conference play (ACC, Atlantic Sun, Colonial, Conference USA, Ivy, Metro Atlantic, Mid-American, Ohio Valley, Pac-12, Southern, Southland, Summit and WAC), and a .500 record against another two leagues (Horizon and Mountain West).

High Percentage

Indiana State enters the week with the 7th-best winning percentage in the nation (.780). The Sycamores' 32-9 mark features five losses which were by just one run.

Road Success

Entering this week's schedule, Illinois State is tied for second in the NCAA in road wins. The Redbirds have 17 road wins on the season which ranks tied for second with Creighton. Bryant leads the NCAA with 21 road wins this season. The Redbirds' 32 road games are tied with Xavier, Western Michigan and Oakland as the second-most nationally, trailing only Lafayette (33).

Close Calls

The MVC has a 29-23 non-conference record in one run contests this season, including a 9-7 mark in extra inning contests. The MVC sits 15-16 in two run games. The conference holds a 44-39 record in games decided by two runs or fewer.

Projected NCAA Field

Baseball America has two MVC teams in the projected NCAA field of 64 as of April 24. The publication has DBU as a No. 2 seed in the Fayetteville (Arkansas) Regional. Illinois State makes its first appearance in the projected field as the No. 3 seed in the Atlanta (Georgia Tech) Regional. Indiana State is currently listed among the "First Four Out", while Evansville is in the "Next Four Out."

Patriot Profile

DBU enters the week with a perfect record of 15-0 against teams with an RPI of 100+. The Patriots join Louisville (15-0), Mississippi State (14-0), North Carolina (12-0), NC State (15-0), Kentucky (16-0) and Washington (10-0) as the only teams in Division I with zero losses to teams rated outside the RPI Top 100.

Stopper of the Year

Illinois State's Jacob Gilmore listed among 45 student-athletes on the midseason NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award watch list, given to the top relief pitcher. Gilmore has 10 saves and a 3.32 ERA in 16 appearances this season, notching 30 strikeouts in 21.2 innings of work.

National Players of the Week

Bradley's Andy Shadid earned a spot on this week's Collegiate Baseball's National Players of the Week list. Shadid hit four doubles, two home runs and collected 11 RBI over a four game stretch last week against Illinois and Missouri State.

Strong Arms

Bradley currently boasts the nation's fourth-best team ERA at 3.01. Indiana State's staff is also enjoying a great season, sitting 8th nationally in team ERA (3.14).

Indiana State ranks 7th nationally with a 1.17 WHIP, while Bradley sits 18th (1.23 WHIP). Bradley sits 4th nationally in hits allowed per nine innings (6.87), while the Sycamores sit 12th (7.35). Indiana State also ranks 13th with five shutouts.

Quick Starts Crucial

If your team has plans on sitting atop the MVC standings heading into the league's postseason tournament, you might want to get off to a good start as all but one team that has won the MVC regular season has won at least 15 games since 2010, the first year of a 21-game conference schedule.

In the last nine seasons, Indiana State is the only league team to win the MVC regular season title with fewer than 15 league victories, as the Sycamores won the Valley with a 14-7 record in 2012.

Multi-Bid League

Since the 1981 season (38 seasons), the MVC has placed multiple teams into the NCAA Tournament 25 times (66%). On seven occasions (1985, 1990, 1995, 1999, 2000, 2012, 2015) the MVC has put three teams into the NCAA field.

Friday's ninth-inning rally from a 9-6 deficit ended Missouri State's streak of 163 consecutive games when leading after eight innings, dating to 2014, and snapped Bradley's 10-game losing streak to the Bears in Springfield ... By scoring 14 runs in the final three innings to rally for a 16-9 win Saturday, Bradley secured its first series win in Springfield since 1993, when weather shortened that series to a Braves doubleheader sweep ... Seven Weekend Sweeps

Indiana State has recorded seven weekend sweeps during the 2019 season, including four sweeps away from home (at Jacksonville, at UNCW Tournament, at Mercer and against Rutgers in Fort Myers). ISU has swept The Citadel, Valparaiso and most recently Southern Illinois at home. The 2018 Sycamores recorded just two road sweeps (at The Citadel and Valparaiso). The Sycamores took both games from Austin Peay earlier this season, but the finale was canceled due to weather.



Getting On Base

Three Sycamores rank in the top-15 in the Missouri Valley Conference in on-base percentage. Max Wright (.418) ranks sixth, Clay Dungan (.416) ranks ninth and Jake Means (.406) sits at 15th, respectively. Two of the three also sit in the top-10 in hit-by-pitch in the MVC with Means being beamed 11 times and Wright 10.

Pitching Strong for Trees

The Indiana State pitching staff has been outstanding this season, combining for a 3.14 team ERA which is 8th nationally. As a team, ISU also ranks 7th nationally with a 1.17 WHIP and 13th with five shutouts. ISU pitching has combined to hit just 14 batters which is second-best in the country. Five Sycamores have ERA's lower than 2.60 through 41 games. Starting pitcher Collin Liberatore has a 2.00 ERA in 11 starts and 72 innings while Tyler Ward has a 1.99 ERA in over 15 appearances out of the bullpen.

Kotowski Climbing

Bears freshman outfielder Dakota Kotowski turned in another strong stretch last week, hitting a team-best .429 (6-for-14) with two home runs and eight RBIs in MSU's four games against Mizzou and Bradley. Kotowski hit his eighth and ninth round-trippers of the season in the Bears' Valley series with Bradley and now shares the top spot on the MVC's home run leaderboard with five home runs during conference play. The Channahon, Ill., native also leads the league in slugging (.775) and ranks fourth in total bases (31) during Valley play. Additionally, he moved into a tie for third place on MSU's freshman home run list, matching the rookie season totals of Jeremy Eierman (2016), Matt Gardner (1999) and Nick Kays (1997).



April Showers

After winning its first four games in April, Missouri State has staggered down the stretch to drop 11 of its last 13 contests. That swoon has ensured the Bears will post their first sub-.500 month of April since 2007, when they went 4-13, and just their seventh losing April in 56 years as a varsity program. The month of April has traditionally been MSU strongest, with the Bears bringing a .630 all-time April winning percentage into Tuesday's game at Wichita State. May has been winning time for the Bears in recent years, however, with MSU winning 78-percent (49-14 overall) of its May contests since 2015.

Duffy Feeling at Home

Since moving to the top of the Bears' batting order on April 12, Jack Duffy has settled into the role of offensive catalyst nicely, logging a .340 batting mark in MSU's last 11 games. The junior outfielder has recorded six multi-hit performances, including a career-best four-hit effort vs. New Orleans on April 20, and has reached base safely in 10 of the 11 contests. The Kansas City product has also swiped three bags, including his second steal of home this season in Saturday's game against Bradley.

Former Saluki Football player Matt DeSomer pitched 3.2 scoreless innings at Indiana State this weekend, continuing his hot streak. DeSomer allowed five earned runs in a third of an inning on March 9 vs. Northern Illinois, which ballooned his ERA to 37.80. Since then (eight appearances), DeSomer has a 0.00 ERA in 13.1 innings, allowing just five hits, bringing his ERA all the way down to 4.20. His he has pitched 10.1 innings with a 0.00 ERA in MVC games, which trails only Indiana State's Tyler Ward (11.1) for most innings in league play without allowing an earned run. In those 10.1 innings, DeSomer is limiting opponents to an .088 batting average, which leads the league among players with 10+ innings pitched.

Southern Illinois alums Sam Coonrod and Matt Jones both start the 2019 minor league season in Triple-A. They are the frontrunners to become the 25th Saluki to earn a place in the Major Leagues. Most recently, Jason Frasor pitched for the Kansas City Royals in the 2014 World Series. The Salukis have had six players drafted and seven sign professional contracts in the last two years. Among those players, both Joey Marciano (SF Giants) and Connor Kopach (Seattle Mariners) have been assigned to High-A to start the year.

The Salukis went 9-for-10 stealing bases against Indiana State this weekend. Southern improved to 2.77 stolen bases per game, which ranks second in the country. Will LaRue went 4-for-4 and is averaging 0.58 stolen bases per game, which leads the league. 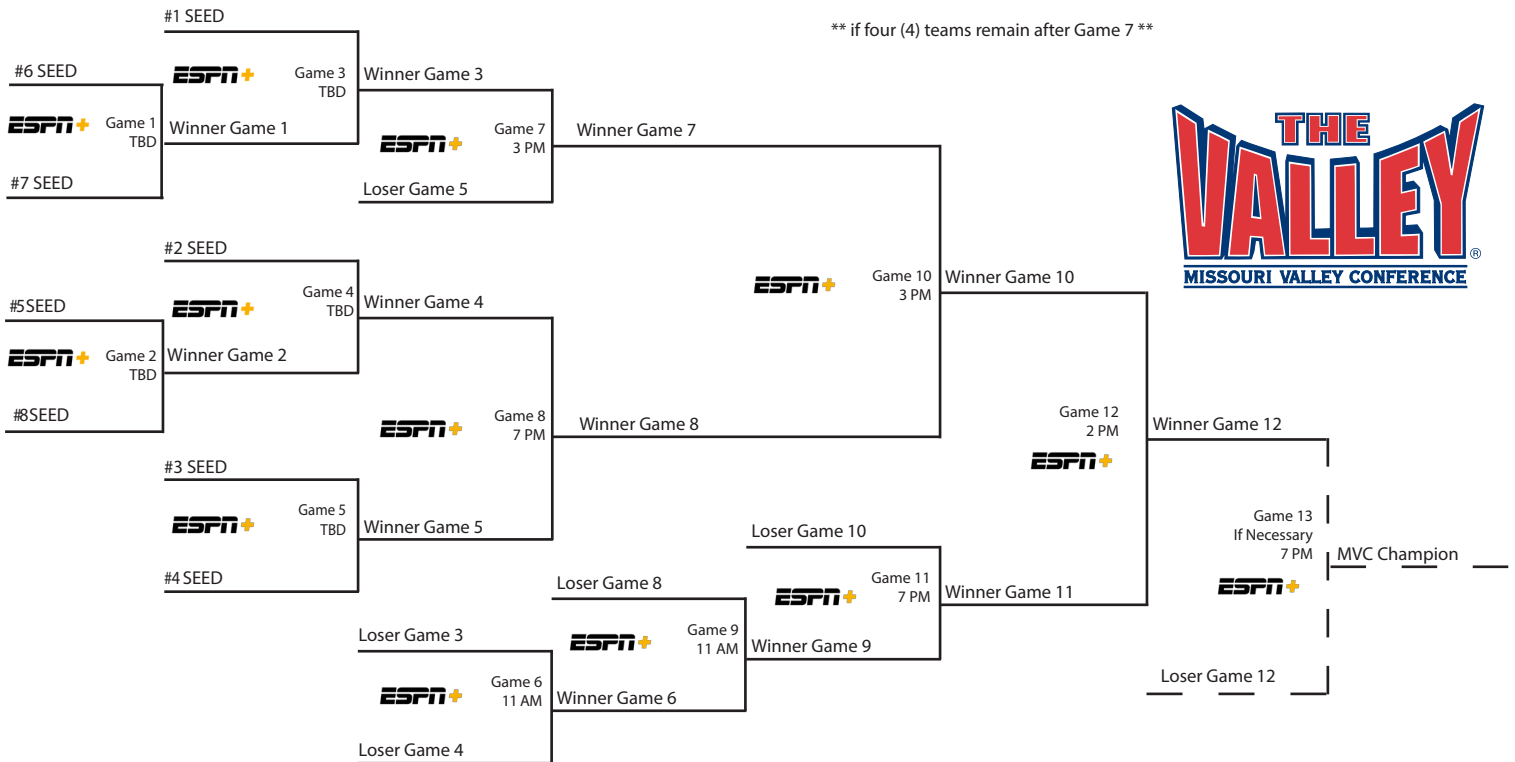

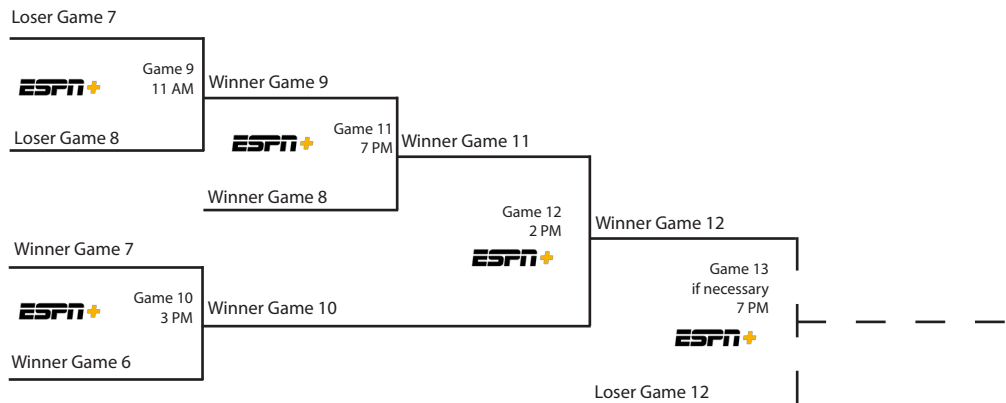
