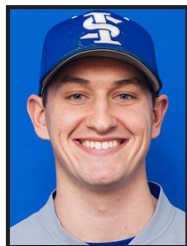
Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Week

Aiden McMahan, Sr., C, Southern Illinois

Southern Illinois' Aiden McMahan had 12 RBI in only 12 at-bats for the Salukis in their 5-0 week. McMahan went 5-for-12 and had a double, triple, home run, 12 RBI, four runs scored and two stolen bases. He slashed .417/.500/.917 for the week and had at least one RBI in all four games he played in. He went 1-for-2 with three walks and three RBIs in the win over Illinois and followed that up with a 3-for-4, 6 RBI performance in the series opener against Evansville—a game in which he was

just a single shy of the cycle.

Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week

Collin Liberatore, Jr., RHP, Indiana State

Indiana State's Collin Liberatore (9-0) put together another phenomenal performance on the mound against Illinois State to even the series in Normal Saturday. Liberatore went for at least seven innings for the eighth time this season as he cruised to his MVC leading ninth victory. The right-hander sat down the Redbirds in order in four different innings and retired seven batters in-a-row on two separate occasions. In total, Illinois State was able to spray just five hits against Liberatore over the course of eight innings as he shut down the Redbirds much of the day. The Greensburg, Pennsylvania native struck out eight and issued just two walks. Liberatore has a 1.80 ERA in 12 starts overall and a 0.67 ERA in MVC games.

NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and newcomer of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

Dan Bolt (BRAD) – Bolt filled the stats sheet during Bradley's series win against Valparaiso, batting .500 (4-8) with a 1.250 slugging percentage and .615 on-base percentage in the three games ... Bolt, who has reached base safely in 21 consecutive games, walked three times, was hit by a pitch and hit a sacrifice fly, giving him nine productive plate appearances in his 13 trips to the plate during the series ... In Friday's series opener, Bolt was 2-for-3 with a double and a first-inning RBI triple off the right center field wall ... He then came in to score what proved to be the winning run in Bradley's 2-1 victory ... In Saturday's 5-2 loss, Bolt hit a game-tying sacrifice fly in the first inning and then walked three times ... Bolt finished the series by going 2-for-4 Sunday with a walk-off, 2-run home run in the 7th to invoke The Valley's 10-run rule ... Bolt now is batting .329 and leads the team with a .589 slugging percentage and .451 on-base percentage ... He also leads the Braves with nine home runs and is second with 35 RBI.

Jake Means (INS) – Third baseman Jake Means hit for a team-best .417 batting average over the last week for the Sycamores. The senior scored four runs, drove in three and picked up two walks for a .556 on-base percentage. He recorded one extra-base hits over the week for a .500 slugging percentage. A Gardner, Kansas native, Means went 2-for-3 with three RBIs in the Sycamores 13-1 victory to even the series with Illinois State Saturday.

Drew Millas (MSU) – Drew Millas continued to swing a hot bat for the Bears, hitting .333 over the weekend against DBU to help MSU claim two of three Valley games from the Patriots. Millas recorded a hit in all three games vs. DBU, including a 2-for-3 effort that included an RBI single as part of MSU's decisive four-run rally in game two. The junior All-American also extended his career-best streak of consecutive games reaching base safely to 20 in a row.

Blake Billinger (VALPO) – Billinger batted .455 over a three-game weekend series at Bradley. He helped Valpo get off to strong starts in all three games by going 3-for-3 with two doubles and an RBI single in the first inning alone during the series. Billinger had three doubles for the weekend including two in Sunday's series finale, his first multi-double game of the season and the fourth of his Valpo career. He leads the team in home runs (9), doubles (11), hits (47), RBIs (32), slugging (.588) and OBP (.414).

Mitch Janssen (BRAD) – The starting pitcher in Bradley's 2-1 win Friday night against Valparaiso, Janssen recorded a career-best 11 strikeouts while allowing just one run on seven hits in his 7.0 IP ... After allowing a first-inning run, Janssen was scoreless over his final 6.1 IP Friday, lowering his season ERA to 1.45 ... Four of Janssen's five Valley starts have ended in one-run decisions, including a pair of 2-1 victories and a 1-0 loss, and the fifth was his 8-0 shutout against Southern Illinois.

Jordan Martinson (DBU) – DBU senior lefty Jordan Martinson turned in one of his best outings of the season Thursday in a 6-1 win at Missouri State. Martinson went 7.0 innings and allowed just one run on five hits with three walks and eight strikeouts.

Brent Headrick (ILS) – Brent Headrick was phenomenal in the series opener against Indiana State on Friday night. The left-handed pitcher tossed a complete game allowing five hits, three runs, three earned runs, walking two batters, and punching out nine. The performance was Headrick's first career complete game in a Redbird uniform. The win improves Headrick's record to 6-3 with a 4.11 ERA on the season.

Davis Schwab (MSU) – Davis Schwab turned in his best start as a Bear Saturday to complete a doubleheader sweep that locked up a series win over DBU, tossing 5.0 innings of one-hit ball with a career-high eight strikeouts. The senior lefty combined with two relievers on the first one-hit shutout by a Bear in 10 years, allowing just a third-inning single in the 6-0 MSU victory

Trey McDaniel (SIU) – Trey McDaniel pitched five shutout innings and earned three saves for Southern Illinois in its 5-0 week. McDaniel pitched in all five games, going an inning in each contest. He struck out seven and allowed just one hit, limiting opponents to an .063 batting average. McDaniel saved all three games of the Evansville series, becoming the first SIU player to save every game of the series since 2007.

Jon Tieman (VALPO) – Tieman pitched an eight-inning complete game in a 2-1 defeat to Bradley on Friday with both runs he allowed coming in the first inning. He racked up seven strikeouts while scattering six hits and two walks. Tieman threw a pair of complete games a year ago, both of the nine-inning variety and both wins as the right-hander beat Evansville and Illinois State. All three complete games in his career have come on the road and in conference play. Tieman becomes the first Valpo pitcher with three career complete games since Trevor Haas had three during the 2015 and 2016 seasons.

Valley RPI Ranks No. 6

According to the latest RPI update from WarrenNolan.com (May 6), the Missouri Valley Conference ranks No. 6 amongst 31 leagues. Four of the Power-Five conferences (SEC, Big 12, ACC, Pac-12) hold four of the top five positions, while the American sits fifth just ahead of The Valley.

The last time the MVC finished a season rated 6th in conference RPI was in 2015 when the league sent Bradley, DBU and Missouri State to the NCAA Tournament.

Five in RPI's Top-100

Five league teams continue to rank in the top-75 of the RPI, led by Indiana State (No. 29), Illinois State (No. 31), DBU (No. 33), Evansville (No. 64) and Bradley (No. 95).

Wins Over Power Five

Entering this week's action, the MVC has earned 27 wins over members of Power Five conferences (27-41 record). The Valley sits 1-0 vs. the Pac-12, 2-1 vs. the ACC, 17-21 vs. the Big Ten, 5-9 vs. the Big 12 and 2-10 vs. the SEC.

Seven of the eight MVC teams have earned wins against the Power Five. Indiana State leads the league with eight Power Five wins, including an 8-4 mark vs. the Big Ten. DBU has seven Power Five wins, while Evansville has four. Illinois State has three, while Missouri State and Bradley each have a pair. Southern Illinois has one win.

This week's schedule features one game against a Power Five team. Valparaiso will travel to Michigan State on Tuesday, looking for its first Power Five win of the season.

Top 25 Wins

The Valley has earned five Top 25 wins this season. Indiana State has a pair of Top 25 wins on the season. The Sycamores beat #25 Michigan on April 9 and #25 Illinois on March 26. DBU also has a pair, beating #19 TCU on April 9 and #20 Texas A&M on March 12. Illinois State has the league's fifth Top 25 win, beating #1 Vanderbilt on March 10.

Top 50 RPI Wins

Five league teams have won four or more games against teams currently ranked in the Top 50 of the RPI. DBU sits 6-7 against the Top 50, while Evansville (5-9) and Missouri State (5-17) have five wins. Indiana State (4-5) and Illinois State (4-12) each have four wins.

Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 13 leagues in non-conference play (ACC, Atlantic Sun, Colonial, Conference USA, Ivy, Metro Atlantic, Mid-American, Ohio Valley, Pac-12, Southern, Southland, Summit and WAC), and a .500 record against another two leagues (Horizon and Mountain West).

High Percentage

Indiana State enters the week with the 8th-best winning percentage in the nation (.756). The Sycamores' 34-11 mark features six losses which were by just one run.

Road Success

Entering this week's schedule, Illinois State is tied for second in the NCAA in road wins. The Redbirds have 17 road wins on the season which ranks tied for second with Fairfield. Bryant and Creighton lead the NCAA with 21 road wins this season. The Redbirds' 33 road games are third nationally, trailing only Lafayette (34) and Oakland (35).

Close Calls

The MVC has a 29-23 non-conference record in one run contests this season, including a 9-7 mark in extra inning contests. The MVC sits 15-16 in two run games. The conference holds a 44-39 record in games decided by two runs or fewer.

Projected NCAA Field

Baseball America has three MVC teams in the projected NCAA field of 64 as of May 1. The publication has DBU as a No. 2 seed in the Fayetteville (Arkansas) Regional, Illinois State is the No. 3 seed in the Morgantown (West Virginia) Regional and Indiana State as the No. 3 seed in the Louisville Regional. Evansville is currently listed among the "Next Four Out."

Stopper of the Year

Illinois State's Jacob Gilmore listed among 45 student-athletes on the midseason NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award watch list, given to the top relief pitcher. Gilmore has 10 saves and a 3.32 ERA in 16 appearances this season, notching 30 strikeouts in 21.2 innings of work.

Strong Arms

Bradley boasts the nation's second-best team ERA at 3.01. Indiana State's staff is also enjoying a great season, sitting 6th nationally in team ERA (3.10).

Indiana State ranks 5th nationally with a 1.17 WHIP, while Bradley sits 15th (1.22 WHIP). Bradley sits 4th nationally in hits allowed per nine innings (6.89), while the Sycamores sit 14th (7.46). Indiana State also ranks 16th with five shutouts.

15 is the Magic Number

If your team has plans on sitting atop the MVC standings heading into the league's postseason tournament, you might want to get off to a good start as all but one team that has won the MVC regular season has won at least 15 games since 2010, the first year of a 21-game conference schedule.

In the last nine seasons, Indiana State is the only league team to win the MVC regular season title with fewer than 15 league victories, as the Sycamores won the Valley with a 14-7 record in 2012.

Multi-Bid League

Since the 1981 season (38 seasons), the MVC has placed multiple teams into the NCAA Tournament 25 times (66%). On seven occasions (1985, 1990, 1995, 1999, 2000, 2012, 2015) the MVC has put three teams into the NCAA field.

The Arm of April

Collin Liberatore dominated the month of April on the mound for ISU. In four starts, the junior allowed just four runs in 32.2 innings for a 1.10 ERA. The right-hander struck out 19 and walked just seven while allowing just 16 hits and holding opponents to a .147 average against.

Pitching Strong for Trees

The Indiana State pitching staff has been outstanding this season, combining for a 3.10 team ERA which is 7th-best nationally. As a team, ISU also ranks 5th nationally with a 1.17 WHIP, 14th in hits per nine innings (7.46) and 16th with five shutouts. ISU pitching has combined to hit just 15 batters which is second-fewest in the country. Indiana State's MVC ERA sits at 2.44 in 15 games. The next best team is Evansville at 3.71. Starting pitcher Collin Liberatore (9-0) has a 1.80 ERA in 12 starts and 80 innings while Tyler Ward (5-1, 5 SV) has a 1.85 ERA in over 16 appearances out of the bullpen.

Nailing It Down

Easton Rhodehouse earned the seventh save of his Valpo career in Saturday's victory over Bradley, in the process climbing into the Top 10 in program history in career saves. He is now part of a six-way tie for eighth in the Valpo record book that also includes Jon Tieman despite the fact that Tieman spent less than a full season pitching out of the bullpen.



Scoreless Streak

Valpo reliever Montana Quigley continued his scoreless streak with an important hold in Saturday's 5-2 win over Bradley. The redshirt junior did not allow a run over 2 2/3 scoreless innings. In the sixth, he inherited a two-on, one-out jam and worked out of it, then in the seventh Bradley loaded the bases against him but couldn't push across a run. Quigley has not allowed a run over his last five outings spanning nine innings. During that stretch, Quigley has allowed one run (none earned) on four hits and two walks. Over his first nine appearances of the season, Quigley held a 10.32 ERA, allowing 14 runs (13 earned) on 19 hits including seven home runs while walking five.

Going the Distance

Valpo starting pitcher Jon Tieman's loss in Friday's series opener at Bradley was about as "tough luck" as they come. Tieman pitched an eight-inning complete game in a 2-1 defeat to the Braves with both runs he allowed coming in the first inning. He racked up seven strikeouts while scattering six hits and two walks. Tieman threw a pair of complete games a year ago, both of the nine-inning variety and both wins as the right-hander beat Evansville and Illinois State. All three complete games in his career have come on the road and in conference play. Tieman is the first Valpo pitcher with three career complete games since Trevor Haas had three during the 2015 and 2016 seasons.

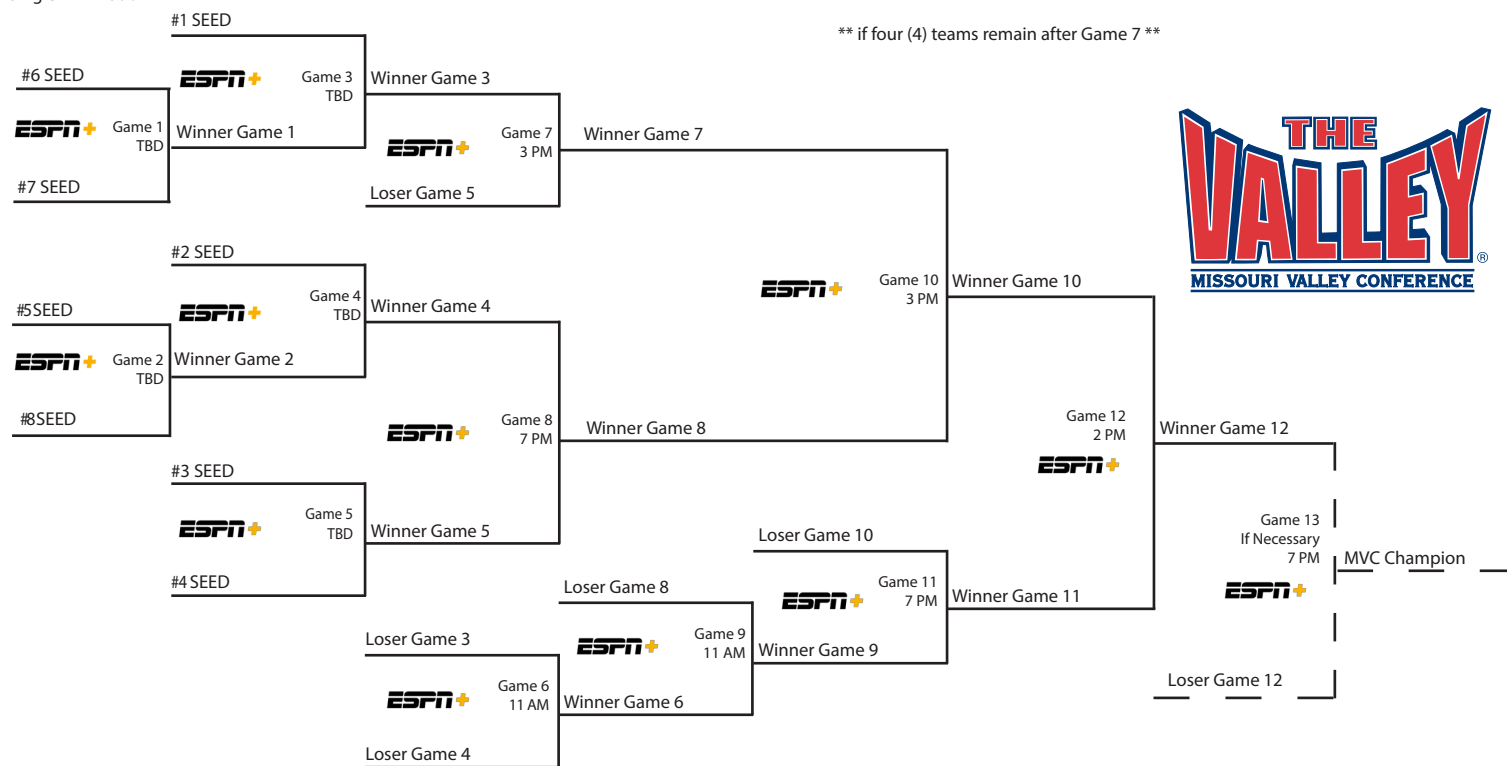

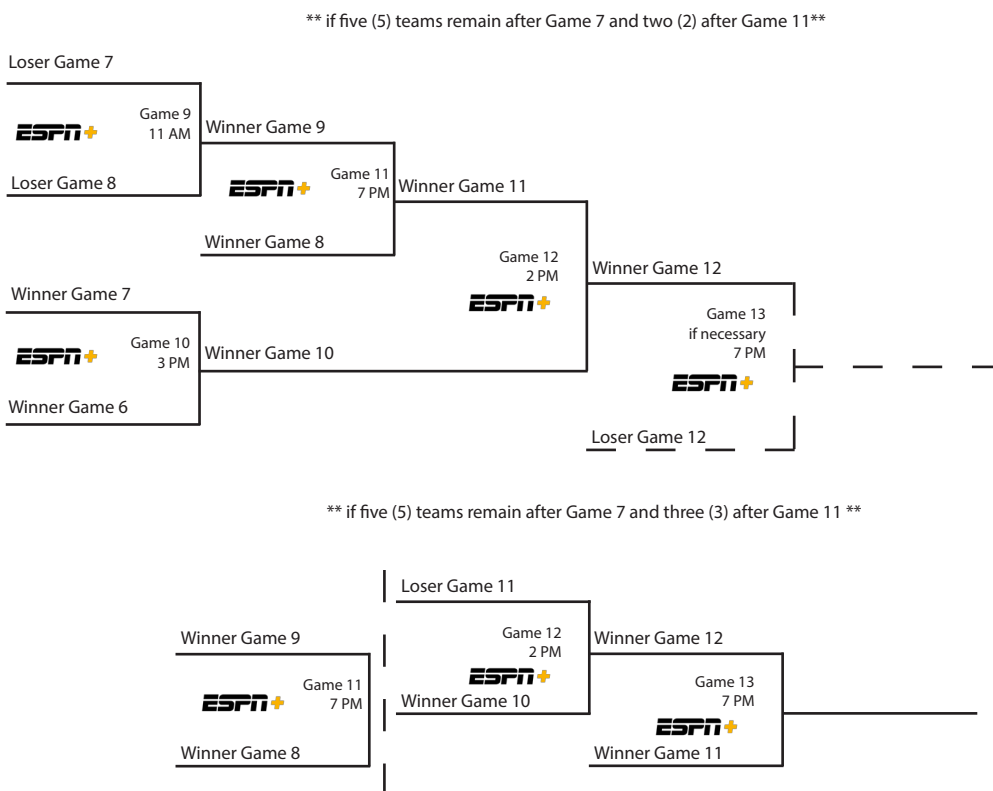
