## **MVC Offensive Player of the Week**

## Stuart Wilkin, Sr., M, Missouri State

Stuart Wilkin recorded goals in back-to-back matches for Missouri State as the Bears opened conference play with a pair of wins against Valparaiso and Loyola to remain perfect on the season. Wilkin launched a game-winning goal in overtime to complete the Bears' comeback in a 2-1 win over Loyola on Sunday. The senior from Surrey scored his first goal of 2019 in the fifth minute of MSU's 3-1 win over Valparaiso on Wednesday, Sept. 18 in the conference opener for both squads. Wilkin tallied

consecutive multi-shot matches to increase his season total to 12 shots which ranks sixth in the league.

## **NOTEWORTHY**

In addition to the league's player of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

**Leroy Enzugusi (DU)** - Enzugusi notched a highlight reel goal in Drake's 2-0 win over Bradley in its MVC opener. He spun his defender around with a fake inside before darting back outside, only to evade another defender with a sharp cut into the heart of the box. Enzugusi curled a beauty of a shot into the side netting to seal his team-best third goal of the season. He also leads Drake with six points and 25 shots thus far in 2019.

Justin Sukow (LUC) - Sukow scored two goals this week against two conference foes, including the game-winner over Evansville. The second goal against Missouri State provided Loyola with a early 1-0 lead and eventually forced the Bears into overtime. Sukow currently tops the Ramblers leaderboard with four goals and 10 points this season.

Adan Garcia (VALPO) - Garcia scored the matchwinner in the 81st minute of Sunday's 2-1 victory over Evansville. He beat several defenders to create a one-on-one with the keeper and converted from 12 yards out for his first goal of the season. Garcia is up to 11 career goals. He notched a game-winner for the second time in his career and the first time since Oct. 30, 2017 against Eastern Illinois.

**Edvin Holst (VALPO)** - Holst grabbed 11 saves over two Missouri Valley Conference matches this week, boosting his season total to 29 in five outings. He earned his first collegiate victory on Sunday, helping Valpo beat Evansville 2-1 with the only goal permitted coming on an own goal by a Valpo player.



## **MVC SOCCER NOTES**

## No Place Like Home

MVC men's soccer programs have been extremely successful at home this nonconference season, sitting 11-2-2 on their home pitches. The start is the best in MVC men's soccer since the 2009 season when MVC programs went 16-4-2 at home in non-league play.

In conference matches, home teams are currently 3-2-0 to begin the season.

## **Bears End Ramblers Streak**

Missouri State came from behind to earn a 2-1 overtime win at Loyola Sunday afternoon, snapping the Ramblers 8-match win streak (dating back to Sept. 7, 2018). The streak was tied for the fifth longest active streak in NCAA Division I.

## **Bears Remain Perfect**

Missouri State extended its winning streak to six games with a pair of MVC wins last week. The Bears have opened their season with six straight wins for the first time since the 1995 team went 7-0 to begin the season. The six-game winning streak is Missouri State's longest winning streak since 2017.

The Bears are one of 10 teams still sitting perfect in all of NCAA Division I, joining Stanford, SMU, St. John's, Saint Mary's, Clemson, Navy, Virginia, Georgetown and Cal St. Fullerton.

## Streaking

Drake saw its win streak reach three straight with wins over Western Illinois and Bradley last week. Goalkeeper Luke Anderson has recorded three straight shutouts in just seven career starts, good for a shutouts per game average of .429, which ranks first in the MVC this season.

## **RPI Update**

According to RPI Update (not official NCAA) Missouri State sits 10th in the RPI at this point with Loyola coming in at No. 24. Valparaiso also currently sits in the Top 100, sitting No. 78 this week. The MVC ranks 10th as a conference.

## National Team of the Week

Drake's Liam Wilson earned a spot on this week's 11-member College Soccer News Team of the Week, after anchoring the Bulldogs' backline in shutout wins over Western Illinois and Bradley. Missouri State's Stuart Wilkin was named to the Top Drawer Soccer Team of the Week for his two goals in a pair of Bears wins.

## **Polling**

Missouri State entered the national rankings this week, appearing at No. 19 in the latest United Soccer Coaches Top 25 poll, No. 24 in the TopDrawerSoccer.com Top 25 and No. 27 in the College Soccer News Top 30 poll.

## **MVC** in Regional Rankings

The MVC has two teams currently ranked in the latest United Soccer Coaches West Regional rankings released on Tuesday (Sept. 24). Missouri State sits No. 2 in the region, while Loyola is ranked sixth.

## **VALPARAISO (2-4-1, 1-1 MVC)**

## **Scary Schedule**

Although Valpo did not get the results it was hoping for on a recent four-game road trip, the level of competition faced during the journey was fierce. SMU was ranked as high as 16th at the time of the meeting and has now vaulted into the Top 10 in most national polls. Missouri State is also receiving votes nationally



and is a fridge Top 25 side. The combined records of SMU, Missouri State, UIC and Oral at the time of the meetings with Valpo was 21-2-0.

## Comeback Kids

Valpo faced a 1-0 deficit as late as the 77th minute on Sunday afternoon against Evansville, but a pair of quick strikes from Dylan Waugaman and Adan Garcia helped Valpo to a 2-1 victory over the Purple Aces. Valpo won after allowing the first goal of the match for the first time since last October, when the team came from 1-0 down to beat Eastern Illinois with two second-half tallies. However, this was the first time in Mike Avery's 13-year head coaching tenure at Valpo that his side was trailing as late as the 77th minute and found a way to win in regulation.

## **Garcia Goal Count**
