MVC Player of the Week

Kaylee Martin, Jr., OH, Illinois State

Kaylee Martin went off this weekend, as the Redbirds opened MVC play with a pair of sweeps for the second-straight year. The junior accumulated 34 kills to average 5.67 kills per set behind an impressive .483 hitting. In ISU's conference-opening sweep of Missouri State, Martin turned in a three-set career-high 20 kills on .621 hitting to help the Redbirds finish with the league's weekend-best single-match attacking percentage of .344. Martin kept her foot on the gas pedal on Saturday, returning to the court and tallying a match-leading 14 kills, while hitting at a .355 clip, in ISU's sweep of the Salukis. The Sterling, Illinois, native also added nine digs (1.50 per set) on the weekend. Her hitting percentage against MSU was the second-highest in the league this weekend, while her combined kills per set average (5.67) ranks second in the MVC.

MVC Defensive Player of the Week

Abbi Staack, Sr., L/DS, UNI

UNI senior Abbi Staack totaled 53 digs (6.6 per set), five assists, and one kill in two matches over the weekend as the Panthers started league play with wins over Evansville and Indiana State. Staack recorded 23 digs in the team's first MVC match of the season, taking on Evansville. The senior libero recorded just her second kill of the year on a rare attack attempt. Staack added 30 digs against Indiana State to help the Panthers move to 2-0 in the MVC.

MVC Freshman of the Week

Melanie Feliciano, Fr., OH, Evansville

In the Aces opening week of conference play, freshman Melanie Feliciano led the team with 5.75 kills per set while hitting a team-high .279 in a weekend split at UNI and Drake. In the opener against the Panthers, Feliciano led the team with 22 kills and two block assists. She added 14 digs as the Aces gave the Panthers all they could handle in a 3-1 match. On Saturday, Feliciano hit an impressive .389 with 24 kills in 54 tries to lead Evansville to a 3-1 road win over Drake. She added nine digs, an ace and block.

NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and freshman of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

Kat Poore (BRAD) - Poore hit .424 in the first two MVC matches of the season, averaging 3.00 kills and 0.89 blocks per set. She entered the first weekend of league play with just one career match with 10 or more kills but had outings of 17 and 10 kills over the weekend. Poore notched a career-best 17 kills, while hitting .366 in the Valley opener against Southern Illinois and also had four blocks against the Salukis. She returned the next night to collect 10 kills with no errors on 18 attacks (.556 hitting percentage) in a four-set victory over Missouri State. Poore added four blocks against the Bears as Bradley earned its third straight victory in the series with MSU.

Paige Aspinwall (DU) - Led Drake on the opening weekend of MVC play with a 81 total assists and 34 digs to help the Bulldogs go 1-1 ... in nine total sets played, she averaged 9.0 assists per set and 3.78 digs per set ... in the Bulldogs five-set win over Indiana State, she recorded a double-double with 40 assists and a career-high 20 digs ... she followed that with 41 assists in four sets against Evansville with 14 digs ... she also had three aces in the two matches.

Chloe Mason (INS) - Chloe Mason had an impressive start to her Valley career over the weekend. Opening at Drake and Northern Iowa, the freshman setter recorded two double-doubles, eclipsing the 20-assist mark in each match. Against the Bulldogs Mason ended with 27 assists as well as 15 digs, while she tallied 23 assists and 13 digs against UNI. Additionally, she earned two kills against Drake on Friday. She is currently eighth in the valley with 5.56 assists-per-set and seventh in aces-per-set at .37.

Elle Van Grinsven (LUC) - Van Grinsven turned in her best performance of the season in Loyola's Valley opener, a sweep of local rival Valparaiso on September 27. The junior middle blocker totaled a season-high 11 kills and added a career-best nine blocks, two aces and a pair of assists, while hitting .667 (11-1-15). On the year, the 2017 MVC All-Freshman Team selection is contributing 1.91 kills and 0.91 blocks per set and is hitting at a .238 (82-31-214) clip. When Van Grinsven delivers double-digit kills this season, Loyola, which was won seven of its last 10 matches, is 2-0.

Aubrey Cheffey (MSU) - Aubrey Cheffey averaged a team-high 2.71 kills and 3.00 points per set in the opening weekend of MVC play, hitting .241 with five digs, two blocks and an ace in two road matches. Cheffey hit .333 with a match-high 16 kills Saturday at Bradley, adding four digs, two blocks and one ace against the Braves. She had three kills and a digs Friday at Illinois State.

Kaylissa Arndorfer (UNI) - Kaylissa Arndorfer finished the week with 21 kills and only 2 errors for a .543 hitting percentage while taking on MVC rivals Evansville and Indiana State. The freshman middle hitter totaled 4 service aces, 7 digs and 3 blocks over the weekend as well. The Waterloo native had her breakout match of the year against Indiana State, recording 18 kills with just one error for a .548 hitting percentage. Arndorfer added 6 digs and 3 block assists to finish with 22 total points.

Hannah Becker (SIU) - Hannah Becker hit at a .269 clip with a team-best 2.88 kills per set as Southern split on opening weekend of Missouri Valley Conference play. The redshirt sophomore hit at a career-best .362 clip and put down a career-high 18 kills on 47 swings with just one error in SIU's five-set win over Bradley. She followed with five kills and just one error the following night against Illinois State.

Emma Raleigh (BRAD) - Raleigh averaged a team-best 5.11 digs per set and the libero collected her first career double-double during the opening weekend of conference action, averaging 1.56 assists per set. Friday, she had a career-best 28 digs to go with a career-high 10 assists in a five-set contest Southern Illinois. Raleigh tallied a match-high 18 digs to help highlight Saturday's four-set victory over Missouri State. She added four assists and an ace in the win as the Braves earned their third straight victory in the series with the Bears.

Gillian Gergen (DU) - Led Drake at the net with 13 total blocks on the weekend for a 1.44 blocks per set average ... in the MVC opener against Indiana State, she recorded a career-high 11 blocks ... she also led Drake in hitting on the weekend at .289 with 12 total kills ... also added eight digs in the front row and had three aces.

Gabriela Macedo (UE) - One of the top defensive players in the Valley showed her abilities once again as the Aces opened their MVC schedule with a trip to Iowa. The senior led the team with 8.00 digs per set, accumulating a total of 64 in eight sets. She also posted nine assists and an ace over the weekend. Macedo got the weekend started with 34 digs and five assists at UNI. Her dig average translated to 8.5 per set. She was back at it once again against Drake adding 30 digs and four helpers in a 3-1 UE victory.

Kendal Meier (ILS) - Kendal Meier paced Illinois State's defense in a pair of sweeps to open MVC competition this weekend. Meier and the Redbirds held their opponents to a combined .084 hitting percentage, including keeping the Bears at a .020 clip in ISU's conference-opening victory. In the Redbirds' opening set against the Salukis, Meier and ISU's defense held SIU to a .086 hitting percentage. The junior finished with 31 digs on the weekend, averaging a team-best 5.17 digs per set - the sixth-best average in the league.

Melina Tedrow (INS) - Melina Tedrow once again led the defensive effort for Indiana State over the weekend, surpassing the 20-dig mark for the sixth time this season. Against Drake on Friday evening she tallied a season-high 27 digs and followed that performance with 21 digs at the McLeod Center against UNI on Saturday. Currently, Tedrow has recorded 206 digs in 42 sets, putting her at third in the Valley in digs-per-set with 4.90.

Maddy Moser (LUC) - In Loyola's three-set sweep of Valparaiso last Friday, Moser accounted for a team-high 16 digs as the Ramblers won for the seventh time in the last 10 matches. Moser now ranks fourth in Loyola annals with 1,347 digs. She is putting up 5.16 digs and 0.35 aces per set this fall.

Emma Baalman (SIU) - Emma Baalman averaged a team-best 1.00 blocks per set, 1.75 kills per set and hit at a .458 clip as the Salukis split on the opening weekend of Missouri Valley Conference play. The redshirt junior tallied three-plus blocks in each of SIU's matches over the weekend, including five in the win over Bradley. She also hit .455, put down six kills and a career-best 10 digs in the wins over the Braves.

Raeann Bergman (BRAD) - Bergman hit .387 in the first two MVC matches of her Bradley career, averaging 2.14 kills and 1.00 blocks per set last week. She collected five kills, one dig and two blocks in her three sets against Southern Illinois in Bradley's MVC opener Friday. Bergman returned the next night to tally 10 kills with no errors on 18 attacks (.556) in addition to notching a team-best five blocks in a four-set victory against Missouri State. Bergman is hitting a MVC-leading .367 on the year.

Haley Bush (DU) - Led Drake offensively during the opening weekend of MVC action with 42 total kills in nine sets of action to average 4.67 kills per set ... also had 18 total digs to nearly average a double-double ... in the five-set win over Indiana State, she had 25 kills (one shy of a career high) and 12 digs ... followed that with a team-high 17 kills against Evansville.

Sarah Kushner (ILS) - Sarah Kushner finished the weekend with 15 kills to average 2.50 kills per set behind a .154 hitting percentage in a pair of wins for ISU to open MVC play. The rookie tallied five kills and three assists, while collecting seven digs in the conference-opening sweep of Missouri State. Kushner returned to the court on Saturday and registered her fourth double-double of the season with 10 kills and 10 digs on .250 hitting in ISU's victory over the Salukis.

Chloe Mason (INS) - Chloe Mason had an impressive start to her Valley career over the weekend. Opening at Drake and Northern Iowa, the freshman setter recorded two double-doubles, eclipsing the 20-assist mark in each match. Against the Bulldogs Mason ended with 27 assists as well as 15 digs, while she tallied 23 assists and 13 digs against UNI. Additionally, she earned two kills against Drake on Friday. She is currently eighth in the valley with 5.56 assists-per-set and seventh in aces-per-set at .37.

Taylor Venuto (LUC) - Venuto continued her dazzling play in her rookie campaign, sharing the team lead with 11 kills as Loyola rolled to a 25-12, 25-17, 25-22 victory over Valparaiso September 27. The middle hitter hit .526 (11-1-19) and added an assist as the Ramblers won for the seventh time in their last 10 outings. For the year, Venuto has slammed 10 or more kills on eight occasions and she is recording 3.04 kills and 1.04 blocks per set, while hitting a team-best .364 (152-34-324).

Abi Fitzpatrick (SIU) - Fitzpatrick averaged 2.38 digs per set to help the Salukis split on the opening weekend of MVC play. The freshman defensive specialist tallied 14 digs in SIU's win at Bradley, and notched an ace in each of Southern's matches over the weekend.

Hot Starts

For the second-straight year, Illinois State opened conference play with a pair of sweeps against Missouri State and Southern Illinois. ISU's three-set win over the Bears marked the third-consecutive sweep of MSU, while the Redbirds have swept the Salukis in five of their last six outings.

UNI is no stranger to starting the MVC season 2-0. This decade, the Panthers have started MVC action at least 2-0 in every season except 2013 (1-1) and 2016 (0-2). Last season, UNI kicked off league play 10-0.

Thanks to Friday's 25-12, 25-17, 25-22 victory over Valparaiso, Loyola has won its last two Missouri Valley Conference openers. That marks the first time the Ramblers have won consecutive conference lid-lifters since 2004 and 2005, when they were part of the Horizon League. Last fall, Loyola got off to its best start (3-0) since joining The Valley in 2013.

Ramblin' to a Sweep

Loyola has won seven of its last 10 matches overall and captured its Valley opener for the second time in as many seasons with a sweep of Valpo. The win was Loyola's first over Valpo since the Crusaders joined the MVC. Last year, six of the eight Rambler Valley wins were via a sweep.

Non-Con This Decade

Since 2010, the Valley has posted a record above .500 in non-conference play every year except 2014 (55-57) and 2017 (61-66). The MVC finished non-league play with a 57-69(.452) mark in 2019.

Dr. Wynn Banner

Missouri State will unveil a banner in honor of Dr. Mary Jo Wynn at Friday's home match against UNI. Dr. Wynn, who was the backbone of one of the most progressive and successful women's athletics programs in the country at Missouri State and a national pioneer for the cause of women's sports, passed away in January at the age of 87.

Back Home Again

Valpo finally opens its home slate on Monday evening, as the Crusaders will play just nine home matches this season - the nine MVC home contests. Under head coach Carin Avery, Valpo owns a 143-48 (.749) record at the ARC and has been above .500 at home in 16 of her 17 seasons, the only exception being a 5-7 mark in 2016.

Triple Doubles Galore

SIU's Rachel Maguire leads the nation in triple-doubles with eight. She recorded her eighth triple-double of the season in SIU's five-set win over Bradley Friday with a career-high 17 kills, 24 assists and 17 digs. Maguire's eight triple-doubles are not only the most by a Missouri Valley Conference player since at least 2015, but are tied for the third-most in a single-season in the NCAA over at least the past five seasons.

The MVC holds a winning record against nine leagues in non-conference play (Atlantic Sun, Big Sky, Big West, MEAC, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Summit, Sun Belt & SWAC), and at least a .500 record against another five (Big Ten, Conference USA, Mountain West, Southern & WAC).

Approaching 500

UNI head coach Bobbi Petersen enters the week with a career record of 493-159, seven wins away from 500. Only Missouri State's Melissa Stokes (1996-2018) has reached the 500-win mark in MVC history.

Tough to Kill

Six of the 10 MVC programs currently rank Top 25 nationally in digs per set. Bradley leads the league and ranks fourth nationally (19.04), while Evansville ranks 10th (17.82). Indiana State (13th, 17.5), UNI (16th, 17.3), Southern Illinois (17th, 17.1) and Valparaiso (24th, 16.8) round out the teams ranking in the Top 25 nationally.

Feliciano Leading All Rookies

Evansville's Melanie Feliciano continues to rank towards the top of the NCAA leaderboard in kills and points per set during her rookie season. The freshman ranks eighth nationally in kills per set (4.84) and ninth nationally in points per set (5.22). She is currently leading all freshman nationally in both categories.

Double-Double Leaders

Eight different league players have posted eight or more double-doubles this season. Bradley's Hannah Thompson pushed her streak of consecutive double-doubles to 11 with a pair over the weekend. Southern Illinois' Alayna Martin and Rachel Maguire lead The Valley with 13 double-doubles each this season.

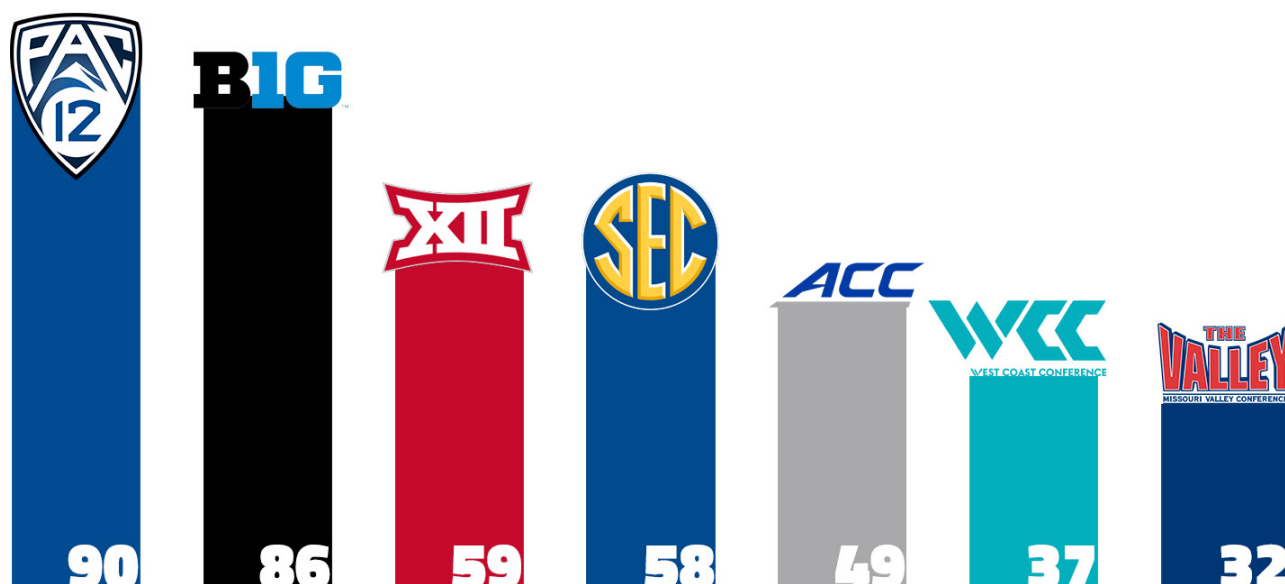

In fact, three Braves had 16 or more kills to mark the first time Bradley had three individuals with 15 or more kills in a match since a Nov. 14, 2013 contest against Missouri State. Bradley and Evansville are the only MVC teams to have two players averaging at least 3.00 kills per set.



Climbing the Charts

Sophomore Hannah Thompson continues to pile up double-doubles, pushing her streak of consecutive double-doubles to 11 with a pair over the weekend. While her 11 double-doubles are one short of matching the longest streak in Bradley history (12 by Sam Hardwick in 2000), she is now the 15th player in program history to collect 550 career kills and 750 career digs. Thompson is the only Brave to reach those career numbers as a sophomore, however. In fact, her 761 career digs are already the most by a Bradley player before the end of their sophomore season as she topped the previous mark of 759 career digs by a BU sophomore held by Rachelle Dejean (2008-11).

Leading the Pack

Freshman middle blocker Raeann Bergman is hitting a conference-best .367 on the young season and had a big opening weekend of league play. Bergman hit .387 while averaging 2.14 kills per set in the first two MVC matches of her career, helping highlight Saturday's win over Missouri State with 10 kills on 18 attacks with no errors (.556). She is also leading Bradley in blocking at 0.90 per set. During Bradley's recently completed four-match home stand, Bergman averaged 2.14 kills and 1.14 blocks per set, while boasting a .446 attack percentage.
