## MVC Player of the Week

### Gabi Haack, Jr., G, Bradley

Haack averaged 18.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.5 steals while shooting 57 percent from the field in a pair of road victories. She scored a game-high 16 points and also had seven rebounds, three assists and one steal at Loyola. Haack followed that up by scoring a game-high 21 points on 6-of-8 shooting (4-of-6 from three-point range) at Valparaiso as she became the 19th player in school history to score 1,000 career points. Haack also had five rebounds, two assists and two

steals to highlight the 75-61 road win at Valpo, scoring 10 of her 21 points during the third quarter to help Bradley pull away for the victory which improved the Braves to 14-2 overall & 5-0 in Valley play. Bradley's 5-0 start to league play is the best in program history, while the 14-2 overall record is also Bradley's best mark through 16 games.

### Gabby Walker, Jr., F, Southern Illinois

SIU's Gabby Walker scored the game-winning basket in the Salukis' 70-68 upset win over No. 17 Missouri State on Friday, as her layup with :01.3 seconds to play sealed Southern's first victory over a ranked opponent since 1991. The junior transfer finished with nine points on 4-of-8 shooting and added a steal and an assist in 13 minutes of work against the Lady Bears.

## NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's Player and Newcomer of the Week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

**Becca Hittner (DU)** - Senior Becca Hittner helped lead Drake to two blowout home wins this past weekend. Hittner averaged 16.0 points, 6.5 rebounds, 2.0 steals and 1.5 assists per game while shooting 47.4 percent (9-of-19) from the floor, 50.0 percent (6-of-12) and 100.0 percent (8-of-8) from the free throw line. She scored 16 points, pulled down six rebounds, handed out two assists and blocked one shot in just 20 minutes in the team's 105-65 win over Indiana State. Hittner knocked down two three-pointers and went 6-for-6 at the free throw line. In the team's 108-44 win over Evansville, she scored 16 points, including making four three-pointers, grabbed six rebounds, nabbed a season-high four steals and handed out one assist in 20 minutes of action.

**TeTe Maggett (ILS)** - Senior guard TeTe Maggett averaged 21.0 points, 6.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists per game and 3.0 steals as the Redbirds split a pair of MVC road games over the weekend. In Friday's win over Valparaiso, Maggett exploded for 26 points on 50 percent (8-of-16) shooting, also grabbing eight rebounds, dishing out seven assists and adding three steals. The senior also posted 16 points at Loyola, 14 of which came in the second half, four rebounds and three steals.

**Allison Day (LUC)** - Loyola sophomore forward Allison Day averaged a team-best 13.5 points as the Ramblers split a pair of games against in-state rivals this past weekend. Following a 10-point (4-13 FGs, 2-4 FT), three-rebound effort on Friday afternoon against Bradley, the Russellville, Ohio product poured in 17 points (6-10 FGs, 5-8 FTs), 15 of which came in the second half, in addition to an assist and a block as the Ramblers picked up a 69-64 win over Illinois State on Sunday. Day, who has scored in double figures 13 times this season, currently ranks second on the Rambler roster in scoring at 13.0 ppg, a mark that puts her 13th in the Missouri Valley Conference.

**Alexa Willard (MSU)** - Alexa Willard posted her seventh 20-point game of the season Friday at Southern Illinois, pouring in a game-high 27 points on 11-for-21 shooting. Willard also grabbed six rebounds, including five on the offensive end, and nabbed a pair of steals. The senior moved up to 19th in school history in career scoring, now with 1,332 points as a Lady Bear.

**Karli Rucker (UNI)** - Karli Rucker averaged 15.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and 5 assists in two games this weekend. She tied her career-high with 28 points against Evansville Friday, including 15 of her 28 points in the final 6:06 in the game to spur a 17-2 run to close the game for the Panthers. She was 6-8 from the three-point line and 11-15 from the field Friday.

**Brittney Patrick (SIU)** - Patrick had her most complete game of the season in SIU's upset win over No. 17 Missouri State, which included the game-winning assist with :01.3 seconds to play. The senior guard finished with a season-high 12 points to go along with eight rebounds, five assists and two steals to help Southern defeat a ranked opponent for the first time since 1991. It marked the second-straight game in which the DeKalb, Ill. native has reached double figures.

**Caitlin Morrison (VALPO)** - Morrison set a career high on Sunday against league-leading Bradley, scoring 15 points while also leading Valpo in rebounding. It is already the second time within Valley play this year that Morrison has surpassed her previous career high, and the junior is averaging 8.8 ppg in conference play after scoring just 4.6 ppg in the non-conference slate.

**Sarah Beth Gueldner (DU)** - Freshman Sarah Beth Gueldner provided a spark off the Bulldogs' bench in the team's two big wins. Gueldner equaled her career-high of 15 points off a career-best five three-pointers in the victory over Evansville. She added one assist in 16 minutes. Against Indiana State, she scored two points and handed out one assist in a career-high 19 minutes.

**Abby Feit (UE)** - On the road in MVC action, freshman Abby Feit was a picture of consistency. In two games, Feit hovered right at her season averages for scoring and rebounding. At UNI, Feit scored 15 points and nine rebounds, while also chipping-in two assists, two blocks, and two assists while not committing a foul or a turnover in 38 minutes of action. Taking on Drake, Feit nearly mirrored her performance from Friday, scoring 14 points and tallying nine rebounds.

**Mary Crompton (ILS)** - Redshirt freshman Mary Crompton averaged 8.5 points and 2.5 assists as the Redbirds split a pair of MVC road games over the weekend. Crompton contributed eight points in Friday's victory over Valpo, including two triples and two assists. The redshirt freshman also drained a pair of three-pointers in Sunday's game at Loyola, finishing with nine points and three assists. Crompton ranks fourth in conference, averaging 2.3 three-pointers per contest on the season.

**Kristina Cavey (UNI)** - Kristina Cavey tallied a double-double Friday with 10 points and 12 rebounds, including six offensive rebounds. She was 2-4 from the three-point line on the weekend and 4-13 from the field.

**Carie Weinman (VALPO)** - Weinman averaged 10 points, 3 rebounds and 2.5 steals per game in Valpo's pair of MVC games last weekend. She poured in 12 points against Illinois State - her fourth double-figure scoring output of the year - and had four steals against the Redbirds. With 16 steals through six MVC games, Weinman is tied with teammate Shay Frederick for the conference lead.

Bradley is 5-0 in MVC play for the first time in school history. The Braves' 14-2 overall start to the year is also the best in school history through 16 games. The five-game MVC win streak is now the third longest for the Braves, behind only two other Valley win streaks of six games.

## Upset in Carbondale

Southern Illinois upset No. 17/19 Missouri State at the buzzer Friday, as Gabby Walker's layup with :01 seconds left delivered the Salukis their first win over a ranked opponent during the regular season since 1991 (81-64 vs. No. 8 NC State). The Lady Bears suffered their first road Valley loss in nearly two years after a school-record streak of 13 consecutive wins.

## RPI Update

The latest weekly installment of the NCAA RPI Report (Jan. 20) has seven Valley teams that rank in the top-100, including three in the top 50. Missouri State sits No. 2 in the RPI after dropping Friday's game at Southern Illinois. Drake comes in at No. 38 and UNI No. 48 this week. Southern Illinois (66), Bradley (72), Illinois State (78) and Loyola Chicago (95) also appear in the Top 100.

The Valley joins the Power Five leagues as the only leagues to have seven or more Top 100 teams.

## ESPN Bracketology

The latest ESPN.com women's basketball bracketology from Charlie Creme (Jan. 20) has three MVC teams in the field of 64. Bradley represents The Valley's AQ and is a 12 seed in Iowa City playing Arizona State. Missouri State is a No. 6 seed playing Purdue in Chicago, while Drake is a No. 10 seed playing West Virginia in Los Angeles. UNI is also appearing in the "Next Four Out". The MVC is one of just seven leagues receiving multiple bids, joining the Power Five leagues and the Big East.

## 8 X 10

Entering this week, the MVC has 8 of its 10 teams with 10 or more victories on the season. Only the Big 12 (9 of 10, 90%) and Big Ten (12 of 14, 85.7%) surpass the MVC with over 80% of its membership reaching double figure wins already this season. The SEC (11 of 14, 78.6%), Pac-12 (8 of 12, 66.7%), ACC (9 of 15, 60%) and Conference USA (8 of 14, 57.1%) are the other conferences with eight or more teams with 10+ wins.

## Historic Conference RPI

The Valley ranks seventh nationally in the NCAA's conference RPI report (Jan. 20). The Valley sits behind the Pac-12, Big Ten, ACC, SEC, Big 12 and Big East entering this week.

The Valley record for RPI in a season is 8th (2008 & 2011).

## Home Sweet Home

Five MVC teams are unbeaten at home entering the week: Bradley (7-0), Drake (8-0), Illinois State (8-0), Missouri State (8-0) and UNI (6-0) have unblemished records on their home courts this season.

The Valley currently has three teams with a home win streak of 12 or more. Drake stretched its streak to 14-straight (5th-longest nationally), while Bradley has won a program-record 13-straight at home and is tied for the 8th-longest streak nationally. Illinois State has a 12-game win streak at home, tied for 12th nationally.

## Ramblin' on the Road

Loyola Chicago is second in the nation with a perfect 8-0 road record this season, trailing only UConn's 9-0 road mark. The Ramblers are one of just seven teams in the nation to remain perfect on the road (UConn, South Carolina, Mississippi State, Northwestern, Tulane and Baylor).

## Strength of Schedule

Three Valley teams have a SOS ranking in the Top 55 according to the NCAA (Jan. 21). Missouri State leads The Valley with a SOS of No. 17 with Southern Illinois' schedule coming in this week ranked No. 41 and Drake's No. 52.

## Power Five Wins

The MVC secured nine wins over Power Five programs during the non-conference schedule. The Valley went 9-12 vs. Power Five teams, tripling last season's win total of three. The Valley has a winning record against the Big 12 (3-2) and SEC (3-1) and sits 3-7 vs. the Big Ten and 0-2 vs. the Pac-12. The average margin of victory in the nine wins is 8.7 points per game. Missouri State and UNI each had three, Drake two, and Illinois State one.

## Sharp Shooters

The Valley has three of the nation's top 15 teams in free-throw percentage so far this season. Drake currently leads the league and sits 7th nationally (78.2%), while UNI sits 8th (77.7%) and Valparaiso 15th (77.0%).

Drake's Becca Hittner leads The Valley and ranks No. 11 nationally hitting 88.8% of her attempts.

The Valley as a whole is shooting 71.2% from the line this season, ranking 4th nationally among NCAA DI Conferences.

## New Non-Con Record

Valley women's basketball reached 73 wins in non-conference play. Only five times previously since the 1992-93 season has the MVC claimed 60+ non-league wins in a season. This year's 73 wins sets a new league record for most non-con wins, surpassing 66 wins in 2009-10. This season marks the second-best non-conference win percentage in league history, trailing only the 1994-95 season.

Drake enters this weekend ranking 3rd nationally in Field Goal Percentage (49.2%). Drake finished 10th in FG% last year, 5th in 2017-18, and 2nd in 2016-17. UConn is the only other school to finish in the top 10 in the last three seasons. The Huskies currently sit ninth nationally.

Drake's Sara Rhine enters the week ranking 4th nationally in field goal percentage (67.2%).

The Valley as a whole is shooting 42.7% from the field this season, ranking 5th nationally among NCAA DI Conferences.

The MVC held a winning record against 15 leagues in non-conference play, including the American (2-1), America East (2-0), A10 (3-2), Big 12 (3-2), Big Sky (1-0), Horizon (6-2), Ivy (1-0), MAC (8-2), Mountain West (1-0), Ohio Valley (11-9), SEC (3-1) Southland (1-0), Summit (10-4), SWAC (2-0) and WAC (5-0). The MVC held a .500 mark against Conference USA (1-1) and the West Coast (2-2). The MVC had a losing record vs. the Atlantic Sun (0-1), Big East (1-3), Big Ten (3-7), Big West (0-1) and Pac-12 (0-2).

## Sharing the Rock

Drake enters the weekend averaging 22.1 assists per game, which ranks second nationally. Drake is the only team in the country to rank in the top three of Assists Per Game each of the previous three seasons.

## Quick Starts Crucial

Since 1982-83, just three teams (Missouri State, champions in 1998-99, 1994-95 and 1990-91; Drake, champions in 1996-97 and co-champions in 1987-88; and Evansville, a 2007-08 co-champion) have won at least a share of the regular-season title without winning its regular-season opener. In fact, 14 of the last 19 regular-season champs (or co-champs) have opened 2-0 or better in MVC play, with Evansville in 2007-08, Missouri State in 2004-05, UNI in 2010-11, Missouri State in 2011-12 and UNI in 2015-16 serving as the only five exceptions.

## Rhine on McClain Watch List

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the WBCA announced that Drake senior Sara Rhine is one of 20 watch list candidates for the 2020 Katrina McClain Award. Named after the two-time All-American and 1987 National Player of the Year, the annual award in its third year recognizes the top power forwards in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players for the 2020 award will be narrowed to just 10.

## Hittner on Drysdale Watch List

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the WBCA announced that Drake senior Becca Hittner is one of 20 watch list candidates for the 2020 Ann Meyers Drysdale Award. Named after the first player, male or female, selected to the All-America Team in four-straight college seasons, the annual Drysdale award is in its third year and recognizes the top shooting guard in NCAA Division I women's college basketball. By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players for the 2020 award will be narrowed to just 10.

## Wade Award Watch List

Drake's Becca Hittner and Sara Rhine have each been selected to the "Wade Watch" list of candidates for the 2020 Wade Trophy presented to the best player in college women's basketball, the WBCA announced Thursday. Drake joins Oregon, Stanford, UConn and Oregon State as the only schools with multiple players on the list.

## Wooden Award Watch List

Drake senior Becca Hittner has been named to the John R. Wooden Award® presented by Wendy's® Women's Preseason Top 30 Watch List. The preseason list represents nine conferences: the Pac-12 leads all conferences with nine selections, followed by the SEC with six, the ACC and Big 12 with four apiece, the American and Big Ten with two each, and Conference USA, Ivy League, and Missouri Valley with one selection apiece.

## Senior CLASS Award

Bradley's Chelsea Brackmann has been named one of 30 national candidates for the Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence: community, classroom, character and competition. Brackmann is the fourth Bradley Women's Basketball player selected as a Senior CLASS Award candidate, joining Michelle Young (2013-14), Jenny Van Kirk (2009-10) and Kelly Krumwiede (2008-09) and is the lone candidate from the Missouri Valley Conference this season.

## Bulldogs Favored

Drake was tabbed as the preseason favorite in the MVC Women's Basketball race in the annual survey of the league's coaches, SIDs and media.

## Hoops In the Heartland

The 2020 Missouri Valley Conference Women's Basketball Tournament will return to the TaxSlayer Center in Moline, Ill., for the fifth-straight season.

Affectionately coined "Hoops in the Heartland," the four-day event (Mar. 12-15) will showcase all 10 Missouri Valley Conference schools as they compete for the Valley's automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament.

The MVC's agreement with Visit Quad Cities will keep the MVC Women's Basketball Championship in TaxSlayer Center through at least 2021.

The 2020 tournament will mark the 13th-consecutive season in its 38-year history that the event will take place at a neutral site.

The Missouri Valley Conference is one of only seven conferences (out of 32 nationally) where the women's basketball tournament is played at a neutral site, separate from the men's championship (AAC, ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, MVC, Pac-12 and SEC are the others).

## Starters Returning

The Missouri Valley Conference will see 30 of 50 starters return (60%) for the 2019-20 season. The league will return nine of its top 10 in scoring, seven of its top 10 in rebounding and four of its top five in assists. The Valley will also have eight of its 11 All-MVC players return and five of its six honorable mention selections.



## Postseason League

The MVC has seen an average of four league teams participate in postseason play in the last 21 seasons, including three teams reaching postseason play in 2018-19. Missouri State reached the Sweet Sixteen for the fourth time in program history, while Drake fell to Missouri in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament. UNI received a bid to the WNIT for the second-straight season. The Valley has earned multiple NCAA Tournament bids in 12 different seasons, including two out of the last three seasons.

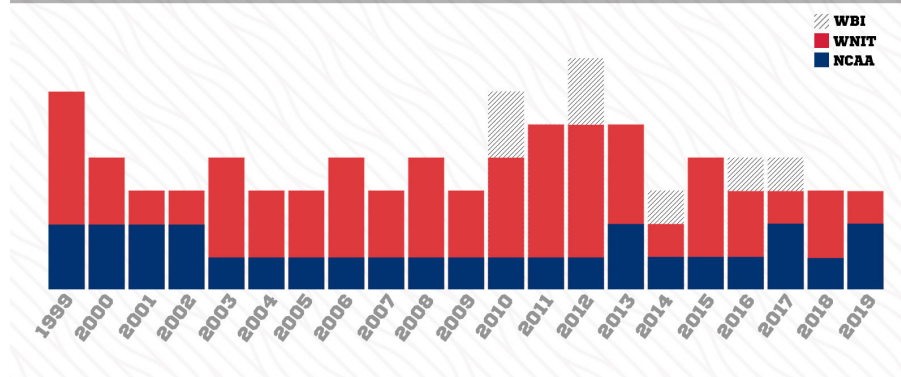

### BRADLEY (14-2, 5-0)

#### Off and Running

Bradley picked up a pair of road wins last weekend to improve to 14-2 overall & the Braves sit alone atop the MVC standings with an unblemished 5-0 league record. Both the 14-2 overall record and 5-0 Valley record are the best starts in program history, surpassing a 13-2 overall start and 4-0 mark to open MVC play by the 2008-09 team which went on to win a school record 21 games. Of the nine teams that have won at least a share of the MVC regular-season title over the last seven seasons just two did not start out league play at least 5-0 (2015-16 - UNI & 2012-13 - Creighton). Bradley's five-game MVC win streak is the team's longest since 2009-10 (6) and one short of tying for the longest conference win streak in program history of six, which has been done twice.



#### Haack Hits 1,000

Junior Gabi Haack scored her 1,000th career point to help highlight Sunday's win at Valparaiso, reaching the mark on her fourth three-pointer of the game near the six-minute mark of the fourth quarter. The 19th player in program history to reach the 1,000-point mark, Haack is just the ninth Bradley junior to do so (first since Katie Yohn in 2011-12) and is the seventh fastest Brave to reach 1,000 (77 games). The six BU players to reach 1,000 points faster than Haack all rank among the top nine in program history in scoring and the last one to reach 1,000 career points in fewer than 80 games was two-time First-Team All-MVC pick Sara Bailey (64 games), who concluded her career in 2002-03.

#### Rebounding Record

There is a new all-time leading rebounder at Bradley with senior Chelsea Brackmann pulling down her 845th career board Friday at Loyola to top the previous school record of 844 career rebounds held by former teammate Leti Lerma. Currently third in the MVC in rebounding at 8.3 per outing this season, Brackmann is 21st in league history with 848 career rebounds. In addition to the Bradley rebounding record, Brackmann needs four free throw attempts to become just the fifth Brave with 400 career trips to the charity stripe and is just 48 points from becoming the 20th player in Bradley history to score 1,000 career points.

### DRAKE (12-5, 4-1)

#### Lots of Points

Drake had quite the return to the Knapp Center this past weekend with blowout wins over Indiana State and Evansville. The Bulldogs cruised past the Sycamores, 105-65 and by the Purple Aces, 108-44. It is the first-ever time a Valley team has surpassed the century mark in back-to-back Missouri Valley Conference games. The 108 points against Evansville are the most points against a league foe in a regulation game behind just the 112 points the 1993 Drake team scored in a four-overtime marathon against UNI.



#### Assisting

Drake, which went in to Sunday's game against Evansville No. 2 in NCAA with 21.3 assists per game, equaled its season-high of 28 in their second-straight win. In Friday's win over Indiana State, senior Brenni Rose, the MVC's assists leader, dished out a game-high nine. Rose was one of 10 Bulldogs to record an assist as the team had 28. In Sunday's win over Evansville, junior Maddie Monahan handed out a game-high seven. Again Drake had 10 players record at least one assist.

#### Chart Climbers

Seniors Sara Rhine and Becca Hittner, who are each vying to hit the 2,000 career point mark, moved up the all-time scoring lists at Drake and in the Valley. Rhine has 1,958 career points, which ranks sixth at Drake and No. 10 in league history. Over the weekend, she moved past Jill Martin (1,928) and Carla Bennett (1,930) at Drake. Sophomore Shay Frederick enjoyed a stellar weekend from a point guard's perspective last weekend distributing the basketball. Frederick handed out five assists without committing a turnover versus Illinois State, and then tallied seven assists - one off her career best - and just one turnover Sunday against Bradley. Frederick currently ranks fifth in the MVC with 4.2 assists/game and is on pace to earn a spot in Valpo's single-season top-10 in assists, and owns the best assist/TO ratio of any MVC player averaging at least 3 assists/game (1.85).



#### Hitting the Freebies

Valpo continued its stellar season at the foul line last weekend, going 17-for-20 (85%) from the stripe over its two games. As a team, Valpo is connecting at a 77% clip from the free throw line this season, good for 15th nationally. The Crusaders have shot below 70% at the line in just two of their 17 games this year, and have been below 75% just once over their first six MVC contests.
