## **MVC Player of the Week**

#### Gabi Haack, Jr., G, Bradley

Haack averaged a team-best 16.5 points per game in addition to collecting 9.0 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.0 steal per game in a pair of historic wins for Bradley. In Friday's win against UNI, which snapped a 16-game losing skid in the series. Haack had eight points, six rebounds and three assists without a turnover. While she had a bit of an off-shooting night offensively, she helped the Braves limit Northern Iowa to its second lowest scoring output of the season in the 61-47 victory. In Saturday's

win against Drake, Haack turned in one of her best performances of the year; collecting a season-best 25 points in addition to matching a career-high 12 rebounds. Bradley trailed by six midway through the first quarter when Haack had 11 points during a 14-0 BU run. The victory ended a 12-game losing skid in the series with the Bulldogs as Bradley improved to 7-0 to start MVC play for the first time in program history and picked up its eighth consecutive win overall to tie for the third longest win streak in Bradley history.

## **MVC Newcomer of the Week**

#### Juliunn Redmond, Jr., G, Illinois State

Illinois State junior Juliunn Redmond recorded 14 points and six rebounds in both of ISU's games this weekend as the Redbirds split a pair of MVC home contests against UNI and Drake. Redmond was responsible for all six of Illinois State's overtime points in their narrow loss to Drake on Friday, 69-67. She also shot 50 percent from behind the three-point line and a perfect 9-of-9 from the charity stripe on the weekend. The junior is averaging 11.9 points and 6.3 rebounds in Valley play this season.

## **NOTEWORTHY**

In addition to the league's Player and Newcomer of the Week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

Becca Hittner (DU)- Senior Becca Hittner helped Drake split a pair of road games this past weekend. Hittner averaged 22.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, 2.5 steals and 1.5 assists per game while shooting 35.3 percent from three (6-of-17), 41.2 percent (14-of-34) from the floor and 73.3 percent (11-of-15) from the free throw line. In Drake's win over Illinois, she scored 16 points and equaled a career-high with five steals. In the Bulldogs' one-point loss at Bradley, she scored a game-high 29 points and pulled down 10 rebounds for her third double-double of the season. Hittner leads the MVC in overall scoring at 17.8 points per game and in league action with a 21.8 percent clip.

**TeTe Maggett (ILS)** - Senior guard TeTe Maggett averaged 17.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists as the Redbirds split a pair of MVC contests over the weekend. Maggett had a game-high 19 points in Friday's 69-67 loss to Drake, 14 of which came in the second half to help force an overtime with the reigning regular season champions. The senior also contributed 15 points in Sunday's victory over UNI, also adding four rebounds, four assists and two steals.

Abby O'Connor (LUC) - Loyola junior forward Abby O'Connor finished with a team-high 16 points in the Ramblers' 66-64 setback to Valparaiso on Friday night at the Athletics-Recreation Center. The South Bend, Ind. native finished 5-of-8 from the field, connecting on 2-of-4 attempts from beyond the three-point arc, as she reached double figures in scoring for a teambest 14th time this season. O'Connor, who also collected seven rebounds and recorded a pair of blocks against the Crusaders, currently ranks 10th overall in the MVC in scoring, averaging 14.1 points across her 18 appearances.

Alexa Willard (MSU) - Alexa Willard averaged 18 points on 56 percent shooting last week, including 4-for-5 from 3-point range and 4-for-4 at the foul line. Willard scored a game-high 23 points on 9-of-16 shooting Friday at Indiana State, including 13 points with a trio of 3-pointers in the first quarter. Sunday, the senior went 5-of-9 from the field with 13 points against Evansville. Willard added four rebounds, three assists and two steals in the two wins, and moved up three spots to 16th on MSU's career scoring list.

Makenzie Silvey (SIU) - Makenzie Silvey averaged 17.0 points on 63.6-percent (14-for-22) shooting to go along with 4.0 rebounds in SIU's back-to-back road wins over the weekend. The Glen Carbon, III. native scored 11 points in Southern's 70-57 win at Evansville. She followed with a game-high 23 points on an efficient 9-of-12 shooting in SIU's 78-55 win at Indiana State. It marked the seventh time this season that the junior guard has scored 20-plus points in a game.

Shay Frederick (VALPO) - Frederick led the way as Valpo put together an epic rally to defeat Loyola in its lone game last week, scoring all seven Valpo points in the final 20 seconds, including the game-winning 3-point play with 5.2 to play. She also connected on a layup with 19.7 remaining and two free throws with 12 seconds to go, as well as assisting on a 3-pointer with 52.2 seconds to play to make it a one-possession game for the first time in the second half. Frederick totaled 14 points in the fourth quarter alone, spearheading the rally, which saw Valpo overcome a deficit which was as large as 13 points in the fourth quarter and was still 11 points with three minutes to play. She tied her career bests for both scoring (21 points) and rebounding (six boards) while also tying for game-high honors with five assists.

Mahri Petree (BRAD) - Petree averaged 6.5 points and 4.0 rebounds per game in a pair of home wins to help Bradley hold on to sole possession of first-place in the MVC standings. She had eight points, four rebounds and one assist in Friday's 61-47 victory over UNI, which snapped a 16-game losing streak in the all-time series. Petree saw extended minutes in Saturday's win against Drake with three BU starters picking up two fouls in the first 12 minutes of the game. She finished with five points and four boards in the win to snap a 12-game Bradley losing streak in the series. Petree helped Bradley earn its eighth consecutive win overall (tied for third longest win streak in program history) as the Braves improved to 7-0 to start Valley play for the first time in school history.

**Abby Feit (UE)** - Facing SIU and Missouri State, freshman Abby Feit continued her impressive first year as an Ace. Against SIU, Feit filled the box score, scoring a team-high 16 points and pulling-down six rebounds, while adding five assists, four steals, and two blocks. On Sunday against No. 22 Missouri State, Feit again scores in double-figures, tallying 12 points for Evansville.

Jala Johnson (LUC) - Loyola freshman guard Jala Johnson fell just shy of matching her season high in the Ramblers' 66-64 defeat at Valparaiso on Friday evening, chipping in 12 points. Out of Toledo, Ohio, Johnson came off the bench to operate at a 5-of-7 clip from the field in 16 minutes of action, also grabbing a pair of rebounds. She's now scored in double figures five times in her 15 appearances this season.

**Gabby Walker (SIU)** - Walker averaged 8.0 points, 2.0 boards and 2.5 assists in SIU's back-to-back road wins over the weekend. The redshirt junior scored six points off the bench in the comeback win at Evansville and followed with 10 points on 4-of-8 shooting to go along with three assists in the victory over Indiana State. The St. Charles, Mo. native made her first start of the season against the Sycamores and has now scored in double figures in five games this season.

Zoe MacKay Zacker (VALPO) - MacKay Zacker, who entered Friday's game against Loyola having played just 19 minutes total all year and having not appeared in a game with a final margin of closer than 19 points, was ready when her number was called against the Ramblers. Despite playing just 13 seconds in all, she had two of the biggest plays to cap Valpo's epic rally for the win. First, with 12 seconds to play and Loyola inbounding the ball up by one, MacKay Zacker took a charge before the ball was inbounded to give Valpo possession and a chance to take the lead. Then, after the Crusaders took the lead with 5.2 seconds to go, MacKay Zacker got her hand on the ensuing inbounds pass, deflecting it away from its intended target and forcing the Ramblers to scramble for a last-second shot which was off the mark.

## **League Leaders**

Bradley's 7-0 league start matches 17 others who have started with at least seven-straight league wins in 2019-20 (through Jan. 27 games).

Bradley is 7-0 in MVC play for the first time in school history. The Braves' 16-2 overall start to the year is also the best in school history. The Braves also pushed their overall win streak to a season-best eight games to tie for the third longest win streak in program history behind a pair of nine game win streaks from 2018-19 and 2001-02.

## **RPI Update**

The latest weekly installment of the NCAA RPI Report (Jan. 28) has six Valley teams that rank in the top-100, including four in the top 60. Missouri State sits No. 13 in the RPI, Drake comes in at No. 30, Bradley No. 53 and UNI No. 58 this week. Southern Illinois (88) and Illinois State (95) also appear in the Top 100 with Loyola Chicago just outside at No. 103.

The Valley joins the Power Five leagues and the Big East as the only leagues to have six or more Top 100 teams.

## **ESPN Bracketology**

The latest ESPN.com women's basketball bracketology from Charlie Creme (Jan. 28) has three MVC teams in the field of 64. Bradley represents The Valley's AQ and is an 11 seed in Iowa City playing LSU. Missouri State is a No. 6 seed playing Old Dominion in Corvallis, while Drake is a No. 11 seed playing Princeton in Starkville. The MVC is one of just six leagues receiving three or more bids, joining the Power Five leagues.

## What's the Difference?

Over the past 20 seasons (since 1999-2000), 12 MVC teams have registered a scoring margin of +12 or better for a season. Currently, three Valley teams have a scoring margin over 12 points. Drake leads with a +13.8 margin, followed by Bradley (+13.2) and Missouri State (+12.1). Last year Drake finished with a +13.9 ppg margin. This would be the fifthstraight season with a scoring margin of +12 for the Bulldogs.

Entering this week, the MVC has 8 of its 10 teams with 11 or more victories and a +.600 win percentage on the season. Only the Big 12 (8 of 10, 80%) matches the MVC with 80% of its membership reaching the milestones. The Big Ten (11 of 14, 78.6%), SEC (11 of 14, 78.6%), Pac-12 (8 of 12, 66.7%), ACC (9 of 15, 60%) and Conference USA (8 of 14, 57.1%) are the other conferences with eight or more teams with 11+ wins.

## **Historic Conference RPI**

The Valley ranks seventh nationally in the NCAA's conference RPI report (Jan. 27). The Valley sits behind the Pac-12, Big Ten, ACC, SEC, Big 12 and Big East entering this week.

## **Home Sweet Home**

Four MVC teams remain unbeaten at home entering the week: Bradley (9-0), Drake (8-0), Missouri State (8-0) and UNI (6-0) have unblemished records on their home courts this season.

The Valley currently has two teams with a home win streak of 14 or more. Bradley stretched its program record streak to 15-straight (5th-longest nationally) over the weekend, while Drake has won 14-straight at home (8th-longest nationally).

## Streaks in League Play

Two of the longest active win streaks against a league opponent were ended over the weekend as Bradley beat UNI and Drake in Peoria. The Braves had lost 16-straight to the Panthers and 12-straight to the Bulldogs before claiming both wins this past weekend.

## Top Freshman

Abby Feit of Evansville is the league's top scoring and top rebounding freshman, as she is averaging 14.4 points and 8.5 rebounds per game. Feit is one of only two freshmen in the nation averaging at least 14.0 points and 8.5 rebounds per game, joining Kansas State's Avonka Lee (15.4 ppg, 10.9 rpg).

The last player to lead the MVC as the highest scoring and rebounding freshman was Sara Rhine of Drake in 2015-16 (13.3 ppg, 7.0 rpg)

## **Power Five Wins**

The MVC secured nine wins over Power Five programs during the non-conference schedule. The Valley went 9-12 vs. Power Five teams, tripling last season's win total of three. The Valley has a winning record against the Big 12 (3-2) and SEC (3-1) and sits 3-7 vs. the Big Ten and 0-2 vs. the Pac-12. The average margin of victory in the nine wins was 8.7 points per game. Missouri State and UNI each had three, Drake two, and Illinois State one.

## **Sharp Shooters**

The Valley has three of the nation's top 20 teams in free-throw percentage this season. Drake currently leads the league and sits 11th nationally (77.9%), while UNI sits 12th (77.3%) and Valparaiso 18th

Drake's Becca Hittner leads The Valley and ranks No. 19 nationally hitting 86.7% of her attempts.

The Valley as a whole is shooting 71.0% from the line this season, ranking 5th nationally among NCAA DI Conferences.

### **New Non-Con Record**

Valley women's basketball reached 73 wins in non-conference play. Only five times previously since the 1992-93 season has the MVC claimed 60+ non-league wins in a season. This year's 73 wins sets a new league record for most noncon wins, surpassing 66 wins in 2009-10. This season marks the second-best non-conference win percentage in league history, trailing only the 1994-95 season.

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the WBCA announced that Drake senior Sara Rhine is one of 20 watch list candidates for the 2020 Katrina McClain Award. Named after the two-time All-American and 1987 National Player of the Year, the annual award in its third year recognizes the top power forwards in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players for the 2020 award will be narrowed to just 10.

## **Hittner on Drysdale Watch List**

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the WBCA announced that Drake senior Becca Hittner is one of 20 watch list candidates for the 2020 Ann Meyers Drysdale Award. Named after the first player, male or female, selected to the All-America Team in four-straight college seasons, the annual Drysdale award is in its third year and recognizes the top shooting guard in NCAA Division I women's college basketball. By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players for the 2020 award will be narrowed to just 10.

## **Wade Award Watch List**

Drake's Becca Hittner and Sara Rhine have each been selected to the "Wade Watch" list of candidates for the 2020 Wade Trophy presented to the best player in college women's basketball, the WBCA announced Thursday. Drake joins Oregon, Stanford, UConn and Oregon State as the only schools with multiple players on the list.

## **Hoops In the Heartland**

The 2020 Missouri Valley Conference Women's Basketball Tournament will return to the TaxSlayer Center in Moline, III., for the fifth-straight season.

Affectionately coined "Hoops in the Heartland," the four-day event (Mar. 12-15) will showcase all 10 Missouri Valley Conference schools as they compete for the Valley's automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament.

The MVC's agreement with Visit Quad Cities will keep the MVC Women's Basketball Championship in TaxSlayer Center through at least 2021.

The 2020 tournament will mark the 13th-consecutive season in its 38-year history that the event will take place at a neutral site.

The Missouri Valley Conference is one of only seven conferences (out of 32 nationally) where the women's basketball tournament is played at a neutral site, separate from the men's championship (AAC, ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, MVC, Pac-12 and SEC are the others).

## **Starters Returning**

The Missouri Valley Conference will see 30 of 50 starters return (60%) for the 2019-20 season. The league will return nine of its top 10 in scoring, seven of its top 10 in rebounding and four of its top five in assists. The Valley will also have eight of its 11 All-MVC players return and five of its six honorable mention selections.



## **Postseason League**

The MVC has seen an average of four league teams participate in postseason play in the last 21 seasons, including three teams reaching postseason play in 2018-19. Missouri State reached the Sweet Sixteen for the fourth time in program history, while Drake fell to Missouri in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament. UNI received a bid to the WNIT for the second-straight season. The Valley has earned multiple NCAA Tournament bids in 12 different seasons, including two out of the last three seasons.



## **BRADLEY (16-2, 7-0)**

7-0 in Valley Play

Bradley ended a pair of lengthy series losing streaks over the weekend to stay perfect in MVC play, topping Northern lowa 61-47 to snap a 16-game skid in the series with the Panthers Friday, before a 77-76 victory over Drake to end a 12-game losing streak in the series with the Bulldogs. The Braves are 7-0 to start MVC play



for the first time in school history and sit alone atop the Valley standings heading into Friday's game at second-place Missouri State. Bradley is the 18th team to start MVC play 7-0 since 1992-93. Eleven of the last 17 teams to start league play 7-0 went on to win the title and five claimed at least a share of second place. All 17 teams finished in the top three of the league standings.

#### Win Streaks

Bradley brings an eight-game win streak into Friday's outing against Missouri State and the Braves have won seven consecutive Missouri Valley Conference games. The seven-game MVC win streak is the longest in school history, surpassing six-game league win streaks by the 2009-10 and 2008-09 Braves. The eight-game overall win streak is tied for the third longest in school history, behind nine-game win streaks by the 2018-19 and 2001-02 teams. Coupled with Bradley's seven-game win streak earlier this year, the Braves have two win streaks of seven of more games in the same season for the first time in program history. Bradley has 16 victories by the end of January for the first time in school history as well. Before this season, the earliest the Braves had reached 16 wins was in 2008-09 (Feb. 7).

Her teammate, Becca Hittner, had a big weekend to bring her magic number to the 2K milestone below the century mark as she is 96 away. The duo will be the first-ever Drake and MVC (men's and women's basketball) teammates to reach the milestone together in the same season. Also impressive is Rhine has 108 double figure scoring games in 126 career games while Hittner has 107 in 116 career games.

#### **In-State Rival**

Friday is a big game for Indiana State women's basketball, as the Sycamores welcome Evansville to the Hulman Center. Both ISU and UE enter Friday's game trying to avoid 10th-place in the Valley, as each hold 0-8 marks in the conference. The Trees hold the advantage



in the all-time series, 37-18, including 20-7 in the Hulman Center, but the Sycamores and Aces split the season series a year ago with Evansville picking up a 59-56 win in Terre Haute.

## **Getting to the Line**

Indiana State manages to get to the free throw line more than almost anyone else in the Missouri Valley Conference. The Sycamores have taken 399 attempts at the line this season, second only to Missouri State's 401, and converted on 246, the fourth-most made free throws in the Valley. The flip-side to that is that the Trees own the worst percentage at the charity stripe in the conference, shooting at an average of 61.7%.

## **Hitting the Boards**

ISU can boast themselves as one of the best offensive rebounding teams in the Missouri Valley Conference. The Trees have pulled down 243 offensive boards in 20 games, giving them an average of 12.2 per-game which is the third-best number in the Valley. Jamyra McChristine leads the blue and white with 5.8 rebounds per game.

## **Defense Stepping Up**

After giving up 55 points in both games last week, Missouri State has now held five consecutive opponents under their season scoring average. Additionally, MSU opponents have scored below the average they brought into the game in eight of nine and 13 of the last 15



contests, the two exceptions beating their usual offensive output by a combined 2.3 points.

#### **Historic Balance**

Last season's Lady Bears became the first MSU team since 1978-79 with 10 separate 100-point scorers on the year, and MSU could potentially repeat that again in 2019-20. So far, six players have scored at least 100 points, with four more in the rotation with current totals of 93, 82, 73 and 59 points. In fact, only six times in 50 seasons have as many as nine players scored 100 total points for Missouri State.

## **Crashing the Boards**

Missouri State won the rebounding battle in both weekend games and has now done so 17 times in 19 games this season, going 16-1 when winning on the glass. Against MVC competition the last two seasons, the Lady Bears have out-rebounded opponents in 26 of 28 games, going 25-1 when collecting more boards.

## **SOUTHERN ILLINOIS (12-6, 4-3)**

## Oh What A Night

Southern overcame a 13-point third quarter deficit to rally for a 13-point win at Evansville, 70-57 on Jan. 24. It was SIU's fifth-straight win over the Aces. The Purple Aces went ahead 45-32 with 3:41 remaining in the third quarter, but the Salukis completed the



comeback by outsooring Evansville, 28-8 in the fourth quarter. It was the largest third quarter deficit that SIU has overcome since it rallied from down 18 to defeat Indiana State in the opening round of the MVC Tournament on March 9, 2018 and marked the first time in the quarters era (since 2015-16 season) that the Salukis have trailed by double-digits and went on to win by double-digits.

## **Big 4th Quarter**

Southern outscored Evansville, 28-8 in the fourth quarter of its 70-57 win on Jan. 24. SIU's 28 fourth quarter points are its most in a fourth quarter of a MVC road game in school history. Overall, its tied for the fourth-most in a fourth quarter in school history.

## **Rolling Right Along**

The Salukis won their third-straight Valley game with a commanding 78-55 win at Indiana State on Sunday. Southern set season-bests in both field goal percentage (57.7%) and three-point field goal percentage (57.1%) in the win. SIU also recorded 26 assists on 30 field goals, won the rebounding battle, 32-to-24, and came away with 10 steals on 15 turnovers. SIU's 26 assists were not only a season-high, but are tied for the sixth-most in a game in school history and are its most since March 4, 2017.

## **VALPARAISO (11-7, 3-4)**

## **Rally Queens**

Valpo rallied from down double figures in the fourth quarter for the second time this year in the win over Loyola, as it trailed by as many as 13 points in the fourth quarter, was still down 12 with 3:45 to play and found the deficit sitting at 11 points at 57-46 as



the clock ticked under three minutes. In non-conference action, Valpo trailed Bowling Green by 12 in the final period before eventually prevailing in overtime. The 13-point deficit overcome in the fourth quarter was Valpo's largest since the women's game moved to four quarters. Ironically, the last time Valpo rallied from that kind of deficit within the game's final 10 minutes came at Loyola on Feb. 17, 2011. The Crusaders trailed that day by 14 points with 8:45 to play and went on to a 72-68 victory.

## **Career Night**

While scoring all seven of Valpo's points in the final 20 seconds is what will be remembered about Shay Frederick's performance in the comeback win over Loyola, the totality of her performance stands out as well. Frederick had 14 points in the fourth quarter to close out a 21-point effort to match her career high. The sophomore also tied her career best with six rebounds - the last of which led directly to a key fast-break 3-pointer in the final minute - and led Valpo with five assists - the 13th time this year in 18 games Frederick has paced Valpo in assists.

## Approaching 1,000

Senior Grace Hales enters this weekend with 985 career points and needs just 15 more to become the 16th player in Valpo program history to score 1,000 career points. Hales would also become just the fourth Valpo player since 2007 to reach the milestone. She will reach the mark thanks to her consistency, as Hales has played in all 112 Valpo games since she stepped on campus as a freshman. She has seen her scoring average go up year by year and is averaging a team-best 12.1 points/game this season.
