In a season-opening road series at Tennessee Tech, Evansville junior Tanner Craig had an incredible weekend. Craig finished the weekend batting .727 (8-for-11) with four home runs, seven RBI, a double, eight hits, three walks, including an intentional walk to end the weekend. Twice this weekend, Craig hit two home runs in a game, including back-to-back homers in Sunday's series finale that helped the Aces build a 10-2 lead. All last season, Craig hit just five home runs in 197 at bats and has

nearly matched that mark in just 11 at bats.

Missouri State senior right-hander Logan Wiley pitched the Bears to a 1-0 opening day victory over Central Arkansas Friday, tossing 7.0 scoreless innings to help pave the way to a series win for MSU in Conway. The Springfield, Mo., native retired the final 12 batters he faced, struck out seven UCA hitters and scattered three hits in a 77-pitch effort that spearheaded MSU's first opening-day shutout since 1970.

NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and newcomer of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

Connor O'Brien (BRAD) – The reigning All-Missouri Valley Conference first team first baseman picked up where he left off last season by posting a 1.302 OPS during the opening weekend of the season. During the 3-game series at Incarnate Word, O'Brien was 4-for-12 (.333) with a double, two home runs and five RBIs against the Cardinals. With 11 total bases in 12 at-bats, O'Brien has started the year with a .917 slugging percentage.

Andres Sosa (DBU) – DBU's Andres Sosa hit a team-high .400 (4-for-10) in the Patriots' series sweep of South Dakota State. Sosa belted his first home run of the year, drove in a team-high four runs, and also posted a team-best .700 slugging percentage in DBU's first three games of the season. In Saturday's comeback win overthe Jackrabbits, Sosa delivered a three-run homer in the third inning and with DBU down a run in the ninth, his base hit tied the game to send the contest into extra innings where the Patriots eventually won, 8-7. Sosa also shined defensively, throwing out 3-of-4 base stealers in his two starts at catcher and also played error-free baseball in his start at second base on Saturday. For the week, he posted a 1.000 fielding percentage in 40 chances.

Joe Butler (ILS) – Preseason MVC All-Conference member Joe Butler started the 2020 campaign right where he left off last season. In three games at Little Rock this past weekend, the senior shortstop had a team-leading .455 batting average, going 5 for 11 in three starts. Out of Butler's five hits, three of them were for extra bases as he compiled two doubles and a solo home run. Overall, Butler slashed .455/.538/.909 on the weekend to lead the Redbirds while also knocking in a run and stealing one base. Butler played solid defense at shortstop as well, notching a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage.

Dominic Cusumano (INS) – Redshirt freshman Dominic Cusumano led the Sycamores at the plate over the weekend at the Snowbird Classic. The utility man started all three games, playing both second base and the outfield. Cusumano hit .571, notching multiple base hits in each game played, including a 3-for-4 effort opening day against Pitt. Cusumano went for eight hits over the weekend with two doubles for a .714 slugging percentage.

Dakota Kotowski (MSU) – Sophomore outfielder Dakota Kotowski played a pivotal role in a pair of Missouri State victories over Central Arkansas, hitting. 417 for the week with a home run and four RBIs. Kotowski drove home go-ahead tallies in all three contests, including the lone run in MSU's 1-0 victory in Friday's season opener. He also homered in game two of the series, logging his second straight two-hit effort and driving in two runs on the day. The Channahon, Ill., product capped his weekend with a run scoring single—his third two-out, RBI hit of the series—to stake the Bears to an early lead in Sunday's finale.

lan Walters (SIU) – Senior infielder lan Walters was 6-for-15 (.400) at the plate with two doubles and six RBIs in SIU's season-opening series win at Jackson State. The Rend Lake College transfer reached base an additional five times on three walks and two HBP. He ended the series with a teambest .524 on-base percentage. Walters collected at least one RBI in three of the four games, which included a game-high three in game two. He doubled twice in the matchup and drove in the tying run in the ninth inning.

Dominic Hamel (DBU) – DBU's Dominic Hamel picked up the win in his first career start as a Patriot, working 5.0 innings and allowing just one earned run on Sunday versus South Dakota State. Hamel struck out nine batters and walked just two in his debut to help lift No. 23 DBU to a perfect 3-0 record to start the 2020 season.

Jake McMahill (UE) – Opening his season with a start in the series finale at Tennessee Tech, Jake McMahill turned a stifling performance on the mound. On Sunday, the senior pitched five innings, allowing just one run on three hits, while striking out six and not walking a batter. McMahill left the contest after the top of the sixth inning with the Aces holding an 8-2 advantage.

Tristan Weaver (INS) – Sycamore starting pitcher Tristan Weaver went six innings in a no-decision effort against Kent State Saturday at the Snowbird Classic. The southpaw retired eight Kent State batters on strikeouts while holding the Golden Flashes to a .118 average against. Weaver allowed just one earned run and two base hits in the outing.

Mason Hiser (SIU) – Senior pitcher Mason Hiser pitched six shutout innings in SIU's season-opening 2-0 win at Jackson State. It marked the third time in his career he allowed no earned runs in a start. Hiser allowed only one extra-base hit and no walks against a JSU offense that ranked fourth nationally in batting average last season (.315). The Barton College transfer also struck out three.



Carraway was named a First Team selection by Baseball America, a Second Team selection by D1 Baseball and Perfect Game and the NCBWA tabbed him to their Third Team. DBU's Jimmy Glowenke also earned a spot on the NCBWA Third Team. Indiana State's Collin Liberatore was named a Second Team selection by Collegiate Baseball.

Award Nominees

The award watch lists have MVC student-athletes as nominees for national awards.

Bradley's Theron Denlinger, DBU's Burl Carraway and Illinois State's Jacob Gilmore are listed among the preseason NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award watch list, given to the top relief pitcher.

MVC Finds Success in MLB Draft

A total of 18 MVC student-athletes had their names called during the Major League Baseball Player Draft. Illinois State's John Rave was the top pick for the league with the 129th overall pick by the Kansas City Royals.

DBU had six players drafted while Illinois State had five players selected. Indiana State had three players chosen and Missouri State had two, while Southern Illinois and Evansville each had one draftee.

Multi-Teams Again

For the 25th time in 39 seasons, multiple MVC baseball teams were selected as part of the field of 64 teams to play for the 2019 College World Series title.

The Missouri Valley Conference was one of only seven leagues to have three or more teams selected for the NCAA Championship. The Valley joined the SEC (10), ACC (8), Big 12 (5), Big Ten (5), Pac 12 (5) and American (3) with three or more in the field.

This was the sixth time in eight years the MVC has placed multiple teams into the NCAA field and the seventh time in league history the MVC sent three teams (1990, 1995, 1999, 2000, 2012, 2015, 2019).

Two-By-Forty

Indiana State (43-18) and DBU (43-20) registered 40 wins on the season, marking the 15th time since the 1992 season that at least two Valley teams tallied 40 or more wins.

Two league teams also recorded 40 or more wins in 2018, 2017, 2015, 2012, 2008, 2007, 2006, 2005, 2003, 2002, 2000, 1996, 1993 and 1992 (three teams).

40 Wins for DBU...Again

DBU reached the 40-win plateau for the sixthstraight season. The Patriots join Louisville and Florida State as the only three NCAA Division I programs with 40+ wins in six-straight seasons.

Shadid did reach safely twice in Saturday's game, however, drawing a walk and a hit-by-pitch. While batting .455 (5-for-11) in the 3-game series, Shadid reached base safely at least two times in each of the three games and his overall on-base streak stands at nine games.



Weekend of Firsts

Fourteen first-year Braves made their Bradley debut during the season-opening series at Incarnate Word. Among the highlights, freshman DH Peter Hansen had an RBI single in his first career at-bat Saturday and completed the weekend batting .500 (3-for-6), while also drawing a walk and a hit by pitch for a .625 on-base percentage, in his first two college games. After getting the starting nod as the DH in Friday's season-opener, freshman Carson Husmann launched a pinch-hit home run in Sunday's series finale for his first career dinger. Husmann hit 31 home runs in high school. Junior college transfer Adam Rellihan started at second base in all three games in San Antonio, batting .200 (2-for-10) with a RBI, while handling all 10 chances at second base.

Lifting the Lid

With its 1-0 win over UCA Friday afternoon, Missouri State improved to 25-13 in season openers under head coach Keith Guttin and 37-20 overall as a program in such contests. MSU posted its seventh opening day victory in the last eight seasons and has now gone a combined 16-6 in its opening weekend series or tournaments since 2014.



Welcome Mat

The Bears received significant contributions from a host of newcomers to claim their opening series from Central Arkansas, Junior infielder Grant Wood led MSU with a .455 batting mark and a .538 on-base percentage, while also registering a perfect weekend in the field, handling all 11 of his defensive chances at third base. Freshmen Drake Baldwin and Greg Ziegler also enjoyed strong showings in their initial series with the Bears. Baldwin turned in a 2-for-4 day Friday, then sparked MSU's go-ahead, three-run rally in game two with a seventh-inning home run. Ziegler delivered a double and a home run in Sunday's finale. On the mound, Hayden Minton turned in a memorable mound effort Saturday, holding UCA to one run on two hits, while fanning four and issuing three walks in his 6.0 innings of work in his collegiate debut. Sophomore right-hander Trey Ziegenbein also chipped in to help MSU claim each of the first two games, totaling three strikeouts in a combined 2.2 scoreless innings of relief.

Wicked Wiley
Senior right-hander Logan Wiley picked up right where he left off last spring in Friday's season opener at UCA, blanking the Bears on three hits over 7.0 innings. The Springfield native registered wins in each of his last five decisions of the 2019 season, finishing the season ranked among the Valley's top 10 hurlers in ERA (3.67), innings pitched (90.2) and strikeouts (82), all of which led MSU's pitching staff. With his opening day win, the two-time All-MVC choice logged his sixth quality start in his last seven outings (since April 19, 2019), over which he has gone 5-0 with a 1.98 ERA.

Battling the Best

Valpo is getting set for a three-game weekend series at Louisville that starts on Friday. The Cardinals are ranked No. 1 in the nation in the preseason D1Basebaell.com poll and by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper, No. 2 by Baseball America and the National Collegiate Baseball Writers' Association and No. 3 in the USA Today Coaches' Poll. Valpo does have a victory over the No. 1 team in the nation in its history, as the program topped No. 1 Notre Dame 7-3 on April 25, 2001 to snap a 16-game winning streak for the Fighting Irish. In recent years, the program has Top 25 wins over No. 25 Illiniosi (April 17, 2018), No. 25 DBU (March 11, 2016), No. 9 Arizona State (April 21, 2013) and No. 4 Arkansas (Feb. 26, 2012).



Strong Schedule
In addition to the aforementioned Louisville team that went 51-18 and was one of the final four teams standing in the College World Series a year ago, Valpo's loaded nonconference schedule features several other high-level opponents. The series against the Cardinals starts a stretch of seven straight games against teams that played in NCAA Regionals last year. The Brown & Gold will play defending Southland Conference champion McNeese State, defending Conference USA champ Southern Mississippi and defending SWAC East crown-holder Alabama State, among other quality foes.

For Openers

The choice for Friday's Opening Day starting pitcher at Western Kentucky was an unconventional one for head coach Brian Schmack. Senior Easton Rhodehouse, who had made 63 career relief appearances and no starts, got the nod. Rhodehouse pitched 1 1/3 innings before giving way to traditional Friday starter in recent years, senior Jon Tieman. Rhodehouse became Valpo's fifth opening day starter in as many years, joining Mike Kornacker, Tieman, Mario Losi and Dalton Lundeen.
