Dan Bolt, Sr., OF, Bradley

Bolt led a Bradley offense that averaged 6.2 runs per game by hitting .421 (8-for-19) with three home runs and seven RBI during the four-game trip to the SAF Dirt Classic in the Nashville area. Bolt heated up Friday when he went 3-for-5 with a three-run home run at Lipscomb. He followed that effort by going 4-for-6 with two home runs and three RBI in Saturday's 11-4 win at Austin Peay. Bolt closed the trip by going 1-for-4 with a HBP and a RBI in Sunday's 8-7 loss at Belmont.

DBU's Dominic Hamel worked seven shutout innings and took a no-hitter into the eighth inning in the Patriots' 3-0 win over #13 North Carolina on Sunday. Hamel, a junior right-hander from Chandler, Arizona, struck out a season-high 10 batters and allowed just one hit, while issuing only one walk against the Tar Heel lineup. With the win, DBU claimed the series over North Carolina. Hamel is now 2-0 on the season with a 0.75 ERA and has struck out 19 batters in 12.0 innings.

NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and newcomer of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

Blayne Jones (DBU) – DBU's Blayne Jones hit a team-best .357 (5-for-14) in a week that saw the Patriots post a 3-1 record and claim a series win on the road at No. 13 North Carolina. Jones also led the team in slugging percentage (.714), on-base percentage (.438), total bases (10), hits (5), and doubles (2). On Sunday, Jones' home run in the ninth inning against the Tar Heels gave the Patriots a much-needed insurance run in their 3-0 shutout of North Carolina.

Indiana Stanley (UE) – After struggling to start the season, sophomore Indiana Stanley got going in the last two games of the weekend for the Aces. Stanley started the year going 0-1.5 from the plate, but reversed it against Belmont on Saturday. Against the Bruins, Stanley went 3-for-5 with three RBI and a run scored, including a fourth-inning solo homer. On Sunday against Austin Peay, Stanley again went 3-for-5, contributing another home run, this time with another solo home run as the sophomore tallied four RBI.

Brian Fuentes (INS) – Junior infielder Brian Fuentes led the Sycamores over the weekend with a .308 batting average over four games. Fuentes recorded four hits while scoring a run and driving in a run for the Sycamores. The Crystal Lake, Illinois native earned a .438 on-base percentage after earning a walk and two passes on hit-by-pitches.

Brad Hudson (SIU) - Began the week cold with a rough performance against Belmont that saw the Allen, Texas native go 0-4 with two strikeouts at the plate. Quickly turned it around s the Salukis headed out West, as the junior was one of the more offensively consistent players during the Tony Gwynn Legacy Classic. Hit for .667 over the weekend with three RBIs. Got the weekend started with a 2-3 showing at the plate, batting in two runs at the top of the third that gave the Salukis a 3-1 over the Arizona Wildcats. Followed up Friday's performance with the best overall performance of his career in the program's marquee win over USC. Against the Trojans, Hudson collected a career-high three hits at the plate in four appearances, in addition to a stolen base and an RBI, which came at the bottom of the fifth and gave the Salukis a 1-0 advantage in the game. He later would fly out to right in the seventh inning, advancing teammate lan Walters to third, who then would score moments later off of a wild pitch to give the Salukis the 3-1 lead.

Nolan Tucker (VALPO) – Tucker started all four games this week and posted a .308 batting average while sharing the team lead in hits and owning the team lead in RBIs. He enjoyed a big day on Sunday at No. 3 Louisville by lashing three hits and driving in four including his first career home run. That performance allowed Tucker to become the first Valpo freshman since 2012 to enjoy a four-RBI game.

Nick King (BRAD) – King worked 4.0 scoreless IP to start Saturday's game at Austin Peay, leading the Braves to their first win of the season. King surrendered just one hit, walked two and struck out four Saturday against the Governors.

Caleb Reinhardt (UE) – In his first year with the Aces, junior Caleb Reinhardt turned in a strong performance for Evansville this weekend. Against Lipscomb, Reinhardt pitched five innings, allowing just one run on two hits, while striking out five.

Colton Johnson (ILS) – In a series that had multiple pitching battles throughout, Colton Johnson put together a solid performance in game one against the No. 23-ranked Oklahoma Sooners. In 7.0 innings pitched, Johnson allowed just two runs on four hits while also walking two. Along with this, Johnson racked up 10 strikeouts, which is a career-high. In two starts this season, Johnson has averaged 9.0 strikeouts per game.

Tristan Weaver (INS) – Sycamore starting pitcher Tristan Weaver went six and two-third innings in his second no-decision of the season Saturday against Omaha. The southpaw retired a career high 11 Mavericks on strikeouts while holding Omaha to just one base hit and a .048 average against. Over two starts. Weaver holds an 0.71 ERA over 12.2 innings.

Logan Wiley (MSU) – Senior right-hander Logan Wiley turned in his second-straight shutout performance in as many starts this season, striking out seven Belmont hitters over the first eight innings of Friday's 1-0, 11-inning loss to the Bruins. The Springfield, Mo., product, who earned a 1-0 opening day win for the Bears at UCA last Friday, had to settle for a no-decision, despite limiting Belmont to five hits and a pair of walks. For the season, Wiley has yet to allow a run in his 15.0 innings but has enjoyed just one run of offensive support in the two games combined.

Brad Harrison (SIU) – The senior pitcher had himself a solid start to the week, as he went an inning against Belmont and kept the Bruins off the board while only allowing a hit. His significant performance this week came out of his outing against USC, which saw the O'Fallon, III. native go for a season-high five innings deep, only allowing a hit to one of the top teams nationally in batting average (6th). Harrison faced 19 batters and struck out four, in addition to forcing out six. Harrison played an instrumental role in the Salukis 3-1 upset win over USC.

Trent Turzenski (VALP0) – Turzenski permitted just one earned run over 6 1/3 innings this week while making two appearances and holding opponents to a .240 batting average. He started the week by allowing one run on four hits on Monday at Western Kentucky before contributing to a solid pitching performance in Game 2 of the three-game weekend series at No. 3 Louisville. He held one of the nation's top teams without an earned run on just two hits over 3 1/3 frames.



Top 25 Series Win

DBU's series win over No. 13 North Carolina was the Patriots' best series win over a top 25 opponent in program history. Prior to this weekend, DBU's series victory over then-ranked No. 22 Sam Houston State in March of 2018.

Close Losses

During the first two weeks of action, MVC teams have combined to go 3-13 in one run games and 2-5 in extra inning contests. Evansville, Illinois State and Southern Illinois all sit 0-3 in one run games so far this season.

VS. 2019 NCAA Tourney Teams

The league went 3-5 against 2019 NCAA Tournament teams during the second weekend after going 0-1 during the opening week of action (Indiana State lost to Ohio State in extra innings).

DBU claimed a 2-1 series win at North Carolina, while Indiana State split a pair of games with Omaha. Valpo dropped all three games at #3 Louisville over the weekend. So far in 2020, the MVC is 3-6 against the 2019 field.

National Pitcher of the Week

DBU's Dominic Hamel was tabbed the National Pitcher of the Week by Collegiate Baseball on Monday. Hamel improved to a perfect 2-0 on the season, shutting out No. 13 North Carolina over a season-high 7.0 innings of work last Sunday. In the Patriots' 3-0 win over the Tar Heels, Hamel took a no-hitter into the eighth inning, striking out a season-high 10 batters, while eventually allowing just one hit and one walk on the afternoon.

Hamel becomes the third pitcher in DBU history to receive National Pitcher of the Week honors, joining Colin Poche (2016) and MD Johnson (2019).

Preseason All-Americans

Three Missouri Valley Conference baseball players were named to a Preseason All-American team. DBU closer Burl Carraway made four appearances on a preseason squad. Carraway was named a First Team selection by Baseball America, a Second Team selection by D1 Baseball and Perfect Game and the NCBWA tabbed him to their Third Team. DBU's Jimmy Glowenke also earned a spot on the NCBWA Third Team. Indiana State's Collin Liberatore was named a Second Team selection by Collegiate Baseball.

Award Nominees

The award watch lists have MVC student-athletes as nominees for national awards.

Bradley's Theron Denlinger, DBU's Burl Carraway and Illinois State's Jacob Gilmore are listed among the preseason NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award watch list, given to the top relief pitcher.

MVC Finds Success in MLB Draft

A total of 18 MVC student-athletes had their names called during the Major League Baseball Player Draft. Illinois State's John Rave was the top pick for the league with the 129th overall pick by the Kansas City Royals.

DBU had six players drafted while Illinois State had five players selected. Indiana State had three players chosen and Missouri State had two, while Southern Illinois and Evansville each had one draftee.

The Valley has placed at least 17 players in the draft six-straight seasons.

Multi-Teams Again

For the 25th time in 39 seasons, multiple MVC baseball teams were selected as part of the field of 64 teams to play for the 2019 College World Series title.

The Missouri Valley Conference was one of only seven leagues to have three or more teams selected for the NCAA Championship. The Valley joined the SEC (10), ACC (8), Big 12 (5), Big Ten (5), Pac 12 (5) and American (3) with three or more in the field.

This was the sixth time in eight years the MVC has placed multiple teams into the NCAA field and the seventh time in league history the MVC sent three teams (1990, 1995, 1999, 2000, 2012, 2015, 2019).

Two-By-Forty

Indiana State (43-18) and DBU (43-20) registered 40 wins on the season, marking the 15th time since the 1992 season that at least two Valley teams tallied 40 or more wins.

Two league teams also recorded 40 or more wins in 2018, 2017, 2015, 2012, 2008, 2007, 2006, 2005, 2003, 2002, 2000, 1996, 1993 and 1992 (three teams).

40 Wins for DBU...Again

DBU reached the 40-win plateau for the sixthstraight season. The Patriots join Louisville and Florida State as the only three NCAA Division I programs with 40+ wins in six-straight seasons.

MISSOURI STATE (3-4)

Pitching In

The depth and talent present on the Missouri State pitching staff has been on full display through the first seven games of the season. The Bears currently rank second in the MVC with both their 2.35 team ERA and .206 batting average against, while MSU leads the circuit in fewest earned runs allowed (16) for the season. In contrast to the 2019 season, the Bears posted a 7.80 team ERA, permitted a .306 opponent batting



mark and allowed 52 earned runs through their first seven games. Even without the services of projected No. 1 starter Ty Buckner due to injury, MSU has employed 10 different pitchers this season, with all but two registering a sub-3.00 ERA to date.

Wood Work

Bears junior transfer Grant Wood has wasted no time in establishing himself as one of the key bats in the MSU lineup. The Jefferson City, Mo., product leads the team and ranks fifth in the Valley with his .370 batting average, while both his on-base percentage (.452) and hits total (10) rank fifth in the conference. Wood has started his Missouri State career with hits in each of the Bears' first seven contests, including three different multi-hit efforts, while posting a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage (in 16 defensive chances) on the MSU infield.

Wiley In Command
Senior right-hander Logan Wiley turned in yet another standout performance on the hill for MSU Friday, holding Belmont to five hits in 8.0 shutout frames. The Springfield, Mo., native allowed three hits over 7.0 innings in a 1-0 season-opening win at UCA on Feb. 14, extended his personal scoreless streak to 16.2 consecutive innings, dating back to last May 21 vs. Valparaiso at the MVC Championship. He has also registered wins in each of his last six decisions and now has seven quality starts in his last eight outings (since April 19, 2019), over which he has gone 5-0 with a 1.71 FRA

VALPARAISO (1-5)

Offensive Explosion
Valpo and No. 3 Louisville produced a score that look more appropriate for the gridiron than the diamond as the Cardinals won the series finale 14-10 on Sunday in Louisville, Ky. Valpo posted season highs in runs (10) and hits (15) and was outhit just 16-15 against the nation's No. 3 team. That marked Valpo's highest single-game hit total since March 16, 2019 against Northern Illinois and the team's first double-figure run total since beating Western Michigan 11-1 on April 16 of last season. The 10 runs were Valpo's most in a loss since March 2, 2018, a 14-13 setback vs. CSUN. The 10 runs were the most allowed by Louisville since a 16-11 loss vs. No. 22 Miami on April 19 of last season.



Promising Pitching
The win-loss record may not have shown it, but there was plenty to be excited about for Valpo baseball after this past weekend's series at Louisville. Not only did the offense break through on Sunday, but Valpo got quality pitching performances in each of the first two games. The Brown & Gold lost 3-0 in the series opener, issuing just one walk in the game. It was the second straight game Valpo permitted just one base on balls after doing so in the 10-inning victory over Western Kentucky on Monday, Feb. 17. The last time Valpo allowed one walk or fewer in back-to-back games was April 3, 2016, when the team issued one base on balls over a doubleheader against Milwaukee.

Tucker's Time

Freshman infielder Nolan Tucker drove in four runs against No. 3 Louisville on Sunday, becoming the first Valpo rookie with a four-RBI game since Grant Yoder on April 24, 2012 at Purdue Fort Wayne (then IPFW). Tucker's big day included his first collegiate home run, allowing him to join Riley Dent as the two Valpo players who have gone yard this season.
