### Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Week

#### Dan Bolt, Sr., OF, Bradley

After hitting three home runs in four games at the SAF Dirt Classic in Tennessee last week, Bolt led the Braves to a three-game series sweep at Tennessee Tech by hitting four home runs in three games versus the Golden Eagles. By hitting at least one home run in each game of the series at Tennessee Tech, Bolt has blasted seven home runs in Bradley's last six games. All four of Bolt's hits at Tennessee Tech left the yard, as he went 4-for-12 (.333) with eight RBI. Bolt also drew three

walks and was hit by a pitch, giving him a .500 on-base percentage for the series, as well as a 1.833 OPS.

### Tristan Weaver, R-Jr., LHP, Indiana State

Sycamore starting pitcher Tristan Weaver was phenomenal Friday as the Sycamores worked a combined shutout of Elon. The redshirt junior recorded a career high 12 strikeouts while tying a career long outing with seven innings pitched. Weaver allowed just three base hits and walked only one batter while holding the Phoenix to a .115 average against. With the win, the lefty improved to 1-0 on the year and dropped his ERA to just 0.46 after three starts.

### **NOTEWORTHY**

In addition to the league's player and newcomer of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

**Jimmy Glowenke (DBU)** – DBU's Jimmy Glowenke hit a team-best .438 (7-for-16) with a home run and a team-high six RBI. Glowenke also led the team in slugging percentage (.688), on-base percentage (.474), and total bases (11).

Craig Shepherd (UE) – Helping the Aces to a 3-1 week against No. 2 Vanderbilt and Butler, senior Craig Shepherd was a force at the plate for Evansville. On the week, Shepherd batted .353, earning six hits, including a double, with four RBI and two runs. Shepherd's weekend highlight came in the first two games of the weekend series with Butler as Shepherd went 5-of-8 from the plate with four RBI.

Jordan Schaffer (INS) – Redshirt junior Jordan Schaffer put on a hitting clinic during the Sycamores' series sweep of Elon over the weekend. The shortstop collected a career high three hits in the opener Friday before breaking the record a day later with a 4-for-5 performance to help ISU clinch the series Saturday. A Terre Haute, Indiana native, Schaffer was perfect in the leadoff spot in the series and finished 8-for-12 for a .667 batting percentage to go along with a .688 on-base percentage. He scored six of ISU's 18 runs on the weekend, worked three walks, drove in in a pair of runs and stole one base.

**Drake Baldwin (MSU)** – Freshman catcher/DH Drake Baldwin led the Bears with a .375 batting mark (6-for-16) and seven RBIs last week, playing key roles in two Missouri State victories. The Madison, Wis., native recorded at least one hit and one RBI in all four MSU contests, including a career-best four-RBI effort in the Bears' 9-3 win over national power Rice on Saturday. In that game, Baldwin went 2-for-4 with a two-run double and a two-run triple to help MSU post its first-ever win over the Owls. He followed that performance with a 2-for-2 day Sunday in which he reached base safely in all four trips to the plate.

lan Walters (SIU) – Walters led Southern Illinois to a 3-1 week and road-series win over Morehead State with a 10-for-18 (.555) showing at the plate. He added two extrabase hits (one triple, one home run) five RBI, four walks and three stolen bases while committing no errors at third base during the four-game stretch. The Paducah, Ky. native tacked two-plus hits in all three games at Morehead, which included a season-high four knocks in SIU's 22-5 victory in the series finale. The week extended Walters' hitting streak to nine games and his on-base streak to 14 games, which dates back to last season.

Riley Dent (VALPO) – Dent enjoyed a strong week at the plate against quality competition, hitting .357 while posting a .500 on-base percentage over four games at the Lake Area Classic in Lake Charles, La. Those numbers came against McNeese State and Southern Miss, both teams that won their respective conferences and qualified for NCAA Regionals a year ago. Dent went 5-of-9 over two games on Saturday and Sunday, posting back-to-back multi-hit efforts to boost his season total to four, tied for the team lead. His week allowed him to lift his team-best batting average to .316 over 10 games.

Matt Hamilton (BRAD) – In his third start for the Braves, Hamilton helped Bradley complete the weekend series sweep at Tennessee Tech by pitching the first six innings of Sunday's 16-1 win. A first-year transfer from Madison College, Hamilton allowed one run on five hits with one walk and six strikeouts Sunday against the Golden Eagles.

**Ray Gaither (DBU)** – DBU's Ray Gaither struck out a careerhigh nine batters on Friday to help lead the Patriots to a win over Arkansas State. Gaither allowed just four hits and walked one over 6.0 innings of work.

**Shane Gray (UE)** – In his third outing of the season, sophomore Shane Gray shut down the Bulldogs in a 4-1 Aces' victory. On Saturday, Gray went seven innings, allowing just one run on two hits, while striking out seven. Gray took a no-hitter into the seventh inning and was perfect through four innings in the victory.

Forrest Barnes (MSU) – Sophomore reliever Forrest Barnes delivered critical performances in both of the Bears' victories last week, picking up a win in Tuesday's 6-3 win at ORU, as well as Saturday's 9-3 decision over Rice. The Ozark, Mo., product fanned five ORU hitters in his 3.0 hitless innings, then earned his second win of the week after striking out three batters in 3.2 innings of relief against Rice.

Ryan Mintz (VALPO) – Mintz turned in a quality outing in his first career start, permitting three runs on seven hits while walking one and striking out three in 6 1/3 innings of work against Southern Miss on Friday afternoon in Lake Charles, La. He became the first Valpo pitcher to work more than five innings in an outing this season. Two of the three runs he yielded came on one swing of the bat.



#### Series Sweeps

Three Valley teams earned series sweeps over the weekend. Bradley, Evansville and Indiana State each claimed a 3-0 series sweep.

Evansville played its first games in Evansville this season and earned a three-game series sweep of Butler. The sweep was the first for the Aces since a three-game sweep of Bradley last March.

The Sycamores finished with 33 base hits (11 per game) in the three wins at Elon over the weekend. Five Sycamores recorded four or more hits during the series sweep.

Bradley's three game sweep at Tennessee Tech was the Braves first non-conference series sweep since taking three at Belmont on March 2-4, 2018.

Bradley's Dan Bolt earned a spot on this week's Collegiate Baseball's National Players of the Week list. During a three-game series at Tennessee Tech, Bolt hit 4 home runs as he went 4-for-12 with 8 RBI. He also drew 3 walks. Over Bradley's last six games, Bolt has blasted 7 home runs.

### **Preseason All-Americans**

Three Missouri Valley Conference baseball players were named to a Preseason All-American team. DBU closer Burl Carraway made four appearances on a preseason squad. Carraway was named a First Team selection by Baseball America, a Second Team selection by D1 Baseball and Perfect Game and the NČBWA tabbed him to their Third Team. DBU's Jimmy Glowenke also earned a spot on the NCBWA Third Team. Indiana State's Collin Liberatore was named a Second Team selection by Collegiate Baseball.

### Award Nominees

The award watch lists have MVC student-athletes as nominees for national awards.

Bradley's Theron Denlinger, DBU's Burl Carraway and Illinois State's Jacob Gilmore are listed among the preseason NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award watch list, given to the top relief pitcher.

### **MVC Finds Success in MLB Draft**

A total of 18 MVC student-athletes had their names called during the Major League Baseball Player Draft. Illinois State's John Rave was the top pick for the league with the 129th overall pick by the Kansas City Royals.

DBU had six players drafted while Illinois State had five players selected. Indiana State had three players chosen and Missouri State had two, while Southern Illinois and Evansville each had one draftee.

The Valley has placed at least 17 players in the draft six-straight seasons.

### **Multi-Teams Again**

For the 25th time in 39 seasons, multiple MVC baseball teams were selected as part of the field of 64 teams to play for the 2019 College World Series title.

The Missouri Valley Conference was one of only seven leagues to have three or more teams selected for the NCAA Championship. The Valley joined the SEC (10), ACC (8), Big 12 (5), Big Ten (5), Pac 12 (5) and American (3) with three or more in the field.

This was the sixth time in eight years the MVC has placed multiple teams into the NCAA field and the seventh time in league history the MVC sent three teams (1990, 1995, 1999, 2000, 2012, 2015, 2019).

### **Two-By-Forty**

Indiana State (43-18) and DBU (43-20) registered 40 wins on the season, marking the 15th time since the 1992 season that at least two Valley teams tallied 40 or more wins.

Two league teams also recorded 40 or more wins in 2018, 2017, 2015, 2012, 2008, 2007, 2006, 2005, 2003, 2002, 2000, 1996, 1993 and 1992 (three teams).

### 40 Wins for DBU...Again

DBU reached the 40-win plateau for the sixthstraight season. The Patriots join Louisville and Florida State as the only three NCAA Division I programs with 40+ wins in six-straight seasons.

### **MISSOURI STATE (5-6)**

### **Welcome Wagon**

The Bears offense has been bolstered by the addition of several talented newcomers over the season's first three weeks. MSU's top three hitters are all new to the program this year, with freshman Drake Baldwin leading the club with a .325 average and eight RBIs through the first 11 games. Junior transfer Grant Wood has gotten off to a hot start as well, batting .310 with hits in each of his first nine games as a Bear, and freshman outfielder Greg Ziegler turning in a .292 batting mark with three multi-hit performances to date.



### **Elite Company**

Last Tuesday's game at ORU marked the beginning of a notable string of elite opponents for the Bears, who will play nine-straight games against NCAA Division I College World Series qualifying teams and 16 of 17 contests overall. MSU will play two games against ORU (who appeared in Omaha in 1978), three against Rice (seven appearances), one game at Oklahoma State (20 appearances) and three games against Maine (seven appearances) over the period Feb. 25-March 8. Following a midweek game against SIU Edwardsville (March 11), the Bears will then play seven more games against three additional CWS qualifiers (UC Irvine, Alabama and San Jose State).

#### What a Relief

The Bears bullpen has been dominant through the first 11 games of the season, posting a 2.55 ERA while limiting the opposition to a .200 batting mark. Sophomore right-handers Forrest Barnes, Trey Ziegenbein and Hayden Juenger have led the way, combining to go 2-0 with three saves and a 1.88 ERA. Ziegenbein has logged a 1.42 ERA in seven appearances, while Juenger leads the club with three saves and Barnes has posted a team-best two mound victories.
