Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Week

Gunner Peterson, So., OF, Illinois State

In a week where Illinois State finished 3-1, sophomore outfielder Gunner Peterson played a key role at the plate for the Redbirds. The Salem, Wis. native slashed .467/.529/.933 with four extra base hits during the week. In a win over #13 Arkansas, Peterson was 2-for-3 with a stolen base as the Redbirds earned their second Top 25 win of the season. In a win against VCU on Friday, Peterson finished going 3-for-5 with a double, triple and grand slam to lead the Redbirds to an 8-5 win. Peterson finished the week with a team-leading six RBI.

Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week

Connor Cline, R-Jr., RHP, Indiana State

Redshirt junior Connor Cline put together a solid week on the mound for the Sycamores. The right-hander – who is recovering from an injury that kept him sidelined last year – appeared in two games for the Sycamores over the past week, including one start. He finished with a 1-0 record after a midweek victory over Top-25 RPI San Diego. He went six complete innings against the Toreros while allowing just four hits and striking out four batters. Cline was solid on the mound in relief Sunday against Kansas, helping the Sycamores to a series win after pitching three and a third scoreless innings, striking out four and allowing just one base hit. Overall on the week Cline went nine and a third innings, allowing five hits while striking out eight and issuing just one walk. He held opponents to a .152 average against and did not allow a run.

NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and newcomer of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

Blayne Jones (DBU) – DBU's Blayne Jones hit .368 (7-for-19) with two home runs and four RBI last week. In Friday's win over Oral Roberts, Jones drove in the game-winning run in the bottom of the ninth with a two-out RBI single to give the Patriots a 3-2 win. In a week that saw the Patriots go 3-1 and sweep Oral Roberts, Jones led DBU in slugging percentage (.684), total bases (13), and runs (5).

Mason Brinkley (UE) – Getting his chance to start for the Aces, junior Mason Brinkley made the most of his opportunity this weekend. In four games last weekend, Brinkley went 9-of-14 from the plate with three runs and two RBI. Against College of Charleston, Brinkley went 8-for-13, including a 7-10 stretch to close the weekend. Brinkley now leads the Aces in batting average, hitting .400 on the year.

Diego Gines (INS) – Freshman Diego Gines powered out two home runs for the Sycamores over the past week as Indiana State went 3-1 with a midweek win over San Diego and a weekend series victory against Kansas. Gines was 4-for-12 from the plate for a .333 average to go along with an .833 slugging percentage and a .429 on-base percentage. The infielder drove in four runs while scoring five runs. He hit a three-run home run in Sunday's series clinching game while also homering against the Toreros Tuesday.

Logan Geha (MSU) – Senior catcher Logan Geha powered Missouri State's offense in its weekend series win over Maine, going 7-for-11 in the three-game set as part of a week in which the Lee's Summit, Mo., product hit .500 overall. Geha posted back-to-back three-hit games against the Black Bears to match a personal single-game high and belted a seventh-inning home run in Saturday's game. He also doubled and stole a base in game two, before driving in a key run with another two-bagger in Sunday's 4-1, series-clinching victory.

Evan Martin (SIU) – Evan Martin hit .556/.636/.667 for SIU in a 3-1 week. Martin went 5-for-9 with a double, a walk and a HBP for the Salukis in three starts. He was 2-for-2 stealing bases and his four runs scored led the team. Martin was particularly impressive in the final two games of the NIU series, going 5-for-6 with a double, and he reached base in 7 of his 8 plate appearances in the final two games.

Burl Carraway (DBU) – DBU's Burl Carraway picked up a pair of saves in the Patriots' three-game sweep of Oral Roberts over the weekend, moving him into fifth all-time in career saves (10) in DBU's Division I era. Of the five outs that Carraway recorded, four were by strikeouts.

Jake McMahill (UE) – Starting the Sunday matchup against College of Charleston, senior Jake McMahill pitched six innings of shutout baseball. McMahill allowed just three hits and no earned runs in six innings, helping the Aces hold an early advantage.

Logan Wiley (MSU) – Senior right-hander Logan Wiley turned in a dominant mound effort to lift the Bears to a 6-2 series-opening win over Maine on Friday. The Springfield, Mo., native struck out six Black Bears and allowed just five hits in 7.0 shutout innings to earn his second win of the season and pave the way to a series win for MSU, riking out three batters in 3.2 innings of relief against Rice.

Dylan Givens (SIU) – Dylan Givens pitched 4.2 scoreless innings and earned the win for SIU in a 6-0 win over NIU on Sunday. Givens entered a bases-loaded, 1-out jam and induced an inning-ending double play ball to start his night. He then flew through 4.2 innings, allowing just two hits (both singles) and walking none. NIU hit .143 against Givens, and he retired 11 of the final 12 men he faced.

Multi-Teams Again

For the 25th time in 39 seasons, multiple MVC baseball teams were selected as part of the field of 64 teams to play for the 2019 College World Series title.

The Missouri Valley Conference was one of only seven leagues to have three or more teams selected for the NCAA Championship. The Valley joined the SEC (10), ACC (8), Big 12 (5), Big Ten (5), Pac 12 (5) and American (3) with three or more in the field.

This was the sixth time in eight years the MVC has placed multiple teams into the NCAA field and the seventh time in league history the MVC sent three teams (1990, 1995, 1999, 2000, 2012, 2015, 2019).

Two-By-Forty

Indiana State (43-18) and DBU (43-20) registered 40 wins on the season, marking the 15th time since the 1992 season that at least two Valley teams tallied 40 or more wins.

Two league teams also recorded 40 or more wins in 2018, 2017, 2015, 2012, 2008, 2007, 2006, 2005, 2003, 2002, 2000, 1996, 1993 and 1992 (three teams).

40 Wins for DBU...Again

DBU reached the 40-win plateau for the sixth-straight season. The Patriots join Louisville and Florida State as the only three NCAA Division I programs with 40+ wins in six-straight seasons.

Remembering Janssen

Bradley's weekend series at Kentucky was cancelled, allowing the Braves to attend the memorial services Saturday and Sunday for 2019 graduate Mitch Janssen, who was killed in a plane crash March 3 outside Lincoln, IL. Janssen was an All-Missouri Valley Conference second-team selection as a senior in 2019 after leading the nation in earned run average for several weeks of the season, finishing 25th at 2.06. In addition to his success on the field during a 4-year (2016-19) for the Braves, Janssen qualified for the MVC Honor Roll in all four years while also moonlighting as a charter jet pilot and flight instructor. Janssen became the second young alumnus of the Bradley Baseball program to die suddenly this year - 2007 graduate Michael Christl passed away this summer, the result of a lake accident. Both RHPs were winners of the Mike Dunne Award as Bradley Baseball's top pitcher, Christl in 2007 and Janssen in 2019.

He has reached base safely in 12-straight games and is currently riding a 10-game hitting streak. Over the last week, Fuentes hit .313 with a .500 slugging percentage and a .389 slugging percentage.

Cline Getting Into a Groove

Redshirt junior Connor Cline put together a solid week on the mound for the Sycamores. The right-hander – who is recovering from an injury that kept him sidelined last year – appeared in two games for the Sycamores over the past week, including one start. He finished with a 1-0 record after a midweek victory over Top-25 RPI San Diego. He went six complete innings against the Toreros while allowing just four hits and striking out four batters. Cline was solid on the mound in relief Sunday against Kansas, helping the Sycamores to a series win after pitching three and a third scoreless innings, striking out four and allowing just one base hit. Overall on the week Cline went nine and a third innings, allowing five hits while striking out eight and issuing just one walk. He held opponents to a .152 average against and did not allow a run.

Welcome Home

Missouri State opened its 2020 home slate this past weekend and extended a recent home-field advantage of unprecedented proportions. With their eighth home-opening victory in the last 10 seasons, the Bears have now gone 11-6 in home debuts since moving to Hammons Field in 2004. They have won 44 of their last 67 regular-season non-conference home games, outscoring their non-league opponents by a 868-583 margin at Hammons Field since the start of the 2015 season. The Bears have logged four of their top single-season home win totals since the 2015 season, going 17-6 at home in 2018, after a 21-7 home mark in 2017, a Hammons Field-record 22 victories in 2016 and the Bears' best-ever home win percentage at Hammons with a 19-3 (.864) mark in 2015.



Bravo to Barnes

Sophomore right-hander Forrest Barnes picked up his team-leading third mound victory in Sunday's series-clinching 4-1 win over Maine. The Ozark, Mo., product held the Black Bears to one run on just two hits, dispatching the first 10 Maine hitters of the game in succession and finishing the afternoon five strikeouts. For the season, Barnes has registered a 2.37 ERA while limiting the opposition to a .148 batting mark with 17 punchouts in 19.0 total innings.

Power Surge

After hitting just two home runs as a team over their previous eight contests dating back to Feb. 20, the Bears powered up to club five long balls in four games last week. The duo of Dakota Kotowski and Ben Whetstone accounted for four of those, with each going deep in successive games against Oklahoma State (March 3) and Maine (March 6). Logan Geha added a solo blast in Saturday's contest, hiking the Bears' season home run total to 11.
