#### **MVC Player of the Week**

#### Lasha Petree, Jr., G, Bradley

Petree averaged a team-best 23.5 points per game as she helped power Bradley to its first sweep of the regular-season series against Southern Illinois since 2012-13. The junior shot 53 percent from the field and was 12-of-14 (85.7 percent) from the free throw line in the two contests, while also averaging 4.0 rebounds, 2.0 assists, 2.0 blocks and 1.0 steals per game against the Salukis. In the opener, she scored 23 points in just 24 minutes of action as she helped Bradley to its biggest win in the series since Feb. 2,

2013. She followed up that performance with another game-high scoring effort (24 points) in Saturday's win. Petree had one of the most efficient games of her career, hitting 8-of-11 from the field, while also collecting four boards, three assists, three blocks and a steal. Now just the fifth junior to reach 1,100 career points in Bradley history. Petree passed former teammate Chelsea Brackmann for 14th on Bradley's all-time scoring list.

#### **MVC Newcomer of the Week**

#### Grace Berg, RSo., F, Drake

Drake's Grace Berg averaged 19.5 points and 6.0 rebounds per game while shooting 55.2 percent (16-of-29) from the floor and 85.7 percent (6-of-7) from the free throw line in two big wins over Evansville. Berg had an outstanding game in the finale with a career-high 27 points on 10-of-16 shooting from the floor. She has already recorded four 20-plus scoring games in her first season. Berg is averaging 15.8 points per game which is tied for second in the MVC while shooting 49.3

percent from the floor and 89.5 percent from the free throw line. Both of her shooting percentages rank second in the Valley.

### **NOTEWORTHY**

In addition to the league's Player and Newcomer of the Week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

**Abby Feit (UE)** - Facing Drake in a series this weekend, sophomore Abby Feit helped lead Evansville. Feit averaged 9.5 points and 4.5 rebounds in the series, including a high of 12 points on Friday. Feit leads the Aces in scoring, rebounding, steals, and blocks this season.

**JuJu Redmond (ILS)** - Senior JuJu Redmond shot 64.7% (11-of-17) from the floor and averaged 14.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and 2.5 assists to help the 'Birds go 2-0 and complete the sweep over Indiana State. Redmond had a team-high 18 points in Thursday night's 74-60 victory, shooting 87.5% (7-of-8) from the floor and a perfect 3-of-3 from long range. The senior also reached double figure scoring on Friday night and for the fifth time this season, finishing with 11 points.

**Karli Rucker (UNI)** - Karli Rucker scored 50 points, added nine rebounds, four steals and six assists to lead UNI to a road split with Valparaiso. Friday, she scored 18 points, grabbed four rebounds, two assists and two steals in the Panthers' 63-56 loss to Valpo, but she shined Friday when she scored a career-high 32 points, added five rebounds, four assists and added a pair of steals in the Panthers' 79-71 win over the Crusaders. She went 11-19 from the field, 3-5 from the three-point line and 7-10 from the free throw line in the win.

**Makenzie Silvey (SIU)** - Silvey averaged 15.0 points on 47.8-percent shooting in a pair of conference road contests at Bradley. The senior guard scored 13 off the bench on Friday and followed with a team-high 17 points against the Braves on Saturday. The two-time All-MVC selection has now scored in double figures in six of the seven games that she has played in this season

Shay Frederick (VALPO) - Frederick led the way last week as Valpo split its MVC-opening series with UNI. She led all players in Valpo's win on Thursday with 20 points, 13 of which came in the fourth quarter as she single-handedly outscored UNI 13-11 in the final period. Frederick scored nine of her fourth quarter points in a three-possession stretch midway through the quarter, turning a one-point deflicit into a six-point lead and giving Valpo the lead for good. She added seven rebounds and led all players with six assists as well in the win. Saturday, she just missed her career high by scoring 26 points, 20 of which came after halftime, and led all players again with six assists. Frederick has scored 20+ in three straight games, the first Valpo player to do so since December 2017.

**Chloe Rice (BRAD)** - Rice came off the bench to average 6.5 points on 83.3 percent shooting as she helped Bradley sweep the regular-season series vs. SIU for the first time since 2012-13. Rice was 4-of-5 from the field and matched a career-high she set as a freshman at Saint Louis with nine points in the opener. In Saturday's series finale, she capped a 12-0 Bradley run in the third quarter that gave the Braves the lead for good with a four-point play.

Rylie Stephens (UE) - Marking the second and third time of the season, freshman Rylie Stephens led the Aces in scoring in both games last week. In the series-opener against Drake, Stephens scored a team-best 10 points on 4-of-9 shooting from the field, to go along with three steals and a pair of assists. On Friday, Stephens matched a career-high with 14 points, going 5-of-11 from the floor. On the season, Stephens sits third on the team in scoring, while playing just 18 minutes per game.

**Terrion Moore (ILS)** - Junior Terrion Moore averaged 7.5 points, 4.5 rebounds and 2.0 assists to help Illinois State go 2-0 and complete the sweep over Indiana State. Moore recorded seven points in Thursday night's 74-60 victory, also grabbing a team-high five boards and three assists. The junior went on to tally eight points, going 66.7% (2-of-3) from long range and corralling four rebounds in Friday's 62-32 defeat of the Sycamores. Moore is averaging 10.4 points and 3.7 rebounds per game so far in her first season as a Redbird.

#### MVC Race

Bradley (3-1), Drake (3-1) and UNI (3-1) currently occupy the top spot in the standings after the first two weekends of league play in the books. Preseason favorite Missouri State has yet to play a league game due to COVID issues the first two weeks. The Lady Bears will look to begin league play at UNI this Saturday. Bradley has the league's longest win streak at three-straight and will face Evansville on the road this weekend. Drake is riding its first two-game win streak of the season and will return home to host Indiana State.

#### **Warren's Win Count**

Tanya Warren owns 249 victories as UNI's head coach. With her next victory, Warren would become the fourth coach in conference women's basketball history to join the league's official 250-Win Club.

#### Conference NET

The Valley ranks eighth nationally in the NCAA's conference NET report (Jan. 11). The Valley sits behind the SEC, ACC, Big 12, Big Ten, Pac-12, Big East and American entering this week.

The Valley finished the 2019-20 season with a league-best conference RPI of 8th.

### **NET Update**

The latest installment of the NCAA NET Report (Jan. 11) has five Valley teams that rank in the top-100. including four in the Top 75. Missouri State leads the way at No. 27 with Illinois State (37), UNI (69), Drake (75) and Bradley (87), rounding out the schools in the Top 100.

The Valley joins the ACC, Big 12, Big East, Big Ten, Pac-12 and SEC as the only leagues nationally with five teams in the NET Top 100.

### Strength of Schedule

Two Valley teams have a SOS ranking in the Top 80 according to the NCAA (Jan. 11). Missouri State leads The Valley with a SOS of No. 3. UNI comes in this week ranked No. 63 and Drake No. 79.

Four Valley teams rank in the Top 75 of "Average Opponent NET Rank" as well. Missouri State sits No. 2 nationally with an average opponent NET ranking of 43, while UNI sits No. 11 (79), Bradley No. 61 (118) and Drake No. 71 (124).

### **Top 25 Success**

The Valley finished non-conference play 2-2 vs. AP Top 25 Teams this season, with Missouri State beating #12 Maryland in the season opener and UNI besting #22 South Dakota State.

The last time The Valley had a pair of AP Top 25 wins during the non-conference portion of the season was back in 2002 when Drake beat No. 18 Iowa State and UNI beat No. 24 Iowa State.

#### **Power Five Wins**

The MVC secured five wins over Power Five programs during the shortened non-conference schedule. The Valley registered a 5-9 vs. Power Five teams after going 9-12 in 2019-20. The Valley went 4-4 vs. the Big Ten, 1-1 vs. the SEC, 0-3 vs. the Big 12 and 0-1 vs. the ACC. Missouri State and Valpo each had two wins, while Drake had the other.

#### **BU: Strong Starts**

Bradley is 3-1 or better to start Valley play for the second straight year and third time in the last four seasons. This year's performance to date marks the eighth time the Braves have started league play 3-1 or better and Bradley has consecutive seasons with a 3-1 or better beginning to conference action for the first time since Andrea Gorski's sophomore (1989-90) and junior (1990-91) seasons. Gorski has been a player or coach of the Braves for six of the eight seasons in which Bradley has had a 3-1 or better start to league play.

#### **DU: Chart Climber**

With her eight assists in the two games against the Purple Aces, senior point guard Maddie Monahan moved to No. 8 all-time in career assists with 390. Monahan, who moved past Karlin Hayes (387) and Jan Krieger (389), needs five more dimes to move past her former teammate, Sammie Bachrodt (394) for seventh all-time.

#### **UE: Defense Holds Drake**

Evansville became one of three teams to hold the Bulldogs to single digits in a quarter, doing so in both games in the series. On Thursday, the Aces allowed DU just nine second quarter points. Friday. Evansville limited Drake to a season-low six points in the first quarter. Creighton and Iowa State held Drake to nine and eight points respectively.

#### **ILS: Dominant Defense**

ISU held Indiana State to 32 points on Friday night, a program record for the fewest points allowed in a MVC game, in a decisive 62-32 win at the Hulman Center. The 32 points was also the fewest in an MVC game since Indiana State held Lovola Chicago to 32 during the 2016-17 season (53-32 Sycamore win).

The Redbirds are now one of seven teams in the country to hold multiple opponents to under 40 points this year. This exclusive list also includes Arizona, Baylor, Campbell, Milwaukee, North Carolina and Rutgers.

### **INS: Struggles in Des Moines**

Sycamore women's basketball has a tall task in front of them this weekend when they travel to Des Moines, lowa for a matchup with Drake. The Sycamores are 5-34 all-time in Des Moines and haven't won at Drake since Mar. 6, 2014 when they earned a 73-71 victory. The last Sycamore win versus the Bulldogs anywhere came on Feb. 14, 2016 in Terre Haute, 68-53.

#### LUC: Back in Action

After seeing this past weekend's series with No. 25/25 Missouri State postponed due to COVID-19 issues within the Lady Bears program, Loyola will be back on the hardwood this weekend when it welcomes in-state foe Southern Illinois to Gentile Arena. The Ramblers have been victorious in two of the last three matchups between the two teams in Rogers Park, including a 51-49 victory over the Salukis last season. With two victories over the Salukis, Loyola can achieve its second 3-1 start to a Valley slate in as many seasons.

### **MSU: Lady Bears MVC History**

This season is Missouri State's 29th in the Missouri Valley Conference. The Lady Bears have finished third or better in the final league standings 21 times in 28 seasons, including each of the last six years, winning 12 or more games each time. MSU is 47-7 in Valley play the last three seasons and 81-17 in the last 98 league contests.

#### UNI: #3 for 30

UNI's Karli Rucker scored a career-high 32 points Friday in a 79-71 victory at Valparaiso. This was the first 30-point game in her career and the first such outing for UNI since Brittni Donaldson's 34-point effort March 2, 2014 during a 99-97 overtime win at Drake.

### SIU: 1,000 Points

Abby Brockmeyer scored her 1,000 career point on Saturday to become just the 28th Saluki in school history to reach the 1,000-point plateau with her 11 points and nine rebounds in the loss. The senior from Raymond, III. is the sixth active Missouri Valley Conference player to reach the mark and is joined by her teammate Makenzie Silvey. The Salukis are one of 20 teams nationally, and one of only two in the Missouri Valley Conference, to have multiple active players reach the scoring milestone.

#### VALPO: Another Milestone Win

In her third season, head coach Mary Evans has led Valpo to many milestone wins, and Thursday's win over UNI was another one. UNI entered the week ranked 66th in the NET, the program's best victory by NET/RPI since a win over Purdue in December 2008. Three of Valpo's last five MVC wins dating back to last season have come over top-100 NET/RPI teams after the program went nearly seven years between top-100 victories.

#### Climbing the Chart

Bradley senior Gabi Haack moved into 18th position in MVC history with 237 career triples after hitting four during the series with Southern Illinois over the weekend. Haack will enter the weekend five shy of 17th position on the list.

Missouri State fell out of the AP Top 25 Poll this week after missing games once again due to CO-VID protocol. MSU sits No. 25 in the USA Today Coaches Top 25 poll (Jan. 5).

### Mid-Major Top-25 Poll

The January 5th edition of the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 has Missouri State No. 3 behind Gonzaga and South Dakota State. UNI sits No. 22 this week, while Drake is 23rd. Bradley is receiving votes in the poll this week.

#### Rise of The Valley

The 2019-20 season tied the highest RPI ranking the Missouri Valley Conference has recorded in its history showcasing how The Valley is becoming one of the best mid-major leagues in the country. The league posted a top-15 RPI for the first time since 2012-13 during the 2018-19 season and increased to 8th last year, including five teams in the Top 100 of the RPI for the first time since the 1998-99 season.



#### Naismith Award Watch List

Bradley junior guard Lasha Petree has been named to the 2021 Women's Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Watch List according to an announcement by the Atlanta Tipoff Club. The preseason Watch List included 50 individuals from 11 conferences with Petree the lone representative from the MVC. The midseason 30 team will be announced in early February. The competition will be narrowed down to 10 national semifinalists on March 2, 2021, and four finalists will be named on March 19, 2021. The winner of the 2021 Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy for Women's Player of the Year will be announced on April 3, 2021.

#### Hammond Award Watch List

Missouri State junior forward Jasmine Franklin was named to the preseason watch list for the 2021 Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year Award presented by Her Hoop Stats. The second player in school history to reach 500 career rebounds as a sophomore, the Favetteville, Ark., native had the 11th-highest defensive rebounding rate in the nation last season and ranked in the top 10% nationally in steals and blocks according to advanced metrics provided by Her Hoop Stats. In January, 15 players will be named to the midseason watch list.

### Lady Bears Favored

Missouri State was tabbed as the preseason favorite in the MVC Women's Basketball race in the annual survey of the league's coaches, SIDs and media.

#### New Schedule Format

The Missouri Valley Conference has adopted a new scheduling format for men's and women's basketball Conference games (the women's schedule is attached in multiple formats.) The Conference will continue to play an 18-game format in which most MVC teams will face one another in a two-game series on back-to-back days at the same site. Each institution will play four road series and four home series and will also face their designated 'travel partner' in a singlegame, home-and-home series.

#### **Title Town**

The league has had nine different regular-season champions in the past 14 seasons (SIU-2007, DU/UE/ILS-2008, ILS-2009, ILS-2010, UNI-2011; MSU-2012; WSU/CU-2013; INS/WSU-2014; WSU2015; UNI-2016; DU-2017; DU-2018; DU-2019; MSU-2020). Bradley, Loyola and Valparaiso are the only league teams not to have won a regular-season MVC championship.

### **Postseason League**

The MVC has seen an average of four league teams participate in postseason play in the last 21 seasons where postseason action took place, including three teams reaching postseason play in 2018-19. Before the 2019-20 season was cut short due to COVID-19, the MVC was in position to send 5 or 6 teams to postseason play. The Valley has earned multiple NCAA Tournament bids in 12 different seasons, including two out of the last three seasons (not counting 2019-20).

### **Hoops In the Heartland**

The 2021 Missouri Valley Conference Women's Basketball Tournament will return to the TaxSlayer Center in Moline, III., for the sixth-straight year.

Affectionately coined "Hoops in the Heartland," the four-day event (Mar. 11-14) will showcase all 10 Missouri Valley Conference schools as they compete for the Valley's automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament.

The 2021 tournament will mark the 14thconsecutive season in its 39-year history that the event will take place at a neutral site. However last year's event was cancelled due to COVID-19.

The Missouri Valley Conference is one of only seven conferences (out of 32 nationally) where the women's basketball tournament is played at a neutral site, separate from the men's championship (AAC, ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, MVC, Pac-12 and SEC are the others).
