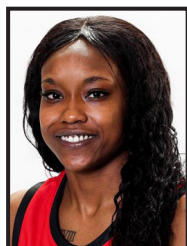


MVC Player of the Week

Brice Calip, Sr., G, Missouri State

Brice Calip continued to fill the stat sheet in three Missouri State wins last week, averaging 15.3 points, 4.0 rebounds, 5.7 assists and 3.7 steals. Calip sunk three free throws with 0.8 seconds left Sunday to give MSU a 74-73 win at Valpo, finishing the game with 23 points on 9-for-9 foul shooting, seven assists without a turnover and five steals. The senior had seven assists and three steals with 11 points in Wednesday's victory against Southern Illinois, and scored 12 points with nine rebounds, three assists and three steals Saturday at Valpo. Calip shot 20-for-22 at the foul line for the week and improved her league-leading assist-to-turnover ratio to 3.0, on pace for MSU's single-season record. The last MVC player to win three-straight Player of the Week awards was Sara Rhine of Drake at the beginning of the 2018-19 season.

MVC Newcomer of the Week

Terrion Moore, Jr., G, Illinois State

Junior Terrion Moore poured in season-highs in points (20) and rebounds (6) while also playing lockdown defense, holding the Valley's leading scorer, Lasha Petree, to 3-of-18 (16.7%) shooting in Wednesday's 66-54 win over I-74 rival Bradley. Moore, who also added two steals and an assist in ISU's lone game last week, scored 18 of her 20 points in the second half, recording a game-high +19 plus-minus.

NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's Player and Newcomer of the Week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

Grace Berg (DU) - Grace Berg recorded her sixth 20-points or more performance of the season, including an impressive three out of the past four games, in Drake's big win over in-state rival UNI last week. Berg, an Indianola native playing in her first game in the rivalry, made 8-of-16 shots from the field and 5-of-6 free throws and added seven rebounds, two assists and career-high two blocks. Berg is averaging a career-high 16.7 points, 5.2 rebounds and 2.3 assists per game while leading the MVC in shooting 53.3 percent from the floor and 83.9 free throw line, which ranks second in the league.

Abby Feit (UE) - Turning-in another team-leading performance, sophomore Abby Feit led the Aces to their first MVC win since March 1, 2019. In a 70-63 overtime victory over Indiana State, Feit finished with a game-high 19 points and narrowly missed a double-double with nine boards. Adding to her impressive star line, Feit also recorded four assists and four blocks.

JuJu Redmond (ILS) - Senior guard JuJu Redmond exploded for 20 points while pulling down a season-high 13 rebounds for her sixth career double-double in Wednesday's 66-54 win over I-74 rival Bradley. Redmond carried ISU's offense early, recording 14 of her 20 points in the first half while also going 2-of-3 from deep. The senior has now scored 20+ points in two of the last three games and is averaging 14.6 points per contest on the year.

Adrian Folks (INS) - Adrian Folks recorded her fourth-consecutive double-figures scoring effort of the season on Wednesday at Evansville when she earned her first double-double of the year with 14 points and 10 rebounds. The sophomore ended 7-of-14 from the field and chipped-in three assists and two blocks. She now leads the team in scoring (9.4 ppg) and is second in rebounding (5.8 rpg).

Bre Hampton-Bey (LUC) - Loyola senior guard Bre Hampton-Bey averaged a team-high 13.5 points, 3.5 rebounds, and 2.5 assists as Loyola swept a pair of games against Southern Illinois over the weekend at Gentile Arena. In Saturday's 53-46 win, Hampton-Bey erupted for a team-best 23 points (9-13 FGs, 5-6 FTs), the top individual scoring output by a Rambler in 2020-21, in addition to six rebounds and three assists. The Toledo, Ohio native chipped in four points (1-2 FGs, 2-2 FTs), a rebound, and two assists in Sunday's 55-46 triumph. Since the start of MVC play, Hampton-Bey is averaging a team-high 10.0 points and has reached double figures in scoring four times this season.

Abby Brockmeyer (SIU) - Abby Brockmeyer averaged 18.3 points to go along with 10.7 rebounds, 1.3 blocks, 1.0 steals and 1.0 assists in a trio of Missouri Valley Conference road games last week. Brockmeyer opened the week with 13 points and 11 rebounds at No. 25 Missouri State and followed with a career-best 28 points on 60-percent shooting at Loyola on Jan. 30. Brockmeyer notched her second double-double of the road trip with 14 points and 13 rebounds in the series finale at Loyola. The senior from Raymond, Ill. now has 22 career double-doubles- the most of any active Missouri Valley Conference player.

Carie Weinman (VALPO) - Weinman averaged a team-best 14.5 points/game to go with 4.5 rebounds and 3 assists per contest as Valpo gave nationally-ranked Missouri State all it could handle in a pair of contests last weekend. Weinman opened with nine points, four rebounds and four assists without a turnover on Saturday, and then delivered her fourth game this year of 20+ points with a 20-point, five-rebound performance in Sunday's heartbreaker. In the latter game, Weinman scored 12 of her points in the third quarter to help turn a three-point deficit into an eight-point lead, and then delivered a driving layup with 12.4 seconds to play that put Valpo in the lead.

Courtney Becker (DU) - Freshman Courtney Becker made an immediate impact in her first game against UNI. Coming off the bench, Becker, poured in a career-high 13 points behind a career-best three three-pointers in just 21 minutes. Becker added two rebounds and one assist. She made 5-of-7 shots and went 3-of-3 from the three-point line. In her first season, the Fountain City, Wis., native is averaging 4.0 points, 3.6 rebounds and 1.1 assists while shooting 45.5 percent from the floor, 45.0 percent from three and 78.6 percent from the free throw line.

Sydney Thurwalker (UE) - In a win over Indiana State on Wednesday, sophomore Sydney Thurwalker recorded an efficient performance to aid the Aces. Thurwalker scored 10 points, going 4-of-6 from the field, while adding five rebounds and a pair of assists and steals.

Quierra Love (SIU) - Quierra Love averaged 6.7 points, 1.7 rebounds and 1.3 assists in SIU's three road Missouri Valley Conference games last week. Love scored seven points and snagged two boards at No. 25 Missouri State and followed with seven points and two steals at Loyola on Saturday. The Glen Carbon, Ill. native finished with six points and two boards in the series finale at Loyola on Sunday.

Lauren Gunn (VALPO) - Gunn averaged four points and four rebounds per game in the pair of matchups with nationally ranked Missouri State last weekend. She opened with five points in Saturday's contest, and then tallied five rebounds to rank second on the team in Sunday's nailbiter. Gunn's five boards helped Valpo to a +5 advantage on the glass over the Lady Bears, the best performance on the boards vs. MSU since Stanford in the 2019 Sweet Sixteen.

MVC Players and Newcomers of the Week are selected each week during the women's basketball season. The players are announced on Monday afternoon and appear in a weekly press release. Nominees are provided by each school's sports information contact and voted on by a panel appointed by the league office.

Halfway Home (Mostly...)

Six of the 10 Valley women's basketball teams hit the midway point of the conference season last week. Missouri State continues to sit at the top of the standings at 7-0, marking the fifth time in program history the Lady Bears have won its first seven league games. (10-0 in 2018-19, 11-0 in 2003-04, 10-0 in 1999-00, 12-0 in 1995-96).

Loyola sits second at 5-2, marking the Ramblers best start to Valley play since opening the 2015-16 season 6-2 in league play.

Bradley, Drake, and Illinois State sit in a tie for third at 6-3 in Valley play. The Braves are 6-3 or better at the turn in back-to-back years for the first time in school history, while Illinois State sits 6-3 for the first time since 2011-12.

UNI owns a 5-4 record midway through its MVC schedule. This is the active-league-high 11th year in a row where the Panthers have a winning mark through the first half of league play.

Elite Company

Missouri State is once again putting together an impressive NCAA Tournament resume. The Lady Bears join Stanford, South Carolina, Tennessee, and Texas A&M as the only teams with at least five quad 1 wins this season (Lady Bears 5-1 vs. Q1) as of Feb. 1. The Lady Bears sit 9-2 overall vs. Q1 and 2 combined.

Rise of The Valley

The 2019-20 season tied the highest RPI ranking the MVC has recorded in its history showcasing how The Valley is becoming one of the best mid-major leagues in the country. The league also saw five teams in the Top 100 of the RPI for the first time since the 1998-99 season. In 2018-19, the league posted a top-15 RPI for the first time since 2012-13 a year after seeing the league's worst RPI in 2017-18 (24). The Valley is looking to match or surpass last year's record numbers in 2020-21.

Conference NET

The Valley ranks 8th nationally in the conference NET report. The Valley sits behind the SEC, ACC, Big 12, Pac-12, Big Ten, Big East and American entering this week.

The Valley finished the 2019-20 season with a league-best conference RPI of 8th.

NET Update

The latest installment of the NCAA NET Report (Feb. 1) has five Valley teams that rank in the top-100, including four in the Top 75. Missouri State leads the way at No. 27 with Drake (51), Illinois State (70), UNI (71), and Bradley (89), rounding out the schools in the Top 100.

The Valley joins the ACC, Big 12, Big East, Big Ten, Pac-12 and SEC as the only leagues nationally with five teams in the NET Top 100.

Streaks in League Play

Three of the MVC series this week are among the longest current winning streaks vs. an MVC opponent. Missouri State is riding a 14-game win streak over Indiana State, while UNI is on a 13-game win streak over Evansville. Drake is also riding a 13-game streak vs. Loyola.

BU: Doing it All

Junior Lasha Petree continues to lead the MVC in scoring at 19.3 points per game and has been Bradley's top scorer in 11 of 16 contests this year. She also continues to show her versatility on the defensive end, collecting a league-best 37 blocks to go with her team-high 32 steals. Through games of Jan. 31, Petree is the only player in the nation with 30 or more three-pointers, 30 blocks and at least 30 steals. Her 118 career blocked shots currently rank 23rd in MVC history.

DU: In-State Win

Drake stopped a two-game losing streak with a big 96-79 win over in-state rival UNI last week in the Bulldogs' lone game. The Bulldogs led from start to finish to avenge last season's loss to the Panthers in Cedar Falls in what ended up being the final game for each school due to the global COVID-19 pandemic. Drake won its fifth-straight at the Knapp Center in the series and have totaled an impressive 200 points in the past two games in Des Moines.

UE: Another Double Figure Game

With 19 points on Wednesday in a win over Indiana State, sophomore Abby Feit recorded her 33rd double figure scoring performance in just 43 career games. Feit has reached double-figures in seven of Evansville's eight wins over the last two seasons.

ILS: Lockdown Defense

The 'Birds held Bradley to just a 29.0% (18-of-62) field goal percentage on Wednesday, marking the seventh time this season ISU has held an opponent to under 35% shooting and the third time this season for under 30% shooting.

Illinois State leads the Valley and is ranked in the top-30 nationally in defensive rebounds per game (23rd, 30.0), field goal percentage defense (26th, 35.2%) and scoring margin (30th, 14.5).

INS: Top 25 Matchups

As it stands now, Friday's and Saturday's games against #25 Missouri State will mark the first Top-25 matchup of the season for the Blue & White. The Sycamores are 3-10 all-time against Top-25 opponents, including a pair of losses last season to the Lady Bears. Indiana State's last victory over a ranked opponent came on Dec. 21, 2014 when they earned a road win over #25/25 St. John's, 73-67, in two overtimes.

LUC: This is 40

In both of its wins over Southern Illinois this past weekend, Loyola held the Salukis to under 40 percent shooting from the field. Dating back to a 59-52 win over Indiana State on January 2, the Ramblers have held their opposition below the 40-percent mark in five of their last six contests, go 5-1 during that stretch. Since head coach Kate Achter's arrival in Rogers Park prior to the 2016-17 season, Loyola is 37-22 (.627) when limiting opponents to under 40 percent efficiency.

MSU: Calip in Rare Company

Brice Calip is one of nine players nationally through Jan. 31 with at least 190 points, 60 rebounds, 50 assists and 35 steals. The senior has played the fewest games of any player on that list and has at least three steals in eight consecutive contests. Additionally, Calip's 3.0 MVC-leading assist-to-turnover ratio this season is on pace to break Amy Nelson's 29-year-old school record of 2.67.

UNI: There's The Wolf

Cynthia Wolf scored a career-high 18 points Wednesday at Drake and became UNI's fifth different leading scorer within its last five games (Karli Rucker, Kam Finley, Maya McDermott, Bre Gunnels, Cynthia Wolf). Wolf is the league's most efficient shooter in conference play (68.9%). Plus, Wolf's overall shooting percentage of 58.2% would rank sixth in single-season Panther history.

SIU: Nearing a Milestone

Abby Brockmeyer has tallied two double-doubles in her last three games and now has 22 double-doubles for her career. Brockmeyer's 22 career double-doubles are the most of any active Missouri Valley Conference player. The Raymond, Ill. native also inched closer to becoming the first player in program history to amass 1,000 career points/700 rebounds/100 steals/100 blocks and 100 assists. She is just one steal shy of reaching that milestone.

VALPO: Double Figure Quarters

Valpo has been feeding the hot hand so far in MVC play, as four different players have combined to score 10+ in a quarter 12 times through Valpo's first seven MVC games. Less than halfway through the conference schedule, that is already the most double-digit quarters in conference play since the women's game moved to quarters. This past weekend, Valpo had five such quarters over the two games versus Missouri State - Shay Frederick scored 10+ in the second quarter and the fourth quarter on Saturday, Grace White and Carie Weinman both reached double digits in the third quarter on Sunday and Caitlin Morrison posted a 14-point fourth quarter in the series finale.

Polling

Missouri State is receiving votes once again in this week's AP Top 25 Poll. The Lady Bears sit 26th with 64 points this week. MSU holds steady at No. 25 in the USA Today Coaches Top 25 poll (Jan. 26), marking its 27th-straight appearance in the poll.

Top 25 Success

The Valley finished non-conference play 2-2 vs. AP Top 25 Teams this season, with Missouri State beating #12 Maryland in the season opener and UNI besting #22 South Dakota State.

The last time The Valley had a pair of AP Top 25 wins during the non-conference portion of the season was back in 2002 when Drake beat No. 18 Iowa State and UNI beat No. 24 Iowa State.

Power Five Wins

The MVC secured five wins over Power Five programs during the shortened non-conference schedule. The Valley registered a 5-9 vs. Power Five teams after going 9-12 in 2019-20. The Valley went 4-4 vs. the Big Ten, 1-1 vs. the SEC, 0-3 vs. the Big 12 and 0-1 vs. the ACC. Missouri State and Valpo each had two wins, while Drake had the other.

Warren Joins Elite Club

Tanya Warren claimed her 250th career win as UNI's head coach with a win over Indiana State. Warren became the fourth coach in conference women's basketball history to join the league's official 250-Win Club.

Naismith Award Watch List

Bradley junior guard Lasha Petree has been named to the 2021 Women's Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy Watch List according to an announcement by the Atlanta Tipoff Club. The preseason Watch List included 50 individuals from 11 conferences with Petree the lone representative from the MVC. The midseason 30 team will be announced in early February. The competition will be narrowed down to 10 national semifinalists on March 2, 2021, and four finalists will be named on March 19, 2021. The winner of the 2021 Jersey Mike's Naismith Trophy for Women's Player of the Year will be announced on April 3, 2021.

Hammond Award Watch List

Missouri State junior forward Jasmine Franklin was named to the preseason watch list for the 2021 Becky Hammon Mid-Major Player of the Year Award presented by Her Hoop Stats. The second player in school history to reach 500 career rebounds as a sophomore, the Fayetteville, Ark., native had the 11th-highest defensive rebounding rate in the nation last season and ranked in the top 10% nationally in steals and blocks according to advanced metrics provided by Her Hoop Stats. In January, 15 players will be named to the midseason watch list.

Lady Bears Favored

Missouri State was tabbed as the preseason favorite in the MVC Women's Basketball race in the annual survey of the league's coaches, SIDs and media.

Title Town

The league has had nine different regular-season champions in the past 14 seasons (SIU-2007, DU/UE/ILS-2008, ILS-2009, ILS-2010, UNI-2011; MSU-2012; WSU/CU-2013; INS/WSU-2014; WSU-2015; UNI-2016; DU-2017; DU-2018; DU-2019; MSU-2020). Bradley, Loyola and Valparaiso are the only league teams not to have won a regular-season MVC championship.

Postseason League

The MVC has seen an average of four league teams participate in postseason play in the last 21 seasons where postseason action took place, including three teams reaching postseason play in 2018-19. Before the 2019-20 season was cut short due to COVID-19, the MVC was in position to send 5 or 6 teams to postseason play. The Valley has earned multiple NCAA Tournament bids in 12 different seasons, including two out of the last three seasons (not counting 2019-20).

Hoops In the Heartland

The 2021 Missouri Valley Conference Women's Basketball Tournament will return to the TaxSlayer Center in Moline, Ill., for the sixth-straight year.

Affectionately coined "Hoops in the Heartland," the four-day event (Mar. 11-14) will showcase all 10 Missouri Valley Conference schools as they compete for the Valley's automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament.

The 2021 tournament will mark the 14th-consecutive season in its 39-year history that the event will take place at a neutral site. However last year's event was cancelled due to COVID-19.

The Missouri Valley Conference is one of only seven conferences (out of 32 nationally) where the women's basketball tournament is played at a neutral site, separate from the men's championship (AAC, ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, MVC, Pac-12 and SEC are the others).
