#### **MVC Offensive Player of the Week**

#### Billy Hency, Sr., M, Loyola Chicago

Coming off a sizzling spring season, Loyola senior midfielder Billy Hency looked to pick up right where he left off on the opening week of the 2021 season. The reigning MVC Player of the Year, Hency opened his account for the new campaign in the 52nd minute of Thursday's clash with city rival DePaul, netting what would serve as the game-winning goal in the Ramblers' 2-1 triumph over the Blue Demons. He was back at it again in Sunday's clash with Western Michigan, converting twice

from the penalty spot, the first of which was the deciding goal, in the Maroon & Gold's 4-2 victory. Hency's currently finds himself tied for first overall on The Valley's goals leaderboard.

#### **NOTEWORTHY**

In addition to the league's player of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

Jake Schoffstall (BU) - Schoffstall came off the bench to score his first career game-winning goal, lifting the Braves to a 1-0 win against Omaha in the season-opener for both teams Thursday night at Shea Stadium ... A "super" freshman who contributed a goal and two assists from his starting back position in the abbreviated 2021 spring season, Schoffstall delivered a nifty toe-poke in traffic to complete a free kick sequence in the 71st minute – Jack Douglas rifled a 35-yard blast off the crossbar and Patrick Fishburne headed the rebound from the top of the penalty area back to the 6-yard box, where Schoffstall split two Mavericks with a right-footed flick for the winner.

**Juan Louis (DU)** - Louis scored one goal in against both Milwaukee and Western Illinois he currently leads the team with most goals this season. In two matches, he played 141 minutes and recorded 4 points, 5 shots, 2 goals, 3 shots on goal.

**Davis Peck (UE)** - In his fourth season in white and purple. Fifth-year senior winger Davis Peck has really stepped up and turned into an offensive threat. The Gilbert, Arizona native opened his account for the season in the 63rd minute of Monday's match at Louisville, putting the Aces in front, before the Cardinals made a late rally.

Jon Koka (MSU) - The junior forward from Bilboa, Spain, had an impressive week for the Bears, heavy on the offensive attack. Against Belmont in MSU's home opener, Koka scored back-to-back goals under one minute apart. The first goal was the tiebreaker to give the Bears the lead for good at the 71:47-minute mark. When the clock hit 72:08. Koka lobbed a short kick over the head of Belmont's goalkeeper to increase the Bears' lead, 3-1. Three days later, Koka continued to be a spark for the MSU offense against Rockhurst. In the 47th minute of play he scored a quick goal to bring his total to three in two games. In the last four games Koka has played in, he has scored five goals for the Bears. Two of these came in a 2020-21 NCAA tournament game against Maryland last season, with the next three coming this season.

**Max Broughton (SIUE)**-Broughton paced the Cougars in two games to open the 2021 season. Thursday he netted his first career goal for SIUE, working out of the back. He made a run to the top of the box where he got the ball back and scored in the 89th minute to tie the score at Wisconsin and force overtime. The Cougars were able to earn the 1-1 draw with the Badgers. He gave SIUE a 2-1 first-half lead at No. 19 Marquette. Ultimately, the Cougars fell 4-3 in the contest. He scored on each of his shots.

**Oliver Hald (UE)** - In his first two matches for Evansville, sophomore defender Oliver Hald impressed along the Aces backline. Hald was tasked multiple times with clearing balls and disrupting chances against both Bellarmine and Louisville, helping to keep the Aces in both matches.

Kyle Hiebert (MSU) - The returning Academic All-America of the year Kyle Hiebert was a key player for the Bears in their first two games of the season. The senior defender and MAC Hermann Watch list member played aggressive in the backfield for 90 minutes on Thursday night against Belmont. Not only did he play a key part in Missouri State's defensive efforts holding Belmont to one goal, and none after the 10th minute of play, but Hiebert was a dangerous player going forward for the Bears as well. In the 19th minute against the Bruins, he kickstarted the Bears' comeback by scoring the tying goal to bring the game to 1-1. He finished the week out with good minutes against Rockhurst as part of a strong backline that helped control the ball, securing a shutout in the team's second game of the season.

### **MVC SOCCER NOTES**

#### **BRAD: Positive Vibes**

Winning the season-opener has proven to be a sign of good things to follow more often than not in Bradley Soccer history ... Thursday's 1-0 win against an Omaha squad that reached the second round of the 2021 spring NCAA Tournament, gives Bradley a 22-9-4 (.686) all-time record in season-openers, including a 20-4-2 (.808) record in the starting games under 26th-year head coach Jim DeRose ... In the 22 seasons Bradley has won its season opener, the Braves have gone on to win at least 10 games in that season 14 times and finished with at least a .500 record in 15 seasons ... In the 13 seasons Bradley lost or drew its season-opener, however, the team has finished that season below .500 nine times.

#### **DU: Louis on Point**

Drake fell to Milwaukee in its season opener 2-1. Senior Juan Louis scored Drake's lone goal in the match. In their home opener, Drake bested Western Illinois 1-0 and Louis scored once again for the Bulldogs. Drake's defensive efforts were led by Jared Brown, TC Anderson, Louis Yuill, and Declan Watters who all helped Drake maintain possession for over half the match. Drake advances to 1-1 on the season.

#### **UE: Pablo Being Pablo**

A menace to opposing defense in the spring, sophomore Pablo Guillen returns to the fold for the Aces. The 2020-21 MVC Freshmen of the Year, Guillen led Evansville with four goals a season ago and recorded his first of the 2021 campaign in the 53rd minute on a penalty that gave Evansville an early 1-0 lead over Bellarmine on Thursday.

#### LUC: Big Week for Billy

Loyola senior midfielder Billy Hency enjoyed a red-hot start to the 2021 season this past week, firing home three goals across the Maroon & Gold's opening two games, highlighted by game-winning tallies in both contests. The reigning MVC Player and Midfielder of the Year, Hency, a Preseason All-America selection by College Soccer News was also recognized on the national stage, earning a spot on the watch list for the prestigious Missouri Athletic Club (MAC) Hermann Trophy.

#### **MSU: Another Perfect Start**

The returning MVC regular-season and tournament champions started their season 2-0 for the third straight year with wins over Belmont and Rockhurst late last week. Thursday night's win in the first game of the season at Bobby & Betty Allison Stadium extends the Bears' streak of being unbeaten in home openers to 24, dating back to 1998.

#### SIUE: Trip Up North

The Cougars have never lost in Madison, Wis., improving to 3-0-2 on the road against the Badgers following a 1-1 draw in the season opener. The 4-3 loss to #19 Marquette marked the first of three times the Cougars are set to face a top 25 opponent (Missouri State twice) based on the preseason rankings by United Soccer Coaches.

#### **Poll Position**

Missouri State moved up to No. 8 in this week's United Soccer Coaches Top 25 ranking. The Bears sat No. 12 in the preseason rankings. MSU also sits No. 8 in the College Soccer News Top 30 poll this week, while moving up to No. 9 in this week's Top Drawer Soccer Top 25 poll.

#### National Team of the Week

Loyola's Billy Hency earned a spot on this week's 11-member Top Drawer Soccer Team of the Week. Picking up where he left off in the spring, Hency scored the winning goal in both of the Ramblers' wins, 2-1 defeat of De-Paul and winning 4-2 versus Western Michigan. He added a brace in the latter match.

#### MAC Hermann Watch List

Three Valley men's soccer players have been named to the Missouri Athletic Club's Hermann Trophy watch list, the organization announced Thursday. Loyola senior Billy Hency and Missouri State seniors Josh Dolling and Kyle Hiebert were included in the prestigious field of 44 players.

The MAC Hermann Trophy is the highest individual honor that a Division I soccer player can receive, and it has been awarded every year since 1967. Following the regular season, the pool of players will be narrowed to 15 following United Soccer Coaches Division I All-America voting. The finalists will be announced on Nov. 30.

#### **Returning Starters**

The Valley will look to build on last season as league teams return 58 starters (88-percent), including nine of 11 first-team all-conference players and 10 of 11 who earned second-team accolades.

Nine of the 12 players appearing on the Preseason All-MVC squad earned All-MVC honors last fall. The 12-member team also has players from seven different countries, including Canada, England, Germany, Italy, Norway, Spain and the United States.

#### Welcome Back!

SIUE is returning to the Missouri Valley Conference after four seasons in the Mid-American Conference. In seven previous seasons in the MVC, SIUE has tallied a record of 25-13-7, two tournament titles, one regular season title, and five appearances in the MVC Tournament Championship game.
