



Game Day Parking & Tailgating Guidelines

Purpose: To encourage responsible game-day socializing, provide a safe environment, and promote a positive experience for alumni, fans, students, the community and corporate sponsors.

Definition: Tailgating is defined as a group or community of participants in a social event in a DESIGNATED area. The NCCU area established for tailgating is known as *The Eagle Alley Tailgating Area, The Pit, and Lincoln Street Parking Lot.*

Guidelines

1. NCCU Tailgating will be used for tailgaters only on the day of the game. Exceptions are RVs that have purchased overnight permits.
2. Tailgating is permitted on game days according to the schedule below. Tailgaters must be parked before parking deadline time. Please note that the gate opening times vary from game to game.
3. Vehicles are **not permitted onto the track**, except at designated crossing areas.
4. All passengers in each vehicle entering the tailgating area must possess a game ticket.
5. **Alcohol is prohibited. The State statutes and University regulations on drug and alcohol consumption will be enforced. All common containers (kegs) are prohibited.**
6. A tailgating permit must be displayed inside each vehicle or on each tent for inspection at all times.
7. Drinking from glass containers is not permitted. Whatever is consumed must be poured into a paper or plastic container.
8. Selling of merchandise, food or beverages is prohibited in the tailgating area.
9. Large grills pulled by vehicles (on their own wheels) without the Athletics Department approval are not permitted in the tailgating area. Grills being used must have a sheet of plywood under the grill to protect the grass.
10. Buses are not permitted in the tailgating area.
11. Grill coals must be disposed in appropriate metal containers located in the tailgating area.
12. Tailgaters are responsible for cleaning up the area prior to leaving the University property. Trash and hot coal receptacles are provided throughout the tailgating area.
13. Tailgaters and spectators will conduct themselves in a manner which ensures the safety and enjoyment of others. Abusive and /or destructive behavior will not be tolerated.
14. Any violation of the tailgating guidelines may result in immediate termination of all tailgating privileges, criminal prosecution, and/or disciplinary action through the Department of Athletics and the NCCU Campus Police.
15. **ALL TENTS ARE PROHIBITED IN FRONT OF THE WALKER COMPLEX. THE ASSIGNED PARKING PERMITTED CAR IS ALLOWED TO HAVE A TENT BEHIND THAT PARTICULAR PARKING SPACE.**

GAME DAY & SEASON PRICING

The Pit: (Surface parking at the Latham Parking Deck)

To purchase in The Pit, you must be a current Eagle Club member (minimum of \$60) or NCCU Athletics Sponsor (minimum of \$5,000). Tailgate parking in **The Pit** will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.

Note the Following:

1. When purchasing tailgate and parking you must be a current Eagle Club member or giving a financial contribution to the Department of Athletics in the current fiscal year.
2. The 2016-2017 fiscal year ends June 30, 2017 and the new fiscal year begins July 1, 2017.
3. In 2018 you must be an Eagle Club member to purchase tailgate and/or parking.
4. For the 2018 football season, Eagle Club giving level will increase in select tailgate and parking areas.

RV Prices: (9 spots available for purchase)

Car Prices: (24 spots available for purchase)

Car Season Package Only **\$225**

Eagle Alley: (Basketball courts in the track area)

To purchase in Eagle Alley, you must be a current Eagle Club member (minimum of \$500) or NCCU Athletics Sponsor (minimum of \$5,000). For Eagle Alley entry, ALL passengers in each vehicle entering the tailgate area must possess a game day ticket. Tailgate parking in Eagle Alley will be assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.

Note the Following:

1. When purchasing tailgate and parking you must be a current Eagle Club member or giving a financial contribution to the Department of Athletics in the current fiscal year.
2. The 2016-2017 fiscal year ends June 30, 2017 and the new fiscal year begins July 1, 2017.
3. In 2018 you must be an Eagle Club member to purchase tailgate and/or parking.
4. For the 2018 football season, Eagle Club giving level will increase in select tailgate and parking areas.

RESERVED SEASON PARKING LOTS

To purchase a reserved season parking spot, you must be an Eagle Club member (minimum \$60)

Note the Following:

1. When purchasing tailgate and parking you must be a current Eagle Club member or giving a financial contribution to the Department of Athletics in the current fiscal year.
2. The 2016-2017 fiscal year ends June 30, 2017 and the new fiscal year begins July 1, 2017.
3. In 2018 you must be an Eagle Club member to purchase tailgate and/or parking.
4. For the 2018 football season, Eagle Club giving level will increase in select tailgate and parking areas.

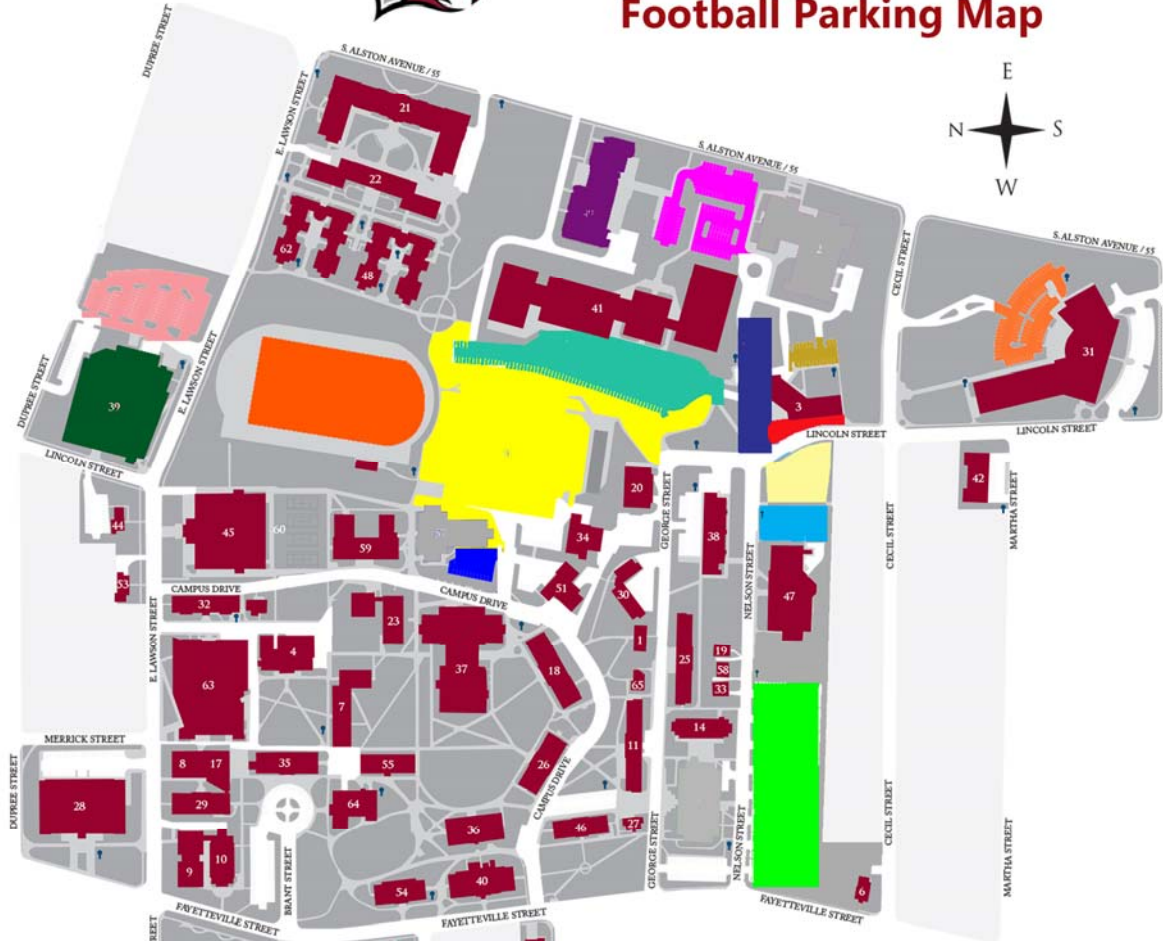

Game Day Parking & Tailgating Guidelines

1. What happens if I arrive after parking deadline for Eagle Alley?

No car or RV will be permitted to enter Eagle Alley and no parking arrangements will be provided.

2. What should I do if I have misplaced my parking decal?

A replacement decal is available for a \$25.00 fee. All replacement decals must be purchased by 5 p.m. on the Thursday prior to game day. No replacement decals will be issued on game day.

3. What should I do if I forgot my parking decal?

You will need to find a new place to park. NCCU Athletics Department recommends you leave your decal in your car after each game to avoid misplacing it. There will be no lists to which staff can refer; no bribes accepted by parking staff; and no access to those who forget their passes.

4. What should I do if a vehicle is parked in my assigned space?

Please contact parking lot attendant or NCCU Campus police if a vehicle is parked in your assigned parking space. **DO NOT** park in any other assigned parking space. Towing will occur if you are parked in an incorrect space.

5. Where can I set up my tailgate within a parking lot?

To ensure everyone has equal space and that plenty of space is available for game day use, fans are limited to one space for one car. Tailgates may be set up at your vehicle provided they do not block access for vehicular traffic passing through the lots.

6. Can I bring my grill to my tailgate?

Propane and charcoal grills are the only permissible sources of heat for cooking. Burned coals and/or residue from cooking should not make contact with the paved surface of the parking lot. Hot coals must be completely extinguished and be disposed in appropriate metal containers located in the tailgating area.

- All grills and fryers being used must have a sheet of plywood used underneath them. The Athletics Department or The University will not provide plywood.

7. Who is responsible for cleaning my tailgate location?

Tailgaters are responsible for cleaning up their areas prior to leaving University property. A \$100 fine will be assessed to each tailgater whose area is not properly cleaned. Trash and hot coal receptacles are provided throughout the tailgate areas.

8. Are there places I can take my trash on game days?

Yes, and thanks for asking. In order to make things easy for trash collection on game days, dumpsters have been placed in high-traffic areas for easy dispersal of garbage following the game. Representatives from the Athletics Department will be passing out trash bags to various parking lots throughout the day.

9. Are bathrooms in dormitories or classroom buildings available for public use?

No, however there is an ample supply of portable bathrooms located in parking lots and tailgate locations throughout campus as well as inside O'Kelly-Riddick Stadium. For safety precautions, no one is allowed into a residence hall.

10. Where can I get power for my tailgate?

No electrical hookup or electricity will be provided. We recommend that you use your vehicle to power any audio or video equipment. AC converters can be purchased at most electronics stores. Generators are also allowed.

Game Day Parking Zones and Information

O'Kelly-Riddick Parking Lot

- Located between O'Kelly-Riddick Stadium and L.T. Walker Complex
- Restricted to Eagle Club members only
- Available as a season pass only
- Area features numbered spaces assigned by Athletics Department
- Cannot be ordered without the purchase of a season ticket

NCCU Public Parking

- Available day of game in several lots near O'Kelly-Riddick Stadium
- Latham Parking Deck and Student Union Parking Lot
- Parking fee \$20, for Homecoming \$25
- Subject to availability and is first-come, first-served

Eagle Alley

- Designated area located inside track area
- Restricted to Athletics Department donors and sponsors
- Available as a season pass only
- Cannot be ordered without the purchase of a season ticket

The Pit

- Designated area located at the surface area of NCCU parking deck
- Accessible via purchase of a season parking pass or an individual game
- Cannot be ordered without the purchase of a season ticket or individual game ticket for an individual game.

Student Service Lot

- Persons with official state-issued accessible permits may purchase a season parking permit
- Area features numbered spaces assigned by Athletics Department
- Cannot be ordered without the purchase of a season ticket
- Available as a season pass only
- Parking is restricted to NCCU Athletics donors and sponsors only

Lincoln Street Lot

- Located at the intersection of Lincoln Street and Nelson Street
- Area features numbered spaces assigned by Athletics Department
- Available as a season pass only
- Cannot be ordered without the purchase of a season ticket and Eagle Club membership

Law School Lot/Criminal Justice Lot/Criminal Justice Side Street

- Lots are located off of Nelson Street
- Area features numbered spaces assigned by Athletics Department
- Available as a season pass only
- Cannot be ordered without the purchase of a season ticket

Game Day Handicap Parking

- Designated area along Campus Drive
- Available day of game only
- Parking fee \$20, for Homecoming \$25
- Persons with official state-issued accessible permits may purchase handicap parking space

Football Parking

All reserved parking for football game day will be handled through the Athletics Department.

During O'Kelly-Riddick Stadium events, traffic may be restricted. During football games, Nelson and Lincoln Streets, Campus Drive and George Street will be closed to traffic starting at 7 p.m. on Fridays. To better accommodate patrons and permit holders, certain lots will be reserved or have spaces reserved for employees who report for work on game days or evenings. When football game restrictions are in effect, commuters and other employees (even those with valid permits) may not park in any of the parking lots, reserved spaces, or in public lots without paying the event fee.

Parking in residential student lots is reserved for students with a valid residential decal for those lots. Those scheduling other events on game days may make arrangements for parking with the Athletics Department at [919-530-7057](tel:919-530-7057).

Certain lots are reserved for NCCU Athletics Eagle Club members, donors, and sponsors. Employees and students are required to move their vehicles from the L.T. Walker Complex, O'Kelly-Riddick, Criminal Justice, Law School, Campus Drive, NCCU Parking Deck, Miller Morgan, School of Education and Communication lots by 7 p.m. on the Fridays before home-game, Saturdays. Employees with permits for these lots will have to pay to park on game days.
