

2021 NSIC Softball Tournament Spectators Guide

The NSIC is pleased to welcome spectators to the RYFSA Complex for the 2021 NSIC Softball Tournament. Given the pandemic, attendance at the tournament is being provided in accordance with strict procedures that must be followed. Any spectator that fails to uphold the protocols outlined in this guide will be escorted from the facility and not provided re-entry for the duration of the tournament.

Pre-Arrival Screening.

All spectators are expected to self-apply appropriate health screening prior to arriving at the facility each day. If you experience any symptoms defined by the CDC (https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/symptoms-testing/symptoms.html), you should refrain from traveling to, and entering the facility.

Risk Mitigation.

All spectators at the RYFSA Complex must wear a face mask while inside the RYFSA Complex unless actively eating or drinking and must practice social distancing at all times. Any individual failing to uphold to this standard will be escorted out of the facility.

• Spectators are encouraged to bring lawn chairs to help support physical distancing and to create more seating outside the outfield and along the left and right field lines.

Admission/Spectator Sign In.

Day and tournament passes will be available for purchase (prices outlined below) at the main gate of the complex. Additionally, all spectators will need to sign in (name and email address) at the main gate of the complex prior to entering the facility. This sign in sheet will be used for contact tracing if a known positive case(s) occurs.

Facility Entrance Timing.

Spectator entrance into the complex will be permitted no earlier than 1 hour before the first scheduled games of the day. All spectators will enter the complex through the main entrance.

Permissible Spaces Within the Facility.

Spectators are allowed to utilize all areas outside the playing fields to view the games and public restrooms will be available for use. Spectators are to practice social distancing and not to come in contact with any student-athletes or coaches on the participating teams.

• Spectators are not allowed in the dugout areas or on the field at any time. Any individual that enters a restricted area of the facility will be immediately removed from the complex and not provided readmittance for the duration of the tournament.

Food/Drink.

Spectators are NOT allowed to bring coolers into the RYFSA Complex. Concessions will be available and will be CASH only.

Facility Departure.

After the conclusion of games for the day, all spectators are to depart the facility in a timely manner.
