## OAC Meritorious Service Awards

The Ohio Athletic Conference Meritorious Service Awards program was initiated in 1985. Full-time institutional employees who serve as faculty representatives, athletics directors, assistant athletics directors, senior woman administrators, coaches, sports information directors and athletic trainers are annually recognized for five, 10 and 20 years of service in the OAC.

A wooden OAC wall clock is presented for 20 years of service to an OAC school, a wooden OAC desk set is given for 10 years of service and a special lifetime OAC pass is awarded upon completion of the fifth year of service.

In addition, an OAC insignia watch is presented upon retirement from an OAC school, with a minimum of 15 years of service, and an engraved plaque is given to the OAC president upon completion of his/her two-year term.

## The Ohio Athletic Conference

Finishing its 116th year, the OAC has developed the reputation as one of the best, if not the best, Division III conferences in the country. This reputation is an outgrowth of a long tradition of success on the field of play and in maintaining the balance between athletics and academics.

The OAC, the third oldest conference in college athletics, is predated only by the Michigan Intercollegiate Athletic Association (1888) and the Big Ten (1895). From a modest beginning of six charter members in 1902, the OAC grew to as many as 24 members in the mid-1920s.

Through the years, a total of 31 colleges and universities at one time or another have been members of the OAC. The Conference currently consists of 10 members, including Baldwin Wallace, Capital, Heidelberg, John Carroll, Marietta, Mount Union, Muskingum, Ohio Northern, Otterbein and Wilmington.

In the OAC's first year of existence, 1902-03, the first Conference champion was crowned — Case Tech, which won the football title with a 5-0-0 record. Outdoor track was added in 1903 and cross country became the third Conference sport in 1914. The addition of women's sports occurred in 1984. The Conference currently sponsors championships in 23 sports, 12 men's and 11 women's.

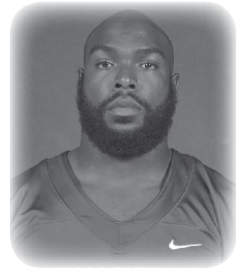

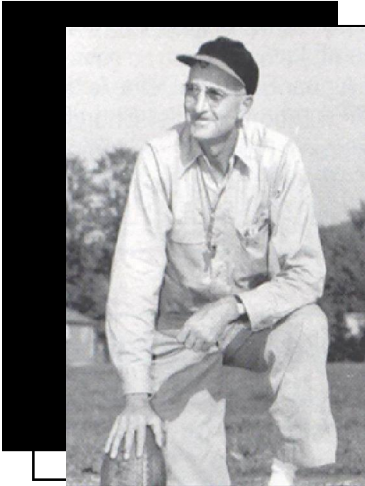

# The Clyde A. Lamb Awards



The Clyde A. Lamb Scholar-Athlete Awards are presented annually to a single male and a single female from each institution. The award winners are honored at the OAC Spring Awards Banquet.

Criteria for the award include at least two years participation in an OAC-sponsored sport, senior status, a minimum grade point average of 3.00 and sportsmanlike conduct in a manner that has brought credit to the student-athlete and his or her institution.

The award was founded in 1985 and is named in honor of Clyde A. Lamb. Lamb organized the department of health and physical education at Ohio Northern University in 1929, and served as a coach, department chairman and athletics director at ONU from 1929-64. He continued to teach full-time until his death in 1969.

Lamb, who received his bachelor's degree from Coe College in 1923 and a master's degree from Columbia University in 1929, coached numerous sports at Ohio Northern during his tenure. In 1959, he was elected to the NAIA Helms Hall of Fame. He was honored as "Ada's Distinguished Citizen" in 1956 and was inducted into Ohio Northern's Athletic Hall of Fame in 1969.
