In a preseason poll of the league's head coaches and sports information directors, **Tennessee Tech** has been selected to win the Ohio Valley Conference Women's Basketball East Division while **UT Martin** is picked to take the West Division in 2012-13. The Golden Eagles earned 15 first-places votes and 121 points while the Skyhawks picked up 19 first-place votes and 129 points. **Eastern Kentucky** is selected to finish second in the East Division after earning six first-place votes and 106 points. OVC newcomer **Belmont** garnered the three remaining first-place votes and 86 points in the East to be predicted to place third. Rounding out the East Division are **Morehead State** (69), **Tennessee State** (68) and **Jacksonville State** (40). In the West Division, **Eastern Illinois** picked up the remaining five first-place votes and 113 points for a second-place predicted finish. **SIUE**, which is in its first season as a full Division I member, is selected to finish third with 86 points followed by **Murray State** (77), **Austin Peay** (47) and **Southeast Missouri** (39).

The 2012-13 Preseason All-OVC is headlined by UT Martin senior guard **Heather Butler** who was selected as the Preseason Player of the Year. In addition to Butler, Eastern Illinois' **Ta'Kenya Nixon** (16.3 ppg, 52.4 FG%) and UT Martin's **Jasmine Newsome** (19.6 ppg, 6.0 apg) were each All-OVC first team picks last year and earned spots on the Preseason All-Conference team this year. Rounding out the preseason squad are Eastern Illinois' **Mariah King** (12.5 ppg, 7.0 rpg) and **Sydney Mitchell** (11.0 ppg, 45.2 FG%); SIUE's **Raven Berry** (11.7 ppg, 9.8 rpg); Murray State's **Erica Burgess** (16.8 ppg, 5.3 rpg); Tennessee State's **Jasmin Shuler** (15.2 pp, 2.5 3-pt field goals made per game); Tennessee Tech's **Jala Harris** (15.2 ppg, 42.2 FG%); and Eastern Kentucky's **Marie Carpenter** (13.4 ppg, 41.8 3-PT FG%).

Butler was a first team All-OVC selection last year after leading the league and ranking fourth in the nation with 23.8 points per game. She also topped the OVC in three-point field goal percentage (42.3%) and three-point field goals made (3.1 per game). She also finished among league leaders in field goal percentage (42.6%), assists (3.3 apg) and free throw percentage (81.1%).

2011-12 OVC WOMEN'S NOTES/PREVIEW

Let the Season Begin: The 2012-13 campaign kicks off on Nov. 1 when Tennessee State host North Alabama and UT Martin welcomes Martin Methodist in exhibition games. The regular-season begins on Nov. 9 with Conference play starting on Dec. 29. Nine different teams have won a regular-season title with Tennessee Tech leading the way with 16.

Belmont Joins the League: Belmont officially joins the league this year bringing the Ohio Valley Conference to 12 teams for the first times. Belmont competes in 17 sports (8 men's sports and 9 women's sports), 16 of which will compete in the OVC (the exception being men's soccer which is not sponsored by the OVC). The Bruins have competed in the Atlantic Sun Conference since 2001-02 and will compete in its final year in that league in 2011-12 before joining the OVC. Since 2001-02 Belmont has won 30 Atlantic Sun Championships, the second most in the conference. Bruins athletic teams have made recent NCAA Tournament appearances in men's and women's basketball, women's soccer, men's tennis and volleyball.

SIUE full Division I Member: After the past five season of reclassification, SIUE is now a full Division I member and will be eligible for postseason play. In its first season with a full OVC schedule, the Cougars posted a 12-4 record and would have been the third seed on the league tournament.

OVC Hosting the 2014 Women's Final Four: The OVC and the Nashville Sports Council will host the 2014 NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Final Four. The event will be held at the Bridgestone Arena. In conjunction with the Final Four, Nashville will also host the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Convention. The WBCA is the national association of approximately 5,000 basketball coaches representing all levels of the game, including junior high, AAU, high school, college and professional.

OVC Women's Hoops on Monday Nights: OVC women's basketball will again be featured on Monday night's. The league approved in 2011 to move away from the men's/women's Thursday night doubleheaders and move the women's games to Monday night.

OVC Basketball to Play in Divisions: With the addition of Belmont and with SIUE gaining full Division I status and becoming eligible for postseason competition, the OVC will feature 12 schools in the sports of men's and women's basketball, softball and volleyball for the first time this coming year. The league announced in February its intention to use a divisional scheduling model for the sports that featured 12 member institutions. The East Division will include Belmont, Eastern Kentucky, Jacksonville State, Morehead State, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech while the West Division will include Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Murray State, Southeast Missouri State, SIUE and UT Martin. In the sports of men's and women's basketball, the top team in each division based on conference winning percentage automatically earns a berth into the OVC Basketball Championship. The next six teams with the highest conference winning percentage will also earn a bid, regardless of division. The No. 1 seed will go to the divisional winner with the top conference winning percentage, while the No. 2 seed will automatically go to the other divisional winner. The remaining six teams will be seeded 3-8 by conference winning percentage, regardless of division.

OVC Associate Commissioner Named to NCAA Women's Basketball Committee: Brad Walker, the Ohio Valley Conference's associate commissioner for operations/chief operating officer, has been appointed to the NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Committee. Walker and Wisconsin senior associate athletic director Terry Gawlik are the new additions to the 10-person committee. This year's chair is Carolayne Henry, associate commissioner of compliance at the Mountain West Conference. Walker's term officially begins in September and will last for five years.

OVC Digital Network: The Ohio Valley Conference has launched the OVC Digital Network (www.OVCDigitalNetwork.com), the new and improved home for live streaming of athletic contests involving OVC member institutions. One of the top new features of the Digital

Network is that all events will be offered free for fans. The events will also feature improved quality with most events streaming in high definition (HD). Fans will also have easier access to the streams, easily accessing them through links at OVCDigitalNetwork.com without any registration being required. The streams will be available on any computer, tablet or smart phone without any app or software download thanks to the use of HTML5 technology. The portal also includes live stats and social media integration to give fans even more interaction. The streaming efforts will concentrate on football and men's and women's basketball in the first year, with all home non-conference and conference contests featuring OVC schools in those sports airing on the platform.

2012-13 In Review: Tennessee Tech was selected to win the 2012-11 title but it was UT Martin who its second regular-season crown. The Skyhawks compiled a 23-9 overall record and a 15-1 mark in the OVC. UT Martin received a double-bye into the semifinals where it defeated No. 4 Murray State, 102-77, to move into the championship game. The Skyhawks then beat Tennessee Tech, 82-65, for the second year in a row to win the OVC Tournament Title. SIUE's Amanda Levens was named the OVC Coach of the Year after leading her team to a 12-4 league mark in its first year with a full conference schedule. UT Martin's Jasmine Newsome was named the OVC Player of the Year while Eastern Illinois' Ta'Kenya Nixon earned Defensive Player of the Year honors. SIUE's Katie Hempen was tabbed as the OVC Freshman of the Year. The OVC had a record four teams in the postseason last year. UT Martin earned the league's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament while Easter Illinois was the OVC's automatic bid to the WNIT. SIUE and Tennessee Tech were invited to play in the Women's Basketball Invitational.

• Junior guard Heather Butler has been named to the preseason Wade Trophy Watch List. She averaged 24.1 points and 4.1 rebounds per game as a sophomore. She led the OVC and ranked third in the NCAA in scoring, pouring in a program record 746 points.
