Jake Byrne, F • Sr., 6-8, 230 • Elsberry, Mo. • Eastern Illinois

Byrne finished out his career in successful fashion, averaging 23.0 points, 10.0 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game while hitting 64.3 percent (18-of-28) from the field. Byrne scored a career-high 30 points in the Panthers 80-64 victory over Jacksonville State while adding 10 rebounds. In EIU's season-ending 64-61 victory over Samford, Byrne added 16 points and 10 boards.

NEWCOMER

Leon Buchanan, F • Sr., 6-5, 200 • Albany, Ga. • Morehead State

Buchanan averaged 14.5 points and 6.5 rebounds and shot 50 percent (9-of-18) from the field as Morehead State split a pair of games last week to finish the Conference season 12-8 and earned the third seed for the OVC Tournament. Buchanan scored 23 points in the Eagles 84-76 come-from-behind victory over Tennessee State on Thursday. He added six points in the team's loss to Austin Peay on Saturday. It marks the fourth time this season Buchanan has been named Newcomer of the Week.

FRESHMAN

Kenneth Faried, C • Fr., 6-8, 215 • Newark, N.J. • Morehead State

Faried averaged 20.0 points and 10.0 rebounds per game last week and hit on 66.7 percent (18-of-27) of his shots as Morehead State split a pair of games last week to finish the Conference season 12-8 and earned the third seed for the OVC Tournament. Faried scored 23 points in the Eagles come-from-behind victory over Tennessee State while also pulling down nine rebounds. He added 17 points and 11 rebounds, his seventh double-double of the year, against Austin Peay. Faried was also named OVC Freshman of the Week on Jan. 21.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

Austin Peay Claims 4th OVC Tournament Championship: With wins over Eastern Kentucky, UT Martin and Tennessee State, the Austin Peay Governors won their fourth OVC Tournament Championship in 2008. The Govs also claimed titles in 1987, 1996 and 2003. Austin Peay, who lost in the OVC Championship game a year ago, garnered a No. 15 seed in the NCAA Tournament and lost to the Texas in the first round.

Austin Peay Wins 8th OVC Regular Season Championship: The Austin Peay Governors (16-4) captured their second consecutive OVC Regular Season Championship in 2008. The Govs finished each of the last two years with identical Conference records and are 32-8 in OVC play over that time period. It marks the eighth time that APSU has won the regular season title and second time in as many years. It also marks the third time the Govs have won back-to-back championships. Austin Peay has also claimed titles in 1973, 1974, 1977, 1997, 2003, 2004 and 2007.

Hudson, Weddle, Tyndall Nab Top OVC Honors: University of Tennessee at Martin junior guard **Lester Hudson** was tabbed as the 2007-08 Ohio Valley Conference Player of the Year while freshman teammate **Marquis Weddle** took home Freshman of the Year honors in a vote by the League's head coaches and sports information directors. Morehead State head coach **Donnie Tyndall**, in his second season coaching his alma mater, was named the OVC Coach of the Year. The All-OVC first-team included Hudson, Austin Peay's **Drake Reed**, Murray State's **Bruce Carter**, Tennessee State's **Bruce Price** and Eastern Kentucky's **Mike Rose**. The All-OVC second-team included Tennessee Tech's **Anthony Fisher**, Austin Peay's **Derek Wright**, Tennessee Tech's **Amadi McKenzie**, Samford's **Travis Peterson** and UT Martin's **Gerald Robinson**. The OVC All-Newcomer included Hudson, Weddle, Tennessee State's **Gerald Robinson, Jr.**, and Morehead State's **Kenneth Faried** and **Leon Buchanan**.

Hudson Named All-American by AP, CollegeInsider.com and CollegeHoops.net: UT Martin junior guard **Lester Hudson** was honored on several All-American teams following the season. Hudson was an honorable mention selection by the Associated Press, was one of 15 players selected to the CollegeInsider.com team and was a Mid-Major All-American selection by CollegeHoops.net. Hudson put together one of the best all-around seasons in Ohio Valley Conference history in 2007-08 and helped his team make a six-game improvement in its league record. Hudson made school, OVC and NCAA history during the season, including becoming the first Division I men's player to record a quadruple-double (25 points, 12 rebounds, 10 assists and 10 steals vs. Central Baptist College) in a college game. He also had a triple-double, eight additional double-doubles and cracked the 30-point plateau 11 times during his rookie season in the league. Hudson set the OVC record for 3-pointers made in a season (124) and helped his team advance to the OVC Tournament semifinals, where they lost by one point in the final seconds to OVC Champion Austin Peay. Hudson was the only player at the Division I level to rank in the Top 100 nationally in points, rebounds and assists, let alone do it in points, rebounds, assists, steals and 3-pointers made per game.

LaPlante Not Retained as JSU Coach: Following the season, Jacksonville State head men's basketball coach **Mike LaPlante's** contract was not be renewed, ending the coach's eight-year tenure with the school. LaPlante finished his eight year reign as head coach with a 95-137 career record and was 57-93 in conference games, but was just 22-84 in road games during his tenure. LaPlante was hired in 2000 as the ninth head coach and the third since joining the Division I ranks, replacing Mark Turgeon.

Morehead State and UT Martin Overcome Preseason Predictions: Although they did not get much respect in a preseason vote by head coaches and sports information directors, Morehead State and UT Martin finished the regular season having had very good years. Morehead State finished 12-8 and locked up the No. 3 seed for the OVC Tournament while UT Martin finished 11-9 and locked up the No. 4 seed; both teams hosted first-round games at their gyms; UT Martin won and Morehead State lost. In the preseason poll released in October, Morehead State was picked to finish 10th in the 11-team league while UT Martin was tabbed 11th.

Two Coaches Reach 100 Career Victories: Tennessee Tech head coach **Mike Sutton** reached the 100 career victory plateau on Feb. 7 with an overtime victory over Jacksonville State. Sutton is in his sixth season with the Golden Eagle program. Just a week later UT Martin head coach **Bret Campbell** reached his 100 career victories with an 82-79 victory at Tennessee Tech. Campbell is in his ninth season with the Skyhawks. Currently the only other coach in the OVC with 100 career victories at their current school is Austin Peay's Dave Loos. Several other coaches have more than 100 career wins, but they came at a combination of schools.

OVC Goes 4-6 in O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters Event This Season: OVC teams competed in the sixth annual O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters event on Feb. 23. It marked the third straight year, that all 11 Ohio Valley Conference schools participated in the event (Tennessee State was slated to play Northern Illinois this year but the game was cancelled after the shooting on the NIU campus). OVC schools compiled a 4-6 record overall this season. Austin Peay has competed in the most BracketBusters games (5) while UT Martin (3-0) is the only team to be undefeated in BracketBusters play after a win at Elon

2008 OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2008 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 4, 7-8. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 4. Those games can be seen live on OVCSports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to historic Municipal Auditorium in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 7 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPNU with the championship game on Saturday, March 8 at 4 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2 (note, this is a change from the original time announced). The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 7th (televised on OVCSports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 8 at 11 a.m. and will be televised on Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast (CSS).

This marks the 14th time in 15 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and the fifth time it will take place in Municipal. The event was also held there in 1989, 1994, 1995 and 2004.

In its sixth year, O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters is an ESPN television property that was tremendously successful with its first five events in February of 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006 and 2007. The event has allowed Division I conferences to participate in a cutting-edge format that involves "wild-card" pairings for the pool of participating teams, with half of the O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters teams pre-designated as "home" and the remaining half as "road" teams. The 2008 O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters had a total pool of 100 teams representing 16 conferences in a 50-game event. In an effort to provide a greater opportunity for NCAA Tournament-caliber teams, the event had expanded its pool of teams (18 in 2003, 46 in 2004, 64 in 2005, 100 in 2006 and 102 in 2007) each year to produce a better cross section of squads for the hoops bonanza.

Ginn Named Academic All-District: Jacksonville State senior **Will Ginn** was selected to the ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District First Team by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA). Ginn, a 6-foot-0-inch guard from Alexandria, Ala., was the only player from the Ohio Valley Conference selected to the five-person squad for District IV, thanks to a 3.82 grade point average in Math Education. He is second on the team in scoring with 10.6 points per game. With the selection to the All-District squad, Ginn will be placed on the organization's Academic All-America ballot, which will be voted on by the Sports Information Directors across the country.

40 Points: Austin Peay senior point guard Derek Wright was on fire against Southeast Missouri State (Jan. 29) when he scored 43 points in his team's 121-116 triple overtime loss to the Redhawks. Wright, who hit numerous big shots in the game, was 11-of-26 from the field, 5-of-12 from 3-point range and 16-of-20 from the free throw line. Twenty (20) of his 43 points came during the overtime period. The 43 points ranks as the second-highest Division I total so far this season (trailing only the 44 points scored by Troy's Justin Jonas on Nov. 14). Wright was the first OVC player to score 40 or more points in a game since Eastern Illinois' Josh Gomes scored 40 against UT Martin on Feb. 7, 2004. It was the most points scored since Eastern Illinois' Henry Domercant scored 46 against Tennessee Tech on March 1, 2003.

OVC Mandates Courtside Replay Systems For Basketball Games: On December 21, Dr. Jon A. Steinbrecher, Ohio Valley Conference Commissioner, mandated the use of courtside replay systems at all OVC basketball venues for the remainder of the season. The mandate was reviewed by the OVC Board of Athletic Directors on Jan. 3 and the systems were put in place in all 11 venues by Jan. 12 and will be used in situations that are outlined by NCAA rules. Prior to this mandate, replay had only been available for games that were televised; the new mandate allows for officiating crews to watch replays regardless of the presence of television crews.

UT Martin's Hudson Nets First Quadruple-Double in Division I Men's Basketball History: UT Martin junior guard **Lester Hudson** made NCAA Division I men's basketball history on Tuesday, Nov. 13 when he recorded a quadruple-double in the Skyhawks 116-74 victory over Central Baptist College. He is believed to be the first men's player to accomplish the feat at the Division I level. Hudson filled up the box score with 25 points, 12 rebounds, 10 assists and 10 steals in 31 minutes of play. He was 10-of-17 from the field and 5-of-7 from 3-point range and also blocked a shot. The 10 steals are the most for a Division I player this season. The transfer from Southwest Tennessee Community College was named OVC Player of the Week on Nov. 12 after his first week with the Skyhawk program. In research conducted by ESPN and the NCAA, no other recorded instances of a quadruple-double occurring at the Division I men's basketball level have ever been record. At the Division I women's level, UCLA's Ann Meyers had 20 points, 14 rebounds, 10 assists and 10 steals in a 1978 contest against Stephen F. Austin. The feat has only happened four times in the NBA since the 1973-74 season (when the NBA started to officially recognize blocks and steals). The NBA players to accomplish the feat include David Robinson (Feb. 17, 1994), Hakeem Olajuwon (March 29, 1990), Alvin Robertson (Feb. 18, 1986) and Nate Thurmond (Oct. 18, 1974). The feat has also occurred once in the ABA (Jamel Staten on Feb 2, 2007) and once in the ABL (Debbie Black on Dec. 8, 1996). Four instances of it happening at the women's Division III level have also been documented.

Loos Inducted to Austin Peay Hall of Fame: Current Austin Peay head coach and athletic director **Dave Loos** was inducted into the Austin Peay Hall of Fame on Feb. 16. Loos is the winningest coach in APSU history. It is the fourth Hall of Fame in which he is a member, as he is a member of the St. Louis Baseball Amateur Hall of Fame (he was a former prep player and coach), University of Memphis Athletics Hall of Fame (he was a two-sport star for the Tigers) and the Missouri Basketball Coaches Hall of Fame (from his days coaching his alma mater of Mehlville High School).

Jacksonville State Sets OVC Record for 3-Pointers Made in a Game: Jacksonville State set an OVC record for 3-pointers made in a game on Nov. 12 when they knocked down 19 triples in a 99-74 victory over Tennessee Temple. The 19 3-pointers surpassed the record of 18 previously held by Morehead State (1995-96 season) and Tennessee Tech (1999-00 season). In that game, JSU point guard **Will Ginn** set the school with eight 3-pointers, while **Jeremy Bynum** added seven trifectas.

OVC Reaches 60th Year: This year marks the 60th season of basketball in the Ohio Valley Conference, which was formed in 1948. The OVC is the eighth oldest Division I

Familiar Faces: When players take to the court this season, teams and fans will see a lot of familiar faces on the court. Less than 30 players finished their eligibility at the end of last season, meaning every team has several experienced players back this season. Two teams - Austin Peay and Eastern Illinois - return all five starters as well as double-digit letterwinners (EIU did not lose a single letterwinner from last season). Jacksonville State and Southeast Missouri each return four starters while Eastern Kentucky, Murray State, Samford and Tennessee State will have three starters apiece back.

All 11 Head Coaches Return: There was no turnover in the OVC coaching ranks at the completion of last season as all 11 OVC men's basketball coaches return this season to guide their respective squads. It marks only the sixth time in the last 30 years (dating back to the 1978-79 season) that every Conference head coach has returned from the previous season. The other years in which every coach returned were 1978-79, 1993-94, 1994-95, 2001-02 and 2004-05.

Alexander and Steinbrecher Named to NCAA Men's Basketball Academic Enhancement Group: This past June NCAA President Myles Brand announced the establishment of the Division I Men's Basketball Academic Enhancement Group. The group, which includes Ohio Valley Conference Commissioner **Jon A. Steinbrecher** and Tennessee State University head men's basketball coach **Cy Alexander**, is comprised of presidents and chancellors, head coaches, commissioners, directors of athletics and faculty athletics representatives and is charged with developing strategies to enhance academic performance and graduation rates in Division I men's basketball. Specifically, the charge to the Division I Men's Basketball Academic Enhancement Group is to: (1) Analyze available data, research and literature regarding the academic performance trends of Division I men's basketball student-athletes, (2) Identify characteristics and factors in the sport that may be serving to impair the academic performance of Division I men's basketball student-athletes, (3) Identify changes that would enhance academic performance and graduation rates in Division I men's basketball, (4) Submit to the Division I Board of Directors, no later than the end of 2008, a set of recommendations and proposals that would enhance APR and graduation rates in Division I men's basketball and (5) Maintain ongoing communication with, and seek reactions from, the NCAA governance structure, the NABC membership and conference offices during the course of the project.

Austin Peay Picked as Preseason Favorite: In a preseason vote of league head coaches and sports information directors, defending regular season champion Austin Peay has been picked to repeat as champions in 2007-08. The Governors were 16-4 last season in claiming their seventh OVC regular season championship and lost in the finals of OVC Tournament. They received 19 of a possible 22 first-place votes. Eastern Kentucky, last year's Tournament Champion, was picked to finish second and received one first-place vote. Tennessee Tech, who received the other two first-place votes, was picked third, followed by Murray State, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Samford, Eastern Illinois, Jacksonville State, Morehead State and UT Martin.

All-Time Preseason Predicted Order of Finish: Does being picked the preseason favorite mean good things for a team? In the 28 years of preseason OVC polls that are available, the preseason poll predicted the eventual league champion 60.7 percent of the time (17 out of 28). That was a much better percentage than the preseason football polls, which predicted the OVC champion only 42.9 percent of the time. From 1994-95 through 1999-00, the preseason champion was picked correctly, but over the last eight years, the preseason poll has correctly predicted the champion only every other season (incorrectly picking Samford last season). If that trend continues, it would mean good things for Austin Peay this year.

Reed Tabbed as Preseason Player of the Year: Austin Peay junior forward **Drake Reed** was tabbed as the preseason OVC Player of the Year in a vote of league head coaches and sports information directors. Reed was named the 2006-07 OVC Player of the Year after helping Austin Peay to the regular season championship; he became the first sophomore to take home OVC Player of the Year honors since Murray State's Ron "Popeye" Jones did in 1990. Reed was one of 10 players selected to the preseason All-OVC team. He was joined by **Bruce Carter** (Murray State), **Anthony Fisher** (Tennessee Tech), **Brandon Foust** (Southeast Missouri), **Adam Leonard** (Eastern Kentucky), **Fernandez Lockett** (Austin Peay), **Romain Martin** (Eastern Illinois), **Amadi McKenzie** (Tennessee Tech), **Travis Peterson** (Samford) and **Mike Rose** (Eastern Kentucky).

Multiple Postseason Berths: Last season the OVC had a team in each the NCAA Tournament and the National Invitational Tournament on both the men's and women's side. For the men, Eastern Kentucky played in the NCAA Tournament, while Austin Peay was the NIT representative. That marked the first time since the 2002 season (when Murray State made the NCAA's and Tennessee Tech the NIT) that the OVC had put two men's squads into the postseason. On the women's side, Southeast Missouri (NCAA) and Murray State (NIT) accomplished the feat, marking the second year in a row two women's squads had earned postseason bids. Only one other time in OVC history (1989) had four total teams played in the postseason; that year Murray State (NCAA) and Middle Tennessee (NIT) were in on the men's side while Tennessee Tech (NCAA) and Murray State (NIT) advanced to postseason on the women's side.

Team Notes

Despite the loss in the regular season finale, the Skyhawks finished 11-8 in OVC play, which earned them the No. 4 overall seed for the OVC Tournament and a home first-round game against No. 5 seed Samford...It took three overtimes, but UTM came out on top 101-94 against the Bulldogs in that contest...UTM then pushed eventual tournament champion Austin Peay to the limit in the semifinals before falling 78-77 on a late free throw...This year marked the first time since the 2006 season that UTM has played in the OVC Tournament (they were a No. 8 seed that year)...The No. 4 seed was the highest for the program since joining the OVC in 1992; the 'Hawks had made five previous trips to the OVC Tournament but never advanced past the first round...The win over Samford this year was the first in the postseason as a Division I team...Overall the program's 17 wins on the season was the most since joining the OVC; the last time the program won 20 games was in 1987 when they were 20-8 overall...It also marked the first time since 2001-02 that UTM had a winning overall record during the season (15-14 that season)...The 11 victories in OVC play was also a program-best for UT Martin...Junior guard Lester Hudson, who ranked among the national leaders in scoring, steals and 3-pointers made was named OVC Player of the Year and OVC Newcomer of the Week...Teammate Marquis Weddle was named OVC Freshman of the Year and senior forward Gerald Robinson was named to the All-OVC second-team.
