## THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

### PLAYER

**Kenneth Faried, C • So., 6-8, 215 • Newark, N.J. • Morehead State**

Faried netted his 16th and 17 double-doubles of the season last week as Morehead State improved to 12-3 in Conference play and maintained first place in the standings by a half-game. Faried averaged 18.0 points and 15.5 rebounds per game while hitting 58.3 percent (14-of-24) from the field. Faried had 16 points, 13 rebounds and two blocks in the Eagles win over Eastern Illinois on Thursday and followed that with 20 points and 18 rebounds in a win over Southeast Missouri. Faried's 17 double-doubles are now fourth-most nationally this season. It marks the second time this season Faried has been named OVC Player of the Week (Jan. 5 was the other).

### NEWCOMER

**LaMont Russell, F • Jr., 6-6, 220 • Wichita, Kan. • Southeast Missouri**

Russell notched his second double-double of the season on Thursday at Eastern Kentucky, scoring 10 points and grabbing 10 rebounds in 40 minutes of action. He also had two assists, three steals and a block while hitting 5-of-9 shots from the field. Russell followed the performance by scoring five points and netting seven rebounds in a loss at league-leading Morehead State. He was perfect (2-of-2) from the field against the Eagles.

### FRESHMAN

**Kevin Murphy, F • Fr., 6-6, 185 • Fairburn, Ga. • Tennessee Tech**

Murphy led Tennessee Tech in three games last week, averaging 17.0 points, 4.7 rebounds, 1.7 assists and 1.0 steals per game. He scored 16 points in a start last Monday against Austin Peay and followed that with 12 points and seven boards in 27 minutes of action at Murray State. Murphy followed that with a 23-point, 5-rebound, 3-assist and 2-steal effort at UT Martin. In that game Murphy hit 11-of-12 free throws and for the week connected on 17-of-19 (89.5%) charity attempts.

## NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

**OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights:** The OVC race is winding down, as most teams have either two or three Conference games to play before the regular season comes to an end...There are five mid-week OVC games this week before teams take Saturday off to participate in the ESPN BracketBusters series; five OVC teams will host BracketBusters games this weekend while five will go on the road...One of the more intriguing matchups is defending champion Austin Peay at defending Missouri Valley Champion Drake...Among the Conference matchups this weekend is a rivalry matchup on Wednesday when first-place Morehead State travels to Eastern Kentucky...Morehead State has won six of its last seven (and 10 of 12) and holds a half game lead over UT Martin in the standings; Eastern Kentucky has moved up to fifth in the standings (half a game behind Murray State for fourth) after having won five of its last six (and 7 of its last nine)...Also on Wednesday night UT Martin will look to increase its winning streak to 11 games when it travels to Eastern Illinois; the Skyhawks have won 16 of its last 17 games overall dating back to mid-December and the squad's 10-game winning streak is currently the fourth-longest nationally (Memphis is first with 16 wins in a row)...UT Martin and Murray State (who is currently in fourth place) are the only teams with four OVC games remaining; the teams had to re-schedule a game from earlier in February after an ice storm in the Murray area forced the cancellation of the game (the game is set for next Monday, Feb. 23)...Thursday features an ESPN clash between Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech; the Golden Eagles are one game behind the Tigers in the OVC standings...TSU is now 2-1 since naming Mark Pittman interim head coach; last week the Tigers won road games at Jacksonville State and Austin Peay to jump from ninth to seventh in the standings.

**ESPN BracketBusters Games This Weekend:** The matchups for the 2009 ESPN BracketBusters series were announced on Monday, Feb. 2. For the fourth straight year, every Ohio Valley Conference school will participate in the event. Five schools will host games while the other five will go on the road. Austin Peay has competed in the most BracketBusters games, competing in each of the last five years. UT Martin (3-0) is the only OVC school to go undefeated in BracketBusters games. Now in its seventh year, ESPN BracketBusters is an ESPN television property that was tremendously successful with its first six events in February of 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007 and 2008. The event has allowed Division I conferences to participate in a cutting-edge format that involves "wild card" pairings from the pool of participating teams, with half of the ESPN BracketBusters teams pre-designated as "home" and the remaining half as "road" teams. This season 102 total teams from 17 conferences will compete in the event to be held Friday, Feb. 20 and Saturday, Feb. 20. Of the 51 games, a total of 13 will be televised nationally on either ESPN2, ESPN or ESPN360.com. This season no OVC team was picked for one of the televised games. **TTU's Davis Named to ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District Squad:** Tennessee Tech junior guard **Frank Davis** has been named to the ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District IV First-Team as selected by CoSIDA. Davis was the only men's basketball player in the OVC selected to one of the eight All-District squads. Davis carries a 3.42 grade point average in exercise science. For making the first-team Davis will now advance to the national ballot for consideration of Academic All-American. To be eligible for nomination, a student-athlete must have reached sophomore academic standing and have at least a 3.30 cumulative grade point average. District IV selections come from schools located within the states of Alabama, Kentucky, Michigan, Ohio and Tennessee.

**ESPN Radio 1370 in Chattanooga to Air OVC Men's Basketball Game of the Week:** In January the OVC announced a partnership with ESPN Radio 1370 WDEF in Chattanooga to broadcast an OVC Men's Basketball Game of the Week. The broadcast will be produced by Broadcaster Marketing Services and air exclusively on WDEF. Veteran play-by-play announcer Frank Santore will serve as the play-by-play announcer for the games. Each of the 10 OVC schools competing for the Conference championship this season will make one appearance on the broadcasts this season. **Hudson Only Player to Score 20 or More Points in Every Game This Season; Ranks Second Nationally in Scoring:** OVC Preseason Player of the Year **Lester Hudson** is the only player nationally to score 20 or more points in every game this season. Hudson has reached that plateau in all 24 UTM games. His season high is 41 points at Central Arkansas and his season-low is 20 points against Tennessee and USC. Hudson enters this week ranked second nationally in scoring (27.9 points/game). That trails only Davidson's Stephen Curry, who is averaging 29.0 points a contest.

**Morehead State's Faried Has Second Best Rebounding Game of the Season Nationally; Ranks Third Nationally in Rebounding:** Morehead State's **Kenneth Faried** grabbed a career-high 24 rebounds against Florida A&M on Nov. 23. So far this season that performance ranks as the

## 2009 OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2009 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 3, 6-7. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 3. Those games can be seen live on [OVCSports.TV](http://OVCSports.TV).

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 6 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPN with the championship game on Saturday, March 7 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 6th (televised on [OVCSports.TV](http://OVCSports.TV)) and the women's championship game is set for March 7 at a time to be announced.

This marks the 15th time in 16 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and 10th time the event has been held at the Sommet Center (and first since the 2007 tournament).

second most rebounds by one player in a game at the Division I level. It trails only a 25-rebound performance by Chris Gadley of Canisius. Faried has also had a 20-rebound game, a 19-rebound game, an 18-rebound outing, two 17-rebound performances and two 16-rebound games in 2008-09. Faried is averaging 12.9 rebounds per game this season, which ranks third nationally (he is averaging 14.1 rebounds per game in 15 OVC contests this season).

**Faried Ranks Among Nation's Leaders on Double-Doubles:** Morehead State sophomore center **Kenneth Faried** has 17 double-doubles through 27 games this season. That currently ranks as the fourth-most nationally as of Feb. 16. The nation's leader is Oklahoma's Blake Griffin (22) and he is followed by Santa Clara's John Bryant (21) and Notre Dame's Luke Harangody (18). Faried is the only player currently with exactly 17 double-doubles.

**Moving up the Coaching Victory Chart:** Austin Peay head coach **Dave Loos** now has 309 career victories while in the OVC, a mark that ranks second in league history. He is just 10 wins shy of Cal Luther (319 wins at Murray State and UT Martin) for the all-time mark. He is by far the active leader in the category as well, as only two other current OVC coaches - UT Martin's **Bret Campbell** and Tennessee Tech's **Mike Sutton** have reached the 100-win plateau at their respective OVC schools.

The women's semifinals will begin at 12 p.m. on Friday, March 6 with the men's semifinals following at 6 p.m. that evening. The women's championship game will be held at 3 p.m. on Saturday, March 7 with the men's championship game beginning at 7 p.m. that evening. **UT Martin's Hudson One of 10 Finalists for Lowe's Senior CLASS Award:** **Lester Hudson** has been named among the high-achieving group of 10 finalists for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award, which has become the premier honor for senior student-athletes in the nation. Hudson is the first UT Martin men's basketball player to advance to the final round of balloting for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. This announcement launches a nationwide balloting process to determine the 2009 award winner. Lowe's, an official Corporate Partner of the NCAA will announce and present the men's basketball winner with the distinctive Lowe's Senior CLASS Award trophy in front of a national television audience during the CBS telecast of the NCAA Men's Final Four in Detroit. For the first time in the basketball division, text voting will also be available during the voting period. To vote for Hudson via text, fans can send the text code MBS to the number 839863. Joining Hudson among the 10 finalists are A.J. Abrams (University of Texas, Austin), Jimmy Baron (University of Rhode Island), Dionte Christmas (Temple University), Tyler Hansbrough (University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill), Curtis Jerrells (Baylor University), Jerel McNeal (Marquette University), Andy Wicke (Belmont University), Terrence Williams (University of Louisville) and Sam Young (University of Pittsburgh). Finalists for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award were selected from a list of 30 candidates, based on personal qualities that define a complete student-athlete. Each finalist displays numerous accomplishments across four award pillars: classroom, community, character, and competition.

**Alexander Dismissed as TSU Coach; Pittman Named Interim Coach:** Tennessee State University director of athletics, Teresa Phillips announced the dismissal of head basketball coach **Cy Alexander** on Feb. 6. Alexander was in his sixth season at Tennessee State posting a record of 67-107 and 48-56 in the Ohio Valley Conference. Overall, in 24 years, Alexander has posted a record of 344-306. Last season, TSU finished 15-17, 10-10 in the OVC, after reaching the championship game of the Ohio Valley Conference. **Mark Pittman** will serve as interim head coach. Pittman joined the Tennessee State basketball program in 2003, reuniting him with Alexander. Pittman served previously as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator under Alexander at South Carolina State from 1989-92. A 1977 graduate of Illinois, Pittman is a veteran of both the collegiate and high school coaching ranks. Along with his tenure at South Carolina State, he was an assistant and recruiting coordinator at Cincinnati from 1983-89. He was an administrative assistant at Jacksonville University (1998-2001) and worked as an assistant coach at Florida Community College (1996-98). He also served as both a graduate assistant and student assistant basketball coach at Illinois.

**TSU's Robinson a Candidate for Bob Cousy Award:** Tennessee State sophomore guard **Gerald Robinson, Jr.** has been named a candidate for the Bob Cousy Award, presented by The Hartford; the award is given to the top collegiate point guard annually spanning all divisions. The selection criteria emphasize leadership, team work, success and fundamentals as being critical parts for the games of basketball as a point guard. Nominations are solicited from head coaches across the country and the winner is selected by a Blue Ribbon Selection Committee. Other nominees include UNC's Ty Lawson, Davidson's Stephen Curry and UCLA's Darren Collison.

**Loos Named to Division I Men's Basketball Issues Committee:** **Dave Loos**, Austin Peay State University's athletics director and head men's basketball coach, has been appointed to the NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Issues Committee. Loos will fill the unexpired term of Delaware State's Rick Costello. His appointment begins immediately and runs through Sept. 1, 2012. Loos currently is in his 19th season as Austin Peay head coach and is the only Division I basketball

The NCAA Division I Men's Basketball Issues Committee is charged with oversight of all issues pertaining to NCAA Division I men's basketball. The committee works closely with the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) on legislation and other issues, as well as the National Basketball Association and USA Basketball. The committee's primary duties are to ensure the appropriate oversight of the sport, with an emphasis on recruiting activities and to enhance the development and public perception of the sport. The committee also makes policy recommendations per topics unrelated to legislative and playing rules issues.

**Hudson Named to Early Season Naismith Watch List:** UT Martin senior guard **Lester Hudson** was one of 50 players on the Naismith Trophy Early Season Watch List as announced by the Atlanta Tipoff Club. The watch list was compiled by the Atlanta Tipoff Club's Board of Selectors, which based its criteria on player performances from the previous year and expectations for the 2008-09 college basketball season. The watch list does not include incoming freshmen, although those student-athletes will be considered in the first vote in February, 2009. The Naismith Trophy presented by AT&T will be awarded at the 2009 NCAA Men's Final Four in Detroit, Mich. In February, the Naismith Trophy voting academy, comprised of leading basketball journalists, coaches and administrators from around the country, will narrow its early season list to the Top 30 players in the nation. Those players, and others who distinguish themselves throughout the season, will be eligible for the final ballot in March.

**Former TTU Point Guard Named Head Coach of NBA's Philadelphia 76ers: Tony DiLeo,** the starting point guard for the Tennessee Tech Golden Eagles during two years in the mid 70s, has been named head coach of the NBA's Philadelphia 76ers. DiLeo played at Tech as a freshman in the 1973-74 season, and as a sophomore in 1974-75, both under head coach Connie Inman. He transferred to LaSalle in his hometown of Philadelphia for his final two seasons. Playing in 50 games for the Golden Eagles, DiLeo dished out 272 assists, which ranked as the second-most in school history, only eight behind Wayne Pack's school record. More than 30 years later, DiLeo's total still ranks 14th in the career record book. DiLeo, currently the team's Senior Vice President and Assistant General Manager, will remain in the position through the end of the 2008-09 season. DiLeo is in his 19th season with the Sixers organization and his fifth as the team's Senior Vice President and Assistant General Manager.

**Hudson Named to John R. Wooden Award Watch List:** **Lester Hudson**, a senior guard at The University of Tennessee at Martin, is one of 50 preseason candidates for the 2008-09 John R. Wooden Award All-American Team and Player of the Year trophy. The list of candidates for the Wooden Award is composed of 50 student-athletes who, based on last year's individual performance and team records, are the early frontrunners for college basketball's most prestigious honor. Among the other candidates for the Wood Award are Tyler Hansbrough of North Carolina, last year's Wooden Award winner; Notre Dame forward Luke Harangody; and Davidson guard Stephen Curry. In all, 42 schools and 13 conferences are represented on the Wooden Award Pre-Season list. Leading the way is the Big East with 12 candidates. Hudson is the only candidate for the award from the Ohio Valley Conference. In mid-January, the Wooden Award Committee will release the Midseason Top 30 list, followed in March by the national ballot, consisting of approximately 20 top players who have proven to their universities that they are also making progress toward graduation and maintaining a cumulative 2.0 GPA. The Wooden Award All-American Team will be announced the week of the "Elite Eight" round during the NCAA Tournament. Created in 1976, the John R. Wooden Award is the most prestigious individual honor in college basketball. It is bestowed upon the nation's best player at an institution of higher education who has proven to his university that he is making progress toward graduation and maintaining a cumulative 2.0 GPA. Previous winners include such notables as Larry Bird (1979), Michael Jordan (1984), Tim Duncan (1997) and 2007 recipient Kevin Durant of Texas.

**Hudson and Robinson Earn Preseason Recognition From CollegeInsider.com:** UT Martin senior guard **Lester Hudson** and Tennessee State sophomore guard **Gerald Robinson** earned preseason All-American honors from CollegeInsider.com. Hudson was named to the 16-player All-American team while Robinson was one of 25 players named to the Mid-Major All-American squad. Both Division I coaches and NBA scouts were part of the selection process along with the CollegeInsider.com staff. Hudson was one of just 16 selections to the All-America team, which included the likes of North Carolina's Tyler Hansbrough, Davidson's Stephen Curry and Kentucky's Patrick Patterson. Robinson was one of 25 selections to the Mid-Major All-American Team.

**Hudson Named to CollegeHoops.net Preseason Mid-Major All-America Team:** UT Martin senior guard **Lester Hudson** was named to CollegeHoops.net First-Team Mid-Major All-America squad. Hudson joins Davidson's Stephen Curry; Saint Mary's Patrick Mills; Butler's Matt Howard and Saint Mary's Diamon Simpson on the first-team.

**The 2008-09 Season:** The 2008-09 season marks the 61st of competition for the Ohio Valley Conference. Over the previous 60 years, 11 different teams have claimed an OVC regular season championship, including three different schools in the past four years.

**UT Martin's Hudson Tabbed as Preseason Player of the Year:** The 2008-09 All-OVC Preseason Men's Basketball team was headlined by UT Martin senior guard **Lester Hudson**, the 2007-08 OVC Player of the Year. Hudson was tabbed a nearly unanimous Preseason Player of the Year after earning the award at the end of last season. Overall seven different schools were represented on the team with Morehead State, Tennessee State and UT Martin each placing two individuals on the team. The team included six seniors, a junior and three sophomores while featuring three repeat selections from last year's All-OVC squads. Hudson finished last year

ranked in the Top 10 nationally in each points per game (25.7 - 4th), steals (2.8 - 4th) and 3-pointers made per game (3.8 - 10th). He also became the first Division I men's basketball player to record a quadruple-double in a game. Hudson was joined by two other players who were selections on the 2007-08 All-OVC team - Austin Peay forward **Drake Reed** (the 2006-07 OVC Player of the Year and last year's preseason Player of the Year) and Eastern Kentucky guard **Mike Rose**. Reed averaged 14.4 points and 5.6 rebounds per game last season while leading APSU to the OVC regular season and tournament championships. Rose led ECU with 15.3 points per game while also adding 4.4 rebounds, 2.2 assists and 1.8 steals per game. All five individuals who were named to the OVC All-Newcomer Team last season made this year's preseason team. That includes Hudson, his UT Martin teammate **Marquis Weddle** (17.1 ppg, 99 made 3-pointers), Morehead State's **Leon Buchanan** (13.2 ppg, 6.1 rpg, 53.5 FG%) and **Kenneth Faried** (10.5 ppg, 8.0 rpg, 51.6 FG%) and Tennessee State's **Gerald Robinson** (15.2 ppg, 60 made 3-pointers). Rounding out the Preseason All-OVC team was Tennessee State's **Jerrell Houston** (11.6 ppg, 6.1 rpg), Tennessee Tech's **Daniel Northern** (12.8 ppg, OVC-best 9.3 rebounds per game and OVC-best 2.8 blocks per game) and Murray State's **Danero Thomas** (12.3 ppg, 4.9 rpg).

**Murray State Picked as Preseason Favorite:** In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head men's basketball coaches and sports information directors, Murray State was picked as the 2008-09 preseason favorite in the 10-team league. The Racers, who received 11 of 20 first-place votes, finished second in the OVC last season (13-7) and return nine players and four starters from the team. It marks the 12th time in the last 20 years that Murray State has been picked the preseason favorite and the first time since the 2005-06 season. Murray State totaled 149 points and was closely followed by UT Martin who received six first-place votes (142 points). It marks the highest preseason ranking the Skyhawks have received since joining the OVC in 1992. Previously UTM had been picked no higher than sixth in the preseason predictions (four different times). Defending champion Austin Peay received two first-place votes and was tabbed third (129 points) while Morehead State received one first-place vote and was picked fourth (118), its highest preseason selection since 2003-04. Tennessee State was picked fifth (108), followed by Tennessee Tech (77), Eastern Kentucky (59), Southeast Missouri State (57), Eastern Illinois (35) and Jacksonville State (26).

**Preseason Predictions:** Is being picked the preseason favorite, always a good thing? Over the past 29 years of preseason polls that were available, the league's head coaches and sports information directors correctly pick the eventual OVC regular season champion 62 percent of the time, picking the correct winner 18 times over the last 29 years. Over the past nine years, the preseason poll has correctly picked the winner every other year. Last season the poll correctly picked Austin Peay to claim the championship.

**A New Face:** Jacksonville State's **James Green** is the lone new coach in the OVC last year, as he takes over the Gamecock program after previously coaching at Mississippi Valley State.

**SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC:** On July 1 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, Ill., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States).

**Replay Systems for OVC Basketball Venues Enter Year Two:** On Dec. 21, 2007, the Ohio Valley Conference mandated the use of courtside replay systems at all OVC basketball venues. The systems were put into place in January and used through the remainder of the 2007-08 season. They are in effect once again in 2008-09. The systems are used in situations that are outlined by NCAA rules.

**OVC Players in the Pros:** As of January 2009, there was two former Ohio Valley Conference players on an NBA roster - Austin Peay's **Trenton Hassell** and Murray State's **James Singleton**. Hassell is in his eighth season in the NBA and second with the New Jersey Nets. He also played with the Chicago Bulls (who drafted him 30th overall in the 2001 Draft and where he played two seasons), Minnesota Timberwolves (four seasons) and Dallas Mavericks (37 games in 2007-08). During his 539-game career he has averaged 6.2 points, 2.8 rebounds and 1.9 assists per game while hitting 44.7 percent of his field goal attempts. Singleton is playing in his first season with the Dallas Mavericks after playing two years with the Los Angeles Clippers. He has seen action in 112 games prior to the 2008-09 season. After finishing his two-year career at Murray

**A Look Back to 2007-08:** For the second consecutive year the Austin Peay Governors claimed the OVC Regular Season Championship but this time around the team completed the sweep and also claimed the tournament crown. After losing in the Tournament Championship Game on a last-second shot in 2007, Austin Peay finished the job and topped Tennessee State 74-54 to claim their fifth OVC Tournament Championship. APSU would go on to play No. 2 seed Texas in the NCAA Tournament, falling to the Longhorns in the game played in Little Rock, Ark. Over the past two seasons the Govs have compiled a 32-8 OVC record. UT Martin guard **Lester Hudson** was named an All-American by several outlets after having an outstanding year. Hudson became the first Division I men's player to record a quadruple-double in a game when he had 25 points, 12 rebounds, 10 assists and 10 steals in a win over Central Baptist College. He also broke the OVC single-season record for 3-pointers made (124) in a season and finished in the Top 100 nationally in each points, rebounds, assists, steals and 3-pointers made/game - the only Division I player to accomplish that feat. He declared for the NBA Draft but decided to return to school following pre-draft workouts. Hudson's teammate **Marquis Weddle** was named to OVC Freshman of the Year while Morehead State's **Donnie Tyndall** took home Coach of the Year honors.

**OVCsports.TV:** For the third consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV Sports allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of conference matchups (excluding only national television games which are not available) on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and has streamed nearly 1,000 events in its first two years, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Packages are available on a yearly, seasonal, monthly or per-event basis.

### OVC Tournament Tiebreaker System

Regular season standings will be the determining factor in setting first-round pairings for the tournament. All ties will be broken starting at the top of the conference standings and working down. The tiebreaking system will utilize the following factors, in order, until all ties are broken.

#### TWO-WAY TIES

- Records in head-to-head competition are compared, with the higher seed going to the team that has won the most games against the other.
- In the event step 1 does not resolve the tie (i.e. if the two teams split their games during the season), then the records of the tying teams against the No. 1 seed shall be compared. The team with the better record against the No. 1 seed shall gain the higher seed.
- If the potential No. 1 seed is among tied teams, the process in step 2 will begin at the highest point in the standings which does not involve a tied team.
- The process continues, through the No. 11 team in the standings, if necessary.
- In the event the tie cannot be broken, seeds will be determined by a coin flip.

#### MULTIPLE TIES

- Composite records between the tying teams will be evaluated to determine whether one team has won more games against the other tying institutions (in which case that team would receive the higher seed) and/or one team has won the least number of games among the tied teams (in which case the team will receive the lowest seed, and/or two teams have the same composite record (in which case the two-team tiebreaker scenario shall be utilized).
- In the event step 1 does not solve the multiple ties, or reduce the multiple ties to one tie, then a comparison of records of the tying institutions against the No. 1 seed will occur. The team among the tying institutions with the better record against the No. 1 seed will receive the higher seed.
- If the potential No. 1 seed is among tied teams, the process in step 2 will begin at the highest point in the standings which does not involve a tied team.
- The process continues, through the No. 11 team in the standings, if necessary.
- In the event this process does not resolve the ties, seeding will be determined by a coin flip.

*Note: If a multiple tie is reduced to a tie between two teams, the two-team tiebreaker formula will then be utilized. Ties involving teams higher in the standings are always broken before ties involving teams lower in the standings.*

### AUSTIN PEAY GOVERNORS (14-11, 10-5)

#### Team Notes

Austin Peay split a pair of games last week to fall to 10-5 in OVC play, which puts them in third place, a half game ahead of fourth place and two games out of first place...The week began with a 86-80 road victory against Tennessee Tech...Drake Reed scored 24 points in that game and also moved into first place on the APSU career free throws attempted list; he needs just four more free throw makes to be first place all-time in that category...In Saturday's 88-80 loss to Tennessee State, Reed added 30 points to become only the fourth player in Governors history to score 1,800 points in a career...For the week Reed averaged 27.0 points and 4.5 rebounds while hitting 53.1 percent (17-of-32) from the field...In the loss to TSU, the Govs shot just 28 percent from the field in the first half in falling to the Tigers in Clarksville for the first time since the 1999 season...TSU did grab 47 rebounds in the game, tied for the most allowed by APSU in a game this season...Overall Austin Peay has lost five games at home this season, the most they have lost at the Dunn Center since the 2004-05 season (they were 7-5 that year)...Austin Peay will play at Jacksonville State on Tuesday and then travel to Drake for the ESPNU BracketBusters matchup on Saturday.

### EASTERN KENTUCKY COLONELS (16-10, 9-6)

#### Team Notes

Eastern Kentucky remained one of the league's hottest teams by winning twice last week to improve to 9-6 in the OVC, which puts them in fifth place (just a half game out of fourth place) with three league games to play...Eastern Kentucky won twice last week and have now won five of its last six and seven of its last nine games overall...Senior guard Mike Rose had another good week, averaging 27.5 points, 3.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals per game while hitting 54.5 percent (18-of-33) from the field and 52.4 percent (11-of-21) from 3-point range...Rose scored 27 points, hitting 5-of-7 3-pointers, as the Colonels topped Southeast Missouri 84-64 on a game seen nationally on ESPNU...In that game EKU trailed 14-5 early but used a 36-10 run the rest of the half to take control of the game...Four other players scored in double figures for EKU, including Jorge Camacho who had 10 points, four rebounds, three assists a block and a steal...Against Eastern Illinois, the Colonels shot 55.6 percent from the field and committed only five turnovers in winning 73-55...Rose added 28 points on 6-of-10 3-point shooting while Justin Stommes added 12...Rose is once again ranked first nationally in 3-point shooting (49.2%)...As a team EKU is second nationally in 3-pointers made (10.5/game), eighth in turnovers (11.2/game) and 10th in 3-point percentage (39.9%)...Eastern Kentucky plays its final two home games of the year this week, hosting league-leading Morehead State on Wednesday and Ohio in ESPNU BracketBusters competition on Saturday.

#### Team Notes

Morehead State continues to be in first place in the OVC as the Eagles won twice last week to improve to 12-3 overall...The Eagles have a half game lead over UT Martin in the Conference standings and those two teams will meet in the last game of the regular season on Feb. 28...The 12 OVC wins equals the team's output from last year, and with one win in the Eagles three remaining OVC games it will be the most wins since 2002-03, then the squad won 13 and shared the OVC regular season championship...The Eagles were led last week by sophomore center Kenneth Faried, who was named OVC Player of the Week...Faried averaged 18.0 points and 15.5 rebounds a game while hitting 58.3 percent (14-of-24) from the field...Faried netted his 16th and 17th double-doubles of the season, which places him fourth in the nation in that category; Faried's 12.9 rebounds per game now places him third nationally...Faried ended the week with a 20-point, 18-rebound performance in the win over Southeast Missouri...Leon Buchanan averaged 17.5 points and 5.5 rebounds per game last week and scored 26 in Saturday's regular season home finale over SMO...Buchanan made 19-of-20 (95%) free throws last week, including 18-of-19 in the Southeast victory...Morehead State ranks seventh nationally in rebounding margin (+7.5)...The Eagles will play their final four games of the regular season on the road, starting Wednesday when they travel to rival Eastern Kentucky...Saturday the team heads to Kent State for an ESPN BracketBusters matchup.
