CO-PLAYER

Jeremy Bynum, G • Jr., 6-3, 185 • Oxford, Ala. • Jacksonville State

Bynum set a Jacksonville State school record by connecting on nine 3-pointers in the Gamecocks 95-78 victory over Norfolk State last week. The nine trifectas was just one 3-pointer short of the OVC single-game record. Bynum hit 9-of-14 (64.3%) from long range in scoring 27 points in the victory. Bynum also pulled down seven rebounds and had an assist in 27 minutes of action. It marks the third straight week that Jacksonville State has had the OVC Player (or Co-Player) of the Week.

CO-PLAYER

Benzor Simmons, F • Jr., 6-5, 215 • Miami, Fla. • UT Martin

Simmons netted his third double-double of the season by scoring a career-high 35 points and grabbing 10 rebounds in the team's road loss to Evansville. After missing his first two field goal attempts of the game, Simmons made his next seven attempts to finish with 19 points in the first half. For the game the junior forward hit on 11-of-18 shots (61.1%) and 11-of-12 free throws (91.7%). Simmons also added a steal and was the only UTM player in double figures in the game. Simmons 20.3 points per game average ranks first in the OVC and 23rd nationally.

NEWCOMER

Trenton Marshall, G/F • Jr., 6-5, 225 • Garyville, La. • Jacksonville State

Marshall was named OVC Newcomer of the Week for the third time this season after netting a double-double in Jacksonville State's 95-78 victory over Norfolk State last week. Marshall scored 16 points and pulled down 10 rebounds to net his first collegiate double-double. Seven of Marshall's 10 rebounds were on the defensive end as the transfer netted a season-high rebound total. Marshall also dished out four assists and had two steals while connecting on 3-of-7 3-point attempts.

Isaiah Canaan, G • Fr., 6-0, 175 • Biloxi, Miss. • Murray State

Canaan earned his second OVC Freshman of the Week honor of the season after averaging 15.5 points, 2.5 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game last week as Murray State lost at Louisiana Tech and defeated Chattanooga at home. He led the Racers in scoring for the week despite coming off the bench in both games. Against Tech, Canaan had 15 points on 4-of-8 shooting, including 6-of-8 from the charity stripe. Canaan also had two rebounds and two assists in that road contest. Against UTC. Canaan hit 6-of-11 shots and scored 16 points to go along with three rebounds, three assists and a steal. For the week he hit 52.6 percent (10-of-16) from the field, 70 percent (7-of-10) from the line and 36.4 percent (4-of-11) from 3-point range.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: OVC teams had another good week of nonconference competition as the league was 7-5 overall last week...Over the past two weeks the OVC is 16-10 against non-conference foes...In the latest set of RPI data from RPIRatings.com, the OVC is ranked 23rd out of 33 Conferences overall, with Austin Peay (53) and Murray State (79) being the highest rated teams; the OVC was 24th in the RPI at the end of the 2008-09 season...One of the highlights on this week's schedule is UT Martin traveling to play Florida State on Dec. 22; FSU is coached by Leonard Hamilton who was the first African-American to play collegiate sports at UT Martin (1971 graduate)...SIU Edwardsville also has a test on Tuesday when they travel to play the No. 4 ranked Purdue Boilermakers.

OVC in the NCAA Stat Leaders: In the latest set of NCAA statistical rankings, three players rank in the top 10 nationally in their respective categories. Morehead State's **Kenneth Faried** in third nationally in rebounding (13.0/game), Jacksonville State's **Nick Murphy** is fourth in field goal percentage (68.3%) and Morehead State's **Brandon Shingles** is sixth in assists (6.3/game). In team rankings, Murray State is third nationally in steals (12.5/game) and fifth in field goal percentage (51.0%) while Eastern Kentucky is fourth in 3-pointers made per game (10.6), fifth in 3-point percentage (43.5%) and sixth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.58).

Murray State Ranked in CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Poll: After its quick start Murray State entered CollegeInsider.com's Mid-Major Poll at No. 23 on Nov. 23. After running its winning streak to five games the Racers climbed to No. 16 and then to No. 13, a spot they have held each of the past two weeks. Austin Peay and Eastern Kentucky were among the other teams receiving votes in the poll. This week's poll was not available at the time this release was finished. Now in its 11th season, the Mid-Major poll is made up of team's from the following conferences: America East, Atlantic Sun, Big Sky, Big South, Big West, Colonial, Great West, Horizon, Independents, Ivy, Metro Atlantic, Mid-American, Mid-Eastern, Missouri Valley, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southern, Southland, Southwestern, Summit, Sun Belt, West Coast. It is voted upon by coaches from those conferences, with one coach per conference casting a vote (Murray State's Billy Kennedy is the OVC rep).

Morehead State's Faried Enters Season as Nation's Leading Returning Rebounder: Morehead State junior Kenneth Faried enters the 2009-10 season as Division I's leading returning rebounder. Faried is now third nationally in rebounding (13.0 rebounds/game). He has five double-doubles in eight total games this season. Last season Faried, the OVC Defensive Player of the Year and OVC Tournament MVP, ranked third nationally in rebounds per game, pulling down 13.0 a contest (that number increased to 13.5 boards per game in OVC games). That trailed only National Player of the Year Blake Griffin (14.4 rebounds/game) and Santa Clara's John Bryant (14.2/game) in the national standings and both of those players have left the college game. Faried had a career-high 24 rebounds in a game against Florida A&M, which was the third most rebounds in a game in Division I last season. Faried also had a 21-rebound game, a 20-rebound game, a 19-rebound game, an 18-rebound outing, five 17-rebound performances and two 16-rebound games in 2008-09.

Loos Becomes All-Time Winningiest Coach in OVC History: With a 68-66 victory at Ohio on Dec. 9, Austin Peay head coach Dave Loos recorded his 320th career victory while in the OVC, a mark that ranks first all-time. Loos passed Cal Luther (319 wins at Murray State and UT Martin) for the all-time mark. Loos, the Dean of OVC coaches, is in his 20th year at Austin Peay where he also serves as the Athletics Director, making him the only Division I head men's basketball coach to hold that distinction. Loos now has 321 victories in his tenure at Austin Peay and 403 for his career.

The 2009-10 Season: The 2009-10 season marks the 62nd of competition in the OVC. Over the previous 61 years, 12 different teams have claimed an OVC regular season championship, including four different schools in the past five years. UT Martin won its first OVC Regular Season Championship in 2008-09.

New Faces: The OVC welcomes three new head coaches to the league this season, the most new faces since the 1991-92 season (that season the new coaches were David Farrar at Middle Tennessee, Dick Fick at Morehead State, Scott Edgar at Murray State and Frankie Allen and Tennessee State). Former Arkansas State head coach Dickey Nutt takes over at Southeast Missouri State, John Cooper, lastly the associate head coach at Auburn, is the new man in charge at Tennessee State and Jason James is UT Martin's new head coach after previously serving as an assistant coach at the school. James (32) is the third youngest coach at the Division I level, trailing only IPFW's Dane Fife (30 years old) and Fordham interim coach Jared Grasso (29) who took over that program during the season (on Dec. 3).

OVC Tournament to Be Held at Sommet Center for 11th Time and in Nashville For 16th Time in 17 Years: The 2010 OVC Basketball Tournament will be held at the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville for the 11th time this season. The event was first held there in 1997 (marking the first basketball event in the venue) and has been held there

During the regular season a bi-weekly teleconference featuring the league's 10 head coaches will be held on Tuesday mornings at 10 a.m. Central Time. The initial teleconference will take place on Wednesday, Dec. 2. 2010 OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 2, 5-6. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 2. Those games can be seen live on OVCSports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 5 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPNU with the championship game on Saturday, March 6 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 5 (televised on OVCSports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 6 at a time to be announced.

This marks the 16th time in 17 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and 11th time the event has been held at the Sommet Center.

every year since with the exceptions of 2002, 2004 and 2008. Last year the men's final went two overtimes with Morehead State finally topping Austin Peay when Steve Peterson hit his only bucket of the game with 1.4 seconds left in the second overtime. Overall this year will mark the 16th time in the last 17 years the tournament has been held in Nashville (with 2002 being the only year in that stretch the event was not in Music City).

Westwood One to Broadcast OVC Championship Game: For the first time this season, the 2010 Men's Basketball Championship game will be broadcast by the Westwood One radio network, the largest provider of audio content in America. Westwood One is one of the nation's largest providers of network radio programming and one of the largest domestic providers of traffic information in the U.S. Westwood One serves more than 5,000 radio and 170 TV stations in the U.S. Westwood One provides over 150 news, sports, music, talk and entertainment programs, features and live events to numerous media partners. Westwood One is home of the most prestigious sports broadcasts on radio. Westwood One's lineup includes regular season NFL football, the Playoffs and the Super Bowl; NCAA Football and Basketball including the Final Four; College World Series; Frozen Four; the Olympics; the Masters and more. Through its Metro Traffic division, Westwood One provides traffic reporting and local news, sports and weather to approximately 2,300 radio and TV stations. Westwood One also provides digital and other cross-platform delivery of its network and Metro content.

Morehead State and Murray State Picked as Preseason Co-Favorites: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head men's basketball coaches and sports information directors, Morehead State and Murray State each received 10 first-place votes and were picked as co-favorites for the 2009-10 season. Morehead State finished last season 12-6 in league play (4th place) and went on to win the OVC Tournament Championship. Murray State was tied for second overall last season with a 13-5 record and lost in the OVC Tournament semifinals. It marks the 13th time in the last 21 years that Murray State has been picked the preseason favorite and second year in a row. Morehead State is tabbed first for the first time since the 1983-84 season (when they went 25-6 and won the OVC regular season and tournament championships). It marks just the third time since 1980-81 (when preseason polls were first available) that co-favorites have been picked in the preseason poll (it also happened in 1991-92 and 1994-95). Morehead State and Murray State each received 154 points and were followed next by Austin Peay who had 114 total points. Eastern Illinois was picked fourth (105 points) and followed by Eastern Kentucky (93), Jacksonville State (86), Tennessee Tech (76), UT Martin (55), Tennessee State (44) and Southeast Missouri State (19).

Preseason Predictions: Is being picked the preseason favorite, always a good thing? Over the past 30 years of preseason polls that were available, the league's head coaches and sports information directors correctly pick the eventual OVC regular season champion 60 percent of the time, picking the correct winner 18 times over the last 30 years. Over the past 10 years, the preseason poll has correctly picked the winner every other year. Last season the poll tabbed Murray State the favorite, although the Racers finished second to UT Martin, who won its first-ever OVC Championship a year ago.

Morehead State's Faried Tabbed as Preseason Player of the Year: The 2009-10 All-OVC Preseason Men's Basketball team was headlined by Morehead State junior center Kenneth Faried. Faried is coming off a season where he was named OVC Defensive Player of the Year and OVC Tournament MVP. Overall six different schools were represented on the team with Murray State's three selections leading the way. Eastern Illinois and Morehead State each had two selections while Austin Peay, Eastern Kentucky and Tennessee State had one player apiece on the squad. The team features just one player (Faried) who was a first-team All-OVC selection last season. The team does have three second-team All-OVC picks from 2008-09 and two players who were on last season's All-Newcomer Team. Faried made a splash last season being named the Conference's first OVC Defensive Player of the Year after ranking third nationally in rebounding (13.0/game), 52nd nationally in blocked shots (1.9/ game) and 69th nationally in steals (1.9/game). Faried also added 13.9 points per game and connected on 55.6 percent of his field goal attempts (36th nationally). The 6-8 native of Newark, N.J. also tallied 25 double-doubles, which was the second most nationally, trailing only National Player of the Year Blake Griffin (29). Austin Peay's

Wesley Channels, Eastern Illinois' Romain Martin and Murray State's Danero Thomas were each second-team All-OVC picks last season and are each on the preseason team this year. Murray State's Ivan Aska and Isacc Miles were two of the five All-OVC Newcomer selections in 2008-09 who are also on this year's All-OVC preseason squad. The Preseason All-OVC team is rounded out by Tennessee State's Darius Cox, Eastern Illinois' Tyler Laser, Morehead State's Maze Stallworth and Eastern Kentucky's Justin Stommes.

OVC Scores First NCAA Tournament Win in 20 Years; Places Three Teams in Postseason in 2008-09: With its 58-43 win over Alabama State in the NCAA Tournament Opening Round game in Dayton last March, Morehead State snapped a 19-year losing streak in the NČAA Tournament for teams from the Ohio Valley Conference. It marked the first NCAA Tournament victory since Middle Tennessee State beat Florida State 97-83 in Nashville in 1989. The Eagles were then defeated by No. 1 overall seed Louisville in the first round. The year also marked the first time since 1987 (when Austin Peay and Middle Tennessee were in the NCAA Tournament and Akron was in the NIT) that three OVC schools had participated in the postseason in the same year. In addition to Morehead State playing in the NCAA Tournament, UT Martin was in the NIT and Austin Peay played in the inaugural CollegeInsider.com Tournament.

OVC Players in the Pros: As of October 2009, there are three former OVC players on NBA rosters. Those three players are Austin Peay's Trenton Hassell (New Jersey Nets), Murray State's James Singleton (Dallas Mavericks) and UT Martin's Lester Hudson (Boston Celtics). Hassel is in his ninth season in the NBA and third with the Nets. He also played with the Chicago Bulls (who drafted him 30th overall in the 2001 Draft and where he played two seasons), Minnesota Timberwolves (four seasons) and Dallas Mavericks (37 games in 2007-08). During his 592-game career he has averaged 5.9 points, 2.8 rebounds and 1.8 assists per game while hitting 44.7 percent of his field goal attempts. After being undrafted out of college (2003), Singleton played overseas before being signed by the Los Angeles Clippers before the 2005-06 season and played two seasons there before signing with Dallas in 2008-09. In his 174game career, Singleton has averaged 3.5 points and 3.2 rebounds per game while hitting 49.3 percent of his shots. Hudson won the last two OVC Player of the Year awards before being drafted by the Boston Celtics in the second round (pick No. 58) of the 2009 NBA Draft. Hudson signed a one-year unguaranteed contact after his play in the NBA Summer League with the team.

All 11 OVC Teams to Participate in ESPN BracketBusters For Fifth Straight Year: All 11 OVC schools will participate in the ESPN BracketBusters series for the fifth straight season in 2009-10. Now it its eighth year, ESPN BracketBusters is an ESPN television property that was tremendously successful with its first seven events in February of 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009. The event has allowed Division I conferences to participate in a cutting-edge format that involves "wild card" pairings from the pool of participating teams, with half of the ESPNU BracketBusters teams pre-designated as "home" and the remaining half as "road" teams. OVC schools are 16-29 all-time in the event, including a 3-7 mark a season ago. Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Eastern Kentucky, Jacksonville State and Murray State will all be home teams in the series this year while Morehead State, Southeast Missouri, SIU Edwardsville, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin will all go on the road. The 2010 matchups will be announced on Feb. 1, 2010.

Replay Systems for OVC Basketball Venues Enter Year Three: On Dec. 21, 2007, the Ohio Valley Conference mandated the use of courtside replay systems at all OVC basketball venues. The systems were put into place in January 2008 and have been used since. The systems are used in situations that are outlined by NCAA rules.

SIU Edwardsville Continues Reclassification Process to Division I: On July 1, 2008 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, III., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States.

OVCSports.TV: For the fourth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCSports.TV. The venture with JumpTV Sports allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of conference matchups (excluding only national television games which are not available) on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and has streamed over 1,000 events in its first three years, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball events and OVC Championship events. Packages are available on a yearly, seasonal, monthly or per-event basis.
