THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

Kenneth Faried, C • Jr., 6-8, 225 • Newark, N.J. • Morehead State

Faried earned his fifth OVC Player of the Week honor of the season (and third in the past four weeks) after averaging 19.0 points, 14.0 rebounds, 2.0 blocks and 2.0 steals/game in a pair of Morehead State victories. Faried had 26 points (one off his career-high) and 17 rebounds in the Eagles win over Tennessee Tech on Saturday. He hit 7-of-10 from the field, 12-of-17 from the free throw line and added two blocks and two steals. The junior began the week with a 12-point, 11-rebound effort against Jacksonville State, as he was limited to only 20 minutes of play due to foul trouble. The two double-doubles increased his season total to 18, which is second nationally. Faried still leads the nation in rebounding average (13.7).

NEWCOMER

B.J. Jenkins, G • Jr., 6-0, 205 • Virginia Beach, Va. • Murray State

Jenkins averaged 13.5 points, 3.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 3.0 steals/game last week as Murray State won two games to increase its win total to 13-straight. Jenkins had a team-high 17 points while adding five rebounds, two assists and three steals in Thursday's win over Tennessee State. In a two-point victory over Austin Peay on Saturday, Jenkins added 10 points, two rebounds, five assists and three steals. For the week he connected on 45.5 percent (10-of-22) of his shots from the field and 33.3 percent (5-of-15) from 3-point range.

FRESHMAN

Jud Dillard, G • Fr., 6-4, 180 • Riverdale, Ga. • Tennessee Tech

Dillard earned his third Freshman of the Week honor of the season (and second in the last three weeks) after averaging 17.0 points and 7.5 rebounds/game last week. Dillard also hit 57.1 percent (12-of-21) from the field and recorded three assists and two steals. Making his first start of the season against Morehead State, Dillard had his first double-double of his career, finishing with 25 points and 12 rebounds. He hit 9-of-12 shots in that game, had two assists and two steals and five of his 12 rebounds came on the offensive end. Against Eastern Kentucky, Dillard had nine points and three rebounds.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: There are just three weekends of play left before the 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Tournament, which will be held at the Sommet Center in Nashville (March 5-6)...Murray State continues to be the leader, as the Racers are undefeated (13-0) following a buzzer-beating victory over Austin Peay on Saturday...Murray State has clinched a first round home game in the OVC Tournament (March 2)...The Racers have won 20-straight OVC regular season games, just five off the all-time record held by Western Kentucky (1965-67)...Morehead State is just two games behind the Racers but will play three of its final five OVC games at home, including hosting Murray State the last weekend of the season...The Eagles can clinch a first round home game with one victory this week...Eastern Kentucky (9-5) and Austin Peay (8-5) are in third and fourth place in the league respectively and have clinched at least a spot in the eight-team OVC Tournament field...After the top four things are bunched a little tighter, as Eastern Illinois, Jacksonville State and Tennessee Tech are all tied for fifth place...Southeast Missouri State, Tennessee State and UT Martin are each fighting for the final spot in the field...Kenneth Faried continues to lead the nation in rebounding (13.7/game); he was named OVC Player of the Week for the fifth time this season after averaging 19.0 points and 14.0 rebounds/game in two Eagle victories...Faried will have a chance to play in front of a national audience on Thursday night when the Morehead State/Eastern Illinois game is televised on ESPNU.

Murray State Conference Winning Streak Ranks Fourth in OVC History: With two more OVC wins last week, Murray State increased its OVC winning streak to 20 games dating back to last season. The Racers have won 13 OVC games this season, and last lost to an OVC foe in the regular season on Feb. 7, 2009 (83-80 at Austin Peay). The 20-game OVC winning streak is fourth longest in league history.

Morehead State's Faried Ranks 1st Nationally in Rebounding: Morehead State junior **Kenneth Faried** entered the 2009-10 season as Division I's leading returning rebounder and is first nationally in rebounding (13.7 rebounds/game) this year. That number is 15.3 rebounds per game in 13 Conference games this season. He also has 18 double-doubles in 24 total games this season (which ranks second nationally behind Radford's Artsiom Parakhouski who has 19). Faried had a season-high 21 rebounds in a road win over Tennessee State on Jan. 28. He has also had a 19-rebound game, an 18-rebound game, a 17-rebound game, four 16-rebound games and four 15-rebound games in 2009-10. He is also one of seven Division I players to have a 20/20 game this season (23 points, 21 rebounds against Tennessee State). Last season Faried, the OVC Defensive Player of the Year and OVC Tournament MVP, ranked third nationally in rebounds per game, pulling down 13.0 a contest (that number increased to 13.5 boards per game in OVC games). That trailed only National Player of the Year Blake Griffin (14.4 rebounds/game) and Santa Clara's John Bryant (14.2/game) in the national standings and both of those players have left the college game. Faried had a career-high 24 rebounds in a game against Florida A&M, which was the third most rebounds in a game in Division I last season.

Pairings Announced for ESPN BracketBusters Series: All 11 OVC schools will participate in the ESPN BracketBusters series for the fifth straight season in 2009-10. The 2010 matchups were announced on Feb. 1 and can be found below. Murray State was picked for a TV game with Morgan State, the fourth time an OVC school has been picked for a TV game, and first since 2007. Now it's eighth year, ESPN BracketBusters is an ESPN television property that was tremendously successful with its first seven events. The event has allowed Division I conferences to participate in a cutting-edge format that involves "wild card" pairings from the pool of participating teams, with half of the ESPN BracketBusters teams pre-designated as "home" and the remaining half as "road" teams. OVC schools are 16-29 all-time in the event, including a 3-7 mark a season ago. The games will be played on Feb. 19-20 this year.

Murray State Reaches 20 Victories Third Quickest Nationally: With its win over UT Martin on Jan. 30, Murray State became just the third team nationally to reach 20 wins, trailing only BYU and Syracuse. The 20-win season is the 23rd for Murray State all-time.

2010 OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 2, 5-6. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 2. Those games can be seen live on OVCSports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 5 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPNU with the championship game on Saturday, March 6 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 5 (televised on OVCSports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 6 at a time to be announced.

This marks the 16th time in 17 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and 11th time the event has been held at the Sommet Center.

Murray State Ranked in CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Poll: After its quick start Murray State entered CollegeInsider.com's Mid-Major Poll at No. 23 on Nov. 23. The Racers are now seventh nationally, the highest they have been this season. Morehead State is currently among the other teams receiving votes in the poll (this week's poll was not available at release time). Now in its 11th season, the Mid-Major poll is made up of team's from the following conferences: America East, Atlantic Sun, Big Sky, Big South, Big West, Colonial, Great West, Horizon, Independents, Ivy, Metro Atlantic, Mid-American, Mid-Eastern, Missouri Valley, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southern, Southland, Southwestern, Summit, Sun Belt, West Coast. It is voted upon by coaches from those conferences, with one coach per conference casting a vote (Murray State's Billy Kennedy is the OVC representative).

Home Court Winning Streaks: Eastern Kentucky saw its school-record 19-game home winning streak come to an end on Jan. 23 with a loss to Morehead State. It was the first at home for the Colonels since December 4, 2008 (58-50 to Murray State). The streak was the sixth-longest nationally when it came to an end. Murray State now has the longest home court winning streak in the OVC at 16 games. That streak currently ranks 10th nationally. The Racers will next play at home on Feb. 16 against Southeast Missouri. Kansas has the nation's longest home court winning streak (55).

The OVC Among the NCAA Statistical Leaders: In the latest set of NCAA statistical leaders, Murray State ranks second nationally in field goal percentage (50.8%), second in scoring margin (+18.4) and second in steals/game (11.0). Eastern Kentucky is second nationally in 3-pointers made/game (10.2), ninth in 3-point percentage (40.6%), third in assist-to-turnover ratio (+1.57) and third in fewest turnovers/game (10.0). Morehead State ranks fourth in rebound margin (+9.5) while Tennessee Tech is fifth in 3-point percentage (41.6%). Individually, Morehead State's **Kenneth Faried** is first nationally in rebounding (13.7/game) and second in double-doubles (18) while Tennessee Tech's **Frank Davis** is third in 3-point percentage (47.9%).

Channels An All-Around Consistent Performer: Looking at the list of OVC active leaders in five of the major statistical categories, the name of Austin Peay senior guard **Wesley Channels** keeps popping up. In his solid four-year career Channels has been one of the top all-around performers in the league. The Memphis, Tenn. native currently ranks first among active players in scoring (1,562), first in assists (300), second in steals (157), fourth in 3-pointers made (207) and eighth in rebounds (408).

Loos Becomes All-Time Winningest Coach in OVC History: With a 68-66 victory at Ohio on Dec. 9, Austin Peay head coach **Dave Loos** recorded his 320th career victory while in the OVC, a mark that ranks first all-time. Loos passed Cal Luther (319 wins at Murray State and UT Martin) for the all-time mark. Loos, the Dean of OVC coaches, is in his 20th year at Austin Peay where he also serves as the Athletics Director, making him the only Division I head men's basketball coach to hold that distinction. Loos now has 328 victories in his tenure at Austin Peay and 410 for his career.

Faried Named Midseason Mid-Major All-American by Sporting News: Sporting News writer Mike DeCourcy named Morehead State's **Kenneth Faried** as one of his five mid-season mid-major All-Americans. DeCourcy called Faried the "nation's best rebounder" and that he "chases rebounds with an attitude." Faried was joined by Butler's Gordon Hayward, Saint Mary's Omar Samhan, Radford's Artsiom Parakhouski and Cornell's Ryan Wittman on the team.

OVC Tournament to Be Held at Sommet Center for 11th Time and in Nashville For 16th Time in 17 Years: The 2010 OVC Basketball Tournament will be held at the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville for the 11th time this season. The event was first held there in 1997 (marking the first basketball event in the venue) and has been held there every year since with the exceptions of 2002, 2004 and 2008. Last year the men's final went two overtimes with Morehead State finally topping Austin Peay when Steve Peterson hit his only bucket of the game with 1.4 seconds left in the second overtime. Overall this year will mark the 16th time in the last 17 years the tournament has been held in Nashville (with 2002 being the only year in that stretch

Westwood One to Broadcast OVC Championship Game: For the first time this season, the 2010 Men's Basketball Championship game will be broadcast by the Westwood One radio network, the largest provider of audio content in America. Westwood One is one of the nation's largest providers of network radio programming and one of the largest domestic providers of traffic information in the U.S. Westwood One serves more than 5,000 radio and 170 TV stations in the U.S. Westwood One provides over 150 news, sports, music, talk and entertainment programs, features and live events to numerous media partners. Westwood One is home of the most prestigious sports broadcasts on radio. Westwood One's lineup includes regular season NFL football, the Playoffs and the Super Bowl; NCAA Football and Basketball including the Final Four; College World Series; Frozen Four; the Olympics; the Masters and more. Through its Metro Traffic division, Westwood One provides traffic reporting and local news, sports and weather to approximately 2,300 radio and TV stations. Westwood One also provides digital and other cross-platform delivery of its network and Metro content.

Hudson and Domercant Named to CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major All-Decade Team: Two Ohio Valley Conference players were among the 26 players selected to the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major All-Decade Team. Former UT Martin guard **Lester Hudson** and former Eastern Illinois forward **Henry Domercant** were on the squad released on Jan. 3. Hudson (2007-09) was a two-time All-American and OVC Player of the Year at UT Martin and became the first Division I men's player to record a quadruple-double in a game. He was drafted by the Boston Celtics in the second round of the 2009 NBA Draft. Domercant's 2,602 career points are the most in OVC history (and No. 26 all-time in NCAA history) and he finished in the top five in the nation in scoring three times. Division I coaches and NBA scouts were part of the selection process but the final decision was made by the CollegeInsider.com staff.

The 2009-10 Season: The 2009-10 season marks the 62nd of competition in the OVC. Over the previous 61 years, 12 different teams have claimed an OVC regular season championship, including four different schools in the past five years. UT Martin won its first OVC Regular Season Championship in 2008-09.

OVC Players in the Pros: There are three former OVC players on NBA rosters. Those three players are Austin Peay's **Trenton Hassell** (New Jersey Nets), Murray State's **James Singleton** (Dallas Mavericks) and UT Martin's **Lester Hudson** (Memphis Grizzlies). Hassell is in his ninth season in the NBA and third with the Nets. He also played with the Chicago Bulls (who drafted him 30th overall in the 2001 Draft and where he played two seasons), Minnesota Timberwolves (four seasons) and Dallas Mavericks (37 games in 2007-08). During his 592-game career he has averaged 5.9 points, 2.8 rebounds and 1.8 assists per game while hitting 44.7 percent of his field goal attempts. After being undrafted out of college (2003), Singleton played overseas before being signed by the Los Angeles Clippers before the 2005-06 season and played two seasons there before signing with Dallas in 2008-09. In his 174-game career, Singleton has averaged 3.5 points and 3.2 rebounds per game while hitting 49.3 percent of his shots. Hudson won the last two OVC Player of the Year awards before being drafted by the Boston Celtics in the second round (pick No. 58) of the 2009 NBA Draft. Hudson signed a one-year unguaranteed contract after his play in the NBA Summer League with the team. He appeared in 16 games with the Celtics until being waived in January; that same week he was signed by his hometown Memphis Grizzlies. Another UT Martin product, **Jared Newson**, is currently in the NBDL, playing for the Bakersfield Jam.

Morehead State and Murray State Picked as Preseason Co-Favorites: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head men's basketball coaches and sports information directors, **Morehead State** and **Murray State** each received 10 first-place votes and were picked as co-favorites for the 2009-10 season. Morehead State finished last season 12-6 in league play (4th place) and went on to win the OVC Tournament Championship. Murray State was tied for second overall last season with a 13-5 record and lost in the OVC Tournament semifinals. It marks the 13th time in the last 21 years that Murray State has been picked the preseason favorite and second year in a row. Morehead State is tabbed first for the first time since the 1983-84 season (when they went 25-6 and won the OVC regular season and tournament championships). It marks just the third time since 1980-81 (when preseason polls were first available) that co-favorites have been picked in the preseason poll (it also happened in 1991-92 and 1994-95). Morehead State and Murray State each received 154 points and were followed next by **Austin Peay** who had 114 total points. **Eastern Illinois** was picked fourth (105 points) and followed by **Eastern Kentucky** (93), **Jacksonville State** (86), **Tennessee Tech** (76), **UT Martin** (55), **Tennessee State** (44) and **Southeast Missouri State** (19).

Preseason Predictions: Is being picked the preseason favorite, always a good thing? Over the past 30 years of preseason polls that were available, the league's head coaches and sports information directors correctly pick the eventual OVC regular season champion 60 percent of the time, picking the correct winner 18 times over the last 30 years. Over the past 10 years, the preseason poll has correctly picked the winner every other year. Last season the poll tabbed Murray State the favorite, although the Racers finished second to UT Martin, who won its first-ever OVC Championship a year ago.

Morehead State's Faried Tabbed as Preseason Player of the Year: The 2009-10 All-OVC Preseason Men's Basketball team was headlined by Morehead State junior center **Kenneth Faried**. Faried is coming off a season where he was named OVC Defensive Player of the Year and OVC Tournament MVP. Overall six different schools were represented on the team with Murray State's three selections leading the way. Eastern Illinois and Morehead State each had two selections while Austin Peay, Eastern Kentucky and Tennessee State had one player apiece on the squad. The team features just one player (Faried) who was a first-team All-OVC selection last season. The team does have three second-team All-OVC picks from 2008-09 and two players who were on last season's All-Newcomer Team. Faried made a splash last season being named the Conference's first OVC Defensive Player of the Year after ranking third nationally in rebounding (13.0/game), 52nd nationally in blocked shots (1.9/game) and 69th nationally in steals (1.9/game). Faried also added 13.9 points per game and connected on 55.6 percent of his field goal attempts (36th nationally). The 6-8 native of Newark, N.J. also tallied 25 double-doubles, which was the second most nationally, trailing only National Player of the Year Blake Griffin (29). Austin Peay's **Wesley Channels**, Eastern Illinois' **Romain Martin** and Murray State's **Danero Thomas** were each second-team All-OVC picks last season and are each on the preseason team this year. Murray State's **Ivan Aska** and **Isacc Miles** were two of the five All-OVC Newcomer selections in 2008-09 who are also on this year's All-OVC preseason squad. The Preseason All-OVC team is rounded out by Tennessee State's **Darius Cox**, Eastern Illinois' **Tyler Laser**, Morehead State's **Maze Stallworth** and Eastern Kentucky's **Justin Stommes**.

Coaches vs. Cancer Suits and Sneakers Awareness Weekend Was Jan. 29-31: Coaches vs. Cancer® Suits and Sneakers awareness weekend, a collaborative initiative of the American Cancer Society and the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC), was held the weekend of Jan. 29-31, 2010. Participating NABC member coaches wore sneakers instead of dress shoes with their suits during weekend games to demonstrate their support for the American Cancer Society and its vision of a world with less cancer and more birthdays. Basketball fans were also encouraged to wear sneakers to games that weekend to show their support. By lacing up sneakers with their suits, college and high school basketball coaches nationwide will spotlight the fact that while cancer remains a major health concern, everyone can take daily steps to reduce their risk of the disease.

New Faces: The OVC welcomes three new head coaches to the league this season, the most new faces since the 1991-92 season (that season the new coaches were David Farrar at Middle Tennessee, Dick Fick at Morehead State, Scott Edgar at Murray State and Frankie Allen and Tennessee State). Former Arkansas State head coach **Dickey Nutt** takes over at Southeast Missouri State, **John Cooper**, lastly the associate head coach at Auburn, is the new man in charge at Tennessee State and **Jason James** is UT Martin's new head coach after previously serving as an assistant coach at the school. James (32) is the third youngest coach at the Division I level, trailing only IPFW's Dane Fife (30 years old) and Fordham interim coach Jared Grasso (29) who took over that program during the season (on Dec. 3).

OVC Scores First NCAA Tournament Win in 20 Years; Places Three Teams in Postseason in 2008-09: With its 58-43 win over Alabama State in the NCAA Tournament Opening Round game in Dayton last March, Morehead State snapped a 19-year losing streak in the NCAA Tournament for teams from the Ohio Valley Conference. It marked the first NCAA Tournament victory since Middle Tennessee State beat Florida State 97-83 in Nashville in 1989. The Eagles were then defeated by No. 1 overall seed Louisville in the first round. The year also marked the first time since 1987 (when Austin Peay and Middle Tennessee were in the NCAA Tournament and Akron was in the NIT) that three OVC schools had participated in the postseason in the same year. In addition to Morehead State playing in the NCAA Tournament, UT Martin was in the NIT and Austin Peay played in the inaugural CollegeInsider.com Tournament.

Replay Systems for OVC Basketball Venues Enter Year Three: On Dec. 21, 2007, the Ohio Valley Conference mandated the use of courtside replay systems at all OVC basketball venues. The systems were put into place in January 2008 and have been used since. The systems are used in situations that are outlined by NCAA rules.

SIU Edwardsville Continues Reclassification Process to Division I: On July 1, 2008 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, Ill., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States).

OVCsports.TV: For the fourth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV Sports allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of conference matchups (excluding only national television games which are not available) on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and has streamed over 1,000 events in its first three years, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball events and OVC Championship events. Packages are available on a yearly, seasonal, monthly or per-event basis.

Morehead State won two more games last week to improve to 17-7 overall and 11-2 in the OVC, two games behind Murray State for first place...The Eagles have now won 13 of its last 14 games overall with the lone loss being a one-pointer at Austin Peay...Kenneth Faried continued to dominate the glass and earned his fifth OVC Player of the Week honor of the season after averaging 19.0 points and 14.0 rebounds/game...Faried hit 66.7 percent (12-of-18) from the field and also averaged 2.0 steals and 2.0 blocks a game...Faried had 26 points (one off his career-high) and 17 rebounds in the win over Tennessee Tech and 12 points and 11 rebounds in just 20 minutes against Jacksonville State...Faried still leads the nation in rebounding (13.7/game) and is second in double-doubles (18)...Senior Maze Stallworth became the Eagles all-time leader in 3-pointers made and attempts, breaking the mark of former NBA player Ricky Minard...Stallworth now has 245 made 3-pointers (9th most in OVC history) and 666 attempts (7th most in OVC history)...MSU is fourth nationally in rebounding margin (+9.5)...Steve Peterson, the hero of last year's OVC Tournament Championship game, had a career-high 20 points in the win over Tech, while Brandon Shingles scored a career-high 13...Shingles continues to lead the OVC in assists (5.3/game)...The Eagles play their last two road OVC games of the season this week, traveling to Eastern Illinois (Thursday, ESPNU) and Southeast Missouri (Saturday).
