THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

Kenneth Faried, C • Jr., 6-8, 225 • Newark, N.J. • Morehead State

Faried averaged 17.0 points and 15.5 rebounds per game last week as Morehead State won a pair of games to extend its winning streak to eight games overall. The junior center hit 52.2 percent (12-of-23) from the field and also had three blocks and two steals as the Eagles are now 7-1 in OVC competition. Faried had a double-double in each contest to raise his season total to 12. In a 40-point victory over Southeast Missouri, Faried had 12 points and 16 rebounds to go along with three blocks. In a 22-point win over Eastern Illinois, Faried had 22 points, 15 rebounds and two steals while going 8-of-10 at the free throw line. Faried increased his season rebounding average to 13.1/game, which is now first nationally. This marks the third time this season Faried has been named OVC Player of the Week.

CO-NEWCOMER

B.J. Jenkins, G • Jr., 6-0, 205 • Virginia Beach, Va. • Murray State

Jenkins averaged 12.3 points, 3.7 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 3.0 steals per game last week as Murray State won three games to improve to an OVC-best 8-0 in Conference play (and 16-3 overall). The junior scored 14 points, had six rebounds, five assists and four steals in a victory over Eastern Illinois to start the week. Against Jacksonville State Jenkins had 19 points, three assists and three steals. To finish the week, he had four points, four rebounds, and three steals against Tennessee Tech. For the week Jenkins hit 43.8 percent (7-of-16) from 3-point range and was perfect (10-of-10) at the free throw line. This marks the third OVC Newcomer of the Week award of the season for Jenkins, a transfer from Liberty.

CO-NEWCOMER

Josh Sain, F • Jr., 6-5, 200 • Jackson, Tenn. • Tennessee State

Sain, who earned his fourth OVC Newcomer Award of the season, averaged 19.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 2.5 steals per game as Tennessee State lost two close road games last week. He hit 42.4 percent (14-of-33) from the field and 43.8 percent (7-of-16) from 3-point range. In a five-point loss at Iowa, Sain scored 19 points while hitting 4-of-9 from 3-point range. In a two-point loss at Austin Peay, the junior added 20 points, eight rebounds, two assists and a steal.

FRESHMAN

Jacquan Nobles, G • Fr., 6-4, 190 • Greenville, N.C. • Tennessee State

In two close road losses for Tennessee State last week, Nobles averaged 17.0 points and 2.0 rebounds per game while hitting 47.8 percent (11-of-23) from the field and 43.8 percent (7-of-16) from 3-point range. In a five-point loss at Iowa, Nobles hit a trio of 3-pointers and scored 14 points. In a two-point loss at Austin Peay in a nationally-televised game, Nobles had a game-high 20 points by hitting on 4-of-8 3-pointers. the freshman guard came off the bench in that game with his team trailing 20-9 and helped lead the team to a 33-18 run that saw the Tigers go up by four (42-38) at halftime.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: The top of the OVC standings kept winning last week as Murray State won three times to improve to 8-0 in Conference play, Morehead State won both of its games to stay a game back at 7-1 and Eastern Kentucky won twice and is now 6-2 overall...Murray State has now won seven games overall in a row and is 16-3 overall on the year...Morehead State has an eight-game winning streak and is now 12-6 after a 4-6 start...Eastern Kentucky improved to 10-0 at home this year and extended its home-court winning streak to 18 games, a new school record; the Colonels' winning streak is the seventh-longest home court streak nationally...One streak will end on Saturday when Morehead State travels to Richmond to battle Eastern Kentucky...Morehead State's Kenneth Faried recorded his 12th double-double of the year and increased his season rebounding average to 13.1 boards/game, which is now ranked first nationally.

OVC in the NCAA Stat Leaders: In the latest set of NCAA statistical rankings (released last Friday, new statistical leaders will not be released until Tuesday afternoon), Murray State ranks fifth nationally in field goal percentage (50.5%), eighth in scoring margin (+17.7) and fourth in steals (11.3/game). Eastern Kentucky is second nationally in 3-pointers made per game (10.1), fourth in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.53) and sixth in fewest turnovers per game (10.6). Individually, Morehead State's **Kenneth Faried** ranks first in rebounding (13.1/game) and fourth in double-doubles (10). Tennessee Tech senior guard **Frank Davis** now ranks fourth in 3-point percentage (50.5%).

Murray State Ranked in CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Poll: After its quick start Murray State entered CollegeInsider.com's Mid-Major Poll at No. 23 on Nov. 23. After running its winning streak to five games the Racers climbed to No. 16 and then as high as No. 13; the team is at No. 14 this week (up from No. 17) after winning three games last week. Also this week Morehead State and Eastern Kentucky are among the other teams receiving votes in the poll. This week's poll (Jan. 18) was not available at release time. Now in its 11th season, the Mid-Major poll is made up of team's from the following conferences: America East, Atlantic Sun, Big Sky, Big South, Big West, Colonial, Great West, Horizon, Independents, Ivy, Metro Atlantic, Mid-American, Mid-Eastern, Missouri Valley, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southern, Southland, Southwestern, Summit, Sun Belt, West Coast. It is voted upon by coaches from those conferences, with one coach per conference casting a vote (Murray State's Billy Kennedy is the OVC rep).

Morehead State's Faried is Nation's Leading Returning Rebounder; Currently Ranks 1st This Season: Morehead State junior **Kenneth Faried** entered the 2009-10 season as Division I's leading returning rebounder. Faried is now first nationally in rebounding (13.1 rebounds/game) after this past weekend's games. He also has 12 double-doubles in 18 total games this season. Faried had a season-high 19 rebounds in an overtime win over Austin Peay on Jan. 2; he has also had an 18-rebound game, a 16-rebound game and four 15-rebound games in 2009-10. Last season Faried, the OVC Defensive Player of the Year and OVC Tournament MVP, ranked third nationally in rebounds per game, pulling down 13.0 a contest (that number increased to 13.5 boards per game in OVC games). That trailed only National Player of the Year Blake Griffin (14.4 rebounds/game) and Santa Clara's John Bryant (14.2/game) in the national standings and both of those players have left the college game. Faried had a career-high 24 rebounds in a game against Florida A&M, which was the third most rebounds in a game in Division I last season. Faried also had a 21-rebound game, a 20-rebound game, a 19-rebound game, an 18-rebound outing, five 17-rebound performances and two 16-rebound games in 2008-09.

EKU's Home Court Winning Streak Ranks 7th Nationally: With two victories over the weekend Eastern Kentucky increased its winning streak at McBrayer Arena to 18 games, the longest streak in EKU history. The Colonels have not lost at home since December 4, 2008 (58-50 to Murray State). The 18-game winning streak ranks seventh nationally, trailing Kansas (52), Missouri (30), Pitt (30), Siena (30), Dayton (29) and Tulsa (20).

Channels An All-Around Consistent Performer: Looking at the list of OVC active leaders in five of the major statistical categories, the name of Austin Peay senior guard **Wesley Channels** keeps popping up. In his solid four-year career Channels has been one of the top all-around performers in the league. The Memphis, Tenn. native currently ranks first among active players in scoring (1,457), first in assists (277), second in steals (149), fifth in 3-pointers made (191) and ninth in rebounds (377).

By lacing up sneakers with their suits, college and high school basketball coaches nationwide will spotlight the fact that while cancer remains a major health concern, everyone can take daily steps

2010 OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 2, 5-6. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 2. Those games can be seen live on OVCSports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 5 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPN2 with the championship game on Saturday, March 6 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 5 (televised on OVCSports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 6 at a time to be announced.

This marks the 16th time in 17 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and 11th time the event has been held at the Sommet Center.

Hudson and Domercant Named to CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major All-Decade Team: Two Ohio Valley Conference players were among the 26 players selected to the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major All-Decade Team. Former UT Martin guard **Lester Hudson** and former Eastern Illinois forward **Henry Domercant** were on the squad released on Jan. 3. Hudson (2007-09) was a two-time All-American and OVC Player of the Year at UT Martin and became the first Division I men's player to record a quadruple-double in a game. He was drafted by the Boston Celtics in the second round of the 2009 NBA Draft. Domercant's 2,602 career points are the most in OVC history (and No. 26 all-time in NCAA history) and he finished in the top five in the nation in scoring three times. Division I coaches and NBA scouts were part of the selection process but the final decision was made by the CollegeInsider.com staff.

Loos Becomes All-Time Winningest Coach in OVC History: With a 68-66 victory at Ohio on Dec. 9, Austin Peay head coach **Dave Loos** recorded his 320th career victory while in the OVC, a mark that ranks first all-time. Loos passed Cal Luther (319 wins at Murray State and UT Martin) for the all-time mark. Loos, the Dean of OVC coaches, is in his 20th year at Austin Peay where he also serves as the Athletics Director, making him the only Division I head men's basketball coach to hold that distinction. Loos now has 324 victories in his tenure at Austin Peay and 406 for his career.

Fox Sports Radio 1370 WDEF-AM in Chattanooga to Broadcast OVC Men's Basketball Game of the Week: For the second straight season Fox Sports Radio 1370 WDEF-AM out of Chattanooga will broadcast an OVC Men's Basketball Game of the Week in 2009-10. This season the station will broadcast a seven-game schedule, including broadcasting the OVC Tournament semifinals for the first time. The broadcasts are produced by Broadcaster Marketing Services and feature veteran play-by-play announcer Frank Santore. The schedule is below:

The 2009-10 Season: The 2009-10 season marks the 62nd of competition in the OVC. Over the previous 61 years, 12 different teams have claimed an OVC regular season championship, including four different schools in the past five years. UT Martin won its first OVC Regular Season Championship in 2008-09.

New Faces: The OVC welcomes three new head coaches to the league this season, the most new faces since the 1991-92 season (that season the new coaches were David Farrar at Middle Tennessee, Dick Fick at Morehead State, Scott Edgar at Murray State and Frankie Allen and Tennessee State). Former Arkansas State head coach **Dickey Nutt** takes over at Southeast Missouri State, **John Cooper**, lastly the associate head coach at Auburn, is the new man in charge at Tennessee State and **Jason James** is UT Martin's new head coach after previously serving as an assistant coach at the school. James (32) is the third youngest coach at the Division I level, trailing only IPFW's Dane Fife (30 years old) and Fordham interim coach Jared Grasso (29) who took over that program during the season (on Dec. 3).

OVC Tournament to Be Held at Sommet Center for 11th Time and in Nashville For 16th Time in 17 Years: The 2010 OVC Basketball Tournament will be held at the Sommet Center in downtown Nashville for the 11th time this season. The event was first held there in 1997 (marking the first basketball event in the venue) and has been held there every year since with the exceptions of 2002, 2004 and 2008. Last year the men's final went two overtimes with Morehead State finally topping Austin Peay when Steve Peterson hit his only bucket of the game with 1.4 seconds left in the second overtime. Overall this year will mark the 16th time in the last 17 years the tournament has been held in Nashville (with 2002 being the only year in that stretch the event was not in Music City).

Morehead State and Murray State Picked as Preseason Co-Favorites: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head men's basketball coaches and sports information directors, **Morehead State** and **Murray State** each received 10 first-place votes and were picked as co-favorites for the 2009-10 season. Morehead State finished last season 12-6 in league play (4th place) and went on to win the OVC Tournament Championship. Murray State was tied for second overall last season with a 13-5 record and lost in the OVC Tournament semifinals. It marks the 13th time in the last 21 years that Murray State has been picked the preseason favorite and second year in a row. Morehead State is tabbed first for the first time since the 1983-84 season (when they went 25-6 and won the OVC regular season and tournament championships). It marks just the third time since 1980-81 (when preseason polls were first available) that co-favorites have been picked in the preseason poll (it also happened in 1991-92 and 1994-95). Morehead State and Murray State each received 154 points and were followed next by **Austin Peay** who had 114 total points. **Eastern Illinois** was picked fourth (105 points) and followed by **Eastern Kentucky** (93), **Jacksonville State** (86), **Tennessee Tech** (76), **UT Martin** (55), **Tennessee State** (44) and **Southeast Missouri State** (19).

Preseason Predictions: Is being picked the preseason favorite, always a good thing? Over the past 30 years of preseason polls that were available, the league's head coaches and sports information directors correctly pick the eventual OVC regular season champion 60 percent of the time, picking the correct winner 18 times over the last 30 years. Over the past 10 years, the preseason poll has correctly picked the winner every other year. Last season the poll tabbed Murray State the favorite, although the Racers finished second to UT Martin, who won its first-ever OVC Championship a year ago.

Morehead State's Faried Tabbed as Preseason Player of the Year: The 2009-10 All-OVC Preseason Men's Basketball team was headlined by Morehead State junior center **Kenneth Faried**. Faried is coming off a season where he was named OVC Defensive Player of the Year and OVC Tournament MVP. Overall six different schools were represented on the team with Murray State's three selections leading the way. Eastern Illinois and Morehead State each had two selections while Austin Peay, Eastern Kentucky and Tennessee State had one player apiece on the squad. The team features just one player (Faried) who was a first-team All-OVC selection last season. The team does have three second-team All-OVC picks from 2008-09 and two players who were on last season's All-Newcomer Team. Faried made a splash last season being named the Conference's first OVC Defensive Player of the Year after ranking third nationally in rebounding (13.0/game), 52nd nationally in blocked shots (1.9/game) and 69th nationally in steals (1.9/game). Faried also added 13.9 points per game and connected on 55.6 percent of his field goal attempts (36th nationally). The 6-8 native of Newark, N.J. also tallied 25 double-doubles, which was the second most nationally, trailing only National Player of the Year Blake Griffin (29). Austin Peay's **Wesley Channels**, Eastern Illinois' **Romain Martin** and Murray State's **Danero Thomas** were each second-team All-OVC picks last season and are each on the preseason team this year. Murray State's **Ivan Aska** and **Isacc Miles** were two of the five All-OVC Newcomer selections in 2008-09 who are also on this year's All-OVC preseason squad. The Preseason All-OVC team is rounded out by Tennessee State's **Darius Cox**, Eastern Illinois' **Tyler Laser**, Morehead State's **Maze Stallworth** and Eastern Kentucky's **Justin Stommes**.

OVC Scores First NCAA Tournament Win in 20 Years; Places Three Teams in Postseason in 2008-09: With its 58-43 win over Alabama State in the NCAA Tournament Opening Round game in Dayton last March, Morehead State snapped a 19-year losing streak in the NCAA Tournament for teams from the Ohio Valley Conference. It marked the first NCAA Tournament victory since Middle Tennessee State beat Florida State 97-83 in Nashville in 1989. The Eagles were then defeated by No. 1 overall seed Louisville in the first round. The year also marked the first time since 1987 (when Austin Peay and Middle Tennessee were in the NCAA Tournament and Akron was in the NIT) that three OVC schools had participated in the postseason in the same year. In addition to Morehead State playing in the NCAA Tournament, UT Martin was in the NIT and Austin Peay played in the inaugural CollegeInsider.com Tournament.

OVC Players in the Pros: There are three former OVC players on NBA rosters. Those three players are Austin Peay's **Trenton Hassell** (New Jersey Nets), Murray State's

James Singleton (Dallas Mavericks) and UT Martin's **Lester Hudson** (Memphis Grizzlies). Hassel is in his ninth season in the NBA and third with the Nets. He also played with the Chicago Bulls (who drafted him 30th overall in the 2001 Draft and where he played two seasons), Minnesota Timberwolves (four seasons) and Dallas Mavericks (37 games in 2007-08). During his 592-game career he has averaged 5.9 points, 2.8 rebounds and 1.8 assists per game while hitting 44.7 percent of his field goal attempts. After being undrafted out of college (2003), Singleton played overseas before being signed by the Los Angeles Clippers before the 2005-06 season and played two seasons there before signing with Dallas in 2008-09. In his 174-game career, Singleton has averaged 3.5 points and 3.2 rebounds per game while hitting 49.3 percent of his shots. Hudson won the last two OVC Player of the Year awards before being drafted by the Boston Celtics in the second round (pick No. 58) of the 2009 NBA Draft. Hudson signed a one-year unguaranteed contract after his play in the NBA Summer League with the team. He appeared in 16 games with the Celtics until being waived in January; that same week he was signed by his hometown Memphis Grizzlies. Another UT Martin product, **Jared Newson**, is currently in the NBDL, playing for the Bakersfield Jam.

All 11 OVC Teams to Participate in ESPN BracketBusters For Fifth Straight Year: All 11 OVC schools will participate in the ESPN BracketBusters series for the fifth straight season in 2009-10. Now it its eighth year, ESPN BracketBusters is an ESPN television property that was tremendously successful with its first seven events in February of 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008 and 2009. The event has allowed Division I conferences to participate in a cutting-edge format that involves "wild card" pairings from the pool of participating teams, with half of the ESPNU BracketBusters teams pre-designated as "home" and the remaining half as "road" teams. OVC schools are 16-29 all-time in the event, including a 3-7 mark a season ago. Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Eastern Kentucky, Jacksonville State and Murray State will all be home teams in the series this year while Morehead State, Southeast Missouri, SIU Edwardsville, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin will all go on the road. The 2010 matchups will be announced on Feb. 1, 2010.

Replay Systems for OVC Basketball Venues Enter Year Three: On Dec. 21, 2007, the Ohio Valley Conference mandated the use of courtside replay systems at all OVC basketball venues. The systems were put into place in January 2008 and have been used since. The systems are used in situations that are outlined by NCAA rules.

SIU Edwardsville Continues Reclassification Process to Division I: On July 1, 2008 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, Ill., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States).

OVCSports.TV: For the fourth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCSports.TV. The venture with JumpTV Sports allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of conference matchups (excluding only national television games which are not available) on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and has streamed over 1,000 events in its first three years, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball events and OVC Championship events. Packages are available on a yearly, seasonal, monthly or per-event basis.
