Liabo earned his second-straight OVC Freshman of the Week award after averaging 13.5 points in a pair of road games for UT Martin last week. Liabo hit 52.9 percent (9-of-17) from the field and 54.5 percent (6-of-11) from 3-point land in the two contests. At Eastern Kentucky on Saturday the freshman poured in a game-high 18 points in just 15 minutes of playing time off the bench. After not playing at all in the first half of that game, Liabo provided the spark that helped the Skyhawks close the deficit from 21 to just three points in a span of 8:34. He opened the week by scoring nine points, grabbing a rebound, blocking a shot and netting a steal at Morehead State.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: OVC teams played their first set of Conference games last week, the first of two pairs of games that will happen prior to the 2011 calendar year begins... Austin Peay went on the road and won two games while Morehead State won two on the road and both now sit on top of the Conference standings early in the season...Tennessee Tech played just one Conference last week and is also undefeated (1-0) in OVC action...Morehead State extended its home court winning streak to 18 games (the sixth-longest streak nationally) with a 10-point victory over preseason OVC favorite Murray State on Saturday night; the loss marked the third-straight season Murray State has lost in Morehead (last year that was the only OVC loss Murray State suffered all season on its way to 31 overall victories)...Morehead State will look to extend that streak to 19 games on Tuesday when it hosts St. Catharine...On Saturday the Eagles will play at Northern Iowa, who also enters the week with an 18-game home court winning streak...Murray State actually has the longest home court winning streak in the league, having won 21-straight (the Racers do not play at home again until next Wednesday, Dec. 15)... Morehead State, however, does have the longest home court OVC winning streak, having won 20-straight dating back to the end of the 2007-08 season (Kansas has the longest home court conference winning streak at 28 games)...Morehead State's Kenneth Faried is first nationally in double-doubles (7), second in rebounding (14.3), 15th in field goal percentage (63.2%), 16th in steals (2.8), 32nd in blocks (2.5) and 68th in scoring (18.4).

20/20: Morehead State's Kenneth Faried had a monster game at SIU Edwardsville on Nov. 28, scoring 25 points and pulling down 20 rebounds in a win. That is one of just two 20/20 games at the Division I level this season. Faried also had a 20/20 game last season (23 points, 21 rebounds at Tennessee State); that was one of just nine 20/20 efforts nationally during the 2009-10 season. That game is one of seven double-doubles for Faried this season (in 8 games), which ranks first nationally. For his career Faried has 63 career double-doubles, which is the most nationally among active players.

Home Court Winning Streaks: Entering this week Murray State has the longest home court winning streak among OVC teams at 21 games. That streak currently ranks fourth nationally. Morehead State's 18-game winning streak is currently sixth nationally. Kansas has the nation's longest home court winning streak (64).

The OVC Among NCAA Statistical Leaders: In the latest NCAA statistical leaders release (Dec. 6), Morehead State ranks 15th nationally in steals/game (10.0) while Tennessee State is 15th nationally in free throw percentage (77.3%). Individually Morehead State's Kenneth Faried is first nationally in double-doubles (7) and second nationally in rebounding (14.25/game - just barely behind the national leader who is at 14.29 per game). Overall Faried is also 15th in field goal percentage (63.2%), 16th in steals (2.8/game), 32nd in blocks (2.5/game) and 68th in scoring (18.4 points/game).

Morehead State 19th, Murray State 20th in CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Poll: After finishing last season with an OVC-record 31 wins. Murray State finished the 2009-10 season ranked sixth in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major poll. This season the Racers began the year fifth in that poll and are currently ranked 20th in the Dec. 6 poll. Morehead State appeared in the poll for the first time this season on Dec. 6, entering at No. 19 after topping Murray State in the first head-to-head meeting between the teams this season. Now in its 12th season, the Mid-Major poll is made up of team's from the following conferences: America East, Atlantic Sun, Big Sky, Big South, Big West, Colonial, Great West, Horizon, Independents, Ivy, Metro Atlantic, Mid-American, Mid-Eastern, Missouri Valley, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southern, Southland, Southwestern, Summit, Sun Belt, West Coast. It is voted upon by coaches from those conferences, with one coach per conference casting a vote (Murray State's Billy Kennedy is the OVC representative).

OVC Tournament Makes Moves to Municipal Auditorium with More Teams, New Format: Beginning this season the OVC Basketball Tournament will move to Municipal Auditorium in Nashville as its new annual home. This year's event will mark the 17th time in the last 18 years the league's marquee event has been held in Music City, USA (2002 was the lone year the event was not held in Nashville). It marks the sixth time the combined men's and women's tournament has been held in Municipal, following the 1994, 1995, 1996, 2004 and 2008 events (a men's only event was also held there in 1989). New this season is the fact that all eight men's and all eight women's teams that qualify for the tournament field will gather at a single site for the entire tournament (previously first round games were played on campus sites with the semifinals and finals being held in Nashville). That marks the first time since 1996 that the entire tournament has been held at one site. The bracket also shifts from a traditional 1 vs. 8, 2 vs. 7, etc. format to a merit-based format that rewards the top teams during the regular season with byes into the

2011 OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2011 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 2-5 at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. For the first time since 1996, the entire tournament will be held at one site (instead of first round games being played on campus sites). The tournament has also switched to a merit-based format with the No. 1 and 2 seeds getting double byes into the semifinals and the No. 3 and 4 seeds getting a bye into the quarterfinals.

The first round and quarterfinal games (which start at 12 and 2 p.m. for the women, and 6 and 8 p.m. for the men) can be seen on OVCSports.TV. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 4 at 7 and 9 p.m. and televised on ESPNU with the championship game on Saturday, March 5 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 4 (televised on OVCSports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 5 at 3:00 p.m. (TV TBD).

This marks the 17th time in 18 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

CREDENTIALS. For the second year in a row, credentials will be requested through an online system. That information will be available in January. The deadline to request credentials is MONDAY, FEB. 28 at Noon. No credentials will be mailed; they can be picked up at Media Will-Call, located at teh back entrance of the arena (at the intersection of 5th Ave. North and Gay Street).



quarterfinals and semifinals (the No. 1 and 2 seeds will receive double byes into the semifinals while the No. 3 and 4 seeds will receive a bye into the quarterfinals). The 2011 OVC Men's and Women's Basketball Championship dates are March 2-5.

More on Municipal Auditorium: As part of the deal to host the tournament at Municipal Auditorium, the Nashville City Council and Municipal Auditorium committed \$200,000 to improvements at the venue, which opened in 1962. Among the major improvements that will be completed prior to this year's championship are upgrades to the dressing rooms, two new scoreboards and the new OVC-branded playing surface. The floor, which was unveiled at the league's Media Day event in October, was built by Horner Sports Flooring (http://www.hornerflooring.com), whose corporate headquarters are in Dollar Bay, Mich. The company has made floors for many collegiate and National Basketball Association (NBA) teams, including building the floor for the 2010 NBA All-Star Game which was held at Texas Stadium. The Horner Pro King portable floor at Municipal Auditorium was purchased for a cost of \$71,960; the court will be used for the OVC Tournament, various high school games/tournaments and special events such as the Harlem Globetrotters.

Faried Named to Naismith Award Watch List: Morehead State senior Kenneth Faried is one of 50 players named to the 2010-11 Naismith Award preseason watch list as announced by the Atlanta Tipoff Club. The Naismith Trophy is the most prestigious national award presented annually to college basketball's player of the year. Faried is the reigning OVC Player and Defensive Player of the Year, and was named this year's OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Last year, he averaged 16.9 points and 13.0 rebounds per game, leading the nation with 456 total rebounds. He also led the conference with 67 blocked shots and collected 56 steals on his way to honorable mention All-American honors. This year's diverse list includes the top men's college basketball players from 44 schools around the country. The watch list was compiled by the Atlanta Tipoff Club's Board of Selectors, which based its criteria on player performances from the previous year and expectations for the 2010-11 college basketball season. The Naismith Trophy presented by AT&T will be awarded at the 2011 NCAA Men's Final Four in Houston.

Faried Named Candidate for Lowe's Senior CLASS Award: Morehead State senior center Kenneth Faried is one of 30 candidates for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award in men's basketball. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - community, classroom, character and competition. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School®, the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The candidate class will be narrowed to 10 men's finalists midway through the regular season, and those names will be placed on the official ballot. Ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one finalist who best exemplifies excellence in the four Cs of community, classroom, character and competition.

Loos is All-Time Winningest Coach in OVC History: With a 68-66 victory at Ohio on Dec. 9 of last season, Austin Peay head coach Dave Loos recorded his 320th career victory while in the OVC, a mark that ranks first all-time. Loos passed Cal Luther (319 wins at Murray State and UT Martin) for the all-time mark. Loos, the Dean of OVC coaches, is now in his 21st year at Austin Peay where he also serves as the Athletics Director, making him the only Division I head men's basketball coach to hold that distinction. Loos is one of just 14 active Division I coaches to have coached at the same school for 20 or more years. Loos now has 336 victories in his tenure at Austin Peay and 418 for his career.

The 2010-11 Season: The 2010-11 season marks the 63rd of competition in the OVC. Over the previous 62 years, 12 different teams have claimed an OVC regular season championship, including three different schools in the past three years.

OVC Has Postseason Success: After several years of not having much postseason success, OVC teams have turned it around the past two years. Each of the last two years the league has sent three teams to the postseason, including Murray State to the NCAA Tournament and Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI) last season. The biggest splash came from No. 13 seed Murray State who knocked off No. 4 seed Vanderbilt 66-65 in the NCAA Tournament when Danero Thomas hit a jumper at the buzzer. It was the first time an OVC team had won a First Round NCAA Tournament game since 1989 (when MTSU beat Florida State) and marked the second year in a row the league had won a NCAA Tournament game (Morehead State beat Alabama State in the Opening Round game in 2009). Murray State would lose to eventual national runner-up Butler in the Second Round, falling 54-52. Morehead State would win its first game in the CBI, marking the first time since 1988 that two different OVC teams had won postseason games in the same season.

OVC Teams to Once Again Compete in ESPN BracketBusters Series: For the sixth-straight season every OVC team will compete in the ESPN BracketBusters series in 2010-11. Now it its ninth year, ESPN BracketBusters is an ESPN television property that was tremendously successful with its first eight events. The event has allowed Division I conferences to participate in a cutting-edge format that involves "wild card" pairings from the pool of participating teams, with half of the ESPN BracketBusters teams pre-designated as "home" and the remaining half as "road" teams. This year there are 114 teams from 15 conferences in the pool of teams who will be selected for one of 11 nationally-televised games. Teams not selected for a television

OVC Players in the NBA: Entering the season there was just one former OVC player on a NBA roster. Former UT Martin All-American **Lester Hudson** began the year on the roster of the Washington Wizards but was waived on Nov. 22. Hudson was a two-time OVC Player of the Year at UT Martin before being selected No. 58 overall by the Boston Celtics in the 2009 NBA Draft. Hudson spent half of his rookie season with the Celtics before finishing the year with the Memphis Grizzlies and in the NBA Development League. There are also three former OVC players playing in the NBA Development League as former Tennessee Tech standout **Willie Jenkins** is with the Idaho Stampede and Jacksonville State's **Walker Russell** (Fort Wayne Mad Ants) and **Amadou Mbodji** (Utah Flash) are also in the league.

Murray State Picked as Preseason Co-Favorites: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head men's basketball coaches and sports information directors, Murray State received 18 first-place votes and was picked as the favorite for the 2010-11 season. Last season Murray State won an OVC-record 31 games on its way to the OVC regular season and tournament champion-ship as well as a NCAA Tournament first round victory over No. 4 seed Vanderbilt. It marks the 14th time in the last 22 years that Murray State has been picked the preseason favorite and third in a row (they were tabbed co-favorites with Morehead State last season). Murray State received 162 total points and was followed next by Morehead State (2 first-place votes, 146 points), who was a consensus No. 2 pick. Eastern Illinois was picked third (123) and was followed by Austin Peay (107), Eastern Kentucky (92), Tennessee Tech (85), Tennessee State (81), Jacksonville State (51), Southeast Missouri (41) and UT Martin (20).

Preseason Predictions: Is being picked the preseason favorite, always a good thing? Over the past 31 years of preseason polls that were available, the league's head coaches and sports information directors correctly pick the eventual OVC regular season champion 61 percent of the time, picking the correct winner 20 times over the last 32 years. Over the past 10 years, the preseason poll has correctly picked the winner every other year.

Morehead State's Faried Tabbed as Preseason Player of the Year: The 2010-11 All-OVC Preseason Men's Basketball team was headlined by Morehead State senior center Kenneth Faried, marking the second year in a row he has been bestowed that honor. Faried was named both the OVC Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year in 2009-10. Overall seven different schools were represented on the team with Murray State's four selections leading the way. Morehead State had two selections while Austin Peay. Eastern Illinois. Eastern Kentucky. Jacksonville State and Tennessee Tech had one player apiece on the squad. The team features four players who were All-OVC first-team selections last season. The team also has one player who was a second-team selection and two players who were on the All-Newcomer squad. In addition to Faried, Murray State's B.J. Jenkins and Isacc Miles and Eastern Illinois' Tyler Laser were each first-team All-OVC picks last season and are each on the preseason team this year. Austin Peay's Anthony Campbell was the lone second-team selection from last season who returned to the OVC this year, while Murray State's Isaiah Canaan, along with Jenkins, were the All-Newcomer selections from last year who were on this year's preseason team. The Preseason All-OVC team was rounded out by Murray State's Ivan Aska, Morehead State's Demonte Harper, Tennessee Tech's Kevin Murphy, Jacksonville State's Nick Murphy and Eastern Kentucky's Justin Stommes.

All League Head Coaches Return: For the second-time in four years, every OVC head coach returns from the previous season. This last happened in the 2007-08 season. Overall it is the seventh time there has been no turnover in coaches between seasons since the 1978-79 season (the other years were 1978-79, 1993-94, 1994-95, 2001-02, 2004-05 and 2007-08).

Replay Systems for OVC Basketball Venues Enter Year Four: On Dec. 21, 2007, the Ohio Valley Conference mandated the use of courtside replay systems at all OVC basketball venues. The systems were put into place in January 2008 and have been used since. The systems are used in situations that are outlined by NCAA rules.

SIU Edwardsville Continues Reclassification Process to Division I: On July 1, 2008 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular

season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition this year; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, Ill., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States.

OVCSports.TV: For the fifth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCSports.TV. The venture with NeuLion (formerly JumpTV Sports) allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of conference matchups (excluding only national television games which are not available) on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and has streamed over 1,000 events in its first four years, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball events and OVC Championship events. Packages are available on a yearly, seasonal, monthly or per-event basis.

OVC TELEVISION PACKAGE

This season the OVC is sponsoring a 21-game television package for basketball. In addition to this Conference-sponsored package, there are approximately 62 additional games that will air either locally, regionally or nationally involving OVC institutions during the season. That brings the total number of television games involving OVC schools this season to 83.

The sponsored OVC games are produced and aired by ESPNU/ESPN2 (9 agmes) and the Wazoo Sports network (12 games). Wazoo Sports is a Regional Sports Network located in London, Ky. Wazoo Sports (http://www.wazoosports.com) launched online in December of 2007 and expanded to a 24/7 sports television network on September 25, 2009. During the 2010 football season Wazoo produced an aired a 10-game OVC Football Game of the Week package.

The games that do not air on ESPNU can be seen on the Wazoo Sports Network in addition to CSS (Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast), ESPN3.com and ESPN Full Court. Four of the five women's games will air on Wazoo, ESPN3.com and ESPN Full Court, while the fifth will be exclusive to Wazoo. In addition, WEIU, an affiliate located in Charleston, III., will pick up all nine of the games. CSS, which was launched in 1999, can be found only on cable and serves over six million customers in 13 states. ESPN3.com, the network's live 24/7 broadband channel, was launched as ESPN360 in 2001 and renamed ESPN3.com in April, it is available at no additional cost to fans with a high-speed Internet connection from an affiliated provider. ESPN Full Court is an out-of-market pay-per-view sports package. The package is available on most major cable and satellite television providers.

Eastern Kentucky opened Conference play this past week by splitting a pair of home games, losing by two points (74-72) to OVC preseason favorite Murray State before topping UT Martin 77-69...The Murray State game was a back-and-forth affair that featured 14 ties, lastly at 70 with 55 seconds remaining...The first half had been mostly EKU, as the Colonels led 24-10 with just under five minutes to play, before a 14-3 Racer run trimmed the halftime margin to just three...Overall Eastern shot 54.8 percent from the field, marking the first time this season the team had lost when shooting better than 50 percent from the field...Senior Spencer Perrin led the Colonels with 17 points and added a season-high six rebounds while Joshua Daniel had 15 points...Although the Colonels have lost five-straight to Murray State, four of those games have been decided by eight points or less... On Saturday the outcome was different as EKU topped UT Martin for the eighth straight time...The game was highlighted by senior Justin Stommes scoring his 1,000th career point, becoming the 30th player in Eastern Kentucky history to achieve that feat; Stommes finished the game with 15 points, a season-high... Overall 10 different Colonel players made a field goal in the win...Daniel added 17 points (his third-straight game in double figures) while Perrin scored 15 and Willie Cruz added a team-high six rebounds off the bench...Eastern Kentucky will host Kentucky Christian on Wednesday, before traveling to Minnesota to battle Tubby Smith and the Golden Gophers on Saturday; Minnesota is ranked No. 20 in the USA Today/ESPN Coaches Top 25 poll (No. 22 in the AP poll).

Jacksonville State was 0-2 overall last week, losing a non-conference road game against UAB before returning home and dropping a close 64-62 decision to Tennessee Tech in the home opener for both squads...At UAB, in what may have been the team's toughest opponent of the season, the Gamecocks held their own, trailing by just two points with three minutes to go before losing 59-53... Junior Stephen Hall tied his career-high with 20 points, hitting 10-of-21 shots in a game played in his hometown of Birmingham...Senior Nick Murphy had another milestone, becoming Jax State's all-time leading scorer at the Division I level, passing Walker Russell on the list; Murphy was already the program's all-time leading rebounder at the Division I level (breaking the mark earlier this season)...Fellow senior Jeremy Bynum hit 4-of-7 from behind the arc and scored 18 points; he is now second in JSU history for made 3-pointers (180)...JSU won the battle of the boards (36-31) and committed only nine turnovers on the night...On Saturday it was a hot second half by Tennessee Tech that led to the narrow loss...TTU shot 68 percent from the floor in the second half, overcoming a 14-point first half deficit...After the Golden Eagles pulled ahead by two with 13 seconds left, a 3-point attempt before the buzzer fell short for JSU...Bynum led the way with a season-high 21 points, hitting 5-of-8 3-pointers on the night...For the year Bynum ranks first in the OVC in 3-pointers made/game (2.0) and second in 3-point percentage (46.2%)...Jacksonville State has the next nine days off for final exams before returning to the court at Oregon on Monday, Dec. 13...Two days after that game the team will be at Presbyterian, which is 2,754 miles away on the opposite coast.

MOREHEAD STATE EAGLES (5-3, 2-0)

Morehead State ran its winning streak to four games and its home court winning streak to 18 (the sixth-longest streak nationally) with wins over UT Martin (70-49) and Murray State (75-65), the OVC preseason favorite...Overall the Eagles have not lost an OVC game at Johnson Arena in its last 20 games, dating back three seasons (last game of the 2007-08 season)...Senior Kenneth Faried was dominant once again, averaging 18.0 points, 15.0 rebounds and 3.0 steals/game in the wins...Faried currently ranks second nationally in rebounding (14.3) and first in double-doubles (7 - in eight total games)...Faried had 20 rebounds in the win over UT Martin (his second 20-rebound game of the season), while also adding three steals and four blocks...In the win over Murray State, Faried had 21 points and 10 rebounds...The double-double was the 64th of his career, the most among active players nationally...Demonte Harper added 22 points and five assists in the win over the Racers, while Terrance Hill hit 3-of-6 3-pointers and finished with 15 points...The 65 points scored by Murray State against the Eagles were the most of any opponent (including nationally-ranked Florida and Ohio State) this season...Sam Goodman had 13 points, two blocks and four steals in the win over UT Martin to begin the week...Morehead State is now off to a 5-3 start, its best under fifth-year head coach Donnie Tyndall...Morehead State will look to extend its home court winning streak on Tuesday when it hosts St. Catharine... The week concludes on Saturday at Northern Iowa, a team that also enters this week with an 18-game home winning streak.

OVC Tournament Tiebreaker System

Regular season standings will be the determining factor in setting first-round pairings for the tournament. All ties will be broken starting at the top of the conference standings and working down. The tiebreaking system will utilize the following factors, in order, until all ties are broken.

TWO-WAY TIES

- 1. Records in head-to-head competition are compared, with the higher seed going to the team that has won the most games against the other.
- 2. In the event step 1 does not resolve the tie (i.e. if the two teams split their games during the season), then the records of the tying teams against the No. 1 seed shall be compared. The team with the better record against the No. 1 seed shall gain the higher seed.
- 3. If the potential No. 1 seed is among tied teams, the process in step 2 will begin at the highest point in the standings which does not involve a tied team.
- 4. The process continues, through the No. 11 team in the standings, if necessary.
- 5. In the event the tie cannot be broken, seeds will be determined by a coin flip.

MULTIPLE TIES

- Composite records between the tying teams will be evaluated to determine whether one team has won more games against the other tying
 institutions (in which case that team would receive the higher seed) and/or one team has won the least number of games among the tied teams (in
 which case the team will receive the lowest seed, and/or two teams have the same composite record (in which case the two-team tiebreaker scenario
 shall be utilized).
- 2. In the event step 1 does not solve the multiple ties, or reduce the multiple ties to one tie, then a comparison of records of the tying institutions against the No. 1 seed will occur. The team among the tying institutions with the better record against the No. 1 seed will receive the higher seed.
- 3. If the potential No. 1 seed is among tied teams, the process in step 2 will begin at the highest point in the standings which does not involve a tied team.
- 4. The process continues, through the No. 11 team in the standings, if necessary.
- 5. In the event this process does not resolve the ties, seeding will be determined by a coin flip.

Note: If a multiple tie is reduced to a tie between two teams, the two-team tiebreaker formula will then be utilized. Ties involving teams higher in the standings are always broken before ties involving teams lower in the standings.
