THIS WEEK'S adidas® OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK



Kenneth Faried, C • Sr., 6-8, 228 • Newark, N.J. • Morehead State
Faried earned his fifth OVC Player of the Week honor of the season after averaging 17.7 points, 18.0 rebounds and 2.3 blocks/game and hitting 71.4 percent (20-of-28) from the field in three big Morehead State victories last week, all of which came against teams in first place in their conference. Included in that was a 23-point, 23-rebound effort in a win over Tennessee State (who was tied for first place in the OVC at the time), his second 20/20 game of the year (and fourth of his career) and one of just four 20/20 efforts at the Division I level this season. The 23 rebounds were the most by any players nationally this season. Faried began the week with a 13-point, 15-rebound, 2-block, 3-steal game at MAC-leading Ball State, as the Eagles won 50-48 and snapped BSU's seven-game home court winning streak. He capped the week with 17 points and 16 rebounds in a 69-56 victory over OVC-leading Austin Peay, avenging an overtime loss to the Governors from earlier this season. Faried increased his season rebounding average to 14.3/game, which continues to lead the nation (he has four games of 20+ rebounds this season). He also has 18 double-doubles, which is first nationally (his career total of 75 ranks 10th in NCAA history). This marks the 12th time in his career he has been named OVC Player of the Week, a new OVC record (passing the mark previously held by UT Martin's Lester Hudson).

NEWCOMER

Zac Swansey, G • Jr., 6-1, 180 • Dunwoody, Ga. • Tennessee Tech

Against Eastern Illinois on Thursday, Swansey hit his third game-winning shot of the year (a 3-pointer with 7.8 seconds left) to lift the Golden Eagles to a 77-74 road victory; it was his second game-winner against EIU this season. The transfer from Georgia hit 6-of-9 3-pointers in that game on his way to a career-high 22 points; he also dished out five assists and had three rebounds. Two days later he scored 19 points, pulled down seven rebounds, dished out five assists and netted two steals in a victory over Southeast Missouri to move the Golden Eagles into a three-way tie for third place in the OVC. For the week Swansey averaged 20.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 5.0 assists and 1.5 steals/game while hitting 60.9 percent (14-of-23) from the field and 66.7 percent (8-of-12) from 3-point range.

FRESHMAN

Terence Smith, G • Fr., 6-3, 175 • Russellville, Ala. • UT Martin

Smith earned his second Freshman of the Week honor of the season after averaging 16.0 points, 6.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists/game as UT Martin split a pair of games. In a road win at SIU Edwardsville, Smith scored 15 points and a team-high nine rebounds and four assists. He ended the week with 17 points (on 3-of-3 3-point shooting) and had three assists in a loss at Murray State. Smith also knocked down 6-of-6 free throw attempts against the Racers. With the honor, UT Martin has had the winner of the Freshman of the Week award six times in 12 total weeks this season.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: The matchups for the annual ESPN BracketBusters series will be made on Monday with the TV matchups being announced first and the nontelevision matchups coming later in the evening; this is the sixth-straight season every OVC team has participated in the event...The OVC race got even tighter last week as league-leading Austin Peay lost one of its two games (at Morehead State on Saturday) and Tennessee State lost twice on its road trip to Eastern Kentucky/Morehead State... Austin Peay now holds a half of a game lead over Murray State (a team it hosts on Saturday night) and a one game lead over Morehead State, Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech...Another team, Eastern Kentucky, is just two games out of first place...Murray State will battle Tennessee State in a game that can be seen on ESPNU on Thursday night...This week two OVC coaches will go for their 100th victories as head coaches at their schools, as Eastern Kentucky's Jeff Neubauer and Murray State's Billy Kennedy are both currently at 99 victories; Murray State is at Tennessee State and Austin Peay this week while Eastern Kentucky is at Tennessee Tech and Jacksonville State... Tennessee Tech head coach Mike Sutton can also reach a milestone with a victory this week as the coach, in his ninth season at Tech, has 140 victories, just one victory away from the OVC career Top 10 victories list; with his 141st victory he will tie Middle Tennessee's Bruce Stewart who won 141 games from 1984-91.

Faried Has Two of the Four 20/20 Games Nationally This Season: Morehead State's Kenneth Faried had a monster game at SIU Edwardsville on Nov. 28, scoring 25 points and pulling down 20 rebounds in a win. On Jan. 27 against Tennessee State Faried did even better, scoring 23 points and recording 23 rebounds in a victory (the 23 rebounds were the most by a Division I player in a game this season). Those are two of just four 20/20 games at the Division I level this season. Faried also had a 20/20 game last season (23 points, 21 rebounds at Tennessee State - that was one of just nine 20/20 efforts nationally during the 2009-10 season) and a 20/20 game in 2008-09 (27 points, 24 rebounds against Florida A&M).

Faried Sixth in NCAA Career Rebounding Since 1973: For players who have began their careers since 1973 (when freshmen were once again allowed to play NCAA basketball), only four players have grabbed more career rebounds than Morehead State's Kenneth Faried. Faried currently has 1,493 rebounds; Tim Duncan holds the record with 1,570. Faried is only 77 rebounds behind Duncan and has at least nine games left in his season (8 regular season games, at least one tournament game) and would need to average only 8.5 rebounds in those games to claim the record. When Faried gets to 1,505 rebounds, he will be in the Top 25 in NCAA history for rebounds (all-time).

Faried 10th in NCAA History in Double-Doubles: Morehead State's Kenneth Faried has 18 double-doubles this season (in 23 total games), which ranks tied for first nationally. For his career Faried has 75 career double-doubles, which is the most nationally among active players. Currently his 75 career double-doubles ranks 10th in NCAA history (he just passed Navy's David Robinson and Memphis' Keith Lee). The NCAA career record for double-doubles is 87 by Wake Forest's Tim Duncan.

Murray State Spreads the Wealth; Was Last Division I Team Without a 20-Point Scorer This Season: For the second year in a row Murray State has a very balanced attack, as no player averages more than 11.9 points/game and the team has eight players who average between 11.3 and 5.5 points/game. The Racers did not have a 20-point scorer in a game this year until their 21st game on January 29 when Isaiah Canaan scored 24 points. That made them the final Division I team (out of 345 total squads) without a 20-point scorer until that game.

40 Minutes Just Not Enough for Austin Peay; Leads Nation in Overtime Games: So far this season Austin Peay has played in six overtime games, the most of any Division I team (APSU is 2-4 in those games). The next closest teams are Charlotte, Houston, Jacksonville, LaSalle, Liberty, North Carolina A&T, Sacramento State, UMKC, UNC Asheville and Wofford who have each played in four overtime games.

The OVC Among NCAA Statistical Leaders: In the latest NCAA statistical leaders release (Jan. 30) Morehead State is fifth in rebounding margin (+9.4), Tennessee Tech is 10th in field goal percentage (48.8%) and Austin Peay is 12th in turnover margin (+4.5). Individually Morehead State's **Kenneth Faried** is first nationally in rebounding (14.3/game) and double-doubles (18), fourth in field goal percentage (62.4%), 28th in steals (2.2/game), 51st in blocks (2.0/game) and 88th in scoring (17.1/game). Southeast Missouri's **Leon Powell** is third in field goal percentage

2011 OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2011 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 2-5 at Municipal Auditorium in Nashville, Tenn. For the first time since 1996, the entire tournament will be held at one site (instead of first round games being played on campus sites). The tournament has also switched to a merit-based format with the No. 1 and 2 seeds getting double byes into the semifinals and the No. 3 and 4 seeds getting a bye into the quarterfinals.

The first round and quarterfinal games (which start at 12 and 2 p.m. for the women, and 6 and 8 p.m. for the men) can be seen on OVCSports.TV. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 4 at 7 and 9 p.m. and televised on ESPNU with the championship game on Saturday, March 5 at 7 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2. The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 4 (televised on OVCSports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 5 at 3:00 p.m. (Wazoo Sports and other TBA outlets).

This marks the 17th time in 18 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville.

CREDENTIALS. For the second year in a row, credentials will be requested through an online system. That information will be available in January. The deadline to request credentials is MONDAY, FEB. 28 at Noon. No credentials will be mailed; they can be picked up at Media Will-Call, located at the back entrance of the arena (at the intersection of 5th Ave. North and Gay Street).



(62.4%), Eastern Illinois' **Jeremy Granger** is fifth in free throw percentage (92.6%) while Tennessee Tech's **Zac Swansey** is seventh in assists (6.6/game).

Home Court Winning Streaks Come to an End: OVC teams has had two long home court winning streaks come to an end this season. Murray State had a 25-game home court winning streak snapped by Austin Peay on Jan. 8, a streak that dated back to Feb. 21, 2009. Morehead State saw its 24-game home court streak come to an end on Jan. 22 against Eastern Kentucky, the first home loss since Nov. 29, 2009 (Kent State).

OVC Tournament Makes Move to Municipal Auditorium with More Teams, New Format: Beginning this season the OVC Basketball Tournament will move to Municipal Auditorium in Nashville as its new annual home. This year's event will mark the 17th time in the last 18 years the league's marquee event has been held in Music City, USA (2002 was the lone year the event was not held in Nashville). It marks the sixth time the combined men's and women's tournament has been held in Municipal, following the 1994, 1995, 1996, 2004 and 2008 events (a men's only event was also held there in 1989). New this season is the fact that all eight men's and all eight women's teams that qualify for the tournament field will gather at a single site for the entire tournament (previously first round games were played on campus sites with the semifinals and finals being held in Nashville). That marks the first time since 1996 that the entire tournament to a merit-based format that rewards the top teams during the regular season with byes into the quarterfinals and semifinals (the No. 1 and 2 seeds will receive double byes into the semifinals while the No. 3 and 4 seeds will receive a bye into the quarterfinals). The 2011 OVC Men's and Women's Basketball Championship dates are March 2-5.

More on Municipal Auditorium: As part of the deal to host the tournament at Municipal Auditorium, the Nashville City Council and Municipal Auditorium committed \$200,000 to improvements at the venue, which opened in 1962. Among the major improvements that will be completed prior to this year's championship are upgrades to the dressing rooms, two new scoreboards and the new OVC-branded playing surface. The floor, which was unveiled at the league's Media Day event in October, was built by Horner Sports Flooring, whose corporate headquarters are in Dollar Bay, Mich. The company has made floors for many collegiate and National Basketball Association (NBA) teams, including building the floor for the 2010 NBA All-Star Game which was held at Texas Stadium. The Horner Pro King portable floor at Municipal Auditorium was purchased for a cost of \$71,960; the court will be used for the OVC Tournament, various high school games/tournaments and special events such as the Harlem Globetrotters.

Loos is All-Time Winningest Coach in OVC History; Sutton One Win Away From OVC Top 10: With a 68-66 victory at Ohio on Dec. 9 of last season, Austin Peay head coach Dave Loos recorded his 320th career victory while in the OVC, a mark that ranks first all-time. Loos passed Cal Luther (319 wins at Murray State and UT Martin) for the all-time mark. Loos, the Dean of OVC coaches, is now in his 21st year at Austin Peay where he also serves as the Athletics Director, making him the only Division I head men's basketball coach to hold that distinction. Loos is one of just 14 active Division I coaches to have coached at the same school for 20 or more years. Loos now has 344 victories in his tenure at Austin Peay and 426 for his career. Tennessee Tech head coach Mike Sutton needs just one more victory to reach the OVC's all-time Top 10 wins list. Sutton currently has 140 victories in his nine-year tenure at TTU.

Faried Named to Naismith Award Watch List: Morehead State senior Kenneth Faried is one of 50 players named to the 2010-11 Naismith Award preseason watch list as announced by the Atlanta Tipoff Club. The Naismith Trophy is the most prestigious national award presented annually to college basketball's player of the year. Faried is the reigning OVC Player and Defensive Player of the Year, and was named this year's OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Last year, he averaged 16.9 points and 13.0 rebounds per game, leading the nation with 456 total rebounds. He also led the conference with 67 blocked shots and collected 56 steals on his way to honorable mention All-American honors. This year's diverse list includes the top men's college basketball players from 44 schools around the country. The watch list was compiled by the Atlanta Tipoff Club's Board of Selectors, which based its criteria on player performances from the previous year and expectations for the 2010-11 college basketball season. The Naismith Trophy presented by AT&T will be awarded at the 2011 NCAA Men's Final Four in Houston.

Faried Also on Wooden Award Midseason Top 30 Watch List: Morehead State University senior center Kenneth Faried was one of the players on the John R. Wooden Award Midseason Top 30 released by The Los Angeles Athletic Club in early January. Selected by the Wooden Award National Advisory Board, the list is made up of 30 student-athletes who, based on their performances in November and December, are the early frontrunners for college basketball's most prestigious honor. Transfers, freshmen and medical redshirts are eligible for this midseason list but did not appear on the preseason Top 50. All players nationally who excel throughout the season will be evaluated and considered for the official voting ballot released in March. The National Ballot consists of approximately 20 top players who have proven to their universities that they are also making progress toward graduation and maintaining at least a cumulative 2.0 GPA. The Wooden Award All-American Team will be announced the week of the "Elite Eight" round during the NCAA Tournament, making it unique among college postseason awards. The 35th annual Wooden Award ceremony, which will include the announcement of the Men's and Women's Wooden Award winners, a special tribute to Coach Wooden and Wooden Award founder Duke Llewellyn, and the presentation of the Wooden Award All American Teams and the Legends of Coaching Award, will take place the weekend of April 8-10, 2011.

Faried Named Candidate for Lowe's Senior CLASS Award: Morehead State senior center Kenneth Faried was one of 30 candidates for the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award in men's bas-

Entering the season, only two active OVC players have scored more than 1,000 points in their careers. Tyler Laser joined the club in November while Demonte Harper and Justin Stommes each joined the club on Dec. 4. Jeremy Bynum became a member on Dec. 29, Kevin Murphy on Jan. 15 and Benzor Simmons on Jan. 24. ketball. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - community, classroom, character and competition. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School®, the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. The candidate class was narrowed to 10 men's finalists in January but Faried was not on that list.

The 2010-11 Season: The 2010-11 season marks the 63rd of competition in the OVC. Over the previous 62 years, 12 different teams have claimed an OVC regular season championship, including three different schools in the past three years.

OVC Has Postseason Success: After several years of not having much postseason success, OVC teams have turned it around the past two years. Each of the last two years the league has sent three teams to the postseason, including Murray State to the NCAA Tournament and Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State to the College Basketball Invitational (CBI) last season. The biggest splash came from No. 13 seed Murray State who knocked off No. 4 seed Vanderbilt 66-65 in the NCAA Tournament when Danero Thomas hit a jumper at the buzzer. It was the first time an OVC team had won a First Round NCAA Tournament game since 1989 (when MTSU beat Florida State) and marked the second year in a row the league had won a NCAA Tournament game (Morehead State beat Alabama State in the Opening Round game in 2009). Murray State would lose to eventual national runner-up Butler in the Second Round, falling 54-52. Morehead State would win its first game in the CBI, marking the first time since 1988 that two different OVC teams had won postseason games in the same season.

OVC Teams to Once Again Compete in ESPN BracketBusters Series: For the sixth-straight season every OVC team will compete in the ESPN BracketBusters series in 2010-11. Now it its ninth year, ESPN BracketBusters is an ESPN television property that was tremendously successful with its first eight events. The event has allowed Division I conferences to participate in a cutting-edge format that involves "wild card" pairings from the pool of participating teams, with half of the ESPN BracketBusters teams pre-designated as "home" and the remaining half as "road" teams. This year there are 114 teams from 15 conferences in the pool of teams who will be selected for one of 11 nationally-televised games. Teams not selected for a television game will be paired up with other teams in the pool for games that will be played on Saturday, Feb. 19. The matchups will be announced on January 31. OVC schools are 19-37 all-time in the BracketBusters event.

OVC Players in the NBA: Entering the season there was just one former OVC player on a NBA roster. Former UT Martin All-American **Lester Hudson** began the year on the roster of the Washington Wizards but was waived on Nov. 22. Hudson was re-signed by the Wizards on Dec. 20 but waived once again on Jan. 5. Hudson was a two-time OVC Player of the Year at UT Martin before being selected No. 58 overall by the Boston Celtics in the 2009 NBA Draft. Hudson spent half of his rookie season with the Celtics before finishing the year with the Memphis Grizzlies and in the NBA Development League. There are also three former OVC players playing in the NBA Development League as former Tennessee Tech standout **Willie Jenkins** is with the Idaho Stampede and Jacksonville State's **Walker Russell** (Fort Wayne Mad Ants) and **Amadou Mbodji** (Utah Flash) are also in the league.

Murray State Picked as Preseason Co-Favorites: In a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head men's basketball coaches and sports information directors, Murray State received 18 first-place votes and was picked as the favorite for the 2010-11 season. Last season Murray State won an OVC-record 31 games on its way to the OVC regular season and tournament championship as well as a NCAA Tournament first round victory over No. 4 seed Vanderbilt. It marks the 14th time in the last 22 years that Murray State has been picked the preseason favorite and third in a row (they were tabbed co-favorites with Morehead State last season). Murray State received 162 total points and was followed next by Morehead State (2 first-place votes, 146 points), who was a consensus No. 2 pick. Eastern Illinois was picked third (123) and was followed by Austin Peay (107), Eastern Kentucky (92), Tennessee Tech (85), Tennessee State (81), Jacksonville State (51), Southeast Missouri (41) and UT Martin (20).

Preseason Predictions: Is being picked the preseason favorite, always a good thing? Over the past 31 years of preseason polls that were available, the league's head coaches and sports information directors correctly pick the eventual OVC regular season champion 61 percent of the time, picking the correct winner 20 times over the last 32 years. Over the past 10 years, the preseason poll has correctly picked the winner every other year.

Preseason Men's Basketball team was headlined by Morehead State senior center Kenneth Faried, marking the second year in a row he has been bestowed that honor. Faried was named both the OVC Player of the Year and Defensive Player of the Year in 2009-10. Overall seven different schools were represented on the team with Murray State's four selections leading the way. Morehead State had two selections while Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois, Eastern Kentucky, Jacksonville State and Tennessee Tech had one player apiece on the squad. The team features four players who were All-OVC first-team selections last season. The team also has one player who was a second-team selection and two players who were on the All-Newcomer squad. In addition to Faried, Murray State's B.J. Jenkins and Isacc Miles and Eastern Illinois' Tyler Laser were each firstteam All-OVC picks last season and are each on the preseason team this year. Austin Peay's Anthony Campbell was the lone second-team selection from last season who returned to the OVC this year, while Murray State's Isaiah Canaan, along with Jenkins, were the All-Newcomer selections from last year who were on this year's preseason team. The Preseason All-OVC team was rounded out by Murray State's Ivan Aska, Morehead State's Demonte Harper, Tennessee Tech's Kevin Murphy, Jacksonville State's Nick Murphy and Eastern Kentucky's Justin Stommes.

All League Head Coaches Return: For the second-time in four years, every OVC head coach returns from the previous season. This last happened in the 2007-08 season. Overall it is the seventh time there has been no turnover in coaches between seasons since the 1978-79 season (the other years were 1978-79, 1993-94, 1994-95, 2001-02, 2004-05 and 2007-08).

Replay Systems for OVC Basketball Venues Enter Year Four: On Dec. 21, 2007, the Ohio Valley Conference mandated the use of courtside replay systems at all OVC basketball venues. The systems were put into place in January 2008 and have been used since. The systems are used in situations that are outlined by NCAA rules.

SIU Edwardsville Continues Reclassification Process to Division I: On July 1, 2008 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Óhio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition this year; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, III., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States.

OVCSports.TV: For the fifth consecutive year, fans can watch nearly every Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCSports.TV. The venture with NeuLion (formerly JumpTV Sports) allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of conference matchups (excluding only national television games which are not available) on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and has streamed over 1,000 events in its first four years, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball events and OVC Championship events. Packages are available on a yearly, seasonal, monthly or per-event basis.

OVC TELEVISION PACKAGE

This season the OVC is sponsoring a 21-game television package for basketball. In addition to this Conference-sponsored package, there are approximately 62 additional games that will air either locally, regionally or nationally involving OVC institutions during the season. That brings the total number of television games involving OVC schools this season to 83.

The sponsored OVC games are produced and aired by ESPNU/ ESPN2 (9 agmes) and the Wazoo Sports network (12 games). Wazoo Sports is a Regional Sports Network located in London, Ky. Wazoo Sports (http://www.wazoosports.com) launched online in December of 2007 and expanded to a 24/7 sports television network on September 25, 2009. During the 2010 football season Wazoo produced an aired a 10-game OVC Football Game of the Week package.

The games that do not air on ESPNU can be seen on the Wazoo Sports Network in addition to CSS (Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast), ESPN3.com and ESPN Full Court. Four of the five women's games will air on Wazoo, ESPN3.com and ESPN Full Court, while the fifth will be exclusive to Wazoo. In addition, WEIU, an affiliate located in Charleston, III., will pick up all nine of the games. CSS, which was launched in 1999, can be found only on cable and serves over six million customers in 13 states. ESPN3. com, the network's live 24/7 broadband channel, was launched as ESPN360 in 2001 and renamed ESPN3.com in April, it is available at no additional cost to fans with a high-speed Internet connection from an affiliated provider. ESPN Full Court is an out-of-market pay-per-view sports package. The package is available on most major cable and satellite television providers.

Despite splitting a pair of games last week, Austin Peay still finds itself on top of the OVC race, although the margin is now much closer, as four teams are within a game or less of the Govs, and another team is two games back...APSU began its road trip with a 71-62 win over Eastern Kentucky (completing a sweep of the Colonels) and ended it with a 69-56 loss at Morehead State...After scoring 86 points in its win over MSU in Clarksville, Austin Peay scored a season-low 56 points in the return matchup in Morehead...APSU shot just 35.7 percent in that game, the second worst total of the season for the team (and lowest percentage in OVC play)...The loss was the first for the Governors in its last 13 games when it held its opponent to under 70 points...Freshman Will Triggs averaged 7.5 points and 7.5 rebounds/game last week while hitting 56.6 percent (5-of-9) from the field; he made his first career start at EKU and scored eight points and grabbed nine big rebounds in the victory...Austin Peay leading scorer TyShwan Edmondson was held to single-digit points in both games of the road trip, the first time this season he has been without double-digit points in back-to-back games this season; Edmondson is still the leading scorer in the OVC at 18.8 points/ game (1.7 points over the next closest scorer)...Austin Peay returns home with a pair of games this week; the Govs will host UT Martin on Thursday and rival Murray State on Saturday.

Eastern Kentucky saw its four-game winning streak come to an end on Thursday. as league-leading Austin Peay came to town and knocked off the Colonels 61-52... The week ended with an 86-72 victory over Tennessee State...The Colonels are now 6-5 in OVC play, just two games out of first place... Against Austin Peay the game was tied at 43 with 10:31 to play before a 7-0 Governors run gave them a lead that would not give up...Spencer Perrin finished the game with his second double-double of the season, scoring 19 points and pulling down 10 rebounds... Justin Stommes hit on 6-of-9 3-pointers and added 18 points...The six made 3-pointers were a career-high for Stommes...Two days later that duo each scored 22 points in the victory over Tennessee State...Stommes also added five assists in 34 minutes of action while Perrin pulled down six rebounds...EKU shot 61.4 percent for the game in the victory (best shooting night of the season against a Division I opponent for EKU), hitting 9-of-19 from long range (including 3-of-6 by Josh Daniel)...Stommes has now scored 17 or more points in three of his last four games...EKU has not finished the season with four players averaging at least 10 points/game since the 2000-01 season but currently Perrin (12.8), Daniel (11.9), Stommes (10.7) and Joshua Jones (10.4) are all above that mark...This week Eastern Kentucky will travel to Tennessee Tech and Jacksonville State for games.



JACKSONVILLE STATE GAMECOCKS (4-18, 2-9)

Team Notes

Entering the week with a 14-game losing streak, Jacksonville State ended the streak and started a winning one, topping Southeast Missouri 65-56 in overtime and Eastern Illinois 56-46 on the road...The back-to-back road victories were the first in OVC play for the Gamecocks since the 2005-06 season when they also won at SEMO and EIU...Senior forward Nick Murphy averaged 18.0 points, 7.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals/game in the two victories...In the process Murphy moved into fifth place on the school's career scoring list (1,395) and became the all-time Division I leader in steals in the history of the program (he currently has 173)...Murphy had 19 points, all after halftime, in the come-from-behind victory against Southeast Missouri, while also pulling down eight rebounds, dishing out two assists and getting two steals...In the win on Saturday, Murphy had 17 points (13 in the second half) while grabbing seven rebounds...In the Southeast Missouri State game, the Gamecocks never had a lead in regulation, and tied the game on a layup by Brian Williams with eight seconds to go...But in overtime JSU scored the first points and never trailed in picking up the victory...Jax State made 11-of-12 free throw in the overtime period in out-scoring the Redhawks by nine points...Against EIU, Jeremy Bynum hit a 3-pointer right before halftime to put his team up 21-19 and the Gamecocks would not trail again in pulling away during the second half...Jacksonville State will return home for three-straight games, including matchups this week with Morehead State and Eastern Kentucky.

After losing two games in a row, Morehead State rebounded with three big wins last week and are now just one game out of first place in the OVC...The Eagles started the week with a 50-48 road victory over Ball State, a team that entered the game in first place in the Mid-American Conference...MSU returned home and topped the two teams at the top of the OVC standings, knocking off Tennessee State 72-65 before disposing of first place Austin Peay 69-56; both victories avenged overtime losses on the road to the two teams earlier this season... Senior Kenneth Faried had another big week, averaging 17.7 points and 18.0 rebounds/game after netting double-doubles in each of those contests...Faried was named OVC Player of the Week, the 12th time in his career he has won the award, which is now an OVC all-time record...Faried is now averaging 14.3 rebounds/game, which continues to lead Division I; that number is even higher in 11 OVC games (15.5)...Faried had 13 points and 15 rebounds in the win over Ball State, 23 points and 23 boards against TSU and 17 points and 16 rebounds in the win over Austin Peay...The 20/20 game was the second of the season for Faried (and fourth of his career) and one of just four total 20/20 games nationally this season...Faried also took back the national lead in double-doubles (18) and his 75 career double-doubles ranks 10th in NCAA history...After trailing by 14 points with 12:55 to play against TSU, the Eagles used a 24-7 run to grab a lead for good...In the victory over APSU, five Eagles scored in double figures and the team hit 50 percent from the field for the game...Morehead State will go on the road this week to battle Jacksonville State on Thursday and Tennessee Tech on Saturday.

OVC Tournament Tiebreaker System

Regular season standings will be the determining factor in setting first-round pairings for the tournament. All ties will be broken starting at the top of the conference standings and working down. The tiebreaking system will utilize the following factors, in order, until all ties are broken.

TWO-WAY TIES

- 1. Records in head-to-head competition are compared, with the higher seed going to the team that has won the most games against the other.
- 2. In the event step 1 does not resolve the tie (i.e. if the two teams split their games during the season), then the records of the tying teams against the No. 1 seed shall be compared. The team with the better record against the No. 1 seed shall gain the higher seed.
- 3. If the potential No. 1 seed is among tied teams, the process in step 2 will begin at the highest point in the standings which does not involve a tied team.
- 4. The process continues, through the No. 11 team in the standings, if necessary.
- 5. In the event the tie cannot be broken, seeds will be determined by a coin flip.

MULTIPLE TIES

- Composite records between the tying teams will be evaluated to determine whether one team has won more games against the other tying
 institutions (in which case that team would receive the higher seed) and/or one team has won the least number of games among the tied teams (in
 which case the team will receive the lowest seed, and/or two teams have the same composite record (in which case the two-team tiebreaker scenario
 shall be utilized).
- 2. In the event step 1 does not solve the multiple ties, or reduce the multiple ties to one tie, then a comparison of records of the tying institutions against the No. 1 seed will occur. The team among the tying institutions with the better record against the No. 1 seed will receive the higher seed.
- 3. If the potential No. 1 seed is among tied teams, the process in step 2 will begin at the highest point in the standings which does not involve a tied team.
- 4. The process continues, through the No. 11 team in the standings, if necessary.
