## OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

## **OFFENSIVE**

JAVARRIS WILLIAMS • RB, SO., 5'11, 212 • **RICHMOND, TEXAS • TENNESSEE STATE** 

Williams rushed for 162 yards on 35 carries and caught three passes for another 35 yards for 197 yards of total offense in a 29-7 win over Samford. This marked the sixth 100-yard rushing game this season for Williams. The sophomore running back also passed the 1,000-yard mark for the season with 1,045. Williams moved into fourth place for career rushers at TSU.

#### **DEFENSIVE**

KEVIN RONDO • FS, JR., 5'10, 180 • **COLUMBUS, OHIO • UT MARTIN** 

Rondo had 10.5 tackles, including eight solo stops, in the 15-9 win over Eastern Illinois. The junior FS also had 1.5 tackles for loss. He helped the Skyhawk defense limit EIU to 156 yards rushing and 37 passing yards.

#### **SPECIALIST**

ZACH WALDEN • P, JR., 5'10, 170 • **DALLAS, GA. • JACKSONVILLE STATE** 

Walden set a school record and tied another record in Jacksonville State's 17-10 overtime win over Tennessee Tech. The junior punter booted a careerlong 81 vard punt, which was the longest punt in JSU's Division I history. He also tied his own school mark with four punts inside the TTU 20-yard line. He averaged 42.6 yards on eight punts in the game.

#### **NEWCOMER**

AARON WILLIAMS • LB, FR., 5'11 222 • SANFORD, FLA. • TENNESSEE TECH

Williams led a Tennessee Tech defense that limited Jacksonville State to just 67 yards rushing and 231 yards of total offense in a 17-10 overtime loss. The freshman LB had a career-high 15 tackles, including two behind the line for seven yards in losses. It was his fifth game of double-figure tackles this season.

## 2006 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE FOOTBALL NOTES

#### EASTERN ILLINOIS (5-4, 4-1 OVC)

Eastern Illinois had its 13-game OVC win streak snapped as the Panthers fell to UT Martin, 15-9, on Saturday afternoon. Senior RB Vincent Webb rushed for 106 yards against the nation's fifth ranked defense. Webb cracked the 100-yard mark for the 20th time in his career and seventh time this season. Junior LB Donald Thomas was a force all over the field during the game. He had 11 tackles on the day with nine solo stops. Thomas also recoved a fumble on a punt that led to EIU's first points of the game. The Panthers limited UT Martin to 130 yards rushing and 77 yards passing. Eastern Illinois entertains Tennessee State this Saturday. The game can be seen locally on WEIU-TV.

#### EASTERN KENTUCKY (3-5, 2-3 OVC)

Eastern Kentucky is coming off a bye week and will host Murray State on Saturday. The Colonels lead the all-time series 36-25-4. The last time that EKU and MSU met was in 2005 with the Colonels taking the 43-7 win.

#### JACKSONVILLE STATE (4-4, 4-2 OVC)

Jacksonville State picked up a 17-10 overtime win over Tennessee Tech on Saturday. It marked the fifth overtime game in school history and JSU's first victory in overtime. Junior QB Matt Hardin threw for 164 yards, completing 13-of-22 through the air, including a 17-yard touchdown pass to junior WR Taurean Rhetta to give JSU the win. Rhetta also blocked his third punt of the season and fifth of his career in the second quarter. Sophomore P Zach Walden booted a career-long 81-yard punt, which was the longest punt in JSU's Divsion I history. He also tied his own school mark with four punts inside the Tech 20-yard line. He averaged 42.6 yards on eight punts in the game. Senior RB Clay Green scored his 11th touchdown of the season on 1-yard run with 1:42 left in the third quarter. It was his 29th career rushing TD and the 31st of his career. He now has 186 carreer points and needs just 14 more to become the seventh player in JSU history with 200 or more career points. The Gamecocks will step out of Conference play this week as they travel to Chattanooga on Saturday. The game will be tape delayed locally on WJXS-TV.

#### MURRAY STATE (1-8, 0-6 OVC)

Murray State jumped out to an early 7-0 lead against Southeast Missouri and then staged a comeback to tie the game after going down by 10 points, but the Redhawks scored a fourth quarter touchdown to beat the Racers, 24-17. Freshman S Taylor Lanigan returned a blocked punt for a TD and junior LB Nathan Williams returned a fumble 24 yards to led the MSU defense. Freshman WR Shane McClesky, making just his second appearance of the season, scored his first collegiate TD when he caught a 30-yard pass from freshman QB Zac Barnard. Barnard finished the game with 200 yards passing. Murray State will travel to Eastern Kentucky on Saturday.

#### **SAMFORD (3-6, 1-5 OVC)**

Samford fell to Tennessee State, 29-7, on Saturday. Senior DB Quinton Griffin registered seven tackles, including five solo stops. He also blocked a field goal in the game. Senior P Chris Hicks punted five times for an average of 49.0 yards per kick. He had a long of 56 yards and placed one kick inside the TSU 20-yard line. Samford will host Tennessee Tech in its final home game of the 2006 campaign this week.

#### <u>SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (4-4, 2-3 OVC)</u>

Southeast Missouri defeated Murray State, 24-17, on Saturday. Sophomore RB Tim Holloman rushed 24 times for a career-high 212 yards and two touchdowns. He had a TD run of 27 yards and a 76-yard run with the winning score with 9:14 remaining in the game. Senior DE Edgar Jones tallied six solo tackles and two tackles for losses of eight yards. He also had one quarterback sack for a loss of six yards. Freshman RB Tony Anderson rushed 25 times for a career-best 92 yards and one TD. The Redhawks will host UT Martin this week.

#### TENNESSEE STATE (5-3, 4-0 OVC)

Tennessee State defeated Samford, 29-7, on Saturday. Sophomore RB Javarris Williams rushed for 162 yards on 35 carries and caught three passes for another 35 yards for 197 yards of total offense. It marked the sixth time this season Williams has reached the 100-yard rushing mark. He also passed the 1,000 yard mark on the season and now has 1,045. Williams moved into fourth place for career rushers at Tennessee State. Sophomore QB Antonio Heffner passed for 105 yards while also rushing for 40 yards and three TDs before leaving in the fourth quarter with a bruised shoulder. The Tigers will hit the road this week when they travel to Eastern Illinois on Saturday.

#### TENNESSEE TECH (2-6, 2-3 OVC)

Tennessee Tech dropped a 17-10 overtime loss to Jacksonville State despite a Golden Eagle defense that limited the league's third-ranked rushing offense to only 67 yards on the ground. Freshman LB Aaron Williams had a career-high 15 tackles, including two for losses of seven yards. It was his fifth game with double-digit tackles. Tech had seven tackles for losses for a combined 35 yards and had three quarterback sacks. Sophomore DB Maurice Smith had eight tackles and two tackles for losses while junior DT Geoffrey Woods tallied eight tackles and 2.5 TFL. Freshman PK Nate Johnson made a career-long 36-yard field goal to give Tech the 3-0 lead. The Golden Eagles will travel to Samford this week.

#### **UT MARTIN (7-1, 4-0 OVC)**

UT Martin won its seventh straight game Saturday when it beat Eastern Illinois, 15-9. The last time the Skyhawks won seven consecutive games was in 1988 en route to an 11-2 record and the Division II Playoffs. Freshman QB Greg Preston had three carries for 18 yards and he completed 12-of-29 passes for 77 yards. For the second straight week, junior RB Don Chapman flirted with 100 yards rushing. He had 25 carries for 94 yards in the game. The Skyhawk defense limited EIU to 193 yards of total offense, marking the third time this season UTM has held a team to less that 200 yards of offense. Junior FS Kevin Rondo had 10.5 tackles, including eight solo stops. He also had 1.5 tackles for loss. Sophomore P Adam Ivey had four punts for a total of 155 yards. He averaged 38.8 yards per punt and put two inside the 20-yard line. UT Martin will travel to Southeast Missouri this Saturday.

#### **OVC RECORDS WATCH**

Eastern Illinois junior Micah Rucker has nine receiving touchdowns, six off the OVC record of 15 (Samford's Efrem Hill, 2003) while Jacksonville State senior Clay Green has 11 rushing touchdowns, 10 short of the Conference mark of 21 (Eastern Kentucky's Elroy Harris, 1988). Southeast Missouri senior David Simonhoff currently sports a 45.3 punting average, not far off his OVC-record mark of 46.0, set in 2004.
