# OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

#### **OFFENSIVE**

DON CHAPMAN • RB, JR., 5'10, 215 • MARIETTA, GA. • UT MARTIN

Chapman had 36 carries for 225 yards and three touchdowns in the Skyhawks' 28-14 win over Southeast Missouri. He scored on runs of 3, 1, and 81 yards in the second half. The junior RB also had one reception for 14 yards.

#### **DEFENSIVE**

DONALD THOMAS • LB, JR., 5'10, 237 • ST. LOUIS, MO. • EASTERN ILLINOIS

Thomas spearheaded an EIU defense that held the Conference's top rusher, Javarris Williams, to only 38 yards rushing during the Panthers 29-3 win over Tennessee State. Thomas had 12 tackles, including two solo stops and two for losses as EIU limited the Tigers to 49 yards on the ground and 211 yards total.

#### **SPECIALIST**

JESSIE BURTON • WR, JR., 5'10, 185 • McCOMB, MISS. • UT MARTIN

Burton had a 100-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in the 28-14 win over Southeast Missouri. The touchdown opened the second half and tied the game at 7-7. The junior WR had two kick returns for a total of 119 yards and two punt returns for 27 yards. He finished the day with 146 return yards. His kickoff return for a TD was his second of the season.

#### **NEWCOMER**

COLE STINSON • QB, JR., 6'5 238 • ESTERO, FLA. • EASTERN ILLINOIS

Stinson led Eastern Illinois to a 29-3 win over Tennessee State as the Panthers compiled 423 yards of total offense. The junior QB was 21-for-35 for 223 yards with one touchdown. Stinson also added a rushing touchdown from one yard out.

# DETERMINATION OF COMPETING INSTITUTIONS FOR THE NCAA DIVISION I FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

#### **CHAMPIONSHIP STRUCTURE**

The Division I Football Championship provides for a maximum field of 16 teams. Teams will play first-round games on the campuses of competing teams. Eight member conferences have been granted automatic qualification for the 2006 championship. The remaining eight teams will be selected at-large by the Division I-AA football committee. The top four teams in the 16-team bracket for the championship will be seeded. Team pairings will be determined by geographical proximity, with the exception that teams from the same conference may not be paired in the first round.

#### **CHAMPIONSHIP SELECTION**

At-large teams shall be selected by the Division I-AA football committee, assisted by four regional advisory committees that serve in an advisory capacity only.

The following principles shall apply when selecting at-large teams:

- 1. The committee shall select the best teams available on a national at-large basis to complete the bracket;
- 2. There is no limit to the number of teams the committee may select from one conference;
- 3. The won-lost record of a team will be scrutinized to determine a team's strength of schedule; however, less than seven Division I wins may place a team in jeopardy of not being selected;
- 4. The committee may give more consideration to those teams that have played all Division I opponents; and
- 5. If the team of a committee member is under consideration, the member may not vote for the team being considered and will not be in the room when a vote is taken.

#### **AUTOMATIC QUALIFIERS**

The following conferences have been granted automatic-qualification privileges for the 2006 championship:

Atlantic 10 Conference Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference Southern Conference Big Sky Conference OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE Southland Conference

Gateway Football Conference Patriot League

Additional Football Criteria. Conferences must conduct regular-season, round-robin play among the members to determine the champion. The Division I-AA football committee may grant exceptions to the round-robin requirement subject to approval of the NCAA Executive Committee.

#### **PAIRINGS**

All pairings will be made by the Division I-AA football committee. The following principles are applied when pairing teams:

- 1. The teams awarded the top four seeds are placed in the appropriate positions in the bracket (Nos. 1 and 4 in the upper half, and Nos. 2 and 3 in the lower half), and will be paired with teams that are in closest geographic proximity;
- 2. The remaining teams will be paired according to geographic proximity and placed in the bracket according to geographic proximity of the four pairings previously placed in the bracket.
- 3. Teams from the same conference will not be paired for first-round games;
- 4. Once the first-round pairings have been determined, there will be no adjustments to the bracket.

#### **SEMIFINAL DETERMINATION PROCEDURE**

The semifinal games during the 2006 Division I Football Championship will be conducted on two different days. One semifinal game will occur Friday evening, December 8, while the other will occur Saturday afternoon, December 9. Both games will be broadcast nationally on ESPN2 and ESPN, respectively.

The Division I-AA football committee has determined that the two remaining teams in the top half of the 16-team championship bracket will play Friday night, while the two remaining teams in the bottom half of the bracket will play Saturday afternoon. Please note, however, that the determination of which teams play on which dates is subject to change if issues arise (e.g., host facility specifications) that necessitate a change in the best interest of the championship. All eight teams participating in quarterfinal competition will be made aware before their games of the won-loss scenarios that will dictate which teams play Friday night or Saturday afternoon.

# 2006 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE FOOTBALL NOTES

#### EASTERN ILLINOIS (6-4, 5-1 OVC)

Eastern Illinois handed Tennessee State its first OVC loss of the season as the Panthers defeated the Tigers, 29-3, on Saturday. Senior RB Vincent Webb cracked the 4,000 yard rushing mark for his career as he rushed for 82 yards scoring two touchdowns versus TSU. Webb also caught six passes for 46 yard and one TD. Junior LB Donald Thomas spearheaded an EIU defense that held the Conference's top rusher, Javarris Williams, to only 38 yards rushing. Thomas had 12 tackles, including two solo stops and two for losses as the Panthers limited the Tigers to 39 yards on the ground and 211 total yards. Junior QB Cole Stinson was 21-for-25 for 223 yards. He passed for one touchdown and had an interception in the game. Eastern Illinois compiled 423 yards of total offense during the win. The Panthers will hit the road this week as they travel to Tennessee Tech on Saturday.

#### EASTERN KENTUCKY (4-5, 4-3 OVC)

Eastern Kentucky defeated Murray State, 51-21, to win back-to-back games for the first time this season. Junior RB Mark Dunn had 10 carries for 92 yards and three touchdowns. He also hauled in one pass for 23 yards for 115 yards of total offense. Sophomore WR Davin Walker returned a kickoff 100 yards for a touchdown in the second quarter. It marked EKU's first kickoff return for a TD in almost two years. Sophomore S Zach Denton finished the game with four tackles. He also blocked a punt that resulted in a safety and recorded his first career interception. The Colonels tallied a season-high five sacks versus the Racers led by senior DT Mark Christiani with 1.5 sacks. Eastern Kentucky will travel to UT Martin on Satuday.

#### JACKSONVILLE STATE (5-4, 4-2 OVC)

Jacksonville State won a 13-10 non-conference decision over Chattanooga on Saturday. Senior RB Clay Green tied a career-high 163 yards on 22 carries and one TD to led JSU. He also added two kickoff returns for 44 yards and two receptions for 13 yards to finish with 220 all-purpose yards. Senior DB Montae Pitts finished with six tackles and one pass break-up. Pitts helped limit Chattanooga to just 47 passing yards through three quarters. Junior QB Matt Hardin passed for 130 yards, marking his 10th career 100-yard passing game. Sophomore PK Gavin Hallford kicked a 22-yard field goal in the first quarter and then a 23 yard-field goal in the fourth quater. He is a perfect 12-of-12 from the 20-29 yard range this season. Jacksonville State will host Samford this Saturday. The game can be seen regionally on CSS.

#### MURRAY STATE (1-9, 0-7 OVC)

Murray State allowed Eastern Kentucky to jump out to a 23-7 first quarter lead and never recovered as the Racers dropped a 51-21 decision in Richmond, Ky. Senior QB Ryne Salyer came into the game in the second quarter and finished with 207 yards and a pair of touchdowns on 18-of-24 passing. Sophomore WR Rod Harper caught five passes for 138 yards and two TDs. Redshirt freshman WR DeAngelo Nelson caught his first-career touchdown pass. Nine different players had at least one catch for the Racers. Junior CB Derrick Parrott returned a kickoff 63 yards in the second quarter. The Racers will have a bye week before returning for their season finale at home against UT Martin on Nov. 18.

#### **SAMFORD (3-7, 1-6 OVC)**

Samford fell to Tennessee Tech, 20-14, on Saturday. Junior WR Jeff Moore returned a punt 62 yards for touchdown late in the first quarter. Moore average 33.0 yards per punt on two returns in the game. Senior DB Chase McTorry had seven solo tackles, an interception and a fumble recover in the loss. McTorry returned the interception 27 yards. Sophomore DB Matt Butler has seven tackles and a forced fumble in the game. Six of Butler's seven tackles were solo stops. The Bulldogs conclude their 2006 campaign at Jacksonville State this Saturday. The game can be seen regionally on CSS.

#### SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (4-5, 2-4 OVC)

Southeast Missouri fell to UT Martin, 28-14, on Saturday. Senior WR Oge Oge tallied five catches for 91 yards and one touchdown in the game. Junior LB Adam Casper had a game-high 13 tackles, including nine solo stops. Senior P David Simonhoff recorded five punts for an average of 44.2 yards. He had a long punt of 51 yards and put one inside the 20-yard line. Southeast Missouri will travel to Tennessee State this week.

#### TENNESSEE STATE (5-4, 4-1 OVC)

Tennessee State suffered its first OVC loss of the season as Eastern Illinois defeated the Tigers, 29-3. Senior QB Richard Hartman started for the injured Antonio Heffner and passed for 162 yards. Sophomore RB Javarris Williams was limited to 38 yards rushing on 15 carries. Williams also had three catches for 17 yards. Tennessee State will host Southeast Missouri on Saturday.

#### TENNESSEE TECH (3-6, 3-3 OVC)

Tennessee Tech claimed its second OVC road win of the season with a 20-14 victory at Samford. Freshman QB Lee Sweeney passed for 232 yards and rushed for 17 to account for 249 yards of total offense. Sweeney passed for two touchdowns. Junior taliback Derek White rushed for 117 yards and senior taliback Anthony Ash gained 102 yars while junior WR Larry Shipp caught five passes for 121 yards. White moved into 10th place on Tech's career rushing list and Shipp climbed to third in career receiving. Freshman PK Nate Johnson kicked two field goals and two PATs to account for eight of Tech's points. The Golden Eagles play their final home game of 2006 season on Saturday when they host Eastern Illinois. The game will be tape delayed locally on WCTE-TV.

#### **UT MARTIN (8-1, 5-0 OVC)**

UT Martin won its eighth straight victory and remained undefeated in OVC play with a 28-14 win over Southeast Missouri. Junior Don Chapman had 36 carries for 225 yards and three touchdowns. He also had one reception for 14 yards. Chapman needs just 73 rushing yards to hit the 1,000-yard mark for the season. Senior K Taylor Brown has now kicked 23 consecutive PATs. Junior WR Jessie Burton had a 100-yard kickoff return for a touchdown to open the second half. His TD tied the game at 7-7. Burton had two kick returns for a total of 119 yards and two punt returns for 27 yards. Senior LB David Gilmore led the Skyhawks with six tackles, including four solo stops. UT Martin will host Eastern Kentucky on Saturday. The game will be tape delayed locally on WLJT-TV

#### **OVC TEAMS IN TOP 25**

Eastern Illinois and UT Martin continue to be ranked in both of the latest Sports Network and CSN Coaches Polls, which were released on Oct. 30 UT Martin climbed into the 8th spot in both polls while Eastern Illinois remained at No. 20.

#### **OVC RECORDS WATCH**

Eastern Illinois junior Micah Rucker has nine receiving touchdowns, six off the OVC record of 15 (Samford's Efrem Hill, 2003) while Jacksonville State senior Clay Green has 12 rushing touchdowns, 9 short of the Conference mark of 21 (Eastern Kentucky's Elroy Harris, 1988). Southeast Missouri senior David Simonhoff currently sports a 45.2 punting average, not far off his OVC-record mark of 46.0, set in 2004.

# **OVC TIEBREAKER**

In the event of a tie for the Ohio Valley Conference championship, the following procedures will be used to break all ties to determine the league's NCAA I-AA playoff representative:

#### **TWO-WAY TIES**

- 1.) A two-way tie shall exist only if the tied teams have the same number of losses.
- 2.) Should two teams have the same number of losses, and the two teams played each other during the regular season, the winner of the head-to-head contest shall be the league's postseason representative.
- 3.) If the two tied teams have the same number of losses, but did not play each other during the regular season, the following procedure shall be utilized to break the tie:
- a.) A comparison of each team's head-to-head record against the team occupying the highest position in the regular-season standings that each team has played. If one team won its game against that team, the winning team shall be declared the representative.
- b.) Should the procedure outlined in Item a. fail to break the tie, the process will continue to the next-place team and beyond until the tie is broken.
- c.) When arriving at another group of tied teams, composite records between the tying teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.
- 4.) If the procedures described previously fail to break the tie, the representative shall be determined by a coin flip.

#### **MULTIPLE TIES**

- 1.) A multiple tie (three or more teams) shall exist only if the tied teams have the same number of losses.
- 2.) If all of the teams involved in the multiple tie played each other during the regular season, then the composite records among the tied teams shall be compared to break the tie.
- 3.) If the process outlined in Step 2 reduces the tie to a tie among two teams, the two-team tiebreaker formula shall then be utilized.
- 4.) If not all of the tied teams played each other during the regular season, or if step 2 does not break or reduce the tie, the following procedure shall be utilized:

  a.) A comparison of each of the tied teams' head-to-head record against
- the team occupying the highest position in the regular-season standings that each team has played. If one team won its game against that team, the winning team shall be declared the representative.
- b.) Should the procedure outlined in Item a. fail to break the tie, the process will continue to the next-place team and beyond until the tie is broken.
- c.) When arriving at another group of tied teams, composite records between the tying teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.
- 5.) If the procedures described previously fail to break the tie, the representative shall be determined by a blind drawing.
