OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSIVE

DON CHAPMAN • RB, JR., 5'10, 215 •
MARIETTA, GA. • UT MARTIN

Chapman rushed for 171 yards and two touchdowns on 31 carries as the Skyhawks fell to Eastern Kentucky, 31-28. Chapman recorded his third consecutive 1,000-yard rushing season. The junior running back has 1,098 yards on the season and 3,578 career rushing yards. He is 101 yards away from being among the OVC career rushing leaders.

DEFENSIVE

BRANDON GATHOF • SS, SO, 6'1, 205 •
LaGRANGE, KY. • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Gathof tied a personal-best with a game-high 12 tackles, including nine solo stops as Eastern Kentucky handed UT Martin its first OVC loss of the season. The sophomore strong safety added a sack and an interception which set up ECU's third touchdown of the game.

SPECIALIST

MATT SCHOBORG • WR, SR., 6'0, 196 •
INDEPENDENCE, KY. • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Schoborg blocked two punts as the Colonels defeated UT Martin, 31-28. The senior wide receiver's second block occurred with :34 second remaining in regulation and set up the game-winning field goal against the Skyhawks.

NEWCOMER

BOBBY WASHINGTON • RB, JR., 6'0 219 •
MIAMI, FLA. • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Washington finished with a team season-high 119 yards rushing on 22 carries against the nation's sixth-ranked rushing defense. The junior running back tallied a personal best two rushing touchdowns in the win over UT Martin. Washington also added a team-high six receptions for 38 yards.

DETERMINATION OF COMPETING INSTITUTIONS FOR THE NCAA DIVISION I FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

CHAMPIONSHIP STRUCTURE

The Division I Football Championship provides for a maximum field of 16 teams. Teams will play first-round games on the campuses of competing teams. Eight member conferences have been granted automatic qualification for the 2006 championship. The remaining eight teams will be selected at-large by the Division I-AA football committee. The top four teams in the 16-team bracket for the championship will be seeded. Team pairings will be determined by geographical proximity, with the exception that teams from the same conference may not be paired in the first round.

CHAMPIONSHIP SELECTION

At-large teams shall be selected by the Division I-AA football committee, assisted by four regional advisory committees that serve in an advisory capacity only.

The following principles shall apply when selecting at-large teams:

1. The committee shall select the best teams available on a national at-large basis to complete the bracket;
2. There is no limit to the number of teams the committee may select from one conference;
3. The won-lost record of a team will be scrutinized to determine a team's strength of schedule; however, less than seven Division I wins may place a team in jeopardy of not being selected;
4. The committee may give more consideration to those teams that have played all Division I opponents; and
5. If the team of a committee member is under consideration, the member may not vote for the team being considered and will not be in the room when a vote is taken.

Additional Football Criteria. Conferences must conduct regular-season, round-robin play among the members to determine the champion. The Division I-AA football committee may grant exceptions to the round-robin requirement subject to approval of the NCAA Executive Committee.

PAIRINGS

All pairings will be made by the Division I-AA football committee. The following principles are applied when pairing teams:

1. The teams awarded the top four seeds are placed in the appropriate positions in the bracket (Nos. 1 and 4 in the upper half, and Nos. 2 and 3 in the lower half), and will be paired with teams that are in closest geographic proximity;
2. The remaining teams will be paired according to geographic proximity and placed in the bracket according to geographic proximity of the four pairings previously placed in the bracket.
3. Teams from the same conference will not be paired for first-round games;
4. Once the first-round pairings have been determined, there will be no adjustments to the bracket.

SEMIFINAL DETERMINATION PROCEDURE

The semifinal games during the 2006 Division I Football Championship will be conducted on two different days. One semifinal game will occur Friday evening, December 8, while the other will occur Saturday afternoon, December 9. Both games will be broadcast nationally on ESPN2 and ESPN, respectively.

The Division I-AA football committee has determined that the two remaining teams in the top half of the 16-team championship bracket will play Friday night, while the two remaining teams in the bottom half of the bracket will play Saturday afternoon. Please note, however, that the determination of which teams play on which dates is subject to change if issues arise (e.g., host facility specifications) that necessitate a change in the best interest of the championship. All eight teams participating in quarterfinal competition will be made aware before their games of the won-loss scenarios that will dictate which teams play Friday night or Saturday afternoon.

2006 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE FOOTBALL NOTES

EASTERN ILLINOIS (7-4, 6-1 OVC)

Eastern Illinois defeated Tennessee Tech, 38-14, on Saturday afternoon. Junior QB Cole Stinson threw for a season-high 275 yards and three touchdowns in the win. Stinson was 19-for-38 with a long pass of 43 yards. Junior WR Micah Rucker hauled in two touchdown passes to give him 11 for the season. Rucker had six catches for 99 yards as he became the first EIU receiver to record over 800 yards receiving since the 1986 season. Eastern Illinois will close out the regular-season at home this Saturday as the Panthers host Jacksonville State. The game can be seen locally on WEIU-TV.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (5-5, 4-3 OVC)

Eastern Kentucky handed UT Martin its first OVC loss of the season as the Colonels defeated the Skyhawks, 31-28. Junior RB Bobby Washington finished with a team season-high 119 yards rushing on 22 carries against the nation's sixth-ranked rushing defense. He had two rushing touchdowns and added a team-best six receptions for 38 yards. Sophomore SS Brandon Gathof tied a personal-best with a game-high 12 tackles, including nine solo stops. Gathof added a sack and an interception. Senior WR Matt Schoborg blocked two punts against UT Martin. Schoborg's second block occurred with :34 seconds remaining in the regulation and set up the game-winning field goal. With the win the Colonels have now won three straight road games and improved to 18-0 versus the Skyhawks. Eastern Kentucky will host Tennessee State this Saturday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (6-4, 5-2 OVC)

Jacksonville State defeated Samford, 55-7, on Saturday afternoon. Senior RB Clay Green recorded his 13th career 100-yard rushing game with 110 yards on 22 carries and scored two touchdowns. Green also had four receptions for 31 yards. On the first play of the game, senior DB Craig Agee intercepted a Samford pass and returned it 17 yards to give the Gamecocks a quick 7-0 lead. Agee finished with four tackles from his defensive position and also added four punt returns for 23 yards. Sophomore P Zach Walden averaged 42.0 yards on three punts. Walden put one punt inside the 20-yard line and one inside the 5-yard line. Junior QB Matt Hardin passed for 218 yards and two touchdowns in the win. The Gamecocks travel to Eastern Illinois this Saturday.

MURRAY STATE (1-9, 0-7 OVC)

Murray State is coming off a bye week and will host UT Martin in the final game of the Racers' season. Murray State leads the all-time series, 31-10-1. The last time the Racers and Skyhawks met was in 2005 with UT Martin coming away with the 49-20 win. The game will be tape-delayed locally on MSU-TV.

SAMFORD (3-8, 1-7 OVC)

Samford concluded its 2006 campaign with a 55-7 loss at Jacksonville State. Sophomore LB Rodney Shephard led all tacklers with 11, including eight solo stops. Senior DB Quinton Griffin returned four kicks for 97 yards for an average of 24.3 yards per punt. Griffin had a long return of 45 yards on the day. The Bulldogs end the season with a 3-8 overall record and a 1-7 OVC mark.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (4-6, 2-5 OVC)

Southeast Missouri fell to Tennessee State, 31-0, on Saturday afternoon. Senior DL Edgar Jones, the national leader in sacks, had one sack for an eight yard loss, 1.5 tackles for losses of 10 yards and seven total tackles. Senior P David Simonhoff had three punts for an average of 43.7. Simonhoff also put two punts inside the 20-yard line. Southeast Missouri will host Tennessee Tech this Saturday to close out the 2006 campaign.

TENNESSEE STATE (6-4, 5-1 OVC)

Tennessee State defeated Southeast Missouri, 31-0, on Saturday afternoon. Senior QB Richard Hartman made his second straight start and threw for 152 yards. Sophomore Javarris Williams had 19 carries for 78 yards and two touchdowns. The Tigers will travel to Eastern Kentucky this Saturday for its final game of the regular-season.

TENNESSEE TECH (3-7, 3-4 OVC)

Tennessee Tech dropped a 38-14 decision to visiting Eastern Illinois on Saturday. Rs.-Freshman LB Aaron Williams and senior LB Craig Simonton each recorded 11 tackles to lead the Tech defense against EIU. Freshman QB Lee Sweeney passed for 189 yards and two touchdowns. Senior WR Bryon Attrix grabbed his second TD of the season and senior WR Brent McNeal his third of the year to account for Tech's scoring. Senior RB Anthony Ash had a 64-yard run on the opening play of the game and Sweeney hit McNeal on a 15-yard strike on the second play for a TD to put the Golden Eagles up 7-0 less than a minute in to the contest. Ash finished with 107 yards, marking his second consecutive 100-yard game and fifth of his career. Junior TE Orlandus Kirby had a career-best three catches for 47 yards to lead Tech's receivers. Tech plays at Southeast Missouri this Saturday to close out the 2006 season.

UT MARTIN (8-2, 5-1 OVC)

UT Martin had its eight-game winning streak snapped as it dropped a 31-28 contest to Eastern Kentucky. It was the first OVC loss of the season for the Skyhawks. Junior RB Don Chapman rushed for 171 yards and two touchdowns on 31 carries. Senior LB David Gilmore had six tackles, including four solo stops. He also forced a fumble and had a fumble recovery as well as an interception in the game. Senior K Taylor Brown has now made 27 straight PATs. UT Martin will travel to Murray State to conclude the regular-season this Saturday.

Eastern Illinois and UT Martin continue to be ranked in both of the latest Sports Network and CSN Coaches Polls, which were released on Nov. 13. UT Martin dropped to 12th in the Sports Network Poll and 13th in the CSN Coaches Poll while Eastern Illinois climbed to 17th in both polls.

OVC RECORDS WATCH

Eastern Illinois junior Micah Rucker has 11 receiving touchdowns, four off the OVC record of 15 (Samford's Efram Hill, 2003) while Jacksonville State senior Clay Green has 14 rushing touchdowns, 7 short of the Conference mark of 21 (Eastern Kentucky's Elroy Harris, 1988). Southeast Missouri senior David Simonhoff currently sports a 45.1 punting average, not far off his OVC-record mark of 46.0, set in 2004.

OVC TIEBREAKER

In the event of a tie for the Ohio Valley Conference championship, the following procedures will be used to break all ties to determine the league's NCAA I-AA playoff representative:

TWO-WAY TIES

- 1.) A two-way tie shall exist only if the tied teams have the same number of losses.
- 2.) Should two teams have the same number of losses, and the two teams played each other during the regular season, the winner of the head-to-head contest shall be the league's postseason representative.
- 3.) If the two tied teams have the same number of losses, but did not play each other during the regular season, the following procedure shall be utilized to break the tie:
 - a.) A comparison of each team's head-to-head record against the team occupying the highest position in the regular-season standings that each team has played. If one team won its game against that team, the winning team shall be declared the representative.
 - b.) Should the procedure outlined in Item a. fail to break the tie, the process will continue to the next-place team and beyond until the tie is broken.
 - c.) When arriving at another group of tied teams, composite records between the tying teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.
- 4.) If the procedures described previously fail to break the tie, the representative shall be determined by a coin flip.

MULTIPLE TIES

- 1.) A multiple tie (three or more teams) shall exist only if the tied teams have the same number of losses.
- 2.) If all of the teams involved in the multiple tie played each other during the regular season, then the composite records among the tied teams shall be compared to break the tie.
- 3.) If the process outlined in Step 2 reduces the tie to a tie among two teams, the two-team tiebreaker formula shall then be utilized.
- 4.) If not all of the tied teams played each other during the regular season, or if step 2 does not break or reduce the tie, the following procedure shall be utilized:
 - a.) A comparison of each of the tied teams' head-to-head record against the team occupying the highest position in the regular-season standings that each team has played. If one team won its game against that team, the winning team shall be declared the representative.
 - b.) Should the procedure outlined in Item a. fail to break the tie, the process will continue to the next-place team and beyond until the tie is broken.
 - c.) When arriving at another group of tied teams, composite records between the tying teams shall be utilized to determine if one of the tied teams has won more games against the group of tied teams.
- 5.) If the procedures described previously fail to break the tie, the representative shall be determined by a blind drawing.
