OFFENSIVE

LEE SWEENEY • QB, FR., 6'3, 220 •

MT. JULIET, TENN. • TENNESSEE TECH

Sweeney set five individual school records while leading one of the biggest comebacks in school history as Tennessee Tech defeated Southeast Missouri, 32-29, after trailing 29-6 late in the third quarter. The freshman QB set records for most yards (437), most attempts (57), most completions (46), most yards of total offense (437) and most plays (64). All five were season highs by any OVC player this year. He threw TD passes of 18 and 49 yards to Larry Shipp, and directed scoring drives on five consecutive possessions in the final 18 minutes, including the game-winning drive in the final minute that went 60 yards in seven plays.

DEFENSIVE

KENNY BROWN • S, SR., 6'2, 175 •

CARTERSVILLE, GA. • JACKSONVILLE STATE

On the first play of the second quarter, Brown intercepted an EIU Cole Stinson pass and raced 83 yards for a touchdown to give JSU a 21-7 lead with 14:45 left in the second quarter. The Cartersville, Ga., native also finished with a team-high nine tackles, including four solo stops and one pass break-up. The JSU defense held EIU to just 92 rushing yards and held Vincent Webb to 74 yards on 24 carries.

SPECIALIST

CLAY GREEN • RB, SR., 6'0, 205 •

BIRMINGHAM, ALA. • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Green returned punts for the first time in his four-year career and took his first-ever punt return 59 yards for a touchdown to give Jacksonville State a 14-7 lead over nationally ranked Eastern Illinois. Green finished with 235 all-purpose yards, including 92 rushing, 11 receiving, 81 on punt returns and 51 on kickoff returns. The 41 all-purpose attempts set a JSU school Division I record.

DETERMINATION OF COMPETING INSTITUTIONS FOR THE NCAA DIVISION I FOOTBALL CHAMPIONSHIP

CHAMPIONSHIP STRUCTURE

The Division I Football Championship provides for a maximum field of 16 teams. Teams will play first-round games on the campuses of competing teams. Eight member conferences have been granted automatic qualification for the 2006 championship. The remaining eight teams will be selected at-large by the Division I-AA football committee. The top four teams in the 16-team bracket for the championship will be seeded. Team pairings will be determined by geographical proximity, with the exception that teams from the same conference may not be paired in the first round.

CHAMPIONSHIP SELECTION

At-large teams shall be selected by the Division I-AA football committee, assisted by four regional advisory committees that serve in an advisory capacity only.

The following principles shall apply when selecting at-large teams:

1. The committee shall select the best teams available on a national at-large basis to complete the bracket;
2. There is no limit to the number of teams the committee may select from one conference;
3. The won-lost record of a team will be scrutinized to determine a team's strength of schedule; however, less than seven Division I wins may place a team in jeopardy of not being selected;
4. The committee may give more consideration to those teams that have played all Division I opponents; and
5. If the team of a committee member is under consideration, the member may not vote for the team being considered and will not be in the room when a vote is taken.

Additional Football Criteria. Conferences must conduct regular-season, round-robin play among the members to determine the champion. The Division I-AA football committee may grant exceptions to the round-robin requirement subject to approval of the NCAA Executive Committee.

PAIRINGS

All pairings will be made by the Division I-AA football committee. The following principles are applied when pairing teams:

1. The teams awarded the top four seeds are placed in the appropriate positions in the bracket (Nos. 1 and 4 in the upper half, and Nos. 2 and 3 in the lower half), and will be paired with teams that are in closest geographic proximity;
2. The remaining teams will be paired according to geographic proximity and placed in the bracket according to geographic proximity of the four pairings previously placed in the bracket.
3. Teams from the same conference will not be paired for first-round games;
4. Once the first-round pairings have been determined, there will be no adjustments to the bracket.

SEMIFINAL DETERMINATION PROCEDURE

The semifinal games during the 2006 Division I Football Championship will be conducted on two different days. One semifinal game will occur Friday evening, December 8, while the other will occur Saturday afternoon, December 9. Both games will be broadcast nationally on ESPN2 and ESPN, respectively.

The Division I-AA football committee has determined that the two remaining teams in the top half of the 16-team championship bracket will play Friday night, while the two remaining teams in the bottom half of the bracket will play Saturday afternoon. Please note, however, that the determination of which teams play on which dates is subject to change if issues arise (e.g., host facility specifications) that necessitate a change in the best interest of the championship. All eight teams participating in quarterfinal competition will be made aware before their games of the won-loss scenarios that will dictate which teams play Friday night or Saturday afternoon.

2006 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE FOOTBALL NOTES

EASTERN ILLINOIS (8-4, 7-1 OVC)

Eastern Illinois defeated Jacksonville State, 28-24, to win a share of the 2006 OVC regular-season title. It marked the Panthers fourth regular-season crown and its second straight. Junior WR Micah Rucker made three catches for 106 yards and two touchdowns. Rucker finished the regular-season with 13 receptions and 966 receiving yards. Senior WR Ryan Voss recovered a fumble with 7:23 left in the fourth quarter that led to the Panthers game-winning score. Voss also had a touchdown reception in the game. Junior LB Donald Thomas had 16 tackles, including three solo stops and two tackles for loss of 12 yards. Eastern Illinois earned an at-large bid to the 2006 NCAA Division I Football Championship playoffs and will host Illinois State in the first round on Saturday, Nov. 25. Kickoff is set for 1:00 p.m. Central.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (6-5, 5-3 OVC)

Eastern Kentucky defeated Tennessee State, 20-3, to earn its 29th straight winning season. The Colonels have not had a losing record since 1972. Junior RB Mark Dunn carried the ball 20 times for 86 yards and two scores. It marked the third time this season that Dunn has had multiple rushing touchdowns. He added three catches for 68 yards to give him 144 of total offense. Sophomore QB Allan Holland completed 11-of-15 passes for 160 yards, tallying his highest completion percentage of the season. Junior LB Justin Curry recorded a career-high eight tackles to help the defense hold Tennessee State to their lowest point total of the season. He notched his second interception of the season and also caused a forced fumble. The Colonels recorded at least 340 yards of total offense in the final six games of the year. EKV finishes the season with a 6-5 overall record and a 5-3 OVC mark.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (6-5, 5-3 OVC)

Jacksonville State fell to Eastern Illinois, 28-24, to conclude the 2006 season. Senior RB Clay Green topped the 1,000-yard rushing plateau during the Gamecocks' opening drive. There have been just nine players in JSU's 102-year history to top 1,000 yards in a single-season. Green returned punts for the first time in his four-year career and took his first-ever punt 59 yards for a touchdown. He finished with 235 all-purpose yards, including 92 rushing, 11 receiving, 81 on punt returns and 51 on kickoff returns. Senior S Kenny Brown intercepted an Cole Stinson pass and raced 83 yards for a touchdown with 14:45 left in the first quarter. He finished with a team-high nine tackles, including four solo stops and one pass breakup. The JSU defense held the EIU offense to just 92 rushing yards. The Gamecocks finished the year with a 6-5 overall record and a 5-3 OVC mark.

MURRAY STATE (1-10, 0-8 OVC)

Murray State fell to UT Martin, 42-14, in its final game of the 2006 season. The Racers struggled offensively and watched as the Skyhawks broke open a 14-point game at halftime with 21 unanswered points to begin the second half. Senior P Tim Wright was called upon to punt 10 times and averaged 45.9 yards per punt. Two of his punts went for 62 and 54 yards. Senior RB Dante Woods finished with 55 yards on eight carries. Sophomore WR Rod Harper caught eight passes for 80 yards and had one touchdown grab. Freshman LB Tamar Butler finished with a game-high 12 tackles. Murray State ended the year with a 1-10 overall mark and a 0-8 OVC mark.

SAMFORD (3-8, 1-7 OVC)

Samford concluded its 2006 campaign with a 55-7 loss at Jacksonville State on Nov. 11. Sophomore LB Rodney Shephard led all tacklers with 11, including eight solo stops. Senior DB Quinton Griffin returned four kicks for 97 yards for an average of 24.3 yards per punt. Griffin had a long return of 45 yards on the day. The Bulldogs end the season with a 3-8 overall record and a 1-7 OVC mark.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (4-7, 2-6 OVC)

Southeast Missouri fell to Tennessee Tech, 32-29, to end its 2006 campaign. Senior QB Kevin Ballatore tallied 149 yards on 10-of-21 passing with a pair of touchdowns. Ballatore completed his first TD strike to Brandon Simpson in the first quarter and added a 53-yard scoring pass to Samora Goodson in the second quarter. Senior P David Simonoff made seven punts for 268 total yards. He had a long of 67 yards and put two punts inside the 20-yard line. The Redhawks finished the year with a 4-2 overall record while going 2-6 in the OVC.

TENNESSEE STATE (6-5, 5-2 OVC)

Tennessee State fell to Eastern Kentucky, 20-3, in its final game of the 2006 season. Junior QB Antonio Heffner returned to action and threw for 162 yards. Sophomore RB Javaris Williams had 17 carries for 72 yards. The Tigers concluded the season with a 6-5 overall record and a 5-2 OVC mark.

TENNESSEE TECH (4-7, 4-4 OVC)

Tennessee Tech came from behind to defeat Southeast Missouri, 32-29, to conclude the 2006 season. Freshman QB Lee Sweeney set five individual school records while leading the Golden Eagles to one of the biggest comebacks in schools history. Sweeney set records for most yards passing (437), most attempts (57), most completions (36), most yards of total offense (437) and most plays (64). All five were season highs by any OVC player this year. He two TD passes of 18 and 49 yards to Larry Shipp and directed scoring drives on five consecutive possessions in the final 18 minutes. Freshman RB Raymond Coleman scored Tech's first TD, a 61-yard run on his only attempt of the game. Junior LB Jaques Williams led the defensive effort with seven total tackles, including three tackles for loss. Freshman DB Taron Ryce broke up three passes and made his first career interception while sophomore DB Maurice Smith had his fourth interception of the season on the final play of the game. Freshman PK Nate Johnson kicked two field goals in the final two minutes, including the game-winner with seven seconds remaining. The Golden Eagles finished the year with a 4-7 overall record while going 4-4 in the OVC.

UT MARTIN (9-2, 6-1 OVC)

UT Martin defeated Murray State, 42-14, to win a share of its first OVC regular-season title. Junior TB Don Chapman rushed 30 times for 208 yards and three touchdowns in the win. He scored on runs of 30, 1 and 12 yards. This marked the third straight game Chapman has rushed for more than 100 yards, and it is also the third time this season he has rushed for more than 200 yards in game. Junior WR Jessie Burton had two catches for 51 yards and a touchdown. He scored the Skyhawks' first TD with a 35-yard reception from Greg Preston. Burton also had seven punt returns for 66 yards and one kickoff return for 11 yards. Senior LB Markeseo Jackson led the team with eight tackles, including six solo stops. He also had three pass breakups. Sophomore P Adam Ivey punted seven times for 274 yards. He averaged 39.1 yards per punt and had two punts inside the 20-yard line. Ivey had a long punt of 65 yards. The Skyhawks earned the league's automatic bid to the 2006 NCAA Division I Football Championship playoffs and will travel to Southern Illinois for the first round on Saturday, Nov. 25. Kickoff is set for 1:30 p.m. Central.

OVC TEAMS IN TOP 25

Eastern Illinois and UT Martin continue to be ranked in both of the latest Sports Network and CSN Coaches Polls, which were released on Nov. 20. UT Martin remained to 12th in the Sports Network Poll and jumped to 12th in the CSN Coaches Poll while Eastern Illinois climbed to 14th in the Sports Network Poll and 16th in the CSN Coaches Poll.

OVC RECORDS WATCH

Eastern Illinois junior Micah Rucker has 13 receiving touchdowns, two off the OVC record of 15 (Samford's Efre Hill, 2003) while Jacksonville State senior Clay Green has 15 rushing touchdowns, 6 short of the Conference mark of 21 (Eastern Kentucky's Elroy Harris, 1988). Southeast Missouri senior David Simonhoff ended the season with a 44.8 punting average, not far off his OVC-record mark of 46.0, set in 2004.
