OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSIVE

**CHAD COOK • RB, SR., 6-1, 230 •
NEW ORLEANS, LA • MURRAY STATE**

Cook rushed for a career-high 223 yards and three touchdowns to help Murray State claim its first win of the season with a 59-40 non-conference triumph over Indiana State. The senior running back averaged a gaudy 8.9 yards per carry while recording the eighth best single-game total in school history. His 223 yards is the highest single-game total in the OVC thus far in 2006.

DEFENSIVE

**DERRICK PARROTT • CB, JR., 6-0, 180 •
MAYFIELD, KY • MURRAY STATE**

Parrott did a little bit of everything to aid Murray State's 59-40 victory over Indiana State. The junior cornerback sealed the Racers' victory when he forced a fourth-quarter fumble, then picked it up and raced 25 yards to the end zone for the score. A native of Mayfield, Ky., Parrott also blocked an extra-point attempt and broke up two passes while recording nine tackles.

SPECIALIST

**DAVID SIMONHOFF • P, SR., 6-2, 200 •
CORAL GABLES, FL • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI**

Simonhoff punted eight times for an average of 51.2 yards per punt in Southeast Missouri's 38-7 Ohio Valley Conference loss at Jacksonville State. A senior from Coral Gables, Fla., Simonhoff had five punts go over 50 yards, including two over 60, with a long of 66 yards. He currently leads all of I-AA football with a season average of 48.29 yards per punt.

NEWCOMER

**MARCUS DAWSON • RB, JR., 6-0, 235 •
CINCINNATI, OH • UT MARTIN**

Dawson earned his first start of the season and responded by rushing 29 times for 150 yards and a touchdown in UT Martin's 35-9 non-conference win over Gardner-Webb. The junior running back from Cincinnati, Ohio, averaged 5.2 yards per carry, and scored his lone TD on a 5-yard run in the third quarter.

COLONELS AND GOLDEN EAGLES SQUARE OFF ON ESPNU: The Sept. 21 OVC opener between Eastern Kentucky and Tennessee Tech will be televised live on ESPNU. Kickoff is set for 6:30 p.m. Central with Charlie Neal and Jay Walker calling the action.

OTHER GAMES ON THE TUBE: In addition to Thursday's EPSNU broadcast, two Sept. 23 contests involving OVC squads will be available later that night on a tape-delayed basis at the local level. Jacksonville State and UT Martin's Conference matchup will be aired at 9:00 p.m. Central on WLJT-TV, while Murray State's non-conference meeting with Illinois State will be broadcast at 10:00 p.m. Central on MSU-TV.

THREE OVC TEAMS IN TOP-25 POLL: For the first time since pre-season 2003, the OVC has three teams ranked in at least one Top 25 I-AA poll. Jacksonville State's win over Southeast Missouri has landed the Gamecocks at No. 25 in the latest Sports Network I-AA poll, released on Monday. Meanwhile, losses by Eastern Illinois and Eastern Kentucky caused the Panthers and the Colonels to fall to No. 20 and No. 24, respectively, in the Sports Network poll. EIU was the only OVC squad to be ranked (No. 19) in the CSN Coaches I-AA poll, also released on Monday.

OVC VERSUS GATEWAY: The Sept. 23 meeting between Murray State and Illinois State is the final contest of 2006 between teams from the Ohio Valley and Gateway Conferences. The OVC is 3-1 this season against the Gateway and will finish the series at .600 or better, snapping a streak of four consecutive losing seasons to its Midwest-based rival.

SOUTHEAST IDLE: Southeast Missouri will have some extra time to recover from its Conference-opening loss to Jacksonville State. The Redhawks will have a bye this week before hosting Samford in their OVC home opener.

DEFENDING THE CROWN: Eastern Illinois begins defense of its OVC crown with a trip to Samford on Saturday. The Panthers, who ran the table en route to their third OVC title a year ago, have won nine straight versus league opponents, dating back to the final game of the 2004 campaign.

GRASS IS GREENER: Jacksonville State senior Clay Green extended his streak of 100-yard rushing contests versus OVC opponents to nine games, collecting 120 yards and a career-high three touchdowns on 17 carries against Southeast Missouri. Green, who has topped the century mark in nine of his last 10 games, moved into sixth place on the school's career rushing chart (2,151 yards).

RACERS WIN: Murray State defeated Indiana State, 59-40, on Saturday to give first-year head coach Matt Griffin his first Racer victory. MSU rolled up 514 yards of total offense and recorded its highest point total since the 2000 season while picking up its first-ever win in Terre Haute.

COOKING WITH GAS: Murray State senior Chad Cook moved into fourth and eighth place, respectively, on the school's all-time lists for touchdowns (24) and rushing yardage (2,015 yards). His career-high 223 rushing yards against Indiana State is the highest single-game effort to date in the OVC this season, and marked the eighth best total in school history.

BROWN KICKS WAY INTO RECORD BOOK: UT Martin senior Taylor Brown kicked four field goals and three PATs in the Skyhawks' 35-9 win over Gardner-Webb to set a new school single-game record for most points scored by kicking (15). Brown's field goal number fell just shy of the OVC record of five, held by former Tennessee Tech standout Ryan Weeks, who also owns the league's mark for points scored by kicking (22), registering both records in a 1989 outing against Chattanooga.

SIMONHOFF SHINES: Southeast Missouri senior David Simonhoff booted five punts over 50 yards and two over 60 yards, including a long of 66, in Southeast Missouri's 38-7 loss to Jacksonville State. Simonhoff's 51.2 average on eight punts fell just short of the OVC mark of 54.0 yards, set by former Middle Tennessee punter Mike Shawen versus Ball State in 1974.

FIELD GOAL STRING: Eastern Illinois sophomore Zach Yates has connected for a field goal in eight consecutive games and is one of two OVC kickers with a perfect mark in field goal attempts this season (3-of-3). The Idaho Falls, Idaho native was 9-of-13 in field goal tries as a rookie in 2005.

GAINING GROUND: Four of the league's top rushers are averaging at least 100 yards a game, led by Tennessee State sophomore Javaris Williams (118.3 ypg). Eastern Illinois senior Vincent Webb and Murray State senior Chad Cook are tied for second (116.7 ypg), while Jacksonville State senior Clay Green is fourth (110.0 ypg).

HAPPY RETURNS: Three weeks into the season, four OVC players find themselves among I-AA football's top return specialists. Eastern Kentucky sophomore Davin Walker (31.63 ypr) and Tennessee State senior Mike Mason (31.29 ypr) rank seventh and eighth in the nation, respectively, in kick return average, while Jacksonville State senior Craig Agee (16.29 ypr) and UT Martin junior E.J. Daniel (15.75 ypr) are 10th and 11th, respectively, in punt return average.

OPTING TO PUNT: Southeast Missouri senior David Simonhoff's 51.2 punting average against Jacksonville State last week has propelled him to the top of the I-AA punting leaderboard. Through games of Sept. 16, the Coral Gables, Fla., native is averaging 48.29 yards per punt while dropping seven of his 17 kicks inside the 20 and boasting a long boot of 71 yards. Also ranking among the nation's top 20 in punting are Samford senior Chris Hicks (10th-42.35 ypp), Jacksonville State junior Zach Walden (16th-41.5 ypp) and Tennessee Tech senior Jon Mahan (18th-41.43 ypp).

RECORDS WATCH: UT Martin senior WR Taurean Stephens caught one pass in the Skyhawks' win over Gardner-Webb on Saturday. Stephens now has 199 career catches, just 33 shy of the league record of 232, held by former Austin Peay standout Harold Roberts (1967-70).

I-A TRANSFERS HAVING AN IMPACT: Just three games into the 2006 campaign, several former Division I-A players are already making a name for themselves in their I-AA debuts:

SPOO UPDATE: Eastern Illinois head football coach Bob Spoo continues his recovery following a surgical procedure. Spoo was scheduled to enter his 20th season as the Panthers' head coach before announcing in mid-August that he had to undergo surgery and would miss 4-to-6 weeks for recovery.

NAME CHANGE FOR NCAA FOOTBALL: At its Aug. 3 meeting, the Division I Board of Directors approved a recommendation to delete the labels Division I-A, I-AA and I-AAA from NCAA use, effective Dec. 15, 2006. Additionally, the Board adopted the title "NCAA Division I Football Championship" to replace the "Division I-AA Football Championship." The Board also adopted the terms "Football Bowl Subdivision" and "NCAA Football Championship Subdivision" to refer to the level of football played by Division I members.

THREE OVC PLAYERS ON I-AA WATCH LISTS: Three OVC players are among 32 I-AA players nationally listed by *The Sports Network* as official "Payton Watch" and "Buchanan Battle" members. The OVC players on the preseason lists include Eastern Kentucky QB Josh Greco, Jacksonville State RB Clay Green and Eastern Illinois LB Clint Sellers.

EASTERN ILLINOIS' NFL COACHING TIES: Eastern Illinois is tied with San Diego State and USC for having the most alumni serving as head coaches in the National Football League. Current NFL skippers who boast Panther ties are Mike Shanahan (Denver Broncos), Sean Payton (New Orleans Saints) and Brad Childress (Minnesota Vikings).

GAME NOTES: Eastern Kentucky and Tennessee Tech square off in a nationally-televised ESPN contest on Thursday, with Charlie Neal and Jay Walker calling the action. This marks the second consecutive week the Golden Eagles have appeared on ESPN. EKU has won five straight against Tech and leads the series, 46-16. Both teams will be looking to kick off the OVC portions of their schedules on a winning note after coming out on the short end of their respective final non-conference tilts last week. EKU dropped a 20-17 heartbreaker to Western Carolina, while Tech was shut out in a 44-0 loss to in-state rival Middle Tennessee.

SCOUTING EASTERN KENTUCKY: Senior TE Patrick Bugg recorded the fifth multi-touchdown outing of his career last week, catching two TD strikes while racking up a personal-best 118 receiving yards on five catches at Western Carolina. He ranks second in the league and 20th nationally in I-AA in receiving yards per game (82.67 ypg). Junior RB Bobby Washington is averaging over five yards a carry, leading the Colonels' ground attack with 193 yards on 38 touches. Turnovers continue to plague junior QB Josh Greco, who has thrown multiple interceptions in five of his last six games. Through three outings in 2006, Greco has been picked off a league-leading seven times. Junior DB Derrick Huff has a Conference-best six pass breakups, while senior LB Brandon Rosser leads the team with 27 tackles, one forced fumble and one fumble recovery.

SCOUTING TENNESSEE TECH: Tech will be looking to regroup this week after watching a strong defensive stand in the first half of the MTSU contest go for naught as the Golden Eagle offense was held to 10 rushing yards overall while committing four costly second-half turnovers. Senior Brent McNeal and Larry Shipp each caught passes against MTSU to extend their respective streaks. Shipp is fifth and tied for sixth in the OVC, respectively, in receiving yardage (173 yards) and receptions (11). Senior punter Jon Mahan ranks 18th in I-AA football with a 41.43 average. Heading up the Golden Eagles' defensive efforts are senior DB Anthony James (22 tackles) and senior LB Craig Simonton (20 tackles). Freshman LB Aaron Williams sported three tackles for loss and a sack among five total stops last week, while sophomore DB Maurice Smith netted his second career pick.

GAME NOTES: Eastern Illinois travels to Samford in an OVC-opening tilt for both squads. The visiting Panthers have won two straight against the Bulldogs and lead the brief series, 2-1. Samford has a few extra days to prepare for EIU's visit after dispatching Austin Peay, 17-10, in a Thursday night outing last week. The Panthers, meanwhile, will be looking to bounce back from a 44-30 setback at No. 7 Illinois State. Saturday's contest features two of the league's top-ranked air attacks as EIU is averaging an OVC-best 203.3 passing yards while Samford is third (185.3 ypg). It also pits an EIU offensive line that has allowed just one sack this season against a Samford defensive front that has registered seven sacks thus far.

SCOUTING EASTERN ILLINOIS: The Panthers are rolling up a Conference-high 416 yards of total offense each time out, including 212.7 yards on the ground, thanks to the tailback tandem of senior Vincent Webb and sophomore Norris Smith. Webb is tied for second in the OVC and 16th nationally in I-AA in rushing average (116.67 ypg), while Smith is gaining 7.0 yards per carry. Junior QB Mike Donato has completed 55 percent of his passing attempts to rank second in the OVC and 19th nationally in I-AA in pass efficiency (144.8). Junior WR Micah Rucker has an OVC-high five TD receptions among 13 total catches, ranking third and fourth, respectively, in I-AA in total receiving yards (344) and receiving average (114.67 ypg). Junior LB Donald Thomas (31 tackles) and sophomore DL Pierre Walters (3.0 sacks, 4.5 TFL) find themselves among the nation's top I-AA stoppers.

SCOUTING SAMFORD: Sophomore QB Dante Williams is making his bid to earn the starting quarterback role on a permanent basis. He has completed a league-high 62 percent of his pass attempts (31-of-50) while throwing only one interception to rank eighth in the OVC in passing (110.3 ypg) and fourth in efficiency (120.2). Senior Freddy Young (138 yards, 14 catches) and junior Jeff Moore (207 yards, 13 catches) are among the league's top receivers. Senior specialist Chris Hicks ranks 10th in I-AA football with a 42.35 punting average. Senior DE Steve Tennin and sophomore LB Brent Nall have 2.0 sacks apiece for the Bulldogs, with Tennin also boasting 3.5 tackles for loss. After finishing with 15 total tackles in 2005, sophomore LB Rodney Shepherd has posted at least seven in each of his first three outings this season to emerge as the team's leading stopper (25 tackles).

GAME NOTES: UT Martin opens Ohio Valley Conference play on Saturday, hosting Jacksonville State. The visiting Gamecocks already have one OVC win under their belt after dispatching Southeast Missouri, 38-7, last week. The Skyhawks, meanwhile, are coming off back-to-back wins for the first time since 1994 following a 35-9 triumph over Gardner-Webb. JSU has won five straight meetings with UT Martin and holds a 23-4 lead in the series, which dates back 1967-1990, when both teams competed as Division II members of the Gulf South Conference. Saturday's contest pits the OVC's leading ground attack (JSU-222.5 ypg) against the Conference's stingiest rushing defense (UTM-92.7 ypg).

SCOUTING JACKSONVILLE STATE: Jax State's pass defense ranks 5th in I-AA football, while its rushing offense is 13th. The Gamecocks are near-perfect inside the redzone, scoring on seven of eight chances (4 TD/3 FG). Senior RB/KR Clay Green ranks second in the league and 20th nationally in all-purpose yardage (146.5 ypg). Sophomore RB Daniel Jackson (77 yards, 10 carries) and freshman RB Shawn Green (71 yards, 12 carries) are coming off career-high rushing efforts, averaging 7.7 and 5.9 yards per carry, respectively, last week. Senior QB Matt Hardin is sixth in the OVC in passing average (131.5 ypg) after throwing for a career-high 155 yards (10-15-1) against Southeast. The JSU defense limited Southeast to 163 yards of total offense, the third fewest allowed in the school's Division I history. Senior LB George Summers has a team-high 13 tackles.

SCOUTING UT MARTIN: The quarterback tandem of freshmen Greg Preston and Dexter Anoka combined for 195 yards in passing while connecting with seven different receivers against Gardner-Webb. With senior TB and top rusher Don Chapman sidelined (ankle), junior RB Marcus Dawson earned his first start of the season and responded by rushing for 150 yards and a touchdown on 29 carries in the GWU contest. Sophomore WR E.J. Daniel continues his solid play, catching four passes for 74 yards and a TD last week. He is in the OVC's top six in receiving yards (147) and receptions (11). The Skyhawks' defensive unit boasts I-AA football's third-best total defense (184.33 ypg), limiting opponents to league-lows of 91.7 yards on the ground and 92.7 yards through the air. Both figures are among the Top 20 in I-AA. Senior LB Markeseo Jackson has a team-high 17 tackles.

GAME NOTES: Murray State closes out the non-OVC portion of its schedule this week, entertaining Gateway Conference foe Illinois State on Saturday. Both squads enter the contest following a win over a member of the other team's conference. Last week, the Racers claimed victory in a 59-40 shootout with Indiana State, while the Redbirds defeated Eastern Illinois, 44-30. MSU will be looking to end a two-game losing skid to ISU, which holds a 2-1 edge in the brief series. Redbird head coach Denver Johnson has Racer ties, having served in the same position at MSU from 1997-99.

SCOUTING MURRAY STATE: Murray State broke into the win column for the first time in three games with its victory at Indiana State. The Racers racked up 514 yards of total offense against the Sycamores, including 335 yards on the ground. Senior RB Chad Cook is tied for second in the OVC in rushing (116.7 ypg) after exploding for a career-high 223 yards and three touchdowns last week. Redshirt freshman Zach Barnard solidified his role as the Racers' starting quarterback, passing for 139 yards and three scores against Indiana State. He has completed 60 percent of his attempts (39-of-65) to rank third in the OVC in pass efficiency and fifth in passing yardage (138.7 ypg). Sophomore WR Rod Harper leads the league with 18 catches (204 yards). Junior LB Nathan Williams registered a career-high 17 tackles last week, and leads the league with 36 stops overall.

SCOUTING ILLINOIS STATE: The Racers' pass defense will be tested by Redbird senior QB Luke Drone, who has already topped the 3,000-yard passing mark for his career (3,709 yards) and ranks second in the Gateway with a 256.3 passing average this season. His top target is senior Pierre Jackson, who leads the Gateway with 333 receiving yards and three touchdowns on 18 catches. Senior RB Pierre Rembert heads up the Redbirds' ground attack, ranking fourth in the Gateway in rushing (116.3 ypg). Senior LB and Buck Buchanan Award candidate Cameron Siskowic enters the game as I-AA football's top tackler, collecting a career-high 22 stops at EIU last week to give him 45 on the season. Redbird defenders have picked off seven passes this season to give ISU a +4.00 turnover margin.
