OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSIVE

CLAY GREEN • TB, SR., 6-0, 205 •
BIRMINGHAM, AL • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Green rushed for 131 yards and two touchdowns to lead Jacksonville State to a 28-0 shutout win on the road against OVC preseason favorite Eastern Kentucky. The senior tailback from Birmingham, Ala., averaged 5.5 yards on 24 carries as he moved into fifth place on the school's all-time career rushing chart.

DEFENSIVE

LeMARCUS ROWELL • LB, SR., 6-2, 225 •
OPELIKA, AL • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Rowell played a key role in Jacksonville State's 28-0 shutout of OVC preseason favorite Eastern Kentucky. The senior linebacker counted two sacks and two tackles for loss among five total stops while leading a defensive unit that limited ECU to just 114 yards of total offense, a JSU Division I record. A native of Opelika, Ala., Rowell also forced a fumble and had two quarterback hurries.

SPECIALIST

ZACH WALDEN • P, SO., 5-10, 180 •
DALLAS, GA • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Walden averaged 45.0 yards on six punts as Jacksonville State registered a 28-0 shutout over Eastern Kentucky. The sophomore from Dallas, Ga., set a school Division I record with a 75-yard punt and dropped one of his kicks inside the Colonels' 20-yard line. Walden currently ranks second in the OVC and 10th nationally with a 42.16 punting average.

NEWCOMER

LEE SWEENEY • QB, FR., 6-3, 220 •
MT. JULIET, TN • TENNESSEE TECH

Sweeney passed for 251 yards and three touchdowns to lead Tennessee Tech to a 20-14 overtime victory at Murray State. After sustaining a fourth-quarter injury that sent him to the bench for the final series, the freshman quarterback returned in overtime to throw a 14-yard TD pass for the game-winning margin. A native of Mt. Juliet, Tenn., Sweeney was 16-for-28 in completions while throwing TD strikes of 14, 57 and 14 yards.

2006 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE FOOTBALL NOTES

EASTERN ILLINOIS (2-3, 1-0 OVC)

Eastern Illinois remains winless in three trips to Hawai'i following a 44-9 loss to the Warriors on Saturday. Senior TB Vincent Webb averaged an impressive 10.6 yards on 11 carries while registering his fourth consecutive 100-yard outing (117 yards). Webb, who has topped the century mark 17 times during his career, climbed into fourth place on the school's all-time rushing chart (3,503 yards) and now currently sits 175 yards shy of moving into the OVC's Top-10 list of all-time rushing leaders. Junior LB Donald Thomas has recorded at least six tackles each time out this season and leads the team with 45 stops overall. Sophomore DE Pierre Walters has 4.0 sacks, ranking among national and OVC leaders. Sophomore kicker Zach Yates has converted at least one field goal in 10 consecutive games, booting a 43-yarder in the second quarter at Hawai'i. The Panthers resume defense of their OVC title on Saturday, when they put a 10-game Conference win streak on the line at home against Southeast Missouri.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (1-4, 0-2 OVC)

Eastern Kentucky suffered its first shutout loss at home in eight years, dropping a 28-0 decision to Jacksonville State. Saturday's outing was the second shutout loss of 2006 for the Colonels, marking the first time since 1972 an EKU squad has gone scoreless in two contests in a single season. Senior Brandon Rosser registered a game-high 14 stops against JSU. He has led EKU in tackles in all five games this season to rank among national and OVC leaders with a 10.0 per-game average. Opponents are 0-for-3 in fourth-down conversion attempts against the Colonels' defensive unit. EKU boasts one of I-AA's Top 25 kick return averages (23.24 ypr), thanks to the efforts of sophomore Devin Walker, who ranks 16th nationally with a league-high 27.38 yards per return. The Colonels will be looking to snap a streak of six scoreless quarters when they travel to Samford on Saturday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (2-2, 2-1 OVC)

Jacksonville State limited Eastern Kentucky to 114 yards total offense en route to a 28-0 road victory. The defensive performance set a new Division I school record for fewest yards allowed by a JSU opponent, while the shutout was Jax State's first since Oct. 17, 1998, a span of 85 games. Senior LB LeMarcus Rowell recorded two of the Gamecocks' five sacks on the day, finishing with two quarterback hurries, a forced fumble, two tackles-for-loss and five stops overall. Senior TB Clay Green collected his 11th career 100-yard rushing effort and moved into fifth place on the school's all-time list (2,360 yards), running for 131 yards while pushing to three his streak of games with a rushing touchdown. Sophomore Zach Walden's school Division I record 75-yard punt in the first quarter was just the fifth punt of 70 yards or more in JSU history. Jax State has now won six consecutive OVC road games, dating back to the 2004 season. The Gamecocks return home for a CSS-televised Thursday night contest versus Murray State.

MURRAY STATE (1-4, 0-2 OVC)

Despite forcing a season-high five turnovers, Murray State lost a 20-14 overtime heartbreaker to Tennessee Tech. Freshman safety Taylor Lanigan posted his first career touchdown, returning a fumble 93 yards to paydirt in the third quarter. Sophomore CB Dominic Spinks intercepted his fourth pass of the season, and is now tied for sixth in the nation (0.8 pg). The Racers boast the league's top two stoppers in junior LB Nathan Williams and senior safety J.R. Webber. Williams leads the OVC and ranks 15th in I-AA football in total tackles (10.6 pg), while Webber has a Conference-best 38 solo stops to rank third nationally (7.6 pg). Freshman LB Tamar Butler has forced four fumbles this season and leads all of I-AA football while teammate Will Roach is second in the OVC and tied for ninth nationally with three forced fumbles. Murray State defenders have intercepted nine passes in 2006, tying for second nationally and putting the Racers second in I-AA football in turnovers gained (16). MSU has a short turnaround before heading out to Jacksonville State for a Thursday night outing.

SAMFORD (2-3, 0-2 OVC)

Samford saw its OVC losing streak stretch to four games with a narrow 19-14 setback at Southeast Missouri. The Bulldogs have not picked up a win in Conference play since a 31-11 victory over Tennessee State in 2005. Freshman RB Brock Johnson rushed for a team-high 56 yards in his collegiate debut, averaging 8.0 yards on seven carries while also registering his first career touchdown. Junior Jeff Moore and senior Freddy Young continue to lead the OVC and rank among national receiving leaders after catching seven passes apiece in the contest. Sophomore LB Rodney Shep-

herd led all defenders with 13 tackles at Southeast, including eight solo. He is second in the league and tied for ninth nationally in solo stops (6.0 pg). The Bulldogs return home to entertain Eastern Kentucky on Saturday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (3-1, 1-1 OVC)

Southeast Missouri evened its OVC mark at 1-1, posting a 19-14 win over Samford on Saturday. With sophomore RB Tim Holloman sidelined due to a sore ankle, the Redhawks turned to redshirt freshman Tony Anderson, who provided Southeast's lone rushing TD of the contest before finishing with 43 yards on 15 carries. Senior DE Edgar Jones is the national sacks leader (8.0) after recording two for losses of 22 yards on Saturday. Jones also leads all of I-AA football in tackles for loss (10.0). The Redhawks, who have already topped their win total from a year ago, face a tough road test with a Saturday date at defending OVC champion Eastern Illinois.

TENNESSEE STATE (2-3, 1-0 OVC)

Tennessee State closed out the non-conference portion of its schedule with a disappointing 25-22 overtime loss to Florida A&M on Saturday at the Georgia Dome. Sophomore RB Javarris Williams rushed for a career-high 229 yards and a touchdown to be named the Tennessee State MVP of the Atlanta Football Classic. Williams' 229 yards is the OVC's highest single-game performance this season. Senior Dominique Rodgers-Cromartie is tied for second and seventh in the nation in interceptions and passes defended, respectively, after picking off his league-leading fifth pass of the season. Freshman LB Calvin Baker tallied a team-high eight tackles in the contest, including six solo stops. The Tigers have a bye this week before resuming Conference play Oct. 14 at home against Tennessee Tech.

TENNESSEE TECH (2-3, 2-0 OVC)

Freshman QB Lee Sweeney hit senior TE Logan Wilks with a 14-yard touchdown pass in overtime to lift Tennessee Tech to a 20-14 victory over host Murray State. The win snapped Tech's 11-game OVC road losing streak that dated back more than three seasons. Sweeney, who missed part of the fourth quarter with an injury, finished with 251 yards on 16-of-28 passing. Wilks' TD was the first of his career. Junior CB Chris Grimes and senior LB Craig Simonton tied for a team-high seven tackles each while heading up a Tech defensive effort that overcame five Golden Eagle turnovers and limited MSU to just 42 yards of total offense in the second half and overtime period. Sophomore WR Jarrod Houston returned from hand surgery earlier on Monday to catch two passes for 65 yards, including a game-tying TD in the third period. Junior WR Larry Shipp caught six passes for 74 yards and a TD, while senior TB Anthony Ash led the rushing game with 79 yards on 16 carries. Tech hosts UT Martin in a key OVC matchup on Thursday.

UT MARTIN (4-1, 1-0 OVC)

UT Martin is enjoying its first four-game win streak since 1991 following a 20-10 victory over Austin Peay on Saturday. This marks the fourth time since 1982 that the Skyhawks have won four of their first five games. After being slowed by a sore ankle for the first part of the season, junior RB Don Chapman broke out for a season-high 155 rushing yards and a touchdown against the Govs. He averaged 8.2 yards on 19 carries while topping the 100-yard mark for the first time in 2006 and giving UT Martin its third 100-yard rusher in as many games. Opponents are just 1-for-8 in fourth-down conversion attempts against the UT Martin defensive unit, which ranks ninth in the nation in total defense (223.0 ypg). The two-quarterback system appears to be working for the Skyhawks as freshmen Dexter Anoka and Greg Preston combined for 23-of-36 passing while throwing for over 100 yards apiece against the Govs. The Skyhawks visit Tennessee Tech on Thursday in a meeting between two OVC unbeaten.

GAMES ON THE TUBE

The Oct. 5 OVC matchup between Murray State and Jacksonville State will be be televised regionally on Comcast Sports Southeast (CSS) at 5:00 p.m. Central. In addition, the Oct. 5 Conference showdown between UT Martin and Tennessee Tech will be broadcast locally on WCTE-TV at 7:00 p.m. CT, while the Oct. 7 league tilt featuring Southeast Missouri and Eastern Illinois will be broadcast locally at 1:30 p.m. CT on WEIU-TV.

OVC TEAMS IN TOP 25

Eastern Illinois remained at No. 20 in the latest edition of the Sports Network I-AA Top-25 poll, which was released on Oct. 2. UT Martin also cracked the Sports Network's Top 25 for the first time in school history with a No. 22 ranking. EIU is the lone OVC team in the CSN Coaches Poll at No. 20.

PERFECT PAT

Five weeks into the season, a trio of OVC kickers have maintained perfect marks in point-after attempts. Murray State senior Gary Crass leads the pack with a 14-of-14 effort, followed by UT Martin senior Taylor Brown (12-of-12) and Eastern Kentucky sophomore Taylor Long (6-of-6).

PUNTING WAY INTO RECORD BOOK?

For the second time in three years, the OVC record for season punting average is in jeopardy, and the same specialist is responsible for the threat. After re-setting the league mark (46.0 ypp) as a sophomore in 2004, Southeast Missouri's David Simonhoff is on pace to top that this season as he currently leads all of I-AA football with a 47.14 average.

OTHER OVC RECORDS IN PERIL

UT Martin senior WR Taurean Stephens caught two passes in the Skyhawks' win over Austin Peay on Saturday. He now has 201 career receptions, just 31 shy of the league record of 232, held by former APSU standout Harold Roberts (1967-70).
