OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSIVE

**JOSH GRECO • QB, JR., 6-1, 208 •
NAPLES, FL • EASTERN KENTUCKY**

Greco threw for a season-high 323 yards in leading Eastern Kentucky to a 31-12 OVC win at Samford. The junior quarterback also rushed for 15 yards to finish with 338 yards of total offense. A native of Naples, Fla., Greco finished the game on 18-of-28 passing with two touchdowns and no interceptions en route to establishing a new school record for career completions (404). His 323 passing yards and 338 total yards are the highest single-game efforts in the OVC this season.

DEFENSIVE

**LUCIUS SEYMOUR • LB, SR., 5-11, 209 •
DELRAY BEACH, FL • EASTERN ILLINOIS**

Seymour led a solid defensive effort in Eastern Illinois' 21-0 shutout of OVC foe Southeast Missouri. He had a team-high 11 tackles, including six solo stop and tackles for a loss of eight yards. He also had one quarterback sack, an interception return for 24 yards, and two quarterback hurries. EIU held Southeast to 107 total yards and forced three Redhawk turnovers.

SPECIALIST

**ZACH WALDEN • P, SO., 5-10, 180 •
DALLAS, GA • JACKSONVILLE STATE**

Walden finished with a career-best 48.5 average on six punts to help Jacksonville State to a 49-17 OVC win against Murray State. He also tied a JSU Division I school record by dropping four punts inside the 20-yard line, including three punts inside the 10-yard line and two punts inside the 4-yard line.

NEWCOMER

**COLE STINSON • QB, JR., 6-5, 238 •
ESTERO, FL • EASTERN ILLINOIS**

Stinson made the most of his first starting opportunity at Eastern Illinois, leading the Panthers to their 11th straight OVC win with a 21-0 shutout of Southeast Missouri. Stinson, a transfer from Ball State, completed 16-of-22 passes for 208 yards, including three touchdown tosses. Stinson did not throw an interception, finishing the game with a quarterback rating of 197.15.

2006 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE FOOTBALL NOTES

EASTERN ILLINOIS (3-3, 2-0 OVC)

Eastern Illinois stretched its OVC win streak to 11 games with a 21-0 victory over Southeast Missouri on Saturday for the Panthers' first shutout win since 2003. Junior QB Cole Stinson made the most of his first start at EIU, completing 16-of-22 passes without an interception for 208 yards and three touchdowns. Junior WR Micah Rucker caught all three of Stinson's TD strikes, finishing with 180 yards on 10 catches. He boasts the league's top two single-game receiving efforts this season while leading the OVC with nine TDs and 592 yards. Senior TB Vincent Webb continues to lead the OVC in rushing yardage (123.3 ypg), despite being held under 100 yards for the first time in five games. Senior LB Lucius Seymour had a team-high 11 tackles, a sack and a 24-yard interception return while heading up an EIU defensive effort that forced three SEMO turnovers and limited the Redhawks to 101 yards of offense. EIU visits Eastern Kentucky on Saturday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (2-4, 1-2 OVC)

Eastern Kentucky broke into the OVC win column with 31-12 triumph at Samford on Saturday. Junior QB Josh Greco threw for an OVC season-high 323 yards in the contest, finishing with 18-of-28 passing and two touchdowns without an interception. Greco now has 404 career completions, shattering the previous EKV record of 386, set by former Colonel standout Jim Guice (1965-68). The Colonels did not commit a turnover for the first time since Oct. 9, 2004, a span of 23 games. Junior TB Mark Dunn tallied his sixth career 100-yard rushing effort with a season-high 109 yards, while junior WR Quinton Williams caught four passes for a career-high 128 yards. EKV ended a seven-quarter scoring drought with two touchdowns in the second period and also tallied a TD in the third quarter for the first time this season. The Colonels entertain Eastern Illinois on Saturday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (3-2, 3-1 OVC)

Jacksonville State won for the third time in four outings, rolling past Murray State, 49-17. Senior TB Clay Green moved into fourth place on the school's all-time rushing list (2,465 yards), running for 105 yards while tying a career-high with three touchdowns in the contest. Green, who ranks third and second, respectively, in the OVC in rushing (122.4 ypg) and all-purpose (138.4 ypg) yardage, has eclipsed the 100-yard mark three times this season and 12 times in his career. The Gamecocks have capitalized on their opportunities inside the red zone, scoring on 13 consecutive trips and a league-best 19-of-20 overall. Meanwhile, JSU opponents are just 8-of-13 in redzone visits against Gamecock defenders. Sophomore Zach Walden tied a JSU Division I record by dropping four of his punts inside the 20-yard line against the Racers. He finished the game with a career-best 48.5 average on six punts. The Gamecocks step out for a non-conference visit to Mississippi State on Saturday.

MURRAY STATE (1-5, 0-3 OVC)

Despite ringing up 334 yards of offense on the sixth-ranked defense in I-AA football, Murray State fell behind early at Jacksonville State and could not recover in a 49-17 loss to the Gamecocks. The Racers surrendered 21 points in the first 16 minutes of play and trailed 35-10 at halftime. Redshirt freshman QB Zach Barnard threw for 252 yards and a touchdown on 24-of-46 passing while going up against a JSU pass defense that entered the contest ranked second in I-AA (91.3 ypg). Senior Dante Woods was one of eight receivers to haul in passes from Barnard, netting six catches for 44 yards and a TD. Freshman RB Josh Jones finished with 87 all-purpose yards and his first career touchdown, averaging 6.3 yards on nine carries for 57 rushing yards and catching four passes for 30 receiving yards. Lead rusher Chad Cook (86.0 ypg) remains sidelined with a knee injury suffered on Sept. 30. The Racers return home to entertain Samford on Saturday.

SAMFORD (2-4, 0-3 OVC)

Samford's OVC losing streak stretched to five games with a 31-12 setback to Eastern Kentucky on Saturday. Junior WR Jeff Moore is the league's leading pass-catcher (37) after reeling in seven aerials for 112 yards and a touchdown in the contest. Sophomore Rodney Shepherd is tied for fifth in the Conference in tackles (8.7 pg). He had seven solo stops against EKV and now leads all OVC linebackers with 37. Freshman RB Brock Johnson has rushed for 100 yards over his last two outings, averaging 6.3 yards on 16 carries. The Bulldogs go back out on the road this week, paying a visit to Murray State. Both teams enter Saturday's contest in search of their first OVC win of the season.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (3-2, 1-2 OVC)

After going without a turnover in its first four games, Southeast Missouri committed three miscues in a 21-0 loss to Eastern Illinois on Saturday. Heading into last week's action, the Redhawks were the only team in I-A or I-AA football to have not committed a turnover this season, and they still rank second nationally in I-AA with a +2.0 turnover margin. Junior LB Adam Casper tallied a career-high 20 stops in the contest. He leads the league and ranks 13th nationally with a 10.6 tackle average this season. The Redhawks face a tough test on Saturday as they step out of OVC play with a trip to Arkansas, marking only the second meeting between the two squads. The first matchup was 100 years ago, when Arkansas beat Southeast, 12-0, in 1906. The No. 17 Razorbacks moved into the Associated Press Top 25 for the first time since the middle of the 2003 season after stunning then-No. 2 Auburn last week, 27-10.

TENNESSEE STATE (2-3, 1-0 OVC)

Tennessee State had last week off, and now face a stretch of six consecutive OVC outings, beginning with a home contest against Tennessee Tech on Saturday. Sophomore RB Javarris Williams, who rushed for a career-high and OVC season-high 229 yards in an overtime loss to Florida A&M on Sept. 30, leads the league in all-purpose yardage (740 yards) while ranking second in rushing (122.4 ypg). Sophomore QB Antonio Heffner continues to top the OVC in both passing (194.4 ypg) and total (197.8 ypg) offense. He also sports a league-best 136.3 efficiency rating. As a team, the Tigers also lead the Conference in pass offense (198.8 ypg) and efficiency (136.4). Junior Dominique Rodgers-Cromartie has picked off an OVC-high five passes this season and is tied for first nationally (1.0 pg). Freshman Calvin Baker ranks among OVC leaders with 6.0 tackles for loss.

TENNESSEE TECH (2-4, 2-1 OVC)

Tennessee Tech fell from the ranks of the OVC's unbeaten, dropping a 35-16 decision to UT Martin in the Golden Eagles' fourth Thursday night game of the 2006 campaign. Tech came out on the short end of the ledger, despite having 20 first downs and going 3-for-3 in the red zone while boasting a time of possession of 32:12. Junior WR Larry Shipp caught a career-high eight passes for 81 yards and a touchdown. He has now caught at least one pass in all 27 games of his career, and has grabbed a TD strike in each of the last three games. Freshman Nate Johnson became the first Tech kicker to make three field goals in his first career game, nailing attempts of 35, 25 and 33 yards. Freshman LB Aaron Williams paced the Golden Eagle defense with a career-high 13 tackles, while sophomore safety Maurice Smith tallied a personal-best 10 stops to go with a forced fumble and an interception. Tech visits Tennessee State on Saturday.

UT MARTIN (5-1, 2-0 OVC)

Heading into a bye week, UT Martin is 5-1 for the first time since 1988 following a 35-16 road victory over Tennessee Tech on Thursday. The Skyhawks, who snapped a 41-game OVC road losing streak with the win at Tech, have also won five straight for the first time since the '88 campaign. Junior RB Don Chapman eclipsed the 100-yard mark for the second straight week and tallied his fourth career 200-yard effort, rushing for 214 yards and a touchdown on 27 carries at Tech. Taurean Stephens' bid to become the league's all-time leader in receptions was cut short when the senior suffered a season-ending knee injury in practice prior to the Tech contest. Stephens closes out his four-year career at UT Martin with 201 catches, ranking second behind the OVC record of 232, set by Austin Peay's Harold Roberts (1967-70). The Skyhawk defense, which ranks seventh in the nation against the run (86.7 ypg), has surrendered only two 100-yard rushing efforts this season. UT Martin has not allowed an opponent to rush for more than 120 yards in a game in 2006.

In addition, the Oct. 14 Conference tilt featuring Samford and Murray State will be broadcast locally on MSU-TV 11 on a tape-delayed basis at 10:00 p.m. CT, while Jacksonville State's Oct. 14 non-conference outing at Mississippi State will be available on a tape-delayed basis on CSS at 8:30 p.m. on Sunday, Oct. 15.

OVC TEAMS IN TOP 25

Eastern Illinois and UT Martin are ranked No. 16 and 17, respectively, in both of the latest Sports Network and CSN Coaches Polls, which were released on Oct. 9. The Panthers moved up from a No. 20 ranking in both polls last week, while the Skyhawks went from No. 22 in the Sports Network poll and being unranked in the CSN Coaches poll.

OVC RECORDS WATCH

Eastern Illinois junior Micah Rucker has nine receiving touchdowns, six off the OVC record of 15 (Samford's Efreem Hill, 2003) while Jacksonville State senior Clay Green has nine rushing touchdowns, 12 short of the Conference mark of 21 (Eastern Kentucky's Elroy Harris, 1988). Southeast Missouri senior David Simonhoff currently sports a 45.0 punting average, not far off his OVC-record mark of 46.0, set in 2004.
