OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSIVE

JAVARRIS WILLIAMS • RB, SO., 5'11, 215 •
RICHMOND, TX • TENNESSEE STATE

Williams rushed for 195 yards and two touchdowns to lead Tennessee State to a 30-20 OVC win over Tennessee Tech. The sophomore running back recorded 170 rushing yards in the first half alone. A native of Richmond, Texas, Williams caught one pass for 30 yards to give him 225 total yards against the Golden Eagles.

DEFENSIVE

LUCIUS SEYMOUR • LB, SR., 5-11, 209 •
DELRAY BEACH, FL • EASTERN ILLINOIS

Seymour was a factor all over the field during Eastern Illinois' 28-21 win over Eastern Kentucky. The senior linebacker had 11 tackles, including four solo stops and one for a loss against the Colonels' offense. He also had an interception in the fourth quarter with less than two minutes remaining that ended the Colonels' drive for a game tying score.

SPECIALIST

CHRIS HICKS • P, SR., 5-10, 175 •
CALHOUN, GA • SAMFORD

Hicks punted five times for an average of 40.2 yards per kick in Samford's 33-7 win at Murray State. The senior punter placed two kicks inside the Racer 20-yard line and he had a long punt of 44 yards on the day.

NEWCOMER

LEE SWEENEY • QB, FR., 6-3, 200 •
MT. JULIET, TN • TENNESSEE TECH

Sweeney set a school record with 28 completions and passed for a career-high 305 yards and three touchdowns in Tech's 30-20 loss to Tennessee State. The freshman quarterback was one attempt (50) shy of the school record. He threw a 17-yard TD pass to Derek White, and connected with Brent McNeal for two touchdowns of six and five yards to direct a Golden Eagle second-half comeback that came up short.

2006 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE FOOTBALL NOTES

EASTERN ILLINOIS (4-3, 3-0 OVC)

Eastern Illinois stretched its OVC win streak to 12 games with a 28-21 victory over Eastern Kentucky on Saturday. Junior QB Cole Stintson made his second start for the Panthers, completing 9-of-16 passes for 157 yards and one touchdown. Stintson did not throw an interception for the second straight week as he opened the game completing his first five passes as the Panthers raced out to 28-0 first quarter lead. Senior RB Vincent Webb continued his climb into both the EIU and OVC record books as he found the end zone on three occasions to move into a tie for third place on the Panthers' career touchdown lists. Webb finished the day with 124 yards rushing for his 18th career 100-yard rushing effort. He also moved into 10th place on the OVC all-time rushing charts with 3,692 career rushing yards. Senior LB Lucius Seymour was a factor all over the field, tallying 11 tackles, including four solo and one for a loss. He also had an interception in the fourth quarter with less than two minutes remaining that ended the Colonels' drive for a game-tying score. Sophomore kicker/punter Zach Yates led the special teams attack with five punts on the afternoon with a long of 39 yards. Two of Yates' punts were downed inside the 20-yard line. Yates was also a perfect 4-for-4 in extra point opportunities during the win. Eastern Illinois will host Murray State on Saturday which can be seen locally on WEIU-TV.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (2-5, 1-3 OVC)

Eastern Kentucky came up short in a 28-21 loss to Eastern Illinois on Saturday. Junior QB Josh Greco passed for 270 yards versus the Panthers to set a new EKV record for career passing yards (5,285) surpassing the old total of 5,041 established by Jim Guice (1965-68). Junior RB Mark Dunn carried the ball 22 times for 116 yards, both of which are season-highs. It was Dunn's third 100-yard rushing game of the year. Dunn also caught three passes for 33 yards. The Colonels allowed 28 first quarter points versus EIU and have now been outscored in the opening stanza, 62-17, this season. EKV needs to win the remaining four games to ensure a winning season. The Colonels have notched a winning record in 28 consecutive seasons. Eastern Kentucky will travel to Southeast Missouri on Saturday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (3-3, 3-1 OVC)

Jacksonville State dropped a 35-3 decision to non-conference foe Mississippi State in front of 38,635 which marks the second-largest crowd to ever see the Gamecocks play. Junior QB Matt Hardin threw an interception on the first play from scrimmage to MSU's Derek Pegues and it was returned for a touchdown. It snapped a string of eight consecutive quarters without a turnover for JSU. Hardin finished the game 12-for-26 with one interception for 149 yards. It was the third-best passing effort of his career. Senior S Kenny Brown led the Gamecocks with eight tackles, including six solo stops. The JSU defense has still not allowed an offensive touchdown in the first quarter. Junior P Zach Walden finished with a 39.5 yard punting average on six punts and he also had three inside the 20-yard line. Over the last two weeks, Walden has had seven punts inside the 20-yard line. The Gamecocks welcome Tennessee State on Saturday which can be seen on CSS.

MURRAY STATE (1-6, 0-4 OVC)

Murray State fell to Samford, 33-7, at home on Saturday. The Racers turned the ball over six times and the Bulldogs capitalized with 20 points on MSU turnovers. Murray State committed turnovers on four straight possessions, two at the end of the second quarter and two to start the third quarter. Junior QB Ryne Salyer came in late in the second half and finished the game with 101 yards passing and a touchdown. Freshman RB Charlie Jordan finished with 103 all purpose yards, 48 on the ground and 55 receiving yards. Senior P Tim Wright averaged 43.3 yards per punt and junior LB Nathan Williams finished with a game-high 14 tackles and a forced fumble. Murray State will head to Eastern Illinois on Saturday.

SAMFORD (3-4, 1-3 OVC)

Samford snapped its five-game OVC losing streak with a 33-7 victory over Murray State on Saturday. Junior QB Jefferson Adcock passed for two touchdowns and ran for two more in the win. He completed 10-of-19 passes for 145 yards, two interceptions and two touchdowns in the game. Adcock also rushed 13 times for 30 yards and two scores. Sophomore RB Marcus Rice rushed 19 times for 92 yards, averaging 4.8 yards per carry. He had a long run of 19 yards on the day. Senior DB T.C. Meyers led a defense that

held Murray State to just seven points. Meyers had an interception and a forced fumble to go along with two solo tackles. Senior P Chris Hicks punted five times for an average of 40.2 yards per kick. He placed two kicks inside the Murray State 20-yard line and had a long punt of 44 yards on the day. Samford will play host to UT Martin on Saturday.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (3-3, 1-2 OVC)

Southeast Missouri dropped a 63-7 decision to No. 17 Arkansas on Saturday. The only Redhawk touchdown came in the third quarter when Southeast Missouri drove 84 yards in eight plays to score on an 8-yard run by senior RB John Radney. Senior QB Kevin Ballatore finished the day with eight completions for 108 yards. Ballatore also had two passes picked off in the game. Senior P David Simonoff had seven punts with an average of 45.1 yards per punt. Simonoff's long punt of 75 yards was the longest punt against No. 17 Arkansas this season. Freshman LB Jared Goodson recorded a game-high 11 tackles on the day. Southeast Missouri returns to league action this week as it hosts Eastern Kentucky on Saturday.

TENNESSEE STATE (3-3, 2-0 OVC)

Tennessee State remained undefeated in OVC play with a 30-20 win over Tennessee Tech on Saturday. Sophomore RB Javarris Williams rushed 28 times for 195 yards and two touchdowns. He rushed for 170 yards in the first half alone. Williams also caught one pass for 30 yards to end the game with 225 yards of total offense. Senior CB Aaron Strong recorded 9.5 tackles, including nine solo stops. Senior P Tim Ehart had his best punting day of the season, making four punts for 166 yards. He averaged 41.5 yards per kick and had a long of 48 yards on the day. Tennessee State will travel to Jacksonville State on Saturday.

TENNESSEE TECH (2-5, 2-2 OVC)

Tennessee Tech fell behind 27-0 in the first half, then put together a second-half comeback by outscoring Tennessee State, 20-3, after the intermission, only to come up short in 30-20 loss at LP Field. Freshman QB Lee Sweeney passed for a career-high 305 yards and three touchdowns, setting a school record with 28 completions in the contest. His 50 attempts was one short of another school mark. Tech had 23 first downs in the game and held TSU to 122 yards of total offense in the second half. The Golden Eagles didn't suffer a turnover until the interception in the final minute. Senior WR Brent McNeal, who was questionable for the game with a pulled muscle, caught a career-high seven passes for 72 yards and two touchdowns. Senior RB Derek White also had a career-best seven catches for 57 yards and one TD. Junior WR Larry Shipp had a season-high 96 receiving yards on four catches. Shipp also rushed for 18 yards and had one kick return for 20 yards to account for 134 all-purpose yards. Freshman LB Aaron Williams had 11 total tackles and recovered a fumble. Tech has an open date this weekend and will return to action on Oct. 28 when it hosts Jacksonville State.

UT MARTIN (5-1, 2-0 OVC)

UT Martin is coming off an open week and will return to action on Saturday when it travels to Samford. The Skyhawks will play the rest of the season without senior WR Taurean Stephens. The Cincinnati, Ohio, native suffered a season-ending knee injury Oct. 4, the day before UT Martin's win over Tennessee Tech. The Skyhawks will be seeking their second consecutive Conference road victory and their sixth straight win of the season on Saturday.

OVC TEAMS IN TOP 25

Eastern Illinois and UT Martin continue to be ranked in both of the latest Sports Network and CSN Coaches Polls, which were released on Oct. 16. The Panthers are ranked 16th in the CSN Coaches Poll while dropping a spot to 17th in the Sports Network Poll. UT Martin remains at 17th in the CSN Coaches Polls and moved up to 16th in the Sports Network rankings.

OVC RECORDS WATCH

Eastern Illinois junior Micah Rucker has nine receiving touchdowns, six off the OVC record of 15 (Samford's Efrem Hill, 2003) while Jacksonville State senior Clay Green has nine rushing touchdowns, 12 short of the Conference mark of 21 (Eastern Kentucky's Elroy Harris, 1988). Southeast Missouri senior David Simonhoff currently sports a 45.1 punting average, not far off his OVC-record mark of 46.0, set in 2004.
