OFFENSIVE

TIM HOLLOWMAN • RB, FR., 6-0, 180
ORLANDO, FL • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Holloman scored four touchdowns in Southeast Missouri's narrow 33-32 loss at Eastern Kentucky. He rushed for two scores while carrying the ball 31 times for 155 yards, and added two more touchdowns on the receiving end, making six catches for 95 yards. A true freshman from Orlando, Fla., Holloman finished the game with 250 all-purpose yards.

DEFENSIVE

TRISTAN BURGE • JR., SAF., 6-0, 200
ROMEOVILLE, IL • EASTERN ILLINOIS

Burge scored two touchdowns on fumble recoveries and intercepted a pass at the Eastern Illinois 10 that thwarted a potential Murray State scoring drive in the Panthers' 35-28 win at MSU. The junior safety returned a first-quarter fumble 68 yards for a touchdown, then recovered a fumble in the endzone for a third-quarter score. A native of Romeoville, Ill., Burge also contributed eight tackles, including seven solo stops, and returned one kickoff for 25 yards.

SPECIALIST

DARREN WILLIAMS • SAF., SR., 6-2, 199
CLARKSDALE, MS • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Williams recorded his first career blocked punt late in the second quarter of Jacksonville State's 33-3 win over Tennessee State. The blocked punt turned into a JSU touchdown, giving the Gamecocks a 20-3 lead heading into halftime. A senior safety from Clarksdale, Miss., Williams also added three tackles on the day.

2005 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE FOOTBALL NOTES

EASTERN ILLINOIS (5-2 overall, 4-0 OVC): Junior RB **Vincent Webb** rushed for 164 yards on 25 carries, including an 83-yard touchdown run, as Eastern Illinois remained unbeaten in OVC action with a 35-28 win at Murray State...Junior safety **Tristan Burge** accounted for three of the Panthers' six turnovers gained, scoring touchdowns on two fumble recoveries and also intercepting a pass...Senior punter **Tom Schofield** averaged 43.7 yards per kick while having two of his seven punts downed at the one-yard line...Junior LB **Clint Sellers** forced a fumble and registered a team-high 13 tackles, including 12 solo stops, a QB sack and two tackles for loss...Senior CB **Terrance Sanders'** third career interception came at the EIU 37 with 20 seconds left and MSU driving for the potential game-tying score...The defensive unit scored 21 of the Panthers' 35 points in the contest...EIU ran 55 plays to MSU's 91 and had just 254 yards total offense to the Racers' 433...The Panthers take their four-game win streak into an Oct. 29 home meeting with UT Martin.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (4-4 overall, 4-1 OVC): Junior TE **Patrick Bugg** caught a 23-yard touchdown pass with 1.4 seconds remaining to lift Eastern Kentucky to a 33-32 win over Southeast Missouri...Sophomore QB **Josh Greco** set school single-season records for pass attempts (299) and completions (174), going 18-of-32 with one interception for 247 yards and a touchdown...Sophomore RB **Mark Dunn** matched an EKU single-game record for touchdowns, running for four scores while finishing with a team-high 91 yards on 20 carries...Senior WR **Andre Ralston** caught a team-best six passes for 81 yards, while junior WR **Lewon Lurry** hauled in five receptions for a season-high 60 yards...With the win, the Colonels improved to 5-0 under head coach **Danny Hope** in OVC games immediately following a league loss...For the first time this season, EKU won a contest in which it lost the turnover battle, committing two miscues to Southeast's zero...Eastern Kentucky takes the week off before returning to action Nov. 5 at Murray State.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (4-4 overall, 4-1 OVC): Junior **Clay Green** became the first JSU running back to rush for 100 yards in five consecutive games, collecting 125 yards and two touchdowns on 18 carries in Jacksonville State's 33-3 road win over Tennessee State...The Gamecock offense rolled up 376 yards and did not commit a turnover...Sophomore LB **Devin Phillips** had a team-high six tackles, including a sack and tackle for loss...Senior safety **Darren Williams'** first career blocked punt led to a Gamecock touchdown in the second quarter...Junior FB **Raynodd Zeine** caught his first TD pass of the season, finishing with career-highs of 53 yards on four receptions...Zeine also netted his first rushing TD of 2005, ending with 18 yards on four carries...Sophomore WR **Adrian Smith** had career-highs of four catches and 53 yards...After starting the season 0-3, JSU has won four of its last five contests heading into Saturday's home game against Tennessee Tech.

MURRAY STATE (1-6 overall, 0-4 OVC): Murray State lost a 35-28 Homecoming decision to Eastern Illinois, dropping the Racers to 1-6 for the first time since 1990 and marking MSU's first five-game losing streak since 1992...Leading 28-21 with 7:28 left in the third quarter, the Racers gave up 14 quick points on back-to-back turnovers...Junior QB **Ken Topps** became the first MSU signal-caller to rush for 100 yards in a game since 1982, averaging 7.4 yards on 16 carries to finish with 118 yards...Topps also threw for 92 yards and two touchdowns to end with 214 total yards...Senior LB **Patrick Schultz** intercepted his first pass of the season and contributed seven tackles...Senior RB/KR **Nick Turner** registered his second special teams TD return of the season, returning a punt 65 yards for a touchdown...Turner also averaged 25 yards on four kickoff returns to finish with 165 overall...Sophomore WR **Robb Harper** hauled in his first career TD as part of a seven-catch, 94-yard effort...Next up for the Racers is an Oct. 29 trip to Southeast Missouri.

SAMFORD (4-4 overall, 3-2 OVC): The Samford defense intercepted five passes, returning two for touchdowns, on the way to a 30-22 win at UT Martin. The win was Samford's first road victory of the season, snapping a five-game slide that dated back to Oct. 23, 2004...Senior FS **Cortland Finnegan**, sophomore CB **Sean Hill**, junior CB **Quinton Griffin**, freshman DB **Kyle Morton** and freshman FS **Luke Landers** each had an interception for the Bulldogs, with Finnegan and Hill returning their picks for TDs...Finnegan also led the team with nine tackles...Landers' pick, the first of his career, came with 12 seconds left in the game and ended the threat of a Skyhawk comeback...Sophomore QB **Jefferson Adcock** completed 14-of-26 passes for 113 yards and two touchdowns...Junior punter **Chris Hicks** placed five of his 11 punts inside the 20-yard line, including two inside the five...The Bulldogs return home for an Oct. 29 meeting with Tennessee State.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (0-7 overall, 0-4 OVC): Southeast Missouri's bid for its first win of the season fell one second short as the Redhawks dropped a 33-32 heartbreaker at Eastern Kentucky...Running back **Tim Holloman** scored four touchdowns and finished with 250 all-purpose yards in the contest, rushing for 155 yards and two TDs on 31 carries while catching six passes for 95 yards and two TDs, all of which marked career-highs for the true freshman...Senior QB **Mike Haley** went without an interception for the first time this season, completing 18-of-27 passes for 237 yards and two touchdowns...Junior DB **D'Eldrick Taylor** had a game-high 10 tackles, including seven solo stops...Senior DE **Justin Komondoreas** had a career-high two sacks among six stops...The game was the first this season in which the Redhawks did not commit a turnover...Southeast returns home to host Murray State in a Homecoming contest on Oct. 29.

UT MARTIN (4-3 overall, 2-2 OVC): UT Martin dropped a 30-22 decision to Samford, giving the Skyhawks consecutive losses for the first time this season...Senior QB **Brady Wahlberg** completed 16-of-33 passes for 184 yards and two touchdowns, but was picked off five times for the second straight week...Sophomore **Jamaal Akbar** caught both of Wahlberg's TD strikes, finishing with 46 yards on three receptions, while junior WR **Taurean Stephens** led the team with 54 yards on six catches...Sophomore RB **Don Chapman** recorded his fourth 100-yard effort of 2005, running for 134 yards on 24 carries to move up to sixth place on the school's career rushing charts (1,934 yds.)...Senior PK **Taylor Brown's** final point-after attempt in the game was blocked, ending his streak of 29 consecutive PATs that dated back to Oct. 23, 2004...Junior LB **David Gilmore** had a team-high 12 tackles, all solo...The Skyhawks' defense held Samford to just 118 passing yards while recording four quarterback sacks...UT Martin visits Eastern Illinois on Oct. 29.

TENNESSEE STATE (2-5 overall, 1-2 OVC): Tennessee State's first home game in seven weeks ended with a 33-3 loss to Jacksonville State...TSU took an early 3-0 lead in the opening period, but saw the Gamecocks score 33 unanswered points en route to the win...The Tigers allowed several opportunities to slip away, including three scoreless trips inside the JSU 15...Redshirt freshman RB **Javaris Williams** notched his second consecutive 100-yard game, carrying the ball 27 times for 134 yards...TSU's defense featured eight solo tackles among a game-high 10 stops from **Jamar Landrom**...Junior QB **Richard Hartman** completed 16-of-25 passes for 163 yards...Sophomore RB/KR **Denard Cox** racked up 102 kickoff return yards on five carries...TSU goes back out on the road for an Oct. 29 visit to Samford.

TENNESSEE TECH (2-5 overall, 1-3 OVC): Tennessee Tech had the week off, returning to action Oct. 29 at Jacksonville State.

FINNEGAN HONORED: Samford senior FS/KR **Cortland Finnegan's** 75-yard punt return for the game-winning touchdown in the Bulldogs' Oct. 15 victory over Murray State earned him national recognition as *The Sports Network's* Specialist of the Week and as a I-AA.org All-Star.

AIRING IT OUT: OVC quarterbacks have thrown for 200 or more yards in 24 of 47 games this season, including five 300-yard efforts...Eastern Kentucky sophomore **Josh Greco** owns three of the five 300-yard performances, including a Conference-high 398-yard outing against Eastern Illinois, while Samford sophomore **Jefferson Adcock** and Tennessee Tech redshirt freshman **John Conrad McCrary** boast one apiece...Greco leads the league in passing (272.9 ypg), total offense (286.6 ypg), pass efficiency (131.4) and touchdown passes (18).

BEST AND WORST: The nation's stats for turnover margin begin and end with OVC squads...**Eastern Illinois** has forced 28 turnovers while giving up only 13 to top all I-AA football squads with a plus-15 margin (2.14 pg), while **Murray State** and **Tennessee Tech** lie at the other end of the spectrum with a minus-13 effort (-1.86 pg) each.

100-YARD MEN: Jacksonville State junior RB **Clay Green** has rushed for 100 yards in five consecutive games, and is the only OVC rusher or receiver with six 100-yard efforts to his credit this season...Eastern Kentucky senior WR **Andre Ralston** is next with five 100-yard receiving games...UT Martin sophomore RB **Don Chapman** and Murray State junior RB **Chad Cook** are the only two players to top the 200-yard rushing mark in 2005.

TAYLOR-MADE: Eastern Kentucky freshman kicker **Taylor Long** boasts a perfect 26-of-26 marks in point-after attempts this season.

THE MATCHUP: The league's second-highest passing offense (Southeast Missouri-278.9 ypg) and second-best passing defense (Murray State-162.1 ypg) square off against each other Saturday in Cape Girardeau...Both teams are winless in OVC play at 0-4 apiece...MSU is 1-6 overall, Southeast is 0-7...The Racers have won 12 straight over the Redhawks, including a 28-13 decision last year in Murray, and hold a 34-4-1 lead in the series, which began in 1926...After meeting annually from 1926-31, the two teams faced each other only six more times over the next 45 years before beginning a 13-year stretch of contests in 1976...Following a brief hiatus, the series resumed in 1991 when Southeast joined the OVC...Southeast has defeated MSU only once as Conference opponents, a 14-10 decision in 1991...Racers head coach **Joe Pannunzio** is 5-0 against the Redhawks, while Southeast mentor **Tim Billings** is 0-5 vs. MSU...Both teams are coming off losses last week with MSU falling, 35-28, to Eastern Illinois and Southeast losing a 33-32 heartbreaker at Eastern Kentucky.

SCOUTING MSU: Turnovers were the name of the game last week at Eastern Illinois as the Racers surrendered 21 points off a season-high six giveaways...Junior QB **Ken Topps** finds himself ranked 10th among the league's rushing leaders (46.7 ypg) following a 100-yard effort last week...After racking up 358 rushing yards in his previous two outings, junior RB **Chad Cook** was limited to just 25 yards on the ground at EIU...Cook is fifth in the league with an 82.6 average...Senior WR **Daniel Rumley** is third in the OVC in receptions (4.83 pg) and 10th in receiving yardage (51.7 ypg)...Senior RB/KR **Nick Turner** ranks first and fifth in the OVC, respectively, in punt (11.7 ypr) and kick (24.6 ypr) return average...Turner is also fourth in all-purpose yardage (122.2 ypg)...Each of the Racers' last three losses have been by a touchdown or less...Junior PK **Gary Crass** has missed just one PAT this season (11-of-12) and is a perfect 4-of-4 in field goal attempts...Sophomore LB **Nathan Williams** counts 36 solo stops among a team-high 58 tackles.

SCOUTING SEMO: Southeast was turnover-free for the first time this season at Eastern Kentucky...After relying on their passing attack for the first half of the season, the Redhawks have turned to their ground game of late, topping the 100-yard rushing mark twice in the last three games...Senior QB **Mike Haley** is third in the OVC in passing yardage (200.7 ypg)...Prior to last week's four-touchdown, 250 all-purpose-yards performance, true freshman RB **Tim Holloman** had amassed just 130 rushing and 76 receiving yards through six games...Senior WR **T.J. Milcic** has caught at least two passes in every game this season to rank fourth and 10th, respectively, in the OVC in receiving yardage (63.1 ypg) and receptions (3.86 pg)...Freshman PK **Colin Schermann** has missed only once in 10 field goal attempts this fall and leads the league in both kicking percentage (90%) and average (1.29 pg)...Junior DB **Mike Miller** (60 tackles) is the Redhawks' leading stopper...Senior DE **Justin Komondoreas** ranks among Conference leaders in sacks (3.5) and tackles for loss (7.5).

THE MATCHUP: Tennessee State and Samford meet up for just the third time when the Bulldogs host the Tigers ...TSU's league-leading pass defense (156.9 ypg) will be put to the test against the Bulldogs' third-ranked air attack (235.0 ypg)...The two-year-old series is tied at 1-1 with the visiting team winning each of the previous two meetings...Last season, Samford came out on top of a 42-36 overtime thriller in Nashville...Samford skipper **Bill Gray** is 1-1 against the Tigers, while TSU field boss **James Webster** is meeting the Bulldogs for the first time...After last week's 33-3 loss to Jacksonville State, the Tigers (2-5 overall, 1-2 OVC) head into Saturday looking to even their OVC record at .500...Meanwhile, the Bulldogs (4-4 overall, 3-2 OVC) are riding a two-game win streak following last week's 30-22 triumph at UT Martin.

SCOUTING TSU: Junior **Richard Hartman** and redshirt freshman **Jerald Cook** continue to split time at the quarterback position as the Tigers look for ways to improve their offense output, which ranks last in the league at 14.0 points per game...Redshirt freshman **Javarris Williams** has recorded back-to-back 100-yard rushing efforts and ranks fourth in the OVC with 87.6 yards per game...Senior **Fred Burnette** (27 rec., 333 yds.) is the lone starter remaining in a receiving corps that has been hard-hit with injuries...Senior DB **Jamar Landrom** has forced a league-high four fumbles and also tops the Conference with 11.5 tackles for loss...Senior LB **Wesley Holmes** has a team-best 67 stops and is tied for second in the Conference with 7.5 tackles for loss...TSU went without a sack for the first time this season in the JSU contest, but still tops the OVC with 23 sacks on the year, tying for seventh nationally...After committing 18 turnovers in the first five games, the Tigers have taken better care of the ball over their last two outings with just four miscues combined...TSU's ability to defend the pass is helping the Tigers hold opponents to a league-low 322.1 yards per game.

SCOUTING SAM: The Bulldogs' normally pass-heavy offense has featured a more balanced attack over the last two games, averaging 115 yards on the ground and 116 through the air during that span...After getting picked off a season-high three times Sept. 29 against Eastern Kentucky, sophomore QB **Jefferson Adcock** has gone without an interception in his last two outings...Adcock currently ranks second in the OVC in both passing (211.1 ypg) and total (247.1 ypg) offense, with the bulk of his tosses being caught by sophomore WR **Jeff Moore** (36 rec., 451 yds.) and senior WR **Ossie Buchannon** (34 rec., 367 yds.)...Moore is also pulling double-duty on special teams, ranking among Conference leaders in kick return average (21.6 ypr) and all-purpose yardage (83.6 ypg)...After being limited to just eight yards on five carries in the loss at EKU, junior RB and top rusher **Justin Ray** has bounced back for a combined 109 yards on 29 totes in the last two games...Ray is ninth in the OVC in rushing (48.1 ypg)...Senior DB **Cortland Finnegan** has a team-high 73 stops, while sophomore LB **Jay McCurty** and freshman DL **Mark Brown** rank among OVC leaders with 6.0 tackles for loss each.

Tennessee Tech Golden Eagles (2-5) at Jacksonville State Gamecocks (4-4)

THE MATCHUP: Jacksonville State entertains Tennessee Tech for a Homecoming contest on Saturday...The Gamecocks hold a 4-3 edge in the series, which began in 1938...Following the '38 meeting, the two teams didn't face each other again until a three-year stretch of contests from 1977 to 1980...The series was renewed on an annual basis in 2001...Last season, Tech handed Jax State its only OVC loss, a 16-13 thriller in Cookeville...The Golden Eagles also own the only shutout of the series, a 21-0 decision in their first meeting...After starting the season 0-3, JSU has won four of its last five games and sits tied for second in the OVC standings at 4-1 (4-4 overall)...Tech, meanwhile, has struggled with consistency and finds itself on a two-game slide with a 1-3 mark in Conference play (2-5 overall)...JSU field boss **Jack Crowe** and Tech mentor **Mike Hennigan** sport identical 2-2 marks against each other's team...The Gamecocks are coming off a 33-3 win over Tennessee State, while Tennessee Tech enjoyed a bye week.

SCOUTING TTU: Top receiver **Larry Shipp** has also emerged as Tech's leading kick return man in 2005...Shipp is second in the OVC in receiving yardage (78.3 ypg) and fifth in receptions (4.57 pg) while ranking 10th in kick return average (20.4 ypg)...Junior RB **Anthony Ash's** 110 rushing yards Oct. 13 against Tennessee State marked his second 100-yard effort of the season...Ash, sixth in the OVC in rushing (72.4 ypg), has been heading up the Golden Eagles' ground attack as senior **Trey Bonner** deals with a nagging knee injury...Sophomore QB **Stephen Britton** is banged up and may not start on Saturday...If Britton is unable to go, redshirt freshman **John Conrad McCrary** will get the nod...McCrary made quite an impression in his first career start two weeks ago, completing 25 of a school-record 51 pass attempts while throwing for 324 yards and a TD...Tech's secondary accounts for the bulk of the Golden Eagles' top tackle numbers, led by senior DB **Anthony James**, who has a team-high 55 stops...Senior DE **Yusuf Sharif** is tied for second in the OVC with 7.5 tackles for loss.

SCOUTING JSU: JSU played turnover-free ball for the first time this season at Tennessee State while rolling up over 300 yards of offense for the fourth straight game...The Gamecocks are second in the Conference in rushing (214.0 ypg) and third in total (356.4 ypg) offense...Junior RB **Clay Green**, second in the OVC in rushing (117.4 ypg), is closing in on the 1,000-yard mark (939 yds.) after rushing for 100 yards for the fifth straight game last week...Green is also doing some damage on special teams, recording 498 kick return yards to top the OVC and rank second nationally in all-purpose yardage (192.1 ypg)...Sophomore WR **Taurean Rhetta** has caught at least one pass in every game this season and ranks fifth in the Conference in receiving yardage (60.4 ypg)...Junior safety **Kenny Brown** leads the team with 49 tackles...Senior safety **Darren Williams**, the Gamecocks' second-leading tackler (47 stops) is among league leaders with seven passes defended...Senior LB **Derrick Sistrunk** counts a team-high 3.5 sacks among 41 tackles this season.

THE MATCHUP: Eastern Illinois puts its perfect 4-0 OVC record (5-2 overall) on the line this week when the Panthers entertain UT Martin...Despite losing their last two games, the Skyhawks are off to their best start since 1995 (4-3 overall, 2-2 OVC)...Saturday's contest pits the league's top rushing offense (UTM-215.4 ypg) against the OVC's best rushing defense (EIU-120.3 ypg)...Eastern Illinois owns the only shutout in 10 meetings between the two teams, a 38-0 decision in 1996, and holds a 9-1 lead in the series, which began in 1995...The Skyhawks snapped a nine-game losing streak to the Panthers last season with a 32-14 win in Martin...EIU head coach **Bob Spoo** is 9-1 against UT Martin, while Skyhawk skipper **Matt Griffin** is 1-1 versus the Panthers...Last week's 35-28 victory over Murray State extended EIU's win streak to four games...UT Martin's 30-22 setback to Samford a week ago marked its first back-to-back losses of the season.

SCOUTING UTM: Sophomore RB **Don Chapman** recorded his fourth 100-yard rushing effort of the season last week and continues to lead the league with a 121.4 average, ranking seventh nationally...Junior WR **Taurean Stephens** leads the OVC and ranks 12 nationally in receptions (6.29 pg)...Stephens is also third in the Conference in receiving yardage (69.4 ypg)...After throwing just one interception in his first five outings, senior QB **Brady Wahlberg** has struggled of late, getting picked off five times in each of his last two games...Junior LB **David Gilmore** has recorded double-digit tackle efforts in four of his last five outings and leads the team with 63 stops overall...Senior DE **Andre Plummer** is one of five OVC players with a league-high 4.0 sacks this season...UT Martin is rolling up a Conference-best 394.4 yards offense each time out while limiting foes to 359.4 yards on the defensive end (3rd in OVC)...The Skyhawks have scored on nine straight trips inside their opponents' 20 and continue to lead the league with an 85.7 percent success rate in the redzone.
