NORRIS SMITH • RB, SO., 5'9, 222 •

ET. LAURDALE, FLA. • EASTERN ILLINOIS

Smith was one of two Eastern Illinois running backs that finished with more than 150 rushing yards on Saturday afternoon as the Panthers ground out 335 rushing yards in a 20-10 win over Murray State. The sophomore running back finished with 154 yards on 22 carries for a 7.0 yards per carry average. He also scored two times with both runs coming from four yards out, the first score knotting th game at 10-10.

Jackson led UT Martin with eight total tackles, including seven solo stops as the Skyhawks defeated Samford 10-6 on Saturday. He also had a fumble recovery and one pass breakup in the game. The senior linebacker help limit the Samford offense to 97 yards rushing and 131 passing yards.

Heffner passed for 260 yards and 2 touchdowns to lead Tennessee State past Jacksonville State, 38-31, on Saturday. The Sophomore quarterback also rushed for 33 yards and one TD. He led the Tigers on sustained scoring drives of 73, 70, 61, 49, and 57 yards.

2006 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE FOOTBALL NOTES

EASTERN ILLINOIS (5-3, 4-0 OVC)

Eastern Illinois stretched its OVC win streak to 13 games with a 20-10 victory over Murray State on Saturday. Sophomore Norris Smith was one of two EIU running backs that finished with 154 yards on 22 carries for a 7.0 yards per carry average. He also scored two times with both runs coming from four yards out, the first TD knotting the game at 10-10. It was the second time this season and second time in school history that two EIU backs finished with more than 150 yards. Senior Vincent Webb had 182 yards for the Panthers. Junior DT Tim Kelly was part of a solid defense front that held Murray State to less than 90 yards rushing on the afternoon. Kelly was credited with six tackles, making one solo stop and one for a loss. Sophomore kicker/punter Zach Yates was 2-for-3 on field goals during the game. Yates missed on a 35-yard attempt in the first quarter but redeemed himself to make two second half field goals. Eastern Illinois will travel to UT Martin on Saturday.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (3-5, 2-3 OVC)

Eastern Kentucky scored 27 points in the third quarter to defeat Southeast Missouri, 27-21, on Saturday. Sophomore QB Allan Holland completed 72.7 percent of his passes for 187 yards and two scores. The two touchdowns were the first of Holland's career. Junior LB Justin Curry notched his first career interception in the third quarter and returned it 60 yards for a touchdown. He also tallied three tackles and helped the defense hold the Redhawks' Tim Hollman to just three rushing yards in the second half. The Colonels' 27 points in the third quarter were the most points in a quarter since scoring 28 versus EIU on Oct. 9, 2004. Eastern Kentucky has not scored a touchdown on the opening possession in the second half in three straight games. The Colonels are off this week and will return to action on Nov. 4 when they welcome Murray State.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (3-4, 3-2 OVC)

Jacksonville State fell to Tennessee State, 38-31, for the first time ever. Saturday marked the 56th game under Jack Crowe that JSU has reached 300 yards or more in total offense. Junior QB Matt Hardin threw for a career-high 261 yards and two touchdowns. It marked the third time in his career that Hardin has thrown for two or more TDs in a game. Junior P Zach Walden had a punt blocked for the first time in his career during the first quarter. Freshman WR James Wilkerson caught a career-long 70-yard pass from Hardin to tie the game at 7-7. The pass completion was the longest play from scrimmage on the season for JSU. In the third quarter, the Gamecocks had just 16 yards of offense and one first down. Jacksonville State will look to get back on the winning track as they travel to Tennessee Tech on Saturday.

MURRAY STATE (1-7, 0-5 OVC)

Murray State led No. 16 Eastern Illinois 10-0 at halftime but the Racers couldn't hold off a Panther comeback and fell 20-10. Freshman RB Charlie Jordan capped MSU's opening drive with his first collegiate touchdown. He finished with 90 yards on 24 carries. Jordan also caught a game-high 10 passes for 58 yards. Redshirt-freshman QB Zach Barnard completed 29-of-39 passes for 210 yards and did not throw an interception. Freshman WR Derrick Townsel caught seven passes for 76 yards. Junior LB Nathan Williams made 15 tackles while freshman LB Taylor Lanigan picked off his second pass of the season. The Racers will look to pick up their first OVC win of the season as they host Southeast Missouri on Saturday.

SAMFORD (3-5, 1-4 OVC)

Samford lost to UT Martin, 10-6, to snap a 14-game winning streak in the series. The last time that the Bulldogs fell to the Skyhawks was in 1988. Junior PK Shannon Fleming produced all of the Bulldog's points with field goals from 22 and 28 yards. Junior LB Jay McCurdy led all tacklers with nine tackles, all of which were solo stops. He also had one tackle for a loss of eight yards in the game. Samford will travel to Tennessee State on Saturday in a game that can be seen regionally on CSS.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (3-4, 1-3 OVC)

Southeast Missouri fell to Eastern Kentucky, 27-21, on Saturday. The Redhawks allowed the Colonels to score 27 points in the third quarter. Sophomore RB Tim Hollman tallied 25 carries for 99 yards as well as six catches for 41 yards. Junior DE Edgar Jones recorded eight tackles, including 1.5 for losses of two yards. He also had one quarterback sack and one quarterback hurry. Senior P David Simonhoff had six punts for an average of 50.7 yards per punt. He put two inside the 10 yard line and had a long of 69 yards versus the Colonels. Southeast Missouri travels to Murray State this week.

TENNESSEE STATE (4-3, 3-0 OVC)

Tennessee State defeated Jacksonville State, 38-31, for the first time ever. Sophomore WR Chris Johnson made five catches for 156 yards and two touchdowns. His 63 yard TD was the game-winning catch. Sophomore QB Antonio Heffner passed for 260 yards and two TDs. He also rushed for 33 yards and one touchdown to finish with 293 yards of total offense. He led the Tigers on sustained scoring drives of 73, 70, 61, 49, and 57 yards. Sophomore RB Javarris Williams rushed for 76 yards to move in to fifth place among career rushers at TSU. Williams' four yard TD run in the first quarter marked the first time JSU has surrendered a first half offensive touchdown. Tennessee State will welcome Samford this week in a game that can be seen regionally on CSS.

TENNESSEE TECH (2-5, 2-2 OVC)

Tennessee Tech is coming off a bye week and will host Jacksonville State on Saturday. The last time JSU and Tech met was in 2005 with the Gamecocks taking the 43-17 win.

UT MARTIN (6-1, 3-0 OVC)

UT Martin defeated Samford, 10-6, to extend its winning streak to six straight. The win over the Bulldogs was the second in 18 meetings and the first since 1988. Also with the victory, the Skyhawks have assured themselves of their second consecutive winning season. Freshman QB Dexter Anoka complete 7-of-10 passes without an interception for 63 yards. He also had five carries for 72 yards. Senior K Taylor Brown had one extra point and a 21-yard field goal in the win. His four points turned out to be the difference in the game. Brown has made 18-of-18 PATs and 9-of-12 field goals. He has a total of 45 points and leads the Skyhawks in scoring this season. Senior LB Markeseo Jackson led the team with eight tackles, including seven solo stops. He also had a fumble recovery and one pass breakup. Jackson helped limit the Samford offense to 97 yards rushing and 131 passing yards. UT Martin will host Eastern Illinois on Saturday.

Southeast Missouri senior David Simonhoff currently sports a 45.9 punting average, not far off his OVC-record mark of 46.0, set in 2004.
