THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

Gerald Robinson, F • Sr., 6-9, 230 • Los Angeles, Calif. • UT Martin

Robinson earned his second Player of the Week award of the season (Jan. 28 was the other) after averaging 26.0 points, 12.5 rebounds, 2.0 steals and 1.0 assists per game in a pair of UT Martin victories last week. The victories improved the Skyhawks to 11-8 in OVC play and secured a place for the team in the OVC Tournament for only the sixth time since joining the league in 1992. Robinson hit 62.1 percent (18-of-29) from the field and 46.7 percent (7-of-15) from the field as he recorded his ninth and 10th double-doubles of the year (the second most among OVC players). Robinson scored 26 points in both games and had 10 rebounds against Tennessee Tech and 15 in a win over Southeast Missouri. Robinson ranks seventh in the OVC in scoring (15.2) and third in rebounding (8.3).

NEWCOMER

Lester Hudson, G • Jr., 6-3, 190 • Memphis, Tenn. • UT Martin

Hudson earned his fifth Newcomer of the Week award and ninth award overall in 14 total weeks this season after putting together quality numbers and recording a triple-double in the Skyhawks two victories last week. Hudson averaged 17.5 points, 8.5 rebounds, 8.5 assists and 2.0 steals per game last week as UT Martin clinched an OVC Tournament berth. After recording the first quadruple-double in men's Division I history earlier this season Hudson recorded a triple-double in the win over Southeast Missouri; he had 26 points, 12 rebounds and 10 assists as the 'Hawks won their fifth game in a row. He was limited to only nine points in a road win over Tennessee Tech, but did dish out five assists in the victory. Hudson has been named either Player or Newcomer of the Week in seven of the past eight weeks.

CO-FRESHMAN

Jeremy Bynum, G • Fr., 6-2, 170 • Oxford, Ala. • Jacksonville State

Bynum averaged 15.0 points and 2.5 rebounds per game in a pair of Jacksonville State victories last week. He hit 57.9 percent (11-of-19) from the field and 57.9 percent (6-of-13) from 3-point range in wins over Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State, two teams who are tied for third place in the OVC standings. Coming off the bench against EKU, Bynum led all scorers with 18 points in just 14 minutes of action, thanks to a 7-of-7 effort from the field, including 4-of-4 from 3-point range. Bynum also came off the bench in the win over Morehead State, as he scored 12 points. Bynum was also named Freshman of the Week on Nov. 26 of this season. He is the third straight Jax State player to be named OVC Freshman of the Week this season.

CO-FRESHMAN

Marquis Weddle, G • Fr., 6-1, 185 • Union City, Tenn. • UT Martin

Weddle averaged 21.5 points, 3.5 assists, 1.0 steals and 1.0 rebounds per game in a pair of UT Martin victories as the Skyhawks clinched an OVC Tournament berth. Weddle hit 47.1 percent (16-of-34) from the field and was perfect (6-of-6) at the free throw line. He scored 14 points, all of which came in the second half, in Saturday's win over Southeast Missouri. In the Skyhawks road victory at Tennessee Tech, Weddle scored 29 points on 11-of-18 shooting in 38 minutes of play. It marks the sixth time this season that Weddle has been named OVC Freshman of the Week.

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NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: The OVC Tournament picture began to become a little more clear this week as five teams have now clinched berths in the eight-team field...Austin Peay, who has clinched a share of the OVC Regular Season Championship, has been joined in the field by Murray State, Eastern Kentucky, Morehead State and UT Martin...Samford and Tennessee Tech can clinch a spot with one more victory or a Southeast Missouri State loss while Tennessee State will need a combination of those things to happen to hold onto the eighth place spot it currently occupies...With this week mainly consumed by games in the O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters event, there are only two OVC games on tap...Austin Peay plays at Tennessee State on Monday and Wednesday night features one of the most key games of the year when Morehead State plays at Eastern Kentucky; Morehead and Eastern are currently tied for third place in the standings...10 of the 11 OVC schools will compete in BracketBusters on Saturday; the 11th team - Tennessee State - was scheduled for the event but their game at Northern Illinois was cancelled in the wake of the deadly shooting on the NIU campus last week...Lester Hudson needs five 3-pointers to break the OVC single-season mark for trifectas in a season (120); he is currently sixth nationally in 3-pointers made per game...Hudson had a triple-double last week; that adds to the quadruple-double he had earlier this season and eight other double-doubles...Tennessee Tech's Daniel Northern leads the OVC in double-doubles (11) while also leading the Conference in rebounding (9.0/game) and blocked shots (2.8/game).

OVCsports.TV: For the second consecutive year, fans can watch EVERY Conference matchup and all non-conference home contests this season at OVCsports.TV. The venture with JumpTV Sports (formerly XOS Technologies) allows fans to access live and on-demand streaming video and audio of all conference matchups on their home computer. The premium Web site was launched in July 2006 and streamed hundreds of events in its first season, including all Conference matchups in football and men's and women's basketball as well as select baseball, soccer, softball and volleyball games and OVC Championship events. Last season the OVC was one of just two Conferences nationally streaming every football and men's and women's basketball game on the Internet. O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters Pairings Announced: The matchups for the 2008 O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters series were announced on Monday, Feb. 4. For the third straight year, all 11 Ohio Valley Conference schools will participate in the event. Five schools will host games this season while the other six will go on the road. Austin Peay has competed in the most BracketBusters games, competing in each of the past four years. Murray State (3-0) and UT Martin (2-0) are the only OVC schools with unblemished records in BracketBusters play. In its sixth year, O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters is an ESPN television property that was tremendously successful with its first five events in February of 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006 and 2007. The event has allowed Division I conferences to participate in a cutting-edge format that involves "wild-card" pairings for the pool of participating teams, with half of the O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters teams pre-designated as "home" and the remaining half as "road" teams. The 2008 O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters will take place over two days for the third straight year — Friday-Saturday, February 22-23 — with a total pool of 100 teams representing 16 conferences in a 50-game event. In an effort to provide a greater opportunity for NCAA Tournament-caliber teams, the event had expanded its pool of teams (18 in 2003, 46 in 2004, 64 in 2005, 100 in 2006 and 102 in 2007) each year to produce a better cross section of squads for the hoops bonanza. No OVC team was picked for one of the 14 television matchups this season. Tennessee State's BracketBusters game at Northern Illinois was cancelled in the wake of the shooting on the NIU campus.

Austin Peay Clinches at Least a Share of 8th OVC Championship: Entering Monday's game at Tennessee State with a 14-3 OVC record, the Austin Peay Governors have clinched at least a share of the OVC Regular Season Championship. The Govs can win the title outright with one more victory in their three remaining OVC games or with one loss by Murray State. It marks the eighth time that APSU has won the regular season title and second time in as many years. It also marks the third time the Govs have won back-to-back championships. Austin Peay has also claimed titles in 1973, 1974, 1977, 1997, 2003, 2004 and 2007. Austin Peay has compiled an impressive 30-7 record over the past two years in OVC play.

2008 OVC TOURNAMENT

The 2008 Ohio Valley Conference Men's & Women's Tournaments will be held March 4, 7-8. The first round games will be held at campus sites (top four seeds on each side) on Tuesday, March 4. Those games can be seen live on OVCsports.TV.

The winners of those games will shift to historic Municipal Auditorium in downtown Nashville, Tenn. for the semifinals and finals. The men's semifinals will be held on Friday, March 7 at 6 and 8 p.m. and televised on ESPN2 with the championship game on Saturday, March 8 at 4 p.m. and televised live on ESPN2 (note, this is a change from the original time announced). The women's semifinals are set for 12 and 2 p.m. on March 7th (televised on OVCsports.TV) and the women's championship game is set for March 8 at 11 a.m. and will be televised on Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast (CSS).

This marks the 14th time in 15 years that the tournament has been held in Nashville and the fifth time it will take place in Municipal. The event was also held there in 1989, 1994, 1995 and 2004.

Top Scoring Teammate Tandems: Only two other duos in Division I college basketball currently score more total points than UT Martin guards **Lester Hudson** (25.8) and **Marquis Weddle** (16.4). The duo currently combines for 42.2 points per game which trails only a duo from Niagara and VMI. One other OVC duo (TSU's **Bruce Price** and **Gerald Robinson, Jr.**) rank among the top 42 duos nationally (42nd).

Two Coaches Reach 100 Career Victories: Tennessee Tech head coach **Mike Sutton** reached the 100 career victory plateau on Feb. 7 with an overtime victory over Jacksonville State. Sutton is in his sixth season with the Golden Eagle program. Just a week later UT Martin head coach **Bret Campbell** reached his 100 career victories with an 82-79 victory at Tennessee Tech. Campbell is in his ninth season with the Skyhawks. Currently the only other coach in the OVC with 100 career victories at their current school is Austin Peay's Dave Loos. Several other coaches have more than 100 career wins, but they came at a combination of schools.

Ginn Named Academic All-District: Jacksonville State senior **Will Ginn** was selected to the ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District First Team by the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA). Ginn, a 6-foot-0-inch guard from Alexandria, Ala., was the only player from the Ohio Valley Conference selected to the five-person squad for District IV, thanks to a 3.82 grade point average in Math Education. He is second on the team in scoring with 10.6 points per game. With the selection to the All-District squad, Ginn will be placed on the organization's Academic All-America ballot, which will be voted on by the Sports Information Directors across the country.

40 Points: Austin Peay senior point guard Derek Wright was on fire against Southeast Missouri State (Jan. 29) when he scored 43 points in his team's 121-116 triple overtime loss to the Redhawks. Wright, who hit numerous big shots in the game, was 11-of-26 from the field, 5-of-12 from 3-point range and 16-of-20 from the free throw line. Twenty (20) of his 43 points came during the overtime period. The 43 points ranks as the second-highest Division I total so far this season (trailing only the 44 points scored by Troy's Justin Jonas on Nov. 14). Wright was the first OVC player to score 40 or more points in a game since Eastern Illinois' Josh Gomes scored 40 against UT Martin on Feb. 7, 2004. It was the most points scored since Eastern Illinois' Henry Domercant scored 46 against Tennessee Tech on March 1, 2003.

OVC Mandates Courtside Replay Systems For Basketball Games: On December 21, Dr. Jon A. Steinbrecher, Ohio Valley Conference Commissioner, mandated the use of courtside replay systems at all OVC basketball venues for the remainder of the season. The mandate was reviewed by the OVC Board of Athletic Directors on Jan. 3 and the systems were put in place in all 11 venues by Jan. 12 and will be used in situations that are outlined by NCAA rules. Prior to this mandate, replay had only been available for games that were televised; the new mandate allows for officiating crews to watch replays regardless of the presence of television crews.

UT Martin's Hudson Nets First Quadruple-Double in Division I Men's Basketball History: UT Martin junior guard **Lester Hudson** made NCAA Division I men's basketball history on Tuesday, Nov. 13 when he recorded a quadruple-double in the Skyhawks 116-74 victory over Central Baptist College. He is believed to be the first men's player to accomplish the feat at the Division I level. Hudson filled up the box score with 25 points, 12 rebounds, 10 assists and 10 steals in 31 minutes of play. He was 10-of-17 from the field and 5-of-7 from 3-point range and also blocked a shot. The 10 steals are the most for a Division I player this season. The transfer from Southwest Tennessee Community College was named OVC Player of the Week on Nov. 12 after his first week with the Skyhawk program. In research conducted by ESPN and the NCAA, no other recorded instances of a quadruple-double occurring at the Division I men's basketball level have ever been recorded. At the Division I women's level, UCLA's Ann Meyers had 20 points, 14 rebounds, 10 assists and 10 steals in a 1978 contest against Stephen F. Austin. The feat has only happened four times in the NBA since the 1973-74 season (when the NBA started to officially recognize blocks and steals). The NBA players to accomplish the feat include David Robinson (Feb. 17, 1994), Hakeem Olajuwon (March 29, 1990), Alvin Robertson (Feb. 18, 1986) and Nate Thurmond (Oct. 18, 1974). The feat has also occurred once in the ABA (Jamel Staten on Feb 2, 2007) and once in the ABL (Debbie Black on Dec. 8, 1996). Four instances of it happening at the women's Division III level have also been documented.

Loos Inducted to Austin Peay Hall of Fame: Current Austin Peay head coach and athletic director **Dave Loos** was inducted into the Austin Peay Hall of Fame on Feb. 16. Loos is the winningest coach in APSU history. It is the fourth Hall of Fame in which he is a member, as he is a member of the St. Louis Baseball Amateur Hall of Fame (he was a former prep player and coach), University of Memphis Athletics Hall of Fame (he was a two-sport star for the Tigers) and the Missouri Basketball Coaches Hall of Fame (from his days coaching his alma mater of Mehlville High School).

Jacksonville State Sets OVC Record for 3-Pointers Made in a Game: Jacksonville State set an OVC record for 3-pointers made in a game on Nov. 12 when they knocked down 19 triples in a 99-74 victory over Tennessee Temple. The 19 3-pointers surpassed the record of 18 previously held by Morehead State (1995-96 season) and Tennessee Tech (1999-00 season). In that game, JSU point guard **Will Ginn** set the school with eight 3-pointers, while **Jeremy Bynum** added seven trifectas.

OVC Reaches 60th Year: This year marks the 60th season of basketball in the Ohio Valley Conference, which was formed in 1948. The OVC is the eighth oldest Division I Conference.

Familiar Faces: When players take to the court this season, teams and fans will see a lot of familiar faces on the court. Less than 30 players finished their eligibility at the end of last season, meaning every team has several experienced players back this season. Two teams - Austin Peay and Eastern Illinois - return all five starters as well as double-digit letterwinners (EIU did not lose a single letterwinner from last season). Jacksonville State and Southeast Missouri each return four starters while Eastern Kentucky, Murray State, Samford and Tennessee State will have three starters apiece back.

All 11 Head Coaches Return: There was no turnover in the OVC coaching ranks at the completion of last season as all 11 OVC men's basketball coaches return this season to guide their respective squads. It marks only the sixth time in the last 30 years (dating back to the 1978-79 season) that every Conference head coach has returned from the previous season. The other years in which every coach returned were 1978-79, 1993-94, 1994-95, 2001-02 and 2004-05.

Alexander and Steinbrecher Named to NCAA Men's Basketball Academic Enhancement Group: This past June NCAA President Myles Brand announced the establishment of the Division I Men's Basketball Academic Enhancement Group. The group, which includes Ohio Valley Conference Commissioner **Jon A. Steinbrecher** and Tennessee State University head men's basketball coach **Cy Alexander**, is comprised of presidents and chancellors, head coaches, commissioners, directors of athletics and faculty athletics representatives and is charged with developing strategies to enhance academic performance and graduation rates in Division I men's basketball. Specifically, the charge to the Division I Men's Basketball Academic Enhancement Group is to: (1) Analyze available data, research and literature regarding the academic performance trends of Division I men's basketball student-athletes, (2) Identify characteristics and factors in the sport that may be serving to impair the academic performance of Division I men's basketball student-athletes, (3) Identify changes that would enhance academic performance and graduation rates in Division I men's basketball, (4) Submit to the Division I Board of Directors, no later than the end of 2008, a set of recommendations and proposals that would enhance APR and graduation rates in Division I men's basketball and (5) Maintain ongoing communication with, and seek reactions from, the NCAA governance structure, the NABC membership and conference offices during the course of the project.

Austin Peay Picked as Preseason Favorite: In a preseason vote of league head coaches and sports information directors, defending regular season champion Austin Peay has been picked to repeat as champions in 2007-08. The Governors were 16-4 last season in claiming their seventh OVC regular season championship and lost in the finals of OVC Tournament. They received 19 of a possible 22 first-place votes. Eastern Kentucky, last year's Tournament Champion, was picked to finish second and received one first-place vote. Tennessee Tech, who received the other two first-place votes, was picked third, followed by Murray State, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Samford, Eastern Illinois, Jacksonville State, Morehead State and UT Martin.

All-Time Preseason Predicted Order of Finish: Does being picked the preseason favorite mean good things for a team? In the 28 years of preseason OVC polls that are available, the preseason poll predicted the eventual league champion 60.7 percent of the time (17 out of 28). That was a much better percentage than the preseason football polls, which predicted the OVC champion only 42.9 percent of the time. From 1994-95 through 1999-00, the preseason champion was picked correctly, but over the last eight years, the preseason poll has correctly predicted the champion only every other season (incorrectly picking Samford last season). If that trend continues, it would mean good things for Austin Peay this year.

Reed Tabbed as Preseason Player of the Year: Austin Peay junior forward **Drake Reed** was tabbed as the preseason OVC Player of the Year in a vote of league head coaches and sports information directors. Reed was named the 2006-07 OVC Player of the Year after helping Austin Peay to the regular season championship; he became the first sophomore to take home OVC Player of the Year honors since Murray State's Ron "Popeye" Jones did in 1990. Reed was one of 10 players selected to the preseason All-OVC team. He was joined by **Bruce Carter** (Murray State), **Anthony Fisher** (Tennessee Tech), **Brandon Foust** (Southeast Missouri), **Adam Leonard** (Eastern Kentucky), **Fernandez Lockett** (Austin Peay), **Romain Martin** (Eastern Illinois), **Amadi McKenzie** (Tennessee Tech), **Travis Peterson** (Samford) and **Mike Rose** (Eastern Kentucky).

Multiple Postseason Berths: Last season the OVC had a team in each the NCAA Tournament and the National Invitational Tournament on both the men's and women's side. For the men, Eastern Kentucky played in the NCAA Tournament, while Austin Peay was the NIT representative. That marked the first time since the 2002 season (when Murray State made the NCAA's and Tennessee Tech the NIT) that the OVC had put two men's squads into the postseason. On the women's side, Southeast Missouri (NCAA) and Murray State (NIT) accomplished the feat, marking the second year in a row two women's squads had earned postseason bids. Only one other time in OVC history (1989) had four total teams played in the postseason; that year Murray State (NCAA) and Middle Tennessee (NIT) were in on the men's side while Tennessee Tech (NCAA) and Murray State (NIT) advanced to postseason on the women's side.

Team Notes

Austin Peay won its only game last week to improve to 14-3 in OVC play this season...With three games remaining the Governors have clinched at least a share of their program's eighth OVC Regular Season Championship (and second in as many years); with one more victory the team will clinch the title outright...The Gobs also won the regular season titles in 1973, 1974, 1977, 1997, 2003, 2004 and 2007...The win last week was a 80-76 home court victory over rival Tennessee Tech...Senior point guard Derek Wright broke the APSU all-time steals record on Saturday, swiping seven steals against the Golden Eagles and breaking the record previously of 71 held by LaMonte Ware; Wright now has 75 steals this season and ranks in the top 10 nationally in steals/game...The Gobs forced TTU into 21 turnovers last week, marking the 10th time this season an opponent had committed 20 or more miscues in a game...Junior forward Drake Reed pulled down his 500th career rebound en route to his sixth double-double of the season on Saturday; he scored 15 points in the win over Tech and became the 25th player in Governor history to grab 500 caroms...Austin Peay also moved past the 200 made 3-pointers mark for the season (they have 203 now) on Saturday; it marked only the fifth time in Gobs history they had amassed more than 200 trifectas in a season - the school record is 228 set in the 1996-97 season...Austin Peay will try to clinch the OVC title outright on Monday night when they play at Tennessee State...On Saturday the Gobs will play their final home regular season game of the season when they host Georgia Southern in the O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters contest.
