THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

CO-PLAYER

DRAKE REED • F, SR., 6'5, 235 • CLARKSVILLE, TENN. • AUSTIN PEAY

Reed led Austin Peay in scoring all three games over the past two weeks, shooting better than 50 percent in each contest, and averaging 18.0 points and 7.7 rebounds per game. Against Evansville, he scored 19 points on 9-of-14 shooting, while adding five rebounds. Against Middle Tennessee, Reed scored a game-high 21 points on 9-of-17 shooting, including the game-winning 3-point play with 18 seconds left. Despite struggling with a 2-for-8 night at the line up to that point, he calmly sank the game-winning free throw. Against Marian, Reed recorded his season's first double-double with 14 points and 10 rebounds.

CO-PLAYER

RANDALL GULINA • G, SR., 6'1, 200 • BATON ROUGE, LA. • SAMFORD

Gulina earned all-tournament honors at the 2006 Hispanic College Funds Classic hosted by LSU and averaged 18 points and 3.0 rebounds per game over the last two weeks. He led the Bulldogs in scoring in all three of his team's games in the four-team competition and rattled off a game-high 26 points in Samford's overtime victory over Mississippi Valley State. Gulina tallied 21 points and five rebounds in the Bulldogs' road win over OVC-rival Southeast Missouri on Dec. 19 and extended his double-figure scoring streak to 12-consecutive games on Friday as he finished with a team-high 14 points against 17th-ranked LSU. He has scored in double figures in every game this season and has reached the 20-point plateau four times.

NEWCOMER

BRUCE CARTER • G, JR., 6'5, 200 • DETROIT, MICH. • MURRAY STATE

Carter, who averaged 17 points and 4.0 rebounds per game, scored 19 points in the Racers overtime win over Jacksonville State. That included scoring seven of Murray State's 14 points in the extra time. He added 16 points against Samford on 8-of-17 shooting. For the two-week period he only missed one free throw attempt (8-of-9).

FRESHMAN

Romain Martin • G, FR., 6-3, 180 • MINNEAPOLIS, MINN. • EASTERN ILLINOIS

Martin, who won the award for the fourth time this season, scored 15 or more points in all four of EIU's games over the past two weeks, extending his double-figure scoring streak to nine games, averaging 17.5 over the time period. He had 20 in the win over Western Illinois, where he was 4-of-7 from 3-point range. He also hit four 3-pointers against Morehead State when he scored 18 points, and hit three 3-pointers and scored 17 against Eastern Michigan.

2006-07 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL REPORT

TEAM NOTES

AUSTIN PEAY (5-6 overall; 2-1 OVC): The Governors compiled a 2-1 record over the past two weeks, losing a close battle against Evansville before topping in-state rival Middle Tennessee 64-63 in overtime and Marian College 83-50...Senior **Drake Reed** was named OVC Co-Player of the Week after averaging 18 points, 7.7 rebounds and 2.7 assists per game and hitting 57.1 percent (24-of-42) from the field; Reed hit 50 percent or better in all three games, made the game-winning 3-point play with 18 seconds left against Middle Tennessee and had his first double-double of the season (14 points, 10 rebounds) against Marian...Junior **Fernandez Lockett** continued his fine play, netting his third double-double of the season with 17 points (a career-high) and 13 rebounds against Middle Tennessee; he has scored in double figures in four straight games...Sophomore **Landon Shipley** missed the Marian contest with an injury but is expected to return against UT Martin; he is currently averaging 11.5 points per game...APSU out-rebounded Middle Tennessee 20-14 in the second half of their victory over the Blue Raiders but were out-rebounded 9-0 in overtime but still managed to hang on for the 1-point victory thanks to forcing four turnovers in the extra period...Austin Peay also struggled at the line against MTSU, hitting only 11-of-22; they rebounded with an 11-of-12 (91.7%) performance the last time out against Marian...The Govs are still leading the OVC in two key defensive categories, blocks (4.09/game) and steals (8.36/game)...The team will get a dose of travel this week, as they will travel nearly 1,135 miles to play at Jacksonville State on Thursday (one of the two southern most schools in the OVC) and then head to Eastern Illinois (the northern most school) on Saturday...The week begins for Austin Peay as they host UT Martin on Tuesday night.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (5-9 overall; 1-4 OVC): Eastern Illinois compiled a 1-3 record over the past two weeks, losing a pair of conference games to Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State at home, before topping Western Illinois and losing at Eastern Michigan (a rematch of the ESPNU BracketBusters game from last season)...Freshman **Romain Martin** continued to rule the OVC Freshman of the Week awards, winning the award for the fourth time in five weeks as he averaged 17.5 points and 2.5 rebounds per game while hitting 46.4 percent from the field; Martin scored 15 or more points in his last four games, extending his double-figure scoring streak to nine, as he had 20 against Western Illinois, 18 against Morehead State and 17 against Eastern Michigan...Martin is eighth in the OVC in scoring (13.8/game) and 3-pointers made (2.14/game)...In Conference-only games, Martin ranks third in scoring (18.8/game)...Sophomore **Mike Robinson** leads the OVC in steals (2.79/game), a mark that was fifth nationally in the last set of NCAA rankings that were released (Dec. 19)...EIU continues to be tough on defense, as the squad ranks first in the league in field goal defense (41.9%), 3-point percentage defense (31.3%), but they currently rank last in the league in scoring (59.8/game)...Currently 1-4 in the league, Eastern Illinois hosts Murray State on Tuesday before traveling to Southeast Missouri on Thursday and then heads back home on Saturday to play Austin Peay.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (8-4 overall; 3-1 OVC): Eastern Kentucky won a pair of road OVC games over the past two weeks, topping Eastern Illinois (73-57) and UT Martin (82-69) to improve to 3-1 in the league...The team saw its winning streak come to an end on Dec. 30 when they fell 78-65 at Kentucky...In the Kentucky contest, freshman **Adam Leonard** was deadly from outside, hitting on 6-of-6 3-pointers in scoring a career-high 20 points; Leonard also dished out a personal-best six assists against UT Martin and averaged 14.7 points, 3.0 rebounds, 3.7 assists and hit 50 percent (15-of-30) from the field over the two-week period...Leonard is currently second in the OVC in 3-point percentage (44.7%), trailing only APSU's Derek Wright (51.6%) while his 3.17 3-pointers made per game is tied for the Conference lead with Belton Rivers of Tennessee Tech...Junior **Darnell Dials** tallied a season-high 15 points against each UT Martin and Kentucky and hit 76.2 percent (16-of-21) in the three games...Sophomore **Mike Rose** made seven 3-pointers in his team's win at UT Martin; the seven made trifectas matched a EKV single-game record...EKU begins the new year by challenging Southeast Missouri on Tuesday night at home; a win over SEMO would push the team's conference record to 4-1 for the first time since the 1991-92 season...The team will then travel to Tennessee Tech for a Thursday night contest with the Golden Eagles...EKU continues to lead the nation in fewest fouls per game (12.9).

JACKSONVILLE STATE (3-10 overall; 1-3 OVC): Jacksonville State ended a five-game away-from-home stretch by competing at UW-Green Bay's Oneida Casino Holiday Classic last week; the Gamecocks suffered losses to host UWGB (90-67), Bowling Green (77-69) and Michigan Tech (76-58)...The last two weeks also included a 70-67 overtime loss at Murray State on Dec. 19...Senior **Courtney Bradley** continued to put up big numbers on the season, scoring 21 points and grabbing 13 rebounds against Michigan Tech; Bradley is fourth in the OVC in scoring (16.8/game) and leads the league in rebounding (8.9/game)...Bradley has four games this season of 12 or more rebounds...**DeAndre Bray** continues to lead the Conference in assists (5.77/game) while **Will Ginn** ranks third (4.31/game)...The Gamecocks begin the New Year on Thursday when they host Austin Peay; the week concludes a trip to rival Samford on Saturday, a game that starts a three-game road swing for JSU.

MOREHEAD STATE (7-5 overall; 3-1 OVC): Morehead State compiled a 3-1 record over the past two weeks, increasing its win total on the season to seven, three more than it had during the entire 2005-06 campaign...That included three straight victories, coming in road OVC contests at UT Martin and Eastern Illinois, as well as a home victory over Indiana-South Bend...The Eagles then dropped a 1-point decision, 52-51, at home to Central Michigan in a rematch of last season's BracketBusters game...MSU's last three losses have come by a total of five points (1 to Marshall, 3 to Murray State and 1 to Central Michigan)...Seniors **Quentin Pryor** and **Shaun Williams** have each averaged 11.3 points per game over the last four contests...Williams scored 27 points and had 12 rebounds, his third double-double of the season, in the 71-63 road victory at Eastern Illinois...Sophomore **Cordaryl Ballard** averaged 14.0 points and 4.8 rebounds per contest over the last two weeks, including 19 in the win over UT Martin...The Eagles currently lead the OVC in each assists (16.17/game), scoring margin (+3.7), rebounding margin (+4.0) and turnover margin (+2.42 - the only OVC school with a greater than +1.0 margin)...**Nik Stojakovic** leads the OVC in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.08)...Morehead State has a pair of home games this week, hosting Tennessee State on Tuesday and Tennessee Tech on Saturday.

MURRAY STATE (5-8 overall; 3-2 OVC): The Racers have not played a game since Dec. 21 when they lost 55-44 at home to Samford...That loss ended a 15-game home-court winning streak at the Regional Special Events Center, a streak that was the 11th longest in the nation; the loss was also ended a 14-game OVC home-court winning streak for the Racers...The 44 points by MSU was the lowest point total ever scored at the RSEC in nine years of games in the building...Junior **Bruce Carter** was named OVC Newcomer of the Week for the second time this season, after averaging 17 points, 4.0 rebounds per game and hitting 41.9 percent of his shots during the week...Senior **Shawn Witherspoon** missed the Samford contest with an

injury, snapping a string of 43 consecutive starts for the OVC Preseason Player of the Year; Witherspoon needs 117 points to join Murray's 1,000-Point Club...Murray State has used 10 different starting lineups this season in the first 13 games of the year...2007 begins with road contests at Eastern Illinois (Tuesday) and Tennessee State (Jan. 4); the month should be a defining month for the program, as the Racers play only two home games (Jan. 8 vs. Southeast Missouri and Jan. 20 vs. UT Martin) during the entire calendar month.

SAMFORD (6-6 overall; 3-0 OVC): Samford is currently one of two undefeated teams (Tennessee State at 2-0 is the other) in Conference play, holding a 3-0 record beginning the 2007 portion of its schedule...The Bulldogs improved to 3-0 with road victories at Southeast Missouri and Murray State in late December...The win over Murray State snapped the Racers 15-game home-court winning streak, the 11th longest streak in the nation...Samford is beginning the Conference season 3-0 for the second time in three years; in 2004-05 Samford began OVC play 6-0...Last week the team traveled to Baton Rouge, La. to play in LSU's Hispanic College Funds Classic, as they topped Mississippi Valley State 64-59 in overtime before falling to Wright State (61-50) and No. 17 LSU (60-45)...Senior **Randall Gulina** was named to the All-Tournament team at the event after averaging 15.3 points per game, including scoring 26 points in the win over Mississippi Valley State; Gulina was also named OVC Co-Player of the Week for his performance over the past two weeks, when he averaged 18 points and 3.0 rebounds per game and hit 50 percent (32-of-64) from the field...Gulina, a native of Baton Rouge, scored 14 points in a meeting with his hometown Tigers; he has scored in double figures in every game this season and currently leads the OVC in scoring (19.1/game)...Those games closed a stretch of seven straight road games, as the team did not play a home contest during the entire month of December; the reward for the hard schedule is three straight at Seibert Hall to start 2007...Those games begin on Tuesday when Samford hosts Tennessee Tech and continues with games on Thursday (UT Martin) and Saturday (Jacksonville State)...Samford has played only two home games so far this season, are a perfect 2-0 at home and have won by a margin of 19 points per game...Head Coach **Jimmy Tillette** was named national mid-major Coach of the Week by CollegeInsider.com on Dec. 27 after leading his team to four straight victories and a 3-0 start in Conference play...Samford has announced a "Sell Out Seibert" promotion for the team's key home game with Murray State on Jan. 29 -- the 2006-07 season marks the final year in the 45-year old building and the athletic department wants to break the building attendance record of 4,240 (set on Feb. 1, 2001 vs. Georgia State) by having 4,500 fans in the seats for the game; former Bulldog coaches and players will be honored at halftime of the game...Samford currently ranks second nationally in turnovers per game (10.3/game), trailing Butler by mere percentage points.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (3-11 overall; 1-4 OVC): Southeast Missouri has dropped six straight contests, including three over the past two weeks...The Redhawks dropped their fourth straight OVC game on Dec. 19, falling by only a lone point to league-leader Samford; that was followed by losses at Big 12 foe Iowa State (87-71) and Big Ten opponent Purdue (101-77)...Freshman **JaJuan Maxwell** averaged 10.7 points and 3.0 rebounds per game in his team's last three games, while also hitting 52.6 percent (10-of-19) from the field, 8-of-8 (1.000) from the free throw line and 4-of-9 (44.4%) from 3-point range; the Raytown, Mo. native had 14 points at Iowa State and came back with a season-best 15 versus Purdue...The Redhawks have struggled defensively this season, ranking 10th or 11th in the OVC in scoring defense, field goal defense, 3-point field goal defense and rebounding defense...Southeast Missouri plays twice this week, Tuesday at Eastern Kentucky and Thursday at home against Eastern Illinois.

TENNESSEE STATE (5-6 overall; 2-0 OVC): Tennessee State is currently one of two OVC teams with perfect league records (Samford at 3-0 is the other) as they hit the heart of the Conference schedule this week...They are 2-0 for only the fourth time since 1991-92 (1994-95, 2001-02 and 2003-04 were the other years the team started 2-0 in OVC play)...TSU was 1-2 over the past two weeks, losing to the SEC's Auburn on Dec. 19 before rebounding to top Ball State for the second straight year (this time by a 67-60 margin)...Last time out the Tigers fell 81-69 at Siena...Junior **Ladarious Weaver** averaged 15.0 points and 2.3 assists over the last three games, including hitting seven 3-pointers in that stretch; Weaver had 21 points in the win over Ball State...Senior **Larry Turner** had a double-double, his second of the season, by registering 16 points and 10 rebounds in the loss at Siena...Tennessee State will play four of its first six games in 2007 at home, beginning on Thursday when they host Murray State; the week, however, begins with a road trip to Morehead on Tuesday, and it ends on Saturday at UT Martin.

2006-07 Predicted Order of Finish: The race for the 2006-07 Ohio Valley Conference men's basketball crown appears to be wide open, according to a preseason poll of OVC head basketball coaches and sports information directors. **Samford**, the 2006 OVC tournament runner-up, received nine first-place votes and 177 points to claim the top spot in the poll, edging out **Tennessee State**, who earned six first-place votes and 169 points to follow in second. **Tennessee Tech** was a close third with four first-place votes and 165 points, while defending OVC champion **Murray State** was selected fourth, claiming the remaining three first-place votes and 144 points. **Southeast Missouri** earned a fifth-place preseason selection with 134 points, followed by **Austin Peay** in sixth with 110 points. Rounding out the number seven through 11 spots in the poll were **Jacksonville State** (103 points), **Eastern Kentucky** (71 points), **Eastern Illinois** (56 points), **UT Martin** (53 points) and **Morehead State** (28 points).

Murray State's Witherspoon Headlines Preseason All-OVC Squad: According to preseason voting by the league's coaches and sports information directors, Murray State senior **Shawn Witherspoon** is the player to watch in 2006-07, selecting the 6-foot-5 forward as the OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Joining Witherspoon on the preseason All-OVC first team are Tennessee State senior forward **Clarence Matthews**; Jacksonville State senior forward **Courtney Bradley**; Samford senior guard **Randall Gulina**; and Tennessee Tech junior guard **Anthony Fisher**. Witherspoon earned first team All-OVC honors in 2005-06 after averaging a team-high 10.6 points per game while boasting a league-high 2.38 assist-to-turnover ratio and ranking second in the Conference in rebounding (7.7 rpg) and sixth in steals (1.68 spg). Matthews was a second team All-OVC selection a year ago, shooting a league-best 54.5 percent from the field and pulling down a Conference-high 8.5 rebounds per game while contributing a 13.7 scoring average and 47 blocked shots. Bradley led his team in scoring (15.3 ppg) and rebounding (7.6 rpg), ranking sixth in the league in both categories. Gulina dished out 55 assists last season and was second on his team in scoring (12.6 ppg), while Fisher averaged a team-high 12.9 points a game to go with 64 assists in 2005-06. Selected to the 2006-07 preseason All-OVC second team were Tennessee Tech senior guard **Belton Rivers**; Morehead State senior guard **Shaun Williams**; Samford junior center **Travis Peterson**; Eastern Illinois sophomore guard **Mike Robinson**; and Jacksonville State junior forward **Dorien Brown**.

Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin) will host games while Austin Peay, Murray State, Eastern Illinois, Eastern Kentucky and Jacksonville State will play road contests. As part of the agreement, home teams will play a return game at the home facility of their BracketBusters series opponent in November or December of the following season.

BracketBusters Rematches: As part of the ESPN BracketBusters event, teams pay a return visit to the teams they hosted a year ago and vice versa. Last year the OVC was 5-6 in BracketBuster games and were 5-6 in the return matchups in 2006-07. Four of those five wins helped OVC teams avenge losses from a season ago, as Eastern Kentucky (UNC Asheville), Samford (Ohio), Southeast Missouri (UC Riverside) and Tennessee Tech (Bradley) all topped teams that had defeated them last February. Tennessee State topped Ball State for the second straight year this December.

Early Conference Openers: Murray State and Eastern Illinois opened the conference season on Nov. 25 with the earliest OVC Conference matchup in league history. The teams were the first squads to play a conference game nationally as well. The game was pushed up due to both schools competing in the BracketBusters event later this year; the Nov. 25 date was the only other date that worked for the teams. Murray State topped EIU 53-50.

Nationally-Ranked Opponents: OVC schools have competed against eight nationally-ranked teams so far this season. Samford has played the toughest schedule, battling No. 1 Florida, No. 15 Arizona and No. 17 LSU this year. Eastern Kentucky has played at No. 4 Ohio State, Tennessee State played at No. 12 Kansas and No. 6 Alabama, Austin Peay battled No. 19 Memphis and Tennessee Tech played at No. 21 Tennessee.

Weaver Named to Las Vegas Invitational All-Tournament Team: Tennessee State junior **Ladarious Weaver** was named to the All-Tournament team at the Las Vegas Invitational after four quality games including a 13-point performance in the team's final game against Towson. Tennessee State finished the event 2-2 with losses to Western Kentucky and No. 12 Kansas and wins over Prairie View A&M and Towson.

Rivers Named to San Juan Shootout All-Tournament Team: Tennessee Tech guard **Belton Rivers** was named to the All-Tournament team at the San Juan Shootout after averaging 19 points per game in contests against Northwestern, Vanderbilt and Central Florida. He had 22 points including the game-winner against Northwestern to open the tournament.

Gulina Earns All-Tournament Honors at Hispanic College Funds Classic: Samford's **Randall Gulina** was named to the All-Tournament Team at the Hispanic College Funds Classic hosted by LSU Dec. 27-29. Gulina averaged 15.3 points per game at the event including a game-high 26 points in the Bulldogs overtime victory over Mississippi Valley State and 14 points against No. 17 LSU.

Samford Puts An End to Murray State's Home Court Winning Streak: When Samford defeated Murray State 55-44 on Dec. 21, it marked the end of the Racers 15-game home court winning streak, a mark that was tied for the 11th longest nationally. The Bulldogs became the first team to win at the Regional Special Events Center since Dec. 2005. It also snapped a streak of 14 straight OVC victories at the RSEC.

It Doesn't Get Much Closer: Early in the Conference season, competition in the Ohio Valley Conference has been close. Through 21 Conference games, the average margin of victory has been 5.2 points and just 3.2 points per game when you factor out the four contests won by 10 or more points. In total, there have been five 1-point games and 14 games decided by five points or less.

Morehead Exceeds Win Total From 2006 After Only Nine Games: After only nine games this season first-year head coach **Donnie Tyndall** led his alma mater Morehead State to more wins than it had the entire 2005-06 season (4). The fifth win came on Dec. 18 at UT Martin (56-55). Morehead won five of its first nine games and now has seven wins overall on the season.

Samford's Tillette Named Coach of the Week by CollegeInsider.com: Samford head coach **Jimmy Tillette** was named the nation's mid-major Coach of the Week on Dec. 27 by CollegeInsider.com. The award came after his team had won four games in a row including opening up the Conference season 3-0.

Buzzer Beaters: OVC schools have had their fare share of exciting finishes this season with several buzzer beaters factoring into the final outcome of games. One of the most dramatic came on Dec. 2 when Eastern Illinois' **Mike Robinson** hit a 3-pointer from just inside of half court to top Arkansas State 73-70 in Charleston; that game was a re-match of the BracketBusters matchup between the squads a year ago.
