THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

BELTON RIVERS • G, Sr., 6'4, 195 • ATLANTA, GA. • TENNESSEE TECH

Rivers led Tennessee Tech to two OVC wins last week, averaging 21.5 points, 2.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game while hitting 54.2 percent (13-of-24) from the field, 64.3 percent (9-of-14) from 3-point range and 88.9 percent (8-of-9) from the charity stripe. Against Jacksonville State, Rivers scored 18 points on 4-of-8 3-pointers and added four assists. In the victory over league co-leader Samford, Rivers drained 5-for-6 from long range and 6-for-6 at the free throw line to score a game-high 25 points. He also had three rebounds, two assists, two steals and a blocked shot. Rivers was also named Player of the Week on Dec. 11 of this season.

BRANDON FOUST • F, JR., 6'6, 215 • COLUMBIS, OHIO • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Foust averaged a double-double with 19 points and 10.5 rebounds per game in contests against Murray State and Austin Peay last week. He also averaged 1.0 assists and 1.5 steals per game and hit 53.5 percent (15-of-28) from the field. Foust had 23 points and nine rebounds in a win a Murray State and 15 points and 12 rebounds in a one-point loss at APSU. He also had a pair of blocks on the week.

FRESHMAN

ADAM LEONARD • G, FR., 6'0, 185 • LEE'S SUMMITT, MO. • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Leonard averaged 16.0 points, 2.5 rebounds, 2.0 assists and 1.5 steals per game last week while hitting 56.3 percent (9-of-16) from the field, 57.1 percent (8-of-14) from 3-point range and was perfect from the foul line (6-of-6). He tallied a career-high 22 points against Eastern Illinois when he equaled a personal best with six 3-pointers. Leonard added 10 points on 75 percent shooting against Morehead State. For the week he averaged 35.5 minutes per game as ECU was 2-0.

TEAM NOTES

AUSTIN PEAY (9-6 overall; 6-1 OVC): Head Coach **Dave Loos** became the winningest coach in Austin Peay history on Saturday night, as the Govs topped Southeast Missouri 68-67 in their lone contest of the week...Loos' 259 wins surpassed the 258 victories by Dave Aaron; Loos is now third all-time in OVC history in wins, trailing only Cal Luther's 319 and E.A. Diddle's 296 wins, while his 17 years coaching in the OVC is second behind only Luther (23 years)...With the victory, the Govs now find themselves in sole possession of first place in the Conference...Austin Peay has now won six in a row, the team's longest winning streak since winning 14 straight in the 2003-04 season...The Govs are 7-0 this season when holding their opponents below 70 points...Through seven OVC games so far this season, APSU is shooting 44.8 percent from 3-point range while holding its opponents to only 28.3 percent from behind the arc...Junior guard **Todd Babington** has led the Governors in scoring in three of the last four games, including 17 points in the win over SEMO; he has connected on 21 of his last 35 3-points and is third overall in the OVC in 3-point percentage (43.8%) in all games and third in Conference-only games (53.8%) as well...Junior forward **Fernandez Lockett** has scored in double figures in eight straight games while sophomore **Drake Reed** has seven straight double-figure scoring games...The Govs start the week by hosting rival Murray State Tuesday night in a game that will be seen nationally on ESPNU (6 p.m.)...On Thursday night they take to the road to play UT Martin (7:30 p.m.)...APSU is 6-1 at home this season.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (5-14 overall; 1-9 OVC): Eastern Illinois played two more league games last week, bringing its early season total to 10, the most of any Division I team in the country so far this season...Last week the Panthers played well at Eastern Kentucky, but dropped a 63-62 decision when ECU's Julian Mascoll scored on a lay-up with 5.2 seconds remaining...The week began with a 67-43 defeat at UT Martin...EIU has lost six games in a row overall and eight OVC games in a row overall entering this week...Freshman **Romain Martin**, the team's leading scorer and four-time OVC Freshman of the Week this year, was held to just 15 combined points last week (output of six and nine points) as team's keyed on the scoring threat; Martin is eighth in the OVC in scoring (14.5 points/game) but ranks third overall in Conference-only games (17.6 points/game)...As a team, EIU is 10th in the league in scoring (60.3)...The team will finally get a chance to play some more home games this week by hosting Tennessee Tech (Thursday) and Tennessee State (Saturday)...EIU topped Tech 74-69 on Dec. 7 of this season and lost narrowly 59-56 to Tennessee State on Dec. 9...Eastern Illinois is 4-4 at Lantz Arena this year.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (10-6 overall; 5-3 OVC): After dropping two games the previous week Eastern Kentucky rebounded with two wins this past week, winning at home against Morehead State (73-65 in a game that was on ESPNU) and Eastern Illinois (63-62)...Senior **Julian Mascoll** came up big in the last-second win over Eastern Illinois, as Mascoll hit a driving, left-handed lay-up with just 5.2 seconds left to give his team the victory; for the week Mascoll averaged 14 points, 7.5 assists, 2.5 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game and had a career-high eight assists against EIU...Mascoll added seven assists and 17 points in the televised win over rival Morehead State...Freshman **Adam Leonard** continued his hot shooting on the season, averaging 16 points per game and hitting 8-of-14 (57.1%) from 3-point range on his way to OVC Freshman of the Week honors; Leonard had a career-high 22 points against Eastern Illinois when he equaled his personal-best of six made 3-pointers (also done against Kentucky)...Sophomore **Mike Rose** notched his fifth 20-point performance of the season against Morehead State, scoring 23 points in the win over the Eagles; ECU is 5-0 this season when Rose hits the 20-point plateau...Eastern committed a season-low five turnovers against Eastern Illinois and have now won six in a row over EIU...After missing 17 free throws in a loss to Tennessee Tech two weeks ago, ECU rebounded by making its final 10 charity shots in a tight finish with Morehead State, while going 17-of-19 (89.5%) in the second half of that contest...Eastern ranks first in the OVC in field goal percentage (46.0%) and first in 3-pointers made (8.19/game)...ECU will hit the road this week for a pair of games in the state of Alabama...The Colonels play at Jacksonville State on Thursday; JSU eliminated the Colonels from the OVC Tournament a season ago...On Saturday ECU squares off with Samford.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (3-14 overall; 1-7 OVC): Jacksonville State dropped a pair of OVC games last week, falling 75-71 at Tennessee Tech and 83-74 at Tennessee State...JSU has lost eight games in a row overall and five straight in the OVC...The losses dropped the Gamecocks to 1-7 in the league, despite the fact JSU has lost those seven games by an average of 4.8 points per game; five of their seven losses have been by fewer than five points and three have been one-point decisions...Senior **Courtney Bradley** ranks sixth in the OVC in scoring (15.0 points/game) and fifth in rebounding (7.6/game)...**Harold Crow** has found the touch from the floor and now leads the OVC in field goal percentage (58.9%) while **Dorien Brown** tops the Conference in blocked shots (1.56/game)...**DeAndre Bray** also continues to lead the Conference in assists (5.12/game) while **Will Ginn** ranks fourth (4.24/game)...Jacksonville State will host Eastern Kentucky (Thursday) and Morehead State (Saturday) this week.

MOREHEAD STATE (10-6 overall; 6-2 OVC): Morehead State split a pair of games last week and now finds itself tied for second in the Conference with Samford...The six OVC wins this season doubles the team's output from last season (3)...Morehead has won five of its last six OVC games overall...The Eagles lost to rival Eastern Kentucky 73-65 on a game televised on ESPNU before coming home to top UT Martin 70-48...Junior newcomer **Brandon Callahan** averaged 11 points per game and hit 7-of-9 (77.8%) from the field for the week, including scoring a career-high 22 points in the win over UT Martin...Freshman **Maze Stallworth** scored 14 points off the bench at ECU and averaged 11 points for the week...Senior **Shaun Williams** hit 10 of his 11 field goal attempts on the week...Morehead State shot 58.8 percent from the field in the pair of games last week and 45.9 percent (17-of-37) from 3-point range...The MSU offense was very unselfish on Saturday against UT Martin, as they were credited with 23 assists on 26 made baskets (UTM was credited with 10 assists on 11 made baskets for the game)...Morehead State ranks first in the OVC in scoring margin, rebounding margin and turnover margin...Morehead State will travel to Samford (Thursday) and Jacksonville State (Saturday) for games this week.

MURRAY STATE (7-9 overall; 5-3 OVC): Murray State played only once last week, falling to Southeast Missouri 96-85 last Monday...In that contest, former coach Scott Edgar, now the head coach at Southeast Missouri, returned to Murray to lead his Redhawks to a victory over his former team; Edgar had a 78-40 overall record, won three OVC regular season titles and led MSU to

two NCAA Tournaments in his tenure in Murray... The game with Southeast Missouri featured a league-high 59 fouls and 90 free throw attempts, the highest totals in the league in nearly five years... This week the Racers return to action by playing rival Austin Peay (Tuesday) in a game featured on ESPNU... Murray leads the all-time series with the Gobs by a 67-35 margin but APSU holds a 24-22 advantage in games played in Clarksville; MSU had lost four straight in the Dunn Center until winning there in overtime last season... Sophomore Tyler **Holloway**, last week's OVC Player of the Week, is hitting 92 percent (46-of-50) from the free throw line this season, a mark that leads the OVC and ranks seventh nationally entering the week (updated NCAA statistics will not be released until Tuesday of this week)... Holloway was 14-of-15 from the line against Southeast Missouri... Senior **Shawn Witherspoon**, the league's preseason Player of the Year who has battled injuries this season, is 99 points away from joining MSU's 1,000-Point Club... Following Murray State's tilt with Austin Peay, the Racers will host UT Martin on Saturday night.

SAMFORD (9-8 overall; 6-2 OVC): Samford entered last week as the only undefeated team in the OVC and was atop of the league standings; the Bulldogs, however, dropped both contests last week and are now 6-2 in the league and in a tie for second place (with Morehead State)... Samford lost 59-41 at Tennessee State last Thursday to suffer its first loss of the OVC season and followed that up with a 73-59 loss at Tennessee Tech on Sunday... Despite being near the top of the league in the standings and having the No. 2 scorer (**Randall Gulina**) in the Conference, Samford ranks last in the OVC in team offense (59.4 points/game)... In their losses last week, Samford shot only 39.3 percent from the floor and 29.5 percent from 3-point range... The Bulldogs opened OVC play this season with a 6-1 mark, the third straight season they have accomplished that feat... Samford returns to the friendly confines of Seibert Hall this week, hosting Morehead State (Thursday) and Eastern Kentucky (Saturday); Samford has now won seven straight games at home dating back to last season... Samford has announced a "Sell Out Seibert" promotion for the team's key home game with Murray State on Jan. 29 -- the 2006-07 season marks the final year in the 45-year old building and the athletic department wants to break the building attendance record of 4,240 (set on Feb. 1, 2001 vs. Georgia State) by having 4,500 fans in the seats for the game; former Bulldog coaches and players will be honored at halftime of the game.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (6-12 overall; 4-5 OVC): Southeast Missouri split a pair of games last week, knocking off rival Murray State last Monday, 96-85, in Head Coach Scott Edgar's return to Murray; Edgar had previously been the head coach at Murray and led the Racers to three OVC titles... The week concluded with a one-point loss at Austin Peay (68-67)... In that game the team was without senior **Terrick Willoughby**, who is suffering from mono, and junior **Michael Rembert**, who served a one-game suspension for being ejected from the Murray State contest... Junior newcomer **Brandon Foust** stepped up big for the Redhawks last week and earned OVC Newcomer of the Week honors for his work; Foust averaged 19 points and 10.5 rebounds per game, including scoring 23 points at Murray State and netting 15 points and 12 rebounds against Austin Peay... Foust hit 53.5 percent (15-of-28) of his shots last week; he is currently 18th in the OVC in scoring (12.0/game)... Freshman Marcus Rhodes, who is first in the OVC in Conference-only games in 3-point percentage (10-of-18 - 55.6%) averaged 10.5 points per game last week, hitting 3-of-5 from long range... Southeast Missouri will host Tennessee State (Thursday) and Tennessee Tech (Saturday) at the Show Me Center this week.

TENNESSEE STATE (7-9 overall; 4-3 OVC): Tennessee State snapped a four-game losing streak last week with a pair of victories, including handing previously undefeated Samford its first Conference loss of the season (59-41 on Jan. 11); TSU also topped Jacksonville State last week to improve to 4-3 in the league, which put them in sixth place overall... Junior point guard **Reiley Ervin** was instrumental in his team's performance last week, averaging 18.5 points, 5.0 assists and 4.5 rebounds per game; Ervin had a career-high 29 points in the win over Jacksonville State, hitting 15-of-16 (93.8%) from the free throw line as he finished the week 19-of-20 (95%) from the charity stripe... Junior **Ladarious Weaver** averaged 14.5 points and 2.5 rebounds per game last week while hitting 50 percent from the field (9-of-18) and 3-point range (6-of-12)... TSU is 5-1 at the Gentry Center this season but 0-8 in true road games... They open the week with a non-conference game against intra-city rival Fisk before beginning a two-game road with games at Southeast Missouri (Thursday) and Eastern Illinois (Saturday).

TENNESSEE TECH (8-9 overall; 4-4 OVC): The Golden Eagles won a pair of games last week to improve to .500 in the Conference and nearly .500 overall on the season... The wins came at home against Jacksonville State (75-71) and Samford (73-59), who had entered the week No. 1 atop the Conference standings... Senior guard **Belton Rivers** was named OVC Player of the Week for the second time this season after averaging 21.5 points, 3.0 assists, 2.5 rebounds and 1.0 steals per game and hitting 54.2 percent (13-of-24) from the field, 64.3 percent (9-of-14) from 3-point range and 88.9 percent (8-of-9) from the free throw line; Rivers scored 25 against Samford, draining 5-of-6 from 3-point range after registering 18 against JSU... Rivers now leads the OVC in scoring (18.9 points/game)... Teammate **Anthony Fisher**, who averaged 18.5 points per game last week, ranks second in the OVC in scoring (17.8) but is first in Conference-only games (19.6/game)... Junior **Amadi McKenzie** moved up to second in the OVC in rebounding (7.9/game) after averaging eight caroms per contest last week... Tennessee Tech will play at Eastern Illinois (Thursday) and Southeast Missouri (Saturday) this week.

UT MARTIN (5-14 overall; 3-6 OVC): The Skyhawks ran their OVC winning streak to two games to start last week, topping Eastern Illinois 67-43 before seeing the streak come to an end with a 70-48 loss at Morehead State... The last time UTM had held an opponent to 43 points or less in a game was 16 years ago during the 1990-91 season when they topped St. Louis Christian 113-37... Newcomer **Gerald Robinson** averaged 11.5 points, 7.5 rebounds and 1.0 assists per game last week while hitting 43.8 percent (7-of-16) from the field; Robinson came off the bench to score 15 in the win over EIU... Senior **Cleve Woodfork** currently has 934 career points, just 66 away from becoming the 12th player in UT Martin's 1,000-Point Club... The Skyhawks will host Austin Peay on Thursday before traveling to Murray State for a Saturday contest.

2006-07 Predicted Order of Finish: The race for the 2006-07 Ohio Valley Conference men's basketball crown appears to be wide open, according to a preseason poll of OVC head basketball coaches and sports information directors. **Samford**, the 2006 OVC tournament runner-up, received nine first-place votes and 177 points to claim the top spot in the poll, edging out **Tennessee State**, who earned six first-place votes and 169 points to follow in second. **Tennessee Tech** was a close third with four first-place votes and 165 points, while defending OVC champion **Murray State** was selected fourth, claiming the remaining three first-place votes and 144 points. **Southeast Missouri** earned a fifth-place preseason selection with 134 points, followed by **Austin Peay** in sixth with 110 points. Rounding out the number seven through 11 spots in the poll were **Jacksonville State** (103 points), **Eastern Kentucky** (71 points), **Eastern Illinois** (56 points), **UT Martin** (53 points) and **Morehead State** (28 points).

Murray State's Witherspoon Headlines Preseason All-OVC Squad: According to pre-season voting by the league's coaches and sports information directors, Murray State senior **Shawn Witherspoon** is the player to watch in 2006-07, selecting the 6-foot-5 forward as the OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Joining Witherspoon on the preseason All-OVC first team are Tennessee State senior forward **Clarence Matthews**; Jacksonville State senior forward **Courtney Bradley**; Samford senior guard **Randall Gulina**; and Tennessee Tech junior guard **Anthony Fisher**. Witherspoon earned first team All-OVC honors in 2005-06 after averaging a team-high 10.6 points per game while boasting a league-high 2.38 assist-to-turnover ratio and ranking second in the Conference in rebounding (7.7 rpg) and sixth in steals (1.68 spg). Matthews was a second team All-OVC selection a year ago, shooting a league-best 54.5 percent from the field and pulling down a Conference-high 8.5 rebounds per game while contributing a 13.7 scoring average and 47 blocked shots. Bradley led his team in scoring (15.3 ppg) and rebounding (7.6 rpg), ranking sixth in the league in both categories. Gulina dished out 55 assists last season and was second on his team in scoring (12.6 ppg), while Fisher averaged a team-high 12.9 points a game to go with 64 assists in 2005-06. Selected to the 2006-07 preseason All-OVC second team were Tennessee Tech senior guard **Belton Rivers**; Morehead State senior guard **Shaun Williams**; Samford junior center **Travis Peterson**; Eastern Illinois sophomore guard **Mike Robinson**; and Jacksonville State junior forward **Dorien Brown**.

Murray State, Eastern Illinois, Eastern Kentucky and Jacksonville State will play road contests. As part of the agreement, home teams will play a return game at the home facility of their BracketBusters series opponent in November or December of the following season.

BracketBusters Rematches: As part of the ESPN BracketBusters event, teams pay a return visit to the teams they hosted a year ago and vice versa. Last year the OVC was 5-6 in BracketBuster games and were 5-6 in the return matchups in 2006-07. Four of those five wins helped OVC teams avenge losses from a season ago, as Eastern Kentucky (UNC Asheville), Samford (Ohio), Southeast Missouri (UC Riverside) and Tennessee Tech (Bradley) all topped teams that had defeated them last February. Tennessee State topped Ball State for the second straight year this December.

Early Conference Openers: Murray State and Eastern Illinois opened the conference season on Nov. 25 with the earliest OVC Conference matchup in league history. The teams were the first squads to play a conference game nationally as well. The game was pushed up due to both schools competing in the BracketBusters event later this year; the Nov. 25 date was the only other date that worked for the teams. Murray State topped EIU 53-50.

Nationally-Ranked Opponents: OVC schools have competed against eight nationally-ranked teams so far this season. Samford has played the toughest schedule, battling No. 1 Florida, No. 15 Arizona and No. 17 LSU this year. Eastern Kentucky has played at No. 4 Ohio State, Tennessee State played at No. 12 Kansas and No. 6 Alabama, Austin Peay battled No. 19 Memphis and Tennessee Tech played at No. 21 Tennessee.

Weaver Named to Las Vegas Invitational All-Tournament Team: Tennessee State junior **Ladarious Weaver** was named to the All-Tournament team at the Las Vegas Invitational after four quality games including a 13-point performance in the team's final game against Towson. Tennessee State finished the event 2-2 with losses to Western Kentucky and No. 12 Kansas and wins over Prairie View A&M and Towson.

Rivers Named to San Juan Shootout All-Tournament Team: Tennessee Tech guard **Belton Rivers** was named to the All-Tournament team at the San Juan Shootout after averaging 19 points per game in contests against Northwestern, Vanderbilt and Central Florida. He had 22 points including the game-winner against Northwestern to open the tournament.

Gulina Earns All-Tournament Honors at Hispanic College Funds Classic: Samford's **Randall Gulina** was named to the All-Tournament Team at the Hispanic College Funds Classic hosted by LSU Dec. 27-29. Gulina averaged 15.3 points per game at the event including a game-high 26 points in the Bulldogs overtime victory over Mississippi Valley State and 14 points against No. 17 LSU.

Samford Puts An End to Murray State's Home Court Winning Streak: When Samford defeated Murray State 55-44 on Dec. 21, it marked the end of the Racers 15-game home court winning streak, a mark that was tied for the 11th longest nationally. The Bulldogs became the first team to win at the Regional Special Events Center since Dec. 2005. It also snapped a streak of 14 straight OVC victories at the RSEC.

Samford's Tillette Named Coach of the Week by CollegeInsider.com: Samford head coach **Jimmy Tillette** was named the nation's mid-major Coach of the Week on Dec. 27 by CollegeInsider.com. The award came after his team had won four games in a row including opening up the Conference season 3-0.

Buzzer Beaters: OVC schools have had their fair share of exciting finishes this season with several buzzer beaters factoring into the final outcome of games. One of the most dramatic came on Dec. 2 when Eastern Illinois' **Mike Robinson** hit a 3-pointer from just inside of half court to top Arkansas State 73-70 in Charleston; that game was a re-match of the BracketBusters matchup between the squads a year ago. Sutton Given Contract Extension at Tennessee Tech: Tennessee Tech head basketball coach Mike Sutton was given a contract extension through the 2010-11 season by the school on Dec. 22. Sutton, who is in his fifth year with the program, is the 11th head coach in program history and was named the 2005 OVC Coach of the Year after leading the Golden Eagles to the OVC Championship. Last season Tech was 19-12 and finished third in the Conference during a year Sutton bravely battled Guillain-Barre' Syndrome.

It Doesn't Get Much Closer: Early in the Conference season, competition in the Ohio Valley Conference has been close. Through 45 Conference games, the average margin of victory has been 7.9 points per game. That includes eight 1-point games, 22 games decided by five points or less and four overtime contests. That number has been on the rise slightly as of late, as 13 of the 24 games over the past two weeks have been decided by 10 or more points, after only four of the first 21 OVC games of the season were decided by double digits.

Morehead Exceeds Win Total From 2006 After Only Nine Games: After only nine games this season first-year head coach **Donnie Tyndall** led his alma mater, Morehead State, to more wins than it had the entire 2005-06 season (4). The fifth win came on Dec. 18 at UT Martin (56-55). With a 70-48 win over UT Martin on Jan. 13, Morehead doubled its OVC win total (3) from a season ago. Morehead is now 10-6 overall and 6-2 in the OVC entering this week and has won five of its last six OVC contests.

Loos Becomes Winning Coach in APSU History: Austin Peay head coach Dave Loos became the winningest coach in Austin Peay State University history on Jan. 13 when his team defeated Southeast Missouri 68-67 at home. That gave him 259 wins, one better than Dave Aaron. Loos' career record at APSU is now 259-231 in 17 seasons (and is 241-283 in 22 years overall). He is also among elite company that have coached in the OVC. His 259 victories at APSU (all of which were as a member of the OVC) is third all-time among all coaches who have coached in the OVC. He trails only Cal Luther (319 wins with Murray State and UT Martin) and E.A. Diddle (296 wins at Western Kentucky when the Hilltoppers were members of the OVC; it does not include his wins prior to WKU joining the Conference in 1948). The next highest active OVC coach as far as win totals goes is UT Martin's Bret Campbell (83). Loos' 17 years coaching in the OVC is second all-time, behind only Luther who coached 23 years in the Conference.

The Road Can Be Tough: Playing on the road can be tough, just ask the coaches in the OVC. Last week nine of the 10 games held in the Conference were won by the home team, with only Southeast Missouri's win at Murray State going in the favor of the visitor. Overall, home teams have won 13 of the last 15 entering this week.

Sirius Broadcast Schedule: Two Ohio Valley Conference games can be heard on Sirius satellite radio this month. Those contests are Morehead State at Jacksonville State (Jan. 20) and Tennessee Tech at Tennessee Tech (Jan. 27).

OVC Coaches Teleconferences: All 11 OVC men's basketball head coaches will appear weekly on the OVC Teleconference, began on Monday, Jan. 8. The teleconference will run each Monday through the end of the regular season and begins at approximately 10:05 a.m. **Central** time. Audio of the teleconferences will be available at OVCsports.com at the end of the day on Monday.
