THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

COURTNEY BRADLEY • G, Sr., 6'5, 215 • UTICA, MISS. • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Bradley averaged 23.5 points and 6.5 rebounds per game last week to help lead Jacksonville State to a pair of wins as the Gamecocks snapped an eight-game losing streak. He scored 23 points to lead JSU over Eastern Kentucky on Thursday before turning around and scoring 24 in a win over Morehead State on Saturday. Against ECU he was 8-for-13 from the floor, 4-for-6 from behind the 3-point line and 3-for-3 from the charity stripe while pulling in six rebounds. Against MSU he was 7-for-14 from the floor and 9-for-11 from the free throw line, mostly in the second half to help hold off a late Eagles rally. He also added seven boards against Morehead State. Bradley also won the award on Dec. 18 of this season.

NEWCOMER

BRANDON FOUST • F, JR., 6'6, 215 • COLUMBIS, OHIO • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Foust averaged 17.5 points per game while shooting .667 from the field, .833 from three and .667 from the line in games against Tennessee State and Tennessee Tech. He also added 7 rebounds, 5 assists, 4 steals and 3 blocks. He scored 20 points on 8-of-10 shooting (including 4-of-4 from 3-point range) in the win over TSU. This marks the second straight week that Foust has claimed the Newcomer of the Week honor.

FRESHMAN

MAZE STALLWORTH • G/F, FR., 6'4, 185 • ELIZABETHTOWN, KY. • MOREHEAD ST.

Stallworth led Morehead State in scoring (14.5) and rebounding (5.0) for the week while also hitting 56.3 percent (9-of-16) from the field and 5-of-7 (71.4%) from 3-point range. He scored a career-high 24 points against Jacksonville State, including 11 straight (and 13 of his team's final 15 points) at one point of the second half. This marks the second time this season he has won this award; he also garnered the honor on Nov. 20.

TEAM NOTES

AUSTIN PEAY (11-6 overall; 8-1 OVC): Austin Peay enters the week with an eight-game winning streak that dates back to a loss against Evansville on Dec. 18 and started with a win over Middle Tennessee on Dec. 20; the win streak currently ranks fourth nationally, behind Wisconsin (15), Florida (10) and Texas A&M (9)...The Govs got to that mark by topping rival Murray State 68-59 in an ESPN game last week and then going on the road to defeat UT Martin 75-60...The win over Murray State did not come easy as they trailed by 17 points at one point of the first half but were able to hold the Racers to just 19 second half points on the way to the come-from-behind win...APSU committed just four turnovers in the contest, the second fewest turnovers by the Govs in Head Coach **Dave Loos'** 17-year tenure; the last time they had fewer miscues was three against Tennessee Tech in the semifinals of the 1997 OVC Tournament...APSU is 9-0 this season when holding opponents to 70 points or less...**Fernandez Lockett** and **Drake Reed** each averaged 16.5 points per game in their two contests last week...Lockett has now scored in double figures in 10 straight games while Reed has done so in nine straight affairs...Junior point guard **Derek Wright** scored 17 points and had five steals in the win over UT Martin on Thursday, with 14 of those points and four of those steals coming in the second half...Austin Peay will host a pair of home games this week, starting on Thursday when they play Jacksonville State...The week concludes with a battle for first place in the OVC, as Samford comes to town on Saturday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (5-16 overall; 1-11 OVC): Eastern Illinois dropped a pair of home games last week (against Tennessee Tech and Tennessee State) to fall to 1-11 in the Conference...The Panthers have now lost eight games in a row and 10 OVC contests in a row...Freshman **Ousmane Cisse** averaged 11 points and 11 rebounds per game last week for the Panthers, while hitting 47.1 percent (8-of-17) from the field; Cisse had 13 points and nine rebounds against Tennessee Tech and nine points and 13 rebounds versus Tennessee State...Another top freshman on the team, **Romain Martin**, continues to be the team's leading scorer at 14.9 points per game; that mark currently ranks sixth overall in the OVC...Martin is averaging 17.8 points per game in Conference-only contests, a mark that is third behind Tennessee Tech's backcourt duo of Anthony Fisher and Belton Rivers...EIU does lead the OVC in field goal percentage defense (42.7%) and is second in free throw percentage (69.4%)...The Panthers have been unlucky this season and have seen five of their Conference losses come down to the final possession of the game...Eastern Illinois plays only once this week, at Morehead State on Saturday; Morehead topped the Panthers 71-63 on Dec. 20 in Morehead in the other meeting of the season...After the MSU game, the Panthers will play four of their next five contests at home.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (10-8 overall; 5-5 OVC): After winning a pair of home games two weeks ago, the Colonels dropped a pair of road games last week and now sit at .500 in Conference play, which has them in seventh place overall in the OVC...Last week saw Eastern Kentucky fall 66-56 at Jacksonville State and 55-46 at Samford...Since opening OVC play with two straight road victories (at Eastern Illinois and at UT Martin), the team has dropped four straight road games and have averaged only 55 points per game in those contests (they averaged 64.9 points per game overall on the season)...Senior **Julian Mascoll** currently ranks in the top three in the OVC in field goal percentage (57.0%), assists (4.17/game) and steals (2.11/game)...Sophomore **Mike Rose** averaged 14.5 points per game last week and shot 53.8 percent (7-of-13) from 3-point range...Freshman **Adam Leonard** entered the week as one of the top 3-point shooters in the league (44.2%) but struggled in his pair of games, hitting only 1-of-13 (7.7%) from long range...EKU will play three of its next four games at home, starting this week with Tennessee State on Thursday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (5-14 overall; 3-7 OVC): Jacksonville State snapped an eight-game losing streak with a pair of victories last week, topping Eastern Kentucky (66-56) and Morehead State (67-62) at home to improve to 3-7 in the OVC...The wins were the first back-to-back victories of the season for the team and first overall win since topping Southeast Missouri at the buzzer on Dec. 17...The team has had some tough luck in OVC games this season, losing five games by a combined 10 points...Senior **Courtney Bradley** was named OVC Player of the Week on Monday after averaging 23.5 points and 6.5 rebounds per game last week and hitting 55.6 percent (15-of-27) from the field, 45.5 percent (5-of-11) from 3-point range and 85.7 percent (12-of-14) from the free throw line; he scored 23 points in the win over Eastern Kentucky and 24 against Morehead State...Bradley is currently tied for the league lead in 20-plus point games (7 with Romain Martin of EIU and Belton Rivers of TCU) and is second with six double-digit rebounding games (behind Larry Turner's 7 at TSU)...The Gamecocks play on the road twice this week, battling at Austin Peay on Thursday and at UT Martin on Saturday.

MOREHEAD STATE (10-8 overall; 6-4 OVC): After having won six of its last eight games entering the week, Morehead State suffered a pair of defeats last week, falling at Samford (66-53) and Jacksonville State (67-62) on the road...The back-to-back losses were the first suffered by the Eagles this season, a big difference from last year's squad that lost 23 games overall and had a 15-game losing streak at one point of the season...Morehead State, who ranks 10th in the OVC in free throw percentage (63.0%) entering this week, was sharp at the end of the Jacksonville State game, hitting its final 12 attempts of the game...**Maze Stallworth** was named the OVC Freshman of the Week for his contributions to the team; Stallworth averaged 14.5 points and 5.0 rebounds per game while hitting 56.3 percent (9-of-16) from the field and 71.4 percent (5-of-7) from 3-point range...Stallworth scored a career-high 24 against JSU...Stallworth, Shaun Williams and Vincent Crutcher combined to hit 24-of-40 from the field in the two games last week while the rest of the Eagles team hit just 18-of-60 (30%) from the field...MSU gets to return to the friendly confines of home this week, when it hosts Southeast Missouri and Eastern Illinois...Morehead State is 7-3 at home this season.

MURRAY STATE (8-10 overall; 6-4 OVC): Murray State split a pair of games last week, losing to Austin Peay 68-59 on a game televised nationally on ESPN and coming back home to top UT Martin 78-65...Against APSU, the Racers had a 17-point (40-23) first half lead but scored only 19 points in the second half to suffer a loss to the league first-place team...Senior **Shawn Witherspoon** had a good week, averaging 13 points, 3.0 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game while hitting 50 percent (9-of-18) from the field...Witherspoon, who has been battling injuries all season long, scoring in double figures in back-to-back games for the first time this season (against Division I opponents) with 14 points against Austin Peay and 12 against the Skyhawks; he needs just 73 points to become a member of Murray State's 1,000-Point Club...Freshman **Marvin Williams** averaged 9.5 points and three rebounds per game last week while hitting 77.7

percent (7-of-9) from the floor; he had a career-high 15 points in the win over UTM...**Ed Horton** scored 17 points against the Skyhawks, his highest point total of the season...Sophomore **Tyler Holloway** is hitting 87.3 percent from the free throw line on the season, a mark that is 33rd nationally entering this week...Murray State will play one of its toughest stretches of the season this week, playing at Tennessee Tech and Southeast Missouri this week; the Racers have already suffered a loss to SEMO this season... This week's action is followed by a road trip to second place Samford and a home game with first-place Austin Peay.

SAMFORD (11-8 overall; 8-2 OVC): A week after losing its first two Conference games of the season, Samford rebounded with two home victories, topping Morehead State (66-53) and Eastern Kentucky (55-46)... The wins ran the team's home-court winning streak to nine in a row at Seibert Hall... The Bulldogs have not lost a home game since Feb. 14, 2006... Samford is currently in second place in the Conference and their eight wins equals that of OVC-leader Austin Peay... Junior **Travis Peterson** averaged 18.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and 2.5 steals per week while hitting 62.5 percent (15-of-24) and 3-of-6 (50%) from 3-point range; Peterson had 21 points and eight rebounds against ECU as he played a career-high 40 minutes -- he added 16 points against Morehead State... Senior **Randall Gulina** made school history when he became the 20th player to score 1,000 points in their Samford careers on Saturday; he finished the game with 14 points, reaching the milestone with a pair of free throws with nine seconds remaining... Samford has announced a "Sell Out Seibert" promotion for the team's key home game with Murray State on Jan. 29 - the 2006-07 season marks the final year in the 45-year old building and the athletic department wants to break the building attendance record of 4,240 (set on Feb. 1, 2001 vs. Georgia State) by having 4,500 fans in the seats for the game; former Bulldog coaches and players will be honored at halftime of the game... Samford will travel to UT Martin for a Thursday night contest before traveling to Austin Peay on Saturday in a battle of No. 1 vs. No. 2 in the league.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (7-13 overall; 5-6 OVC): For the second straight week Southeast Missouri split a pair of games, topping Tennessee State (92-78) and falling to Tennessee Tech (87-80) in home contests... Junior **Brandon Foust** was named OVC Newcomer of the Week for the second straight week after averaging 17.5 points and 3.5 rebounds per game and hitting 66.7 percent (14-of-21) from the field and 83.3 percent (5-of-6) from 3-point range... Foust scored 20 points on 8-of-10 shooting (including 4-of-4 from 3-point range) in the win over TSU... As a team, Southeast Missouri ranks 35th nationally in 3-pointers made per game (8.3) and 39th nationally in steals (8.9/game)... the Redhawks also lead the Conference in blocks (3.85/game) and rank second in scoring average (70.5)... Southeast will go on the road to start the week with Morehead State, a matchup on Wednesday night... The week concludes by hosting Murray State on Saturday, a team the Redhawks defeated 96-85 in Murray back on Jan. 8; the Murray matchup involves current SEMO coach **Scott Edgar** once again facing off with the team he formerly coached.

TENNESSEE STATE (9-10 overall; 5-4 OVC): Tennessee State stepped out of conference play to begin last week, topping neighborhood rival Fisk University 85-53 at the Gentry Center... The team returned to Conference play by falling at Southeast Missouri (92-78) on Thursday before topping Eastern Illinois (61-58) in Charleston... The win over the Panthers was the team's first on the road in 10 tries this season and first road victory dating back to Feb. 25 of last season (74-64 at Eastern Kentucky)... The Tigers find themselves one game above .500 in the Conference standings, which currently puts them in sixth place overall... Despite losing to Southeast Missouri, the Tigers had a balanced attack, as five different players scored in double figures... In the win over EIU, junior point guard **Reiley Ervin** scored 19 points to lead TSU... **Clarence Matthews** is now the league leader in rebounding, averaging 8.1 rebounds per game... Junior **Ladarious Weaver** ranks 23rd nationally in 3-pointers made per game (3.2)... TSU travels to Eastern Kentucky on Thursday to begin the week, and concludes the week with a home matchup against Tennessee Tech on Saturday.

TENNESSEE TECH (10-9 overall; 6-4 OVC): The Golden Eagles remained one of the hottest teams in the league this past week, sweeping past Eastern Illinois (76-64) and Southeast Missouri (87-80) in road games... The improved the team's record in road games on the season to 3-6 and marked the squad's first back-to-back road victories of the season and first overall since Jan. 14 and 16th (at Samford and at Austin Peay) of last season... Tennessee Tech has now won four in a row and five of six overall and finds itself in a three-way tie for third place in the Conference... In the win over Southeast Missouri, the Golden Eagles were down by as many as 18 points before storming back to win by seven... Junior **Amadi McKenzie**, who ranks second in the OVC in rebounding (7.8/game) had another big week, averaging 21.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game while hitting 61.5 percent (16-of-26) from the field; at EIU he had 18 of his 22 points in the second half and was 10-of-12 at the free throw line and came back with 18 points on 10-of-14 shooting from the field against Southeast Missouri... **Belton Rivers** (18.6 points/game) and **Anthony Fisher** (18.2 points/game) currently rank No. 1 and No. 2 in the Conference in scoring, one of only two instances of teammates doing so nationally (the other in with VMI in the Big South Conference)... Fisher needs just 23 points to reach the 1,000-Point Club on the season... Tech, who is 6-1 at home this season, begins the week by hosting Murray State on Tuesday night in a game that will be seen nationally on ESPNU; the two teams, who are currently two of the three teams in the three-way tie for third, will close the regular season with each other on Feb. 22 in Murray... The week concludes with a road trip to Tennessee State on Saturday.

UT MARTIN (5-16 overall; 3-8 OVC): After a modest two-game OVC winning streak two weeks ago, the Skyhawks have now lost three in a row following losses to Austin Peay (75-60) and at Murray State (78-65) last week... Senior **McKale Jones** tied his career-highs in both scoring (16) and rebounding (9) in the Murray State contest... Senior **Cleve Woodfork** currently has 958 career points, just 42 away from becoming the 12th player in UT Martin's 1,000-Point Club; he also ranks No. 8 on UTM's career free throw made list (242) and No. 5 on free throws attempted (351)... With the loss to Murray State, the Skyhawks are now just 2-30 all-time against the Racers and have never won in Murray; the teams will end the regular season in Martin on Feb. 24... Against the Racers, UTM committed just 12 turnovers and are 2-2 this year when committing 14 or fewer turnovers in a game... Four UT Martin players averaged double figure points last week, with **Bubba Tolliver** leading the pack (12.5/game); **Gerald Robinson** and Woodfork each added 12 a game and Jones averaged 10 a contest... The Skyhawks play at home this week, hosting Samford on Thursday and Jacksonville State on Saturday.

2006-07 Predicted Order of Finish: The race for the 2006-07 Ohio Valley Conference men's basketball crown appears to be wide open, according to a preseason poll of OVC head basketball coaches and sports information directors. **Samford**, the 2006 OVC tournament runner-up, received nine first-place votes and 177 points to claim the top spot in the poll, edging out **Tennessee State**, who earned six first-place votes and 169 points to follow in second. **Tennessee Tech** was a close third with four first-place votes and 165 points, while defending OVC champion **Murray State** was selected fourth, claiming the remaining three first-place votes and 144 points. **Southeast Missouri** earned a fifth-place preseason selection with 134 points, followed by **Austin Peay** in sixth with 110 points. Rounding out the number seven through 11 spots in the poll were **Jacksonville State** (103 points), **Eastern Kentucky** (71 points), **Eastern Illinois** (56 points), **UT Martin** (53 points) and **Morehead State** (28 points).

Murray State's Witherspoon Headlines Preseason All-OVC Squad: According to pre-season voting by the league's coaches and sports information directors, Murray State senior **Shawn Witherspoon** is the player to watch in 2006-07, selecting the 6-foot-5 forward as the OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Joining Witherspoon on the preseason All-OVC first team are Tennessee State senior forward **Clarence Matthews**; Jacksonville State senior forward **Courtney Bradley**; Samford senior guard **Randall Gulina**; and Tennessee Tech junior guard **Anthony Fisher**. Witherspoon earned first team All-OVC honors in 2005-06 after averaging a team-high 10.6 points per game while boasting a league-high 2.38 assist-to-turnover ratio and ranking second in the Conference in rebounding (7.7 rpg) and sixth in steals (1.68 spg). Matthews was a second team All-OVC selection a year ago, shooting a league-best 54.5 percent from the field and pulling down a Conference-high 8.5 rebounds per game while contributing a 13.7 scoring average and 47 blocked shots. Bradley led his team in scoring (15.3 ppg) and rebounding (7.6 rpg), ranking sixth in the league in both categories. Gulina dished out 55 assists last season and was second on his team in scoring (12.6 ppg), while Fisher averaged a team-high 12.9 points a game to go with 64 assists in 2005-06. Selected to the 2006-07 preseason All-OVC second team were Tennessee Tech senior guard **Belton Rivers**; Morehead State senior guard **Shaun Williams**; Samford junior center **Travis Peterson**; Eastern Illinois sophomore guard **Mike Robinson**; and Jacksonville State junior forward **Dorien Brown**.

BracketBusters Rematches: As part of the ESPN BracketBusters event, teams pay a return visit to the teams they hosted a year ago and vice versa. Last year the OVC was 5-6 in BracketBuster games and were 5-6 in the return matchups in 2006-07. Four of those five wins helped OVC teams avenge losses from a season ago, as Eastern Kentucky (UNC Asheville), Samford (Ohio), Southeast Missouri (UC Riverside) and Tennessee Tech (Bradley) all topped teams that had defeated them last February. Tennessee State topped Ball State for the second straight year this December.

Early Conference Openers: Murray State and Eastern Illinois opened the conference season on Nov. 25 with the earliest OVC Conference matchup in league history. The teams were the first squads to play a conference game nationally as well. The game was pushed up due to both schools competing in the BracketBusters event later this year; the Nov. 25 date was the only other date that worked for the teams. Murray State topped EIU 53-50.

Nationally-Ranked Opponents: OVC schools have competed against eight nationally-ranked teams so far this season. Samford has played the toughest schedule, battling No. 1 Florida, No. 15 Arizona and No. 17 LSU this year. Eastern Kentucky has played at No. 4 Ohio State, Tennessee State played at No. 12 Kansas and No. 6 Alabama, Austin Peay battled No. 19 Memphis and Tennessee Tech played at No. 21 Tennessee.

Weaver Named to Las Vegas Invitational All-Tournament Team: Tennessee State junior **Ladarious Weaver** was named to the All-Tournament team at the Las Vegas Invitational after four quality games including a 13-point performance in the team's final game against Towson. Tennessee State finished the event 2-2 with losses to Western Kentucky and No. 12 Kansas and wins over Prairie View A&M and Towson.

Rivers Named to San Juan Shootout All-Tournament Team: Tennessee Tech guard **Belton Rivers** was named to the All-Tournament team at the San Juan Shootout after averaging 19 points per game in contests against Northwestern, Vanderbilt and Central Florida. He had 22 points including the game-winner against Northwestern to open the tournament.

Gulina Earns All-Tournament Honors at Hispanic College Funds Classic: Samford's **Randall Gulina** was named to the All-Tournament Team at the Hispanic College Funds Classic hosted by LSU Dec. 27-29. Gulina averaged 15.3 points per game at the event including a game-high 26 points in the Bulldogs overtime victory over Mississippi Valley State and 14 points against No. 17 LSU.

Samford Puts An End to Murray State's Home Court Winning Streak: When Samford defeated Murray State 55-44 on Dec. 21, it marked the end of the Racers 15-game home court winning streak, a mark that was tied for the 11th longest nationally. The Bulldogs became the first team to win at the Regional Special Events Center since Dec. 2005. It also snapped a streak of 14 straight OVC victories at the RSEC.

Samford's Tillette Named Coach of the Week by CollegeInsider.com: Samford head coach **Jimmy Tillette** was named the nation's mid-major Coach of the Week on Dec. 27 by CollegeInsider.com. The award came after his team had won four games in a row including opening up the Conference season 3-0.

Buzzer Beaters: OVC schools have had their fair share of exciting finishes this season with several buzzer beaters factoring into the final outcome of games. One of the most dramatic came on Dec. 2 when Eastern Illinois' **Mike Robinson** hit a 3-pointer from just inside of half court to top Arkansas State 73-70 in Charleston; that game was a re-match of the BracketBusters matchup between the squads a year ago. Other notable late game-winning shots include:

- Dec. 7 **Joe Ross Merritt (Samford)** - 3-Pointer with 3.5 seconds left to top Jacksonville State 54-53
- Dec. 9 **Cleve Woodfork (UT Martin)** - Baseline jumper with 0.6 seconds left to top Jacksonville State 70-69
- Dec. 9 **Derek Wright (Austin Peay)** - Hit 3-pointer with 4.8 seconds left to give APSU a 59-57 victory at Eastern Kentucky

Dec. 19 **Jerry Smith (Samford)** - Went length of the floor and made a lay-up with 2.7 seconds left to lift Samford to a 65-64 victory at Southeast Missouri

Dec. 19 **Kevin Thomas (Murray State)** - Made a free throw with 6.0 seconds left to lead Murray State to a 72-71 overtime victory over Jacksonville State

Jan. 2 **Nik Stojakovic (Morehead State)** - Credited with a basket on a goaltending call with 0.5 seconds left as Morehead topped Tennessee State 62-60

Jan. 4 **Ray George (Murray State)** - Hit a 3-pointer with 4.0 seconds left in regulation to cap a 19-point Murray State comeback, tie the game at 70 and force overtime. The Racers eventually won 86-83 in the extra period.

Jan. 6 **Curtis West (Samford)** - Hit two 3-pointers in the final nine seconds, including the game-winner with 1.0 second left to push Bulldogs to their second 1-pointer, buzzer-beating victory of the season over Jacksonville State

Jan. 13 **Julian Mascoll (Eastern Kentucky)** - Hit a driving, left-handed lay-up with 5.2 seconds left to give ECU a 63-62 win over Eastern Illinois

Sutton Given Contract Extension at Tennessee Tech: Tennessee Tech head basketball coach Mike Sutton was given a contract extension through the 2010-11 season by the school on Dec. 22. Sutton, who is in his fifth year with the program, is the 11th head coach in program history and was named the 2005 OVC Coach of the Year after leading the Golden Eagles to the OVC Championship. Last season Tech was 19-12 and finished third in the Conference during a year Sutton bravely battled Guillain-Barre' Syndrome.

It Doesn't Get Much Closer: Halfway through the Conference season, competition in the Ohio Valley Conference has been close. Through 56 Conference games, the average margin of victory has been 10.3 points per game. That includes eight 1-point games, 23 games decided by five points or less and four overtime contests. That number has been on the rise slightly as of late, as 20 of the 35 games over the past three weeks have been decided by 10 or more points, after only four of the first 21 OVC games of the season were decided by double-digits.

Morehead Exceeds Win Total From 2006 After Only Nine Games: After only nine games this season first-year head coach **Donnie Tyndall** led his alma mater, Morehead State, to more wins than it had the entire 2005-06 season (4). The fifth win came on Dec. 18 at UT Martin (56-55). With a 70-48 win over UT Martin on Jan. 13, Morehead doubled its OVC win total (3) from a season ago. Morehead is now 10-8 overall and 6-4 in the OVC entering this week and has won five of its last eight OVC contests.

Loos Becomes Winning Coach in APSU History: Austin Peay head coach **Dave Loos** became the winningest coach in Austin Peay State University history on Jan. 13 when his team defeated Southeast Missouri 68-67 at home. That gave him 259 wins, one better than Dave Aaron. Loos' career record at APSU is now 261-231 in 17 seasons (and is 343-283 in 22 years overall). He is also among elite company that have coached in the OVC. His 261 victories at APSU (all of which were as a member of the OVC) is third all-time among all coaches who have coached in the OVC. He trails only Cal Luther (319 wins with Murray State and UT Martin) and E.A. Diddle (296 wins at Western Kentucky when the Hilltoppers were members of the OVC; it does not include his wins prior to WKU joining the Conference in 1948). The next highest active OVC coach as far as win totals goes is UT Martin's Bret Campbell (83). Loos' 17 years coaching in the OVC is second all-time, behind only Luther who coached 23 years in the Conference.

Rivers and Fisher Rank No. 1 & 2 in OVC in Scoring: Entering this week the Tennessee Tech backcourt duo of Belton Rivers (18.6 ppg) and Anthony Fisher (18.2 ppg) currently rank No. 1 and No. 2 in the OVC in scoring. They are one of only two duos in the country (VMI of the Big South Conference is the other school) to rank No. 1 and No. 2 scoring in a Conference in the country.

Austin Peay's Win Streak Ranks Fourth Nationally: Entering this week Austin Peay's eight game winning streak (which started on Dec. 20) ranks fourth nationally. It trails only (1) Wisconsin - 15, (2) Florida - 10 and (3) Texas A&M - 9 and is currently tied with Texas A&M-Corpus Christi. Five schools currently have seven-game winning streak nationally and rank right behind Austin Peay. The Govs return to the court on Jan. 25 against Jacksonville State.
