THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

ANTHONY FISHER • G, Jr., 6'2, 185 • ALPHARETTA, GA. • TENNESSEE TECH

Fisher led the Golden Eagles to a pair of victories by averaging 16.0 points, 6.5 rebounds and 5.5 assists/game. He led Tech to a defensive win over Murray State by posting 12 points and leading the team with eight rebounds and six assists. He was 5-for-5 at the free throw line and committed just two turnovers while playing 39 minutes. In the come-from-behind win on the road at Tennessee State, Fisher scored 20 points and had five rebounds and five assists, played 39 minutes and made just three turnovers. He was 9-for-10 at the free throw line; for the week he was 14-of-15 (93.3%) at the charity stripe. He wins the award for the second time this season (Dec. 4) and it marks the fourth time this year a TTU player has garnered the honor.

NEWCOMER

MICHAEL REMBERT • C, JR., 6'9, 250 • CHICAGO, ILL. • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Rembert averaged 13.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game last week while shooting 50 percent (9-of-18) from the field in two games. Against Morehead State, he had the game-winning putback with 1.4 seconds remaining to lift the Redhawks to a 61-59 victory, a contest where he had 18 points and seven rebounds. He had eight points and six rebounds in a loss to Murray State. This marks the second time this season (Dec. 18) that he has won the award and the third consecutive week a Southeast Missouri player has earned the honor (Brandon Foust won the past two weeks).

CO-FRESHMAN

WES CHANNELS • G, FR., 6'3, 205 • MEMPHIS, TENN. • AUSTIN PEAY

Channels came off bench to score 12 points against Jacksonville State on 4-of-8 shooting, including a trio of 3-pointers. He also had five rebounds, an assist and a steal against the Gamecocks. Channels had five points off bench against Samford on 2-of-4 shooting, including another 3-pointer. For the week he averaged 8.5 points and 2.5 rebounds while shooting 50 percent (6-of-12) from the field and 4-of-7 (57.1%) from 3-point range.

CO-FRESHMAN

OUSMANE CISSE • C, FR., 6'8, 250 • ABIDJAN, IVORY COAST • EASTERN ILLINOIS

In his lone contest last week, Cisse scored 10 points and pulled six rebounds to go along with one blocked shot in EIU's 65-62 win at Morehead State. Cisse was a perfect 3-for-3 from the field and 4-for-5 from the line.

TEAM NOTES

AUSTIN PEAY (13-6 overall; 10-1 OVC): Austin Peay enters the week with a 10-game winning streak, the third longest streak in the country, trailing only Wisconsin (17) and Florida (12)... The Governors have not lost since dropping a 80-75 decision to Evansville on Dec. 18; the streak is the team's longest since the 2003-04 season when the squad won 14 in a row on the way to the OVC Regular Season Championship... Austin Peay is 11-0 this season when holding opponents to less than 70 points... In 11 OVC contests, the Govs have made 59 more free throws than their opponents... Since committing 22 turnovers against Southeast Missouri on Jan. 13, the team has cut out the mistakes and averaging just 9.0 miscues per game... **Wes Channels** was named OVC Co-Freshman of the Week after averaging 8.5 points and 2.5 rebounds per game last week and hitting 50 percent (6-of-12) from the field and 57.1 percent (4-of-7) from 3-point range; he came off the bench to score 12 points against Jacksonville State, a game that saw him hit a trio of 3-pointers... **Drake Reed** has had 16 double-figure scoring performances this season, including 11 in a row entering this week... **Fernandez Lockett** recorded his sixth double-double (tied for the Conference high with JSU's Courtney Bradley) of the year with a 10-point, 14-rebound performance against Samford; his 14 rebounds were a season-high... The Govs lead the Conference in steals (8.6), scoring margin (+2.5) and turnover margin (+2.7)... For the third time this month the squad will have to play three games in a stretch of six days (both other times that happened they won all three games)... The week begins at Southeast Missouri on Monday, continues on Thursday at Murray State and ends on Saturday at Tennessee State... APSU is 4-5 on the road this season (4-1 in OVC road games).

EASTERN ILLINOIS (6-16 overall; 2-11 OVC): Eastern Illinois snapped an eight-game overall and 10-game OVC losing streak on Saturday with a 65-62 victory at Morehead State... The Panthers had not won since topping Western Illinois on Dec. 22... EIU is now 2-5 on the road in the Conference this season but 0-6 at home... Sophomore guard **Mike Robinson** played a big part in the victory, scoring 11 points, pulling down seven rebounds and dishing out five assists without committing a turnover; Robinson scored a basket and made a key free throw late in the contest to help EIU claim the victory... Robinson ranks 29th nationally in steals per game (2.3)... Freshman **Ousmane Cisse** was named OVC Co-Freshman of the Week after he scored 10 points and pulled down six boards while blocking a shot in the win; Cisse was a perfect 3-for-3 from the field and 4-of-5 from the free throw line... Freshman **Romain Martin**, who leads the team in scoring (14.8 points/game), scored 13 points; Martin is one of 23 freshmen nationally who currently lead their respective teams in scoring... EIU will play twice this week, beginning with Jacksonville State at home on Thursday... The week concludes with an ESPN2 matchup against Samford on Saturday (5 p.m. CT) at home.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (10-9 overall; 5-6 OVC): Eastern Kentucky played just once last week and dropped a heartbreaking decision at home to Tennessee State... Clinging to a 62-61 lead, the Colonels allowed TSU to score with just 2.2 seconds remaining to send EKV to its third straight defeat... Eastern is now 5-6 in the Conference, which places them in eighth place, one win ahead of UT Martin for the final OVC Tournament spot... Sophomore **Mike Rose** notched his sixth 20-point performance of the year with 25 points against TSU; he was 6-of-12 (50%) from the field behind the 3-point line and needs just 24 points to reach 500 for his career... Since returning to the starting lineup on Jan. 9 against Morehead State, senior **Michael Brock** has led the Colonels in rebounding in four of the five games (6.4 rebounds/game during the stretch)... EKV committed a season-high 22 fouls in its last game against Tennessee State; the Colonels currently rank second nationally in fewest fouls per game (13.8 - just 0.5 behind national leader Alabama)... The EKV defense has not held its opponents below 47 percent shooting since a Dec. 18 game at Eastern Illinois... The Colonels will play three times this week, starting at home on Monday against UT Martin... The team also plays at Morehead State on Thursday and then back home on Saturday to challenge Tennessee Tech, in a game that will now start at 7 p.m. CT (it was originally scheduled as a doubleheader with the women's team but switched due to a building conflict).

JACKSONVILLE STATE (5-16 overall; 3-9 OVC): Jacksonville State dropped a pair of road games last week, falling at league-leader Austin Peay (73-58) and UT Martin (83-60)... The loss dropped the team to 3-9 in the OVC and they currently sit in 10th place overall... After winning two games the week prior, JSU has lost 10 of its last 12 games overall... Senior **Courtney Bradley**, last week's Player of the Week, averaged 14 points and four rebounds in the pair of losses while **Nick Smith** chipped in with 12 points and 3.5 rebounds a contest... Jacksonville State has a tough schedule this week, playing three games in just five days... The week begins with an ESPNU game with Tennessee State on Tuesday... Following the home game, the team will travel to Eastern Illinois (557 miles to the North) for a game on Thursday; following the EIU affair, the team turns around to travel the 557 miles to play at home on Saturday night against Murray State.

MOREHEAD STATE (10-10 overall; 6-6 OVC): Morehead State suffered a pair of defeats at home last week, falling in the final seconds to Southeast Missouri (61-59) before losing a three-point contest (65-62) to Eastern Illinois... After starting Conference play 5-1, the team has now slipped to 6-6 overall, but still find themselves in sixth place in the league standings... Morehead State has lost four in a row and has five of their final eight Conference games away from Johnson Arena... Junior guard **Brandon Callahan** averaged 14 points and 3.5 rebounds per game last week while hitting 50 percent (10-of-20) from the field and 45.5 percent (5-of-11) from 3-point range... The Eagles have won four games by four or fewer points this season and six of its 10 losses have come by five or less points... The Eagles will play at Tennessee Tech on Monday and home against Eastern Kentucky (Saturday) this week... The EKV contest will be televised regionally on WYMT-TV (CBS affiliate from Hazard, Ky.) and CWKYT (Lexington); it can be seen on cable systems in Eastern and Central Kentucky, Southwestern West Virginia and East Tennessee.

MURRAY STATE (9-11 overall; 7-5 OVC): Murray State split a pair of games last week, losing at Tennessee Tech (63-52) on a game broadcast on ESPNU, before traveling to Southeast Missouri where they avenged an early season loss by winning 85-67... In the earlier meeting between the teams, the Racers lost by 11 points, meaning the series saw a 29-point swing in the two contests... MSU held Southeast Missouri to a season-low 27.1 percent from the field, the lowest total the Racers have held a Division I team to this season... Murray and SEMO have played two physical games this season, contests that have totaled 110 fouls and accounted for 162 free throws; there were also nine combined technical fouls in the two games... **Shawn Witherspoon** continues his approach on the 1,000-Point Club, as he is now just 50 points

away...Sophomore **Tyler Holloway** is hitting 87.3 percent from the charity stripe this season, a mark that is 31st nationally...The week continues to be one of road affairs, as the team plays only two home games during the entire month of January; Murray will travel nearly 3,000 miles during the month...The Racers play at league No. 2 Samford on Monday, host Austin Peay on Thursday and head back to Alabama on Saturday where they will play at Jacksonville State.

SAMFORD (12-9 overall; 9-3 OVC): The Bulldogs, who are currently second in the league standings, split a pair of contests last week, topping UT Martin 71-66 on the road before falling 66-48 at league-leader Austin Peay...Samford has won three of four games entering this week and nine straight at home; the team has not lost at home since Feb. 14, 2006...Samford is outscoring its opponents by a 11.2 points per game average in home games in 2006-07...Senior **Randall Gulina** averaged 23.0 points, 3.0 rebounds and 1.5 steals per game while hitting 50 percent (15-of-30) from the field and 44.4 percent (8-of-18) from 3-point range; he scored 24 points and had six rebounds against UT Martin and 22 points against Austin Peay...Senior point guard **Jerry Smith** is just one assist away from the 400-assist plateau; he is averaging 100 assists per season in his career and is on pace to become the program's all-time leader in that category (Al Walter's 423 assists is currently the record)...Samford has a three-game week this week, playing at home against Murray State on Monday and Tennessee State on Thursday before playing at Eastern Illinois on Saturday; the EIU game can be seen nationally on ESPN2...Monday's affair with Murray State is deemed "Sell Out Seibert" as the team tries to break its arena's attendance record; this marks the last year for the Bulldogs to play at Seibert before moving into a new home next season...Five of the team's final eight OVC games are at home this season.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (8-14 overall; 6-7 OVC): For the third consecutive week the Redhawks split a pair of games, winning 61-59 at Morehead State before falling 85-67 to Murray State at home...The win at Morehead came with just 1.4 seconds left as junior **Michael Rembert** scored on a putback to give SEMO the victory...For the week Rembert averaged 13.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game while hitting 50 percent (9-of-18) from the field, stats that earned him OVC Newcomer of the Week honors; Rembert had 18 points and seven rebounds in the win over Morehead State and won the award for the second time this season...It marked the third straight week a Southeast player had been named the Newcomer of the Week, as junior **Brandon Foust** had won the award in each of the past two weeks...The Redhawks find themselves at 6-7 and in seventh place in the Conference entering this week's play...The team starts the week by hosting league-leader Austin Peay on Monday...The week ends with at game at UT Martin on Saturday.

TENNESSEE STATE (10-11 overall; 6-5 OVC): Tennessee State split a pair of games last week to go to 6-5 in the Conference, which puts them in fifth place overall...TSU went on the road to win at Eastern Kentucky (63-62) before losing at home to Tennessee Tech (73-67)...In the EKV game, **Andrae Belton** scored on a lay-up with 2.2 seconds left to give the team a road victory; the Tigers are now 2-9 in true road games this season, although they are 2-3 in OVC road games and have won two OVC road contests in a row...The loss to Tennessee Tech was only the squad's second at home this season (the other was to Murray State in overtime)...Senior **Clarence Matthews** averaged 16.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game while hitting 62.5 percent (10-of-16) from the field and 76.9 percent (10-of-13) from the free throw line; he had his fifth double-double of the season (second most in the OVC) with 16 points and 10 rebounds against EKV...Matthews' 8.1 rebounds per game currently leads the OVC...The Tigers may have the services of Mississippi State transfer **Jerrell Houston** before the end of the semester; Houston has fought academic issues and may be available in mid-February...The Tigers play three games in five days this week, beginning on Tuesday when they play at Jacksonville State, a game that can be seen on ESPNU...The week continues with a Thursday game at Samford and a Saturday home contest with Austin Peay.

TENNESSEE TECH (12-9 overall; 8-4 OVC): Tennessee Tech remains one of the hottest teams in the league, having won six straight and seven of eight entering this week...They have not lost since dropping an 82-71 decision at Tennessee Tech on Jan. 6...Tech is now just one game behind Samford for second place in the league...Last week the Golden Eagles topped Murray State 63-52 at home and Tennessee State 73-67 on the road...**Anthony Fisher** was named the OVC Player of the Week for the second time this season after averaging 16.0 points, 6.5 rebounds and 5.5 assists per game and hitting 93.3 percent (14-of-15) from the charity stripe; Fisher scored 12 points against Murray State while dishing out six assists and came back with 20 points and five assists in 39 minutes against TSU...Fisher currently ranks third in the OVC in scoring (18.0), although his 19.4 points per game in 12 OVC games is tops in Conference-only contests...Fisher also became a member of Tech's 1,000-Point Club last week, becoming the second OVC player to reach that feat this season...Teammate **Belton Rivers** (18.7 points/game) currently leads the league in scoring, just ahead of Samford's Randall Gulina (18.1 points/game)...If Rivers and Fisher finish No. 1 and 2 in the OVC in scoring, it would be the first time since the 2000-01 that has happened in the OVC...Rivers scored 18 of his 23 points in the second half of the come-from-behind victory over Tennessee State...**Francis Kabore** came off the bench to score 10 points against Murray State and seven against TSU; he hit 71.4 percent (5-of-7) of his shots during the week...Tech limited its opponents last week to 59.5 points per game, 36 percent field goal accuracy and out-rebounded them by a +8.5 margin...TTU will play three games this week, starting with Morehead State on Monday...The Golden Eagles will also host UT Martin and travel to Eastern Kentucky.

2006-07 Predicted Order of Finish: The race for the 2006-07 Ohio Valley Conference men's basketball crown appears to be wide open, according to a preseason poll of OVC head basketball coaches and sports information directors. **Samford**, the 2006 OVC tournament runner-up, received nine first-place votes and 177 points to claim the top spot in the poll, edging out **Tennessee State**, who earned six first-place votes and 169 points to follow in second. **Tennessee Tech** was a close third with four first-place votes and 165 points, while defending OVC champion **Murray State** was selected fourth, claiming the remaining three first-place votes and 144 points. **Southeast Missouri** earned a fifth-place preseason selection with 134 points, followed by **Austin Peay** in sixth with 110 points. Rounding out the number seven through 11 spots in the poll were **Jacksonville State** (103 points), **Eastern Kentucky** (71 points), **Eastern Illinois** (56 points), **UT Martin** (53 points) and **Morehead State** (28 points).

Murray State's Witherspoon Headlines Preseason All-OVC Squad: According to preseason voting by the league's coaches and sports information directors, Murray State senior **Shawn Witherspoon** is the player to watch in 2006-07, selecting the 6-foot-5 forward as the OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Joining Witherspoon on the preseason All-OVC first team are Tennessee State senior forward **Clarence Matthews**; Jacksonville State senior forward **Courtney Bradley**; Samford senior guard **Randall Gulina**; and Tennessee Tech junior guard **Anthony Fisher**. Witherspoon earned first team All-OVC honors in 2005-06 after averaging a team-high 10.6 points per game while boasting a league-high 2.38 assist-to-turnover ratio and ranking second in the Conference in rebounding (7.7 rpg) and sixth in steals (1.68 spg). Matthews was a second team All-OVC selection a year ago, shooting a league-best 54.5 percent from the field and pulling down a Conference-high 8.5 rebounds per game while contributing a 13.7 scoring average and 47 blocked shots. Bradley led his team in scoring (15.3 ppg) and rebounding (7.6 rpg), ranking sixth in the league in both categories. Gulina dished out 55 assists last season and was second on his team in scoring (12.6 ppg), while Fisher averaged a team-high 12.9 points a game to go with 64 assists in 2005-06. Selected to the 2006-07 preseason All-OVC second team were Tennessee Tech senior guard **Belton Rivers**; Morehead State senior guard **Shaun Williams**; Samford junior center **Travis Peterson**; Eastern Illinois sophomore guard **Mike Robinson**; and Jacksonville State junior forward **Dorien Brown**.

the conference holds a 6-8 record in that time frame, with Murray State's perfect 2-0 record leading the way. Six OVC teams (Morehead State, Samford, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin) will host games while Austin Peay, Murray State, Eastern Illinois, Eastern Kentucky and Jacksonville State will play road contests. As part of the agreement, home teams will play a return game at the home facility of their BracketBusters series opponent in November or December of the following season.

BracketBusters Rematches: As part of the ESPN BracketBusters event, teams pay a return visit to the teams they hosted a year ago and vice versa. Last year the OVC was 5-6 in BracketBuster games and were 5-6 in the return matchups in 2006-07. Four of those five wins helped OVC teams avenge losses from a season ago, as Eastern Kentucky (UNC Asheville), Samford (Ohio), Southeast Missouri (UC Riverside) and Tennessee Tech (Bradley) all topped teams that had defeated them last February. Tennessee State topped Ball State for the second straight year this December.

Early Conference Openers: Murray State and Eastern Illinois opened the conference season on Nov. 25 with the earliest OVC Conference matchup in league history. The teams were the first squads to play a conference game nationally as well. The game was pushed up due to both schools competing in the BracketBusters event later this year; the Nov. 25 date was the only other date that worked for the teams. Murray State topped EIU 53-50.

Nationally-Ranked Opponents: OVC schools have competed against eight nationally-ranked teams so far this season. Samford has played the toughest schedule, battling No. 1 Florida, No. 15 Arizona and No. 17 LSU this year. Eastern Kentucky has played at No. 4 Ohio State, Tennessee State played at No. 12 Kansas and No. 6 Alabama, Austin Peay battled No. 19 Memphis and Tennessee Tech played at No. 21 Tennessee.

Weaver Named to Las Vegas Invitational All-Tournament Team: Tennessee State junior **Ladarious Weaver** was named to the All-Tournament team at the Las Vegas Invitational after four quality games including a 13-point performance in the team's final game against Towson. Tennessee State finished the event 2-2 with losses to Western Kentucky and No. 12 Kansas and wins over Prairie View A&M and Towson.

Rivers Named to San Juan Shootout All-Tournament Team: Tennessee Tech guard **Belton Rivers** was named to the All-Tournament team at the San Juan Shootout after averaging 19 points per game in contests against Northwestern, Vanderbilt and Central Florida. He had 22 points including the game-winner against Northwestern to open the tournament.

Gulina Earns All-Tournament Honors at Hispanic College Funds Classic: Samford's **Randall Gulina** was named to the All-Tournament Team at the Hispanic College Funds Classic hosted by LSU Dec. 27-29. Gulina averaged 15.3 points per game at the event including a game-high 26 points in the Bulldogs overtime victory over Mississippi Valley State and 14 points against No. 17 LSU.

Samford Puts An End to Murray State's Home Court Winning Streak: When Samford defeated Murray State 55-44 on Dec. 21, it marked the end of the Racers 15-game home court winning streak, a mark that was tied for the 11th longest nationally. The Bulldogs became the first team to win at the Regional Special Events Center since Dec. 2005. It also snapped a streak of 14 straight OVC victories at the RSEC.

Samford's Tillette Named Coach of the Week by CollegeInsider.com: Samford head coach **Jimmy Tillette** was named the nation's mid-major Coach of the Week on Dec. 27 by CollegeInsider.com. The award came after his team had won four games in a row including opening up the Conference season 3-0.

Buzzer Beaters: OVC schools have had their fair share of exciting finishes this season with several buzzer beaters factoring into the final outcome of games. One of the most dramatic came on Dec. 2 when Eastern Illinois' **Mike Robinson** hit a 3-pointer from just inside of half court to top Arkansas State 73-70 in Charleston. Sutton Given Contract Extension at Tennessee Tech: Tennessee Tech head basketball coach Mike Sutton was given a contract extension through the 2010-11 season by the school on Dec. 22. Sutton, who is in his fifth year with the program, is the 11th head coach in program history and was named the 2005 OVC Coach of the Year after leading the Golden Eagles to the OVC Championship. Last season Tech was 19-12 and finished third in the Conference during a year Sutton bravely battled Guillain-Barre' Syndrome.

It Has Been Pretty Close: A little more than halfway through the Conference season, competition in the Ohio Valley Conference has been close. Through 66 Conference games, the average margin of victory has been 10.3 points per game. That includes nine 1-point games, 27 games decided by five points or less and four overtime contests. That number has been on the rise slightly as of late, as 25 of the 45 games over the past four weeks have been decided by 10 or more points, after only four of the first 21 OVC games of the season were decided by double-digits.

Morehead Exceeds Win Total From 2006 After Only Nine Games: After only nine games this season first-year head coach **Donnie Tyndall** led his alma mater, Morehead State, to more wins that it had the entire 2005-06 season (4). The fifth win came on Dec. 18 at UT Martin (56-55). With a 70-48 win over UT Martin on Jan. 13, Morehead doubled its OVC win total (3) from a season ago. Morehead is now 10-10 overall and 6-6 in the OVC entering this week.

Loos Becomes Winning Coach in APSU History: Austin Peay head coach **Dave Loos** became the winningest coach in Austin Peay State University history on Jan. 13 when his team defeated Southeast Missouri 68-67 at home. That gave him 259 wins, one better than Dave Aaron. Loos' career record at APSU is now 263-231 in 17 seasons (and is 345-283 in 22 years overall). He is also among elite company that have coached in the OVC. His 263 victories at APSU (all of which were as a member of the OVC) is third all-time among all coaches who have coached in the OVC. He trails only Cal Luther (319 wins with Murray State and UT Martin) and E.A. Diddle (296 wins at Western Kentucky when the Hilltoppers were members of the OVC; it does not include his wins prior to WKU joining the Conference in 1948). The next highest active OVC coach as far as win totals goes is UT Martin's Bret Campbell (84). Loos' 17 years coaching in the OVC is second all-time, behind only Luther who coached 23 years in the Conference.

Rivers and Fisher Rank No. 1 & 3 in OVC in Scoring: Entering this week the Tennessee Tech backcourt duo of Belton Rivers (18.7 ppg) and Anthony Fisher (18.0 ppg) rank No. 1 and No. 3 in the OVC in scoring. The past two weeks the duo had been No. 1 and No. 2 (before Samford's Randall Gulina at 18.1 points/game sandwiched himself between the duo), making the Conference one of only two nationally (VMI of the Big South Conference is the other school) to have teammates rank No. 1 and No. 2 in scoring. The last time this happened in the OVC to finish a year was in 2000-01 when Eastern Illinois' Kyle Hill (23.8 ppg) and Henry Domercant (22.8) topped the league scoring charts.

Austin Peay's Win Streak Ranks Third Nationally: Entering this week Austin Peay's 10-game winning streak (which started on Dec. 20) ranks third nationally. It trails only (1) Wisconsin - 17 and (2) Florida - 12 and is ahead of five teams who are at nine wins in a row. It is the team's longest winning streak since the 2003-04 season when the squad won 14 in a row on the way to the OVC Regular Season Championship. That year the team lost in the OVC Tournament Championship game and advanced to the second round of the NIT.

2006-07 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL REPORT

1,000-Point Club: Samford's **Randall Gulina** became the 20th member of his school's 1,000-Point Club on Jan. 20, as he scored 14 points in a win over Eastern Kentucky. Gulina was the first OVC Player to reach the 1,000-Point career mark this season and was joined by Tennessee Tech's **Anthony Fisher** on Jan. 27, when he scored 20 points against Tennessee State. Two other players are nearing the achievement, including UT Martin's **Cleve Woodfork** who is just 9 points away and Murray State's **Shawn Witherspoon** who is currently at 950 career points, just 50 away from the 1,000-Point Club.

Samford Builds On Home-Court Winning Streak: After ending Murray State's 15-game home-court winning streak earlier this season, Samford has continued to win on its home court and now has a nine-game winning streak at Siebert Hall (which is in its final season of existence). The Bulldogs next play at home on Feb. 1 against Tennessee State.

Martin Among Elite Company: Eastern Illinois freshman **Romain Martin** is currently leading his team in scoring (14.8 ppg). He is one of just 23 freshmen nationally to be leading their teams in scoring as on Jan. 29. The nationally freshmen leader in scoring is Texas' Kevin Durant (24.4 ppg).

Coaches vs. Cancer Awareness Week Set for Feb. 9-11: Once against this season the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) is promoting the Coaches vs. Cancer Awareness Week from February 9 through 11. The NABC is asking its membership to wear basketball sneakers at their games over that weekend period.
