MIKE ROSE • G, So., 6'3, 190 • CHICAGO, ILL. • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Rose reached the 20-point plateau twice last week and shot over 50 percent from the field in all three Eastern Kentucky games. He scored the first four points in the second overtime and came away with two key steals later in that stanza to help the Colonels hold off Tennessee Tech, 92-90. Rose posted team highs in points (20) and rebounds (5) at Morehead State. For the week, he averaged 19.0 points, 3.0 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 2.7 steals per game.

NEWCOMER

BRUCE CARTER • G, JR., 6'5, 200 • DETROIT, MICH. • MURRAY STATE

Carter was named Newcomer of the Week for the fourth time this season after averaging 14.0 points, 4.6 rebounds, 1.3 assists and 1.3 steals per game while hitting 50 percent (18-of-36) of his shot attempts. He helped Murray State to an undefeated week with wins over Samford, Austin Peay and Jacksonville State. His best performance was a team-best 19 points on 8-of-15 shooting against Austin Peav.

<u>FRESHMAN</u>

ADAM LEONARD • G, FR., 6'0, 185 • LEE'S SUMMITT, MO. • EASTERN KY.

Leonard earned the Freshman of the Week award for the second time this year (Jan. 15) while averaging 16.7 points, 3.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 1.7 assists per game and hitting 52.2 percent (12-of-23) from 3-point range. He shot 70 percent from the floor while scoring a game-high 18 points in the win over UT Martin and equaled a game-high with 20 points in the double-overtime win over Tennessee Tech. Leonard hit at least three 3-pointers in all three games, while averaging 38.7 minutes/game last week.

TEAM NOTES

AUSTIN PEAY (15-7 overall; 12-2 OVC): Austin Peay saw its 11-game winning streak - the third longest nationally at the time - come to an end last week with a 77-68 loss at rival Murray State... Although the Governors saw the streak come to an end, they had a good week overall, winning by two at Southeast Missouri (75-73) and by nine at Tennessee State as they played all three games away from home and did so in a six-day stretch... The win over Southeast Missouri came from some clutch play from junior guard Todd Babington, who hit a 3-pointer with 17 seconds remaining to give his team the lead for good, and later added a free throw to account for the final margin; Babington knocked down 11 total 3-pointers during the week and averaged 14 points a contest... The loss to Murray State was the first of the 2007 calendar season, as the Govs had not lost since falling 80-75 to Evansville on Dec. 18... Austin Peay is 12-0 this season when holding opponents to less than 70 points... Sophomore Drake Reed averaged 18.3 points, 6.3 rebounds and 1.3 steals per game last week while hitting 62.9 percent (22-of-35) from the field in three games; Reed has now scored in double figures in 11 straight games and 16 total games this season... Reed ranks fifth in the OVC in scoring (16.0 ppg), sixth in rebounding (6.1 rpg) and fifth in field goal percentage (52.0%)... Fernandez Lockett, who ranks third in the OVC in rebounding (7.7/game), recorded his sixth double-double of the season (tied for first in the Conference), as he had 10 points and 14 rebounds against Samford on Jan. 27... Point guard Derek Wright had 14 assists during the week and led the Govs in rebounding (5) at Tennessee State despite being the shortest player on the court (5'9")... Austin Peay will host Eastern Illinois on Thursday before traveling to the League's second place team, Samford, on Saturday... Four of the Govs final six Conference games this season will be at home.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (7-17 overall; 3-12 OVC): Eastern Illinois began last week by extending its winning streak to two games with a 73-59 victory over Jacksonville State at home...The Panthers concluded the week with a 53-48 loss to Samford in a game televised on ESPN2; that game was close despite the fact the team's leading scorer, **Romain Martin**, was sitting out due to a one-game suspension for being ejected from the JSU contest...Junior **Bobby Catchings** was a catalyst for the team, averaging 14 points, 6.5 rebounds and 3.0 assists per game while hitting 48 percent (12-of-25) from the field; Catchings had 16 points against Jacksonville State and 12 points and 12 rebounds - his second career double-double - against Samford...**Mike Robinson** had 15 points in the loss to Samford, doing so in 38 minutes of action; Robinson ranks second in the OVC in steals (2.25/game)...EIU remains the Conference leader in free throw percentage (71.1%)...The Panthers play a pair of games this week, traveling to League-leader Austin Peay on Thursday before hosting UT Martin on Saturday night.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (13-9 overall; 8-6 OVC): Eastern Kentucky had a perfect week, winning all three of its games to improve to 8-6 in the Conference and move from eighth to fifth place in the overall standings... The Colonels topped UT Martin at home 94-57 to start the week; the 37 points was the largest margin of victory in the OVC this season; it was the largest margin of victory by EKU in an OVC game since topping Morehead State by 51 points (105-54) on Jan. 8, 1991... EKU then went on the road to defeat rival Morehead State 69-61 before coming home to top Tennessee Tech 92-90 in double overtime, a win that snapped TTU's eight-game winning streak... Sophomore **Mike Rose** was named OVC Player of the Week after averaging 19 points, 3.0 rebounds, 2.3 assists and 2.7 steals per game while hitting 58.1 percent (18-of-31) from the field and 44.4 percent (8-of-18) from 3-point range; Rose had 20-plus points in two of the three games, including 20 points and five rebounds in the win over Morehead State... Freshman **Adam Leonard** claimed Freshman of the Week honors for the second time this season after averaging 16.7 points, 3.3 assists, 3.0 rebounds and 1.7 steals per game and hitting 53.6 percent (15-of-28) from the field and 52.2 percent (12-of-23) from 3-point range; Leonard had 18 points and hit 70 percent from the field in the win over UT Martin, had a game-high 20 in the double overtime victory over Tennessee Tech and hit at least three 3-pointers in each game of the week... Senior **Julian Mascoll** equaled his career-high with eight assists against Morehead State; his 4.5 assists per game average is tied for second in the OVC... The Colonels will look to extend their winning streak with a game at Murray State on Thursday and a ESPNU contest at Southeast Missouri on Saturday night.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (6-18 overall; 4-11 OVC): Jacksonville State snapped a two-game losing streak by beginning last week with a 72-64 victory over Tennessee State in a game which was broadcast on ESPNU...JSU built a 53-33 lead with 10 minutes to play against TSU before allowing the Tigers to storm back to within a point with 1:36 left and have a chance to take the lead before eventually coming up short...Courtney Bradley had a game-high 24 points for the Gamecocks while Winn Ginn added 14...Bradley's 10 games of 20 or more points this season leads the OVC...Following that Tuesday night matchup JSU then had to travel over 500 miles to its farthest destination in the Conference - Charleston, Ill. - and lost 73-59 to Eastern Illinois on Thursday night...The team then turned around, traveled back home and lost by only two points, 63-61, to the

League's hottest team Murray State...Jacksonville State had four chances in the final 26 seconds of the game to defeat Murray State; JSU lost its two games to Murray by a combined three points on the season...Jax State has lost a game by five points or less seven times this season...The Gamecocks only play once this week, as they host Tennessee Tech on Thursday night.

MOREHEAD STATE (10-12 overall; 6-8 OVC): The Eagles suffered their fifth and sixth consecutive losses last week, losing at Tennessee Tech 65-52 and at home to Eastern Kentucky 69-61... Morehead State has not won since topping UT Martin 70-48 on Jan. 13... they are now 6-8 in the OVC and tied for seventh place with Tennessee State with six games to play... Morehead State had a tough week shooting the ball, hitting just 33.9 percent from the field; MSU did outrebound both of its opponents and committed two fewer turnovers than its opposition despite coming out on the losing end of each game... The Eagles were out-scored at the free throw line by 21 points on the week... Quentin Pryor averaged 15 points, 4.5 rebounds, 1.5 assists, 2.0 steals and 1.0 blocks per game last week... Morehead State will have to go on the road this week to look to end its losing streak, as they play at Southeast Missouri on Thursday and then at Murray State on Saturday night; MSU lost to each of those teams at home earlier this season, doing so by only a combined five points.

MURRAY STATE (12-11 overall; 10-5 OVC): Murray State put itself in good position to host a first-round OVC Tournament game by winning all three of its contests a week ago to jump into a tie for third in the Conference with just five Conference games remaining; Murray will play four of its final five OVC games at home this season...The Racers have now won four in a row overall and five of six; they are over .500 overall (12-11) for the first time this season...The week began

with a 57-51 victory at Samford, as the Racers ended the Bulldogs 9-game home court winning streak; that was fitting as the Bulldogs had ended Murray State's 15-game home court winning streak earlier this season...Three days later another streak ended, as the Racers stopped rival Austin Peay's 11-game overall winning streak, a mark that was the third longest in the country at the time...The week ended with a 63-61 victory at Jacksonville State on Saturday, the team's second trip to Alabama in less than a week...Murray State trailed at halftime of all three of its wins last week...Junior **Bruce Carter** was named OVC Newcomer of the Week for the fourth time this season after averaging 14 points, 4.6 rebounds, 1.3 steals and 1.3 assists per game and hitting 50 percent (18-of-36) from the field; Carter had a team-best 19 points in the win over Austin Peay...Senior **Shawn Witherspoon** moved to within 11 points of becoming the Racers newest member of the 1,000-Point Club; Witherspoon averaged 13 points, 7.6 rebounds and 2.0 assists/game last week while hitting 50 percent (13-of-26) from the field and 71.2 percent (5-of-7) from 3-point range... Witherspoon scored nine straight points down the stretch in the win over Samford, had nine points and nine rebounds against Austin Peay and 15 points against JSU, including the game-tying basket with two minutes left... Freshman **Tony Easley** had six points and seven rebounds against Jacksonville State while playing a career-high 24 minutes... In its last five games, MSU has held its opponents to 37.1 percent shooting from the field and 29.9 percent from 3-point range... Murray begins the home stretch of Conference games by hosting Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State this week.

SAMFORD (14-10 overall; 11-4 OVC): The Bulldogs saw its nine-game home winning streak come to an end to start last week, falling to Murray State 57-51; it was ironic since Samford had ended Murray's 15-game home court winning streak earlier in the year...But the team regrouped and claimed a 70-60 win over Tennessee State and a 53-48 road victory over Eastern Illinois (in an ESPN2 contest) to move to 11-4 in the Conference, a game and a half behind League-leader Austin Peay...Samford has won five of its last seven games and 8 of 12 overall dating back to the beginning of January...Senior Randall Gulina, who leads the OVC in scoring (18.3 ppg), had another good week, averaging 20.0 points and 3.0 rebounds per game while hitting 51.3 percent (20-of-39) from the field and 45.5 percent (10-of-22) from 3-point range; he tallied at least 19 points and had at least three 3-point field goals in each game last week...Gulina has scored in double figures in 23 of Samford's 24 games this season...Senior Jerry Smith reached the 400-assist plateau for his career last week and needs just 22 more assists to becoming the school's all-time leader; he also started for the 78th consecutive game, the longest current streak in the OVC...Samford will have the week off until Saturday when they host OVC-leader Austin Peay; APSU won 66-48 in Clarksville in the only other meeting between the team's this season.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (9-15 overall; 7-8 OVC): For the fourth week in a row, Southeast Missouri split a pair of games, losing a heartbreaker, 75-73, to League-leader Austin Peay, before turning around and winning at UT Martin...Southeast is 4-3 on the road in the OVC this season while 3-5 in OVC home games; they are the only League team to have a winning record on the road and a sub-.500 record at home...Since opening January with a pair of wins, the team has gone 1-1 in every other week of the season...Junior **Michael Rembert** averaged 12.5 points and 8.5 rebounds per game last week while hitting 45 percent (9-of-20) from the field; Rembert had 17 points and seven rebounds against Austin Peay...Freshman **Marcus Rhodes** averaged 10 points and 2.5 rebounds per contest a week ago, registering 12 points in the win over UT Martin, including scoring two field goals and dishing out an assist in the final 1:52 of that road contest...Southeast has made 10 or more 3-pointers in six of its wins this season...The Redhawks will be looking to improve on its home record (which is just 4-6 overall this season) with a pair of home contests this week...SEMO will host Morehead State on Thursday and Eastern Kentucky on Saturday; the EKU game can be seen on ESPNU.

TENNESSEE STATE (10-14 overall; 6-8 OVC): Tennessee State saw its losing streak reach four games as the team lost all three of its contests last week... TSU lost 72-64 at Jacksonville State, 70-60 at Samford (the No. 2 team in the League) and 62-53 at home against Austin Peay (No. 1 in the League)... Tennessee State is now tied for seventh place overall in the OVC with six Conference games remaining... The Tigers were down 20 points at JSU before storming back, pulling within one-point and having possession of the ball to take the lead, before coming up just short against the Gamecocks... **Andrae Belton** continued his hot play, averaging 15 points and 6.3 rebounds per game while hitting 18-of-37 (48.6%) from the field... **Clarence Matthews** averaged 14.7 points and 9.0 rebounds per contest while hitting 12-of-14 (85.7%) of his free throw attempts; Matthews leads the OVC in rebounding (8.2/game)... The Tigers are 6-3 at home in the Gentry Center this season... TSU will play twice this week, hosting UT Martin for an ESPNU contest on Tuesday night before traveling to Tennessee Tech for a Saturday night game.

TENNESSEE TECH (14-10 overall; 10-5 OVC): Tennessee Tech started last week by winning two games to run its winning streak to a season-high eight games, before suffering a 92-90 double overtime loss at Eastern Kentucky...The week began with a 65-52 win against Morehead State and a 82-74 victory at home over UT Martin...The pair of home wins helped the Golden Eagles improve to 9-1 at home on the season; the team is 4-7 in road games...**Amadi McKenzie**, who is second in the OVC in rebounding (7.8 rpg), averaged 16.3 points and 9.7 rebounds per game and hit 66.7 percent (20-of-30) from the field...McKenzie had 14 points and eight rebounds against Morehead State, 19 points and seven rebounds against UT Martin and 16 points and 14 rebounds at EKU (his fifth double-double of the season)...**Belton Rivers** and **Anthony Fisher** now rank second and third in the OVC in scoring, just trailing Samford's Randall Gulina...Fisher averaged 15 points, 6.3 rebounds and 5.0 assists per game last week...TTU will play at Jacksonville State on Thursday before coming home to host Tennessee State on Saturday.

UT MARTIN (6-20 overall; 4-12 OVC): UT Martin lost all three of its contests last week and the team has now lost seven of eight overall...The Skyhawks lost 94-57 at Eastern Kentucky, 82-74 at Tennessee Tech and 73-69 at home to Southeast Missouri...The team must win its four remaining OVC games to claim the eighth and final spot for the OVC Tournament...Senior **Cleve Woodfork** became the 12th member of Tennessee-Martin's 1,000-Point Club last week, scoring his 1,000th career point against Eastern Kentucky on a lay-up with 17:04 remaining in the first half; Woodfork is the fourth OVC player to reach that plateau this season...Woodfork is now No. 5 on the Skyhawks career free throws made list (268) and No. 3 on the career free throws attempted list (382)...Freshman **Joseph Bailey** scored a career-high 12 points in the loss at EKU...The Skyhawks play a pair of road games this week, at Tennessee State on ESPNU on Tuesday night and at Eastern Illinois on Saturday.

2006-07 Predicted Order of Finish: The race for the 2006-07 Ohio Valley Conference men's basketball crown appears to be wide open, according to a preseason poll of OVC head basketball coaches and sports information directors. Samford, the 2006 OVC tournament runner-up, received nine first-place votes and 177 points to claim the top spot in the poll, edging out Tennessee State, who earned six first-place votes and 169 points to follow in second. Tennessee Tech was a close third with four first-place votes and 165 points, while defending OVC champion Murray State was selected fourth, claiming the remaining three first-place votes and 144 points. Southeast Missouri earned a fifth-place preseason selection with 134 points. followed by Austin Peay in sixth with 110 points. Rounding out the number seven through 11 spots in the poll were Jacksonville State (103 points), Eastern Kentucky (71 points), Eastern Illinois (56 points), UT Martin (53 points) and Morehead State (28 points).

Murray State's Witherspoon Headlines Preseason All-OVC Squad: According to preseason voting by the league's coaches and sports information directors, Murray State senior Shawn Witherspoon is the player to watch in 2006-07, selecting the 6-foot-5 forward as the OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Joining Witherspoon on the preseason All-OVC first team are Tennessee State senior forward Clarence Matthews; Jacksonville State senior forward Courtney Bradley; Samford senior guard Randall Gulina; and Tennessee Tech junior guard Anthony Fisher. Witherspoon earned first team All-OVC honors in 2005-06 after averaging a team-high 10.6 points per game while boasting a league-high 2.38 assist-to-turnover ratio and ranking second in the Conference in rebounding (7.7 rpg) and sixth in steals (1.68 spg). Matthews was a second team All-OVC selection a year ago, shooting a league-best 54.5 percent from the field and pulling down a Conference-high 8.5 rebounds per game while contributing a 13.7 scoring average and 47 blocked shots. Bradley led his team in scoring (15.3 ppg) and rebounding (7.6 rpg), ranking sixth in the league in both categories. Gulina dished out 55 assists last season and was second on his team in scoring (12.6 ppg), while Fisher averaged a team-high 12.9 points a game to go with 64 assists in 2005-06. Selected to the 2006-07 preseason All-OVC second team were Tennessee Tech senior quard Belton Rivers: Morehead State senior quard Shaun Williams; Samford junior center Travis Peterson; Eastern Illinois sophomore guard Mike Robinson; and Jacksonville State junior forward Dorien Brown.

BracketBusters Rematches: As part of the ESPNU BracketBusters event, teams pay a return visit to the teams they hosted a year ago and vice versa. Last year the OVC was 5-6 in BracketBuster games and were 5-6 in the return matchups in 2006-07. Four of those five wins helped OVC teams avenge losses from a season ago, as Eastern Kentucky (UNC Asheville), Samford (Ohio), Southeast Missouri (UC Riverside) and Tennessee Tech (Bradley) all topped teams that had defeated them last February. Tennessee State topped Ball State for the second straight yearthis December.

Early Conference Openers: Murray State and Eastern Illinois opened the conference season on Nov. 25 with the earliest OVC Conference matchup in league history. The teams were the first squads to play a conference game nationally as well. The game was pushed up due to both schools competing in the BracketBusters event later this year; the Nov. 25 date was the only other date that worked for the teams. Murray State topped EIU 53-50.

Nationally-Ranked Opponents: OVC schools have competed against eight nationallyranked teams so far this season. Samford has played the toughest schedule, battling No. 1 Florida, No. 15 Arizona and No. 17 LSU this year. Eastern Kentucky has played at No. 4 Ohio State, Tennessee State played at No. 12 Kansas and No. 6 Alabama, Austin Peay battled No. 19 Memphis and Tennessee Tech played at No. 21 Tennessee.

Weaver Named to Las Vegas Invitational All-Tournament Team: Tennessee State junior Ladarious Weaver was named to the All-Tournament team at the Las Vegas Invitational after four quality games including a 13-point performance in the team's final game against Towson. Tennessee State finished the event 2-2 with losses to Western Kentucky and No. 12 Kansas and wins over Prairie View A&M and Towson.

Rivers Named to San Juan Shootout All-Tournament Team: Tennessee Tech quard Belton Rivers was named to the All-Tournament team at the San Juan Shootout after averaging 19 points per game in contests against Northwestern, Vanderbilt and Central Florida. He had 22 points including the game-winner against Northwestern to open the tournament.

Gulina Earns All-Tournament Honors at Hispanic College Funds Classic: Samford's Randall Gulina was named to the All-Tournament Team at the Hispanic College Funds Classic hosted by LSU Dec. 27-29. Gulina averaged 15.3 points per game at the event including a game-high 26 points in the Bulldogs overtime victory over Mississippi Valley State and 14 points against No. 17 LSU.

Samford Puts An End to Murray State's Home Court Winning Streak: When Samford defeated Murray State 55-44 on Dec. 21, it marked the end of the Racers 15-game home court winning streak, a mark that was tied for the 11th longest nationally. The Bulldogs became the first team to win at the Regional Special Events Center since Dec. 2005. It also snapped a streak of 14 straight OVC victories at the RSEC.

Murray State Returns the Favor: After Samford ended Murray State's home court winning streak in December, the Racers re-paid the favor on Jan. 29, defeating the Bulldogs 57-51 in Birmingham to end Samford's 9-game home court streak.

Samford's Tillette Named Coach of the Week by CollegeInsider.com: Samford head coach Jimmy Tillette was named the nation's mid-major Coach of the Week on Dec. 27 by College Insider.com. The award came after his team had won four games in a row including opening up the Conference season 3-0.

Buzzer Beaters: OVC schools have had their fare share of exciting finishes this season with several buzzer beaters factoring into the final outcome of games. One of the most dramatic came on Dec. 2 when Eastern Illinois' Mike Robinson hit a 3-pointer from just inside of half court to top Arkansas State 73-70 in Charleston. Sutton Given Contract Extension at Tennessee Tech: Tennessee Tech head basketball coach Mike Sutton was given a contract extension through the 2010-11 season by the school on Dec. 22. Sutton, who is in his fifth year with the program, is the 11th head coach in program history and was named the 2005 OVC Coach of the Year after leading the Golden Eagles to the OVC Championship. Last season Tech was 19-12 and finished third in the Conference during a year Sutton bravely battled Guillain-Barre' Syndrome.

It Has Been Pretty Close: A little more than halfway through the Conference season, competition in the Ohio Valley Conference has been close. Through 81 Conference games, the average margin of victory has been 9.9 points per game. That includes nine 1-point games, 33 games decided by five points or less and five overtime contests.

Morehead Exceeds Win Total From 2006 After Only Nine Games: After only nine games this season first-year head coach Donnie Tyndall led his alma mater, Morehead State, to more wins that it had the entire 2005-06 season (4). The fifth win came on Dec. 18 at UT Martin (56-55). With a 70-48 win over UT Martin on Jan. 13, Morehead doubled its OVC win total (3) from a season ago. Morehead is now 10-12 overall and 6-8 in the OVC entering this week.

Loos Becomes Winning Coach in APSU History: Austin Peay head coach Dave Loos became the winningiest coach in Austin Peay State University history on Jan. 13 when his team defeated Southeast Missouri 68-67 at home. That gave him 259 wins, one better than Dave Aaron. Loos' career record at APSU is now 266-231 in 17 seasons (and is 348-283 in 22 years overall). He is also among elite company that have coached in the OVC. His 266 victories at APSU (all of which were as a member of the OVC) is third all-time among all coaches who have coached in the OVC. He trails only Cal Luther (319 wins with Murray State and UT Martin) and E.A. Diddle (296 wins at Western Kentucky when the Hilltoppers were members of the OVC; it does not include his wins prior to WKU joining the Conference in 1948). The next highest active OVC coach as far as win totals goes is UT Martin's Bret Campbell (84). Loos' 17 years coaching in the OVC is second all-time, behind only Luther who coached 23 years in the Conference.

Rivers and Fisher Rank No. 2 & 3 in OVC in Scoring: Entering this week the Tennessee Tech backcourt duo of Belton Rivers (18.1 ppg) and Anthony Fisher (17.6 ppg) rank No. 2 and No. 3 in the OVC in scoring. The duo is currently behind Samford's Randall Gulina (18.3 ppg), although they have ranked No. 1 and No. 2 in scoring at different points of this season (only one other team and conference - VMI of the Big South Conference - has that happening right now). The last time this happened in the OVC to finish a year was in 2000-01 when Eastern Illinois' Kyle Hill (23.8 ppg) and Henry Domercant (22.8) topped the league scoring charts.

Austin Peay Sees Nation's Third Longest Winning Streak End: Austin Peay had won 11 games in a row (the third longest streak nationally behind Wisconsin and Florida) until losing 77-68 at Murray State on Feb. 1. The loss was the first for the Governors since falling 80-75 against Evansville on Dec. 18. It was the team's longest winning streak since the 2003-04 season when they won 14 in a row on the way to the OVC Regular Season Championship. That year the team lost in the OVC Tournament Championship game and advanced to the second round of the NIT.

1,000-Point Club: Samford's **Randall Gulina** became the 20th member of his school's 1,000-Point Club on Jan. 20, as he scored 14 points in a win over Eastern Kentucky. Gulina was the

first OVC Player to reach the 1,000-Point career mark this season and was joined by Tennessee Tech's **Anthony Fisher** on Jan. 27, when he scored 20 points against Tennessee State. Two days later it was UT Martin's **Cleve Woodfork** who joined the club, scoring his 1,000th point against Eastern Kentucky. Murray State's **Shawn Witherspoon** who is currently at 989 career points, is just 11 points away from the 1,000-Point Club.

Martin Among Elite Company: Eastern Illinois freshman Romain Martin is currently leading his team in scoring (14.7 ppg). He is one of just 23 freshmen nationally to be leading their teams in scoring as on Feb. 5. The nationally freshmen leader in scoring is Texas' Kevin Durant (25.0 ppg).

Coaches vs. Cancer Awareness Week Set for Feb. 9-11: Once against this season the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) is promoting the Coaches vs. Cancer Awareness Week from February 9 through 11. The NABC is asking its membership to wear basketball sneakers at their games over that weekend period.

Sirius Broadcast Schedule: Tennessee Tech's contest at Jacksonville State on Feb. 8 can be heard live on Sirius Radio. That is the last game available on the service until the OVC Tournament, in which the men's semifinals and finals will be broadcast live.
