## THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

### PLAYER

#### GERALD ROBINSON • F, JR., 6'9, 230 • LOS ANGELES, CALIF. • UT MARTIN

Robinson averaged 29.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game while hitting 47.5 percent (19-of-40) from the field and 44.4 percent (8-of-18) from 3-point range in a pair of games. He scored a career-high 32 points in the Skyhawks' 76-74 road win over Tennessee State and followed it up with 26 points at Eastern Illinois. He came off the bench in both games, playing 31 minutes against TSU and 34 minutes against EIU. He hit 7-of-11 3-pointers (63.6 percent) in the TSU game, a contest seen nationally on ESPNU.

### CO-NEWCOMER

#### ERIK ADAMS • F, JR., 6'5, 195 • PHILADELPHIA, PA. • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Adams recorded his third career double-double in helping the Gamecocks to a key one-point win over Tennessee Tech on Thursday, the team's lone contest last week. He pulled in eight rebounds in the first half and finished with 12 for the game. Adams scored 16 total points against the Golden Eagles and hit all three of his free throw attempts.

### CO-NEWCOMER

#### LADARIOUS WEAVER • G, JR., 6'0, 165 • ATLANTA, GA • TENNESSEE STATE

Weaver averaged 20.5 points, 2.0 rebounds, 2.0 steals and 1.5 assists per game last week while hitting 42.9 percent (15-of-35) from the field and 40 percent (10-of-25) from 3-point range. He set a career-high with 26 points in a loss to UT Martin to start the week. In that game Weaver hit on 7-of-15 3-point attempts in 39 minutes of action and also had a pair of steals. He scored 15 points on 3-of-10 3-point shooting (6-of-16 overall) in 36 minutes at Tennessee Tech.

### FRESHMAN

#### ADAM LEONARD • G, FR., 6'0, 185 • LEE'S SUMMITT, MO. • EASTERN KENTUCKY

Leonard earned the award for the second straight week after averaging 17.0 points, 2.5 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game and hitting 57.9 percent (11-of-19) of his shots and 62.5 percent (10-of-16) of his 3-point attempts in a pair of ECU victories. He equaled his career-high with 22 points at Southeast Missouri also tied a personal best with six 3-pointers in the 66-61 win. In that game he netted two clutch free throws with 19 seconds remaining to help the Colonels hold off the Redhawks. Leonard finished with a team-high 12 points at Murray State while going 66.7 percent from behind the arc. It marked the third time this season he has won the award.

## TEAM NOTES

**AUSTIN PEAY (17-7 overall; 14-2 OVC):** Austin Peay has clinched a spot in the 2007 O'Reilly OVC Basketball Tournament and can clinch the No. 1 seed in the event and at least a share for the regular season championship with a victory over Tennessee State on Monday night...The Govs put themselves in that position by topping Eastern Illinois 98-71 and League No. 2 Samford 52-50 last week...The Govs have won 14 of 15 games overall and are 10-1 at home this season...The 98 points against EIU was the most by an APSU team since the 1999-00 season...They scored almost half that many points (52) against Samford but still pulled out the two-point victory; Austin Peay is now 13-0 this season when holding its opponents to 70 or fewer points in a game...Junior **Fernandez Lockett** averaged 18.0 points, 10.5 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game last week while hitting 58.3 percent (14-of-24) from the field; he had double-doubles in both games last week (20 points and 10 rebounds against EIU and 16 points and 11 rebounds against Samford) and now leads the OVC with eight double-doubles this season...Sophomore **Drake Reed** has now scored in double figures in 16 straight games, netting 22 points against Eastern Illinois and hitting 15-of-21 (71.4%) from the floor in two games last week...Against EIU, Austin Peay hit 66 percent from the field and had 22 assists, both a season-high...APSU also had 38 points off its bench against the Panthers, 18 by sophomore **Landon Shipley**, who hit 5-of-6 3-pointers...After hosting Tennessee State on Monday night, the Govs travel to Akron for Saturday's O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters event; the game will be televised on ESPNU (4 p.m. CT).

**EASTERN ILLINOIS (8-18 overall; 4-13 OVC):** Eastern Illinois kept its OVC Tournament hopes alive by topping UT Martin 74-59 in Charleston on Saturday, after suffering a 98-71 loss to League No. 1 Austin Peay earlier in the week...Freshman **Romain Martin** returned from a one-game suspension to average 15.5 points per game and hit 50 percent (6-of-12) from 3-point range during the week...Sophomore **Mike Robinson** averaged 20.0 points, 5.0 assists, 4.5 steals and 3.5 rebounds per game while hitting 5-of-10 (50%) from 3-point range and 47.1 percent (8-of-17) in two games; Robinson had nine steals during the week and now ranks second on EIU's single-season steals list...Robinson hit 16-of-18 free throws against UT Martin, one shy of the Lantz Arena single-game record for makes and two shy of the EIU single-game record at any site...Robinson's 2.4 steals per game currently ranks 21st nationally...EIU plays host to Southeast Missouri Tuesday night in a game that will be televised nationally on ESPNU...The week concludes with a trip to Chicago to face Loyola of Chicago on Saturday, a game that is part of the O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters event.

**EASTERN KENTUCKY (15-9 overall; 10-6 OVC):** Eastern Kentucky remained one of the hottest team's in the OVC, as it went on the road and won a pair of games to improve to 10-6 in the League and clinch a spot in the 2007 O'Reilly Basketball Tournament...The five-game winning streak is the longest since the club won seven straight at the end of the 2004-05 season, the year they advanced to the NCAA Tournament...EKU won 64-62 at Murray State and followed that up with a 66-61 win at Southeast Missouri...The victory at Murray State was the first since the 1992 season...Eastern also topped MSU 72-66 in overtime earlier this season, producing their first season sweep of the Racers since the 1984-85 season...The come-from-behind win at Southeast Missouri marked another close one at the Show Me Center between the teams, as the last four meetings there have been decided by six points or less...Freshman **Adam Leonard** claimed his second straight OVC Freshman of the Week honor this week, winning the award for the third time overall this season...Leonard averaged 17.0 points, 2.5 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game and hit 62.5 percent (10-of-16) from 3-point range and 57.9 percent (11-of-19) overall from the field in the two wins; he had 22 points in the win at SEMO, where he tied a personal best with six 3-pointers...EKU is now fifth overall in the OVC standings, but just one win out of second place overall with four games to play...This week the Colonels host second place Samford and Jacksonville State before traveling to Youngstown State for Saturday's O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters contest.

**JACKSONVILLE STATE (7-18 overall; 5-11 OVC):** The Gamecocks played only once last week, topping Tennessee Tech 72-71, handing the Golden Eagles only its second loss in a 10-game stretch...The win pushed Jacksonville State to 5-11 in the Conference, placing them ninth overall, just one game out of eighth place in the League...After losing three OVC games at the buzzer and seven of their 11 OVC losses by four points or less, luck was on JSU's side this time; trailing by five with two minutes to play, the team made the comeback, **Will Ginn** hit a lay-up with 11 seconds left and the Gamecocks got a defensive stand to end the game and win 72-71...Junior newcomer **Erik Adams** recorded his third career double-double with 16 points and 12 rebounds in the win over TTU; for his performance, Adams was named OVC Co-Newcomer of the Week...Freshman **Amadou Mbodji** had eight points and seven rebounds against Tech, hitting on 4-of-5 (80%) of his shot attempts; he also had four blocks, including blocking one at the buzzer that sealed the win for JSU...Jacksonville State will play three games in five days this week, traveling to Morehead State and Eastern Kentucky in League play early this week...The week concludes with a trip to Chattanooga for Saturday's O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters contest.

**MOREHEAD STATE (10-14 overall; 6-10 OVC):** Morehead State lost a pair of games last week and have now dropped eight in a row, dating back to mid-January...The Eagles are now 6-10 overall in the Conference and tied for seventh place overall with Tennessee State with four games remaining...**Quentin Pryor** averaged 13.0 points, 6.5 rebounds and 4.5 assists per game last week while hitting 52.6 percent (10-of-19) from the field and 4-of-4 (100%) at the charity stripe...**Shaun Williams** contributed 13.5 points and 5.0 rebounds per game last week...Last week the Eagles out-rebounded both of its opponents and committed fewer turnovers, but hit 45.5 percent from the field while allowing their opponents to hit 50 percent overall...In Morehead's current losing streak, four games have been decided by five or fewer points and the margin of defeat has been just over seven points...MSU has three games at home this week, including OVC contests with Jacksonville State and Samford; the Eagles are only one game above JSU in the standings for eighth place...The week concludes with Bowling Green as part of the O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters event on Saturday.

**MURRAY STATE (13-12 overall; 11-6 OVC):** Murray State lost at home to Eastern Kentucky (64-62) and topped Morehead State (74-62) last week...The Racers are currently tied for third place overall in the League and have clinched a spot in the O'Reilly OVC Tournament...Murray State was unable to hold onto a 12-point second half lead against EKU and lost to the Colonels at home for the first time since 1992...Senior **Shawn Witherspoon** hit a milestone last week as he became the 33rd member of MSU's 1,000-Point Club, scoring 14 points against Eastern

Kentucky...Against Morehead State, six Racers scored in double figures, led by **Ray George's** 15 points; George also had five assists...The Racers are currently 13-12 overall and need to finish above .500 to record their 20th straight winning season; they have not had a losing season since the 1986-87 campaign...Freshman **Marvin Williams** averaged 6.0 points and 2.5 rebounds per game last week; he made his sixth straight start on Saturday against Morehead State and had 10 points on 4-of-5 shooting...The Racers have three OVC games left this season, at home against Tennessee State this week, at home against Tennessee Tech on Feb. 22 and then at UT Martin on the 24th to end the regular season...Also this week the team will travel to Rider for Saturday's O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters contest.

**SAMFORD (14-11 overall; 11-5 OVC):** The Bulldogs played just once last week, falling 52-50 to League-leader Austin Peay at home...Samford is 11-5 overall in the OVC, three games behind Austin Peay for first and a half game ahead of Murray State and Tennessee Tech for second...Senior **Randall Gulina**, who leads the League in scoring, had a team-high 15 points against APSU last week and moved into 15th place on Samford's career scoring list (1,121)...Senior **Jerry Smith** is nearing Samford's all-time assists record, as he needs only 18 more assists to grab the all-time school mark...Samford has four OVC games remaining, including two on the road and two at home...This week's contests begin with road games at Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State...The week concludes with Saturday's O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters contest at home against Evansville.

**SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (10-16 overall; 8-9 OVC):** For the sixth straight week, Southeast Missouri compiled a 1-1 record during the week, topping Morehead State (81-78) and losing to Eastern Kentucky (66-61) at home...Newcomer **Brandon Foust** averaged 16.0 points and 5.0 rebounds per game in two contests a week ago; he had 14 points against MSU and 16 points and six rebounds against Eastern Kentucky...The Redhawks suffered a big loss last week as junior center **Michael Rembert** went down with an injury and missed the EKU game - he is out indefinitely and could miss the remainder of the season; Rembert was averaging 10.3 points (25th in the OVC) and 6.0 rebounds (7th) before his injury...Southeast Missouri, who needs one more win to clinch a spot in the 2007 O'Reilly OVC Basketball Tournament, will travel to Eastern Illinois for a Tuesday matchup that can be seen nationally on ESPNU...The week concludes on Saturday when the team plays its final home game of the season, an O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters contest against Louisiana Tech.

**TENNESSEE STATE (10-16 overall; 6-10 OVC):** Entering this week, Tennessee State has lost six games in a row and now finds itself 6-10 in the OVC and in a tie for seventh place with four Conference games remaining...Last week the Tigers led against UT Martin at home in a nationally televised game but were unable to hold on as they lost 76-74...The week ended with a 86-66 loss in Cookeville to Tennessee Tech...Junior **Ladarious Weaver** had a great week, earning OVC Co-Newcomer of the Week honors after averaging 20.5 points, 2.0 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game and hitting 40 percent (10-of-25) from 3-point range...Weaver scored a career-high 26 points against UT Martin, hitting on 7-of-15 3-point attempts in 39 minutes of play; he had 15 points in the matchup with Tennessee Tech...TSU is just 2-12 on the road this season and will play at League No. 1 Austin Peay and League No. 3 Murray State this week...The week ends when the team comes home to challenge Loyola (Md.) in an O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters contest on Saturday...Saturday night also marks a reunion of the 1956-57 NAIA National Championship basketball team; it is believed eight of the 11 living member will be in attendance on Saturday night.

**TENNESSEE TECH (15-11 overall; 11-6 OVC):** The Golden Eagles split a pair of games last week, falling on the road at Jacksonville State (72-71) before rebounding to beat Tennessee State 86-66 at home...Tech enters this week 11-6 in the OVC and are tied for third overall; they have already clinched a spot in the 2007 O'Reilly OVC Basketball Tournament...Junior **Amadi McKenzie** averaged 17.5 points, 10.0 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game last week while hitting 45.4 percent (10-of-22) from the field and 71.4 percent (15-of-21) from the charity stripe; he now has six double-doubles on the year, second most in the Conference...McKenzie pulled down a career-high 14 rebounds against JSU...**Belton Rivers**, tied with Samford's Randall Gulina for the OVC scoring lead (18.2 ppg), had 22 points in the win over Tennessee State while **Anthony Fisher**, who ranks third in the OVC in scoring (17.5 ppg), added 17...**Frances Kabore** had a career-high eight rebounds in the win over TSU...The Golden Eagles will travel to in-state rival UT Martin this week before coming back home to play 2006 NCAA Tournament participant Northwestern State in the O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters series.

**UT MARTIN (7-21 overall; 5-13 OVC):** With two games remaining on its Conference schedule, UT Martin is still mathematically alive for a spot in the O'Reilly OVC Basketball Tournament...Last week the Skyhawks lost 74-59 at Eastern Illinois but came from behind to win at Tennessee State 76-74, in a game seen nationally on ESPNU...Junior newcomer **Gerald Robinson** was named OVC Player of the Week after averaging 29.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game last week, while hitting 47.5 percent (19-of-40) from the field and 44.4 percent (8-of-18) from 3-point range...Robinson connected on 7-of-11 3-pointers and scored a career-high 32 points in the road win over TSU; he added 26 points in the loss to Eastern Illinois...The win over Tennessee State snapped a three-game losing streak for UTM, and was the team's second road win of the season (the other was at Jacksonville State)...The two-point win over the Tigers marked the 10th time this season UT Martin had a game decided by five points or less; the Skyhawks are 3-7 in those games this season...Senior **Cleve Woodfork** has 139 rebounds this season and is currently No. 6 on the UTM all-time list (529); he also became a member of the 1,000-Point Club earlier this season...To keep its hopes of an OVC Tournament berth alive, the Skyhawks will have to top Tennessee Tech at home this Tuesday...The week concludes with the squad's O'Reilly ESPNU BracketBusters game, Saturday against Saint Peter's.

**2006-07 Predicted Order of Finish:** The race for the 2006-07 Ohio Valley Conference men's basketball crown appears to be wide open, according to a preseason poll of OVC head basketball coaches and sports information directors. **Samford**, the 2006 OVC tournament runner-up, received nine first-place votes and 177 points to claim the top spot in the poll, edging out **Tennessee State**, who earned six first-place votes and 169 points to follow in second. **Tennessee Tech** was a close third with four first-place votes and 165 points, while defending OVC champion **Murray State** was selected fourth, claiming the remaining three first-place votes and 144 points. **Southeast Missouri** earned a fifth-place preseason selection with 134 points, followed by **Austin Peay** in sixth with 110 points. Rounding out the number seven through 11 spots in the poll were **Jacksonville State** (103 points), **Eastern Kentucky** (71 points), **Eastern Illinois** (56 points), **UT Martin** (53 points) and **Morehead State** (28 points).

**Murray State's Witherspoon Headlines Preseason All-OVC Squad:** According to preseason voting by the league's coaches and sports information directors, Murray State senior **Shawn Witherspoon** is the player to watch in 2006-07, selecting the 6-foot-5 forward as the OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Joining Witherspoon on the preseason All-OVC first team are Tennessee State senior forward **Clarence Matthews**; Jacksonville State senior forward **Courtney Bradley**; Samford senior guard **Randall Gulina**; and Tennessee Tech junior guard **Anthony Fisher**. Witherspoon earned first team All-OVC honors in 2005-06 after averaging a team-high 10.6 points per game while boasting a league-high 2.38 assist-to-turnover ratio and ranking second in the Conference in rebounding (7.7 rpg) and sixth in steals (1.68 spg). Matthews was a second team All-OVC selection a year ago, shooting a league-best 54.5 percent from the field and pulling down a Conference-high 8.5 rebounds per game while contributing a 13.7 scoring average and 47 blocked shots. Bradley led his team in scoring (15.3 ppg) and rebounding (7.6 rpg), ranking sixth in the league in both categories. Gulina dished out 55 assists last season and was second on his team in scoring (12.6 ppg), while Fisher averaged a team-high 12.9 points a game to go with 64 assists in 2005-06. Selected to the 2006-07 preseason All-OVC second team were Tennessee Tech senior guard **Belton Rivers**; Morehead State senior guard **Shaun Williams**; Samford junior center **Travis Peterson**; Eastern Illinois sophomore guard **Mike Robinson**; and Jacksonville State junior forward **Dorien Brown**.

the road include Eastern Illinois at Loyola (Chicago), Eastern Kentucky at Youngstown State, Jacksonville State at Chattanooga and Murray State at Rider. Six OVC teams will host BracketBusters games, including Morehead State hosting Bowling Green, Samford playing Evansville, Southeast Missouri against Louisiana Tech, Tennessee State playing Loyola College (Md.), Tennessee Tech hosting Northwestern State and UT Martin hosting Saint Peter's. This marks the fourth consecutive year at least one OVC team has competed in the event, as the conference holds a 6-8 record in that time frame, with Murray State's perfect 2-0 record leading the way. As part of the agreement, home teams will play a return game at the home facility of their BracketBusters series opponent in November or December of the following season.

**BracketBusters Rematches:** As part of the ESPN BracketBusters event, teams pay a return visit to the teams they hosted a year ago and vice versa. Last year the OVC was 5-6 in BracketBuster games and were 5-6 in the return matchups in 2006-07. Four of those five wins helped OVC teams avenge losses from a season ago, as Eastern Kentucky (UNC Asheville), Samford (Ohio), Southeast Missouri (UC Riverside) and Tennessee Tech (Bradley) all topped teams that had defeated them last February. Tennessee State topped Ball State for the second straight year this December.

**Early Conference Openers:** Murray State and Eastern Illinois opened the conference season on Nov. 25 with the earliest OVC Conference matchup in league history. The teams were the first squads to play a conference game nationally as well. The game was pushed up due to both schools competing in the BracketBusters event later this year; the Nov. 25 date was the only other date that worked for the teams. Murray State topped EIU 53-50.

**Nationally-Ranked Opponents:** OVC schools have competed against eight nationally-ranked teams so far this season. Samford has played the toughest schedule, battling No. 1 Florida, No. 15 Arizona and No. 17 LSU this year. Eastern Kentucky has played at No. 4 Ohio State, Tennessee State played at No. 12 Kansas and No. 6 Alabama, Austin Peay battled No. 19 Memphis and Tennessee Tech played at No. 21 Tennessee.

**Weaver Named to Las Vegas Invitational All-Tournament Team:** Tennessee State junior **Ladarius Weaver** was named to the All-Tournament team at the Las Vegas Invitational after four quality games including a 13-point performance in the team's final game against Towson. Tennessee State finished the event 2-2 with losses to Western Kentucky and No. 12 Kansas and wins over Prairie View A&M and Towson.

**Rivers Named to San Juan Shootout All-Tournament Team:** Tennessee Tech guard **Belton Rivers** was named to the All-Tournament team at the San Juan Shootout after averaging 19 points per game in contests against Northwestern, Vanderbilt and Central Florida. He had 22 points including the game-winner against Northwestern to open the tournament.

**Gulina Earns All-Tournament Honors at Hispanic College Funds Classic:** Samford's **Randall Gulina** was named to the All-Tournament Team at the Hispanic College Funds Classic hosted by LSU Dec. 27-29. Gulina averaged 15.3 points per game at the event including a game-high 26 points in the Bulldogs overtime victory over Mississippi Valley State and 14 points against No. 17 LSU.

**Samford Puts An End to Murray State's Home Court Winning Streak:** When Samford defeated Murray State 55-44 on Dec. 21, it marked the end of the Racers 15-game home court winning streak, a mark that was tied for the 11th longest nationally. The Bulldogs became the first team to win at the Regional Special Events Center since Dec. 2005. It also snapped a streak of 14 straight OVC victories at the RSEC.

**Murray State Returns the Favor:** After Samford ended Murray State's home court winning streak in December, the Racers re-paid the favor on Jan. 29, defeating the Bulldogs 57-51 in Birmingham to end Samford's 9-game home court streak.

**Samford's Tillette Named Coach of the Week by CollegeInsider.com:** Samford head coach **Jimmy Tillette** was named the nation's mid-major Coach of the Week on Dec. 27 by CollegeInsider.com. The award came after his team had won four games in a row including opening up the Conference season 3-0.

**Buzzer Beaters:** OVC schools have had their fair share of exciting finishes this season with several buzzer beaters factoring into the final outcome of games. One of the most dramatic came on Dec. 2 when Eastern Illinois' **Mike Robinson** hit a 3-pointer from just inside of half court to top Arkansas State 73-70 in Charleston. Other notable late game-winning shots include:

- Nov. 16 **Ed Horton (Murray State)** - Two free throws with 6.9 Seconds left to top Belhaven 73-72
- Nov. 29 **Anthony Fisher (Tenn. Tech)** - Lay-up with 2.5 seconds left to push Tech to 86-84 victory over Bradley

- Jan. 4 **Ray George (Murray State)** - Hit a 3-pointer with 4.0 seconds left in regulation to cap a 19-point Murray State comeback, tie the game at 70 and force overtime. The Racers eventually won 86-83 in the extra period.
- Jan. 6 **Curtis West (Samford)** - Hit two 3-pointers in the final nine seconds, including the game-winner with 1.0 second left to push Bulldogs to their second 1-pointer, buzzer-beating victory of the season over Jacksonville State
- Jan. 13 **Julian Mascoll (Eastern Kentucky)** - Hit a driving, left-handed lay-up with 5.2 seconds left to give EKU a 63-62 win over Eastern Illinois
- Jan. 24 **Michael Rembert (Southeast Missouri)** - Putback basket with 1.4 seconds remaining led Redhawks to a 61-59 victory at Morehead State.
- Jan. 25 **Andrae Belton (Tennessee State)** - Scored on a lay-up with 2.2 seconds remaining to give the Tigers a 63-62 win at Eastern Kentucky.
- Feb. 8 **Will Ginn (Jacksonville State)** - Scored on a lay-up with 11 seconds left to give JSU a 72-71 home win over Tennessee Tech.

**Sutton Given Contract Extension at Tennessee Tech:** Tennessee Tech head basketball coach Mike Sutton was given a contract extension through the 2010-11 season by the school on Dec. 22. Sutton, who is in his fifth year with the program, is the 11th head coach in program history and was named the 2005 OVC Coach of the Year after leading the Golden Eagles to the OVC Championship. Last season Tech was 19-12 and finished third in the Conference during a year Sutton bravely battled Guillain-Barre' Syndrome.

**It Has Been Pretty Close:** A little more than halfway through the Conference season, competition in the Ohio Valley Conference has been close. Through 91 Conference games, the average margin of victory has been 9.7 points per game. That includes 10 1-point games, 39 games decided by five points or less and five overtime contests.

**Morehead Exceeds Win Total From 2006 After Only Nine Games:** After only nine games this season first-year head coach **Donnie Tyndall** led his alma mater, Morehead State, to more wins than it had the entire 2005-06 season (4). The fifth win came on Dec. 18 at UT Martin (56-55). With a 70-48 win over UT Martin on Jan. 13, Morehead doubled its OVC win total (3) from a season ago. Morehead is now 10-14 overall and 6-10 in the OVC entering this week.

**Loos Becomes Winning Coach in APSU History:** Austin Peay head coach **Dave Loos** became the winningest coach in Austin Peay State University history on Jan. 13 when his team defeated Southeast Missouri 68-67 at home. That gave him 259 wins, one better than Dave Aaron. Loos' career record at APSU is now 268-231 in 17 seasons (and is 350-283 in 22 years overall). He is also among elite company that have coached in the OVC. His 266 victories at APSU (all of which were as a member of the OVC) is third all-time among all coaches who have coached in the OVC. He trails only Cal Luther (319 wins with Murray State and UT Martin) and E.A. Diddle (296 wins at Western Kentucky when the Hilltoppers were members of the OVC; it does not include his wins prior to WKU joining the Conference in 1948). The next highest active OVC coach as far as win totals goes is UT Martin's Bret Campbell (85). Loos' 17 years coaching in the OVC is second all-time, behind only Luther who coached 23 years in the Conference.

**Rivers and Fisher Rank No. 2 & 3 in OVC in Scoring:** Entering this week the Tennessee Tech backcourt duo of Belton Rivers (18.2 ppg) and Anthony Fisher (17.5 ppg) rank No. 1 and No. 3 in the OVC in scoring. The duo is currently behind Samford's Randall Gulina (18.2 ppg) - who is tied with Rivers for first in scoring, although they have ranked No. 1 and No. 2 in scoring at different points of this season (only one other team and conference - VMI of the Big South Conference - has that happening right now). The last time this happened in the OVC to finish a year was in 2000-01 when Eastern Illinois' Kyle Hill (23.8 ppg) and Henry Domercant (22.8) topped the league scoring charts.

**Austin Peay Sees Nation's Third Longest Winning Streak End:** Austin Peay had won 11

games in a row (the third longest streak nationally behind Wisconsin and Florida) until losing 77-68 at Murray State on Feb. 1. The loss was the first for the Governors since falling 80-75 against Evansville on Dec. 18. It was the team's longest winning streak since the 2003-04 season when they won 14 in a row on the way to the OVC Regular Season Championship. That year the team lost in the OVC Tournament Championship game and advanced to the second round of the NIT.

**1,000-Point Club:** Samford's **Randall Gulina** became the 20th member of his school's 1,000-Point Club on Jan. 20, as he scored 14 points in a win over Eastern Kentucky. Gulina was the first OVC Player to reach the 1,000-Point career mark this season and was joined by Tennessee Tech's **Anthony Fisher** on Jan. 27, when he scored 20 points against Tennessee State. Two days later it was UT Martin's **Cleve Woodfork** who joined the club, scoring his 1,000th point against Eastern Kentucky. Murray State's **Shawn Witherspoon** became the latest player to achieve the feat, doing so against Eastern Kentucky on Feb. 8.

**Martin Among Elite Company:** Eastern Illinois freshman **Romain Martin** is currently leading his team in scoring (14.8 ppg). He is one of just 23 freshmen nationally to be leading their teams in scoring as on Feb. 5. The nationally freshmen leader in scoring is Texas' Kevin Durant (25.1 ppg).

**Tennessee State to Hold Reunion for 1956-57 NAIA National Championship Team:** Tennessee State University will honor the members of the 1956-57 men's basketball team that won the NAIA national championship in Kansas City, Kansas. A luncheon honoring the 50 year anniversary of the team's achievement will be held at the Loew's Vanderbilt Hotel on the afternoon of February 17, 2007 and presentation ceremonies will be held at halftime of the Tigers' home game against Loyola College (MD) in conjunction with the ESPNU Bracketbuster game that evening. The 1956-57 team, coached by John McLendon, finished the season with a record 31-4 and was the first traditionally black college (HBCU) team to win a national championship competed for on a universal level. The team, mostly recruited from the Black National Negro High School tournament played in TSU's Kean's Little Garden, was led by Dick "Skull" Barnett from Gary, Indiana, expert ball handler and shooter John "Rabbit" Barnhill from Evansville, Illinois and Vernon McNeal from Chicago, Illinois. McNeal, the NAIA Tournament MVP, was the first Tennessee A&I player drafted by the National Basketball Association (Boston Celtics). Barnett is presently the only player whose jersey has been retired at TSU. John McLendon, who studied under the game's inventor James Naismith, coached at Tennessee A&I State from 1954-59, amassed a record of 144-20 (.878) while coaching the Tigers. McLendon, who also coached at Hampton Institute and North Carolina Central, is credited with inventing the "fast-break" offense as well as the "four-corner" offense made famous by Dean Smith of the University of North Carolina. There will also be a pre-game reception and reunion for the National Negro High School Basketball tournament at the Gentry Center the same evening.

**OVC Tournament Tie Breaker Procedure:** Entering the home stretch, every mens team is still alive for a spot in the 2007 O'Reilly OVC Basketball Tournament and tiebreakers may be needed at the end to determine seeds. Following is a description of the tiebreaker procedure: Regular season standings will be the determining factor in setting first-round pairings for the tournament. All ties will be broken starting at the top of the conference standings and working down. The tiebreaking system will utilize the following factors, in order, until all ties are broken. For Two-Way Ties: (1) Records in head-to-head competition are compared, with the higher seed going to the team that has won the most games against the other. (2) In the event step 1 does not resolve the tie (i.e. if the two teams split their games during the season), then the records of the tying teams against the No. 1 seed shall be compared. The team with the better record against the No. 1 seed shall gain the higher seed. (3) If the potential No. 1 seed is among tied teams, the process in step 2 will begin at the highest point in the standings which does not involve a tied team. (4) The process continues, through the No. 11 seed, if necessary. (5) In the event the tie cannot be broken, seeds will be determined by a coin flip. For Multiple Ties: (1) Composite records between the tying teams will be evaluated to determine if one team has won more games against the other tying institutions. (2) In the event step 1 does not solve the multiple ties, or reduce the multiple ties to one tie, then a comparison of records of the tying institutions against the No. 1 seed will occur. The team among the tying institutions with the better record against the No. 1 seed will receive the higher seed. (3) If the potential No. 1 seed is among tied teams, the process in step 2 will begin at the highest point in the standings which does not involve a tied team. (4) The process continues, through the No. 11 seed, if necessary. (5) In the event this process does not resolve the ties, seeding will be determined by a coin flip. Note: If a multiple tie is reduced to a tie between two teams, the two-team tiebreaker formula will then be utilized. Ties involving teams higher in the standings are always broken before ties involving teams lower in the standings.

The teleconference will run each Monday through the end of the regular season and begins at approximately 10:05 a.m. Central time.
