OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

RANDALL GULINA • G, SR., 6'1, 200 • BATON ROUGE, LA • SAMFORD

Gulina averaged 28 points and 4.5 rebounds per game while hitting 61.3% (19-of-31) from the field in games against Tennessee-Temple and Towson. Gulina had a career-high 38 points in the 83-59 win over Tennessee-Temple, as he connected on 14-of-15 shot attempts (including 11 straight to open the game). During the week he extended his consecutive games started streak to 38.

NEWCOMER

LADARIOUS WEAVER • G, JR., 6'1, 165 • NORCROSS, GA • TENNESSEE STATE

In the Tigers season opener at Western Kentucky, Weaver scored 15 points and grabbed four rebounds while hitting 6-of-18 (.333) from the field.

FRESHMAN

MAZE STALLWORTH • G/F, FR., 6-4, 185 • ELIZABETHTOWN, KY • MOREHEAD STATE

Stallworth averaged 12.0 points, 5.0 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game last week while hitting 57.1% (8-of-14) from the field in games against Asbury and South Alabama. He had nine points against Ashbury and a game-high 15 against USA. In the contest against the Jaguars, he was 5-of-6 from the field and a perfect 4-of-4 from the charity stripe.

AROUND THE OVC...

AUSTIN PEAY (0-2 overall; 0-0 OVC): Austin Peay fell to 0-2 on the season with a 80-35 loss at Big Ten foe Illinois on Tuesday...The loss marked the second largest defeat ever suffered in the **Dave Loos** Era at APSU; the largest defeat was 107-61 to Indiana in 1992-93...The Govs also matched up with Lambuth during the week, but in an exhibition game; Austin Peay won that game 106-72 to improve to 2-0 in exhibition contests this season...Sophomore **Drake Reed** had 25 points to lead all scorers in the game...After two regular season games this season, Austin Peay has 10 different players who are averaging 10 or more minutes per game; the Governors also have five players (**Drake Reed**, **Fernandez Lockett**, **Wes Channels**, **Todd Babington** and **Derek Wright**) who are playing 20 or more minutes per night...This week the team seeks its 1,000 all-time victory when it matches up with Arkansas State in Jonesboro on Friday (4:05 p.m.)

EASTERN ILLINOIS (1-4 overall; 0-0 OVC): Eastern Illinois (along with Murray State) have already played five games this young season, the most of any OVC school...EIU will host UW-Green Bay on Tuesday night before traveling to Murray State on Saturday for the first conference matchup of the season for any team; the game is the first conference game in the country this season and earliest conference opener in each program's history...The game was moved to November due to both schools participation in the ESPN Bracket Buster game on Feb. 17; another OVC game will not be played following that contest until Dec. 7...The Panthers are 4-6 all-time in OVC openers since joining the league, including a 2-5 mark in conference road openers...EIU lost 71-41 at DePaul last week in a game that saw three of its student-athletes get to return home to play in front of family and friends - sophomore **Mike Robins** (11 points), **Bobby Catchings** (6 points, 5 rebounds) and **Billy Parrish** (3 rebounds) are all from the Chicago area.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (2-1 overall; 0-0 OVC): Eastern Kentucky won its first game of last week, topping East Tennessee State (70-53) in Richmond to improve to 2-0 to start the season for the second time in three years...The week finished up with the squad traveling to Columbus to battle the nation's 4th-ranked team in Ohio State, where ECU suffered a 74-45 loss...The matchup was the first time the Colonels had faced a nationally-ranked opponent since Dec. 30, 2004 (No. 19 Louisville)...Eastern Kentucky is now 0-11 all-time against teams from the Big Ten Conference...sophomore guard **Mike Rose** had a great week for the Colonels, averaging 18 points, 2.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.5 steals per game in the two contests...Rose had a career-high 27 points in the win over ETSU while connecting on an impressive 11-of-13 (84.6%) shots; Rose hit 3-of-6 from 3-point range in the game at No. 4 Ohio State...EKU will host Division III foe Kenyon on Monday night before returning to the court on Saturday to face UNC-Asheville on the road.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (0-2 overall; 0-0 OVC): The Gamecocks played just once last week, dropping a heartbreaking 82-80 decision to Wofford at home...In that contest senior **Courtney Bradley** tied his career-high of 31 points by hitting 12-of-18 (.667) shots and pulling down 11 rebounds (six of which were offensive) to net his eighth career double-double...Junior **Dorien Brown** contributed 24 points and 11 rebounds while junior newcomer **Will Ginn** dished out 11 assists while committing no turnovers in his first game at Pete Mathews Coliseum...Jacksonville State will play twice this week, hosting NAIA foe Reinhardt on Tuesday and UMass on Saturday.

MOREHEAD STATE (1-2 overall; 0-0 OVC): The Eagles opened the home season with a 80-57 victory over Asbury College last week, giving first-year head coach his first collegiate victory at his alma mater...Last week's OVC Player of the Week, **Shaun Williams**, had 18 points and eight rebounds while **Brandon Callahan** chipped in with 14 points...The week concluded with a 70-55 loss at South Alabama...In the game against USA, freshman **Maze Stallworth** had 15 points on 5-of-6 shooting from the field and hit all four of his free throw attempts; Stallworth, who averaged 12 points and five rebounds per contest this week, was named OVC Freshman of the Week for his efforts...MSU point guard **Nic Stojakovic**, a transfer from Highland Community College, started his Eagles career with 12 assists and only five turnovers through three games this year...Junior **Ryan Allen** led the team with three blocked shots at South Alabama...Morehead State will host East Tennessee State on Tuesday, the team's only other game this week...That contest will begin a string of four out of five games at Johnson Arena between now and Dec. 17; the team's only away game in that stretch is a Dec. 2 game at Western Illinois.

MURRAY STATE (1-4 overall; 0-0 OVC): The Racers garnered their first victory of the season last week with a dramatic 73-72 victory over Belhaven at home...In that contest Murray State trailed by 11 points with eight minutes to play before beginning a full court press that forced the Blazers into seven straight turnovers; eventually senior **Ed Horten** hit the game-winning free throws with 6.9 seconds left to stretch the Racers home court winning streak to 12 straight games (the 10th best streak in the nation, tied with George Mason)...Murray has now won 17 straight home openers...Senior **Shawn Witherspoon** had nine points in the team's 62-46 loss at Southern Illinois on Sunday; he is now just 184 points away from becoming the 33rd member of the MSU 1,000-Point Club...This week the team prepares for its earliest conference opener when Murray hosts Eastern Illinois on Saturday...Murray State owns a 25-6 mark all-time against EIU and is 15-1 all-time against the Panthers at the Regional Special Events Center.

SAMFORD (1-2 overall; 0-0 OVC): The Bulldogs opened last week by cruising to an 83-59 victory over Tennessee-Temple, as head coach **Jimmy Tillette** earned his school-record 150th victory in the process; Tillette is now 150-115 all-time in his 10th season at Samford...The week concluded with a 69-62 loss at Towson; the Bulldogs trailed by as many as 12 in that contest but closed the lead to three points late in the contest, but could not overcome a career-high 41 points from Towson's Gary Neal...Samford shot only 12.5% (3-of-24) from 3-point range against Towson...Senior guard **Randall Gulina** had a big week for Samford on his way to OVC Player of the Week honors...For the week Gulina averaged 28 points and 4.5 rebounds per contest while hitting 61.3% (19-of-31) from the field and 84.6% (11-of-13) from the free throw line; Gulina had a career-high 38 points in his squad's win over Tennessee-Temple, hitting 14-of-15 from the field (including 11 consecutive baskets to open the game) and followed that with 18 points in the loss at Towson...Gulina currently shares the conference scoring lead with Jax State's Courtney Bradley...Samford will face its second nationally-ranked opponent of the year this week when the team travels to Tucson, Ariz. to battle No. 15 Arizona in a matchup that can be seen on Fox Sports Net Arizona; the team opened the season by battling No. 1 Florida.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (1-3 overall; 0-0 OVC): The Redhawks traveled to frigid Fairbanks, Alaska to compete in the B.P. Top of the World Classic last week...Southeast Missouri dropped its first two games of the event, losing 78-51 to Drake and 83-51 to Centenary before taking seventh place at the event with a 69-66 victory over the host Nanucks...The victory was the first for Scott Edgar who is in his first year with Southeast Missouri...Junior newcomer **Brandon Foust** had a good tournament, averaging 10 points, 5.7 rebounds and 2.3 assists in the three-game affair; Foust had 14 points and six assists in the Redhawks win over Alaska-Fairbanks...Southeast Missouri will open the home season on Friday night when the team places host to UC Riverside; the Redhawks will play three of its next four at the Show Me Center, including matchups with IPFW (Nov. 29) and its conference opener with UT Martin on Dec. 2.

AROUND THE OVC...

TENNESSEE STATE (0-1 overall; 0-0 OVC): Tennessee State became the final Ohio Valley Conference school to play a regular season game on Sunday, as they lost 87-69 at Western Kentucky in Bowling Green...Senior **Clarence Matthews** had 18 points, six rebounds and two steals to lead the Tigers while junior guard **Ladarious Weaver** - the OVC Newcomer of the Week - had 15 points, four rebounds and an assist...6'9" freshman center **Rashad Armstrong** was also strong in his debut, netting nine points, seven rebounds and a pair of blocked shots...The Tigers are in the midst of playing four games in the Findlay Toyota Las Vegas Invitational, of which the Western Kentucky contest was one of those four games...the event continues with a game at No. 12 Kansas on Tuesday night before the action switches to Las Vegas for the final two games; the first game in Las Vegas will be against Prairie View with the final matchup being against either Towson or Chattanooga.

TENNESSEE TECH (1-1 overall; 0-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech opened its season with a pair of games last week, topping Bluefield College 110-69 at home before losing 101-79 at Kansas State...In the Bluefield battle, four players scored in double figures while 15 different players registered at least one point; **Anthony Fisher** had 18 to lead the Golden Eagles in that matchup while **Amadi McKenzie** had a double-double with 14 points and 13 rebounds...The game at K-State was much closer than the final score indicated, as TTU trailed by just eight points with four minutes to play before the Wildcats outscored the Golden Eagles by 14 down the stretch; Fisher added 16 in that contest while **Belton Rivers** scored 21...Fisher finished the week averaging 17 points, two rebounds, two assists and one steal per game while junior newcomer **Rashaud Nixon** averaged 9.5 points and 3.5 rebounds per game while hitting .538 (7-of-13) from the field...Tennessee Tech has road contests at Ole Miss (Wednesday) and UW-Milwaukee (Sunday) before returning home to host Bradley on Nov. 29.

UT MARTIN (1-3 overall; 0-0 OVC): In its only matchup last week, UT Martin led at Southern Mississippi by a point at halftime but Southern Miss took the lead for good with 6:35 to play in sending the Skyhawks to 1-3 overall on the season; the game was tied seven times and the lead changed hands 19 times during the contest...Senior **Bubba Tolliver** had 16 points to lead the way while senior **Will Lewis** contributed eight points and a team-high nine rebounds...UTM shot 45 percent from the 3-point arch on the night as senior **Justin Flatt** hit 3-of-6 from long range...UT Martin will play a pair of Arkansas schools this week, hosting Arkansas State on Monday and traveling to Arkansas-Little Rock on Saturday.
