THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

QUENTIN PRYOR • F, SR., 6'4, 170 • EUPORA, MISS. • MOREHEAD STATE

Pryor had 24 points, eight rebounds, three assists and three blocks in the Eagles 77-56 victory over East Tennessee State last week. He connected on 8-of-11 (72.7%) of his field goal attempts, 5-of-7 (71.4%) from 3-point range and all three of his free throws. The 24 points was his career high and he scored 15 of those points in the second half as MSU pulled away.

NEWCOMER

LADARIOUS WEAVER • G, JR., 6'1, 165 • ATLANTA, GA. • TENNESSEE STATE

Weaver averaged 15 points, 2.3 rebounds and 1.7 assists per game in repeating as the Newcomer of the Week. He was named to the Las Vegas Invitational All-Tournament team after helping the Tigers to a 2-2 record at the event. Weaver had 13 points in the tournament finale against Towson, including having to fill-in at point guard due to a teammate's injury; he hit the game-clinching free throw (49-47) with two seconds on the clock to preserve the 49-47 victory. He had 13 points against No. 12 Kansas and 19 points against Prairie View.

FRESHMAN

ROMAIN MARTIN • G, FR., 6-3, 180 • MINNEAPOLIS, MINN. • EASTERN ILLINOIS

Martin averaged 17.0 points, 2.5 rebounds and 1.0 steals per game and hit 50 percent (13-of-26) from the field and 50 percent (6-of-12) from 3-point range in games against UW-Green Bay and Murray State, helping the Panthers to a 1-1 record. Martin made the driving lay-up with 30 seconds remaining that proved to be the game winner in the home victory over UWGB. In the conference opener at Murray State, Martin added 21 points, hitting 3-of-6 from 3-point range. EIU trailed the Racers 19 at one point, but Martin played a big factor in the team cutting the lead to one and losing by three.

2006-07 Ohio Valley Conference Men's Basketball Report

TEAM NOTES

AUSTIN PEAY (0-3 overall; 0-0 OVC): The Governors dropped a 77-70 decision to Arkansas State in its only matchup of last week...Austin Peay is now 0-3 on the season, the second straight year they have started 0-3; last year after a slow start the team rebounded to finish 17-14 overall...Sophomore Drake Reed had 31 points in the game, becoming the first Austin Peay player to score 30 or more since Adrian Henning had 30 against Evansville on Dec. 19, 2002...Sophomore Fernandez Lockett had 10 points and 10 rebounds against ASU, his second career double-double (he had 11 points and 16 rebounds in a game against UT Martin last season)...Junior Derek Wright had eight assists against Arkansas State, the second highest output of his career...After struggling all season from 3-point range, the Govs connected on 5-of-10 trifectas in the second half against Arkansas State...This week the team finally gets to play a home game, taking on Tennessee Wesleyan on Monday night...The Governors open OVC play on Saturday night when they host Tennessee Tech.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (2-5 overall; 0-1 OVC): The Panthers began the week with a 63-61 home victory over UW-Green Bay; in that contest freshman **Romain Martin** - this week's OVC Freshman of the Week - had 13 points including the a game-winning driving lay-up with 30 seconds remaining...EIU ended the week by opening the OVC season at Murray State, as the teams became the first conference game of the season nationally; Murray won that contest 53-50 despite 21 points from Martin, who connected on 3-of-6 from 3-point range...In that game the Panthers trailed by as many as 19 before eventually losing by only three...EIU returns to the friendly confines of Lantz Arena this week - where they are 2-0 this season to host Arkansas State (a team that has already topped a pair of OVC schools this season in Austin Peay and UT Martin)...Eastern Illinois will open OVC play on Dec. 7 when they travel to Tennessee Tech.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (4-1 overall; 0-0 OVC): EKU won both of its matchups last week, topping Kenyon College at home before traveling to UNC Asheville where the squad picked up a 73-54 victory...In the road victory the Colonels were hot from long range, hitting eight consecutive 3-pointers at one stretch of the game...Eastern held UNCA to only 30.8 percent shooting from the field, the lowest total for the Colonels under second-year head coach **Jeff Neubauer**...Sophomore **Mike Rose** contributed 24 points in the road win...EKU has been getting it done with defense this season, holding opponents to 55.8 points per game through five contests; last season Eastern allowed opponents to score 72.5 points per contest...For the week senior **Julian Mascoll** averaged 16 points and six assists per game while hitting 68.4 percent of his shots; he had a career-high 19 points in the win over Kenyon, while also dishing out a personal best eight assists...Junior **Jamaal Douglas** had a season-high 18 points in the win over Kenyon...EKU currently leads the league in scoring defense (55.8), scoring margin (+7.0), rebounding defense (26.6) and rebounding margin (+6.8)...Eastern Kentucky will continue its three-game road swing this week when it plays at James Madison on Tuesday and travels to in-state foe Western Kentucky on Saturday.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (1-3 overall; 0-0 OVC): Jacksonville State won for the first time this season with a 95-72 victory over Reinhardt last Tuesday...In that contest senior Courtney Bradley had 23 points in just 28 minutes of playing time, connecting on 10-of-16 from the field; four total Gamecocks scored in double figures in that victory...The week ended with a 101-69 loss to Massachusetts over the weekend; freshman Tracy Thomas had 13 points in 10 minutes of action off the bench in that contest...Bradley averaged 21 points, 8.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 2.0 steals per game last week and hit 45.7 percent from the field in those two contests...Will Ginn leads the conference with 6.50 assists per game...Jax State will play seven of its next nine games on the road, including both contests this week...The team will play in Williamsburg, Va. at the William & Mary Tournament, challenging host William & Mary on Friday and playing either VMI or Cornell on Saturday.

MOREHEAD STATE (2-2 overall; 0-0 OVC): Morehead State played just once last week, topping East Tennessee State 77-56 at home...Senior Shaun Williams - the OVC Player of the Week on Nov. 13 - had 16 points, 10 rebounds, four assists, three blocks and three steals in the win over ETSU...Senior Quentin Pryor, who earned this week's OVC Player of the Week honors, had a career-high 24 points in the matchup making 8-of-11 shots including an impressive 5-of-7 from 3-point range; he also blocked three shots in the game...Junior point guard Nik Stojakovic has nearly a 3-to-1 assist-to-turnover ratio through four games...As a team MSU has out-scored and out-rebounded, has a better field goal percentage, more assists and steals and fewer turnovers that its opponents through four games...The Eagles have nine players averaging between 12.0 and 28.5 minutes per game...Morehead State hosts Marshall on Wednesday and will travel to Western Illinois on Saturday.

MURRAY STATE (2-4 overall; 1-0 OVC): The Racers opened OVC play, the earliest opening date in its history, on Saturday with a 53-50 victory at home against Eastern Illinois; MSU and EIU were the first teams to play a conference game nationally in 2006-07...the win was the 100th at the Regional Special Events Center; the Racers now have a 100-15 all-time record in that building which opened in 1998...Murray State's home court winning streak is now at 13 straight overall, a streak that is among the national leaders; the team has won 12 straight regular season OVC games at the RSEC, last losing to Tennessee Tech on Feb. 10, 2005...In the EIU game, Murray State won without a single player scoring double figures, only the fifth time that has happened since 1979; the last time it occurred and MSU won was Jan. 26 of last year when the Racers topped Tennessee Tech 55-51 - the three other times it happened Murray State lost...MSU now leads the all-time series with Eastern Illinois 16-1 in games played in Murray...The Racers play at Illinois-Chicago on Tuesday, a game that is the return game from last year's BracketBusters matchup...The week also includes a game at Tennessee on Friday which will be televised by Fox Sports Net.

SAMFORD (1-3 overall; 0-0 OVC): In its lone matchup of the week, the Bulldogs lost to their second nationally-ranked foe of the season, 86-57 at No. 15 Arizona (the team has previously lost to No. 1 Florida)...Last week's OVC Player of the Week **Randall Gulina** had 21 points, three rebounds and two assists to lead Samford; he made 6-of-7 shots in the second half while extending his consecutive starts streak to 39 games...Gulina leads the league in scoring (23.3) and free throw percentage (.889)...Junior **Travis Peterson**, a native of Glendale, Ariz., made the most of his return to Arizona, netting 10 points, five rebounds, three assists, two blocks and a steal...Samford will host Ohio on Tuesday night, a return game from last year's BracketBusters event...That game will be the last home game for the Bulldogs until Jan. 2, as the team will play seven straight on the road to close out the 2006 portion of its schedule; the week concludes with a matchup at 2006 NCAA Tournament participant South Alabama.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (2-3 overall; 0-0 OVC): In its only game of the week, Southeast Missouri opened its home schedule and topped UC Riverside 78-75 at the Show Me Center...junior transfer **Michael Rembert** had 15 points, nine rebounds and a blocked shot in the contest, while hitting 7-of-15 (47%) from the field...Freshman **Roderick Pearson** added 10 points, two rebounds, two assists and two steals for the Redhawks...In total five Southeast players scored in double figures as **Terrick Willoughby** (14), **Brandon Foust** (13) and **David Johnson** (10) also hit double-digits...**Paul Paradoski** added a team-high seven assists and did not commit a turnover...Southeast Missouri plays at Evansville on Monday night before returning home for games against independent IPFW and its OVC opener against UT Martin (Saturday night).

2006-07 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL REPORT

TENNESSEE STATE (2-2 overall; 0-0 OVC): Tennessee State completed play in the Las Vegas Invitational with a loss at No. 12 Kansas (the tournament champion who defeated No. 1 Florida in the title game) and wins against Prairie View A&M (60-49) and Towson (49-47) on the neutral court in Las Vegas...Junior newcomer **Ladarious Weaver** was named to the All-Tournament team after averaging 15 points, 2.3 rebounds and 1.7 assists per contest; he hit the game-clinching free throw in the two-point win over Towson...Weaver earned OVC Newcomer of the Week honors for the second straight week for his excellent play...Senior **Clarence Matthews** also had a big week, averaging 14.7 points, 8.3 rebounds and 1.3 assists per game; he had five blocks in the win over Towson, including two in the final 15 seconds to help preserve the victory...TSU currently leads the league in field goal defense (.391), 3-point field goal defense (.278) and blocked shots (3.75)...In their only game of the week the Tigers will battle Alabama this Saturday; the Crimson Tide are ranked sixth in this week's AP poll.

TENNESSEE TECH (2-2 overall; 0-0 OVC): Tennessee Tech opened the week with a 86-77 road loss at Mississippi before coming back with a 78-68 road victory at UW-Milwaukee...Senior **Belton Rivers** averaged 20 points in the two games last week, including a team-high 24 against Ole Miss, while also pulling down seven rebounds...Rivers was joined in double figures averages from last week by **Anthony Fisher** (18) and **Amandi McKenzie** (14)...McKenzie's 11.0 rebounds a contest and 74.1 percent (20-of-27) field goal percentage is first among OVC players to this point of the season...TTU currently leads the league in scoring offense (86.0), field goal percentage (.460), rebounding offense (45.5) and blocked shots (3.75)...The Golden Eagles will host Bradley on Wednesday before opening OVC play on Saturday night at Austin Peay.

UT MARTIN (1-5 overall; 0-0 OVC): The Skyhawks played a pair of foes from the state of Arkansas last week, losing both but only by a combined seven points...The week started with a 68-63 home loss to Arkansas State and ended with a 58-56 loss at Arkansas-Little Rock...Of UTM's five consecutive losses entering this week, three of those have been by five points or less and four by 10 points or less...Senior **Zerek Knight** led the Skyhawks with an 11.5 points per game average last week, while senior **Will Lewis** averaged 8.5 rebounds a contest...Junior newcomer **Gerald Robinson** averaged nine points and one steal per game in his two contests, both of which he started...UT Martin will host Evansville in non-conference action on Wednesday before beginning conference play on Saturday night at Southeast Missouri State.

2006-07 Predicted Order of Finish: The race for the 2006-07 Ohio Valley Conference men's basketball crown appears to be wide open, according to a preseason poll of OVC head basketball coaches and sports information directors. Samford, the 2006 OVC tournament runner-up, received nine first-place votes and 177 points to claim the top spot in the poll, edging out Tennessee State, who earned six first-place votes and 169 points to follow in second. Tennessee Tech was a close third with four first-place votes and 165 points, while defending OVC champion Murray State was selected fourth, claiming the remaining three first-place votes and 144 points. Southeast Missouri earned a fifth-place preseason selection with 134 points, followed by Austin Peay in sixth with 110 points. Rounding out the number seven through 11 spots in the poll were Jacksonville State (103 points), Eastern Kentucky (71 points), Eastern Illinois (56 points), UT Martin (53 points) and Morehead State (28 points).

Murray State's Witherspoon Headlines Preseason All-OVC Squad: According to preseason voting by the league's coaches and sports information directors, Murray State senior Shawn Witherspoon is the player to watch in 2006-07, selecting the 6-foot-5 forward as the OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Joining Witherspoon on the preseason All-OVC first team are Tennessee State senior forward Clarence Matthews; Jacksonville State senior forward Courtney Bradley; Samford senior guard Randall Gulina; and Tennessee Tech junior guard Anthony Fisher. Witherspoon earned first team All-OVC honors in 2005-06 after averaging a team-high 10.6 points per game while boasting a league-high 2.38 assist-to-turnover ratio and ranking second in the Conference in rebounding (7.7 rpg) and sixth in steals (1.68 spg). Matthews was a second team All-OVC selection a year ago, shooting a league-best 54.5 percent from the field and pulling down a Conference-high 8.5 rebounds per game while contributing a 13.7 scoring average and 47 blocked shots. Bradley led his team in scoring (15.3 ppg) and rebounding (7.6 rpg), ranking sixth in the league in both categories. Gulina dished out 55 assists last season and was second on his team in scoring (12.6 ppg), while Fisher averaged a team-high 12.9 points a game to go with 64 assists in 2005-06. Selected to the 2006-07 preseason All-OVC second team were Tennessee Tech senior guard Belton Rivers; Morehead State senior guard Shaun Williams; Samford junior center Travis Peterson; Eastern Illinois sophomore guard Mike Robinson; and Jacksonville State junior forward Dorien Brown.
