THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

ANTHONY FISHER • G, JR., 6'2, 185 • ALPHARETTA, GA. • TENNESSEE TECH
Fisher scored the winning basket with 2.9 seconds remaining and led Tech with 20 points in an 86-84 win over Bradley on Wednesday night. On Saturday, he scored 25 of his career-high 35 points in the second half to lead a Golden Eagle comeback effort at Austin Peay. For the week, he averaged 27.5 points and three assists per game while shooting 65 percent (11-for-17) from 3-point range and 63 percent (17-for-27) overall. He had 20 points and four assists against Bradley, going 7-for-10 from the field including 4-for-6 from 3-point range, and drove through the paint to hit the game-winning lay-up with 2.9 seconds to play. At APSU, he was 7-of-11 from 3-point range and had 35 points and two assists. During the final 12 minutes, he scored 20 of the team's 26 points.

Robinson led the Skyhawks in scoring in both games this past week with 13 against Evansville and then 19 against Southeast Missouri in the OVC opener for both teams. He turned in a double-double against SEMO with 19 points and 11 rebounds. For the week he averaged 16 points, 9.5 rebounds, 1.0 assists and 1.5 steals per game.

2006-07 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL REPORT

TEAM NOTES

AUSTIN PEAY (2-3 overall; 1-0 OVC): After starting the season 0-3, the Governors won a pair of contests last week, topping Tennessee Wesleyan 79-64 in its home opener and Tennessee Tech 77-70 in its conference opener...In the win over Tennessee Wesleyan, **Fernandez Lockett** had 16 points and 11 rebounds to record his second straight double-double; he narrowly missed his third straight with nine points and nine boards against Tennessee Tech...The win over TTU came thanks in part to hot shooting, as APSU hit 51 percent (26-of-51) for the game, the first time this season the squad had hit better than 42 percent from the field in a game...**Drake Reed**, a 59.1 percent free throw shooter last season, was a perfect 9-for-9 at the free throw line in the win over Tennessee Tech; as a team the Govs were 22-of-29 (75.9%) from the charity stripe in the game, the team's highest output of the season...Sophomore **J.P. Felder** had a career-high five blocks against the Golden Eagles; Austin Peay currently leads the conference in blocks shots per game (5.40)...Austin Peay continues conference play this week with a Kentucky road trip; the Govs play at Morehead State on Thursday and Eastern Kentucky on Saturday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (3-5 overall; 0-1 OVC): In its only game of the week the Panthers topped Arkansas State, a re-match from last year's BracketBuster event, 73-70 and did so in dramatic fashion...Sophomore **Mike Robinson** drained the game-winning shot, a 3-pointer from just inside half court, as time expired to push the Panthers to a perfect 3-0 at Lantz Arena this year...Robinson finished the game with 16 points, four rebounds and five steals as EIU avenged its loss to ASU from last season...Freshman **Romain Martin** had another week in garnering OVC Freshman of the Week honors for the second straight week; Martin scored 22 points on 7-of-11 shooting (3-of-4 from 3-point range) in the victory...EIU has been tough on defense this season, ranking second in the league in scoring defense (61.8 ppg), field goal percentage defense (42.4%) and 3-point percentage defense (32.1%) as well as being first in the league in turnover margin (+2.25); however, the Panthers are last in the league in scoring (57.5 ppg), which could have helped in four of their losses which came by only a combined 24 points...EIU will play at Tennessee Tech (Thursday) and Tennessee State (Saturday) this week in conference play.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (5-2 overall; 0-0 OVC): The Colonels won a big road contest at James Madison (70-66) to begin the week before suffering a loss to in-state rival Western Kentucky (78-55) in the annual "Battle of the Bluegrass"...In the win over James Madison, Eastern hit a season-best 24-of-45 (53.3%) from the field while connecting on 13 total 3-pointers...With the loss to WKU, EIU has now lost 11 straight to the Hilltoppers and have not won in Bowling Green since 1978...The Colonels did finish the month of November with a .833 winning percentage; the last time EIU had a better month was in Nov. 2004 when they were 3-0 including a 73-66 win at Dayton...Eastern currently leads the league in 3-pointers made (8.43/game), scoring defense (60.4 ppg) and rebounding defense (27.9/game)...Freshman **Adam Leonard**, who ranks fifth in the league in 3-point percentage (45.7%) averaged 13.5 points, 4.0 assists and 2.0 steals per game while hitting 55.6 percent (10-of-18) from the field and 50 percent (7-of-14) from 3-point range last week...EIU's 11.4 fouls per game is the fewest among all Division I schools...the Colonels will host Murray State (Thursday) and Austin Peay (Saturday) in league play.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (2-4 overall; 0-0 OVC): Jacksonville State played a pair of games at the William & Mary Tip-off Classic in Williamsburg, Va. last week, losing to the host Tribe (59-56) before topping VMI 87-85 to close play at the event...**Courtney Bradley**, who leads the conference in scoring (21.5) turned in another excellent week, averaging 19.5 points, 10.0 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 2.5 steals per game while hitting 56 percent (14-of-25) of his shots and 84.6 percent (11-of-13) of his free throw attempts...Bradley earned All-Tournament honors at the Classic for his play; he had 30 points and pulled in 17 rebounds, one off JSU's Division I single-game record, against VMI, including 17 points and 11 rebounds in the first half alone...Bradley also ranks among conference leaders in field goal percentage (4th - 53.8%) and free throw percentage (2nd - 88.6%)...Junior transfer **Erik Adams** also had a big tournament, averaging 15 points and 6.5 rebounds in two games; Adams had a career-high 14 points against William & Mary and followed that up with 16 points in the win over VMI...JSU currently leads the conference in rebounding (42.6/game), free throw percentage (71.7%) and steals (10.40/game)...Jacksonville State will host Samford and UT Martin in conference games this week before embarking on a five-game road swing to close the 2006 portion of its schedule; after this week the Gamecocks do not play at home until Jan. 4 (Austin Peay).

MOREHEAD STATE (3-3 overall; 0-0 OVC): The Eagles played a pair of 1-point games last week, losing to Marshall (81-80) on its home court before traveling to Macomb, Ill. and knocking off Western Illinois by a 57-56 margin...Morehead State lost to the Thundering Herd by only one despite a poor shooting night from senior **Shaun Williams**; Williams was only 1-of-11 from the field as he was limited to only 19 minutes of playing time due to foul trouble...Against WIU, the Eagles overcame a stretch of 7:33 without scoring during the second half to still win by one, marking the team's first road win of the season and snapping a five-game road losing streak dating back to last season...In the win over Western Illinois, **Quentin Pryor** hit a twisting lay-up with 0.4 left on the clock to give the Eagles the win; for the week Pryor averaged 14.5 points and 5.5 rebounds per game...Junior transfer **Brandon Callahan** averaged 12.5 points, 4.0 assists and 2.5 steals per game this week including scoring 17 against Marshall...Freshman **Maze Stallworth** averaged 11.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and hit 61.5 percent (8-of-13) from the field in the two games; he had 21 and pulled down seven boards against Marshall...The Eagles rank first in the OVC in 3-point field goal percentage (38.9%) as well as assists (16.50/game)...**Nik Stojakovic** currently ranks second in the league in assists (4.67) and leads the OVC in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.11)...Morehead, who will play six of its next eight at home, opens OVC play this week by hosting Austin Peay and Murray State.

MURRAY STATE (2-6 overall; 1-0 OVC): The Racers lost both of its contests a week ago, falling 74-68 at Illinois-Chicago (in a re-match of last year's BracketBusters contest) and losing 89-64 at Tennessee...Murray State racked up nearly 1,500 miles in their travels last week...MSU led UIC by as many as 13 points in the first half and held a lead as late of 2:10 to play in the contest before falling...The meeting with UT in Thompson-Boling Arena was the team's first time playing in the venue since the 1990 NCAA Tournament; that day the No. 16 seeded Racers nearly upset No. 1 Michigan State, falling 75-71 in overtime...This week the team returns home to host Anderson University, a Division III school out of Indiana, where they will look to extend their 13-game home court winning streak, a mark that is currently tied (with UAB) for the 11th longest in the country (Gonzaga's 44 game streak is the longest)...The week also includes OVC matchups on the road at Eastern Kentucky and Morehead State.

SAMFORD (2-4 overall; 0-0 OVC): The Bulldogs played a pair of challenging opponents last week, topping Ohio University 80-66 at home before falling to 2006 NCAA Tournament participant South Alabama 59-54 in Mobile...The South Alabama contest marked the first game of a seven-game road trip that will last until Jan. 2 (when the team hosts Tennessee Tech)...A quartet of Samford players (**Jerry Smith, Randall Gulina, Travis Peterson** and **Curtis West**) each averaged in doubles figures last week...Smith led all players by averaging 20.5 points per game while hitting 63.2 percent (12-of-19) from the field and 84.6 percent (11-of-13) from the charity stripe...Gulina, who is currently third in the OVC in scoring (20.3 ppg) averaged 14.5 last week while Peterson averaged 13.5 points and seven rebounds a game...The Bulldogs are currently first in the conference in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.23) but rank last in rebounding (27.3/game) and field goal percentage defense (49.5%)...The team's only matchup this week is at Jacksonville State on Thursday; the team has an 11-day lay-off following the game before traveling to Southeast Missouri on Dec. 19.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (3-5 overall; 1-0 OVC): After dropping a pair of non-conference matchups to begin the week (at Evansville and vs. IPFW), the Redhawks broke into the win column as they opened conference play with a 81-79 victory over UT Martin at the Show Me Center...Junior **David Johnson** played a big role in his team's come-from-behind victory over the Skyhawks...Southeast trailed by as many as 14 points and were leading 76-74 with 1:39 to play in the game...In the final 1:52 of the game, Johnson had six points, two steals, a rebound and an assist, including a 3-pointer with that put Southeast ahead for good; Johnson finished the game with 20 points, four rebounds, four assists and six steals...Newcomer **Brandon Foust** contributed 15 points, six rebounds, two assists and a pair of blocks in the victory and averaged 12.7 points and 5.7 rebounds for the week...Freshman **Marcus Rhoades** added 14 points, four rebounds and six assists in the UTM contest...Southeast currently ranks last in five conference statistical categories but is second in blocks (3.75/game) and third in 3-pointers made (7.13/game) and steals (8.63/game)...The team will travel to Tennessee State (Thursday) and Tennessee Tech (Saturday) as it continues OVC play.

TENNESSEE STATE (2-3 overall; 0-0 OVC): The Tigers played only once last week, traveling to Tuscaloosa to battle the nation's No. 6 ranked team in Alabama, losing 78-60 to the Crimson Tide...TSU played well in the first half, but hit a paltry 35 percent from the floor and a dismal 8.3 percent (1-of-12) from 3-point range; despite the poor shooting the teams were even the first 6:07 of the game before a pair of Alabama runs lengthened the lead to 13 at the break...Senior **Clarence Matthews**, who is sixth in the OVC in scoring (15.8 ppg) and seventh in rebounding (7.4 rpg), had 17 points and six rebounds in the game and held Alabama big man Richard Hendrix to four points and three rebounds below his season averages...Junior **Moraye Ivy**, making his first start of the season, had 15 points in 32 minutes of action...**Larry Turner**, who is first in the OVC in rebounding (10.0/game), registered 10 points and 11 rebounds in the loss...TSU has struggled offensively this season (ranking last or next-to-last in the OVC in scoring, field goal percentage and 3-point field goal percentage) but they have excelled in rebounding (2nd - 42.0/game) and 3-point field goal percentage defense (3rd - .324)...After playing their first five games of the season on the road, the team gets to open at home this week when they host OVC games against Southeast Missouri (Thursday) and Eastern Illinois (Saturday).

TENNESSEE TECH (3-3 overall; 0-1 OVC): The Golden Eagles split a pair of contests last week, topping 2006 NCAA Tournament participant Bradley in Cookeville before dropping its OVC opener at Austin Peay, 77-70, on Saturday...**Anthony Fisher**, this week's OVC Player of the Week after averaging 27.5 points and three assists per game, scored 20 against Bradley including hitting the game-winning basket with just 2.9 seconds remaining in the game; the victory avenged a 77-62 loss at Bradley in last year's BracketBusters event...**Belton Rivers** added 19 points while **Amadi McKenzie**, who is tied for second in the OVC in rebounding (9.3/game), added 16 points and seven rebounds...At Austin Peay, Fisher added 35 points, the second highest point total in the league this season, including scoring 20 of Tech's 26 points over the final 12 minutes of the game; Fisher, who is second in the league in scoring (20.8/game), set his new career-high on 11-of-17 shooting including 7-of-11 from 3-point range...Tennessee Tech will look for its first league victory this week when it hosts Eastern Illinois and Southeast Missouri; the home games are the last until Jan. 4 as the team will play the next five on the road including traveling to the San Juan Shootout in Puerto Rico.

UT MARTIN (1-7 overall; 0-1 OVC): The Skyhawks opened last week with a 75-57 home loss to Evansville and concluded the week with a 81-79 loss at Southeast Missouri in the conference opener for both squads...despite having lost seven games in a row since their season-opening win over High Point, Tennessee-Martin has been close in most every game, with four of their seven setbacks coming by five points or less and two of those coming by two points...Added help is on the way as two freshmen members of the OVC Champion football squad joined the basketball team last week; **Dexter Anoka** and **Bryant Craig** are both now on the roster and Anoka scored two points in the game at Southeast Missouri...Junior college transfer **Gerald Robinson** had his first double-double of the season at SEMO, registering 19 points and 11 rebounds...UTM hit only 1-of-11 from behind the arc against Southeast, with the lone 3-pointer coming from freshman **Joseph Bailey** at the buzzer...The Skyhawks currently lead the league in 3-point field goal defense (31.9%)...UTM hosts Freed-Hardeman on Tuesday before traveling to Jacksonville State this weekend to continue OVC play.

2006-07 Predicted Order of Finish: The race for the 2006-07 Ohio Valley Conference men's basketball crown appears to be wide open, according to a preseason poll of OVC head basketball coaches and sports information directors. **Samford**, the 2006 OVC tournament runner-up, received nine first-place votes and 177 points to claim the top spot in the poll, edging out **Tennessee State**, who earned six first-place votes and 169 points to follow in second. **Tennessee Tech** was a close third with four first-place votes and 165 points, while defending OVC champion **Murray State** was selected fourth, claiming the remaining three first-place votes and 144 points. **Southeast Missouri** earned a fifth-place preseason selection with 134 points, followed by **Austin Peay** in sixth with 110 points. Rounding out the number seven through 11 spots in the poll were **Jacksonville State** (103 points), **Eastern Kentucky** (71 points), **Eastern Illinois** (56 points), **UT Martin** (53 points) and **Morehead State** (28 points).

All 11 OVC Schools to Once Again Compete in ESPN BracketBusters Event: For the second consecutive season all 11 Ohio Valley Conference men's basketball teams will compete in the ESPN BracketBusters event, which this year will be held on Friday, Feb. 16 and Saturday, Feb. 17 at campus sites. The event, now in its fifth season, will feature a record 102 schools in the 51-game, two-day event. The matchups involving the 13 television games will be announced on Jan. 29 with the other matchups being announced on Jan. 31. This marks the fourth consecutive year at least one OVC team has competed in the event, as the conference holds a 6-8 record in that time frame, with Murray State's perfect 2-0 record leading the way. Six OVC teams (Morehead State, Samford, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin) will host games while Austin Peay, Murray State, Eastern Illinois, Eastern Kentucky and Jacksonville State will play road contests. As part of the agreement, home teams will play a return game at the home facility of their BracketBusters series opponent in November or December of the following season.

BrackerBuster Rematches: As part of the BracketBusters event, teams pay a return visit to the teams they hosted a year ago and vice versa. Last year the OVC was 5-6 in BracketBuster games and so far are 4-4 in the return matchups in 2006-07 (with three games to be played before the end of the month). All four of those wins helped OVC teams avenge losses from a season ago, as Eastern Kentucky (UNC Asheville), Samford (Ohio), Southeast Missouri (UC Riverside) and Tennessee Tech (Bradley) all topped teams that had defeated them last February.

Early Conference Openers: Murray State and Eastern Illinois opened the conference season on Nov. 25 with the earliest OVC Conference matchup in league history. The teams were the first squads to play a conference game nationally as well. The game was pushed up due to both schools competing in the BracketBusters event later this year; the Nov. 25 date was the only other date that worked for the teams. Murray State topped EIU 53-50.

Nationally-Ranked Opponents: OVC schools have competed against five nationally-ranked teams so far this season. Samford has battled No. 1 Florida and No. 15 Arizona, Eastern Kentucky played at No. 4 Ohio State and Tennessee State played at No. 12 Kansas and No. 6 Alabama.

Weaver Named to Las Vegas Invitational All-Tournament Team: Tennessee State junior Ladarious Weaver was named to the All-Tournament team at the Las Vegas Invitational after four quality games including a 13-point performance in the team's final game against Towson. Tennessee State finished the event 2-2 with losses to Western Kentucky and No. 12 Kansas and wins over Prairie View A&M and Towson.
