THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

BELTON RIVERS • G, SR., 6'4, 180 • ATLANTA, GA. • TENNESSEE TECH

Rivers averaged 24.5 points, 4.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game last week while hitting 46.4 percent (13-of-28) from the field, 38.1 percent (8-of-21) from 3-point range and 15-of-22 (68.2%) from the free throw line. He scored a career-high 33 points Saturday in a 91-76 win over Southeast Missouri to give the Golden Eagles their first OVC win of the season. He shot 6-for-10 from 3-point range in that contest, and also had six rebounds and three assists. For the week, he shot 46.4 percent from the field and averaged 3.5 assists.

NEWCOMER

BRUCE CARTER • G, JR., 6'4, 200 • DETROIT, MICH. • MURRAY STATE

Carter averaged 14.5 points, 7.0 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game and hit 52 percent (13-of-25) from the field in a pair of games last week. He turned in a double-double in MSU's win at Morehead State (14 points, 11 rebounds) and hit two key shots in the last 30 seconds to secure the victory. Thursday at EKU he scored 14 on 6-of-11 shooting.

FRESHMAN

ROMAIN MARTIN • G, FR., 6-3, 180 • MINNEAPOLIS, MINN. • EASTERN ILLINOIS

Martin won the award for the third week in a row after averaging 20 points, 4.0 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game while hitting 14-of-26 (53.8%) from the field and 5-of-10 (50%) from 3-point range. Martin scored a career high 27 points on Thursday night as the Panthers won at Tennessee Tech. He was 9-of-12 from the field and 3-of-4 from 3-point range. He added 13 points at Tennessee State.

2006-07 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL REPORT

TEAM NOTES

AUSTIN PEAY (3-4 overall; 2-1 OVC): Austin Peay split a pair of road games last week, losing 70-66 at Morehead State before winning 59-57 at Eastern Kentucky...The Governors had 20 turnovers (14 in the first half) in its loss at Morehead State; the team committed 17 in the win over EKU...In that Eastern Kentucky contest, APSU let the Colonels shoot 57.1 percent in the first half but switched to a zone defense in the second half that limited EKU to 33.3 percent overall and 27.8 percent from long range...Junior point guard **Derek Wright** averaged 13 points and 2.5 assists per game last week while connecting on 7-of-8 (87.5%) from 3-point range; Wright not only forced a jump ball late in the EKU game, on the ensuing possession he hit a 3-pointer with 4.8 seconds left to give his team the lead for good and stole the inbounds pass, was fouled and hit a free throw to ice the game...Wright currently leads the Conference in 3-point percentage (61.5%) through seven games...Sophomore guard **Landon Shipley** has scored in double figures in five straight games; he scored 14 at Morehead State and 18 at Eastern Kentucky, both of which led the team...Sophomore **J.P. Felder** continues to lead the league in blocks (2.0)...As a team the Gobs are first in the league in field goal percentage (47.3%) and 3-point percentage (43.6%) in conference-only games; that is an improvement of 5.7 percent in field goals and 10 percent in 3-pointers in their all games total (7 contests)...APSU is one of the few teams with a game this week as they challenge No. 19 Memphis on Thursday.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (4-6 overall; 1-2 OVC): Eastern Illinois scored its first Conference victory of the year on Thursday, topping Tennessee Tech in Cookeville, 74-69, for the squad's first road victory of the season...Freshman **Romain Martin**, who was tabbed as OVC Freshman of the Week for the third straight week on Monday, led all scorers with 27 points (9-of-12 shooting, 4-of-5 from 3-point range) in the contest while three other players hit double figures; for the week Martin averaged 20 points, 4.0 rebounds, 1.5 assists and hit 53.8 percent (14-of-26) of his field goal attempts and 50 percent (5-of-10) of his 3-point attempts...On Saturday the Panthers were unable to make it two in a row, falling by three points, 59-56, at Tennessee State; Martin had 13 points while sophomore **Mike Robinson** added 15...Robinson leads the OVC in steals (3.50/game), a mark that is fifth nationally...EIU continues to be tough on defense, as the squad ranks first in the league in field goal defense (41.7%), 3-point percentage defense (31.6%) and turnover margin (+1.90)...The Panthers will take this week off for final exams but return to the court on Dec. 18 when they begin a 3-game home stand by hosting Eastern Kentucky.

EASTERN KENTUCKY (6-3 overall; 1-1 OVC): The Colonels began OVC play on Thursday by knocking off defending tournament champion Murray State 72-66 in a thrilling overtime contest...Sophomore **Mike Rose** hit a 3-pointer as regulation time expired to force the extra period; Rose finished the week averaging 17.5 points and 5.0 rebounds per contest and hitting 57.9 percent from the floor...The Colonels were on the other end of a late 3-pointer on Saturday, as Austin Peay took the lead with 4.8 seconds remaining on a 3-pointer on its way to a 59-57 victory; APSU scored the final eight points of regulation to win that game...Eastern shot a season-low 20 percent (5-of-25) from 3-point range against the Governors; EKU missed its first 14 3-point attempts during the game...The loss prevented EKU from improving to 2-0 in Conference play for the first time since the 1999-00 season...Junior newcomer **Jamaal Douglas** averaged 9.5 points and 5.5 rebounds per game last week and hit 6-of-7 (85.7%) of his field goal attempts...Freshman sharpshooter **Adam Leonard** has made at least two 3-pointers in every game this season...The Colonels are currently the league-leader in scoring defense (60.9 ppg), rebounding defense (27.9) and they rank second in field goal percentage (45.8%)...That field goal percentage is bolstered by senior **Julian Mascoll**, whose 59.2 percentage is second in the league...In conference-only games, Mike Rose is a perfect 9-of-9 at the free throw line, one of five OVC players to not have missed in a conference game...EKU is still tops nationally in fewest personal fouls per game (12.0)...EKU is off this week for final exams and returns to action on Dec. 18 when they travel to Charleston, Ill. to battle Eastern Illinois; that game begins a three-game road swing for the Colonels.

JACKSONVILLE STATE (2-6 overall; 0-2 OVC): The Gamecocks opened conference play by losing a pair of one-point games on its home court...The week started against Samford, which buried a 3-pointer with 3.5 seconds remaining to defeat their in-state rival 54-53...On Saturday it looked like JSU would turn the tables when senior **Courtney Bradley** connected on a 3-pointer with seven seconds left to give his team a one-point lead; but UT Martin sank a runner from the right side of the court with one second left to send the Gamecocks to the 70-69 loss...JSU's last three losses have come by a combined five points and four of their six losses this season have come by only seven total points...Freshman guard **Tracy Thomas** was the team's top scorer in both contests last week, notching a then career-high 15 against Samford before topping that with a career-high 19 against UT Martin; Thomas hit three 3-pointers in each contest and averaged 17 points for the week...JSU leads the OVC in free throw percentage (70.4%) and steals (9.88/game)...Bradley has slipped to third in the league in points per game (19.4) and rebounds (8.9)...Bradley (third) and **Will Ginn** (first) are at the top of the Conference in free throw shooting while **DeAndre Bray**, fresh off a league season best 12-assist performance against UT Martin, leads the OVC in that category (5.88 assists/game), while Ginn is second (4.88/game)...Jacksonville State will play one of the rare games this week and is involved in the only OVC matchup; the Gamecocks travel to Southeast Missouri State for a 4:30 p.m. game on Sunday.

MOREHEAD STATE (4-4 overall; 1-1 OVC): Morehead State opened OVC play with a 70-66 victory over Austin Peay and concluded the week with a 70-67 loss at home to Murray State...In the win over Austin Peay, senior **Quentin Pryor** had 20 points on 8-of-12 shooting and senior **Shaun Williams** added 15 points as the Eagles matched their win total (4) from the entire 2005-06 season...In the team's loss to Murray State, the game was tied at 65 with 1:32 to play before a Rob Kennedy lay-up put the Racers on top for good...Williams had 19 points and 10 rebounds in the loss as he netted his second double-double of the season...For the week Williams averaged 17 points, 7.5 rebounds and 2.0 assists per game...Freshman **Maze Stallworth** averaged 10 points and 1.5 steals per game in last week's games...The Eagles, who are a bit on the smallish side this year, currently hold a +7.5 rebounding advantage in its two OVC games; on the season MSU is out-rebounding opponents by 4.5 rebounds per contest...Morehead State currently leads the league in 3-point percentage (38.4%), assists (16.63/game) and rebounding margin (+4.5)...The Eagles take eight days off for final exams before traveling to UT Martin on Dec. 18.

MURRAY STATE (3-7 overall; 2-1 OVC): Murray State split a pair of games on its Eastern Kentucky/Morehead State road trip and now sit at 2-1 in the standings, tied with Austin Peay for third overall...The Racers were the victims of a last second 3-pointer at EKU, as Mike Rose forced overtime with a 3-pointer and Eastern went on to score a 72-66 win...Murray State led that contest at halftime, 33-23, as junior **Tyler Holloway** scored 13 points in the first half (and 16 for the game)...At Morehead State, junior **Bruce Carter** had his first double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds to help his squad to a 70-67 victory; Carter averaged 14.5 points, 7.0 rebounds and 1.5 assists per game last week and hit on 52 percent of his field goal attempts on his way to OVC Newcomer of the Week honors...**Rob Kennedy** also scored 14 points, none bigger than a lay-up with 1:32 to play that broke a 65-65 tie and sent the Racers to the victory...Holloway scored 11 points at Morehead State and finished the week with a 13.5 points per game average...Senior **Shawn Witherspoon** added 23 total points during the week and is now only 124 points away from joining the MSU 1,000-Point Club...The Racers are off for final exams and will not return to action until Dec. 19 when they host Jacksonville State; MSU currently has a 14-game home court winning streak, the 11th longest streak nationally.

2006-07 OHIO VALLEY CONFERENCE MEN'S BASKETBALL REPORT

SAMFORD (3-4 overall; 1-0 OVC): The Bulldogs played just once last week and won their OVC opener, topping rival Jacksonville State 54-53 on a last second shot...**Joe Ross Merritt** was the Samford player to come through with the heroics, draining a 3-pointer with 3.5 seconds remaining; Merritt scored 11 of his 13 points in the second half and knocked down a team-high three 3-pointers, grabbed three rebounds and dished out three assists...Samford is one of just two Conference schools (Tennessee State at 2-0 is the other) to not have a conference loss after the opening weekend-plus of play...The road victory was the first of the year for Samford and they have now won four of five against JSU...Senior point guard **Jerry Smith** had a career-high 11 rebounds in the victory and also dished out six helpers...Samford leads the OVC in 3-pointers made (8.00/game) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.12)...Senior **Randall Gulina** now leads the Conference in scoring, averaging 19.9 points through seven games...Samford, who does not play a home game during December, is off until Dec. 19 when they travel to Cape Girardeau to battle Southeast Missouri; the team continues its 7-game road swing until Jan. 2 when they host Tennessee Tech.

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (3-7 overall; 1-2 OVC): Southeast Missouri continued OVC play this week by dropping road games at Tennessee State (75-72) and Tennessee Tech (91-76) last week...Tennessee State built an 11-point lead against the Redhawks but had to hold on late as Southeast Missouri fought until the end...It was freshman **Marcus Rhodes** who was the catalyst, scoring a career-high 17 points and grabbing five rebounds in helping lead his team back...Southeast trailed by three points with 1:16 to play but could not capitalize on six TSU missed free throws...The team's Achilles Heel was free throws, as they managed just 14-of-25 (56%) from the charity stripe on the night; the Redhawks currently rank last in the OVC in free throw percentage (57.4%)...On Saturday **David Johnson** scored 15 points and Rhodes added 11 but it was not enough as the team could not hold onto a 42-39 halftime lead on its way to the defeat...Rhodes finished the week by averaging 14 points, 2.0 assists and 1.5 steals per game...The Redhawks play host to the only Conference matchup of the week, challenging Jacksonville State on Sunday (Dec. 17).

TENNESSEE STATE (4-4 overall; 2-0 OVC): After the first full weekend of Conference play, the Tigers find themselves atop the standings with a perfect 2-0 record...TSU is 2-0 in the league for the first time since the 2003-04 season and only the fourth time since 1994-95 (including the 1994-95, 2001-02 and 2003-04 seasons)...After playing their first six games of the season on the road (including a 67-56 loss at regional foe Middle Tennessee to start the week), Tennessee State made the most of the Gentry Center last week, topping Southeast Missouri 75-72 and Eastern Illinois 59-56...Against Southeast, TSU built a nine-point halftime lead and led by as many as 12 before letting the Redhawks creep back into the game; TSU led by only three in the final minute and missed six free throws to close out the game but forced a pair of SEMO turnovers in preserving the victory...On Saturday it was junior point guard **Reiley Ervin** who sparked the team by hitting 6-of-11 3-pointers including the one that broke a 51-51 tie with 3:56 to play by putting his team on top for good; three of his six trifectas came in the last six minutes of the game...For the week Ervin averaged 14.7 points, 4.0 assists and hit 9-of-22 (40.9%) from 3-point range...**Larry Turner**, who ranks second in the league in rebounding (9.4/game) had a career-high 22 points in the win over Southeast Missouri while also pulling down eight rebounds; he added 14 rebounds in the win over Eastern Illinois...TSU takes this week off for final exams but returns to action on Dec. 19 when they travel to Auburn; Tennessee State does not play another conference game until Jan. 2 at Morehead State.

TENNESSEE TECH (4-4 overall; 1-2 OVC): Tennessee Tech dropped a 74-69 decision at home to Eastern Illinois to begin the week before ending the week with a 15-point victory over Southeast Missouri (91-76) on Saturday...In the win over Southeast, the backcourt duo of **Belton Rivers** and **Anthony Fisher** combined for 52 points, including a career-high 33 from Rivers, who was named OVC Player of the Week for his play...For the week Rivers averaged 24.5 points, 4.0 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game...Rivers hit 6-of-10 3-pointers in the win over SEMO...Fisher's 51 percent 3-point shooting currently ranks 14th nationally...Junior **Amadi McKenzie** produced his league-leading fourth double-double of the young season with 12 points and 12 rebounds against Southeast; McKenzie leads the league in rebounding (9.5/game)...Junior newcomer **Rashaud Nixon** averaged 10 points and five rebounds during the week...TTU currently leads the league in scoring (82.5 - 12.1 points higher than the next best OVC team), field goal percentage (46.5%), rebounding (40.0/game) and scoring margin (+3.1)...Tech's 110 points earlier this season is the 11th highest point total in Division I this season...The Golden Eagles also have this week off for finals but return to action on Dec. 19 when they head to San Juan, Puerto Rico for the San Juan Shootout; Tech battles Northwestern in the first game of that event while other teams in Puerto Rico include Vanderbilt, Utah, Central Florida, Virginia, Appalachian State and Puerto Rico-Mayaguez.

UT MARTIN (3-7 overall; 1-1 OVC): UT Martin began the week with a 70-58 non-conference victory over Freed-Hardeman before beginning Conference play with a 70-69 last-second victory at Jacksonville State...It marked the first time this season the team had back-to-back victories, as the wins snapped a seven-game losing streak...The one-point victory over Jacksonville State came thanks in part to a running jumper by senior **Cleve Woodfork**, who hit the shot with six-tenths of a second left in the contest...The one-point affair was the sixth in 10 games this season for the Skyhawks who are now 2-4 in games decided by five points or less...Senior **Zerek Knight** tied his career-high with 19 points in the win over the Gamecocks...Senior **Bubba Tolliver** averaged 12.5 points, 5.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.5 steals per game last week and assisted on Woodfork's winning basket against JSU...Freshman **Dexter Anoka** hit three 3-pointers in the win over Freed-Hardeman...UTM plays only once this week due to final exams, as they play at Saint Louis University on Saturday night; they return to OVC action on Dec. 18 when they host Morehead State.

2006-07 Predicted Order of Finish: The race for the 2006-07 Ohio Valley Conference men's basketball crown appears to be wide open, according to a preseason poll of OVC head basketball coaches and sports information directors. **Samford**, the 2006 OVC tournament runner-up, received nine first-place votes and 177 points to claim the top spot in the poll, edging out **Tennessee State**, who earned six first-place votes and 169 points to follow in second. **Tennessee Tech** was a close third with four first-place votes and 165 points, while defending OVC champion **Murray State** was selected fourth, claiming the remaining three first-place votes and 144 points. **Southeast Missouri** earned a fifth-place preseason selection with 134 points, followed by **Austin Peay** in sixth with 110 points. Rounding out the number seven through 11 spots in the poll were **Jacksonville State** (103 points), **Eastern Kentucky** (71 points), **Eastern Illinois** (56 points), **UT Martin** (53 points) and **Morehead State** (28 points).

Murray State's Witherspoon Headlines Preseason All-OVC Squad: According to pre-season voting by the league's coaches and sports information directors, Murray State senior **Shawn Witherspoon** is the player to watch in 2006-07, selecting the 6-foot-5 forward as the OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Joining Witherspoon on the preseason All-OVC first team are Tennessee State senior forward **Clarence Matthews**; Jacksonville State senior forward **Courtney Bradley**; Samford senior guard **Randall Gulina**; and Tennessee Tech junior guard **Anthony Fisher**. Witherspoon earned first team All-OVC honors in 2005-06 after averaging a team-high 10.6 points per game while boasting a league-high 2.38 assist-to-turnover ratio and ranking second in the Conference in rebounding (7.7 rpg) and sixth in steals (1.68 spg). Matthews was a second team All-OVC selection a year ago, shooting a league-best 54.5 percent from the field and pulling down a Conference-high 8.5 rebounds per game while contributing a 13.7 scoring average and 47 blocked shots. Bradley led his team in scoring (15.3 ppg) and rebounding (7.6 rpg), ranking sixth in the league in both categories. Gulina dished out 55 assists last season and was second on his team in scoring (12.6 ppg), while Fisher averaged a team-high 12.9 points a game to go with 64 assists in 2005-06. Selected to the 2006-07 preseason All-OVC second team were Tennessee Tech senior guard **Belton Rivers**; Morehead State senior guard **Shaun Williams**; Samford junior center **Travis Peterson**; Eastern Illinois sophomore guard **Mike Robinson**; and Jacksonville State junior forward **Dorien Brown**.

All 11 OVC Schools to Once Again Compete in ESPN BracketBusters Event: For the second consecutive season all 11 Ohio Valley Conference men's basketball teams will compete in the ESPN BracketBusters event, which this year will be held on Friday, Feb. 16 and Saturday, Feb. 17 at campus sites. The event, now in its fifth season, will feature a record 102 schools in the 51-game, two-day event. The matchups involving the 13 television games will be announced on Jan. 29 with the other matchups being announced on Jan. 31. This marks the fourth consecutive year at least one OVC team has competed in the event, as the conference holds a 6-8 record in that time frame, with Murray State's perfect 2-0 record leading the way. Six OVC teams (Morehead State, Samford, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin) will host games while Austin Peay, Murray State, Eastern Illinois, Eastern Kentucky and Jacksonville State will play road contests. As part of the agreement, home teams will play a return game at the home facility of their BracketBusters series opponent in November or December of the following season.

BrackerBusters Rematches: As part of the BracketBusters event, teams pay a return visit to the teams they hosted a year ago and vice versa. Last year the OVC was 5-6 in BracketBuster games and so far are 4-4 in the return matchups in 2006-07 (with three games to be played before the end of the month). All four of those wins helped OVC teams avenge losses from a season ago, as Eastern Kentucky (UNC Asheville), Samford (Ohio), Southeast Missouri (UC Riverside) and Tennessee Tech (Bradley) all topped teams that had defeated them last February.

Early Conference Openers: Murray State and Eastern Illinois opened the conference season on Nov. 25 with the earliest OVC Conference matchup in league history. The teams were the first squads to play a conference game nationally as well. The game was pushed up due to both schools competing in the BracketBusters event later this year; the Nov. 25 date was the only other date that worked for the teams. Murray State topped EIU 53-50.

Nationally-Ranked Opponents: OVC schools have competed against five nationally-ranked teams so far this season. Samford has battled No. 1 Florida and No. 15 Arizona, Eastern Kentucky played at No. 4 Ohio State and Tennessee State played at No. 12 Kansas and No. 6 Alabama. Austin Peay will play at No. 19 Memphis this week.

Weaver Named to Las Vegas Invitational All-Tournament Team: Tennessee State junior **Ladarious Weaver** was named to the All-Tournament team at the Las Vegas Invitational after four quality games including a 13-point performance in the team's final game against Towson. Tennessee State finished the event 2-2 with losses to Western Kentucky and No. 12 Kansas and wins over Prairie View A&M and Towson.

Home Court Winning Streaks: Entering this week Murray State has won 14 straight games at home, which is tied for the 11th longest active streak in the nation. Gonzaga currently has the longest streak (45 straight), followed by UConn (27), Air Force (22), Akron (20), BYU (18), George Washington (18), Northwestern State (18), Memphis (18), UAB (16), Texas (15), and then Murray State (14) who is tied with Lipscomb and Butler. The Racers next play at home on Dec. 19 when they host Jacksonville State.
