THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

COURTNEY BRADLEY • F, SR., 6'5, 215 • UTICA, MISS. • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Bradley recorded his fourth double-double of the season (12 points, 12 rebounds), tied for tops in the OVC, and the 11th of his career to lift Jacksonville State to a 70-67 victory over Southeast Missouri on Sunday afternoon. Down one point with a minute to play, he hit a 3-pointer to give JSU a two-point advantage; the Gamecocks would eventually win on a half-court buzzer beater. Bradley had eight defensive rebounds and four offensive boards and a steal.

NEWCOMER

MICHAEL REMBERT • F, JR., 6'9, 250 • CHICAGO, ILL. • SOUTHEAST MISSOURI

Rembert had a game-high 20 points on 7-of-10 field goal shooting in Southeast Missouri's 70-67 last-second loss to Jacksonville State on Sunday. He was 6-of-11 at the free throw line and added five rebounds, an assist and a game-high three steals for the Redhawks.

FRESHMAN

TRACY THOMAS • G, FR., 6-3, 180 • CHICAGO, ILL. • JACKSONVILLE STATE

Thomas came off of the bench to score 10 points in Jacksonville State's 70-67 victory over Southeast Missouri State on Sunday. That made him one of five JSU players in double figures for the game, which was won on a half-court buzzer beater. The performance was his third straight game in double figures, giving him at least 10 points in all three OVC games this year.

TEAM NOTES

AUSTIN PEAY (3-5 overall; 2-1 OVC): Austin Peay played one of the few finals weeks games last week, traveling to No. 19 Memphis on Thursday night where the team dropped a 88-63 decision to the Tigers... Junior guard **Derek Wright** had a career-high 18 points in the contest, thanks to 2-of-4 shooting from behind the arch... Wright did not hit a 3-pointer in the first four games of the season but has connected on 10-of-17 attempts in his last four games; Wright has scored in double-digits in each of his last four games as well... Wright currently leads the OVC in 3-point percentage (58.8%)... Despite dropping the game to Memphis, APSU had 10 steals, the second time this season they have reached 10-plus steals in a game... The team also saw improved free throw shooting, hitting 20-of-27 free throws, the third time in their last four contests they've hit 70 percent or better from the charity stripe; they failed to reach that mark in the first four games of the season... Sophomore guard **Landon Shipley** had scored in double figures in five straight games which earned him a start against Memphis, but in the game he saw that streak come to an end... The Govs have a pair of non-conference games this week, hosting Evansville (7-3) on Monday and Middle Tennessee (4-5) on Wednesday; the games start a four-game home stand for Austin Peay (which also includes Marian on Dec. 28) who does not go back on the road until Jan. 4... The team's next Conference matchup is Jan. 2 when they host UT Martin.

EASTERN ILLINOIS (4-6 overall; 1-2 OVC): Eastern Illinois did not play last week, as they took the week off for final exams... The team is back in action on Monday night as they begin a three-game home stand; that home stand begins with Eastern Kentucky and continues with Morehead State on Wednesday night... EIU steps out of Conference action to continue its busy week with Western Illinois on Friday night; WIU already lost, 81-80, to another OVC school this season, Morehead State... The team's last action was on Dec. 9 when they lost 59-56 at Tennessee State; the team will have gone nine days without playing when they return to the court... Freshman **Romain Martin** has made his mark this season, winning the OVC Freshman of the Week award three straight times entering this week; Martin ranks 14th among scorers in the league (12.3 ppg), but that rises to 20.3 points per game in Conference-only games, a mark that is second in the OVC (behind Tennessee Tech's Anthony Fisher's 22.7 ppg)... Sophomore **Mike Robinson** leads the OVC in steals (3.50/game), a mark that was fifth nationally as of last week's rankings... EIU continues to be tough on defense, as the squad ranks first in the league in field goal defense (41.7%), 3-point percentage defense (31.6%) and turnover margin (+1.90)... Eastern Illinois follows this week up with a lone game at Eastern Michigan next week (Dec. 28).

EASTERN KENTUCKY (6-3 overall; 1-1 OVC): The Colonels also had last week off for final exams, as they finally return to the court on Monday night when they play at Eastern Illinois; the OVC road swing continues on Wednesday night when they play at UT Martin... EKV will then play one more road game, at in-state rival Kentucky on Dec. 30, to close out the 2006 portion of its schedule; the team next plays at home on Jan. 2 when they host Southeast Missouri... The Colonels are currently the league-leader in scoring defense (60.9 ppg), rebounding defense (27.9) and they rank second in field goal percentage (45.8%)... That field goal percentage is bolstered by senior **Julian Mascoll**, whose 59.2 percentage is second in the league, just 0.1 percentage points behind leader Cordaryl Ballard of Morehead State... In conference-only games, **Mike Rose** is a perfect 9-of-9 at the free throw line, one of five OVC players to not have missed in a conference game... EKV is still tops nationally in fewest personal fouls per game (12.0).

JACKSONVILLE STATE (3-6 overall; 1-2 OVC): The Gamecocks were on the receiving end of two buzzer beating shots that send them to a pair of defeats to open OVC play two weeks ago; last week it was time for Jacksonville State to turn the tide on its opponents and they used some buzzer beater magic to top Southeast Missouri 70-67 and win in OVC play for the first time this season and over a Division I opponent for only the second time in 2006-07... JSU had a 12-point lead early in the second half before Southeast battled back and took a four-point lead of their own; SEMO's Brandon Foust then hit a lay-up with five seconds to play to tie the contest at 70 before junior **Will Ginn** took the inbounds pass, quickly dribbled just past mid-court and let a shot fly and it found nothing but net with 0.5 seconds left, securing the dramatic victory... **Courtney Bradley** (12 points and 12 rebounds) netted his league-leading fourth double-double of the season while **Erik Adams** added his first double-double of the year (11 points, 11 rebounds)... Bradley earned OVC Player of the Week honors for his performance... **Dorien Brown** added 15 points and eight rebounds... Freshman **Tracy Thomas** scored 10 points in the contest and earned OVC Freshman of the Week honors... Bradley currently ranks fourth in the Conference in scoring (18.6) and third in rebounding (9.2); Brown is right behind Bradley in rebounding, averaging 8.3 boards per contest (4th) while ranking 13th (13.0 ppg) in scoring... **DeAndre Bray** and Ginn have given the Gamecocks a pretty good 1-2 punch in the backcourt, as Bray leads the OVC in assists (5.89 per game) and Ginn ranks fourth (4.56 per game)... JSU is second in the league in scoring (70.3 ppg) and first in both free throw percentage (71.0%) and steals (9.00/game)... Jacksonville State continues its road swing by traveling to Murray State on Tuesday night; JSU will look to snap Murray's 14-game home winning streak... JSU, which is in the midst of a five-game road trip (and a stretch where eight of nine games are away from home) will travel UW-Green Bay to play in the Oneida Casino Holiday Classic on Dec. 29-30; they will battle UWGB (Dec. 27), Bowling Green (Dec. 28) and Michigan Tech (Dec. 30) at the event before the New Year.

MOREHEAD STATE (4-4 overall; 1-1 OVC): Morehead State also had last week off thanks to final exams... The Eagles return to action on Monday night with the first of a two-game OVC road swing; that swing begins with UT Martin and continues on Wednesday night with Eastern Illinois in Charleston... Morehead last played nine days ago, as they dropped a 70-67 affair to Murray State, two days after winning their OVC opener over Austin Peay... The Eagles lead the OVC in 3-point percentage (38.4%), assists (16.63/game) and rebounding margin (+5.0)... **Cordaryl Ballard's** 59.3 percent field goal percentage currently leads the OVC... **Brandon Callahan** and **Nik Stojakovic** are currently No. 1 and No. 2 in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.64 and 2.00 respectively) entering the week and **Quentin Pryor's** 51.5 percent 3-point field goal shooting is second in the OVC... The Eagles will host Indiana South Bend on Saturday Dec. 23 and close out the 2006 portion of its schedule a week later when Central Michigan comes to town.

MURRAY STATE (3-7 overall; 2-1 OVC): Murray State, which split a pair of OVC games in action a week ago, will have had 10 days between games when it takes the court on Tuesday night to host Jacksonville State; with a victory in that contest the Racers would be the first team with three Conference victories this season... Murray State brings a 14-game winning streak at the Regional Special Events Center into the week, having not lost at home since December of last season; the streak is the 12th longest nationally entering the week... The week continues when the Racers host Samford (who is 1-0 in the OVC this season) on Thursday night... Following the Samford game the team takes off until Jan. 2 when they begin the bulk of their OVC slate of games... Senior **Shawn Witherspoon** added 23 total points during his last week of play and is now only 124 points away from joining the MSU 1,000-Point Club.

SAMFORD (3-4 overall; 1-0 OVC): Samford also had last week off for finals and is returning to the court having played only seven total games and one OVC contest this season, which are the lowest totals among all conference teams... The action is getting ready to pick up for the Bulldogs, however, who are in the midst of playing seven games (the entire month of December) away from home... Samford returns to action on Tuesday when they battle Southeast Missouri State in Conference play... Two days later they meet up with Murray State for their third Conference game

of the season...After Christmas, the team plays three games in three days at the Hispanic College Funds Classic in Baton Rouge; the Bulldogs battle Mississippi Valley State, Wright State and host LSU at the event to close out the 2006 portion of its schedule...Samford is currently 1-4 on the road this season...Senior **Randall Gulina** leads the team and OVC in scoring (19.9 ppg) and free throw percentage (86.8%)...as a team, Samford leads the OVC in 3-pointers made (8.00/game) and assist-to-turnover ratio (1.12).

SOUTHEAST MISSOURI (3-8 overall; 1-3 OVC): Southeast Missouri lost its lone game last week, falling 70-67 to Jacksonville State on a half-court buzzer beater by JSU's Will Ginn...After trailing by as many as 12 in the second half, the Redhawks battled back and took the lead from the Gamecocks...As the teams battled late, **Brandon Foust** scored with just five seconds left to tie the game at 70-70, but a quick inbounds pass and a long shot by Ginn sent Southeast to its third straight loss and fifth loss in six games...Junior newcomer **Michael Rembert** was a force for Southeast, netting a game-high 20 points on 7-of-10 shooting from the field and 6-of-11 shooting from the free throw line; that outstanding performance earned him OVC Player of the Week honors...Foust, who tied the game with his late score, had 12 points, eight rebounds, two assists and two steals...The team was without junior point guard **Paul Paradoski** who suffered a knee injury in practice earlier in the week and will miss at least a few games; Paradoski had started 53 of 56 games in his Redhawk career...The team managed just 19-of-35 (54.3%) from the free throw line, a stat that hurt them in the close game; they are currently last in the OVC in free throw percentage (56.9%) on the season...Southeast Missouri returns to action on Tuesday night when they host Samford at the Show Me Center...They continue to week with a non-conference game against Iowa State in Ames, Iowa and will play at Purdue on Dec. 30 to close out 2006.

TENNESSEE STATE (4-4 overall; 2-0 OVC): After not playing last week, the Tigers still sit atop the OVC standings with a perfect 2-0 record; they are one of two teams in the league who is undefeated (Samford is currently 1-0)...TSU is 2-0 in the league for the first time since the 2003-04 season and only the fourth time since 1994-95 (including the 1994-95, 2001-02 and 2003-04 seasons)...TSU played its first six games of the season away from home before winning two in a row a week ago; this week they hit the road again, this time to battle the SEC's Auburn, who is 8-3 on the season and who has won four of five entering the week...Tennessee State will return home to host Ball State on Dec. 22 and close out the 2006 portion of the schedule on Dec. 28 when they travel to Siena...TSU's next OVC matchup will be on Jan. 2 when they play at Morehead State...The Tigers will bolster their already athletic lineup with the addition of 6'8 forward Jerrell Houston in the second semester; the Memphis native and transfer from Mississippi State arrived on campus last winter and sat out the past year under NCAA guidelines - the Auburn contest is the first the transfer is eligible to play.

TENNESSEE TECH (4-4 overall; 1-2 OVC): Tennessee Tech took last week off for final exams but returns this week with a treat, a trip to San Juan, Puerto Rico to compete in the San Juan Shootout...The Golden Eagles battle Northwestern in the first game of that event and will face off with Vanderbilt or host Puerto Rico-Mayaguez in the second round; other teams at the event include Utah, Central Florida, Virginia and Appalachian State...The sunny locale should help Tennessee Tech shake off the cobwebs of having not played since Dec. 9 when they topped Southeast Missouri for their first OVC victory of the season...Tech has one game after the Shootout, vs. Tennessee on Dec. 28, before the New Year...TTU currently leads the league in scoring (82.5 - 12.3 points higher than the next best OVC team), field goal percentage (46.5%), rebounding (40.0/game) and scoring margin (+3.1)...Tech's 110 points earlier this season against Bluefield College is the 11th highest point total in Division I so far this season...**Anthony Fisher** and **Belton Rivers** currently rank No. 2 and 3 respectively in the OVC in scoring (19.8 and 18.8 point per game) while Amadi McKenzie leads the league in rebounding (9.5) and is tied for the OVC lead in double-doubles (4).

UT MARTIN (3-8 overall; 1-1 OVC): UT Martin was one of only four OVC schools to play last week, as they lost 77-53 at Saint Louis in non-conference action...The loss snapped the Skyhawks two-game winning streak...Freshman **Spencer Harris** scored a season-high seven points in 24 minutes of action while **Cleve Woodfork** had a season-high 13 points and shot 60 percent from the field...UT Martin returns to the court on Monday night when they host Morehead State in the first of two Conference games this week...The week continues with the Skyhawks hosting Eastern Kentucky on Wednesday...The team will get a post-Christmas treat on Dec. 28 when they travel to Hawaii to battle the University of Hawaii.

2006-07 Predicted Order of Finish: The race for the 2006-07 Ohio Valley Conference men's basketball crown appears to be wide open, according to a preseason poll of OVC head basketball coaches and sports information directors. **Samford**, the 2006 OVC tournament runner-up, received nine first-place votes and 177 points to claim the top spot in the poll, edging out **Tennessee State**, who earned six first-place votes and 169 points to follow in second. **Tennessee Tech** was a close third with four first-place votes and 165 points, while defending OVC champion **Murray State** was selected fourth, claiming the remaining three first-place votes and 144 points. **Southeast Missouri** earned a fifth-place preseason selection with 134 points, followed by **Austin Peay** in sixth with 110 points. Rounding out the number seven through 11 spots in the poll were **Jacksonville State** (103 points), **Eastern Kentucky** (71 points), **Eastern Illinois** (56 points), **UT Martin** (53 points) and **Morehead State** (28 points).

Murray State's Witherspoon Headlines Preseason All-OVC Squad: According to pre-season voting by the league's coaches and sports information directors, Murray State senior **Shawn Witherspoon** is the player to watch in 2006-07, selecting the 6-foot-5 forward as the OVC Preseason Player of the Year. Joining Witherspoon on the preseason All-OVC first team are Tennessee State senior forward **Clarence Matthews**; Jacksonville State senior forward **Courtney Bradley**; Samford senior guard **Randall Gulina**; and Tennessee Tech junior guard **Anthony Fisher**. Witherspoon earned first team All-OVC honors in 2005-06 after averaging a team-high 10.6 points per game while boasting a league-high 2.38 assist-to-turnover ratio and ranking second in the Conference in rebounding (7.7 rpg) and sixth in steals (1.68 spg). Matthews was a second team All-OVC selection a year ago, shooting a league-best 54.5 percent from the field and pulling down a Conference-high 8.5 rebounds per game while contributing a 13.7 scoring average and 47 blocked shots. Bradley led his team in scoring (15.3 ppg) and rebounding (7.6 rpg), ranking sixth in the league in both categories. Gulina dished out 55 assists last season and was second on his team in scoring (12.6 ppg), while Fisher averaged a team-high 12.9 points a game to go with 64 assists in 2005-06. Selected to the 2006-07 preseason All-OVC second team were Tennessee Tech senior guard **Belton Rivers**; Morehead State senior guard **Shaun Williams**; Samford junior center **Travis Peterson**; Eastern Illinois sophomore guard **Mike Robinson**; and Jacksonville State junior forward **Dorien Brown**.

All 11 OVC Schools to Once Again Compete in ESPN BracketBusters Event: For the second consecutive season all 11 Ohio Valley Conference men's basketball teams will compete in the ESPN BracketBusters event, which this year will be held on Friday, Feb. 16 and Saturday, Feb. 17 at campus sites. The event, now in its fifth season, will feature a record 102 schools in the 51-game, two-day event. The matchups involving the 13 television games will be announced on Jan. 29 with the other matchups being announced on Jan. 31. This marks the fourth consecutive year at least one OVC team has competed in the event, as the conference holds a 6-8 record in that time frame, with Murray State's perfect 2-0 record leading the way. Six OVC teams (Morehead State, Samford, Southeast Missouri, Tennessee State, Tennessee Tech and UT Martin) will host games while Austin Peay, Murray State, Eastern Illinois, Eastern Kentucky and Jacksonville State will play road contests. As part of the agreement, home teams will play a return game at the home facility of their BracketBusters series opponent in November or December of the following season.

BrackerBusters Rematches: As part of the BracketBusters event, teams pay a return visit to the teams they hosted a year ago and vice versa. Last year the OVC was 5-6 in BracketBuster games and so far are 4-4 in the return matchups in 2006-07 (with three games to be played before the end of the month). All four of those wins helped OVC teams avenge losses from a season ago, as Eastern Kentucky (UNC Asheville), Samford (Ohio), Southeast Missouri (UC Riverside) and Tennessee Tech (Bradley) all topped teams that had defeated them last February.

Early Conference Openers: Murray State and Eastern Illinois opened the conference season on Nov. 25 with the earliest OVC Conference matchup in league history. The teams were the first squads to play a conference game nationally as well. The game was pushed up due to both schools competing in the BracketBusters event later this year; the Nov. 25 date was the only other date that worked for the teams. Murray State topped EIU 53-50.

Nationally-Ranked Opponents: OVC schools have competed against six nationally-ranked teams so far this season. Samford has battled No. 1 Florida and No. 15 Arizona, Eastern Kentucky played at No. 4 Ohio State, Tennessee State played at No. 12 Kansas and No. 6 Alabama and Austin Peay battled No. 19 Memphis.

Tennessee State finished the event 2-2 with losses to Western Kentucky and No. 12 Kansas and wins over Prairie View A&M and Towson.

Home Court Winning Streaks: Entering this week Murray State has won 14 straight games at home, which is tied for the 12th longest active streak in the nation. Gonzaga currently has the longest streak (45 straight), followed by UConn (28), Air Force (23), Akron (20), BYU (19), George Washington (19), Memphis (19), Northwestern State (18), UAB (16), Texas (16), Lipscomb (15) and then Murray State (14) who is tied with Butler and Texas A&M.
