THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

Matt Kole, UTIL • Sr., 6-2, 180 • Franklin, Tenn. • Austin Peay

Kole hit .500 (9-for-18) with four runs scored, four doubles, three home runs and 14 RBI in five games last week. He opened the week with a 5-for-5 performance where he had three doubles, a home run and five RBI in a victory over Memphis in a game played at Pringles Park in Jackson, Tenn. A night later he once again drove in five runs, going 2-for-5 with a double and home run in a 19-13 road win over Middle Tennessee. Those efforts earned him four walks in the first game of the Eastern Kentucky series on Saturday afternoon. In the EKU series finale, Kole was 2-for-4 with four RBI and his third home run of the week. For the week the senior slugged 1.222 and had a .560 on-base percentage.

CO-PITCHER

Mike Hoekstra, RHP • So., 6-2, 165 • Lansing, Ill. • Eastern Illinois

Hoekstra tossed a 7-inning complete game shutout in Eastern Illinois' 14-0 victory over Morehead State in game two of Saturday's doubleheader. The sophomore shut down the top home run hitting team in the league, limiting the potent Eagle offense to three hits while striking out two and walking only one. The walk came after sitting for a long stretch while the EIU offense produced a 10-run inning and was the first free pass issued by the righty in 26.1 innings.

CO-PITCHER

Stephen Hefler, RHP • Jr., 6-6, 195 • Peoria, Ill. • Eastern Kentucky

Hefler picked up a pair of victories last week as Eastern Kentucky was a perfect 5-0. In Wednesday's win at East Tennessee State the junior pitched 1.2 innings of scoreless, hitless relief to pick up the victory. He returned to the mound in game one of the Austin Peay series, scattering six hits and allowing just one earned run in seven innings of work to pick up his third victory of the season. Hefler struck out four in the 10-1 Colonel victory.

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (17-15, 3-6 OVC): It was an up-and-down week for Austin Peay, who won two road non-conference games against quality opponents (Memphis, Middle Tennessee) before being swept in OVC play at Eastern Kentucky. The week began with a 14-7 victory over Memphis in a game played at Pringles Park in Jackson, Tenn. (the site of this year's OVC Championship). The Governors notched a season-high 19 hits in that game and Matt Kole was 5-for-5 with three doubles, a home run and five RBI. That was just the start of the week for Kole who earned OVC Player of the Week honors after hitting .500 (9-for-18) with four runs scored, four doubles, three home runs and 14 RBI in the five games. The following night, in a 19-13 win over MTSU, Kole drove in five runs once again, going 2-for-5 with a double and home run. In Sunday's finale at EKU, Kole was 2-for-4 with a home run and four RBI. Adam Browett also hit the ball well, finishing the week with a .545 average (12-for-22); he leads the team with a .467 batting average in road games this season. First baseman John Hogan had 10 hits during the week and had a batting average of .455. APSU tied a school record with eight errors in the series opener at EKU. The Govs now begin a stretch where they played 11 of 12 contests at Raymond C. Hand Park. This week that includes games with No. 19 Western Kentucky and a three-game set with Jacksonville State.

Eastern Illinois (9-21, 4-5 OVC): Eastern Illinois won three of its four games last week, topping Illinois College in non-conference action before winning two of three games from Morehead State to improve to 4-5 in Conference play. The Panthers finished a seven-game home stand with a 7-2 overall mark. In the MSU opener, EIU saw its 17-game winning streak against the Eagles come to an end, as Morehead State pulled out the 6-2 victory. But Eastern rebounded to win the final two games 14-0 and 9-5. Sophomore Mike Hoekstra was named OVC co-Pitcher of the Week after tossing a 7-inning complete game shutout in the 14-0 win. The righty limited the potent MSU offense to just three hits while striking out two. Offensively Zach Borenstein hit .500 (8-for-16) with six runs scored, a double, two home runs and six RBI during the week. Borenstein had a career-high four hits in the mid-week victory over Illinois College. In the game two win over Morehead State, Eastern Illinois posted season highs of 14 runs and 17 hits. Preseason All-OVC selection Richie Derbak returned to the lineup after missing eight games due to injury and had two hits and four RBI in the Panthers 10-run fifth inning of that contest. Curt Restko now has a 13-game hitting streak, longest on the team this season. This week Eastern travels to play Illinois (a team they have won three of the last four against) and then an OVC series at Tennessee Tech this weekend.

Eastern Kentucky (17-14, 6-3 OVC): Eastern Kentucky was a perfect 5-0 last week, sweeping a non-conference set at East Tennessee and then netting its second OVC sweep of the season, taking all three games from Austin Peay at Turkey Hughes Field. The three wins put the Colonels 6-3 in OVC play, which is tied for second (just one game out of first place) entering this week's play. EKU won a 20-16 slugfest on Tuesday at ETSU and then a 7-6 decision in the series finale on Wednesday. Eastern then returned home to sweep Austin Peay by scores of 10-1, 8-4 and 15-2. It marked the sixth time in the last seven years that the Colonels have taken the series from the Governors. Junior hurler Stephen Hefler picked up two wins last week and was named OVC co-Pitcher of the Week for his efforts. Hefler pitched 1.2 innings on Wednesday at ETSU, not allowing a hit or a run in picking up the victory. In the first game of Saturday's doubleheader, Hefler scattered six hits and allowed one run in picking up his third victory of the season. Offensively junior 3B Jayson Langfels hit .471 (8-for-17) with 11 runs scored, a double, triple, two home runs, eight RBI and a stolen base in five games. Langfels scored four runs, hit a home run and drove in two in ETSU series opener. In the finale against APSU (a Colonel come-from-behind win), Langfels scored three times while also driving in two runs. Eastern Kentucky is back in action with five games this week including a neutral site game against West Virginia (in Charleston, W.Va.), a road game with Marshall and three OVC games at Morehead State.

Jacksonville State (17-15, 6-3 OVC): Jacksonville State lost an extra-inning affair with No. 19 Alabama to begin the week before dropping two of three OVC games with Murray State. The losses dropped Jax State from first place into a three-way tie for second in the league. The Gamecocks did earn its first walk-off victory of the season on Saturday, as SS Jake Sharrock laced a two-out grand slam in the bottom of the ninth inning to break a 3-3 tie and lift JSU to a 7-3 victory. Sharrock currently leads the team with a .462 batting average in nine Conference games. During the week senior 2B Bert Smith became the OVC's all-time leader in at-bats, breaking the previous record of 831 by MTSU's Clay Snellgrove. This week Smith is poised to become the league's all-time leader in hits, as he enters the week just six shy of Jeremy Johnson's OVC mark of 287. Smith leads the team with 19 stolen bases on the year and is on pace to top his school record of 31 steals set in 2007. As a team the Gamecocks are 48-of-51 in stolen base attempts on the year; the program's single season record for stolen bases is 50. JSU is now 10-0 this season when holding opponents to five runs or less. This week the Gamecocks will go on the road to battle Kennesaw State during mid-week action and conclude the week with a three-game OVC set at Austin Peay.

Morehead State (18-17, 2-4 OVC): Morehead State dropped three of four games last week away from home, losing a non-conference game to Cincinnati before losing two of three OVC games at Eastern Illinois. At UC, Morehead State led for most of the way, but gave up six runs in the bottom of the eighth inning in falling 9-7. In that game J.D. Ashbrook was 3-for-4 overall which sparked a week where he was 8-for-15 (.533) overall. That raised his season average to .438 overall, which is second in the OVC. In Sunday's finale at EIU, Ashbrook hit a pair of solo home runs. But it was the first game of the Eastern Illinois series that the Eagles broke through, winning

2010 OVC TOURNAMENT

A first is in order for the 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship. After nine years in Paducah, Ky., the tournament will be held May 26-29 (30) at Pringles Park in Jackson, Tenn. Every game of the event can be seen live and on-demand at OVCsports.TV.

Pringles Park is the home of the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx, the Double-A affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. The 6,000-seat natural grass stadium opened in 1998. The OVC and Pringles Park agreed to a three-year agreement last summer, guaranteeing the 2010, 2011 and 2012 tournaments will be held in Jackson.

This marks the 10th anniversary of the tournament being held at a neutral site; prior to the 2001 season, the event was held at campus sites.

Last season Tennessee Tech went a perfect 4-0 in the event to claim its first championship since 2001 and in the process became the first No. 5 seed under the current format to win the title. TTU topped Jacksonville State in extra innings in the title game.

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

6-2 and snapping a 17-game losing streak to EIU. Senior Michael Bottoms went the distance, allowing six hits, two runs and just one walk in nine innings while striking out five. It was the senior's third complete game of his MSU career. Taylor Davis now has a nine-game hitting streak for Morehead State. Senior SS Drew Lee is now just eight RBI away from bringing the school's all-time record. Morehead State returns to action this week with a home non-conference game with Marshall and then a three-game home OVC series with Eastern Kentucky.

Murray State (18-13, 6-3 OVC): Murray State began last week with a 12-2 loss to No. 21 Western Kentucky. The Thoroughbreds then traveled to Jacksonville State for a three-game OVC set, and came away with two wins, its first series win over Jax State since 1994 (prior to JSU being a member of the OVC) and only its second series win ever over the Gamecocks. MSU lost the first game of the Jacksonville State series 7-3 on a walk-off grand slam in the bottom of the ninth inning. But the T'Breds rebounded with 9-3 and 9-6 wins in the next two games. On Sunday it was senior reliever Matt McGaha who limited the Gamecocks to just two hits over the final three innings as the 'Breds rallied for the victory. He was also forced to hit for himself, drawing a lead-off walk and later scoring before going back out to retire the side in the ninth inning. On the season McGaha has made 14 appearances, compiling a 2-0 record and three saves while striking out 3 and walking just seven in 33.1 innings of work. His E.R.A. is the fourth-best in the OVC. Murray State will play a home-and-home series with Evansville during the week before traveling to SIU Edwardsville for a three-game weekend series.

Southeast Missouri (20-11, 7-2 OVC): Southeast Missouri began the week with a 16-11 non-conference loss to Southern Illinois, only its second home loss of the season. The Redhawks then took two of three OVC games from Tennessee Tech to improve to 7-2 in Conference play overall on the year. That puts Southeast into sole possession of first place in the league standings, a game ahead of three other teams. Southeast was led offensively by junior Casey Jones, who hit .500 (8-for-16) with five runs scored, four home runs and nine RBI in four games last week. Jones, who reached safely in nine-straight at-bats at one point of the week, hit two home runs against each Southern Illinois and in game one of the Tech series. For the week the third baseman slugged 1.250 and now leads the OVC in hitting (.447) on the season. On the mound Shae Simmons picked up a win and save for the Redhawks in his two outings, both of which came on Saturday. In both of his appearances the winning run was at the plate, but Simmons did not allow a hit while striking out two in 1.2 innings of work. Simmons has not allowed a hit in OVC play this season. Jim Klocke continues to lead the team with a 19-game hitting streak, the longest in the OVC this season. Southeast begins a 10-game road trip this week with a non-conference game at Arkansas State and three OVC contests at UT Martin.

SIU Edwardsville (8-22): SIU Edwardsville lost a mid-week game at Missouri to begin last week and then dropped two of three home games to future OVC foe UT Martin at the SimmonsCooper Complex over the weekend. Despite a Dustin Brooks home run on the first pitch of the second inning that put the team up 1-0, Mizzou had several big innings that led to a 14-3 loss. After a 7-4 loss to UT Martin in game one of that three-game set, SIUE snapped a five-game losing streak with a 6-3 victory. Dustin Quattrocchi earned the victory, improving to 3-3 on the season. He struck out three and scattered eight hits over 5.1 innings. Luke Vine pitched the final 1.2 innings of the game to pick up his first save of the season. SIUE continues its eight-game home stand with games against Saint Louis and Missouri-St. Louis during the week and a three-game set with Murray State over the weekend.

Tennessee Tech (14-19, 1-5 OVC): Tennessee Tech won two games from Lipscomb during the middle of last week and then won the final game of the Southeast Missouri series on Sunday to net the team's first OVC victory of the year. In Tuesday's 15-14 win at Lipscomb, the Golden Eagles banged out 18 hits including the 15th home run of the season by A.J. Kirby-Jones which proved to be the game-winning runs for TTU. A day later Chad Oberacker hit his second career grand slam as Tech topped Lipscomb at home 12-8. After dropping close games in Saturday's doubleheader with SEMO (11-9 and 4-3), Tennessee Tech bounced back with a 12-8 win on Saturday. Kirby-Jones hit his nation-leading 16th home run of the season in that game while Nick Price earned his first career win on the mound. Price worked five innings of relief, allowing two runs and four hits. For the week junior Casanova Donaldson hit .500 (7-for-14) with seven runs scored, two doubles, three home runs and six RBI. He did not walk a batter while striking out three. The win was the first in OVC play for the defending OVC Tournament Champions. This week Tech will entertain Belmont for a single game and Eastern Illinois for a three-game OVC set.

UT Martin (15-16, 1-5 OVC): UT Martin snapped a six-game losing streak by compiling a 3-1 record last week, topping Arkansas State mid-week before traveling to future OVC foe SIU Edwardsville and winning two of three over the weekend. The two road wins over SIUE were just the second and third of the season for the Skyhawks (who are now 3-11 on the road this year). UTM is now 5-0 this season when scoring 10 or more runs in a game. Offensively junior Wes Patterson hit .444 (8-for-18) with three runs, five doubles, a home run and 10 RBI in four games. Patterson, who has hit in eight-straight games, was 3-for-5 with two doubles, a home run and six RBI in the win over Arkansas State. He closed out the week with a three-RBI performance against SIUE. Junior closer Wes Alsup picked up a win and save in two outings last week. The save was his seventh, the second-most in the OVC. He is just one save away from tying the school record for saves in a career. In 12.1 innings of work this season, Alsup has struck out 17 and allowed just one extra base hit. Junior Trey Karlen stole four bases against SIUE and has a team-high 20 on the season. This week the Skyhawks will host Lambuth in non-conference action before entertaining league-leading Southeast Missouri in weekend action.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: Last Tuesday the NCAA released Division I Baseball Mid-Season Trends, which showed the OVC as the nation's leader in scoring (7.76 runs/game) and home runs (1.18/game) out of all conferences; the league was tied for third overall in batting average (.312)...After three weekends of Conference play, four teams are above .500 in OVC games, including Southeast Missouri who is now 7-2 overall...Murray State, Eastern Kentucky and Jacksonville State are now each 6-3 in OVC action...This weekend's Conference games include Eastern Kentucky at Morehead State, Jacksonville State at Austin Peay, Eastern Illinois at Tennessee Tech and Southeast Missouri at UT Martin; in non-conference play Murray State plays at SIUE.

The OVC in the NCAA Statistical Leaders: In this week's national statistical leaders the OVC had several teams and individuals among the leaders. As a team Southeast Missouri ranks sixth in batting average (.355) and eighth in slugging (.550) while Morehead State ranks sixth in scoring (292 runs), third in hits (375), third in home runs (2.00/game) and sixth in slugging (.566). Austin Peay ranks eighth in stolen bases (2.67/game). Individually, Tennessee Tech junior **A.J. Kirby-Jones** ranks first in home runs (0.50/game), third in slugging (.938), 12th in total bases (91), third in walks (1.18/game) and 10th in on-base percentage (.547). Murray State senior **Wes Cunningham** is first in slugging (.955), third in home runs (0.48/game), second in total bases (98) and seventh in runs (1.52/game). Morehead State senior **Drew Lee** is first in hits (56) and fifth in total bases (98). Tennessee Tech's **Chad Oberacker** is also tied for first in hits (56) while Morehead State's **J.D. Ashbrook** is first in runs (1.63/game) and eighth in total bases (92). Morehead State's **Josh Schneider** is third in victories (6) while UT Martin's **Wes Alsup** and Eastern Kentucky's **Ryne Purcell** is 12th in saves (6). The latest set of NCAA rankings will be released on Tuesday.

JSU's Smith Sets OVC Record for Career At-Bats, Closes in on OVC Mark for Hits and Games Played: Jacksonville State senior second baseman **Bert Smith** set the OVC career record for at-bats on April 7 with five at-bats against No. 19 Alabama. That gave him 833 at-bats and pushed him past Middle Tennessee's Clay Snellgrove, who had 831 career at-bats from 1994-97. Smith now has 846 total career at-bats. Smith also has 281 career hits, just six away from tying the all-time mark of 287 currently held by Jeremy Johnson, who played at Southeast Missouri State from 1997-2000. Smith has now played in 208 career games, just 16 away from equaling the mark of 224 held by MTSU's Snellgrove (1994-97).

Pringles Park to Host 2010 OVC Baseball Championship: In May 2009, the Ohio Valley Conference Board of Athletic Directors and Board of Presidents approved a plan to move the OVC Baseball Championship to Jackson, Tenn. for the next three years, beginning with the 2010 season. The six-team, double-elimination tournament will be held May 26-30 at Pringles Park, home of the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx, the AA affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. This year will mark the 31st OVC Baseball Championship. The first elimination style tournament was held in 1980, most usually being played at the site of the regular season champion. Beginning in 2001 the tournament switched to a neutral site for the first time (with the last nine championships have been held at Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky.). Pringles Park opened in 1998 and has a seating capacity of 6,000. The venue hosted the 1999 Southern League All-Star Game and will also host that event in 2011. Pringles Park also has luxury suites, a video board and merchandise shop that will be used for the championship. More information on the stadium and the Diamond Jaxx can be found at <http://www.diamondjaxx.com>. Jackson, Tenn. is located 130 miles from Nashville and 77.2 miles from Memphis on Interstate 40. Tickets for the event will be \$10 per day or \$30 for an all-session pass (up to 11 total games). There is also an \$8 a day rate for students/faculty of OVC-member schools or groups. All seats at the 6,000-seat park are general admission for the OVC Championship. Fans can purchase tickets in person at the Diamond Jaxx box office or by calling (731) 988-5299. A link to order tickets online will be available soon and posted at OVCSports.com.

OVC Players in the Pros: Entering the 2010 season, there were three players from OVC schools on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters. Austin Peay has the distinction of having two former players on teams including 2008 All-Star reliever **George Sherrill** (Baltimore) and relief pitcher **Shawn Kelley** (Seattle). Former Morehead State pitcher **Jon Rauch** is now the closer in Minnesota after being the setup man in Arizona last year. That number became four at the end of the first week of the regular season as another former OVC player - Austin Peay catcher **A.J. Ellis** - was called up from AAA by the L.A. Dodgers. One OVC school - Eastern Illinois - has two alumni who are coaching at the highest level of professional baseball. Former Panther **Kevin Seitzer** is the Kansas City Royals hitting coach with **Tim Bogar** is the Boston Red Sox third base coach.

Cunningham Named to Golden Spikes Watch List: Jacksonville State's **Todd Cunningham** has been named to the preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List, as released by USA Baseball. The watch list features 50 of the nation's top amateur talents, and it will be a "rolling" list to ensure that athletes can play themselves into consideration for the Golden Spikes Award, to be presented live on Tuesday, July 13, at the 2010 Major League Baseball All-Star FanFest in Anaheim, Calif. Cunningham, a native of Jacksonville, led the prestigious Cape Cod League with a .378 batting average after playing for the Falmouth Commodores. He also led the league in hits (59) and on-base percentage (.458) after winning the batting title by 36 points. On Tuesday, June 1, USA Baseball officials will cut the watch list of players to 30 names. The final list of 30 will then be sent to a voting body consisting of select professional baseball personnel, past USA Baseball National Team coaches, select members of the media, former USA Baseball sports information directors, and current USA Baseball staff - close to 150 voters in total.

year head coach **Jason Stein** who played at Eastern Kentucky from 1992-95 and graduated in 1997. He played against Morehead State head coach **Jay Sorg** who was at MSU from 1992-94. Ironically in the 1994 season, Sorg was named OVC Player of the Week on April 11 while Stein earned the same honor on May 2. The other coaches currently at their alma mater are Austin Peay's **Gary McClure** (1987), Murray State **Rob McDonald** (1984) and Southeast Missouri's **Mark Hogan** (1977).

Eastern Illinois Picked as Preseason Favorite: Fresh off the 2009 OVC Regular Season Championship, Eastern Illinois has been picked as the 2010 preseason favorite for the nine-team league in a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches. The overall voting in the preseason poll was close as three different teams received first-place votes. Eastern Illinois garnered three first-place votes and 59 total points in being picked the favorites. Jacksonville State got the most first-place vote (4), but finished three points (56) behind Eastern Illinois in being picked second overall. Tennessee Tech, last year's OVC Tournament Champions, picked up the other two first-place votes and finished third in the predicted order of finish with 51 points. Murray State was picked fourth (43), followed by Morehead State (33), Eastern Kentucky (26), Southeast Missouri (25), Austin Peay (22) and UT Martin (9).


Four Players Share Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year Honors: Preseason voting was so balanced in the OVC this season that four players shared the two major preseason honors. Morehead State senior shortstop **Drew Lee** and Eastern Kentucky junior third baseman **Jayson Langfels** were named OVC Preseason Co-Players of the Year while Murray State senior **Chris Craycraft** and Eastern Illinois junior **Josh Mueller** were tabbed OVC Preseason Co-Pitchers of the Year. In all, 14 players were selected to the Preseason All-OVC team. The 14 players represented seven of the nine teams who will compete for the OVC championship this season. Murray State led the way with four selections while Jacksonville State had three picks. Returning players who were first-team selections at the end of last season were automatic picks for this year's team.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: On July 1 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, Ill., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States).
