THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

Drew Lee, SS • Sr., 5-11, 185 • Mt. Sterling, Ky. • Morehead State

Lee hit .550 (11-for-20) with 12 runs scored, three doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, two stolen bases and a 1.450 slugging percentage in four Morehead State victories last week. In a mid-week win over Marshall, the senior homered, drove in three runs and scored three times as the Eagles prevailed 15-6. Lee started a weekend sweep of OVC foe Eastern Kentucky by homering three times in game one of Saturday's doubleheader. He drove in two more runs in the second game of the twin bill, bringing Saturday's RBI total to six. Lee concluded the week by adding another home run and driving in five additional runs. During the week Lee broke the Morehead State career RBI record and now has 181 for his career (27 away from the all-time OVC mark).

On Saturday the Tennessee Tech teammates each tossed a complete game shutout as the Golden Eagles swept a doubleheader (and eventually the series) from Eastern Illinois. Liberatore started the day with a nine-inning shutout of the Panthers, fanning a career-high 12 batters while walking only one in a 4-0 victory. He scattered eight total hits on the day. In game two Henry tossed a seven-inning shutout, striking out a career-high nine while allowing three hits and four walks. In the process Henry lowered his season E.R.A. to 2.53, second-best in the OVC. In total the duo struck out 21 EIU batters in 16 innings of work without allowing a run.

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (18-18, 4-8 OVC): Austin Peay opened the week with a 14-7 loss to No. 19 Western Kentucky before losing two of three to Jacksonville State over the weekend. The losses left APSU at 4-8 in OVC place which is tied for last place with Eastern Illinois. Senior utility man Matt Kole hit .600 (9-for-15) with four runs scored, a double, triples and five RBI during the week. Kole had multiple-hit games in each of the Jax State contests and was 3-for-4 with runners in scoring position in the series. Over the last two weeks the senior is batting .545 (18 hits) with 19 RBI. After losing the opener to Jacksonville State, Austin Peay came back with a 4-2 win in the middle game of the series. Ryne Harper picked up the win in the contest, allowing five hits and two runs (one earned) in 4.1 innings of work. Harper is now 4-2 on the season. The big inning for the Govs in that game was the third, where they scored three runs, two on a RBI single by Adam Browett. Austin Peay continues its home stand with a mid-week game with Belmont and a weekend series with future OVC foe SIU Edwardsville.

Eastern Illinois (9-25, 4-8 OVC): Eastern Illinois suffered a 0-4 week with a mid-week loss at Illinois and a three-game OVC sweep at the hands of Tennessee Tech. EIU is now 4-8 in league play, which is tied for last place with Austin Peay, but just four games out of first place. So far the Panthers have struggled away from home this year, going 3-23 away from Charleston and having lost 14-straight games played away from Coaches Stadium. After being shutout 4-0 and 3-0 in Saturday's doubleheader with Tennessee Tech, the Panthers struck early in Sunday's finale, scoring five times in the first inning to lead 5-0. However, after the first inning EIU only had two base runners the rest of the game. TTU would take advantage of that and scored three times in the bottom of the ninth to come-from-behind and win 6-5. It marked the team's fifth walk-off loss of the season. The team is now 2-10 in one-run games this year. The Panthers starting rotation was strong, as Mike Recchia struck out seven in the opener, Mike Hoekstra allowed only one earned run and Josh Mueller matched his season-high with eight strikeouts. One area the Panthers have excelled in is picking off base runners, as the 18 pickoffs entering this past weekend's play was ranked third nationally. Zach Borenstein has now reached base safely in 26 consecutive games. This week EIU will play Illinois at a neutral site in Mattoon, Ill. on Wednesday and then head to Murray State for three games this weekend.

Eastern Kentucky (18-18, 6-6 OVC): Eastern Kentucky lost to West Virginia at a neutral site to begin the week but rebounded with a road win over Marshall the following day. In OVC action over the weekend the Colonels lost three games to Morehead State, falling to 6-6 in Conference play this season. EKV is now 6-0 in home OVC games this year and 0-6 in away OVC contests. The scores in Morehead were 20-8, 16-4 and 21-11 as the Eagles scored 57 total runs on the EKV pitching staff. Despite suffering a sweep, Eastern is finds itself in fifth place in the OVC standings, just two games out of first place. Sophomore Jacob Daniel hit .500 (10-for-20) with nine runs scored, a double, four home runs and nine RBI. He homered against Big East foe West Virginia and then hit a grand slam in the MSU opener. Daniel finished the weekend with two more home runs. Eastern Kentucky will look to rebound with a non-conference game against the University of the Cumberlands on Tuesday and a weekend road series with UT Martin.

Jacksonville State (20-16, 8-4 OVC): Jacksonville State won a non-conference road contest over Kennesaw State to begin the week and then won two of three games at Austin Peay over the weekend. That put the Gamecocks at 8-4 in OVC play, which is tied for first place with Murray State and Southeast Missouri. During the APSU series senior second baseman Bert Smith became the OVC's all-time hits leader with his 288th hit on Saturday, passing SEMO's Jeremy Johnson (287 from 1997-00). Smith, already the league's career at-bats leader, will also soon take over the career games played mark as well. For the week Smith hit .444 (8-for-18) with two runs, a double, three RBI and four stolen bases. Smith is one of four Gamecocks who have 200 or more hits, as Smith now has 289, Daniel Adamson is at 213, Steven Leach has 204 and Todd Cunningham has 201. Cunningham, hit .462 (6-for-13) with four runs and five stolen bases in four games last week. He has now drawn a walk in 10 of his last 12 games overall. Sophomore Tanner Freshour picked up two wins in his three relief appearances last week, not allowing a run in six innings of work. He pitched four innings at Kennesaw State, allowing just one hit in the 11-4 Gamecocks victory. On Saturday against Austin Peay, Freshour entered the game and pitched 1.1 innings, allowing four hits but no runs. He is now 5-1 on the season and lowered his E.R.A. by 1.01 points on the week. The Gamecocks do not have a mid-week game this week. Instead they will prepare for a first-place showdown with Southeast Missouri State this weekend. Jax State will host the Redhawks at Rudy Abbott Field.

Morehead State (22-17, 5-4 OVC): Morehead State put up some impressive offensive numbers last week, topping Marshall 15-6 in non-conference action before sweeping OVC foe Eastern Kentucky by scores of 20-8, 16-4 and 21-11. The Eagles hit .471 as a team during the week, with 19 home runs and 64 RBI. Morehead State is now second in the OVC in batting (.343) and ranks in the Top 10 nationally in scoring, home runs and slugging. Senior Drew Lee was named OVC Player of the Week and Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week after hitting .550 (11-for-20) with 12 runs scored, three doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI and two stolen bases. Lee homered in the win over Marshall, hit three home runs in the first game of Saturday's doubleheader and added his fifth blast in Sunday's finale. For the week Lee slugged 1.450 and now leads the OVC in RBI (1.56/game). During game two of Saturday's doubleheader, Lee became the Morehead State all-time leader in RBI, and now has 181 for his career. He is just 27 away from setting the all-time OVC record in that category. Junior Trey Smith made two appearances, picking up a win and save in seven innings of work. In a week highlighted by runs, Smith allowed just three runs (two earned) while striking out eight in 7.1 innings of work. As a staff Morehead State had a 7.41 E.R.A. in four games, although its opponents had a 17.10 combined E.R.A. Taylor Davis recorded a

2010 OVC TOURNAMENT

A first is in order for the 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship. After nine years in Paducah, Ky., the tournament will be held May 26-29 (30) at Pringles Park in Jackson, Tenn. Every game of the event can be seen live and on-demand at OVCsports.TV.

Pringles Park is the home of the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx, the Double-A affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. The 6,000-seat natural grass stadium opened in 1998. The OVC and Pringles Park agreed to a three-year agreement last summer, guaranteeing the 2010, 2011 and 2012 tournaments will be held in Jackson.

This marks the 10th anniversary of the tournament being held at a neutral site; prior to the 2001 season, the event was held at campus sites.

Last season Tennessee Tech went a perfect 4-0 in the event to claim its first championship since 2001 and in the process became the first No. 5 seed under the current format to win the title. TTU topped Jacksonville State in extra innings in the title game.

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

career-high nine RBI in game one on Saturday, and has now hit safely in 13-straight contests. For the week Davis hit .667 (12-for-18) with seven runs, three doubles, a triple, two home runs and 15 RBI. Morehead State, now in fourth place in the OVC standings, will travel to Tennessee Tech (sixth place) for a weekend series.

Murray State (19-17, 6-3 OVC): Murray State lost two games (home and away) to Evansville during the week, before dropping two of three games at SIU Edwardsville over the weekend. The week started with a 20-17, 10-inning loss at home to Evansville. MSU tied the game in the bottom of the ninth on a two-out RBI triple by Tyler Monkman which forced the extra frame. The Purple Aces then scored six runs in the top of the 10 inning while Murray State managed only three in the bottom of the frame. The game saw 37 total runs, 41 hits and last just over four hours. After losing the first two games against future OVC foe SIUE, the Thoroughbreds salvaged the final game on Sunday, winning 11-6. Pitcher Alex Love improved to 5-0 on the season after allowing five runs (three earned) in six innings of work. Brandon Elliott, Wes Cunningham and Bryan Propst each had three hits in that victory. This week Murray State will play at Southern Illinois on Wednesday and then host Eastern Illinois for a three-game set at Reagan Field.

Southeast Missouri (21-14, 8-4 OVC): Southeast Missouri dropped its first three games of the week, losing in non-conference play at Arkansas State before being swept in a Saturday double-header at UT Martin. The Redhawks did end the week with a 15-1 win over the Skyhawks, which put Southeast in a three-way tie (with Jacksonville State and Murray State) for first place in the OVC. During the week Michael Adamson hit .412 (7-for-17) with four runs and six RBI. He hit his first grand slam of the season in Sunday's 15-1 win over UTM. On the season Adamson ranks fifth in the league in hitting (.420). Jim Klocke extended his hitting streak to 23 games, which now ranks fourth nationally among active streaks (the nation's leader is at 31 entering the week) at the Division I level. Also during the week Klocke was named one of 10 finalists for the Lowe's Senior CLASS award. Junior Jordan Underwood continued his recent success, picking up his third win in four outings. He pitched seven innings allowing one run, five hits and four walks while striking out four batters. Underwood lowered his season E.R.A. to 3.99, which is fifth in the OVC. The Redhawks continue to lead the OVC in hitting (.354) and are now second in pitching (6.21 ERA) and fielding (.960 fielding percentage). Southeast Missouri has a busy week ahead, playing five games including a key OVC series. During the week the Redhawks play at Southern Illinois and host Harris-Stowe and then travel to Jacksonville State for a first-place showdown.

SIU Edwardsville (12-23): SIU Edwardsville won mid-week games with Saint Louis University and Missouri-St. Louis last week and then took two of three games from future OVC foe Murray State over the weekend. In the win over local rival SLU, the Cougars collected 17 hits and took advantage of six Billiken errors in winning 17-10. SIUE put up eight runs in the second inning (including a three-run home run by Michael Hopkins) and never looked back. A day later it was sophomore Josh Hogue who tossed seven shutout innings in the win over UMSL. The righty struck out a season-high seven batters in the victory. On Saturday the Cougars recorded 5-4 and 5-2 wins over Murray State. In game one on Saturday, the Cougars had to come back from deficits twice and then hold on to the lead. In game two, Dustin Quattrocchi tossed a complete game as he struck out seven batters. So far this season SIUE has played 13 games against future OVC foes, compiling a 5-8 record. This week the Cougars will travel to Missouri State for a mid-week game and then head to Austin Peay for a three-game weekend series.

Tennessee Tech (18-19, 4-5 OVC): Tennessee Tech enters this week having won seven of its last nine games. After winning its first OVC game of the season in the Southeast Missouri State series finale last weekend, the Golden Eagles used that momentum this week, beating Belmont 15-3 at home before sweeping Eastern Illinois at home in OVC action. In the win over Belmont, junior A.J. Kirby-Jones hit his 17th home run of the season, a three-run shot that sparked Tech's offense. He would add another blast over the weekend, giving him a NCAA-leading 18 on the season. But in Saturday's doubleheader sweep of EIU it was all about pitching, as Tech won by scores of 4-0 and 3-0. Adam Liberatore started in game one, striking out a career-high while tossing a nine-inning complete game shutout. Lee Henry followed that up with a seven-inning complete game in the second contest, as he struck out a career-high nine EIU batters. The duo earned OVC Co-Pitcher of the Week honors for their impressive outings. In Sunday's finale Tech surrendered five runs in the first inning but then only allowed two EIU batters to reach base the rest of the game. Chason Choate (5.0 innings) and Stephen Pryor (3.2 innings) shutdown Eastern the rest of the way, allowing TTU to score three runs in the bottom of the ninth inning and score the 6-5 come-from-behind victory. This week the Golden Eagles play at Middle Tennessee and then host Morehead State for three games over the weekend.

UT Martin (18-17, 3-6 OVC): UT Martin won three of four games last week and is now 18-17 overall on the season. Overall the Skyhawks have won six of its last eight games and are well on pace to top the program's single-season wins mark (21 in 2009) under head coach Bubba Cates. In non-conference action UT Martin topped Lambuth 7-6 thanks in-part to an eighth inning grand slam by Trey Karlen. The Skyhawks then swept a Saturday doubleheader from first place Southeast Missouri, winning 12-4 and 6-3. The week concluded with a 15-1 loss to the Redhawks. Sophomore Jordan Owen hit .455 (5-for-11) during the week, scoring four runs, hitting two home runs and driving in six runs. He drove in five of those runs in the 12-4 win over Southeast Missouri on Saturday. Freshman Dan Tobik continues to lead the OVC in E.R.A. (2.25) as he picked up a save last week in two appearances. He struck out four of seven Lambuth batters he faced on Tuesday and on Saturday got Southeast's leading hitter to ground out and its All-American catcher to ground into a double play to escape a bases loaded, no-out jam. Junior Wes Patterson hit his 31st career home run on Saturday. He is now just one round-tripper shy of the program's all-time record; he has a team-high 10 home runs so far this season. Senior Coty Green moved into a tie for first in the OVC in victories (6) on the year. This week the Skyhawks will play at Lipscomb and then host Eastern Kentucky in OVC play.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: Morehead State and Tennessee Tech earned sweeps of its OVC opponents last week as the league standings saw a bit of a shake-up...Despite not playing a Conference series last week, Murray State is now in a three-way tie for first place in the league, sharing the top spot with Jacksonville State and Southeast Missouri...JSU and SEMO will play a weekend series in Jacksonville this weekend while Murray State dives back into OVC play by hosting Eastern Illinois...Morehead State scored 57 runs in three games against Eastern Kentucky over the weekend; MSU senior shortstop Drew Lee was named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week on Monday (the third OVC player to earn a National Player of the Week honor in 2010) after hitting .550 with 12 runs scored, five home runs (including three in one game), 14 RBI and a 1.450 slugging percentage in four Eagle victories...Lee is now just 27 RBI away from setting the OVC all-time mark in that category...Jacksonville State senior second baseman Bert Smith became the OVC's all-time hits leader on Saturday, recording his 288th hit in a game against Austin Peay; Smith passed the mark of 287 previously held by Jeremy Johnson of Southeast Missouri...Smith is already the OVC's all-time leader in at-bats and will soon break the league's all-time games played record...Southeast Missouri State senior catcher Jim Klocke enters the week with a 23-game hitting streak, the fourth-longest active streak in the country...This past week Klocke was named one of just 10 finalists for the Lowe's Senior CLASS award...Other games this coming weekend include Eastern Kentucky at UT Martin, Morehead State at Tennessee Tech and SIU Edwardsville at Austin Peay.

Lee Named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper: Morehead State senior shortstop **Drew Lee** was named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper on April 19 after an outstanding week. In four Morehead State victories Lee hit .550 (11-for-20) with 12 runs scored, three doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, two stolen bases and a 1.450 slugging percentage. In a mid-week win over Marshall, the senior homered, drove in three runs and scored three times as the Eagles prevailed 15-6. Lee started a weekend sweep of OVC foe Eastern Kentucky by homering three times in game one of Saturday's double-header. He drove in two more runs in the second game of the twin bill, bringing Saturday's RBI total to six. Lee concluded the week by adding another home run and driving in five additional runs.

JSU's Smith Sets OVC Record for Career Hits and At-Bats, Closes in on OVC Mark for Games Played: This season Jacksonville State senior second baseman **Bert Smith** has set OVC career marks for both hits and at-bats. On April 17 Smith set the record for hits, registering his 288th mark against Austin Peay and breaking the previous record of 287 held by Jeremy Johnson (Southeast Missouri, 1997-2000). Smith now has 289 career hits. On April 7 against No. 19 Alabama Smith became the OVC's all-time leader in at-bats, passing the mark of 831 career at-bats previously held by Middle Tennessee's Clay Snellgrove (1994-97). Smith now has 864 career at-bats. Smith has now played in 212 career games, just 12 away from equaling the OVC career mark of 224 held by MTSU's Snellgrove (1994-97).

Morehead State's Lee Searches for OVC Career RBI Record: Morehead State senior shortstop **Drew Lee** is approaching the OVC career RBI mark. Entering the week Lee has 181 RBI (a MSU record) and is now just 27 away from the OVC mark of 208 held by Western Kentucky's Mike Williams (1978-81).

Klocke One of 10 National Finalists for Lowe's Senior CLASS Award: Southeast Missouri State senior catcher **Jim Klocke** has been named one of 10 finalists for the 2010 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. Nationwide voting runs now through May 31 to determine the recipient of the award, which will be announced in June at the NCAA College World Series in Omaha, Neb. Fans can vote online for Klocke by going to <http://www.seniorclassaward.com> or by text messaging BASEBALL to 74567. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - classroom, character, community and competition. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. Lowe's, an official Corporate Partner of the NCAA, will announce the Senior CLASS Award winner at the NCAA College World Series® in June. At the conclusion of the regular season, the Division I national saves leader and four other relief pitching standouts will be selected as finalists and released Wednesday, June 2, prior to start of NCAA regional tournament competition. The NCBWA's All-America Committee then will select the winner, with this year's recipient to be announced on the opening day of the College World Series on June 19.

The OVC in the NCAA Statistical Leaders: In this week's national statistical leaders the OVC had several teams and individuals among the leaders. As a team Southeast Missouri ranks fifth in batting average (.357), fifth in slugging (.569) and 10th in home runs (1.58/game) while Morehead State ranks sixth in scoring (310 runs), third in home runs (1.94/game) and ninth in slugging (.553). Austin Peay ranks seventh in stolen bases (2.63/game). Individually, Tennessee Tech junior **A.J. Kirby-Jones** ranks first in home runs (0.48/game), second in slugging (.923), seventh in total bases (108), third in walks (1.15/game), seventh in on-base percentage (.556) and 12th in RBI (1.52/game). Murray State senior **Wes Cunningham** is third in slugging (.889), ninth in home runs (0.42/game), third in total bases (112) and fifth in runs (1.48/game). Tennessee Tech's **Chad Oberacker** is first in hits (65) while Morehead State's **J.D. Ashbrook** is second in runs (1.56/game), eighth in total bases (107) and eight in on-base percentage (.554). Eastern Kentucky 3B **Jayson Langfels** is eighth in slugging (.846) and 10th in total bases (104). Southeast Missouri State's **Casey Jones** is 10th in batting (.447) while teammate **Louie Haseltine** is ninth in home runs (0.42/game). Eastern Kentucky's **Ryne Purcell** is fifth in saves (8) while UT Martin's **Wes Alsup** is 10th (7). The latest set of NCAA rankings will be released on Tuesday.

Pringles Park to Host 2010 OVC Baseball Championship: In May 2009, the Ohio Valley Conference Board of Athletic Directors and Board of Presidents approved a plan to move the OVC Baseball Championship to Jackson, Tenn. for the next three years, beginning with the 2010 season. The six-team, double-elimination tournament will be held May 26-30 at Pringles Park, home of the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx, the AA affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. This year will mark the 31st OVC Baseball Championship. The first elimination style tournament was held in 1980, most usually being played at the site of the regular season champion. Beginning in 2001 the tournament switched to a neutral site for the first time (with the last nine championships have been held at Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky.). Pringles Park opened in 1998 and has a seating capacity of 6,000. The venue hosted the 1999 Southern League All-Star Game and will also host that event in 2011. Pringles Park also has luxury suites, a video board and merchandise shop that will be used for the championship. More information on the stadium and the Diamond Jaxx can be found at <http://www.diamondjaxx.com>. Jackson, Tenn. is located 130 miles from Nashville and 77.2 miles from Memphis on Interstate 40. Tickets for the event will be \$10 per day or \$30 for an all-session pass (up to 11 total games). There is also an \$8 a day rate for students/faculty of OVC-member schools or groups. All seats at the 6,000-seat park are general admission for the OVC Championship. Fans can purchase tickets in person at the Diamond Jaxx box office or by calling (731) 988-5299. A link to order tickets online will be available soon and posted at OVCSports.com.

OVC Players in the Pros: Entering the 2010 season, there were three players from OVC schools on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters. Austin Peay has the distinction of having two former players on teams including 2008 All-Star reliever **George Sherrill** (Baltimore) and relief pitcher **Shawn Kelley** (Seattle). Former Morehead State pitcher **Jon Rauch** is now the closer in Minnesota after being the setup man in Arizona last year. That number became four at the end of the first week of the regular season as another former OVC player - Austin Peay catcher **A.J. Ellis** - was called up from AAA by the L.A. Dodgers. One OVC school - Eastern Illinois - has two alumni who are coaching at the highest level of professional baseball. Former Panther **Kevin Seitzer** is the Kansas City Royals hitting coach with **Tim Bogar** is the Boston Red Sox third base coach.

Flynn Named CollegeBaseballInsider.com National Player of the Week: Coming off a week where he doubled his season home run and RBIs total, Morehead State sophomore **Cameron Flynn** was named the National Player of the Week by CollegeBaseballInsider.com on March 31. In four games the previous week, Flynn batted .588 (10-for-17) with four home runs and 16 RBI. The Lexington native smacked two doubles and one triple, scored seven runs and slugged a remarkable 1.529. He knocked in a career-high six in a mid-week win over Indiana, before homering three times and tallying nine RBI in an OVC doubleheader against Southeast Missouri State on Saturday.

Kirby-Jones Named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper: Tennessee Tech junior **A.J. Kirby-Jones** was named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper on March 15. In six games during the week Kirby-Jones hit .526 (10-for-19) with eight runs scored, two doubles, five home runs and 13 RBI. The junior had a .655 on-base percentage and a 1.421 slugging percentage for the week. In the first game of the Buffalo series, Kirby-Jones was 4-for-4

Two OVC Catchers Named to Johnny Bench Award Watch List: Two OVC catchers have been named to the 2010 Coleman Company Johnny Bench Award Watch List delivered by Papa John's Pizza and announced by The Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission. The two OVC players are Southeast Missouri State senior **Jim Klocke** and Eastern Kentucky senior **Joey Stevens**. Fifty-three catchers were nominated for the award by their coaches. Because the award is given annually to the top Division I collegiate catcher, the list will be updated to include other candidates until May 5, 2010. The watch list will be narrowed down to 10 semifinalists, whom will be announced May 19, 2010. Ballots will be sent to the national voting panel at the end of May for a vote to determine the three finalists. The finalists will be announced June 2, 2010 prior to the NCAA Regionals and Major League Baseball Draft. A final vote among the national committee will occur during the College World Series. All finalists will be brought to Wichita and the winner will be announced at the 13th Annual Greater Wichita Sports Banquet on July 1, 2010.

Cunningham Named to Golden Spikes Watch List: Jacksonville State's **Todd Cunningham** has been named to the preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List, as released by USA Baseball. The watch list features 50 of the nation's top amateur talents, and it will be a "rolling" list to ensure that athletes can play themselves into consideration for the Golden Spikes Award, to be presented live on Tuesday, July 13, at the 2010 Major League Baseball All-Star FanFest in Anaheim, Calif. Cunningham, a native of Jacksonville, led the prestigious Cape Cod League with a .378 batting average after playing for the Falmouth Commodores. He also led the league in hits (59) and on-base percentage (.458) after winning the batting title by 36 points. On Tuesday, June 1, USA Baseball officials will cut the watch list of players to 30 names. The final list of 30 will then be sent to a voting body consisting of select professional baseball personnel, past USA Baseball National Team coaches, select members of the media, former USA Baseball sports information directors, and current USA Baseball staff - close to 150 voters in total.

Five OVC Coaches Coaching at Their Alma Mater: This season five of the nine OVC head baseball coaches are currently coaching at their alma maters. That lists includes second-year head coach **Jason Stein** who played at Eastern Kentucky from 1992-95 and graduated in 1997. He played against Morehead State head coach **Jay Sorg** who was at MSU from 1992-94. Ironically in the 1994 season, Sorg was named OVC Player of the Week on April 11 while Stein earned the same honor on May 2. The other coaches currently at their alma mater are Austin Peay's **Gary McClure** (1987), Murray State **Rob McDonald** (1984) and Southeast Missouri's **Mark Hogan** (1977).


Eastern Illinois Picked as Preseason Favorite: Fresh off the 2009 OVC Regular Season Championship, Eastern Illinois has been picked as the 2010 preseason favorite for the nine-team league in a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches. The overall voting in the preseason poll was close as three different teams received first-place votes. Eastern Illinois garnered three first-place votes and 59 total points in being picked the favorites. Jacksonville State got the most first-place vote (4), but finished three points (56) behind Eastern Illinois in being picked second overall. Tennessee Tech, last year's OVC Tournament Champions, picked up the other two first-place votes and finished third in the predicted order of finish with 51 points. Murray State was picked fourth (43), followed by Morehead State (33), Eastern Kentucky (26), Southeast Missouri (25), Austin Peay (22) and UT Martin (9).

Four Players Share Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year Honors: Preseason voting was so balanced in the OVC this season that four players shared the two major preseason honors. Morehead State senior shortstop **Drew Lee** and Eastern Kentucky junior third baseman **Jayson Langfels** were named OVC Preseason Co-Players of the Year while Murray State senior **Chris Craycraft** and Eastern Illinois junior **Josh Mueller** were tabbed OVC Preseason Co-Pitchers of the Year. In all, 14 players were selected to the Preseason All-OVC team. The 14 players represented seven of the nine teams who will compete for the OVC championship this season. Murray State led the way with four selections while Jacksonville State had three picks. Returning players who were first-team selections at the end of last season were automatic picks for this year's team.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: On July 1 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, Ill., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States).
