THIS WEEK'S OVC PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

PLAYER

Casey Jones, INF • Jr., 6-1, 219 • St. Louis, Mo. • Southeast Missouri

Jones, the OVC's leading hitter at .449 on the season, hit .556 (10-for-18) with four runs scored, two doubles, two home runs and 14 RBI in four games last week as Southeast Missouri went a perfect 4-0 and took over sole possession of first place in the league. In a 13-1 road victory over rival Southern Illinois, Jones was 4-for-6 with six RBI. He followed that with a 2-for-4 performance against Harris-Stowe, where he hit a home run and drove in four runs. In Sunday's doubleheader sweep of Jacksonville State, Jones combined to go 4-for-8 with three runs scored, four RBI, two doubles and a home run. Jones also leads the OVC in RBI (1.56/game) and has a current 13-game hitting streak, which ranks second in the OVC.

PITCHER

Nick Thomas, RHP • Jr., 6-1, 223 • Plano, Texas • Southeast Missouri

Thomas picked up a pair of two wins in a pair of appearances last week, improving to a perfect 6-0 on the season. In the week's opener, a 13-1 road win over rival Southern Illinois, Thomas scattered four hits over six innings, did not allow a run, struck out six and did not walk a batter. Five days later in the first game of a doubleheader with co-league leader Jacksonville State, Thomas entered the game in the second inning and pitched the final six innings, allowing seven hits and four runs while striking out six and walking only one. Southeast Missouri won that game 10-5 and would go on to sweep the doubleheader and claim sole possession of first place. Thomas is now second in the league in wins (6) and eighth in E.R.A. (4.58).

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (21-18, 4-8 OVC): Austin Peay had the week from Conference action but did compile a 3-0 non-conference mark, topping Belmont 17-14 and sweeping a Sunday doubleheader from future OVC foe SIU Edwardsville. Senior Matt Kole continued his torrid offensive streak, hitting .455 (5-for-11) with four runs, two home runs and six RBI last week. Over his last 12 games (dating back to a game with Memphis on April 6) Kole is hitting .523 (23-for-44) with 12 runs, five doubles, five home runs, 25 RBI and a 1.068 slugging percentage. Chris Lewellyn also added to the offensive attack, driving in six runs himself during the week. After the 31 combined runs in the Belmont victory, the Governors hosted SIUE in Clarksville. Saturday's games were rained out, forcing a Sunday doubleheader. The Govs won the games by 5-2 and 6-5 margins. Game one starter Ricky Marshall held the Cougars scoreless through six innings before surrendering two seventh innings runs. Overall he allowed two runs on six hits while striking out three in the seven-inning complete game effort. Marshall got a lot of help from the Austin Peay defense that had four double plays in the game. This week the Govs will host nationally-ranked Vanderbilt and travel to Belmont during the mid-week schedule, before hosting Morehead State for a crucial three-game series this weekend. APSU finds itself tied for last place in the league, but are just 1.5 games behind Morehead State in the standings.

Eastern Illinois (11-26, 6-8 OVC): Eastern Illinois began last week with a 6-5 extra innings loss to Illinois at a game played at a neutral site in Mattoon, Ill. Zach Borenstein, who hit three home runs during the week, hit a shot in the ninth inning to go ahead by a run, but the Illini tied the game with two outs in the bottom of the inning and went on to win in the 10th inning. That dropped Eastern to just 2-11 in one-run games this season. But the Panthers re-grouped and won two games at Murray State over the weekend (the third game in the series was rained out). The wins moved the Panthers from the cellar and into seventh place in the league standings. The wins also snapped a 15-game losing streak in games away from Charleston and marked only the fourth and fifth of the year in true road contests for Eastern Illinois. Borenstein homered in each of the Murray State games and for the week hit .500 (7-for-14) with four runs scored, three home runs and six RBI. He has now reached base safely in 29-straight games and homered in three straight contests. On the mound Josh Mueller matched his career-high with 10 strikeouts against Murray State. He earned his first victory of the season in the game and his third career complete game. Mike Recchia earned his first career save by pitching the final 2.1 innings in the second game of Sunday's doubleheader sweep. Cam Strang extended his hitting streak to a season-best 10 games. This week the Panthers will take on Big 12 foe Missouri at a neutral site in O'Fallon, Mo. on Tuesday. On Wednesday EIU will host Southern Illinois and then stay home to play a three-game OVC series with UT Martin.

Eastern Kentucky (21-19, 8-7 OVC): Eastern Kentucky compiled a 3-1 record last week, besting University of the Cumberlands 15-2 in non-conference action and winning two of three games at UT Martin. In fact, EKU and UTM were the only two OVC teams to play all three games of their series this past weekend as weather affected every series. The Colonels and Skyhawks got one game in on Saturday (an 18-9 Skyhawk win) and played two on Sunday as Eastern won by margins of 7-3 and 7-4. Senior Anthony Ottrando had another big week, hitting .533 (8-for-15) with four runs scored, four doubles, a home run and eight RBI. Ottrando was 2-for-4 with a home run and two RBI in the mid-week victory over The Cumberlands. In game one of the UTM series, the senior was 3-for-5 with two doubles and two RBI while in game two of the series, his two-run double in the seventh inning gave EKU the lead for good. In Sunday's nightcap Ottrando was 2-for-3 with two crucial RBI base hits. Junior hurler Paul Duncan pitched seven strong innings in the team's 7-3 win in game two of the UTM series. He allowed 11 hits but struck out nine batters and walked only two. With his pitch count at 130 in the bottom of the seventh, Duncan got a strikeout to escape a bases loaded jam while his team was clinging to a one-run lead. This week the Colonels will play at Western Kentucky and then host Tennessee Tech over the weekend. EKU is currently in fifth place in the standings, but just half a game out of second place overall.

Jacksonville State (20-18, 8-6 OVC): Weather altered the team's planned series with co-leader Southeast Missouri, as the teams were rained out on Saturday and forced to play a doubleheader on Sunday. JSU suffered a sweep at the hands of the Redhawks, falling 10-5 and 6-5 to slip to second place in the OVC standings. The Gamecocks do currently have four players with 200 or more career hits, and are believed to be the only Division I team to currently have four 200-plus hits players on their active roster. The four players are Bert Smith (293), Daniel Adamson (214), Steven Leach (206) and Todd Cunningham (204). Entering this season only five other Gamecocks had ever reached the 200-hit plateau. Smith's 293 hits are the most among active Division I players this season; the senior is already the OVC's all-time hits leader. Leach has tied the school record for walks (109). Jax State has been stealing bases at a nice clip this year and have stolen a base in 15 of its last 16 games overall. Smith has 24 steals, the third-most in the OVC this year. Smith also has the team's longest current hitting streak (7). Adamson has reached base safely in 40 of his last 41 games dating back to last year while Smith has reached base in 42 of his last 43 games. This week the Gamecocks play a home-and-home series with UAB and then have the weekend off.

Morehead State (22-19, 5-6 OVC): Morehead State did not play a mid-week game and then traveled to Cookeville for a weekend series with Tennessee Tech. Rain washed away Saturday's games but the teams were able to play a doubleheader on Sunday. Tennessee Tech got the best of the Eagles, winning 5-3 and 12-4. The losses dropped MSU to 5-6, which puts them in sixth place in the OVC standings. Taylor Davis saw his 13-game hitting streak come to an end during the

2010 OVC TOURNAMENT

A first is in order for the 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship. After nine years in Paducah, Ky., the tournament will be held May 26-29 (30) at Pringles Park in Jackson, Tenn. Every game of the event can be seen live and on-demand at OVCsports.TV.

Pringles Park is the home of the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx, the Double-A affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. The 6,000-seat natural grass stadium opened in 1998. The OVC and Pringles Park agreed to a three-year agreement last summer, guaranteeing the 2010, 2011 and 2012 tournaments will be held in Jackson.

This marks the 10th anniversary of the tournament being held at a neutral site; prior to the 2001 season, the event was held at campus sites.

Last season Tennessee Tech went a perfect 4-0 in the event to claim its first championship since 2001 and in the process became the first No. 5 seed under the current format to win the title. TTU topped Jacksonville State in extra innings in the title game.

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

weekend series. In nine OVC games this season Davis is leading the league in hitting at .529 with 18 RBI. Davis is hitting .353 overall in all games this season. The Eagles longest hitting streak now belongs to Andrew Deeds, who has hit in eight-straight. In last week's release of NCAA statistical leaders, J.D. Ashbrook was first in runs (1.63/game), third in hits (69), third in home runs (0.45/game), fifth in batting average (.460), third in slugging (.867), second in total bases (130) and fifth in on-base percentage (.561). New NCAA statistical leaders will be released on Tuesday. Morehead State returns to action this week with a road game at Marshall and a three-game OVC set at Austin Peay.

Murray State (19-20, 6-5 OVC): Murray State suffered three losses last week, falling to Southern Illinois 8-7 and then dropping both games of a Sunday doubleheader to Eastern Illinois, losing 8-6 and 7-4. The losses dropped the Thoroughbreds from first place in the standings to fourth place overall. Brandon Elliott hit .500 (5-for-10) with four runs, a double, triple and two RBI during the week. On Sunday senior Wes Cunningham recorded his 12th career triple, which ties the Murray State all-time record. Cunningham hit .385 during the week and now ranks fifth in the OVC in batting (.426) on the season. This week Murray State will travel to Oxford, Miss. for a Tuesday game with nationally-ranked Ole Miss. The weekend will see the Thoroughbreds travel to Cape Girardeau for a showdown with first place Southeast Missouri.

Southeast Missouri (25-14, 10-4 OVC): Southeast Missouri extended its winning streak to five games after a perfect 4-0 record last week that saw the Redhawks top Southern Illinois 13-1 on the road and Harris-Stowe 10-2 at home during the mid-week schedule. Saturday's games at Jacksonville State were rained out but the teams were able to play a doubleheader on Sunday, and Southeast made the most of the opportunity, topping JSU 10-5 and 6-5. The wins lifted the Redhawks to 10-4 in the OVC, two full games ahead of the Gamecocks in the OVC standings. Junior Casey Jones was named OVC Player of the Week after hitting .556 (10-for-18) with four runs scored, two doubles, two home runs and 14 RBI in four games. Jones, who leads the OVC with a .449 batting average on the season, was 4-for-6 with six RBI in the win over Southern Illinois and 2-for-4 with four RBI in the win over Harris-Stowe. In Sunday's doubleheader sweep of Jacksonville State, Jones combined to go 4-for-8 with three runs scored, four RBI, two doubles and a home run. Jones also leads the OVC in RBI (1.56/game) and has a current 13-game hitting streak, which ranks second in the OVC. Junior Nick Thomas was named OVC Pitcher of the Week as well, making it a clean sweep for the Redhawks this week. Thomas picked up two wins during the week (improving to 6-0 on the year), scattering four hits in six innings against SIU and entering the game in relief on Sunday against JSU, pitching six strong innings. Thomas' six wins this year ranks second in the OVC behind teammate Kyle Gumieny, who is 7-0 on the year. Jim Klocke did see his 25-game hitting streak come to an end in game one at Jacksonville State. The streak was the third longest active streak nationally when it came to an end. This week the Redhawks will play two games at Central Arkansas before returning home to host Murray State this weekend.

SIU Edwardsville (12-26): SIU Edwardsville lost a mid-week game at Missouri State and were swept in a Sunday doubleheader at Austin Peay, finishing last week 0-3 overall. The Cougars controlled most of the game with Missouri State, but gave up a five-spot in the eighth inning to suffer the defeat. Sophomore Josh Hoguet tossed six scoreless innings in his second start of the season, allowing just four hits and striking out seven; he did not figure in the decision. After being rained out on Saturday in Clarksville, SIUE was able to play a doubleheader with Austin Peay on Sunday. The Governors got the best of the Cougars, winning the games by margins of 5-2 and 6-5. Including a single-game loss earlier in the season to Austin Peay, SIUE is now 5-10 this season against future OVC opponents. This week the Cougars will play at Indiana State and Saint Louis during the week and then play a three-game weekend series at Southern Illinois.

Tennessee Tech (20-20, 6-5 OVC): Tennessee Tech suffered a 11-5 road loss to Middle Tennessee during the week before rebounding to win both games against Morehead State over the weekend (the third game was rained out). Overall the Golden Eagles have won seven of its last eight and nine of its last 12 games overall as the team has evened its record at 20-20 on the year. After starting the OVC season 0-5, Tech, the defending OVC Tournament champions, has rebounded to win its last six OVC games to improve to 6-5 and be tied for third place in the OVC standings. Ben Burgess hit .625 (5-for-8) with six runs scored, two home runs and seven RBI in three games last week. He had a 1.375 slugging percentage and a .636 on-base percentage. Casanova Donaldson added six RBI in the three games. On the mound, Chason Choate picked up a save, pitching the final 3.2 innings in Sunday's final game. Lee Henry picked up his third victory of the season on Sunday, pitching 6.1 innings and striking out seven. The Golden Eagles will play at East Tennessee this week and then travel to Eastern Kentucky for a three-game OVC series with the Colonels.

UT Martin (19-20, 4-8 OVC): UT Martin lost a mid-week game at Lipscomb and then lost two of three OVC games with Eastern Kentucky over the weekend. Rain altered the weekend schedule as the team's played just one game on Saturday (an 18-9 Skyhawk win) and a doubleheader on Sunday (games ECU won 7-3 and 7-4). In fact UTM and ECU were the only OVC teams who were able to play the three games in the weekend series. During the week senior catcher Ty Nelson hit .556 (10-for-18) with four runs, three doubles, a triple, home run and four RBI. Nelson slugged 1.000 on the week and has now hit safely in 21 out of his last 22 games while raising his season batting average by 100 points (to a team-best .428). He drove in three runs in the team's 18-9 win on Saturday night. Senior Coty Green picked up a victory on Saturday, improving to 7-2 on the season; the seven wins are tied for the most in the OVC. Dan Tobik pitched the final four innings of the game to pick up his second save of the season and in the process lowered his E.R.A. to an OVC-best 2.54. This week the Skyhawks play at nationally-ranked Ole Miss on Wednesday and then travel to Eastern Illinois for a key OVC series over the weekend. UT Martin is just one game behind EIU in the OVC standings.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: For the first time this season weather played a role in Conference games, as Saturday's schedule was almost a complete washout, as only a single game between Eastern Kentucky and UT Martin was played...That forced doubleheaders league-wide on Sunday...Those games each saw a sweep as Eastern Illinois won two from Murray State, Eastern Kentucky took two from UT Martin, Tennessee Tech swept Morehead State and Southeast Missouri won both at Jacksonville State...The Southeast wins vaulted the Redhawks (10-4 in the OVC) into first place, now a full two games ahead of the Gamecocks (8-6 in the OVC)...The rest of the league is very balanced, as four teams are within 2.5 games of first place and every team is within five games of the top spot...This weekend Southeast Missouri will host third-place Murray State while Morehead State plays at Austin Peay, UT Martin is at Eastern Illinois and Tennessee Tech plays at Eastern Kentucky.

JSU's Smith Sets OVC Record for Career Hits and At-Bats, Closes in on OVC Mark for Games Played: This season Jacksonville State senior second baseman **Bert Smith** has set OVC career marks for both hits and at-bats. On April 17 Smith set the record for hits, registering his 288th mark against Austin Peay and breaking the previous record of 287 held by Jeremy Johnson (Southeast Missouri, 1997-2000). Smith now has 293 career hits (and closing in on a NCAA milestone). On April 7 against No. 19 Alabama Smith became the OVC's all-time leader in at-bats, passing the mark of 831 career at-bats previously held by Middle Tennessee's Clay Snellgrove (1994-97). Smith now has 870 career at-bats. Smith has now played in 214 career games, just 10 away from equaling the OVC career mark of 224 held by MTSU's Snellgrove (1994-97).

Smith Set to Become Only Active NCAA Player with 300 Career Hits: Not only is Jacksonville State's **Bert Smith** rank among all the career and active OVC leaders, but he is only seven hits away from making a mark in the NCAA record book. With seven more hits Smith will become the only active Division I baseball player with 300 career hits. Preston Hale of North Florida is next with 262 career hits among active players.

Morehead State's Lee Searches for OVC Career RBI Record: Morehead State senior shortstop **Drew Lee** is approaching the OVC career RBI mark. Entering the week Lee has 182 RBI (a MSU record) and is now just 26 away from the OVC mark of 208 held by Western Kentucky's Mike Williams (1978-81). Lee has some company in the chase now, as Tennessee Tech's **A.J. Kirby-Jones** and Southeast Missouri's **Jim Klocke** both have 174 career RBI entering this week.

Klocke One of 10 National Finalists for Lowe's Senior CLASS Award: Southeast Missouri State senior catcher **Jim Klocke** has been named one of 10 finalists for the 2010 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. Nationwide voting runs now through May 31 to determine the recipient of the award, which will be announced in June at the NCAA College World Series in Omaha, Neb. Fans can vote online for Klocke by going to <http://www.seniorclassaward.com> or by text messaging BASEBALL to 74567. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - classroom, character, community and competition. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. Lowe's, an official Corporate Partner of the NCAA, will announce the Senior CLASS Award winner at the NCAA College World Series® in June. Earlier in the year two additional OVC players - Murray State first baseman **Wes Cunningham** and Morehead State shortstop **Drew Lee** - were among the 30 candidates for the award but those two did not make the final cut to 10.

Hitting Streaks: Southeast Missouri State senior catcher **Jim Klocke** recently had a 25-game hitting streak come to an end. The streak was the longest in the OVC this season. The all-time OVC mark is 42 games by Austin Peay's Chuck Abbott, set in the 1996 season. Pringles Park to Host 2010 OVC Baseball Championship: In May 2009, the Ohio Valley Conference Board of Athletic Directors and Board of Presidents approved a plan to move the OVC Baseball Championship to Jackson, Tenn. for the next three years, beginning with the 2010 season. The six-team, double-elimination tournament will be held May 26-30 at Pringles Park, home of the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx, the AA affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. This year will mark the 31st OVC Baseball Championship. The first elimination style tournament was held in 1980, most usually being played at the site of the regular season champion. Beginning in 2001 the tournament switched to a neutral site for the first time (with the last nine championships have been held at Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky.). Pringles Park opened in 1998 and has a seating capacity of 6,000. The venue hosted the 1999 Southern League All-Star Game and will also host that event in 2011. Pringles Park also has luxury suites, a video board and merchandise shop that will be used for the championship. More information on the stadium and the Diamond Jaxx can be found at <http://www.diamondjaxx.com>. Jackson, Tenn. is located 130 miles from Nashville and 77.2 miles from Memphis on Interstate 40. Tickets for the event will be \$10 per day or \$30 for an all-session pass (up to 11 total games). There is also an \$8 a day rate for students/faculty of OVC-member schools or groups. All seats at the 6,000-seat park are general admission for the OVC Championship. Fans can purchase tickets in person at the Diamond Jaxx box office or by calling (731) 988-5299. EKU's Purcell Named to Mid-Season NCBWA Stopper of the Year Watch List: Eastern Kentucky junior closer **Ryne Purcell** is one of 45 players named to the NCBWA's Stopper of the Year Award Watch List. The award is given to the top relief pitcher in college baseball. Purcell has an OVC-best eight saves this season. At the conclusion of the regular season, the Division I national saves leader and four other relief pitching standouts will be selected as finalists and released Wednesday, June 2, prior to start of NCAA regional tournament competition. The NCBWA's All-America Committee then will select the winner, with this year's recipient to be announced on the opening day of the College World Series on June 19.

OVC Players in the Pros: Entering the 2010 season, there were three players from OVC schools on Major League Baseball Opening Day rosters. Austin Peay has the distinction of having two former players on teams including 2008 All-Star reliever **George Sherrill** (Baltimore) and relief pitcher **Shawn Kelley** (Seattle). Former Morehead State pitcher **Jon Rauch** is now the closer in Minnesota after being the setup man in Arizona last year. That number became four at the end of the first week of the regular season as another former OVC player - Austin Peay catcher **A.J. Ellis** - was called up from AAA by the L.A. Dodgers. One OVC school - Eastern Illinois - has two alumni who are coaching at the highest level of professional baseball. Former Panther **Kevin Seitzer** is the Kansas City Royals hitting coach with **Tim Bogar** is the Boston Red Sox third base coach.

Lee Named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper and the NCBWA: Morehead State senior shortstop **Drew Lee** was named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper as well as by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) on April 19/20 after an outstanding week. In four Morehead State victories Lee hit .550 (11-for-20) with 12 runs scored, three doubles, five home runs, 14 RBI, two stolen bases and a 1.450 slugging percentage. In a mid-week win over Marshall, the senior homered, drove in three runs and scored three times as the Eagles prevailed 15-6. Lee started a weekend sweep of OVC foe Eastern Kentucky by homering three times in game one of Saturday's doubleheader. He drove in two more runs in the second game of the twin bill, bringing Saturday's RBI total to six. Lee concluded the week by adding another home run and driving in five additional runs.

Flynn Named CollegeBaseballInsider.com National Player of the Week: Coming off a week where he doubled his season home run and RBIs total, Morehead State sophomore **Cameron Flynn** was named the National Player of the Week by CollegeBaseballInsider.com on March 31. In four games the previous week, Flynn batted .588 (10-for-17) with four home runs and 16 RBI. The Lexington native smacked two doubles and one triple, scored seven runs and slugged a remarkable 1.529. He knocked in a career-high six in a mid-week win over Indiana, before homering three times and tallying nine RBI in an OVC doubleheader against Southeast Missouri State on Saturday.

Kirby-Jones Named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper: Tennessee Tech junior **A.J. Kirby-Jones** was named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper on March 15. In six games during the week Kirby-Jones hit .526 (10-for-19) with eight runs scored, two doubles, five home runs and 13 RBI. The junior had a .655 on-base percentage and a 1.421 slugging percentage for the week. In the first game of the Buffalo series, Kirby-Jones was 4-for-4 at the plate with three home runs and five RBI. Two OVC Catchers Named to Johnny Bench Award Watch List: Two OVC catchers have been named to the 2010 Coleman Company Johnny Bench Award Watch List delivered by Papa John's Pizza and announced by The Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission. The two OVC players are Southeast Missouri State senior **Jim Klocke** and Eastern Kentucky senior **Joey Stevens**. Fifty-three catchers were nominated for the award by their coaches. Because the award is given annually to the top Division I collegiate catcher, the list will be updated to include other candidates until May 5, 2010. The watch list will be narrowed down to 10 semifinalists, whom will be announced May 19, 2010. Ballots will be sent to the national voting panel at the end of May for a vote to determine the three finalists. The finalists will be announced June 2, 2010 prior to the NCAA Regionals and Major League Baseball Draft. A final vote among the national committee will occur during the College World Series. All finalists will be brought to Wichita and the winner will be announced at the 13th Annual Greater Wichita Sports Banquet on July 1, 2010.

Cunningham Named to Golden Spikes Watch List: Jacksonville State's **Todd Cunningham** has been named to the preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List, as released by USA Baseball. The watch list features 50 of the nation's top amateur talents, and it will be a "rolling" list to ensure that athletes can play themselves into consideration for the Golden Spikes Award, to be presented live on Tuesday, July 13, at the 2010 Major League Baseball All-Star FanFest in Anaheim, Calif. Cunningham, a native of Jacksonville, led the prestigious Cape Cod League with a .378 batting average after playing for the Falmouth Commodores. He also led the league in hits (59) and on-base percentage (.458) after winning the batting title by 36 points. On Tuesday, June 1, USA Baseball officials will cut the watch list of players to 30 names. The final list of 30 will then be sent to a voting body consisting of select professional baseball personnel, past USA Baseball National Team coaches, select members of the media, former USA Baseball sports information directors, and current USA Baseball staff - close to 150 voters in total.

Five OVC Coaches Coaching at Their Alma Mater: This season five of the nine OVC head baseball coaches are currently coaching at their alma maters. That lists includes second-year head coach **Jason Stein** who played at Eastern Kentucky from 1992-95 and graduated in 1997. He played against Morehead State head coach **Jay Sorg** who was at MSU from 1992-94. Ironically in the 1994 season, Sorg was named OVC Player of the Week on April 11 while Stein earned the same honor on May 2. The other coaches currently at their alma mater are Austin Peay's **Gary McClure** (1987), Murray State **Rob McDonald** (1984) and Southeast Missouri's **Mark Hogan** (1977).

Eastern Illinois Picked as Preseason Favorite: Fresh off the 2009 OVC Regular Season Championship, Eastern Illinois has been picked as the 2010 preseason favorite for the nine-team league in a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches. The overall voting in the preseason poll was close as three different teams received first-place votes. Eastern Illinois garnered three first-place votes and 59 total points in being picked the favorites. Jacksonville State got the most first-place vote (4), but finished three points (56) behind Eastern Illinois in being picked second overall. Tennessee Tech, last year's OVC Tournament Champions, picked up the other two first-place votes and finished third in the predicted order of finish with 51 points. Murray State was picked fourth (43), followed by Morehead State (33), Eastern Kentucky (26), Southeast Missouri (25), Austin Peay (22) and UT Martin (9).

Four Players Share Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year Honors: Preseason voting was so balanced in the OVC this season that four players shared the two major preseason honors. Morehead State senior shortstop **Drew Lee** and Eastern Kentucky junior third baseman **Jayson Langfels** were named OVC Preseason Co-Players of the Year while Murray State senior **Chris Craycraft** and Eastern Illinois junior **Josh Mueller** were tabbed OVC Preseason Co-Pitchers of the Year. In all, 14 players were selected to the Preseason All-OVC team. The 14 players represented seven of the nine teams who will compete for the OVC championship this season. Murray State led the way with four selections while Jacksonville State had three picks. Returning players who were first-team selections at the end of last season were automatic picks for this year's team.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: On July 1 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, Ill., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States).
