In four Murray State wins last week, Hill hit .562 (9-for-16) with six runs scored, six doubles, two home runs and eight RBI. Hill had three multi-hit games during the week including a 2-for-4 performance in a non-conference road win over Belmont to start the week. In the first game of Saturday's doubleheader sweep of UT Martin, Hill was 3-for-6 with two doubles, a home run and four RBI in a 20-2 Thoroughbred win. In the second game he was 4-for-4 with three doubles, a home run and four RBI.

The junior righty retired 10 consecutive batters early in the game and struck out two batters in an inning on three different occasions. Recchia finished the game with seven strikeouts in picking up his third victory of the season. The only hit he allowed was a two-out single in the fourth inning.

TEAM NOTES

Austin Peay (15-12, 3-3 OVC): Austin Peay opened last week with a non-conference victory over a good Middle Tennessee team and then lost two of three OVC games at Eastern Illinois over the weekend. In the win over MTSU it was a seven-run fourth inning that made the difference as APSU improved to 13-4 at Raymond C. Hand Park this season. Jared Delong led the way by going 3-for-5 with two RBI. The win snapped a seven-game losing streak to the Blue Raiders dating back to the 2006 season. After dropping both games of Friday's doubleheader at EIU (2-0 and 4-3), the Govs offense came alive in Saturday's finale, scoring 18 runs on its way to an 18-6 victory. In that game Adam Browett and Shayne Martin each had five RBI to lead the attack. Browett finished the day 3-for-5 with a pair of doubles while Jon Clinard was 3-for-6 with a triple, home run and three RBI. Stephen Huff ended his three-game losing streak on the mound, striking out five over six innings. This Tuesday the Governors will play Memphis in a game at Pringles Park in Jackson, Tenn., the site of this year's OVC Baseball Championship. That will be followed by a game at Middle Tennessee on Wednesday and a three-game OVC set in Richmond against Eastern Kentucky this weekend.

Eastern Illinois (6-20, 2-4 OVC): Playing its first home series of the year (after a single home game the week prior) Eastern Illinois made the most of its, taking two of three from Austin Peay after being swept by Eastern Kentucky in OVC play last week. That series followed a 15-3 road loss to Saint Louis to begin the week. Senior Alex Gee hit .667 (10-for-15) with two runs scored, five doubles and four RBI in the four games last week. In the final game of the APSU series, Gee had a career-high four hits, including three doubles. During the week three of his four RBI came with two outs. On the mound junior Mike Recchia combined for a 2-0 shutout of the Governors in the opener of that series. He pitched into the eighth inning of that game in picking up his third win of the season. He allowed just one hit over 7.1 innings and struck out seven. Curt Restko has hit safely in all nine games since EIU returned from its spring break trip. Josh Mueller returned to the mound on Saturday for the first time since March 5, working four innings and not earning a decision. This week Eastern Illinois will host Illinois College and play at Chicago State in non-conference action before hosting Morehead State. The Panthers have a 17-game winning streak against the Eagles, having not lost to Morehead State since the 2004 season.

Eastern Kentucky (12-14, 3-3 OVC): Eastern Kentucky opened last week with a 10-6 win over Marshall at home. That improved the Colonels to 6-4 at Turkey Hughes Field on the season. In that game junior Ryan Faidley hit two home runs and drove in three runs for EKV. In the weekend series at Southeast Missouri (in with Eastern was swept), Faidley added another home run, three more runs and four additional RBI. For the week he hit .333 (5-for-15) with five runs scored and seven RBI. At SEMO, the Colonels lost the opening game 17-9 before losing on a walk-off grand slam in the second game of Friday's doubleheader. The series concluded with a one-run (8-7) loss. Individually junior Jayson Langfels lead EKV in hitting and ranks seventh in the OVC (.406). This week Eastern goes on the road for a two-game mid-week set at East Tennessee State before returning home to host Austin Peay this weekend.

Jacksonville State (16-12, 5-1 OVC): Jacksonville State dropped a 7-3 decision to No. 23 Alabama to start the week before sweeping Tennessee Tech to improve to 5-1 in OVC play. The 5-1 record ties the Gamecocks with Southeast Missouri State for first place after two weekends of Conference play. Jax State has now won 12 of its last 15 games overall. Preseason All-American Todd Cunningham hit .429 (6-for-14) with two doubles and seven runs scored. He also extended his hitting streak to nine games and raised his season batting average to .363. In six OVC games this season he is hitting .480 (10th in the league). Jacksonville State lowered its team ERA to a season-low over the week. Righty Todd Hornsby made three appearances and pitching 7.1 innings, allowing just two hits while striking out three and earning a win in relief. Senior Bert Smith continues to close in on several OVC records, as his 276 hits is just 11 away from the OVC mark held by SEMO's Jeremy Johnson. Smith is also 20 games played from the OVC all-time mark of 224 and only three at-bats away from that record (828). Smith has reached base safely in 32 of his last 33 games dating back to last season. After traveling to Alabama last week, the Gamecocks will host the Crimson Tide this week. Following that non-conference game JSU will host Murray State for a three-game OVC series this coming weekend.

Morehead State (17-14, 1-2 OVC): Morehead State won all four of its games last week, topping Georgetown (Ky.) 12-3 during midweek action and taking three games from incoming and future OVC opponent SIU Edwardsville. Those wins were by the margins of 11-6, 24-14 (on a windy day) and 8-6. Junior Travis Redmon hit .500 (9-for-18) with nine runs scored, three home runs, five RBI and three stolen bases in four games. All three of his home runs came in Saturday's 24-14 win. Senior Drew Lee became the school's all-time hits leader on Sunday, collecting his 249th hit. That passed the mark of 248 previous held by Josh Cox (1995-98). Lee is also closing in on the MSU records for RBI, doubles and at-bats. Lee's 12-game active hitting streak is the second longest in the OVC entering this week. J.D. Ashbrook, who has an 11-game hitting streak, is fourth in the OVC in batting (.426) while Lee is fifth (.424). Morehead State recorded a

2010 OVC TOURNAMENT

A first is in order for the 2010 Ohio Valley Conference Baseball Championship. After nine years in Paducah, Ky., the tournament will be held May 26-29 (30) at Pringles Park in Jackson, Tenn. Every game of the event can be seen live and on-demand at OVCsports.TV.

Pringles Park is the home of the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx, the Double-A affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. The 6,000-seat natural grass stadium opened in 1998. The OVC and Pringles Park agreed to a three-year agreement last summer, guaranteeing the 2010, 2011 and 2012 tournaments will be held in Jackson.

This marks the 10th anniversary of the tournament being held at a neutral site; prior to the 2001 season, the event was held at campus sites.

Last season Tennessee Tech went a perfect 4-0 in the event to claim its first championship since 2001 and in the process became the first No. 5 seed under the current format to win the title. TTU topped Jacksonville State in extra innings in the title game.

The first official OVC Tournament was held in 1980; prior to that only playoff series between divisional winners were played.

school record 29 hits and tied a program mark with eight home runs. Junior Jeff Arnold made two starts and picked up two wins during the week. He is now 4-0 on the season despite a 7.20 E.R.A. in nine appearances (six starts). The Eagles will go on the road for four games this week. MSU plays at Cincinnati and then at Eastern Illinois for a three-game set.

Murray State (16-11, 4-2 OVC): Murray State has been the streakiest team in the league this season, having five different multi-game streaks so far this year. The Thoroughbreds won four in a row before losing seven straight at the beginning of the season, then after a 1-1 record, won six in a row before dropping three straight. This week the team was 4-0 (increasing its current winning streak to five) winning a non-conference game at Belmont before returning home to sweep UT Martin in Conference action. Daniel Hill hit .562 (9-for-16) with six runs scored, six doubles, two home runs and eight RBI in the four games as he earned OVC Player of the Week honors. In the Breds 20-2 victory, Hill was 3-for-6 with two doubles, a home run and four RBI and followed that up by going 4-for-4 with three doubles, a home run and four RBI in the second game of Friday's doubleheader. Senior Chris Craycraft began just the sixth MSU pitcher to record 20 career victories (and first since Major Leaguer Kirk Rueter did it in 1991) on Friday. He allowed just one run over eight innings while striking out seven batters. The run he allowed in the sixth inning ended a streak of 15-straight shutout innings against UTM, including a complete-game shutout he tossed last year at UTM. Wes Cunningham's triple against Belmont gave him 11 for his career, just one shy of the school's all-time record. Cunningham's .455 average leads the OVC while his 13 home runs are second. Junior Elliot Frey tied the school record with his 32nd career hit by pitch last week. This week the Thoroughbreds have to go on the road and play No. 18 Western Kentucky and then play an OVC series at co-league leader Jacksonville State.

Southeast Missouri (18-9, 5-1 OVC): Southeast Missouri continued its winning ways, sweeping Eastern Kentucky in its only games of the week. The Redhawks are now 5-1 in OVC play and tied atop the standings with Jacksonville State. Southeast has won four games in a row, 12 of its 13 and 14 of 16 overall. The team has played 13 of its last 16 games at home and is 15-1 at Capaha Park overall. Junior outfielder Blake Slattery hit .333 (4-for-12) last week with two home runs and seven RBI. None were more important than a walk-off grand slam in Friday's second game against Eastern Kentucky. The win capped a comeback and gave the Redhawks a 7-4 win. Catcher Jim Klocke now has the longest active hitting streak in the OVC at 15 games. He is now sixth in the OVC in RBI (1.26/game). True freshman Shae Simmons made two appearances last week, picking up a win and a save out of the bullpen. He struck out three without allowing a run or hit in 1.2 innings of work. In the series finale, Simmons entered with two runners on and only one out and retired the side to complete the sweep for the Redhawks. Southeast Missouri continues to lead the OVC in team batting (.355) and team E.R.A. (5.55). Southeast has four home games this week, Southern Illinois in non-conference action and Tennessee Tech in for three games in OVC play.

SIU Edwardsville (7-19): SIU Edwardsville played its second-straight series against a future OVC opponent this past weekend. After playing at Tennessee Tech, the Cougars traveled to Morehead State and they were swept by the Eagles by scores of 11-6, 24-14 and 8-6. SIUE is now 4-16 in road games this season. Adam Eggemeyer continues to lead the team in batting, hitting .350 with seven home runs and 23 RBI. SIU Edwardsville returns to the field this week with a non-conference game at Missouri before returning to SimmonsCooper Complex for a three-game series with another future OVC opponent in UT Martin. That marks the first of eight games at home for SIUE.

Tennessee Tech (11-17, 0-3 OVC): Tennessee Tech lost a non-conference road game at Tennessee to begin the week before dropping its first three OVC games of the season, losing 7-1, 10-2 and 8-7 at Jacksonville State over the weekend. That extended the Golden Eagles losing streak to six games overall and the team has lost nine of its last 11 overall. During the week outfielder Chad Oberacker hit .412 (7-for-17) with two doubles, a home run and a stolen base. His .434 batting average is third in the OVC and he is batting .500 in OVC-only games (5th-best). Slugger A.J. Kirby-Jones continues to lead the OVC in home runs; his 0.50 average is first nationally in last week's NCAA stats (new leaders are released on Tuesday). Starter Lee Henry now leads the OVC in E.R.A., compiling a 2.73 mark in eight games (five starts). This week Tech will play a home-and-home series with Lipscomb and then travel to Southeast Missouri to face the OVC co-leaders.

UT Martin (12-15, 1-5 OVC): UT Martin lost all four of its games last week and has now lost six-straight overall and five-straight OVC games. The Skyhawks lost for the second time this season against Southern Illinois, this week falling 15-3 on the road, before being swept at Murray State in OVC action. UTM is just 1-10 in true road games this season. Junior Trey Karlen hit .357 (5-for-14) in four games last week, scoring four runs, hitting a home run and stealing two bases. He not has 16 stolen bases on the season, which is third most in the league. Junior closer Wes Alsup continued his dominant performance out of the bullpen, making two appearances and striking out six in 3.1 innings of work. Alsup has six saves this season while striking out 15 in 10 innings of work. The Skyhawks return to action with five contests this week. UT Martin will play a home-and-home with Arkansas State this week before playing at future OVC foe SIU Edwardsville this weekend.

NOTES FROM AROUND THE LEAGUE

OVC Overview/This Week's Highlights: After two weekends of Conference play Jacksonville State and Southeast Missouri State sit atop the standings with identical 5-1 marks...Both opponents swept three-games series this past weekend...Murray State, who has won five games in a row, is in third place with a 4-2 mark; the Thoroughbreds swept UT Martin at home this past weekend...Eastern Illinois, the OVC preseason favorite, won its first two OVC games of the season this past week, sweeping a Friday doubleheader from Austin Peay; the Panthers were swept at Eastern Kentucky to open Conference play two weeks ago...Tennessee Tech is currently the only team without an OVC win yet; the Golden Eagles had a bye the first weekend of Conference play and were swept by Jacksonville State this past weekend...It is a busy week of action this week as there are 15 non-conference games to be played on Tuesday and Wednesday...This weekend's OVC contests include Austin Peay at Eastern Kentucky, Morehead State at Eastern Illinois, Murray State at Jacksonville State and Tennessee Tech at Southeast Missouri...Future OVC foe SIU Edwardsville continues its trend of playing an OVC opponent for the third-straight weekend as the Cougars entertain UT Martin in Edwardsville.

The OVC in the NCAA Statistical Leaders: In this week's national statistical leaders the OVC had several teams and individuals among the leaders. As a team Eastern Kentucky ranked fifth in double plays (1.32/game), while Morehead State ranked fourth in home runs (1.81/game) and eighth in runs (237). Austin Peay is now ninth in stolen bases (2.65/game). Individually, Tennessee Tech junior **A.J. Kirby-Jones** ranks first in home runs (0.58/game), first in slugging (1.048), third in total bases (88) and fourth in walks (1.21/game). Murray State senior **Wes Cunningham** is third in home runs (0.52/game), second in total bases (90) and sixth in slugging (.918). Morehead State senior **Drew Lee** is ninth in hits (46) and seventh in total bases (83). Tennessee Tech's **Chad Oberacker** is now second in hits (49) while Morehead State's **J.D. Ashbrook** is fifth in runs (1.59/game) and Austin Peay's **Jon Clinard** is seventh in stolen bases (0.82/game). Morehead State's **Josh Schneider** is first in victories (6) while UT Martin's **Wes Alsop** and Eastern Kentucky's **Ryne Purcell** is sixth in saves (6). The latest set of NCAA rankings will be released on Tuesday.

JSU's Smith Closes in on OVC Hits, At-Bats and Games Played Records: Jacksonville State senior second baseman **Bert Smith** now has 276 career hits, which is just 11 away from tying the OVC all-time record for hits in a career. That mark (287) is currently held by Jeremy Johnson, who played at Southeast Missouri State from 1997-2000. Smith has now played in 204 career games, just 20 away from equaling the mark of 224 held by Middle Tennessee's Clay Snellgrove (1994-97). Smith is also just three (3) at-bats behind Snellgrove's OVC record of 831, and should break that 12-year old record this week.

Pringles Park to Host 2010 OVC Baseball Championship: In May 2009, the Ohio Valley Conference Board of Athletic Directors and Board of Presidents approved a plan to move the OVC Baseball Championship to Jackson, Tenn. for the next three years, beginning with the 2010 season. The six-team, double-elimination tournament will be held May 26-30 at Pringles Park, home of the West Tenn Diamond Jaxx, the AA affiliate of the Seattle Mariners. This year will mark the 31st OVC Baseball Championship. The first elimination style tournament was held in 1980, most usually being played at the site of the regular season champion. Beginning in 2001 the tournament switched to a neutral site for the first time (with the last nine championships have been held at Brooks Stadium in Paducah, Ky.). Pringles Park opened in 1998 and has a seating capacity of 6,000. The venue hosted the 1999 Southern League All-Star Game and will also host that event in 2011. Pringles Park also has luxury suites, a video board and merchandise shop that will be used for the championship. More information on the stadium and the Diamond Jaxx can be found at <http://www.diamondjaxx.com>. Jackson, Tenn. is located 130 miles from Nashville and 77.2 miles from Memphis on Interstate 40. Tickets for the event will be \$10 per day or \$30 for an all-session pass (up to 11 total games). There is also a \$8 a day rate for students/faculty of OVC-member schools or groups. All seats at the 6,000-seat park are general admission for the OVC Championship. Fans can purchase tickets in person at the Diamond Jaxx box office or by calling (731) 988-5299. Flynn Named CollegeBaseballInsider.com National Player of the Week: Coming off a week where he doubled his season home run and RBIs total, Morehead State sophomore **Cameron Flynn** was named the National Player of the Week by CollegeBaseballInsider.com on March 31. In four games the previous week, Flynn batted .588 (10-for-17) with four home runs and 16 RBI. The Lexington native smacked two doubles and one triple, scored seven runs and slugged a remarkable 1.529. He knocked in a career-high six in a mid-week win over Indiana, before homering three times and tallying nine RBI in an OVC doubleheader against Southeast Missouri State on Saturday.

Kirby-Jones Named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball News: Tennessee Tech junior A.J. Kirby-Jones was named Louisville Slugger National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball News on March 15. In six games during the week Kirby-Jones hit .526 (10-for-19) with eight runs scored, two doubles, five home runs and 13 RBI. The junior had a .655 on-base percentage and a 1.421 slugging percentage for the week. In the first game of the Buffalo series, Kirby-Jones was 4-for-4 at the plate with three home runs and five RBI. He also drove in three runs in a road win over South Alabama on Wednesday and in game two of the series against Buffalo.

Two OVC Catchers Named to Johnny Bench Award Watch List: Two OVC catchers have been named to the 2010 Coleman Company Johnny Bench Award Watch List delivered by Papa John's Pizza and announced by The Greater Wichita Area Sports Commission. The two OVC players are Southeast Missouri State senior **Jim Klocke** and Eastern Kentucky senior **Joey Stevens**. Fifty-three catchers were nominated for the award by their coaches. Because the award is given annually to the top Division I collegiate catcher, the list will be updated to include other candidates until May 5, 2010. The watch list will be narrowed down to 10 semifinalists, whom will be announced May 19, 2010. Ballots will be sent to the national voting panel at the end of May for a vote to determine the three finalists. The finalists will be announced June 2, 2010 prior to the NCAA Regionals and Major League Baseball Draft. A final vote among the national committee will occur during the College World Series. All finalists will be brought to Wichita and the winner will be announced at the 13th Annual Greater Wichita Sports Banquet on July 1, 2010.

Cunningham Named to Golden Spikes Watch List: Jacksonville State's **Todd Cunningham** has been named to the preseason Golden Spikes Award Watch List, as released by USA Baseball. The watch list features 50 of the nation's top amateur talents, and it will be a "rolling" list to ensure that athletes can play themselves into consideration for the Golden Spikes Award, to be presented live on Tuesday, July 13, at the 2010 Major League Baseball All-Star FanFest in Anaheim, Calif. Cunningham, a native of Jacksonville, led the prestigious Cape Cod League with a .378 batting average after playing for the Falmouth Commodores. He also led the league in hits (59) and on-base percentage (.458) after winning the batting title by 36 points. On Tuesday, June 1, USA Baseball officials will cut the watch list of players to 30 names. The final list of 30 will then be sent to a voting body consisting of select professional baseball personnel, past USA Baseball National Team coaches, select members of the media, former USA Baseball sports information directors, and current USA Baseball staff - close to 150 voters in total.

Three OVC Players Named Candidates for Lowe's Senior CLASS Award: Three OVC baseball student-athletes are among the 30 baseball players named as a candidates for the 2010 Lowe's Senior CLASS Award. The three players are Murray State first baseman **Wes Cunningham**, Southeast Missouri State catcher **Jim Klocke** and Morehead State shortstop **Drew Lee**. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - classroom, character, community and competition. An acronym for Celebrating Loyalty and Achievement for Staying in School, the Lowe's Senior CLASS Award focuses on the total student-athlete and encourages students to use their platform in athletics to make a positive impact as leaders in their communities. Lowe's, an official Corporate Partner of the NCAA, will announce the Senior CLASS Award winner at the NCAA College World Series® in June. The 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists midway through the regular season, and those 10 names will be placed on the official ballot. Ballots will be distributed through a nationwide voting system to media, coaches and fans, who will select one finalist who best exemplifies excellence in the four Cs of classroom, character, community and competition.

Five OVC Coaches Coaching at Their Alma Mater: This season five of the nine OVC head baseball coaches are currently coaching at their alma maters. That lists includes second-year head coach **Jason Stein** who played at Eastern Kentucky from 1992-95 and graduated in 1997. He played against Morehead State head coach **Jay Sorg** who was at MSU from 1992-94. Ironically in the 1994 season, Sorg was named OVC Player of the Week on April 11 while Stein earned the same honor on May 2. The other coaches currently at their alma mater are Austin Peay's **Gary McClure** (1987), Murray State **Rob McDonald** (1984) and Southeast Missouri's **Mark Hogan** (1977).

Eastern Illinois Picked as Preseason Favorite: Fresh off the 2009 OVC Regular Season Championship, Eastern Illinois has been picked as the 2010 preseason favorite for the nine-team league in a vote of Ohio Valley Conference head baseball coaches. The overall voting in the preseason poll was close as three different teams received first-place votes. Eastern Illinois garnered three first-place votes and 59 total points in being picked the favorites. Jacksonville State got the most first-place vote (4), but finished three points (56) behind Eastern Illinois in being picked second overall. Tennessee Tech, last year's OVC Tournament Champions, picked up the other two first-place votes and finished third in the predicted order of finish with 51 points. Murray State was picked fourth (43), followed by Morehead State (33), Eastern Kentucky (26), Southeast Missouri (25), Austin Peay (22) and UT Martin (9).

Four Players Share Preseason OVC Player/Pitcher of the Year Honors: Preseason voting was so balanced in the OVC this season that four players shared the two major preseason honors. Morehead State senior shortstop **Drew Lee** and Eastern Kentucky junior third baseman **Jayson Langfels** were named OVC Preseason Co-Players of the Year while Murray State senior **Chris Craycraft** and Eastern Illinois junior **Josh Mueller** were tabbed OVC Preseason Co-Pitchers of the Year. In all, 14 players were selected to the Preseason All-OVC team. The 14 players represented seven of the nine teams who will compete for the OVC championship this season. Murray State led the way with four selections while Jacksonville State had three picks. Returning players who were first-team selections at the end of last season were automatic picks for this year's team.

SIU Edwardsville Joins the OVC: On July 1 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville became the 11th member of the Ohio Valley Conference. SIU Edwardsville, who is in the reclassification process to Division I, will begin regular season competition in the OVC during the 2011-12 academic year and will be eligible for postseason competition in 2012-13. The exception is the SIUE softball program, which will be eligible for both regular season and tournament competition in 2010-11; the softball program was the department's women's sport designee to be fast-tracked to Division I, making it eligible to compete at Division I prior to other SIUE sports. SIUE is located in Edwardsville, Ill., which is just northeast of St. Louis (the 18th largest media market in the United States).
